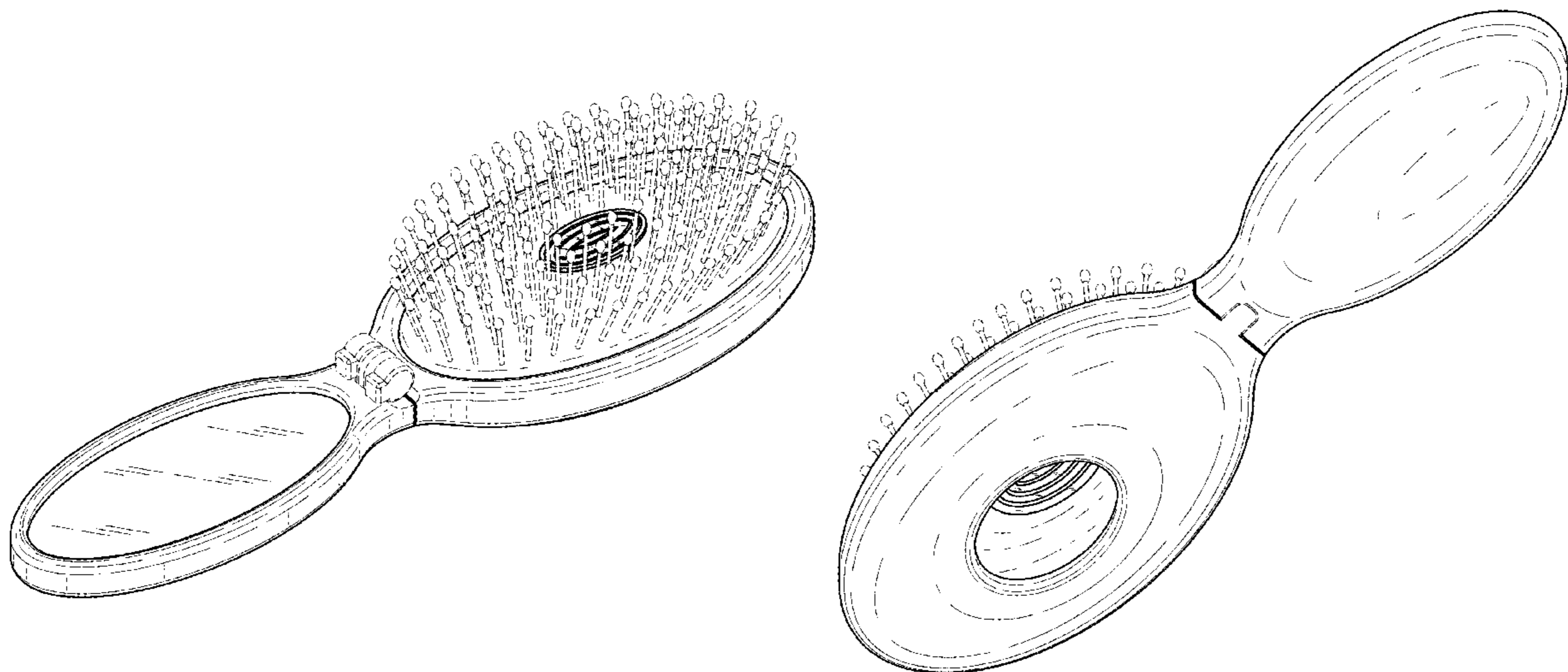
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foldable pop up brush with mirror, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 8 is a perspective view thereof with the brush in a folded position and the bristles in a non-pop up position;
 FIG. 9 is rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a perspective view thereof with the brush in an unfolded position and the bristles in a non-pop up position; and,
 FIG. 11 is an opposite perspective view of FIG. 7.
 The portion of the foldable pop up brush with mirror shown in broken lines form no part of the claimed design. The ovular feature in FIG. 2 is shown through the hole or recess and in FIG. 9 it is shown as flushed with the surface.

