The ornamental design for a shade cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shade cover, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an opposite side view of FIG. 4;

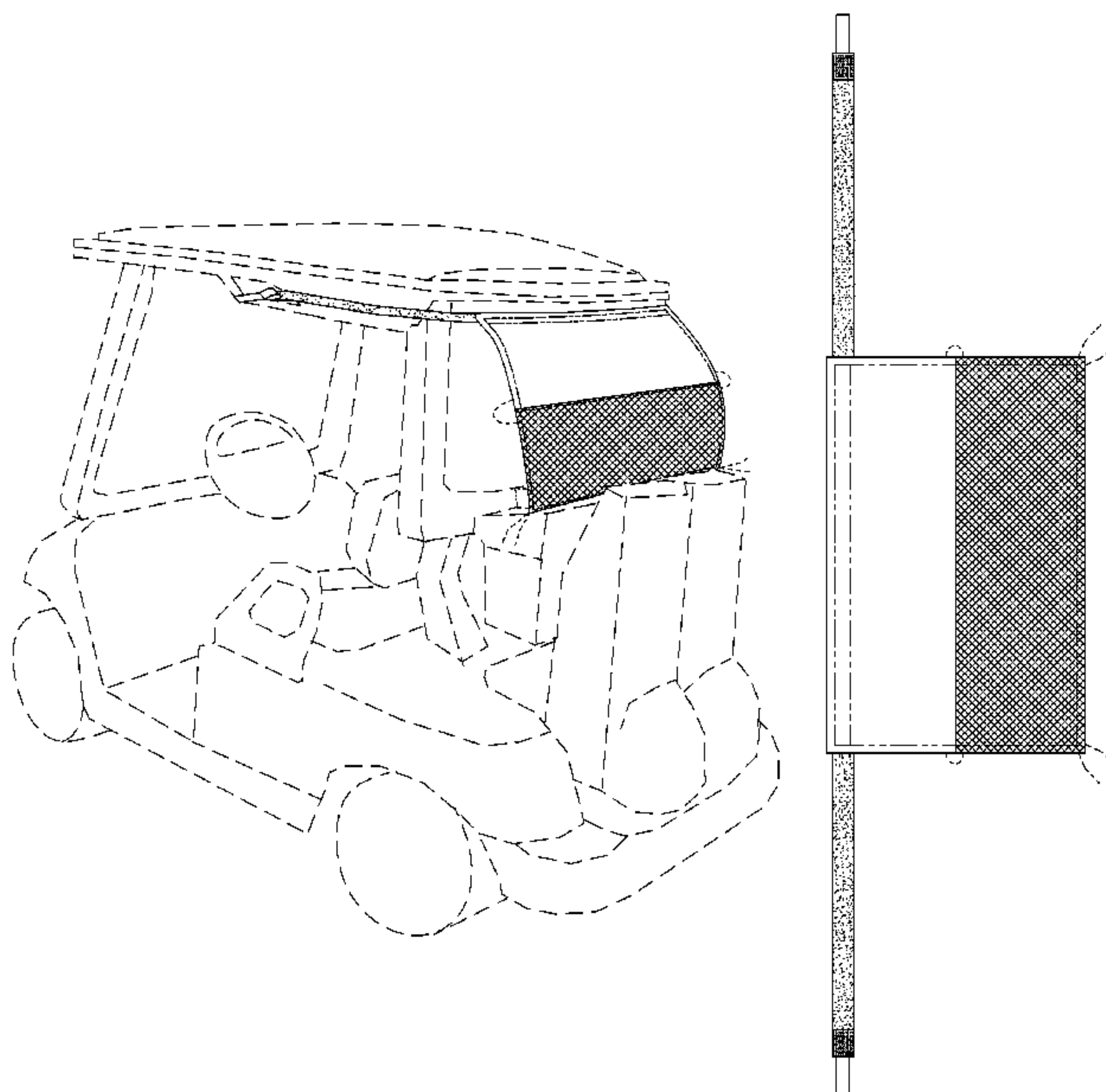
FIG. 6 is a top view of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of FIG. 1.

The broken line portion of FIG. 1 is included to show environment that form no part of the claimed design. The dot-dot-dash line portion of FIG. 1-3 represent stitching.

The scattered stippling shown in FIG. 1-7 represents hook and loop fastening material.

