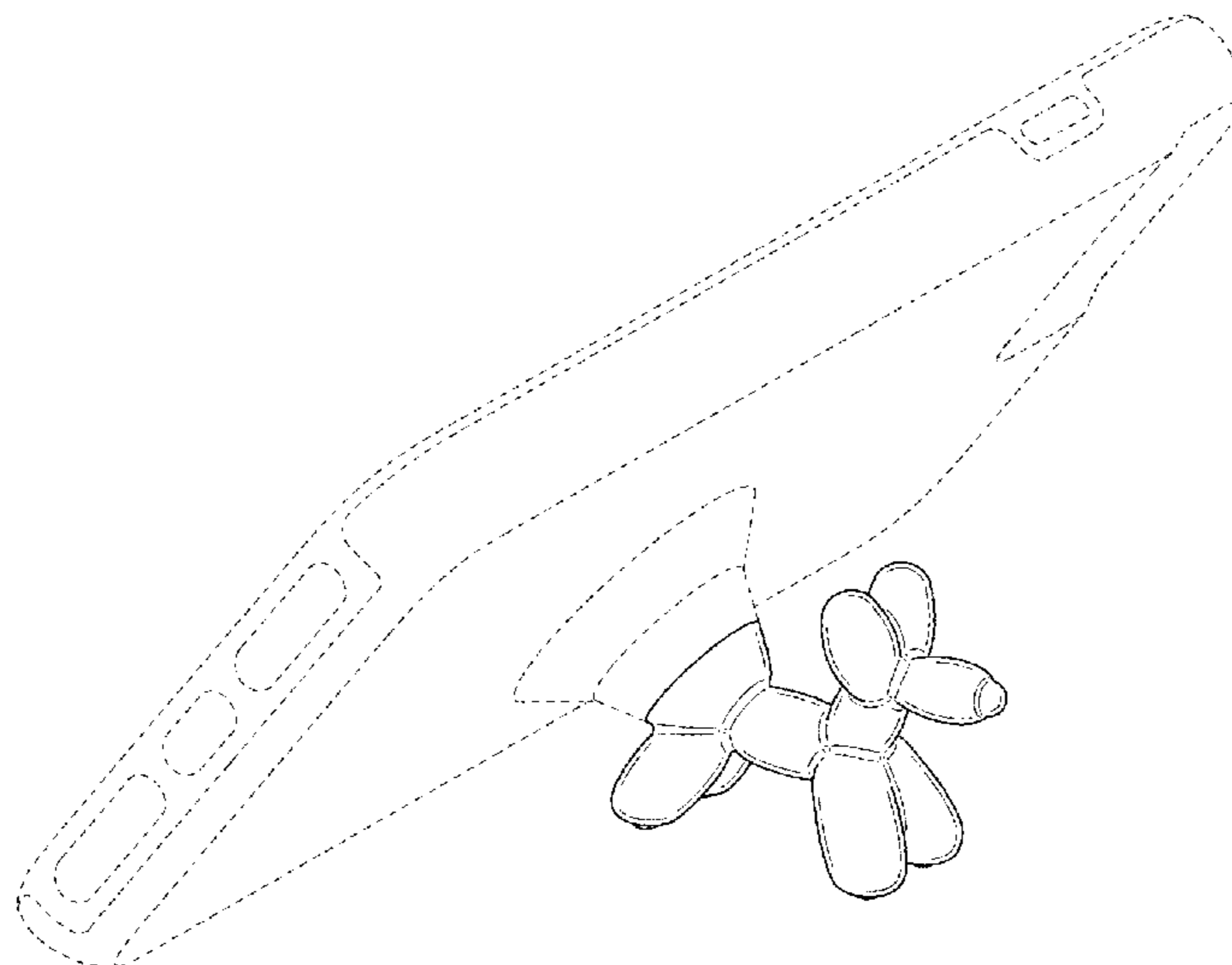

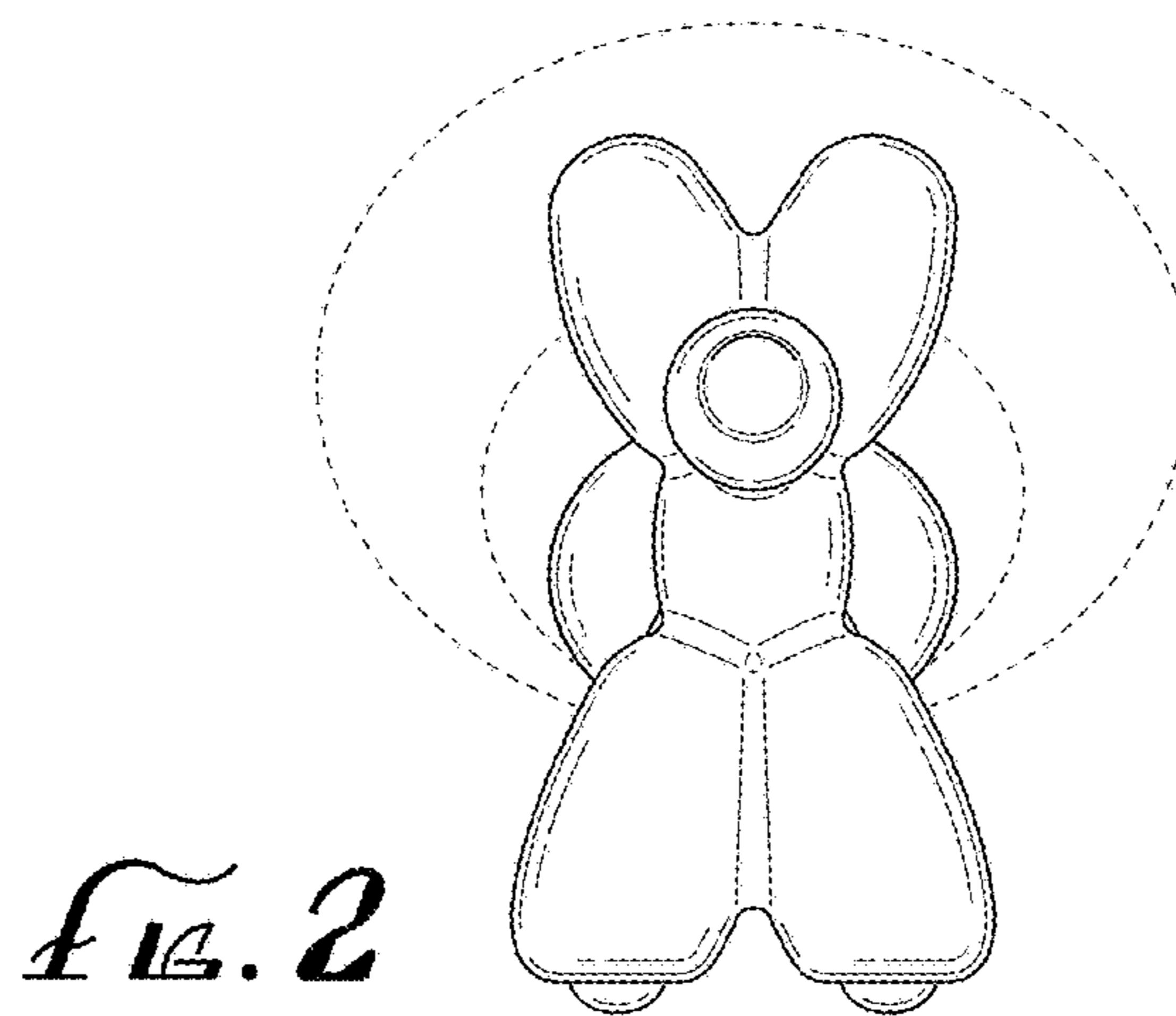
