to a second embodiment;

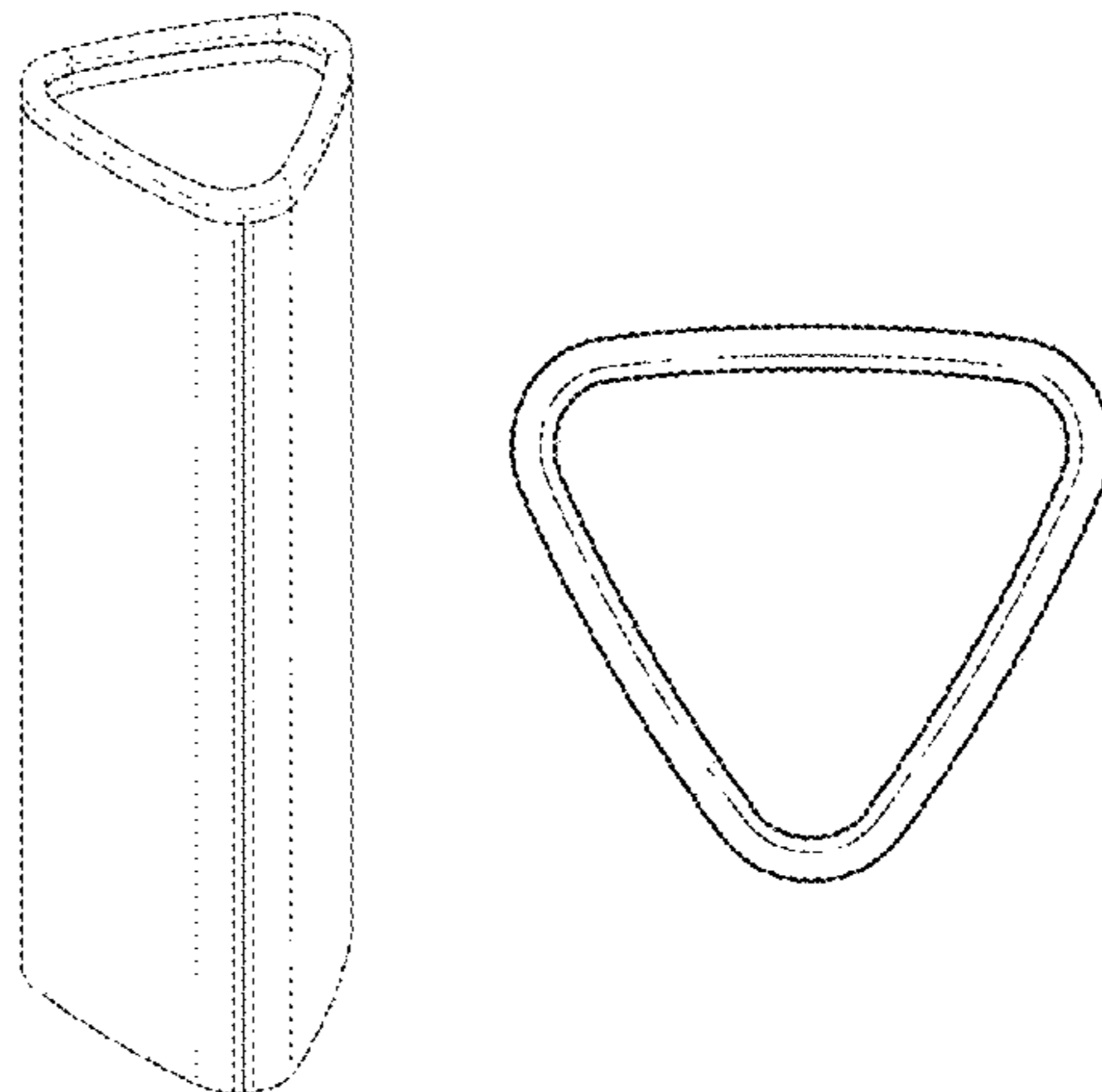
FIG. 9 is a