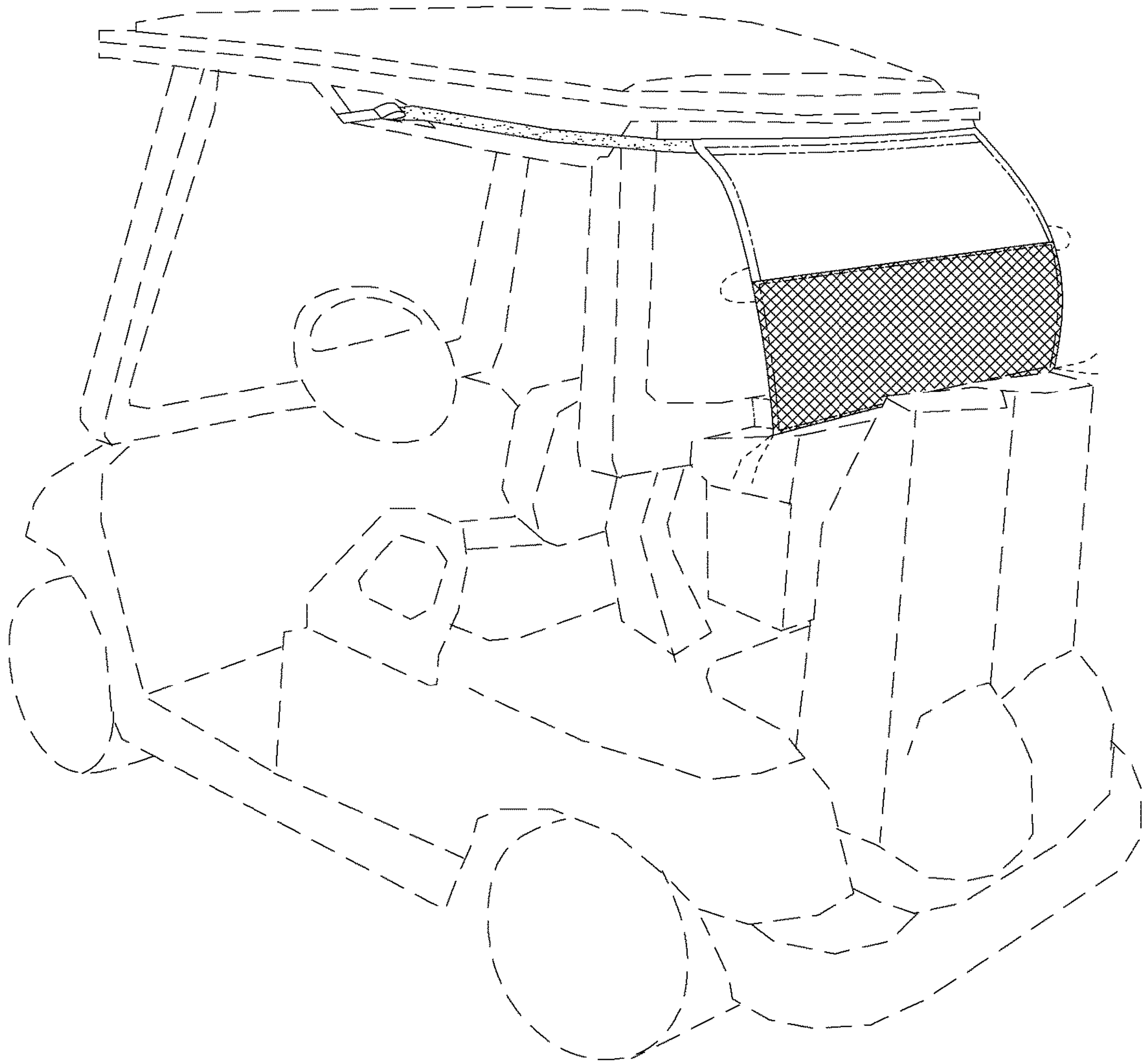

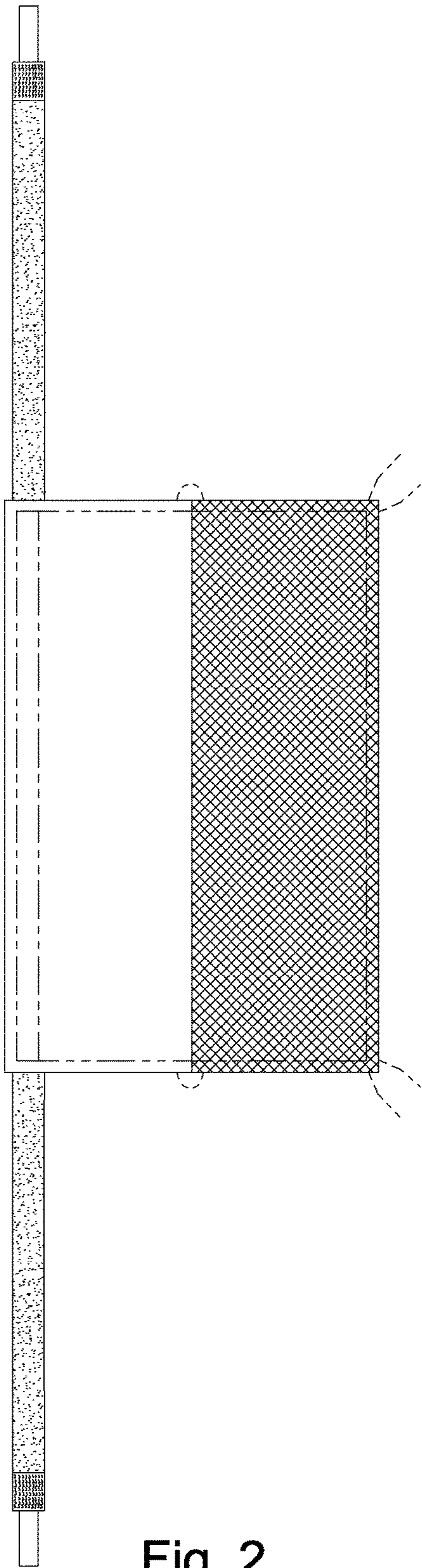

