FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of cards Army E1, E2, E3, E4, E5, E6, E7, E8, and E9 of my military-based card deck; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of cards Army WO, O1, O2, O3, O4, O5, O6, O7, and O8 thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of cards Army O9, O10, and 5 STAR/O11 thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of cards Navy E1, E2, E3, E4, E5, E6, E7, E8, and E9 thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevation view of cards Navy WO, O1, O2, O3, O4, O5, O6, O7, and O8 thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of cards Navy O9, O10, and 5 STAR/O11 thereof; FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of cards Air Force E1, E2, E3, E4, E5, E6, E7, E8, and E9 thereof; FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of cards Air Force WO, O1, O2, O3, O4, O5, O6, O7, and O8 thereof; FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of cards Air Force O9, O10, and 5 STAR/O11 thereof; FIG. 10 is a front elevation view of cards Marines E1, E2, E3, E4, E5, E6, E7, E8, and E9 thereof; FIG. 11 is a front elevation view of cards Marines WO, O1, O2, O3, O4, O5, O6, O7, and O8 thereof; and FIG. 12 is a front elevation view of cards Marines O9, O10, and 5 STAR/O11 thereof; and FIG. 13 is a rear elevation view of each card of the military-based card deck. Each card is of conventional thickness, with the top edge, bottom edge, and side edges being unclaimed.

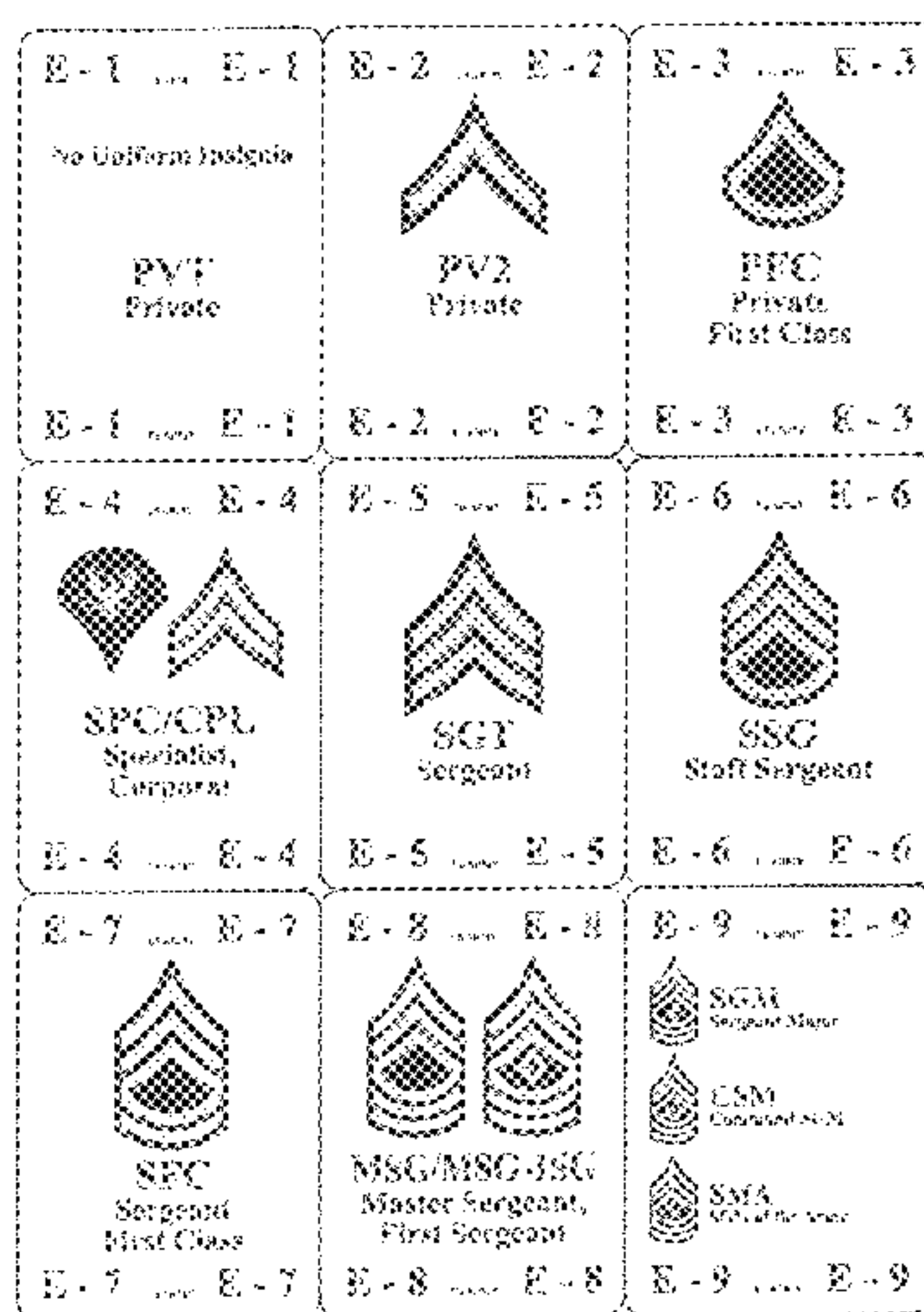