back view of the snack food container according

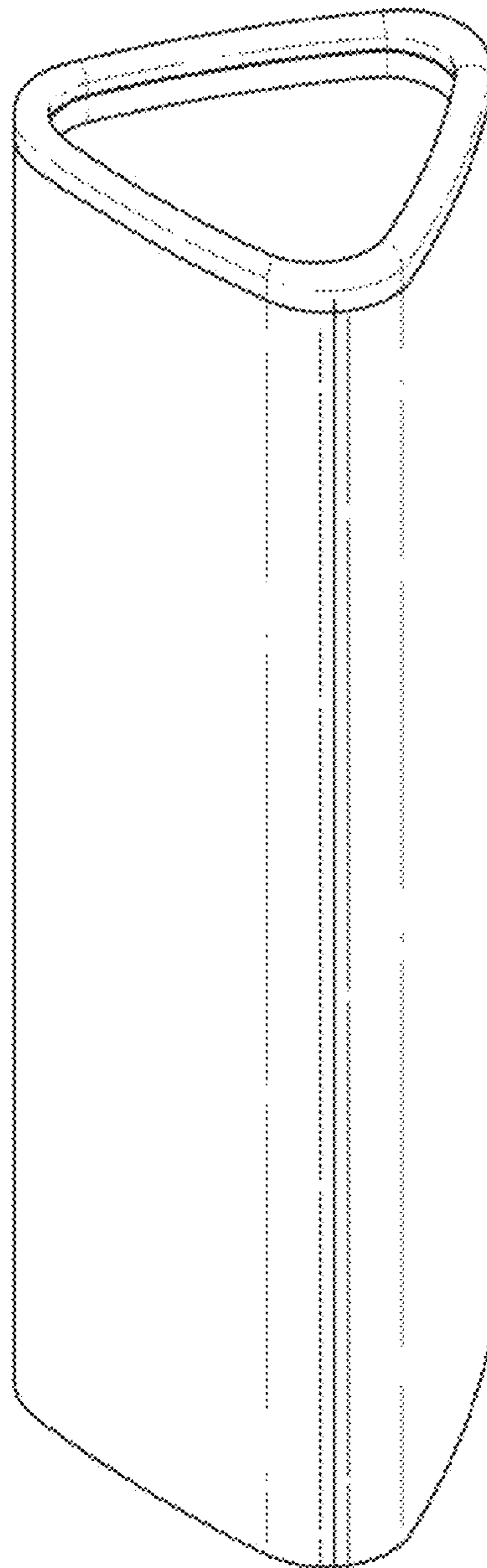

