(57) **CLAIM**

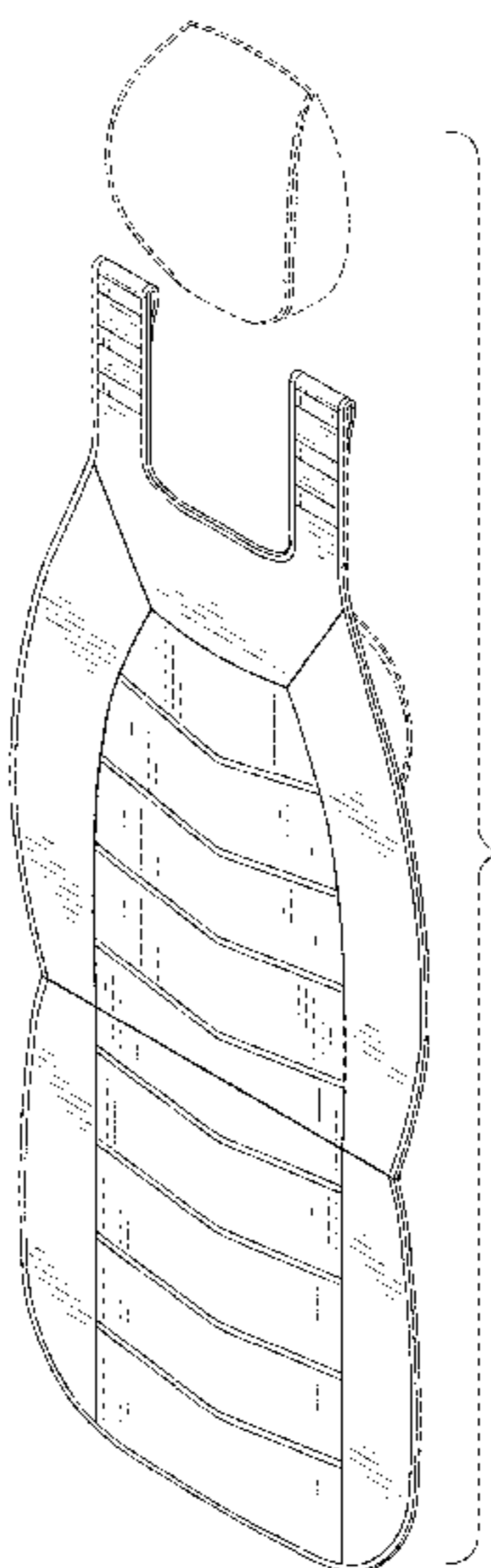
The ornamental design for a car seat cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a car seat cover showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top, rear and left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom, front and left side perspective view showing the car seat cover in a use state; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view showing the car seat cover in a use state.

The broken lines depicting a headrest and car seat represent environment that forms no part of the claimed design. All other broken lines depict portions of the car seat cover that form no part of the claimed design.

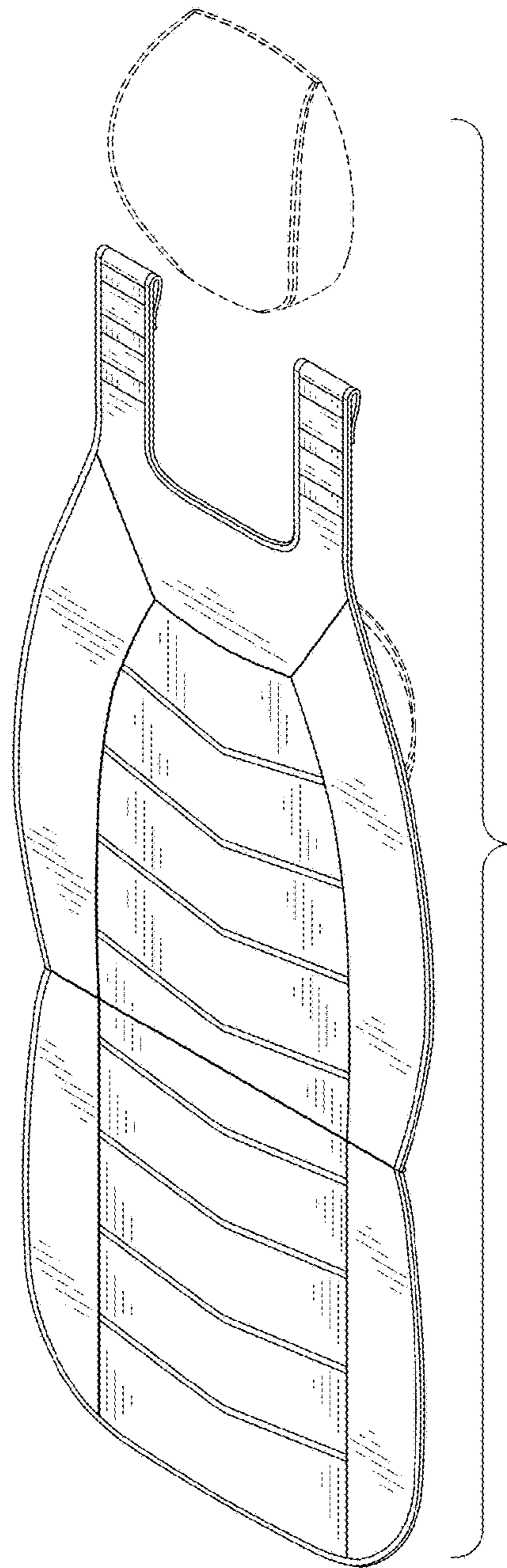