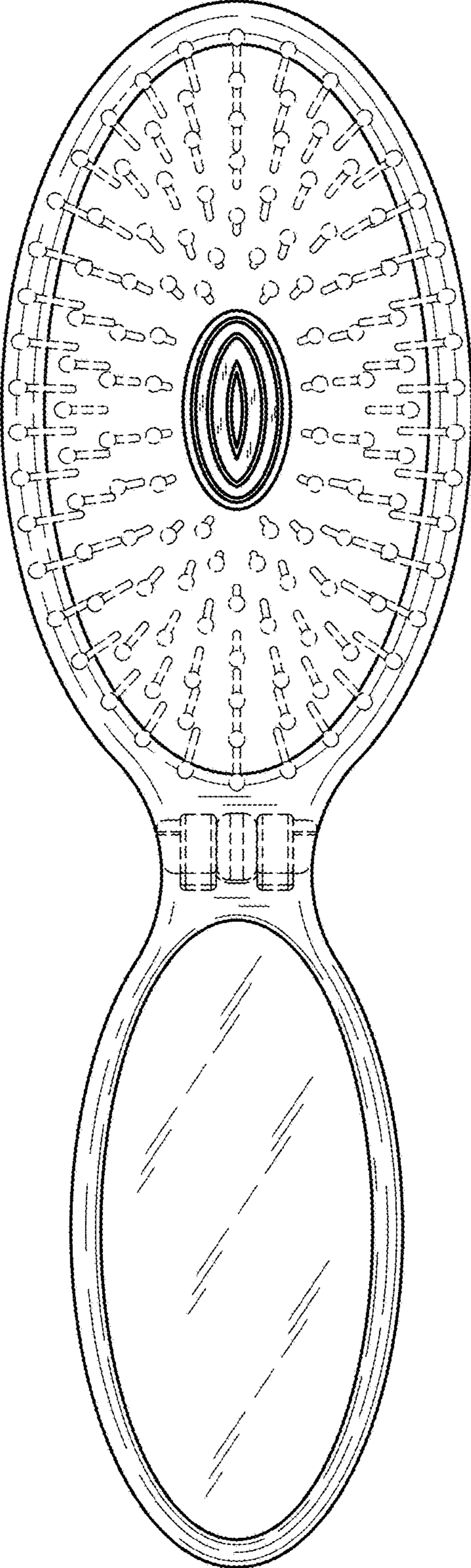

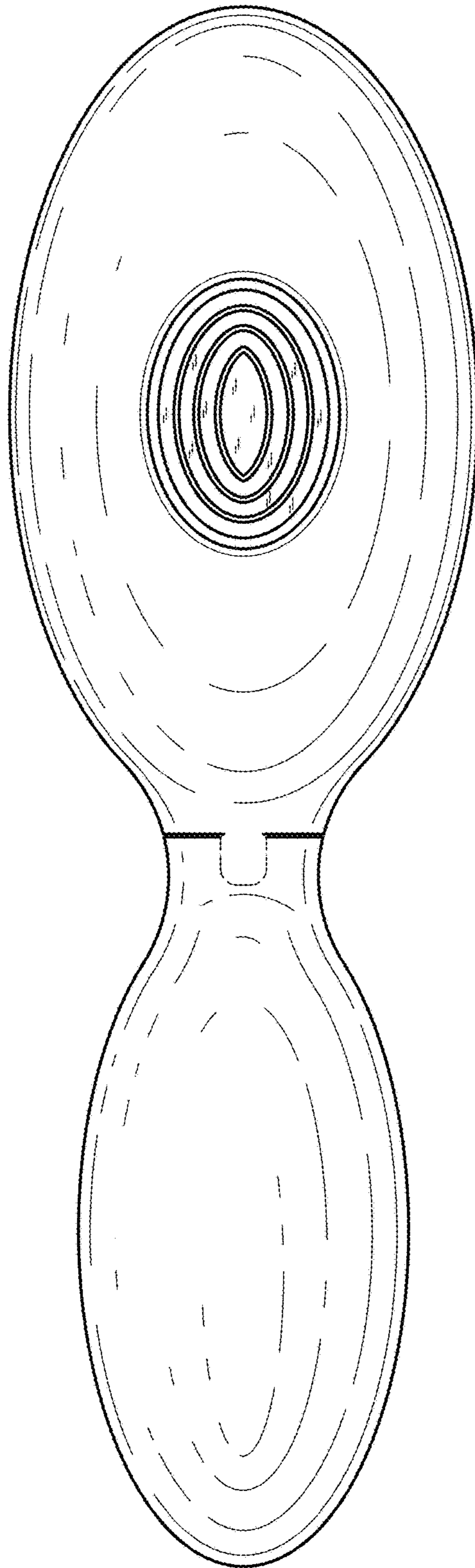