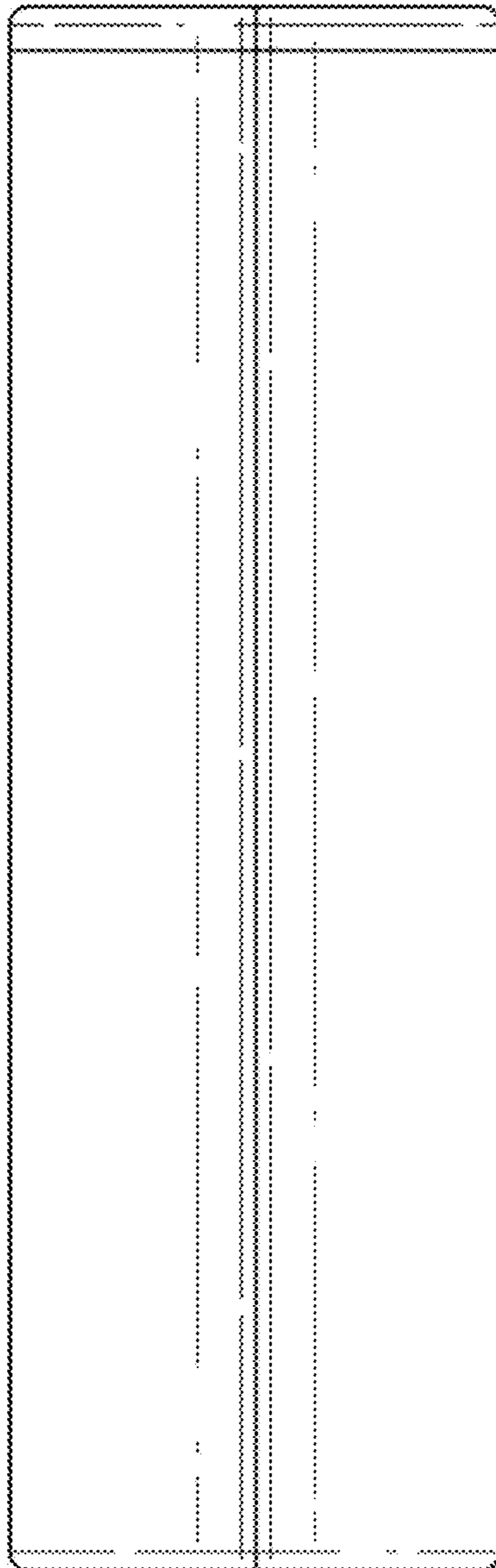

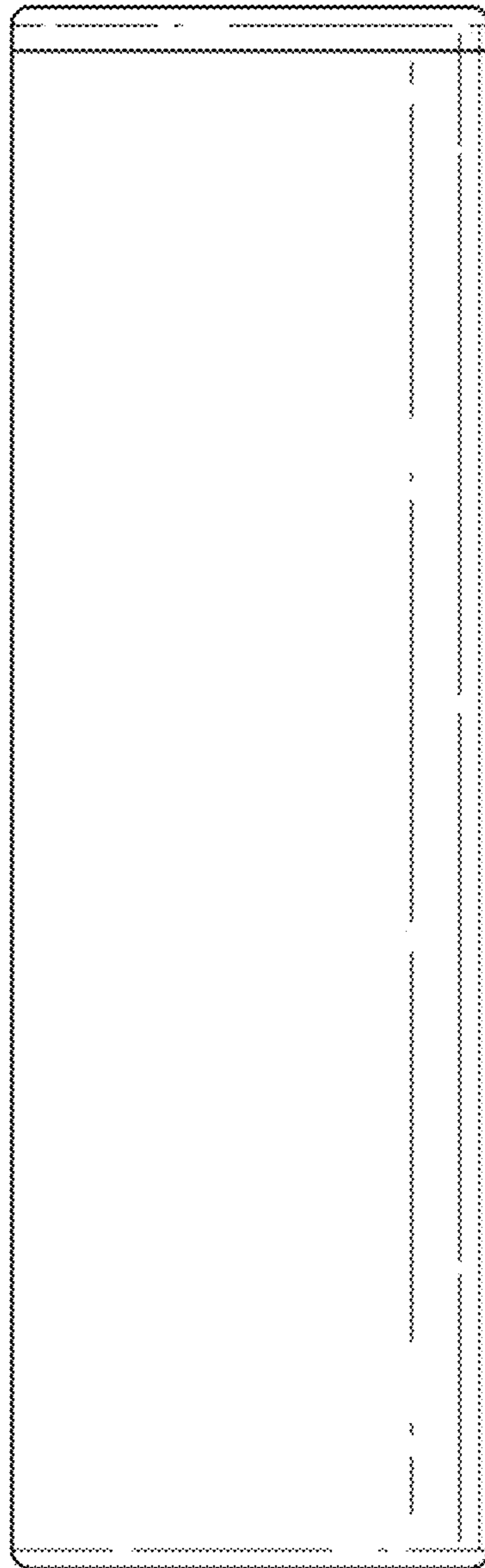

