and,

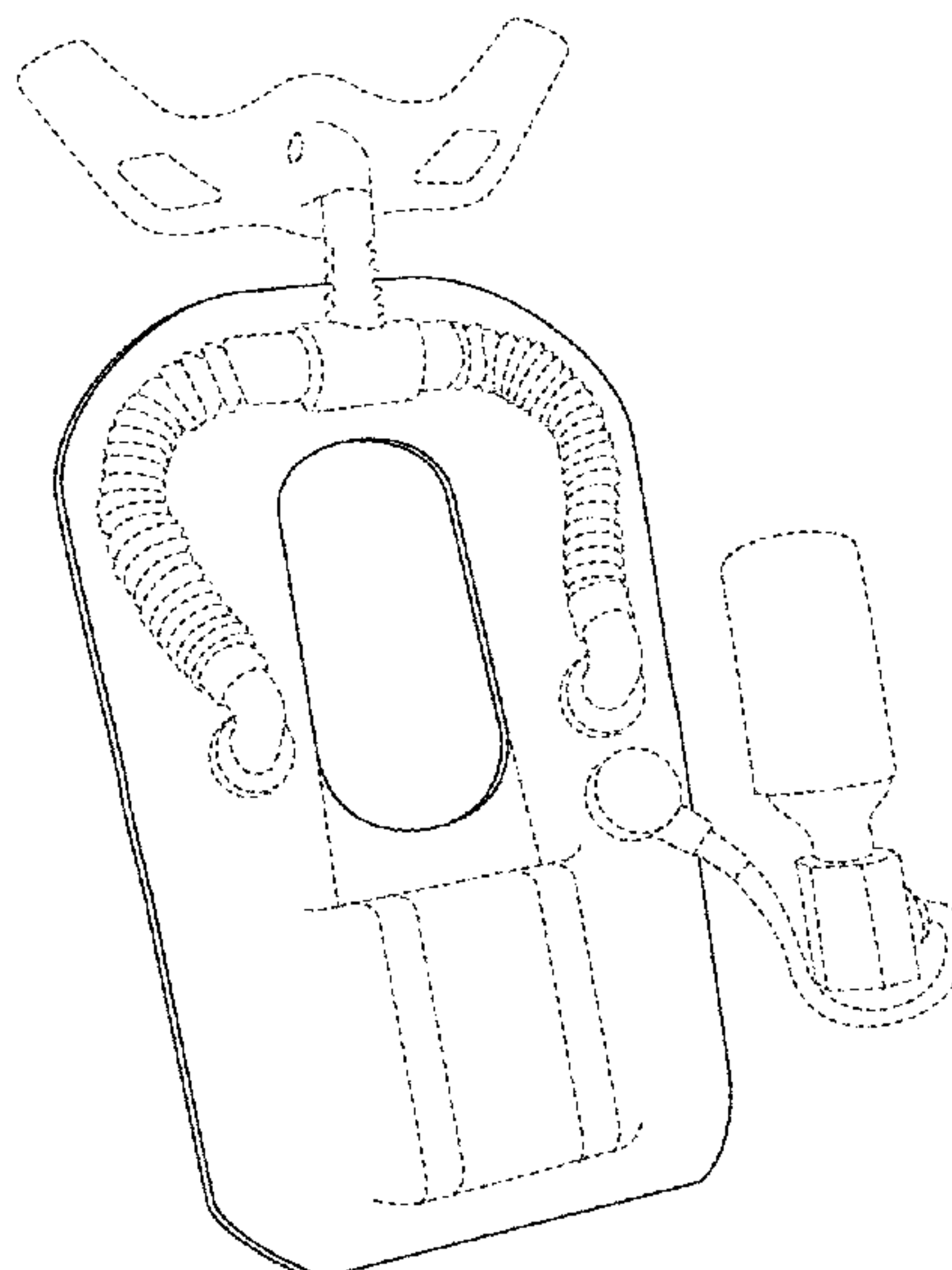
FIG. 9 is a perspective side view thereof.