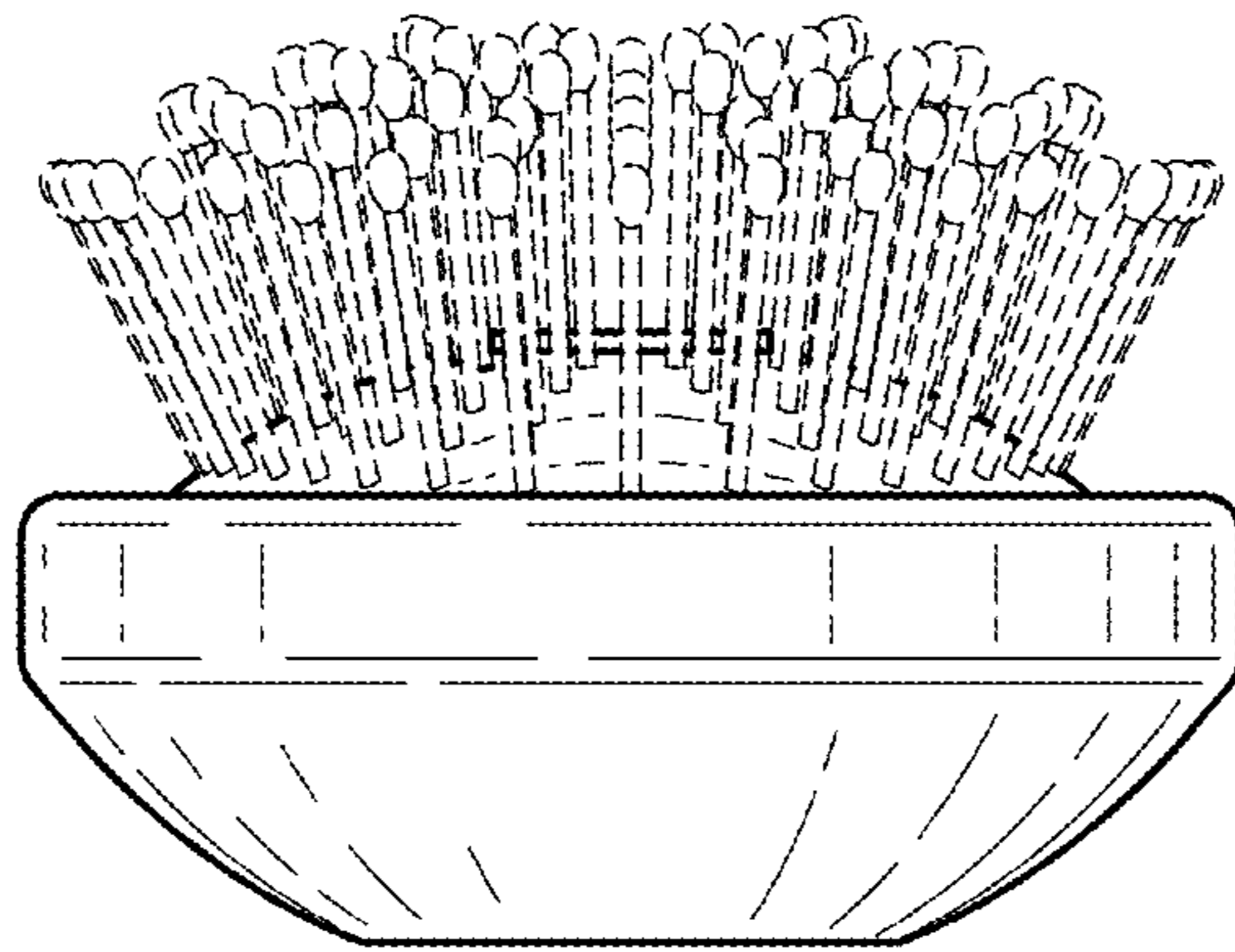