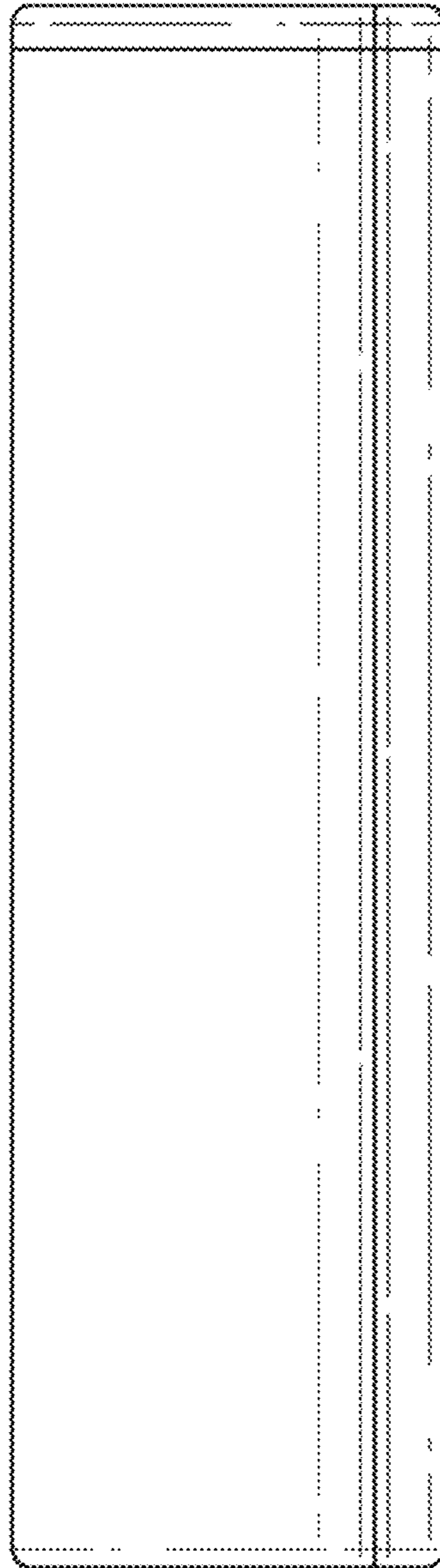

