(57) **CLAIM**

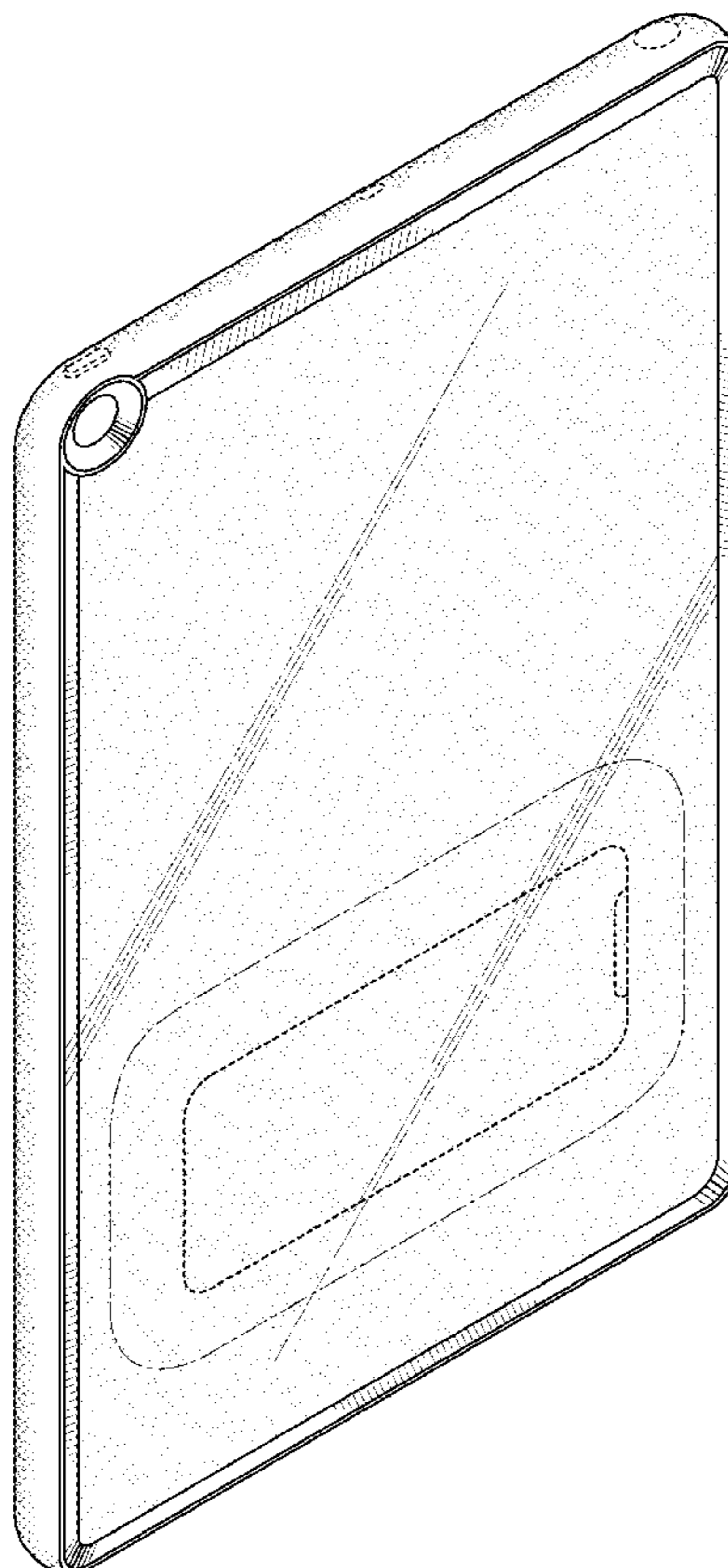
The ornamental design for a protective