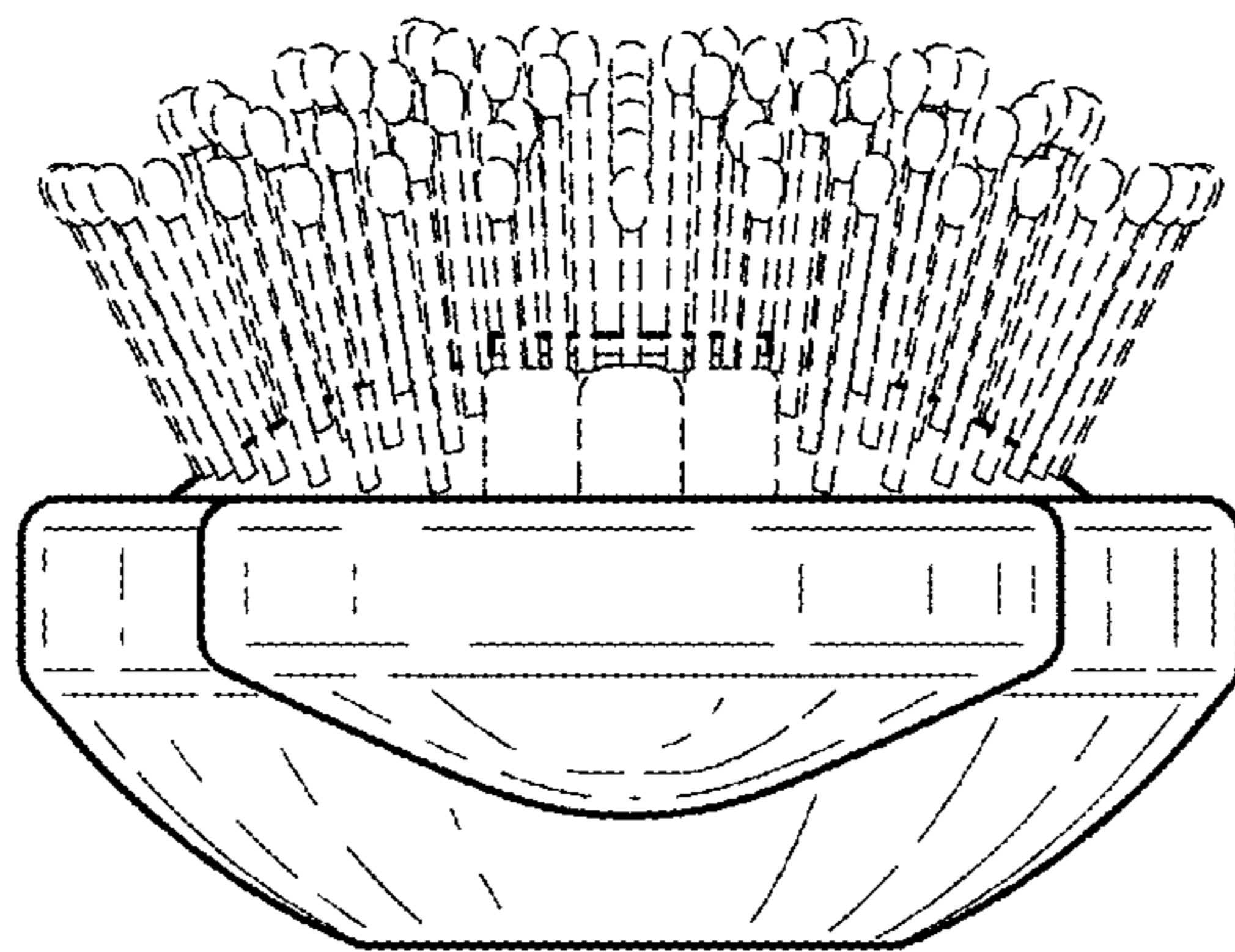

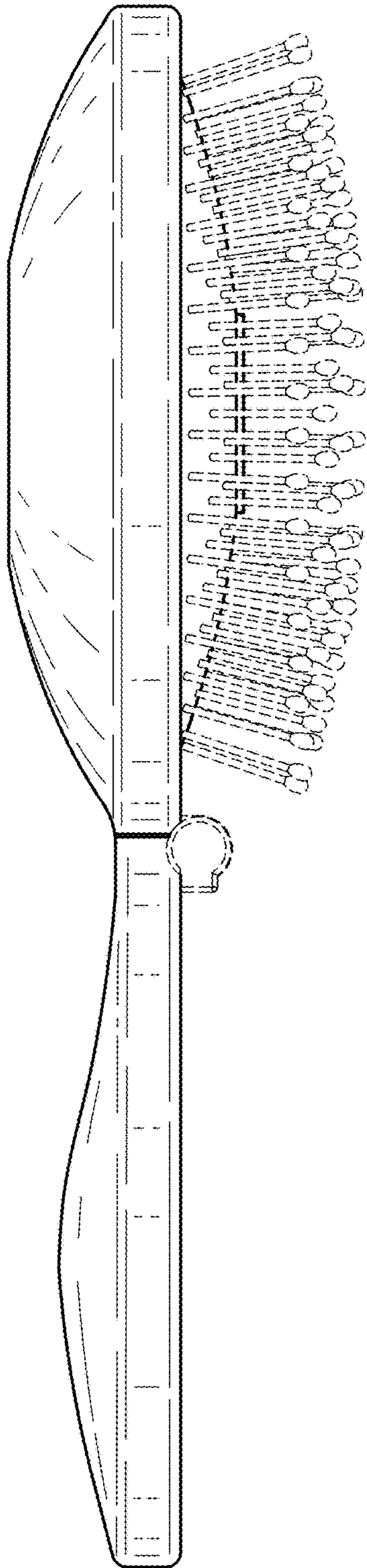