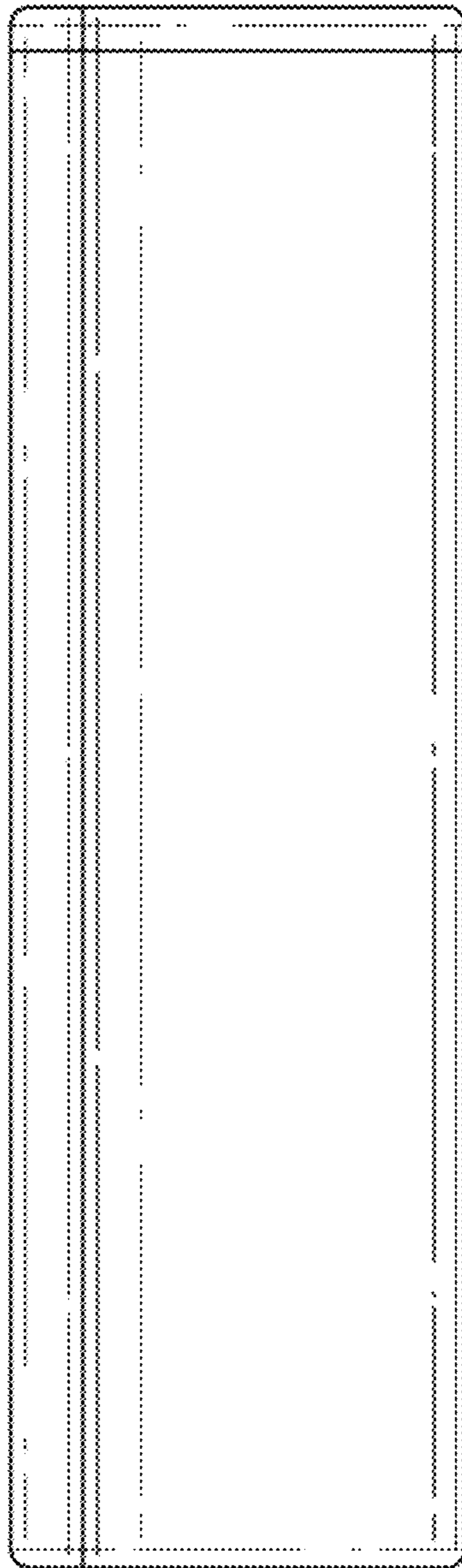

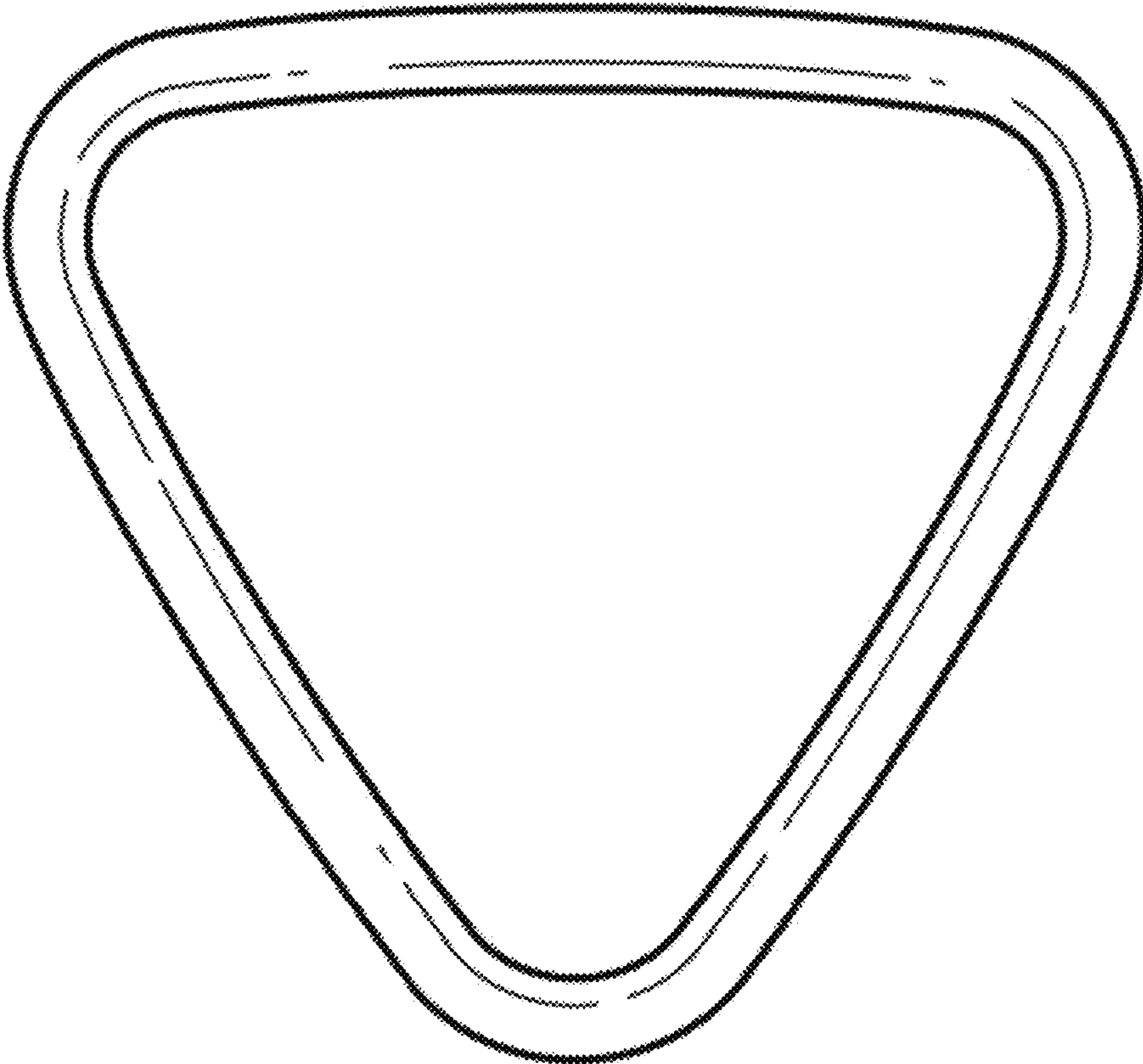