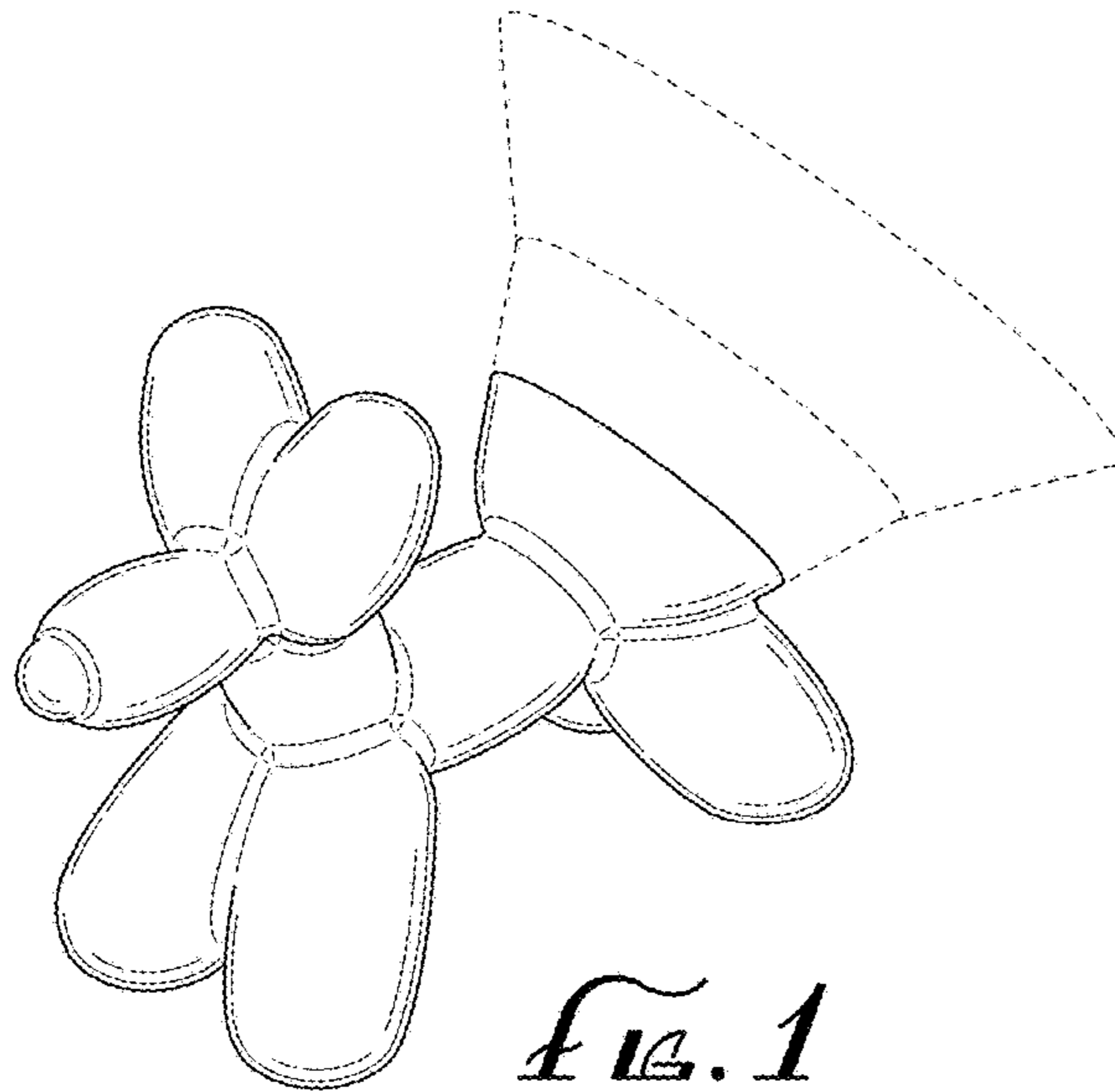
The ornamental design for an accessory for an electronic device, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an accessory for an electronic device, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a second rear view thereof, with unclaimed environment removed for clarity;
FIG. 5 is a side view thereof;

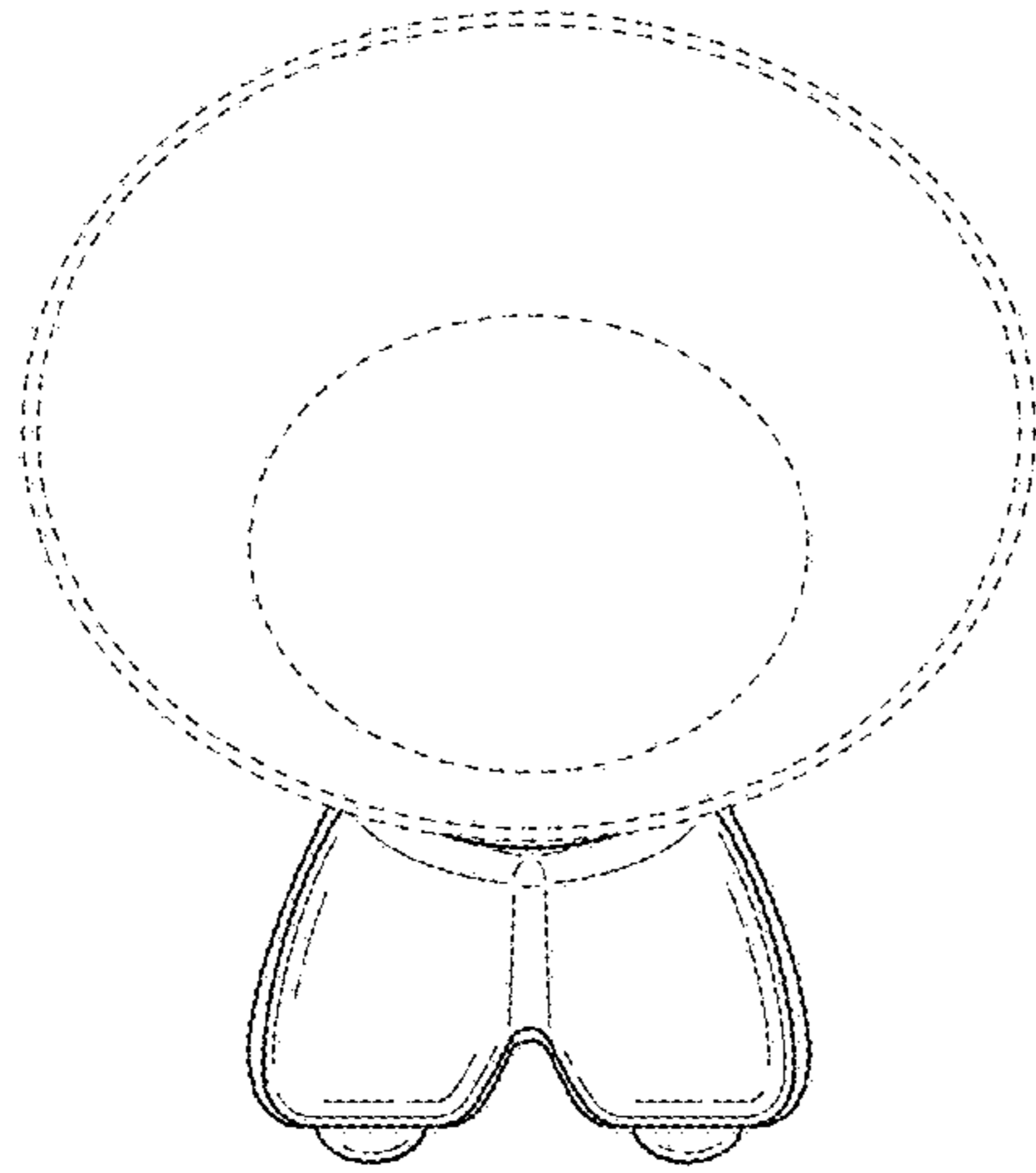

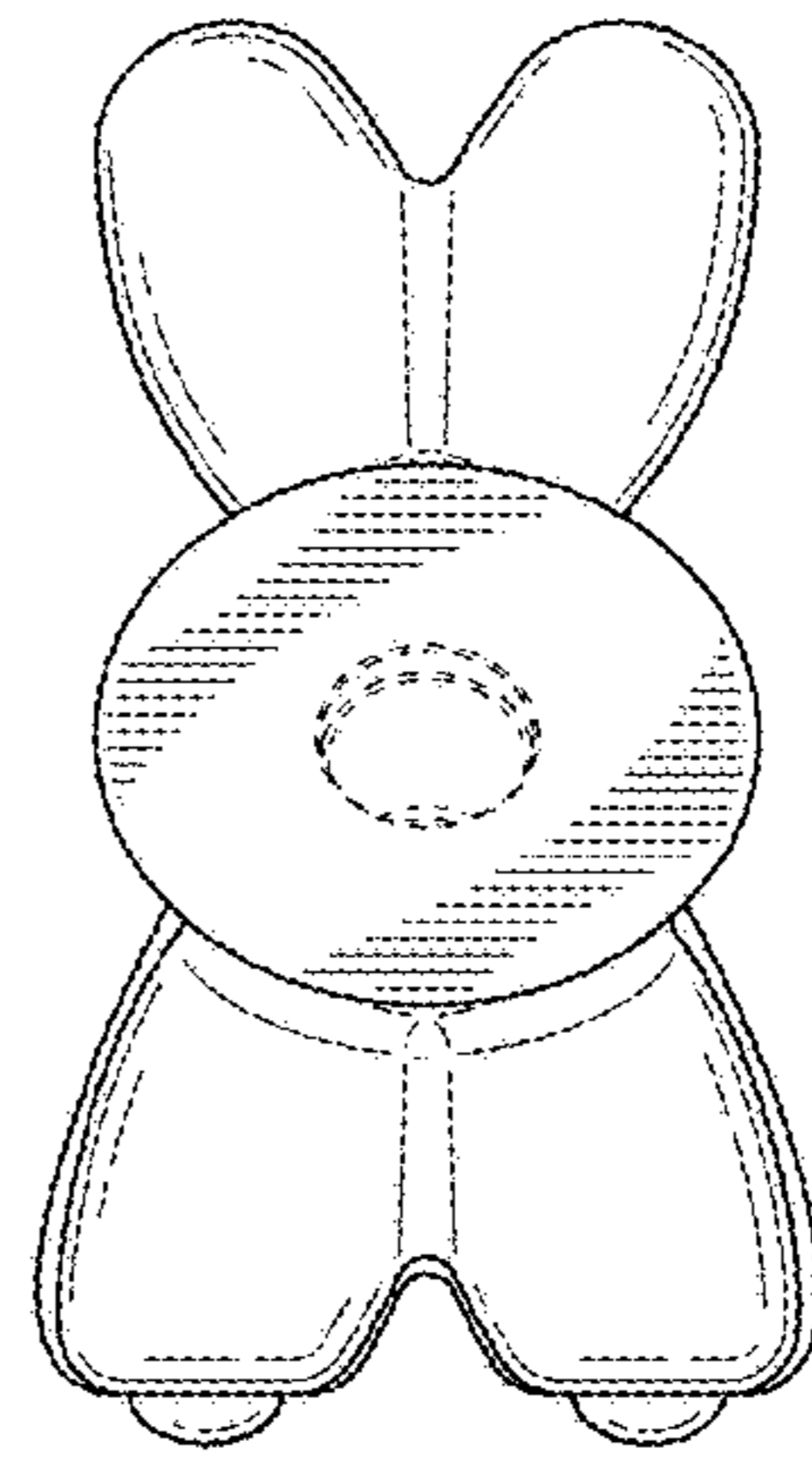

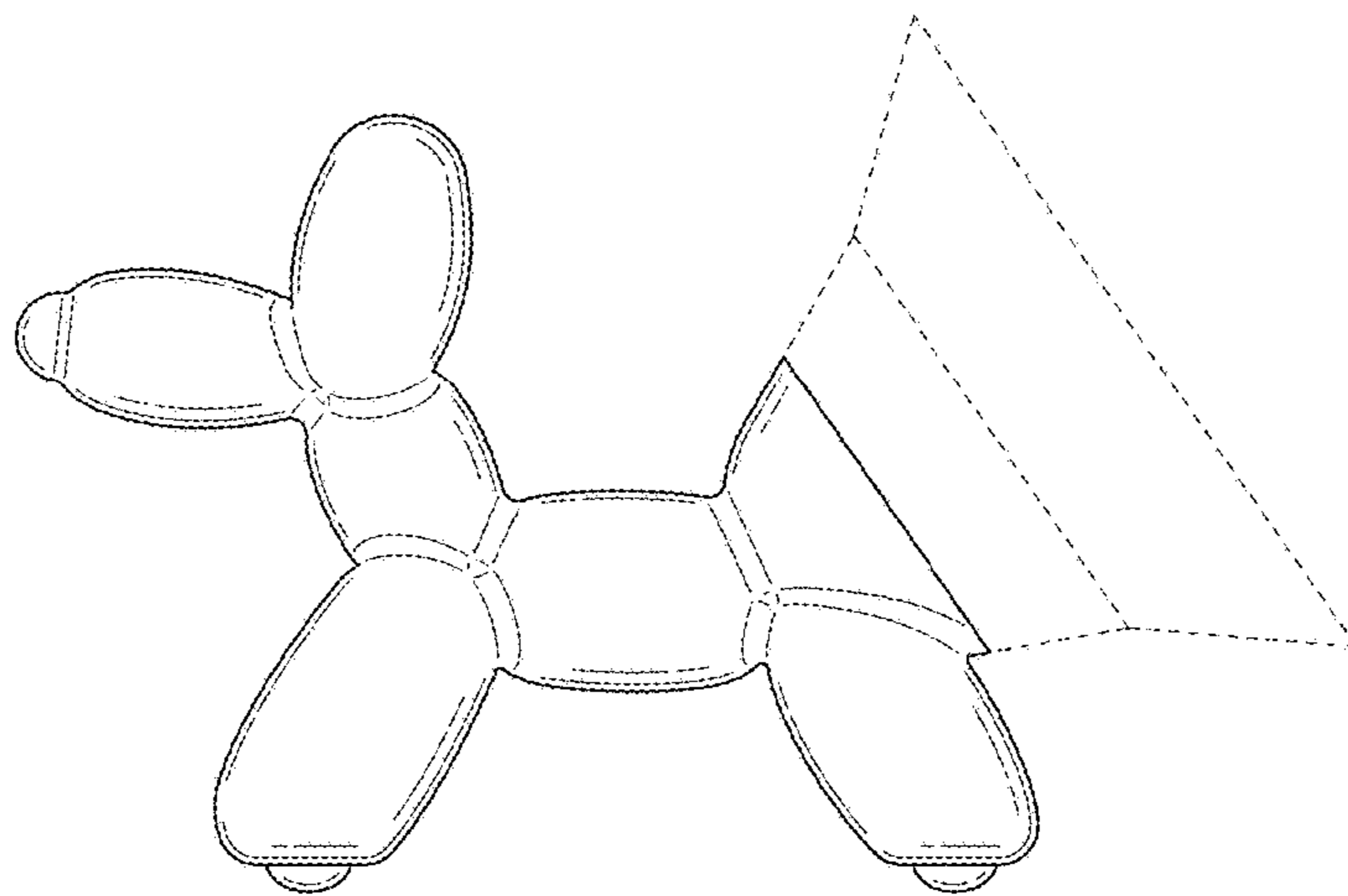