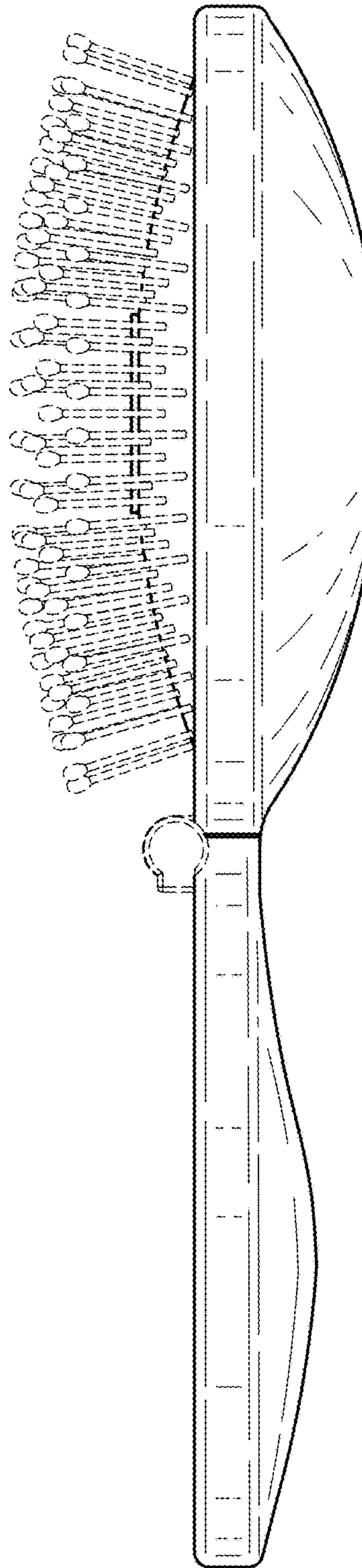