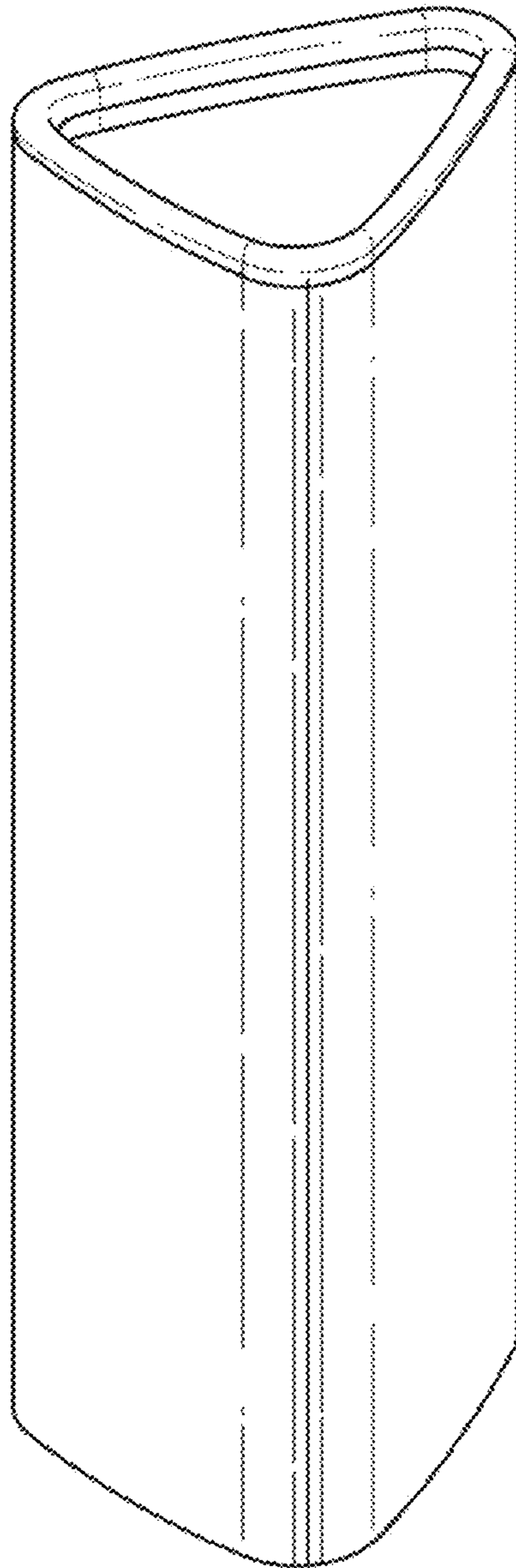

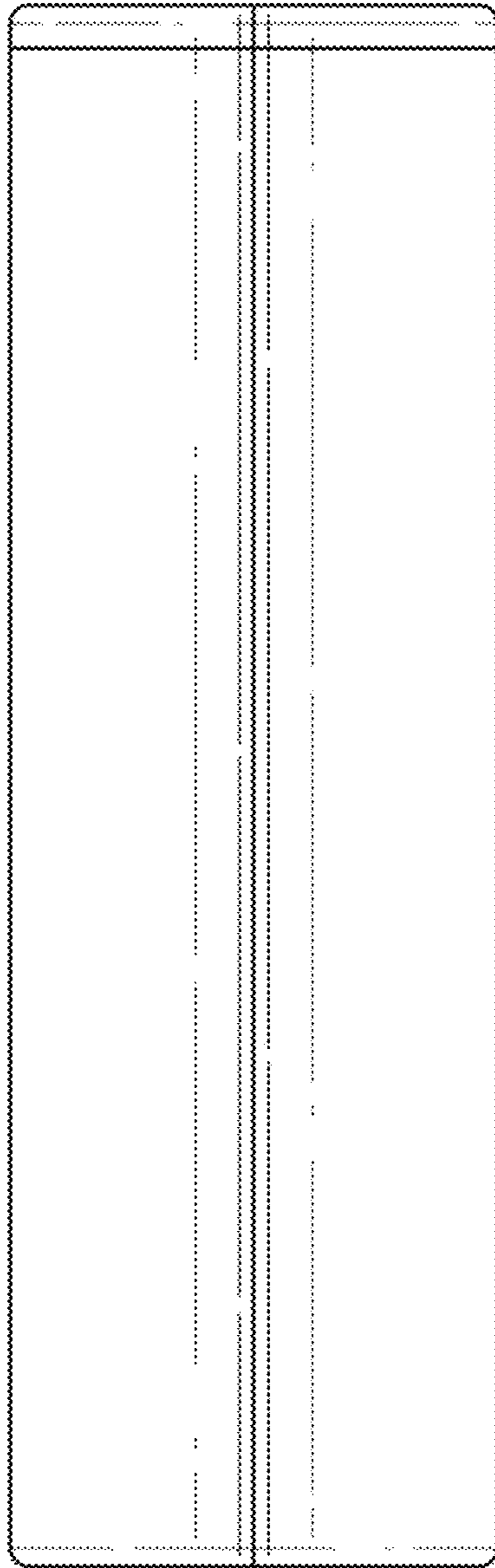