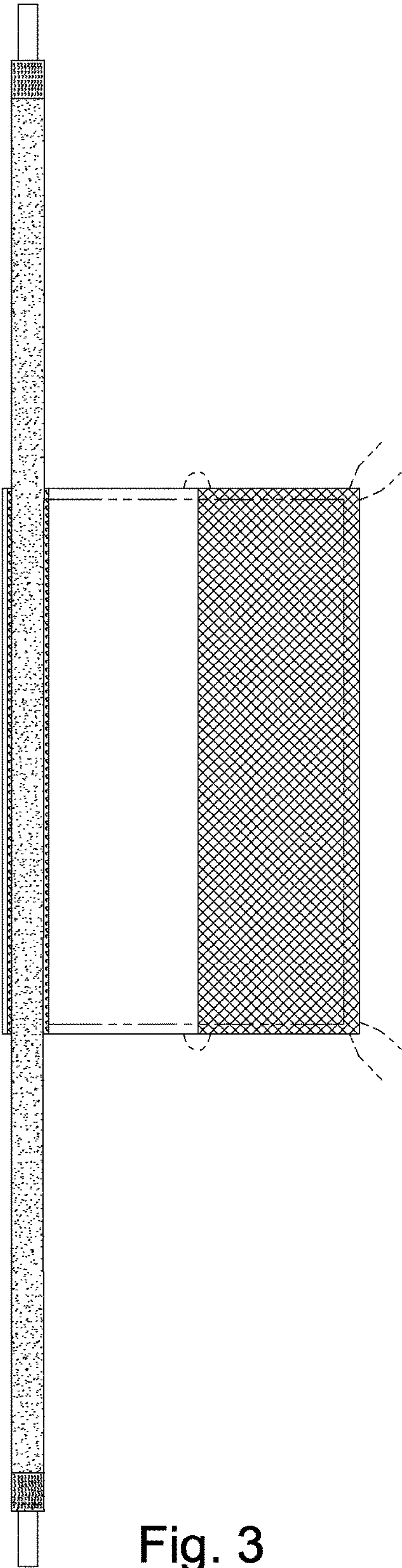

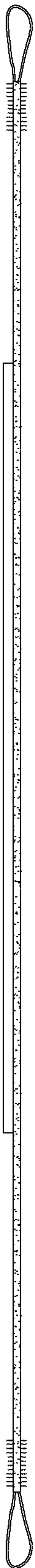