case for mobile device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of my new design for a cell phone case;

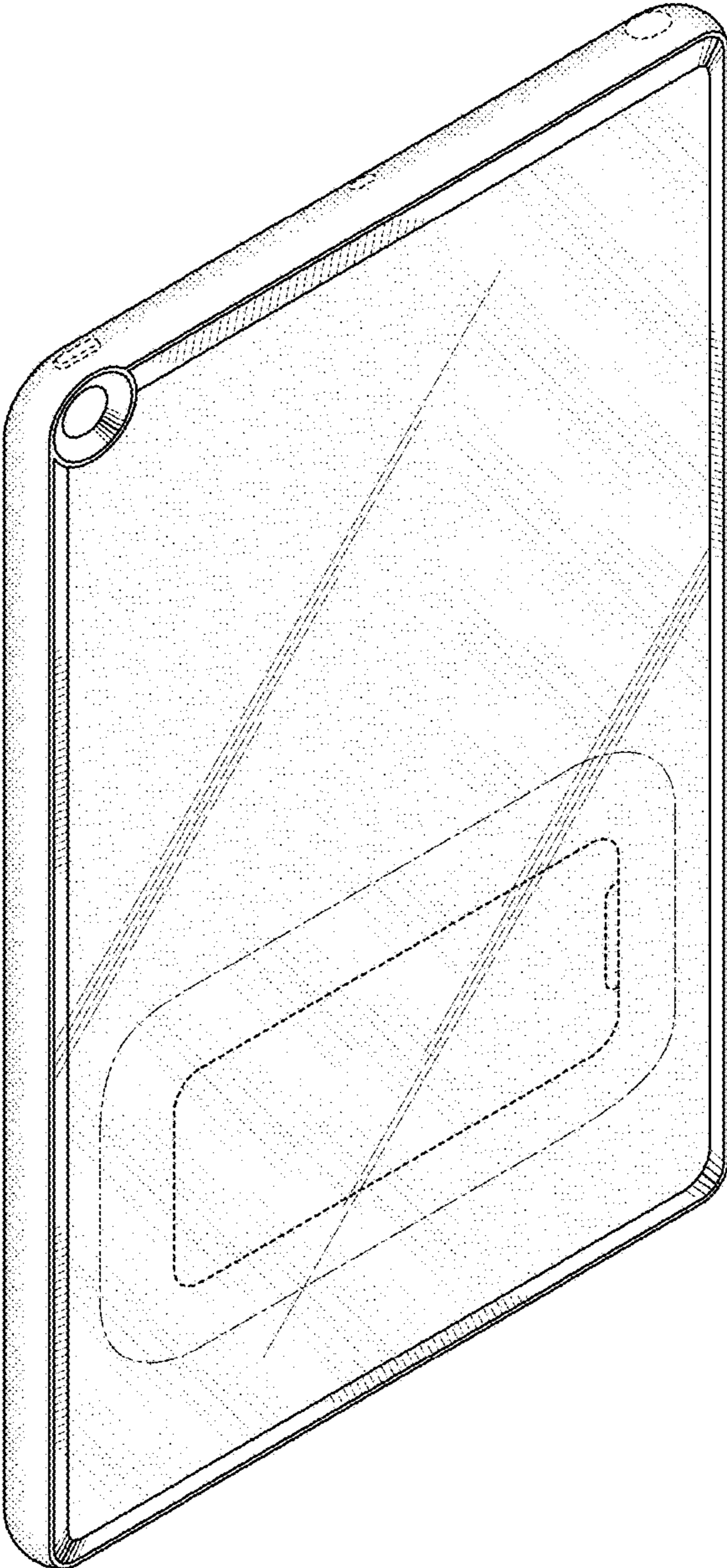

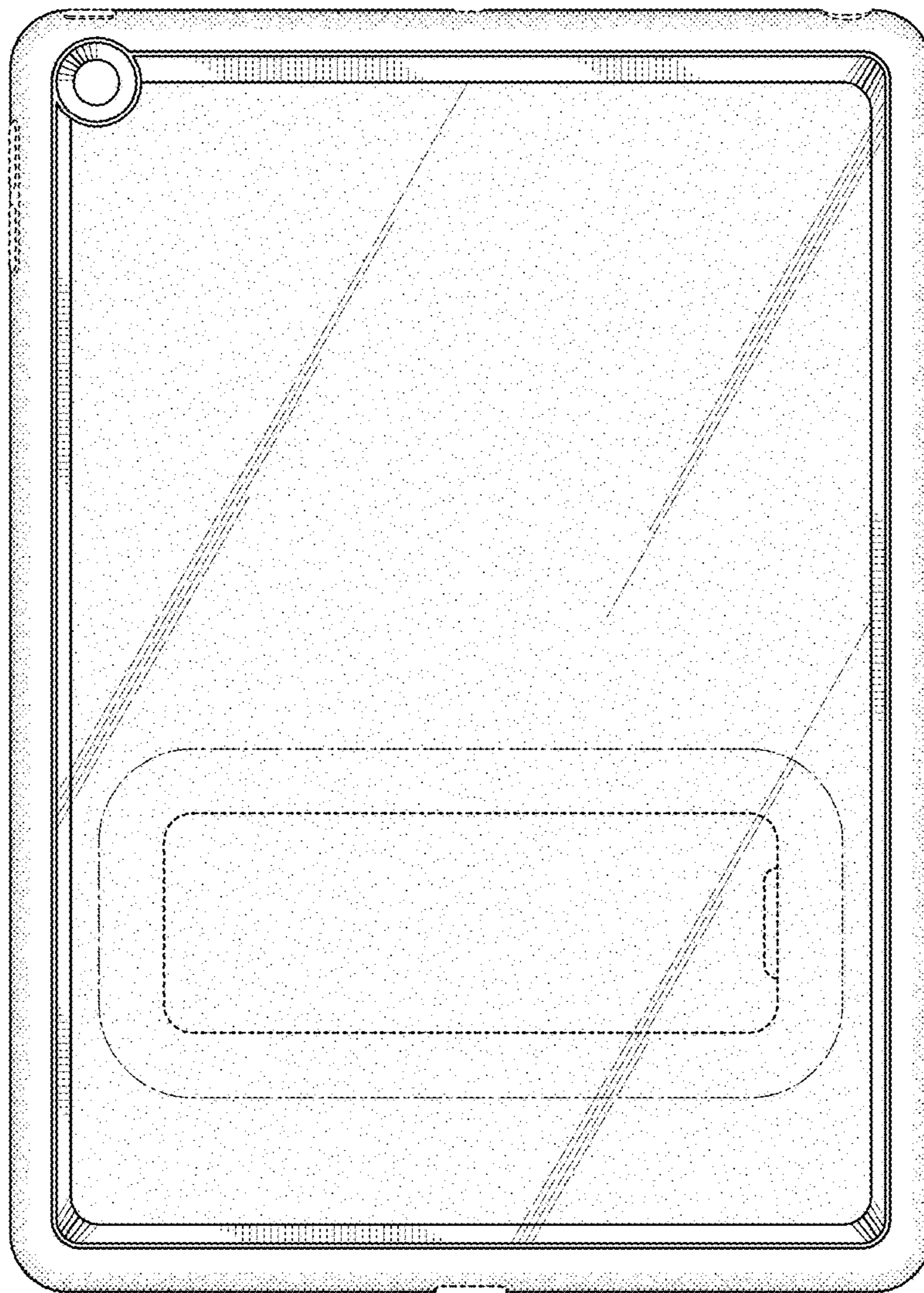