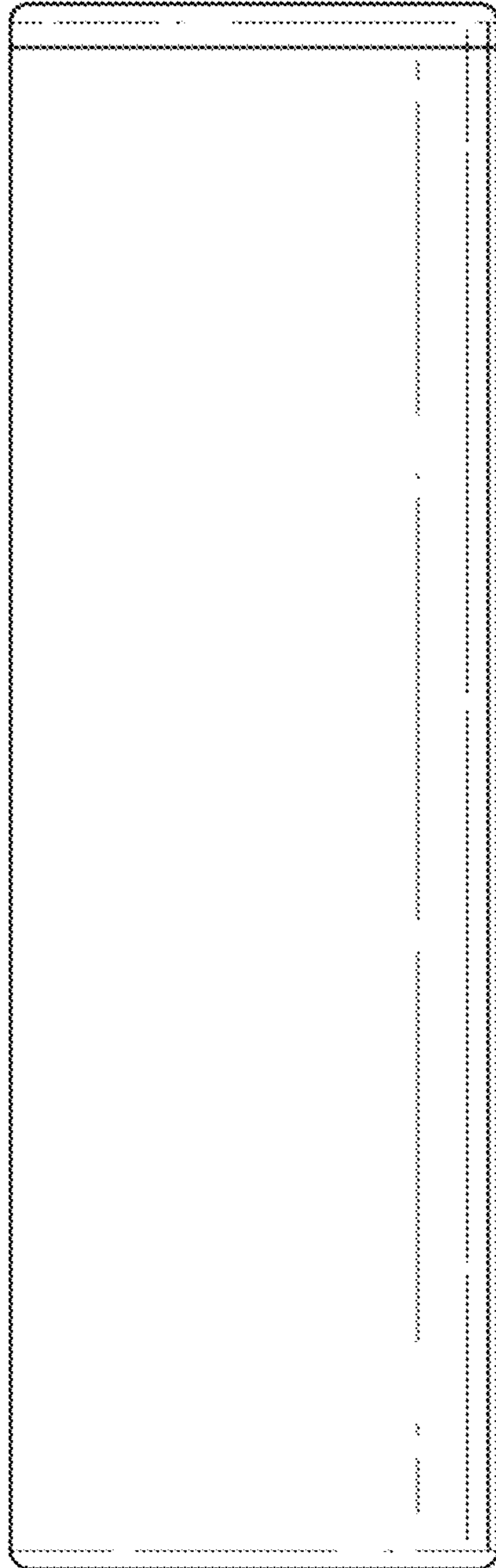

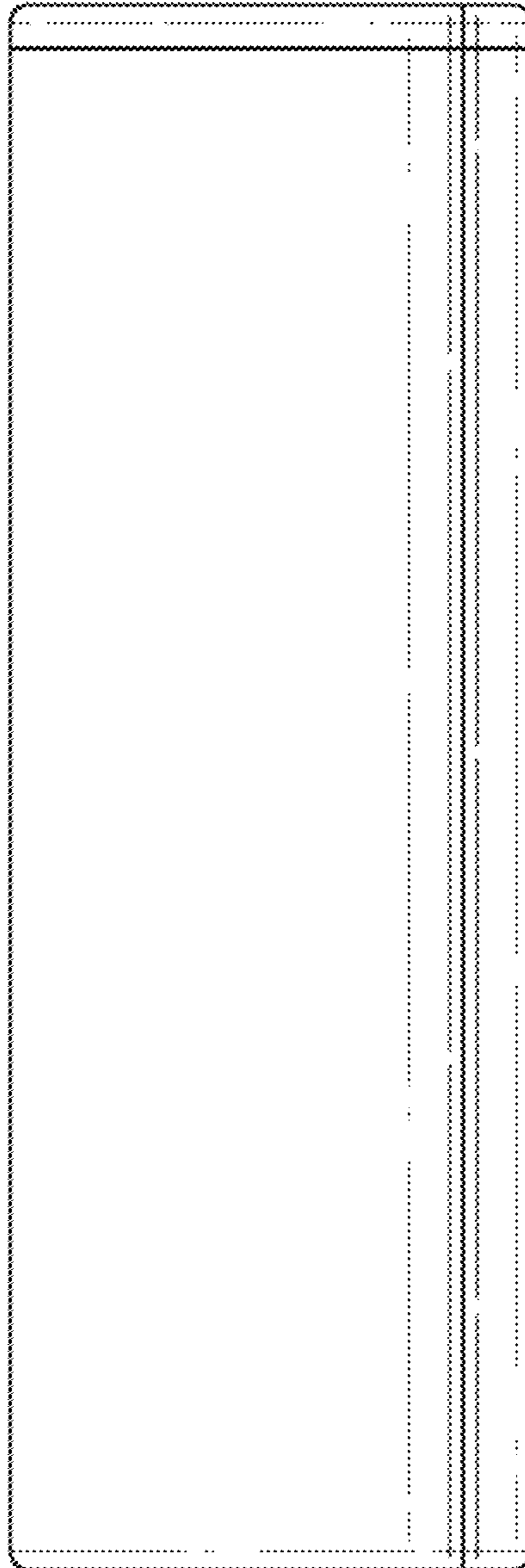