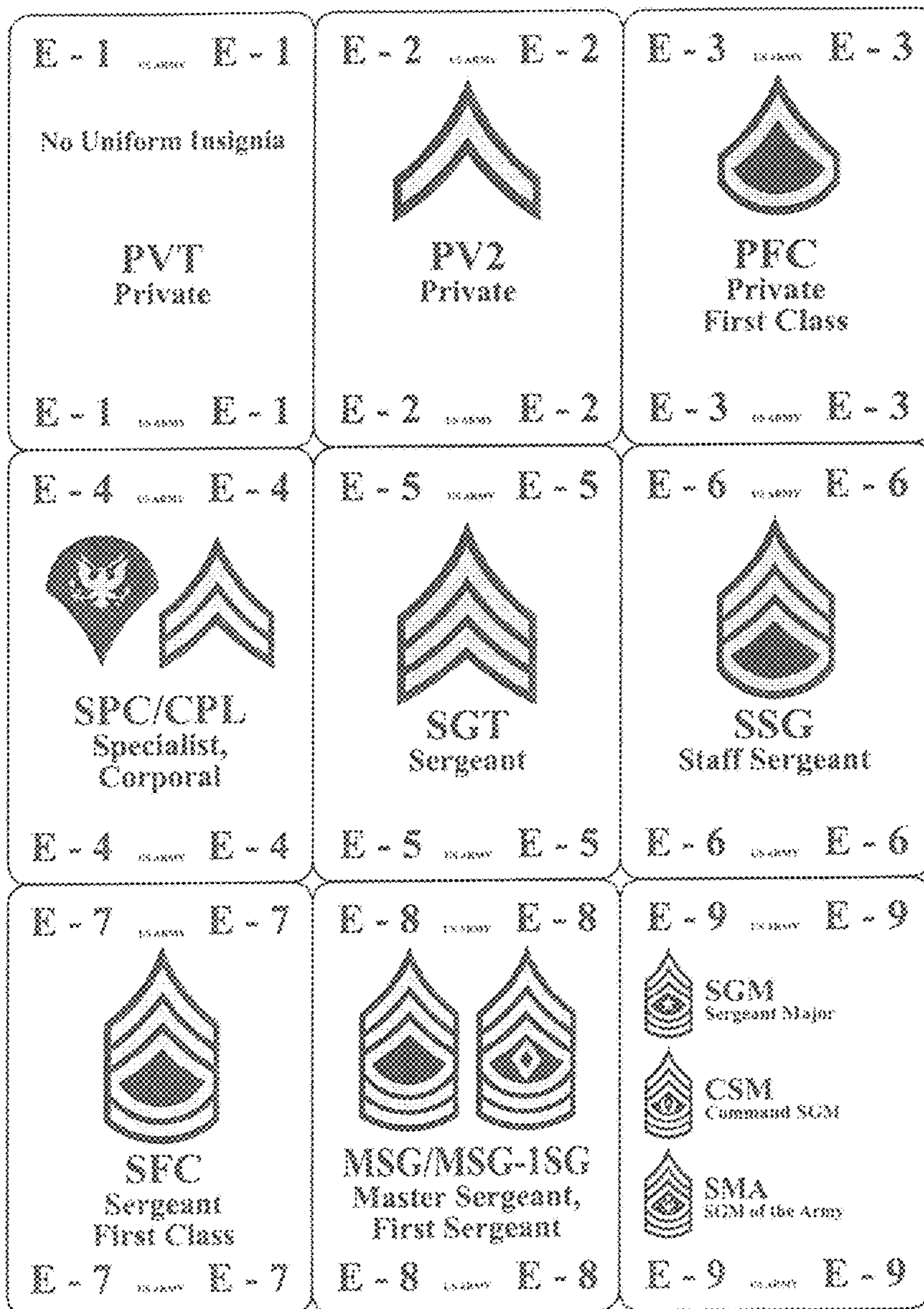

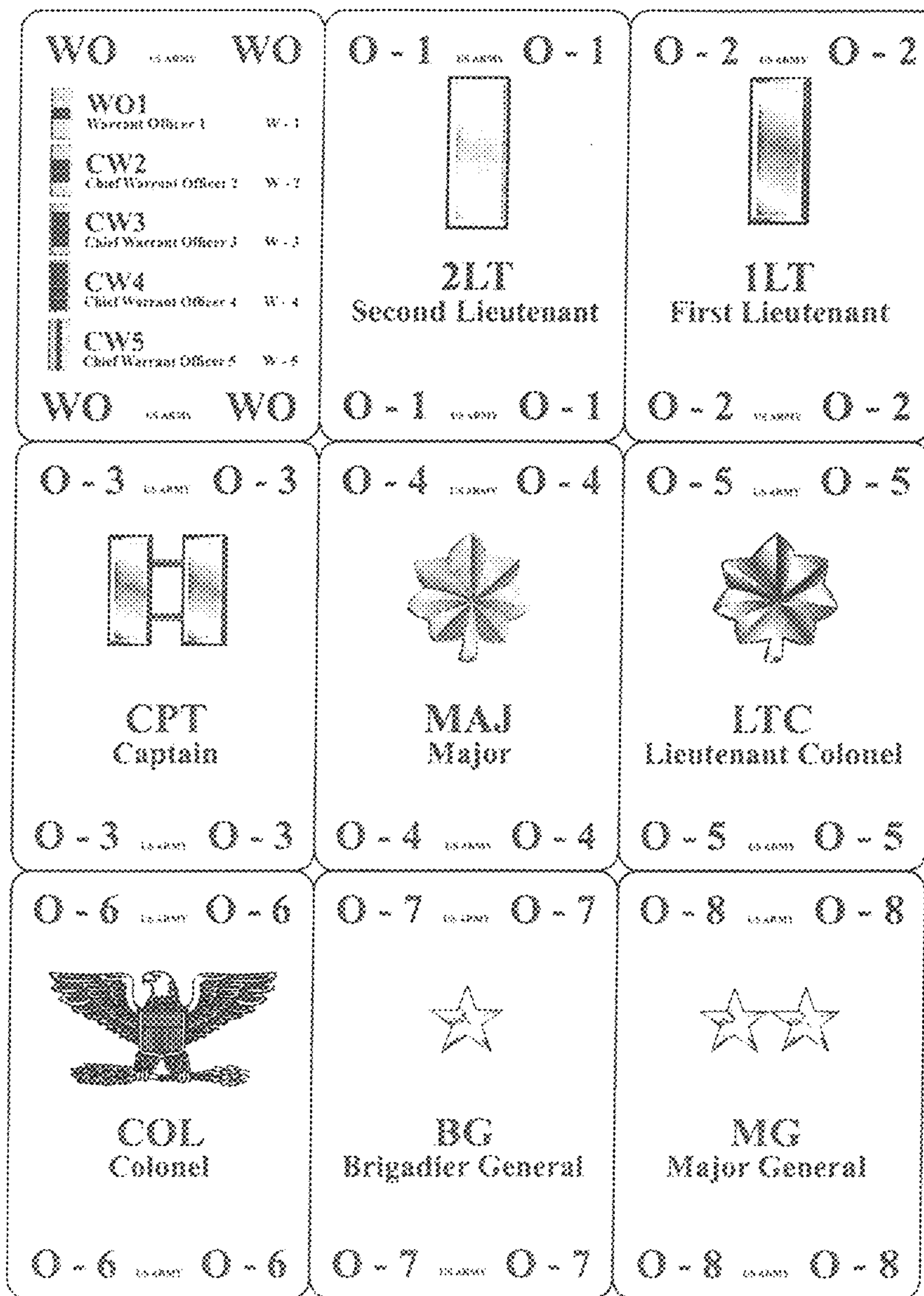

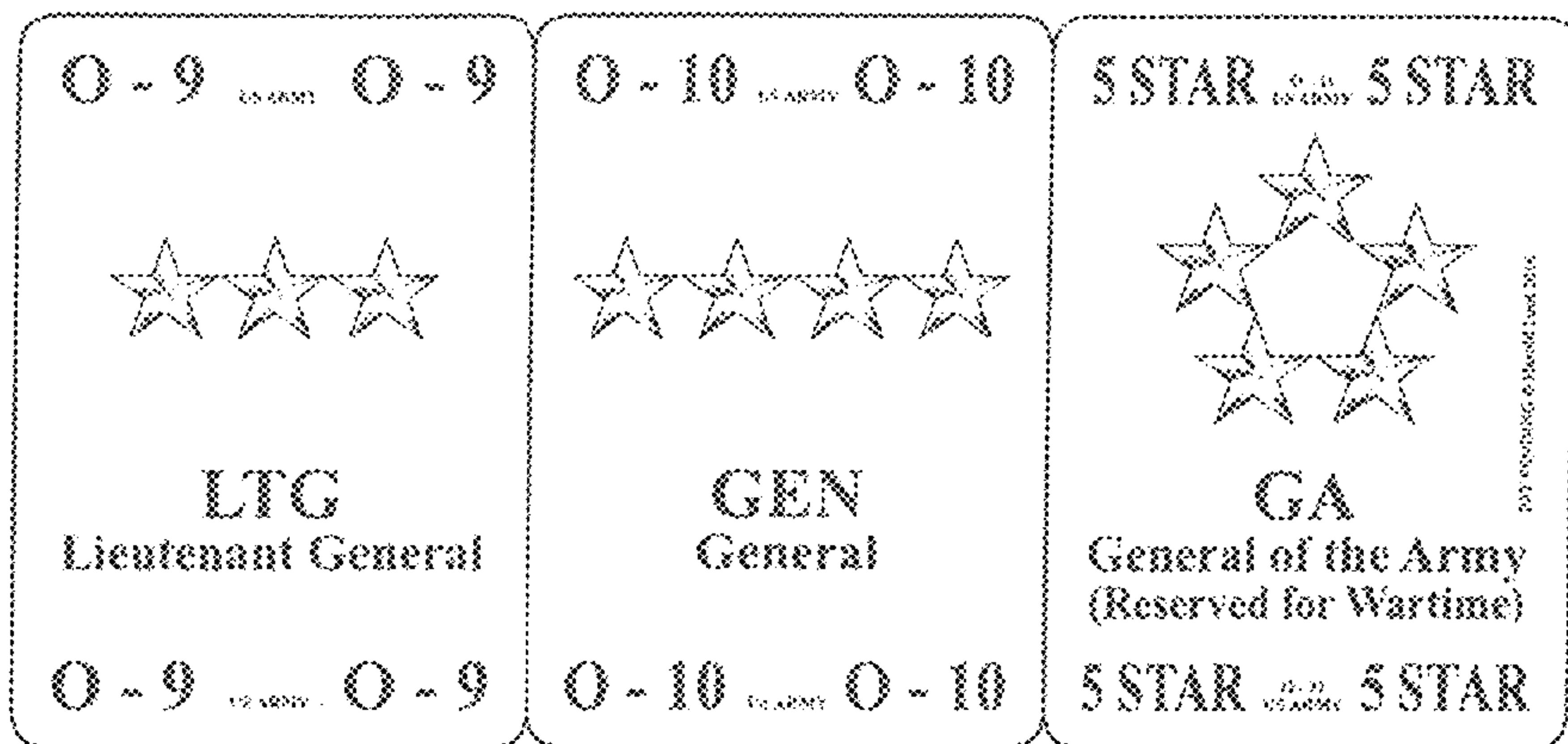

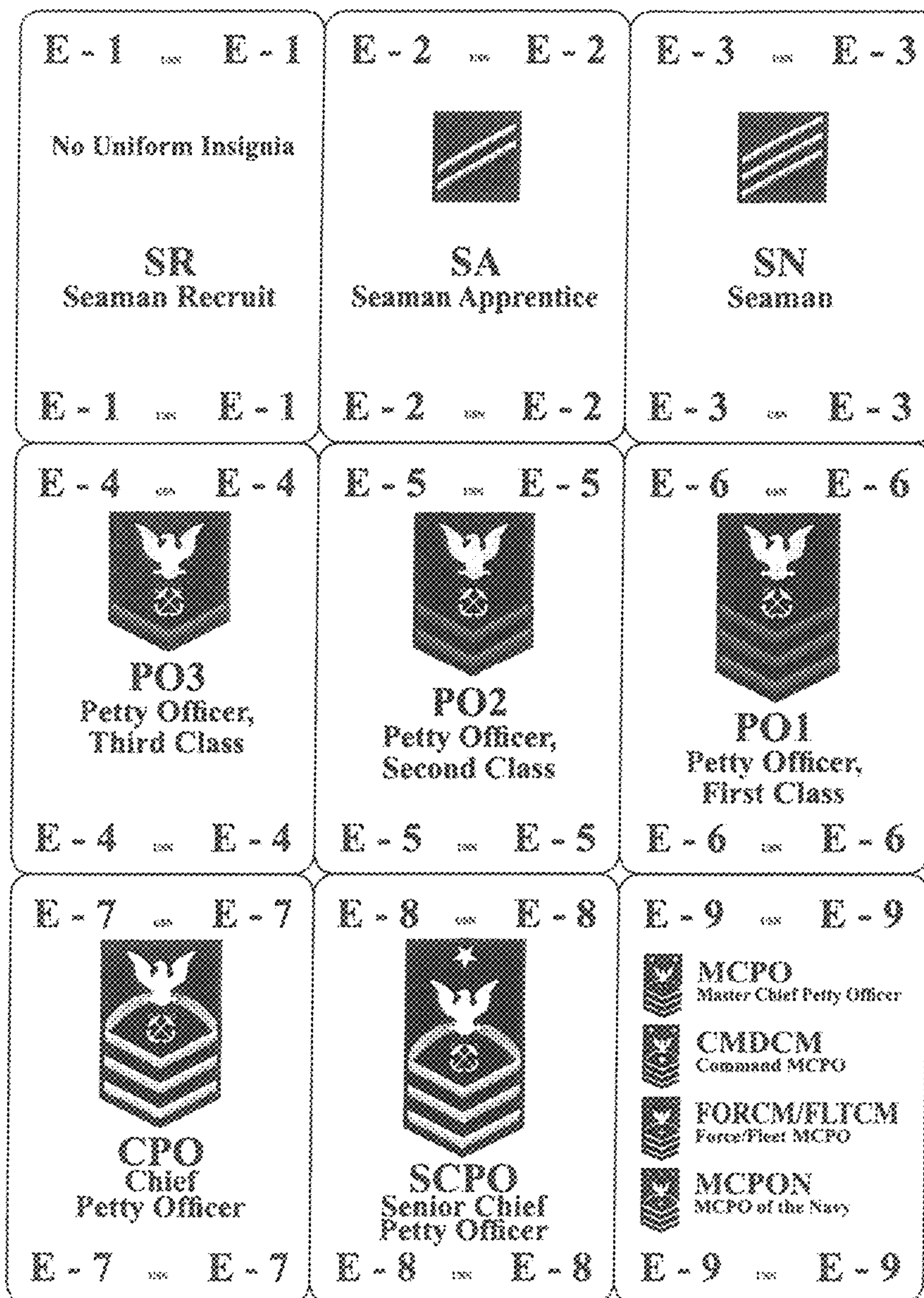

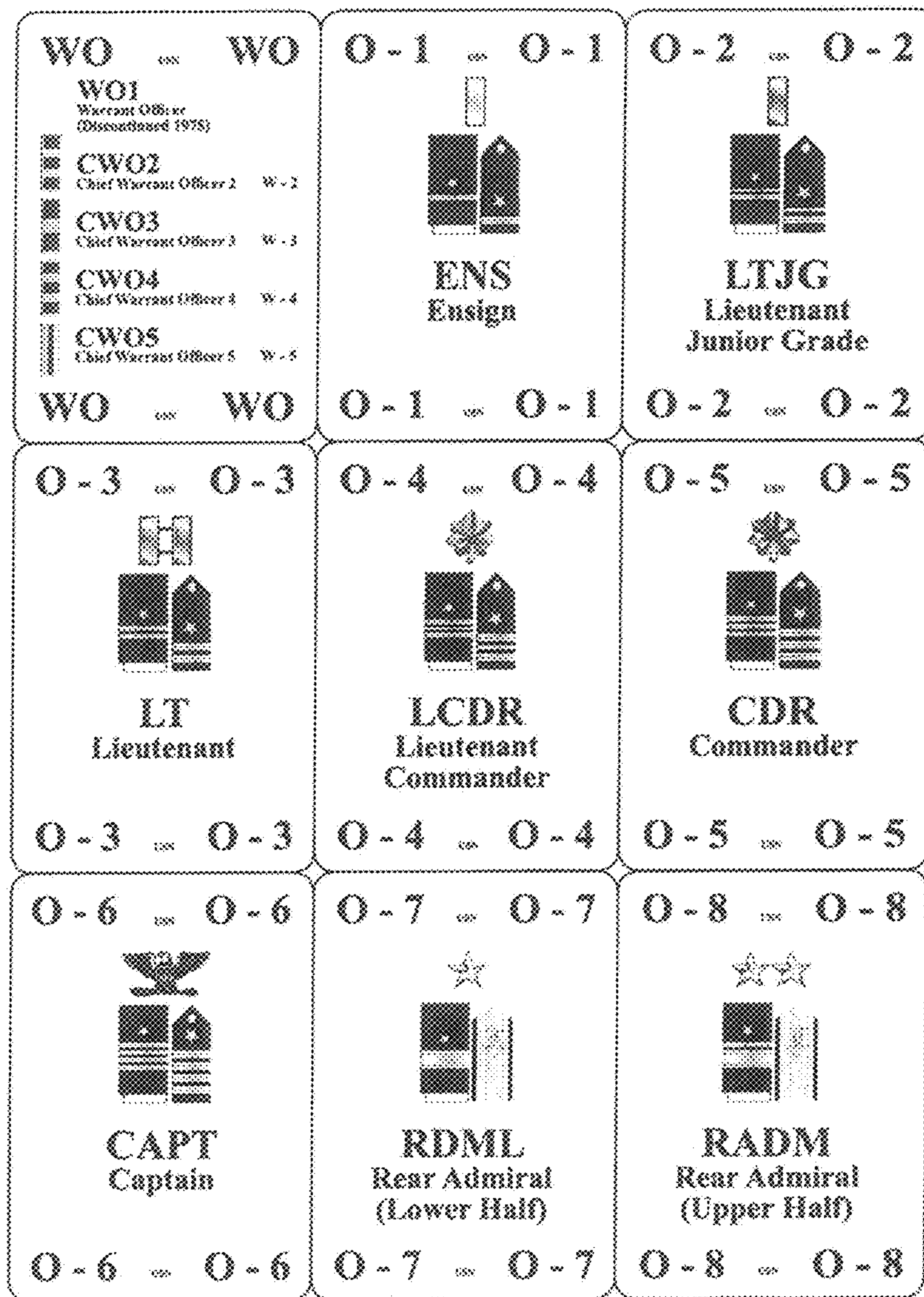

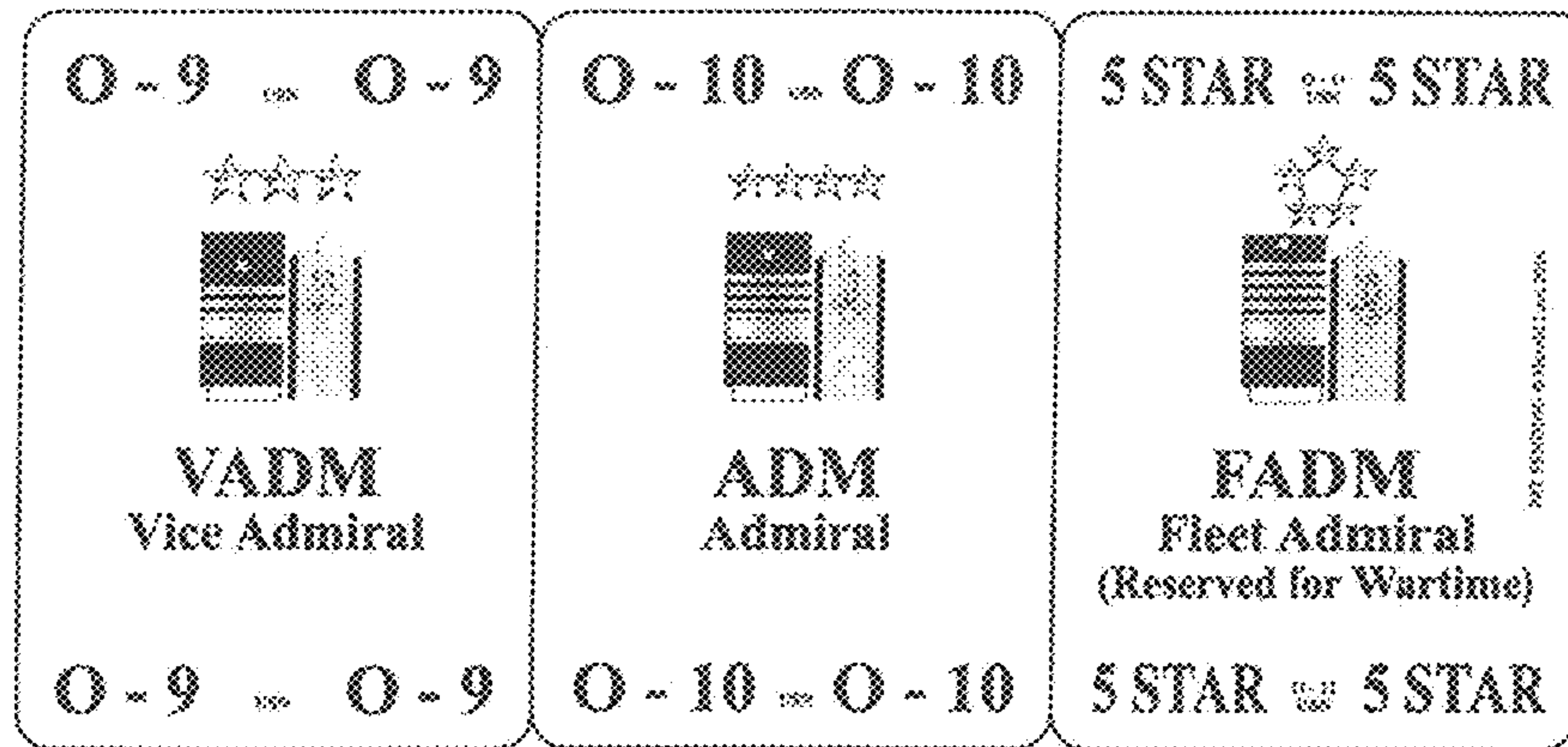

