(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a figurine, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left-front view of a figurine showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a left-side view  
FIG. 3 is a first left-back view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a second left-back view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a back view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a first right-back view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a second right-back view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a right-front view thereof;  
FIG. 10 is a front view thereof; and  
FIG. 11 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 12 is a first detail view thereof; and,  
FIG. 13 is a second detail view thereof, showing the figurine.  
The bottom of the figurine is an unadorned circle, and no claim is made to the bottom.

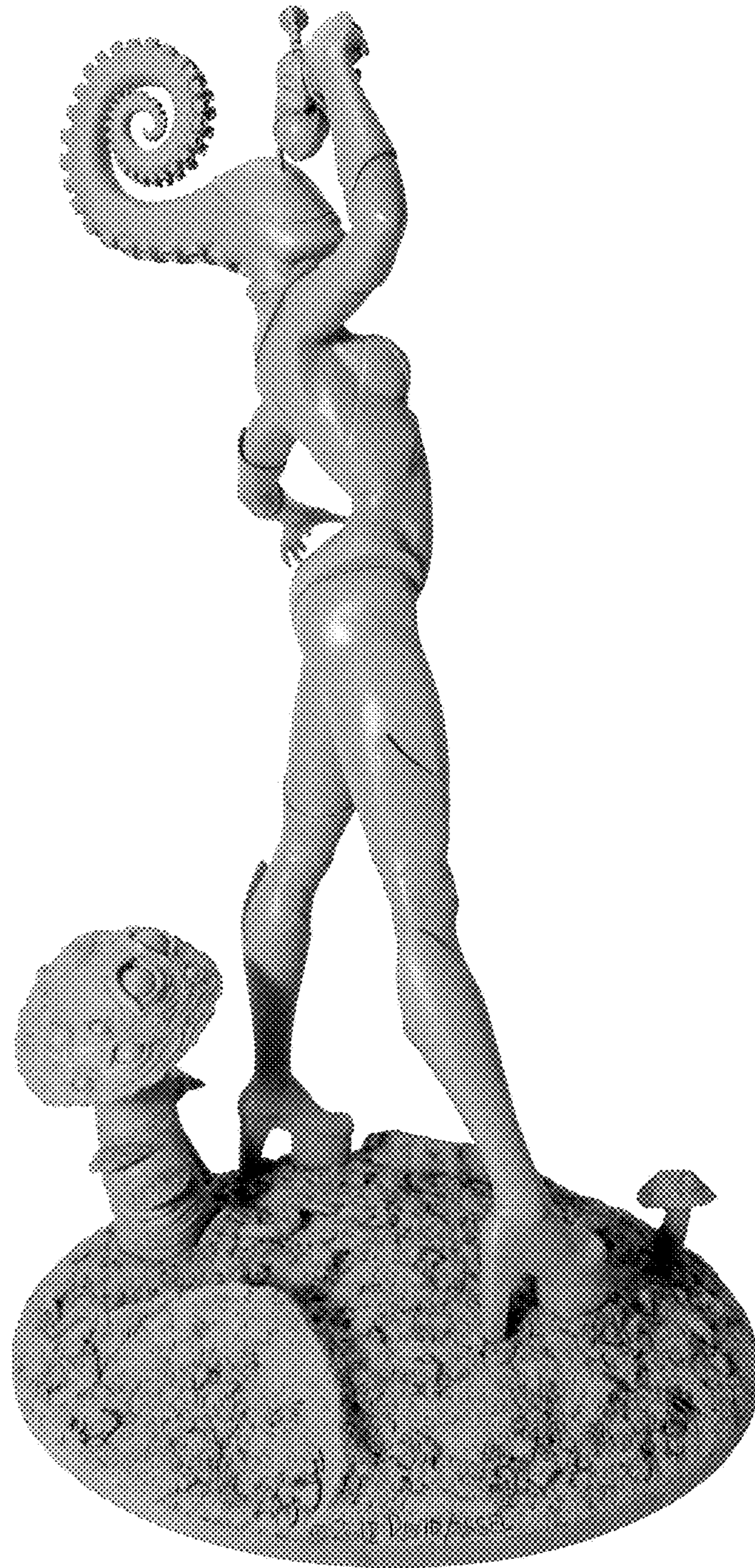

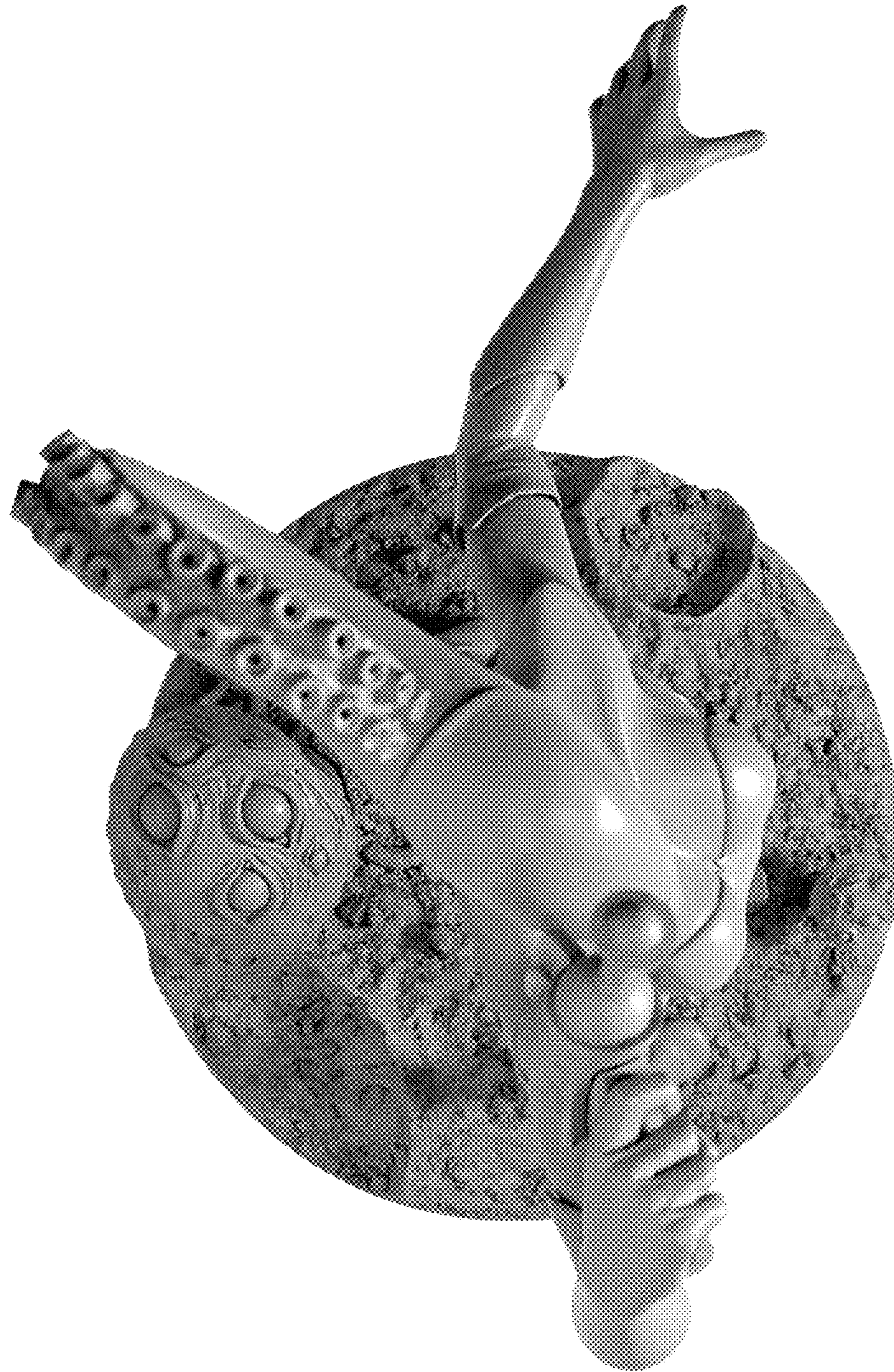

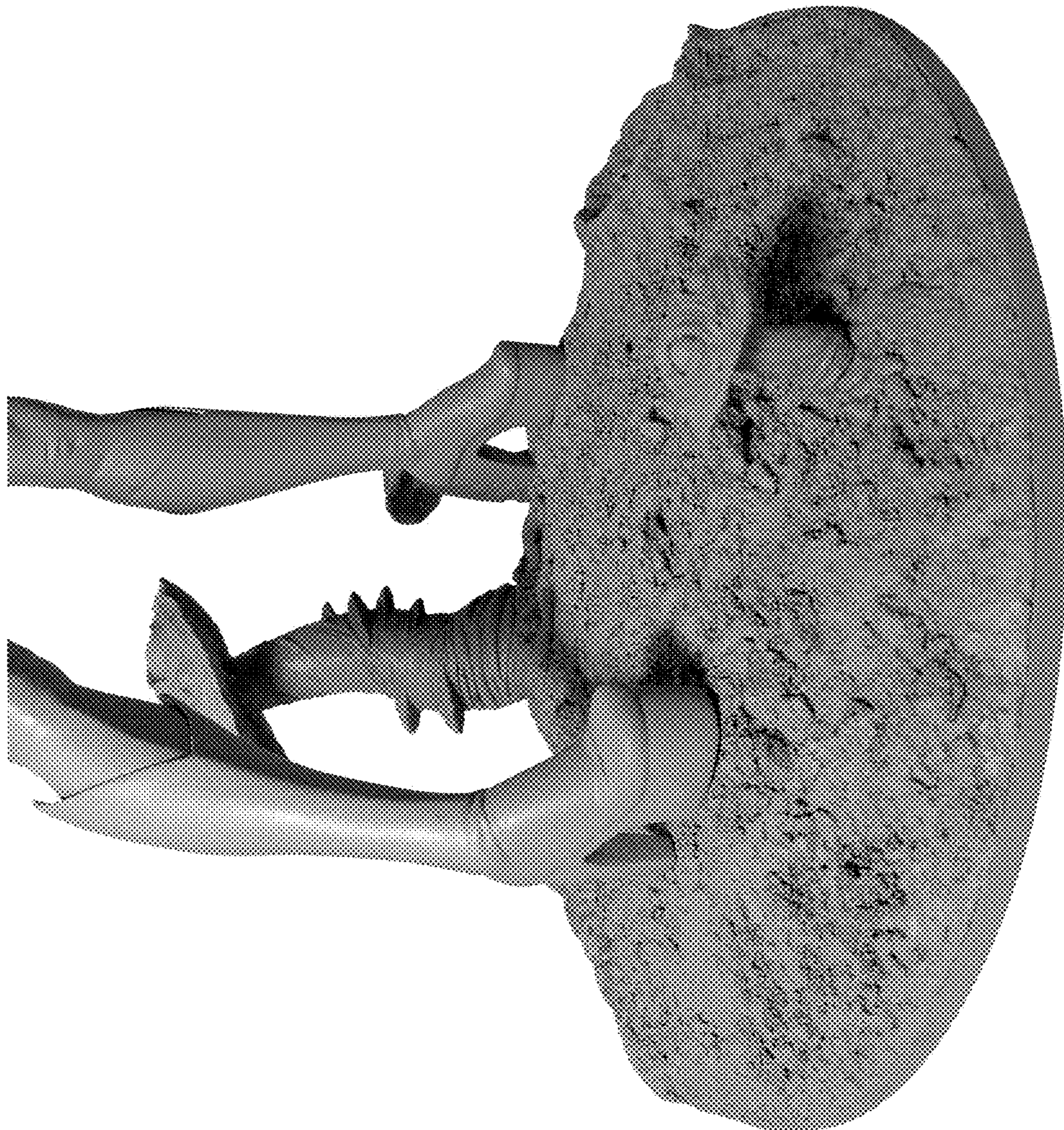