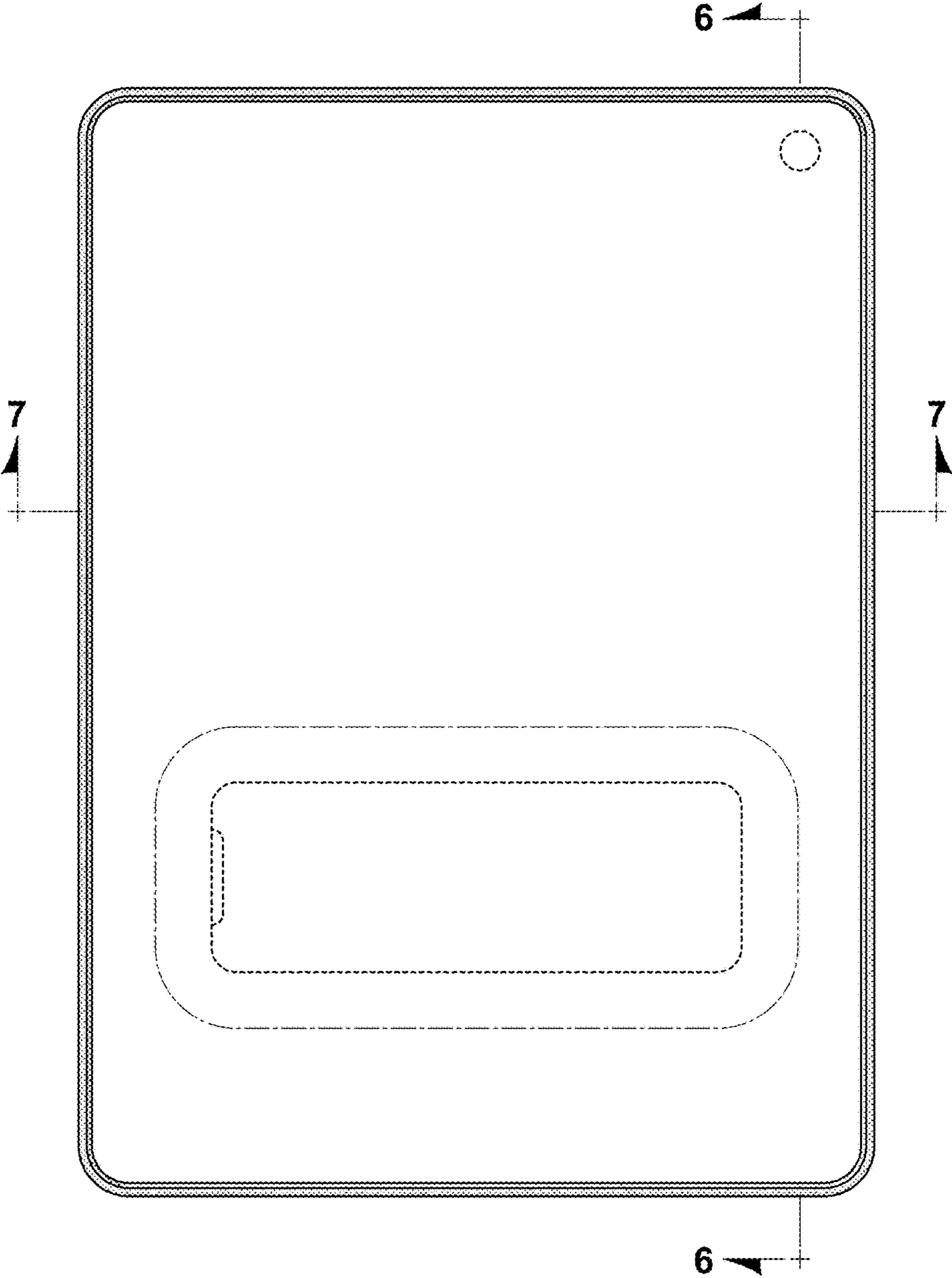

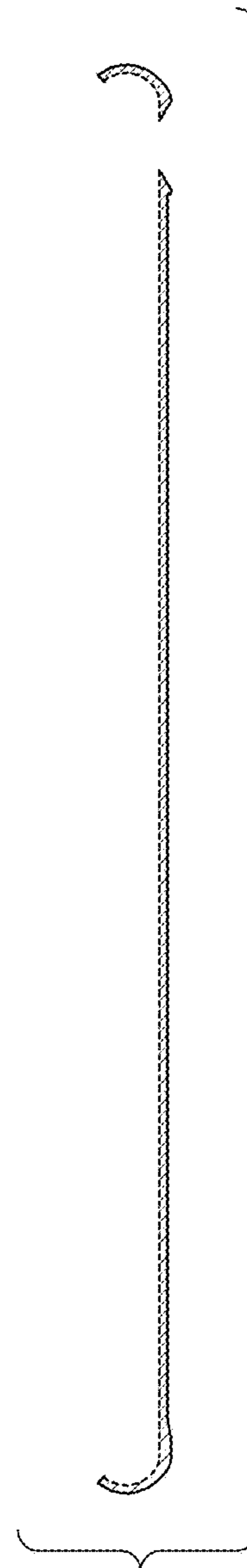