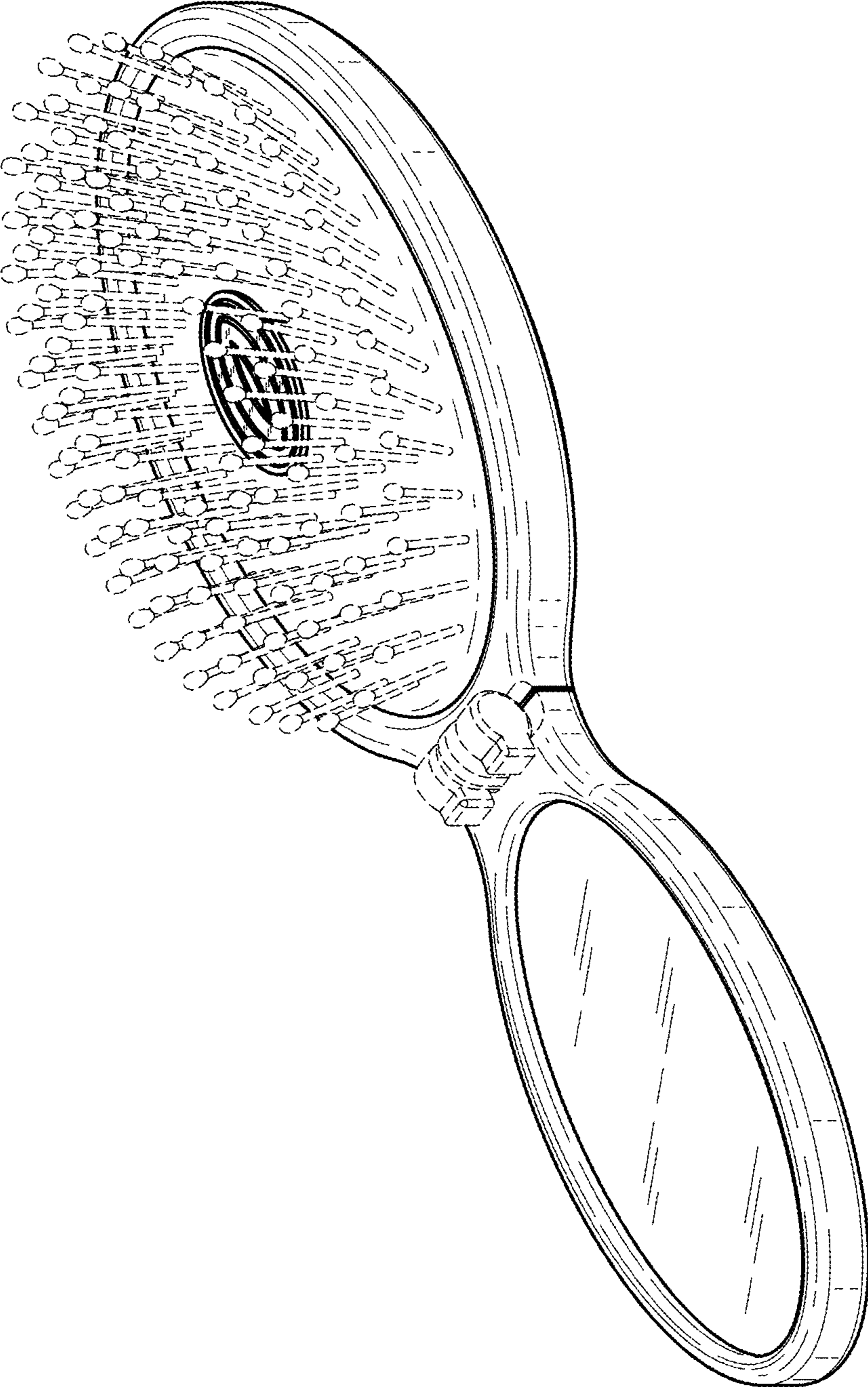

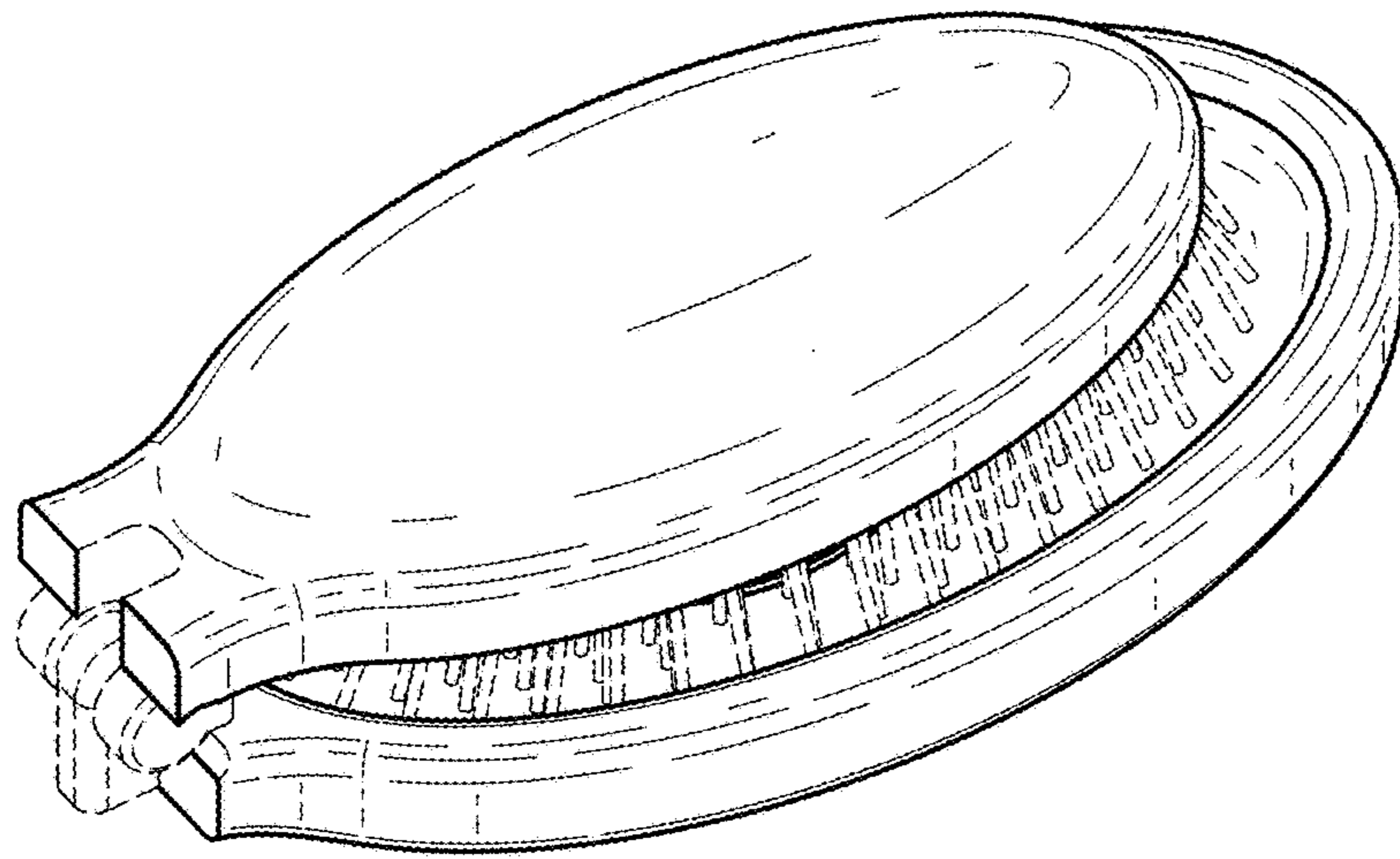