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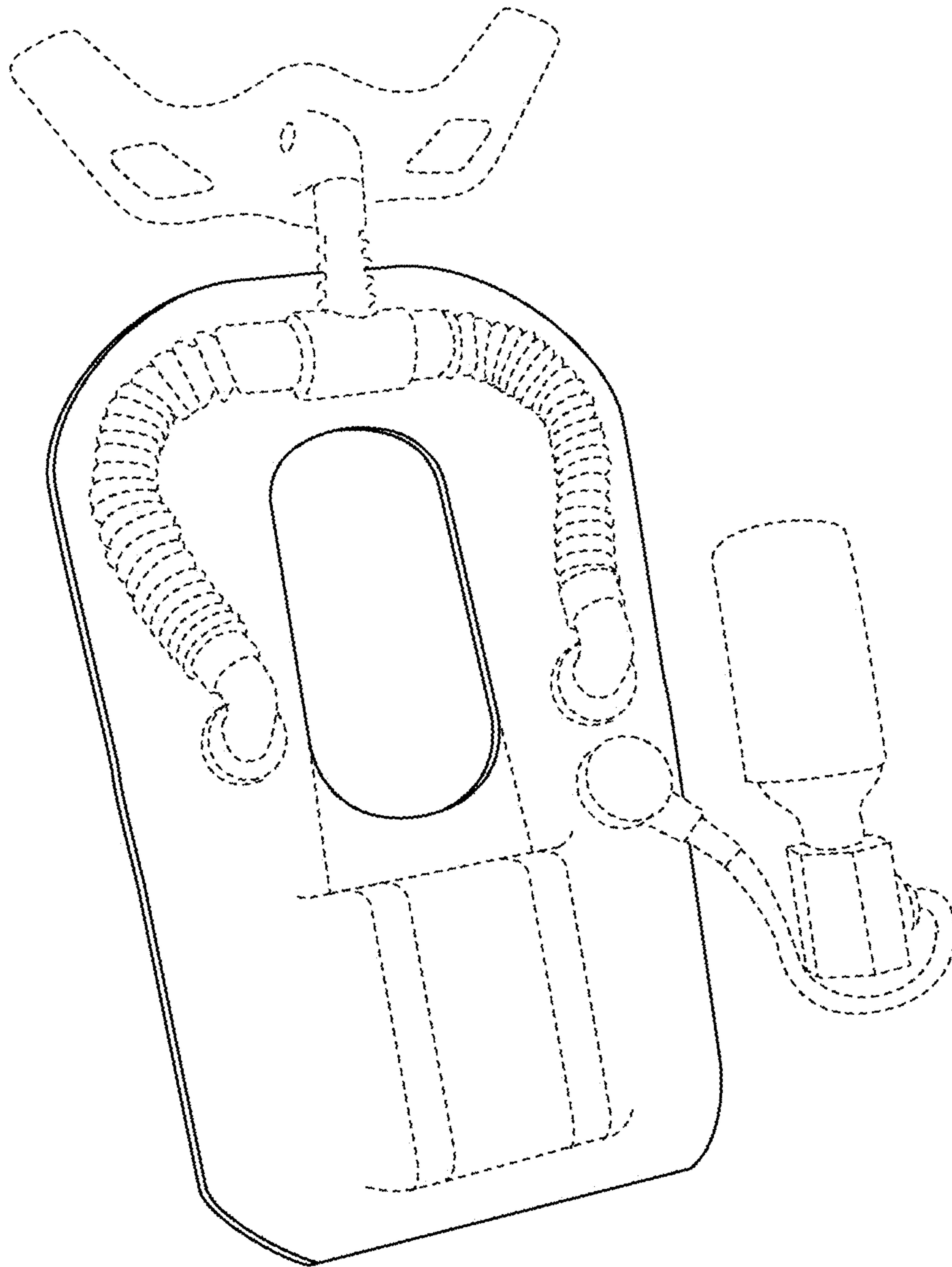