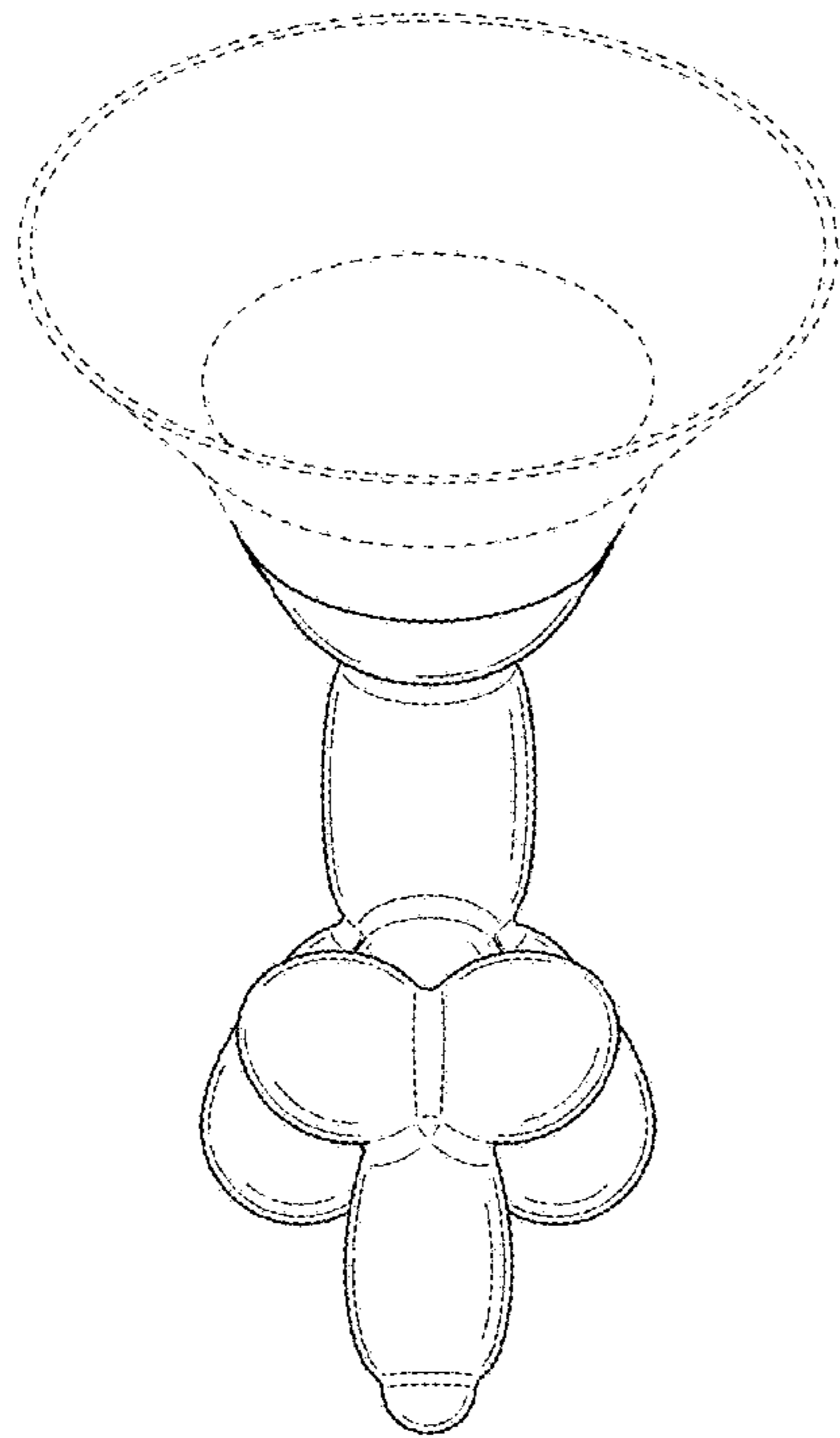

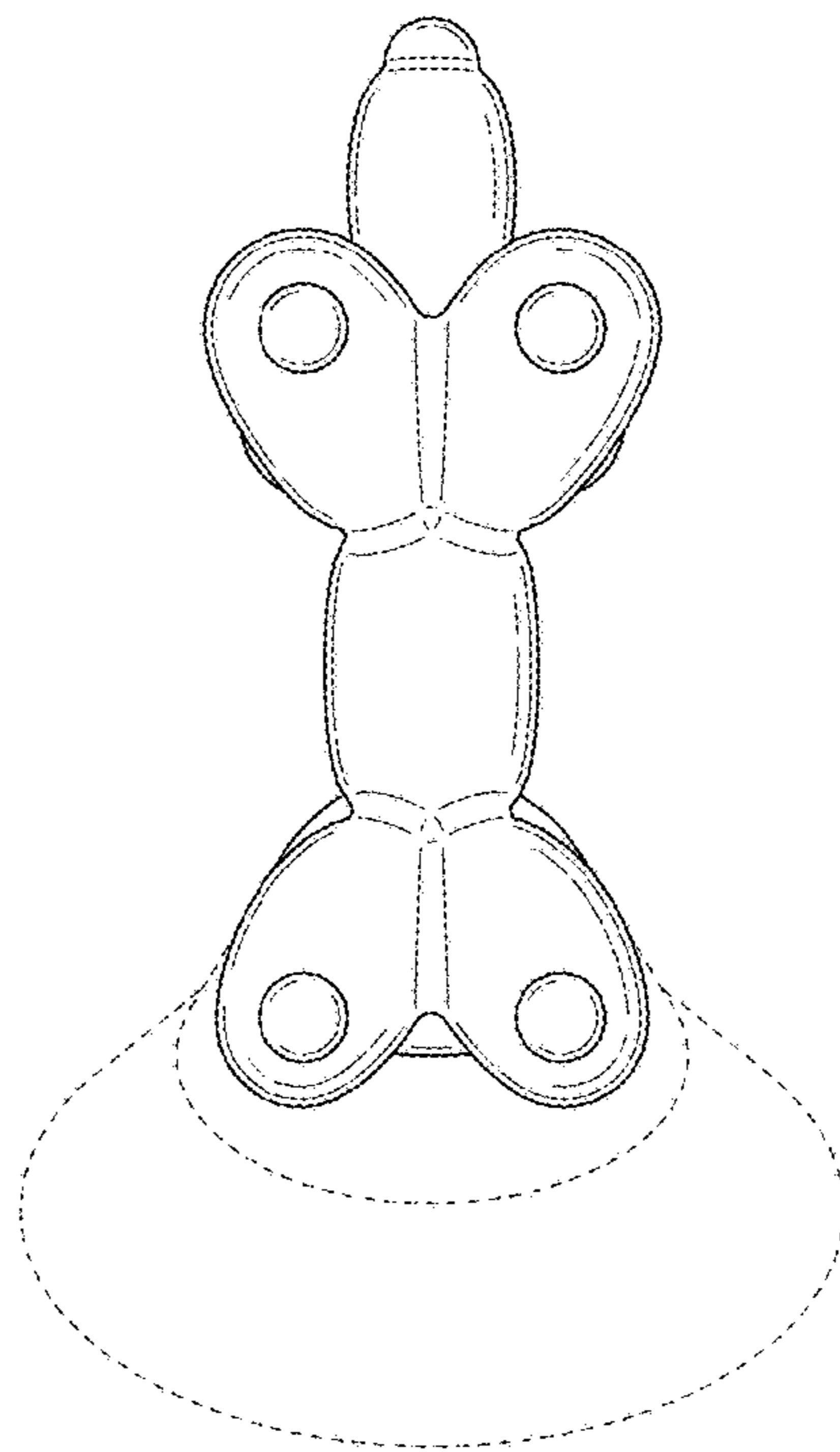