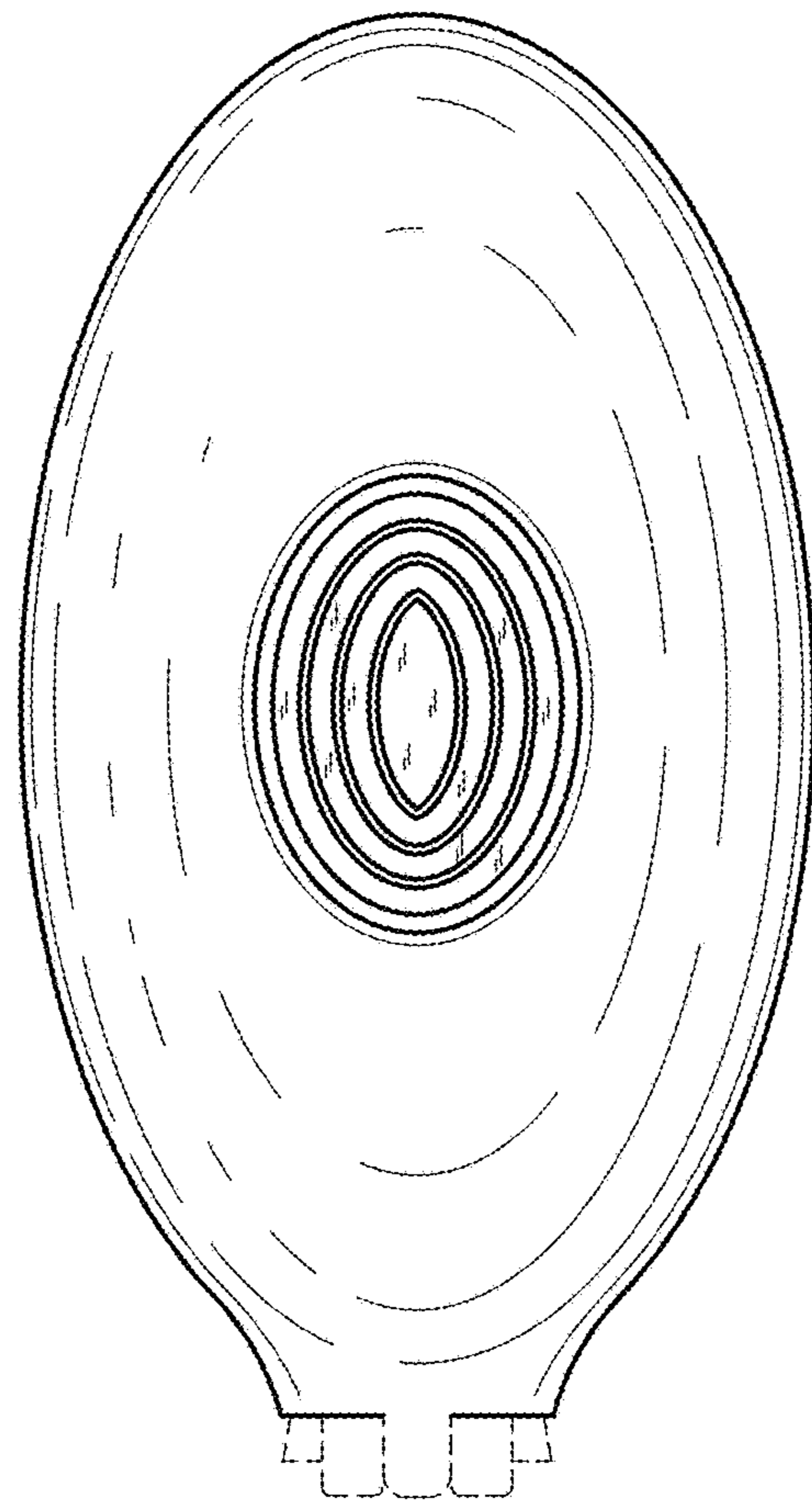