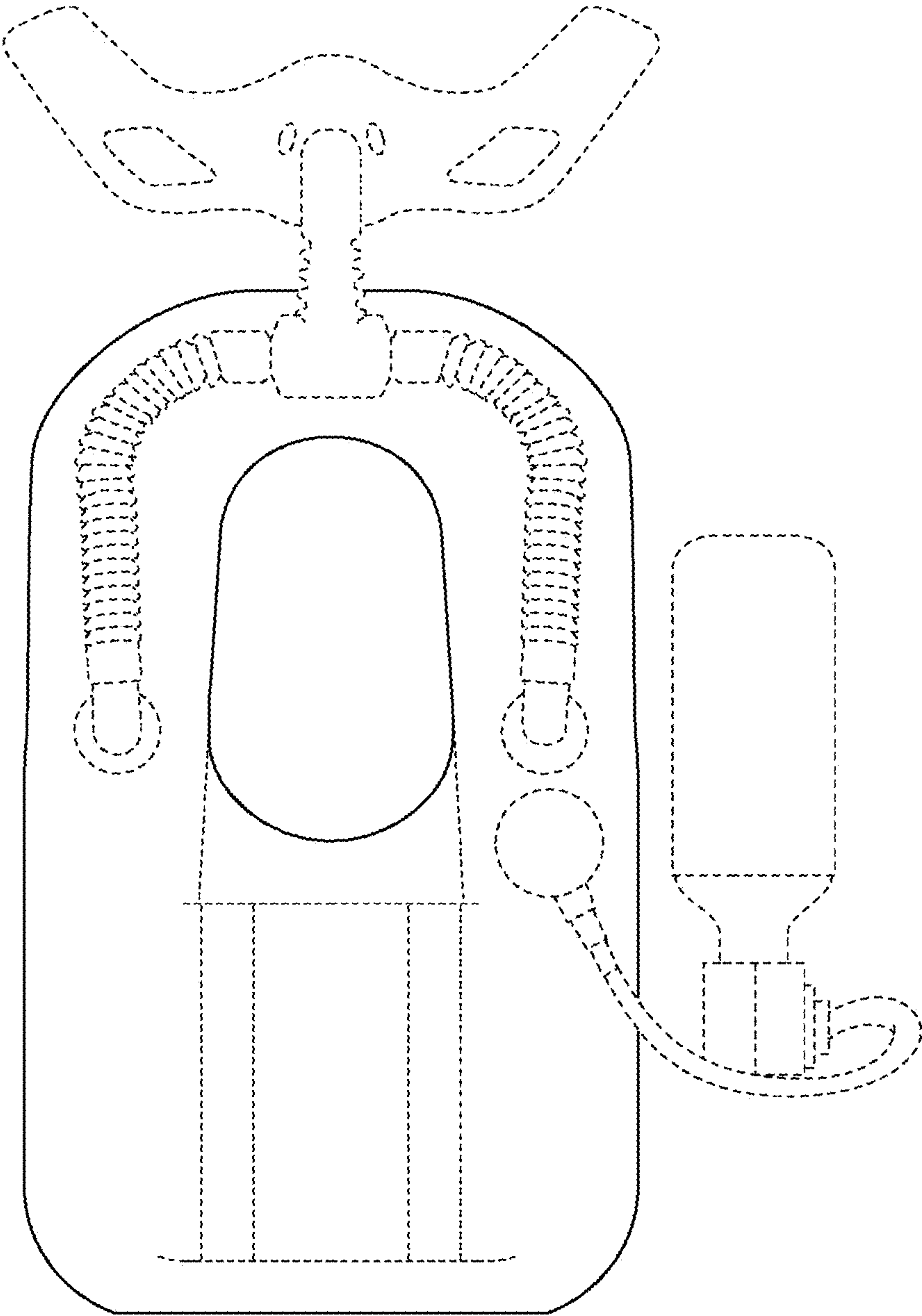

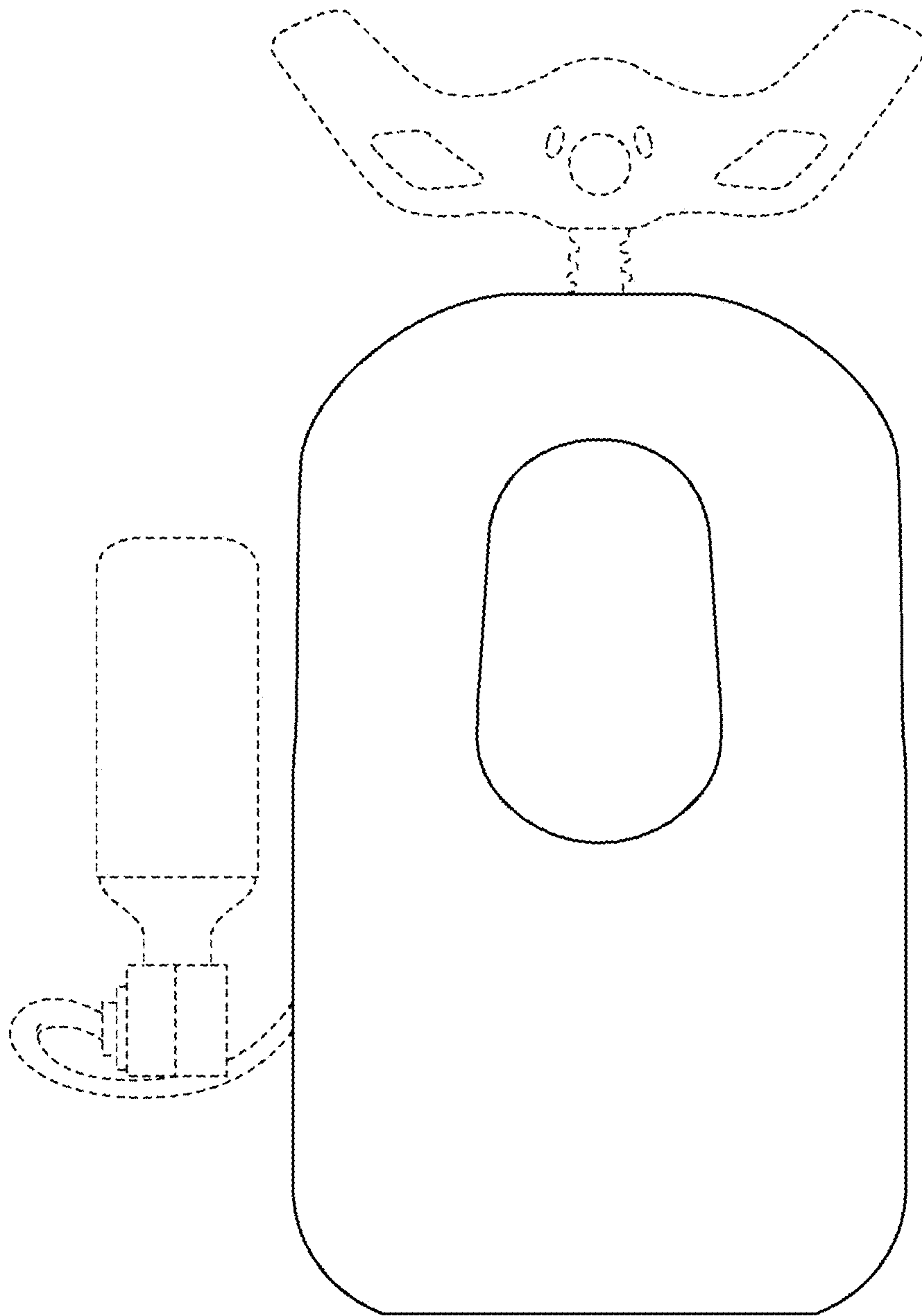