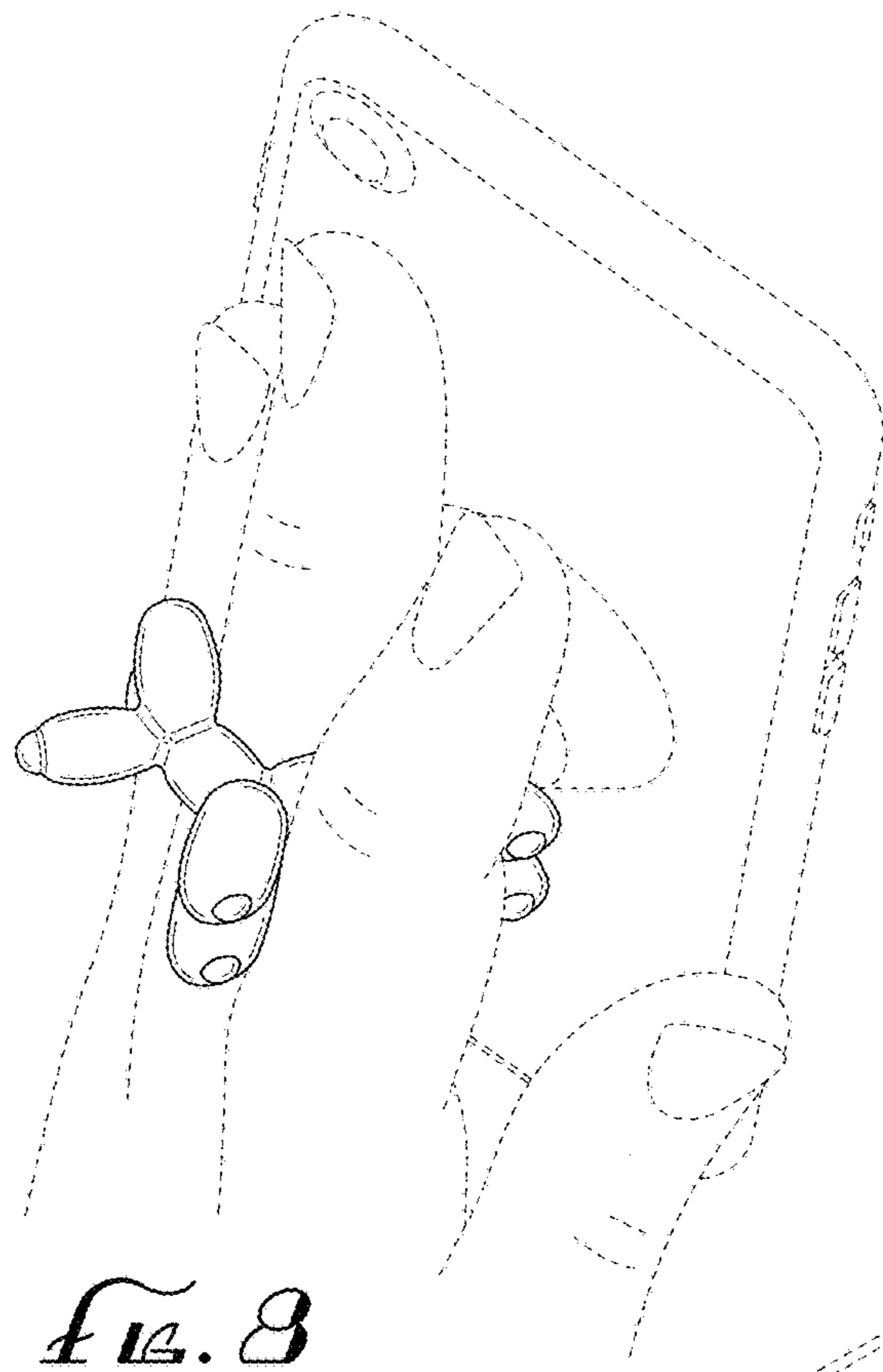

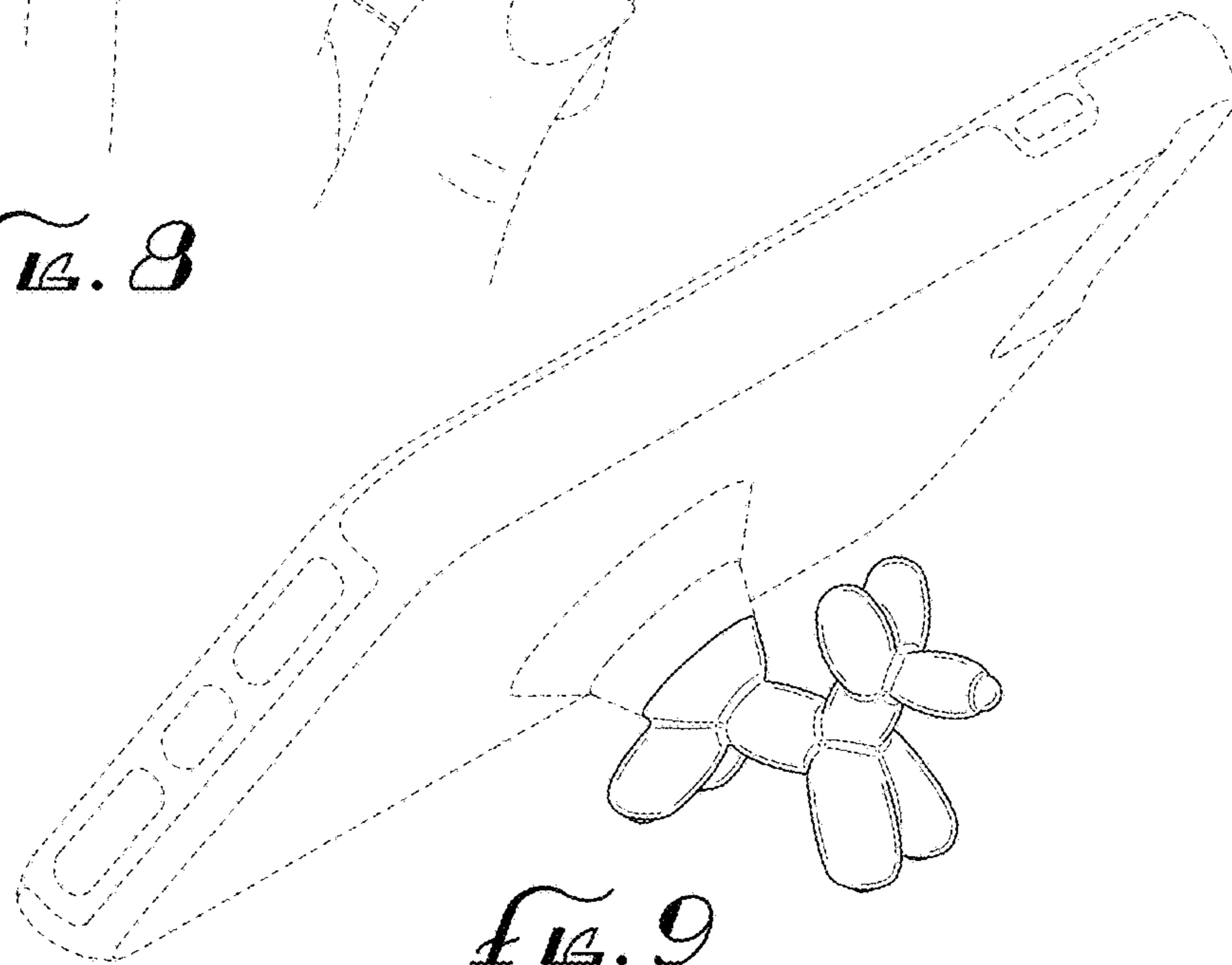