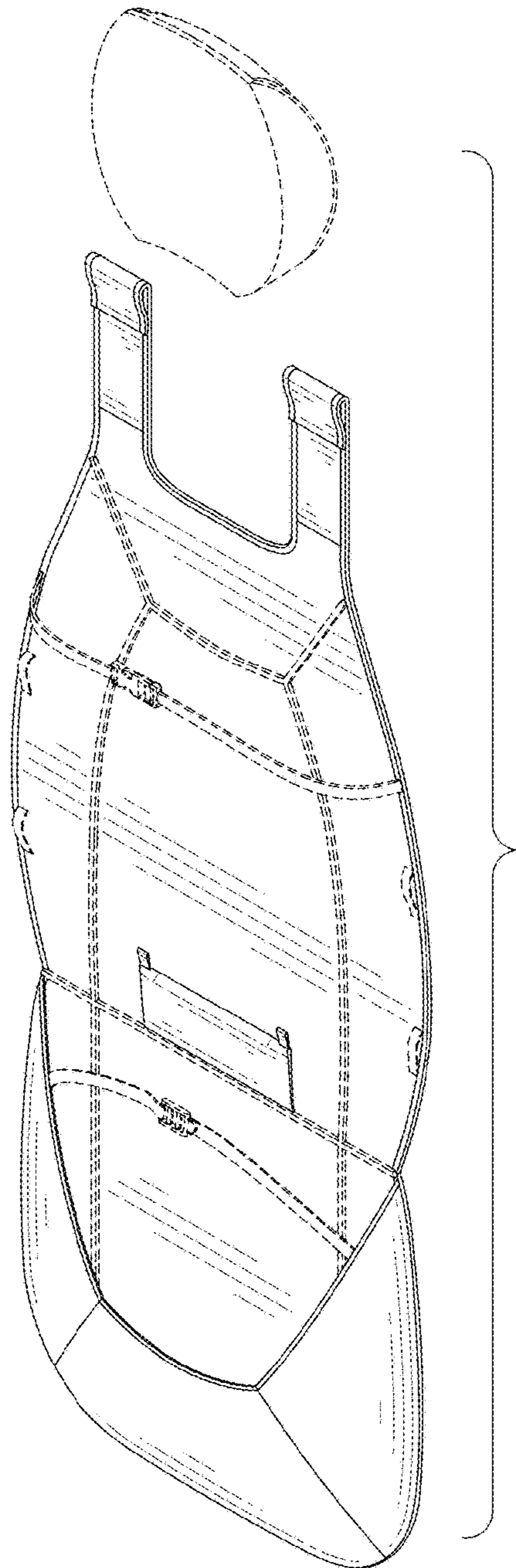

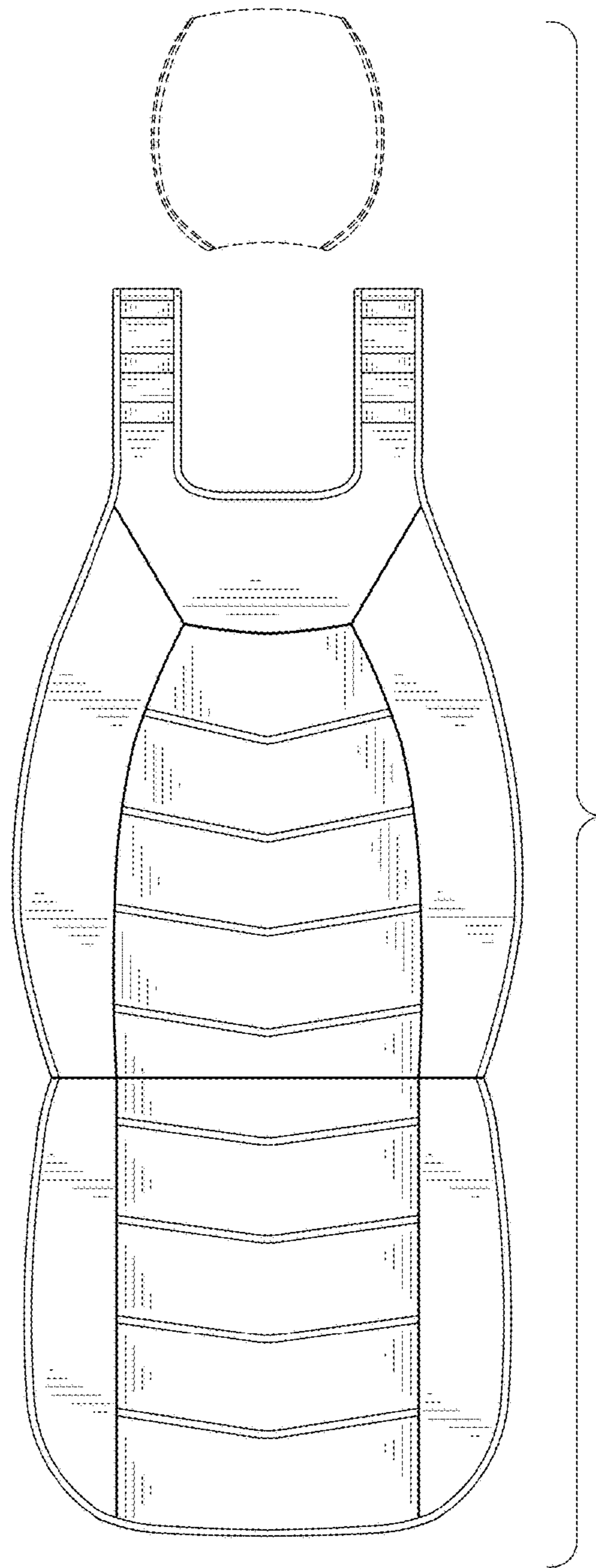

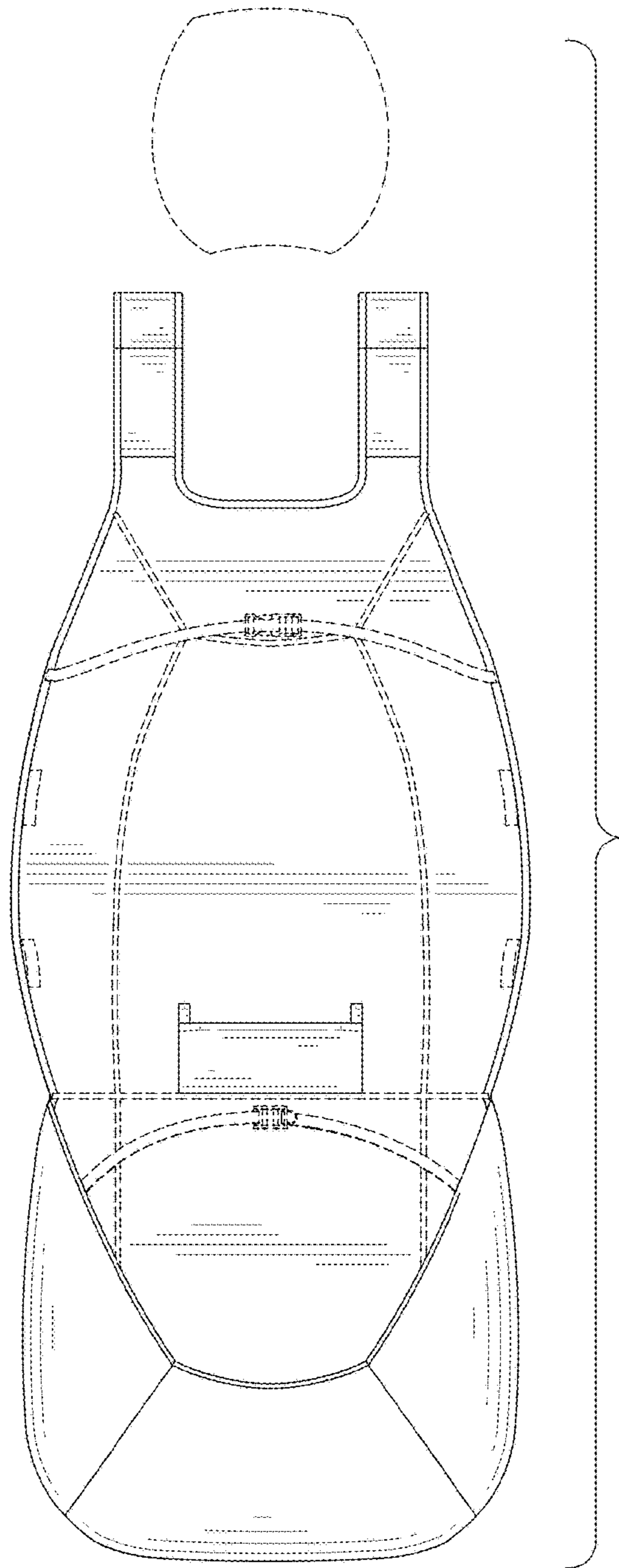

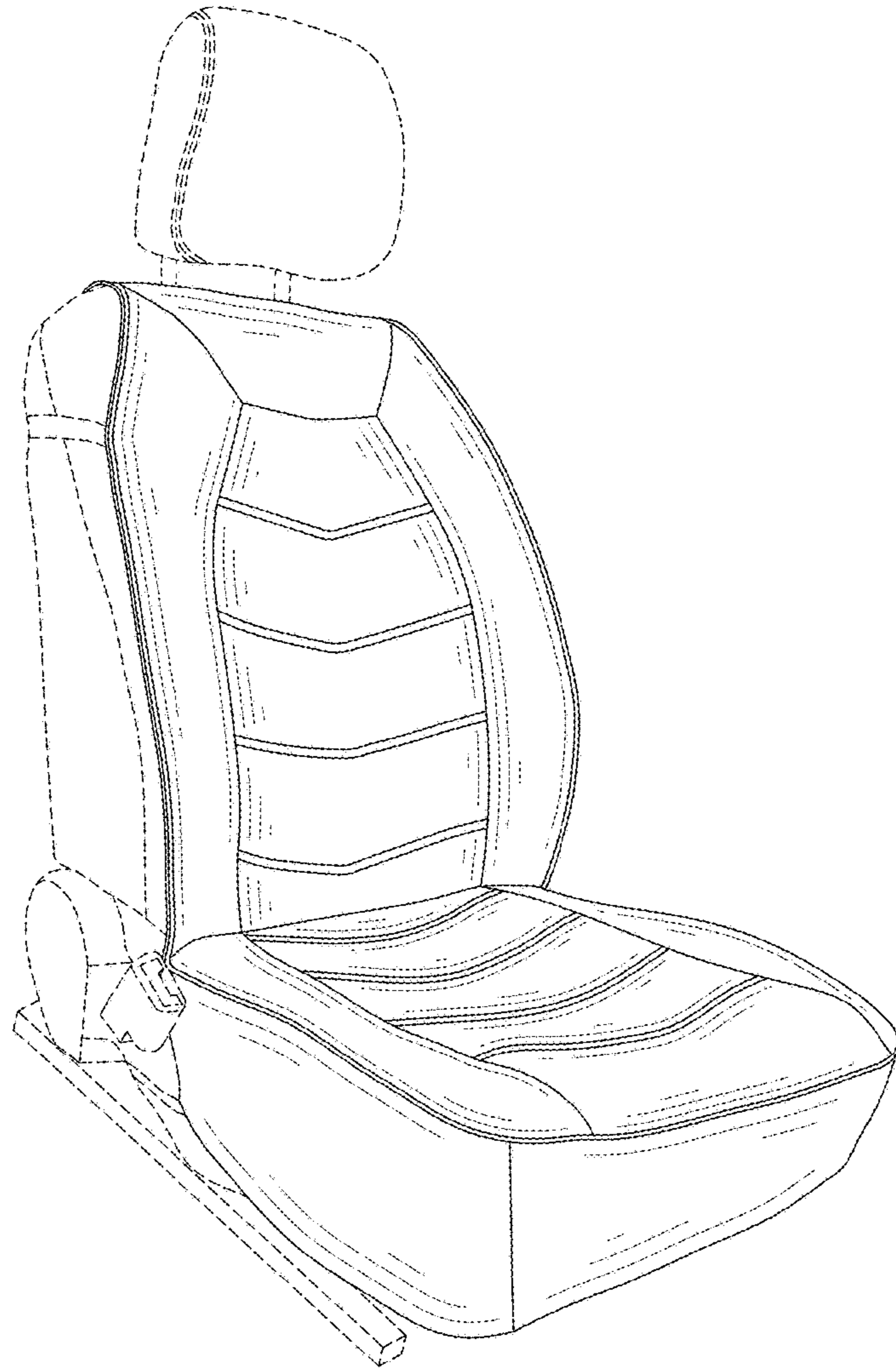

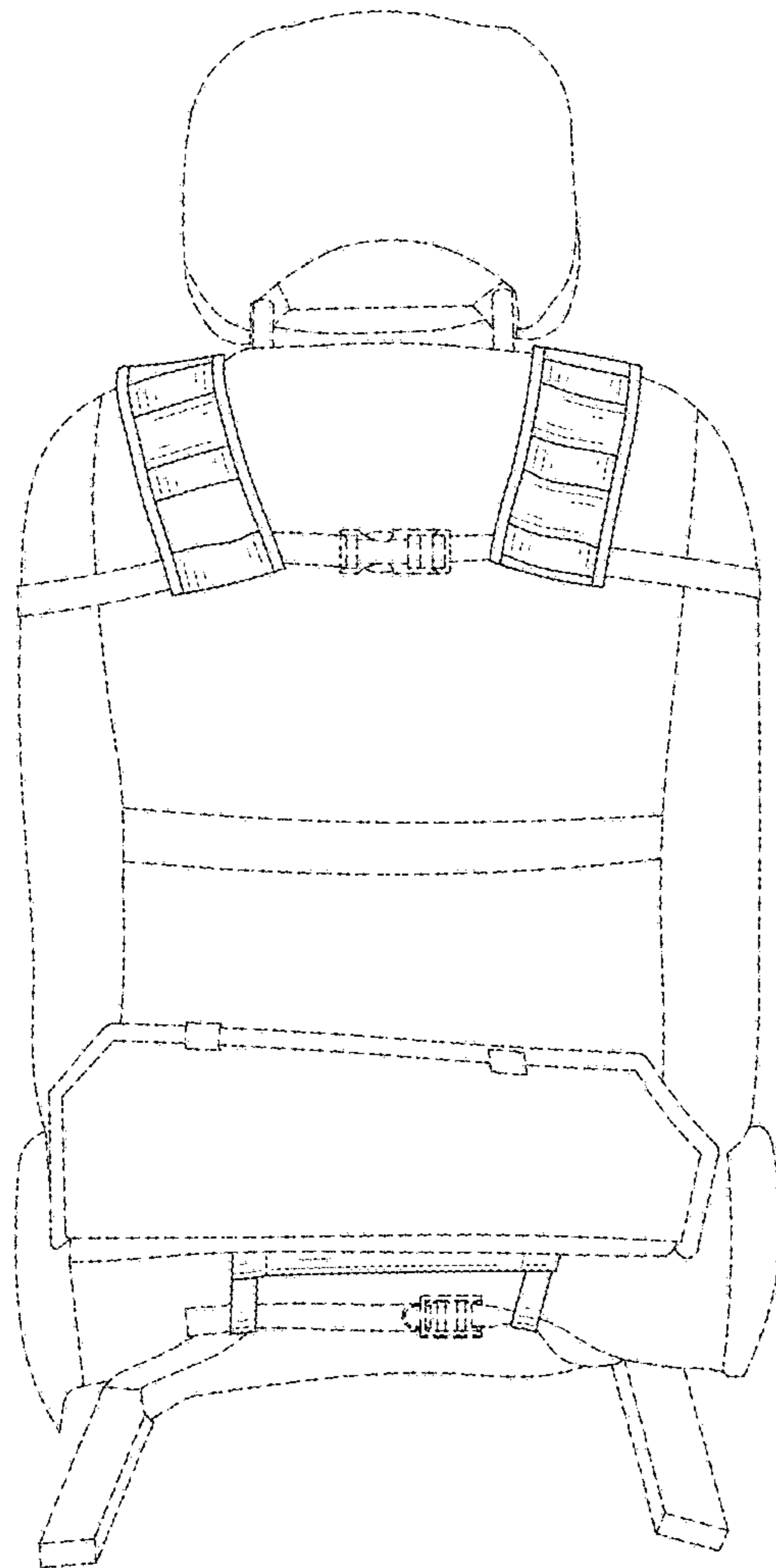