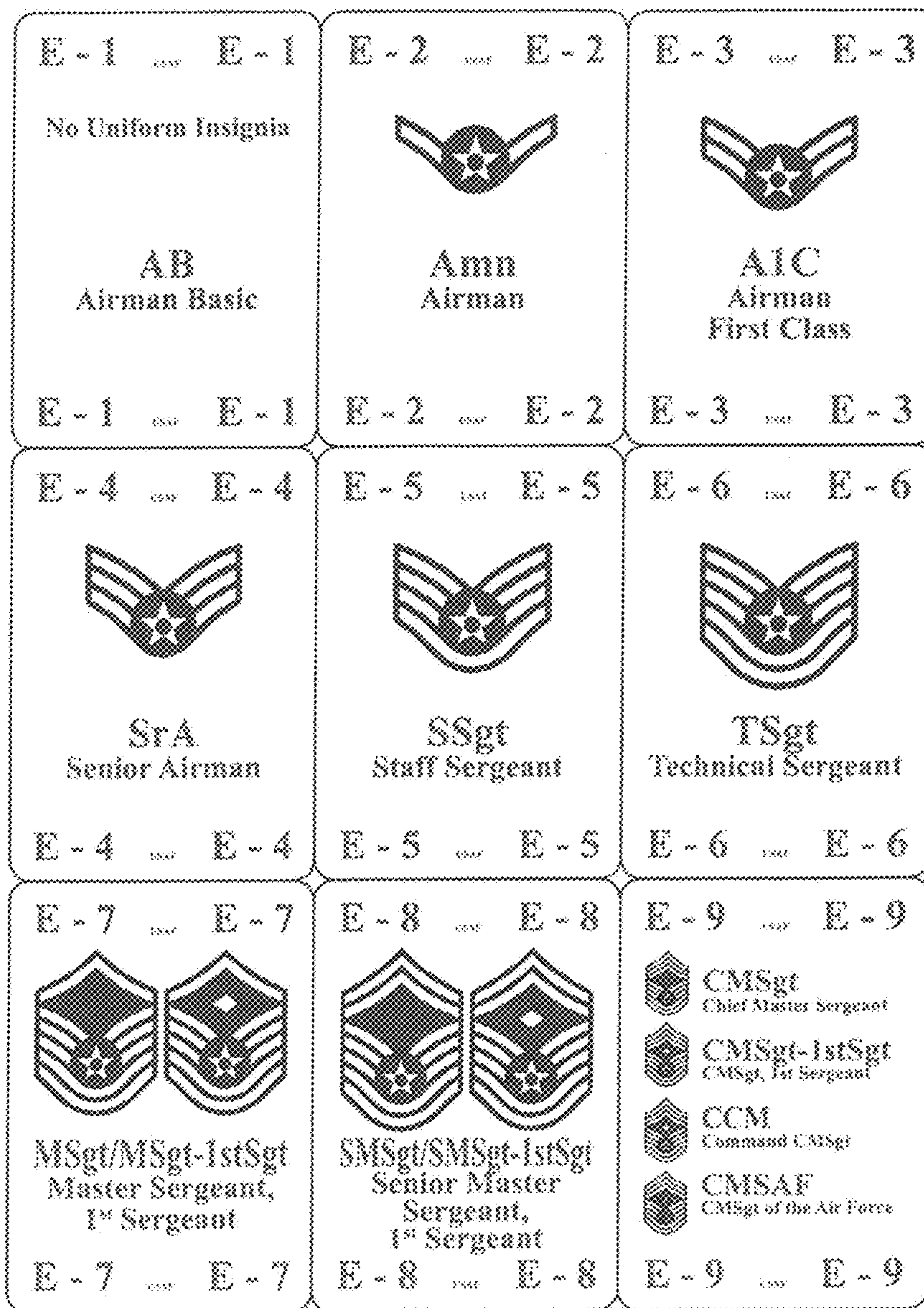

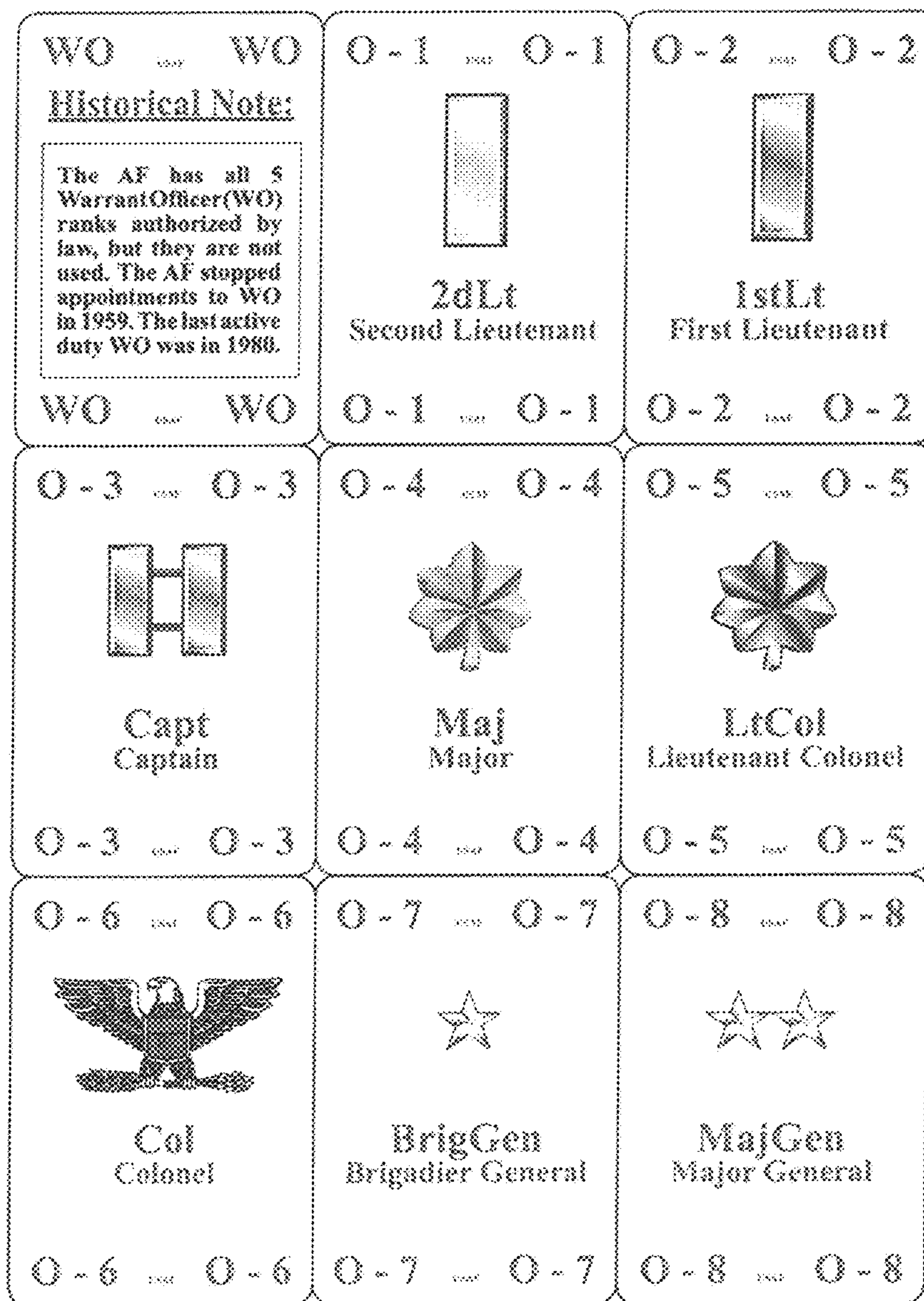

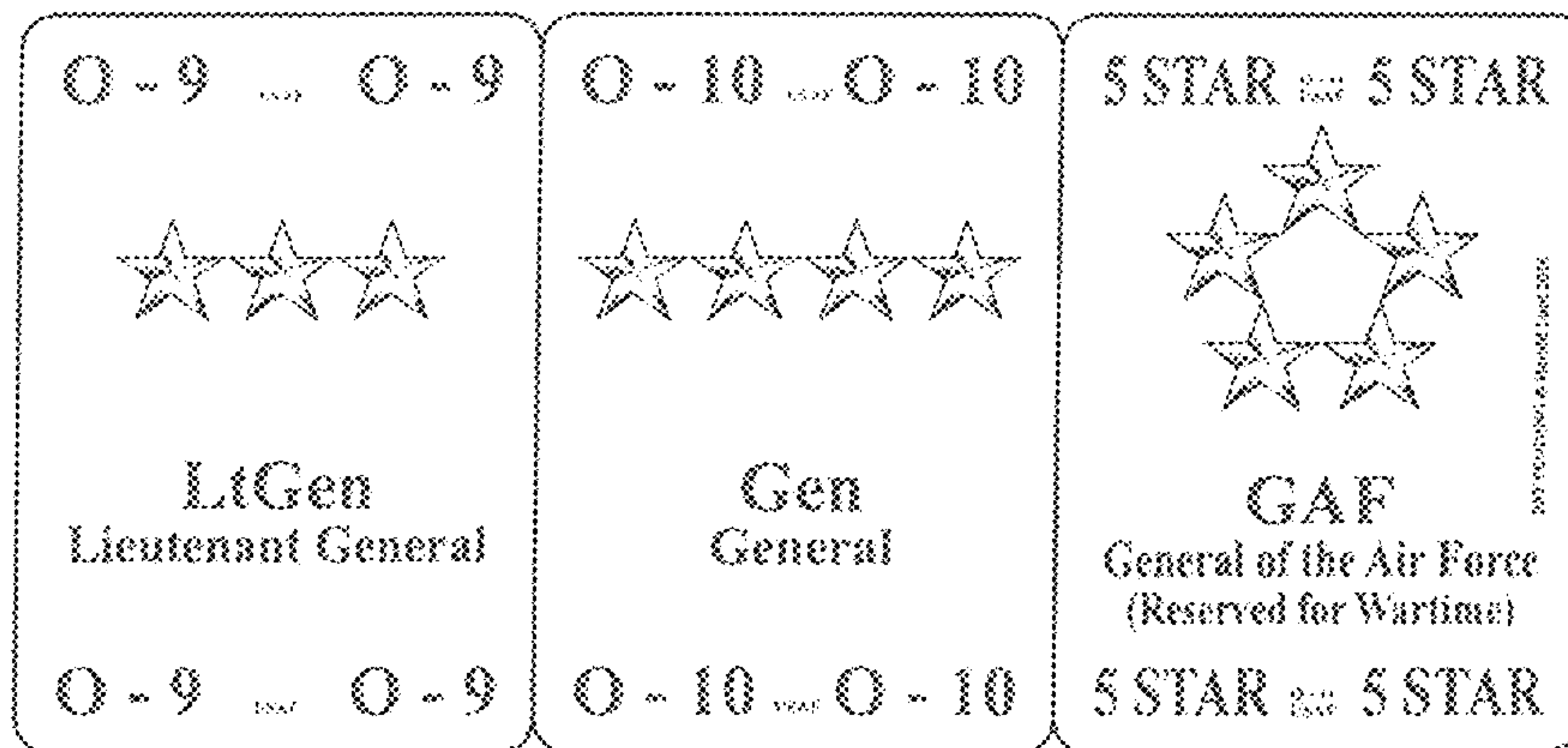

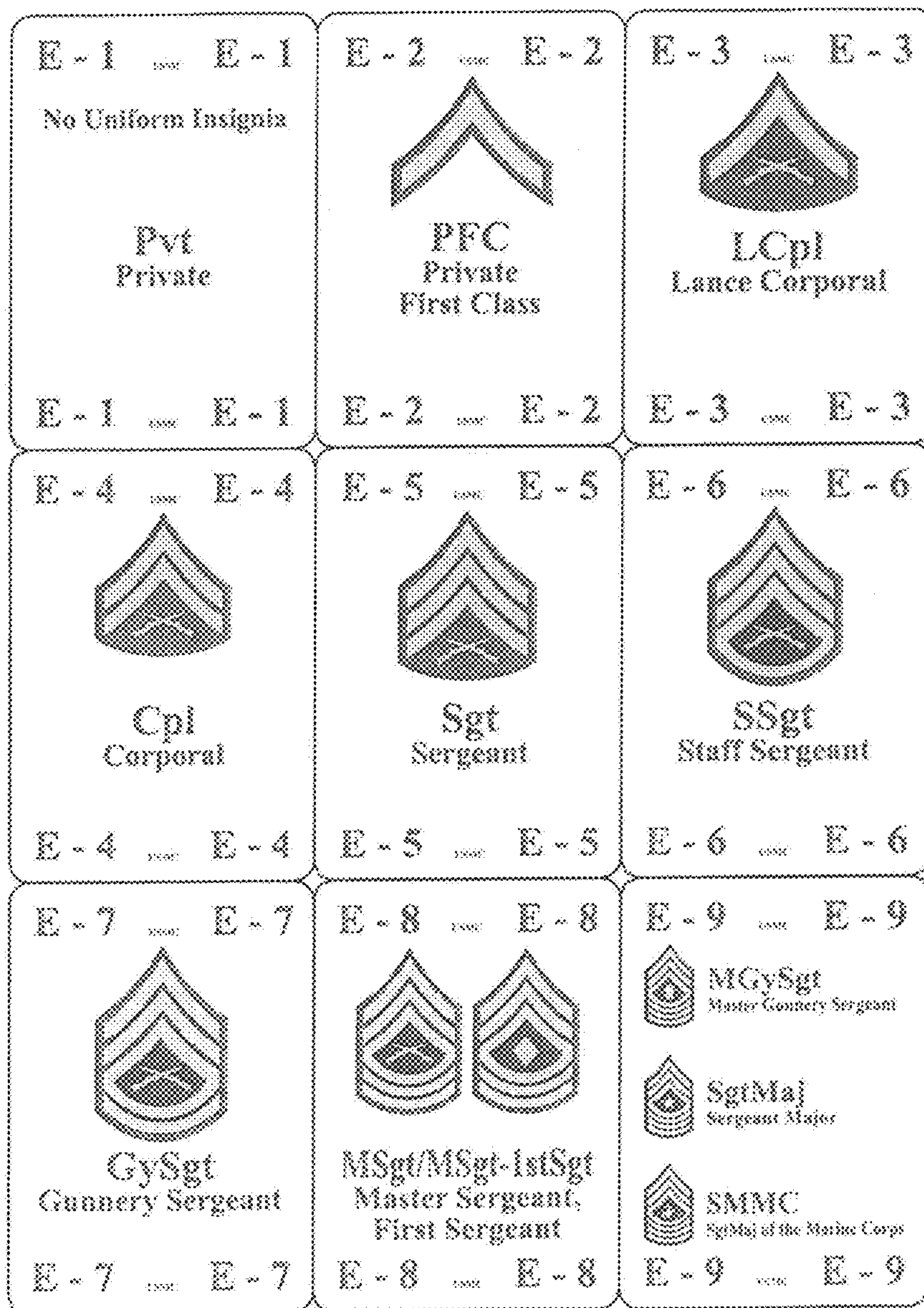

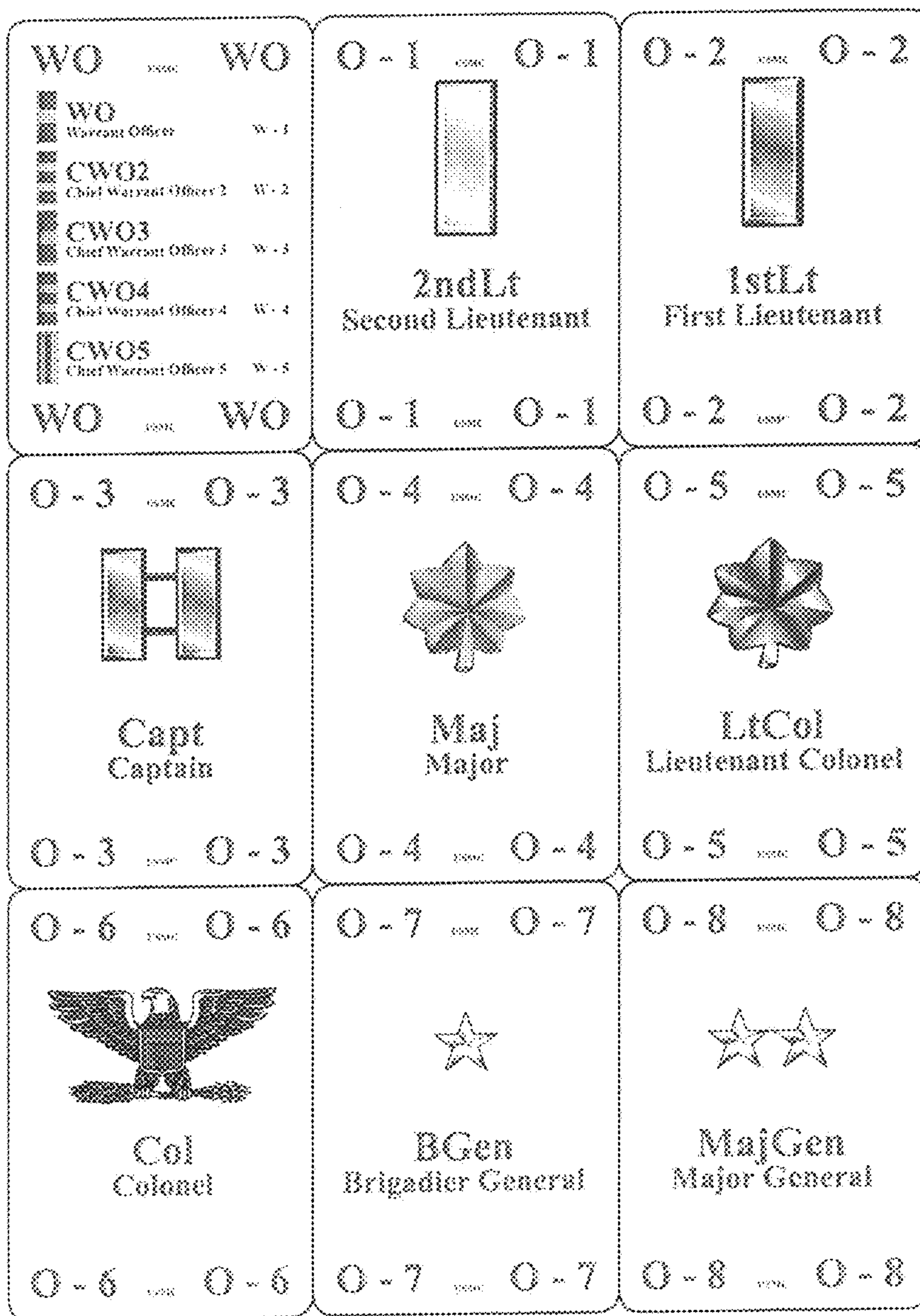

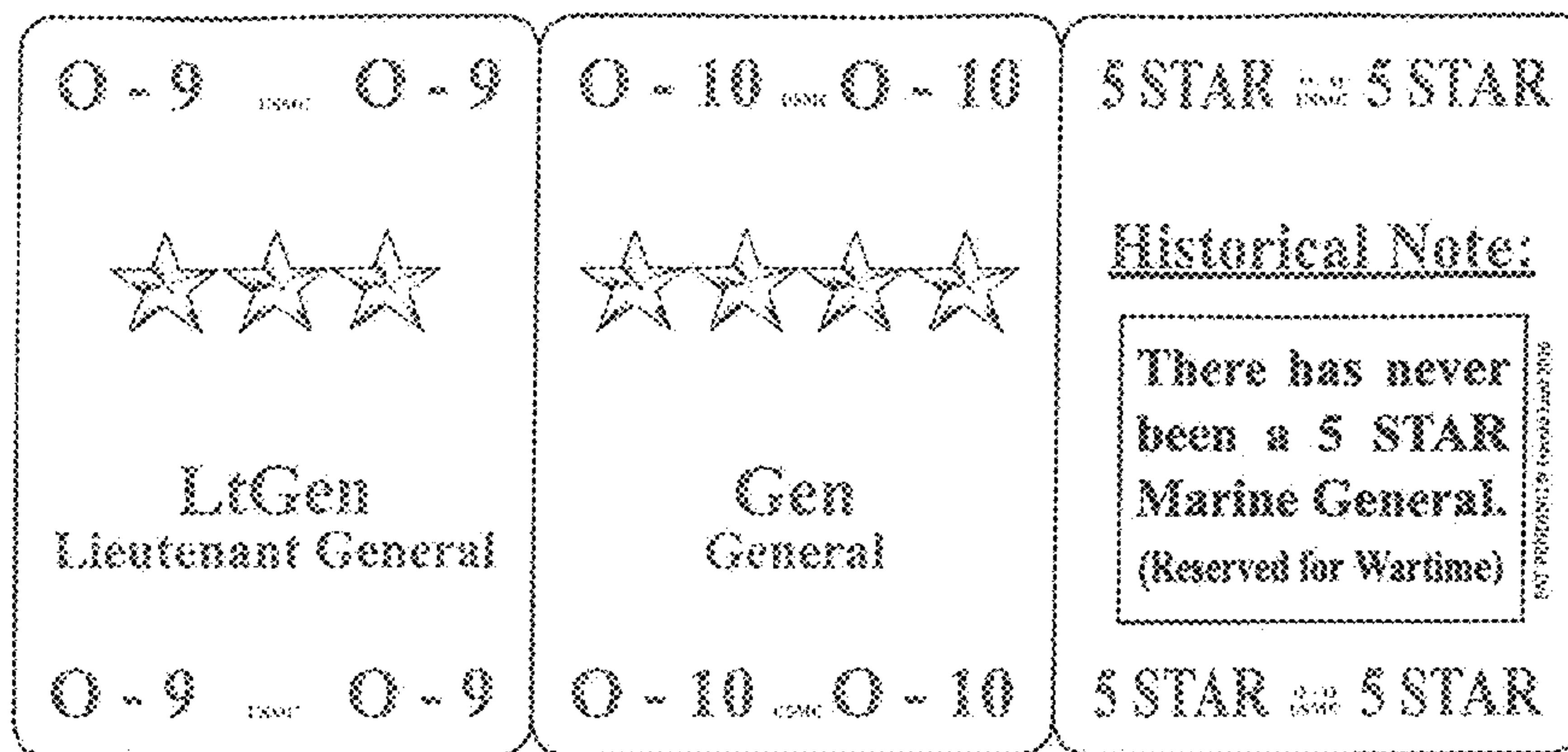