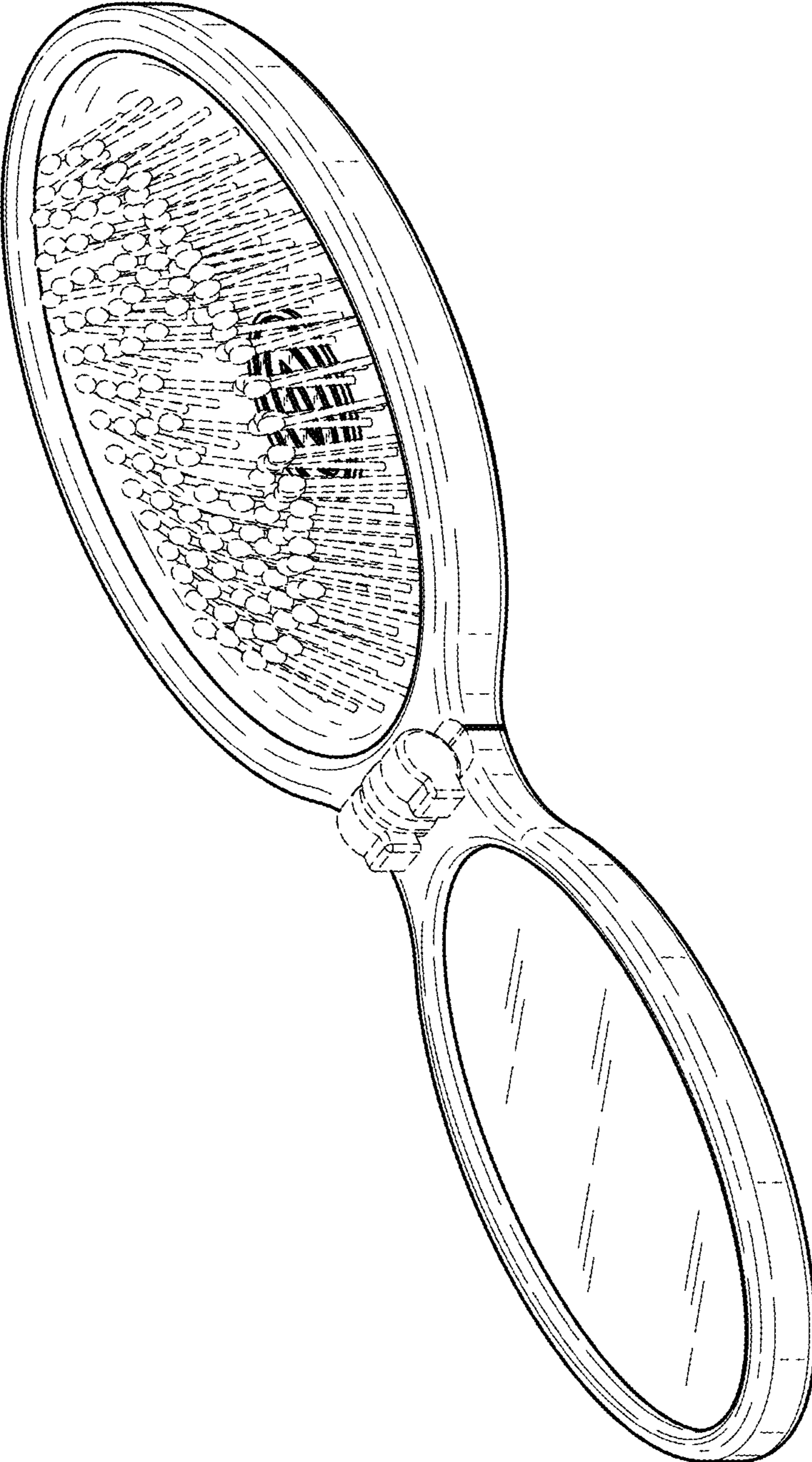

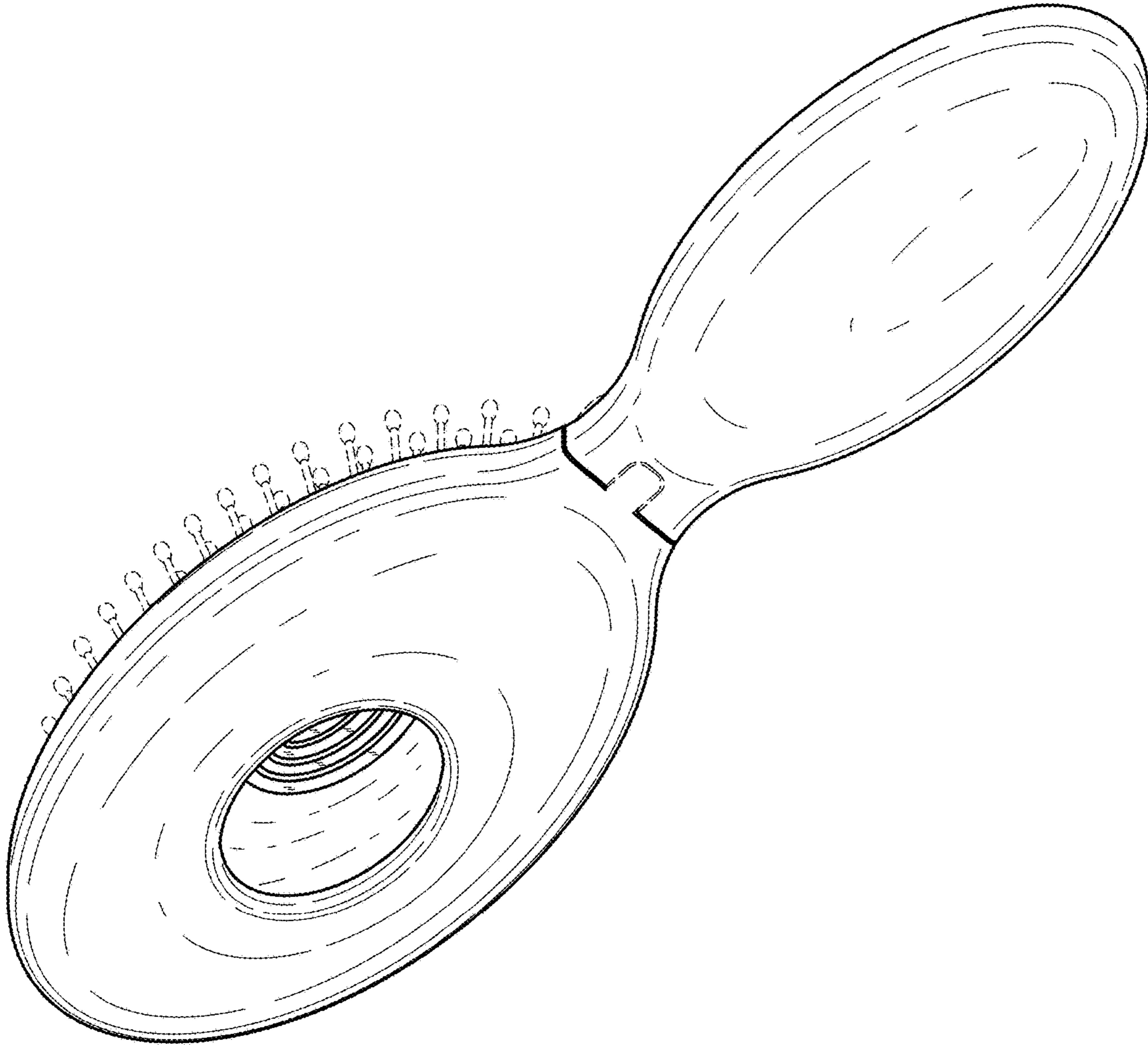