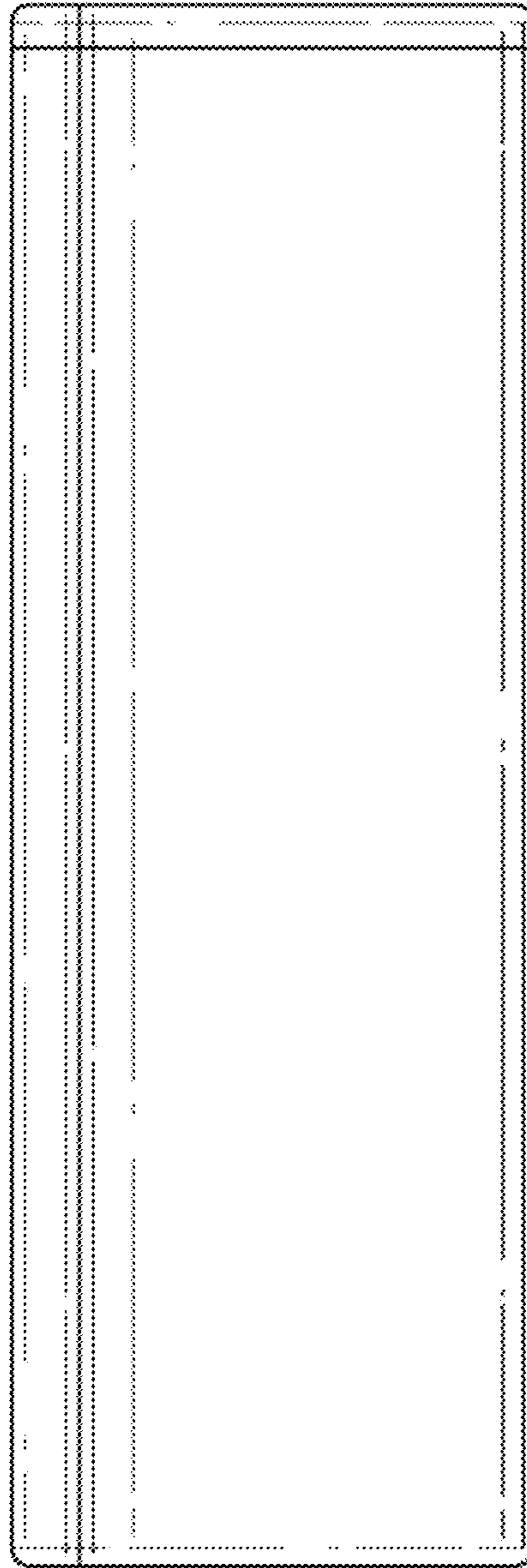

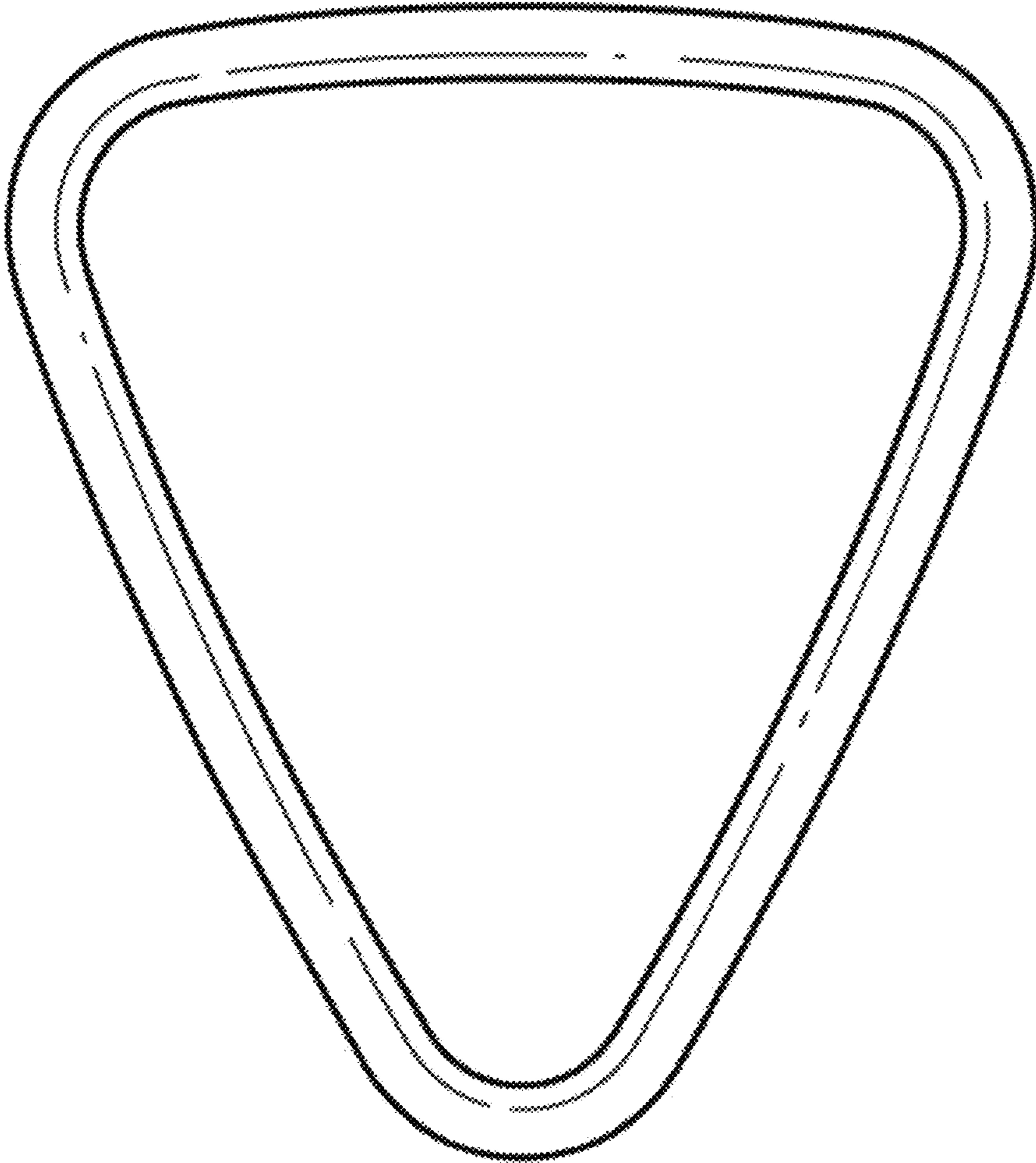