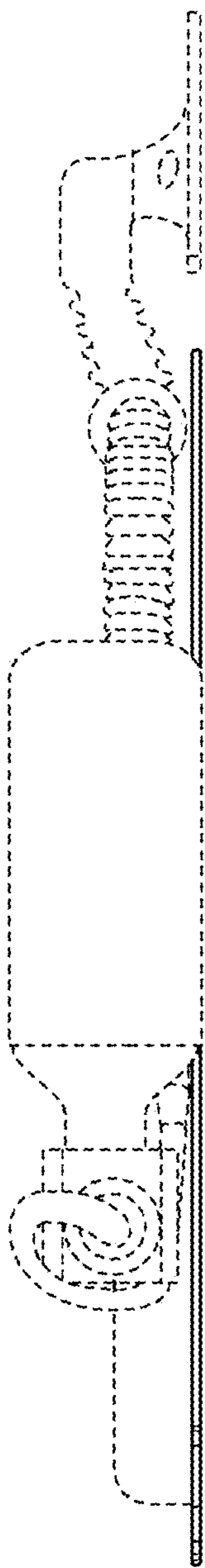

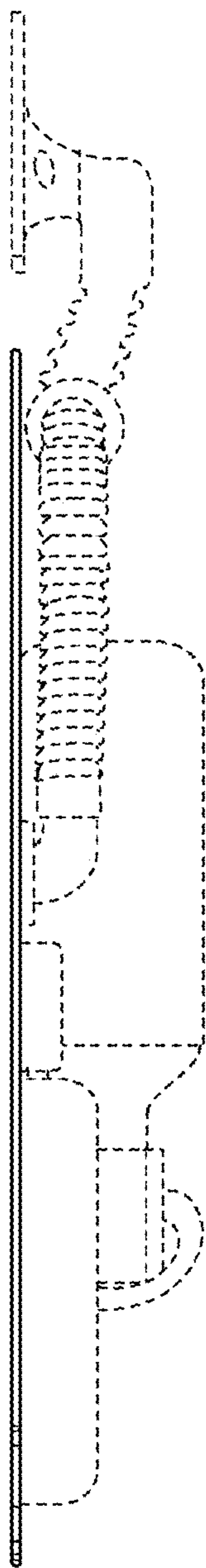

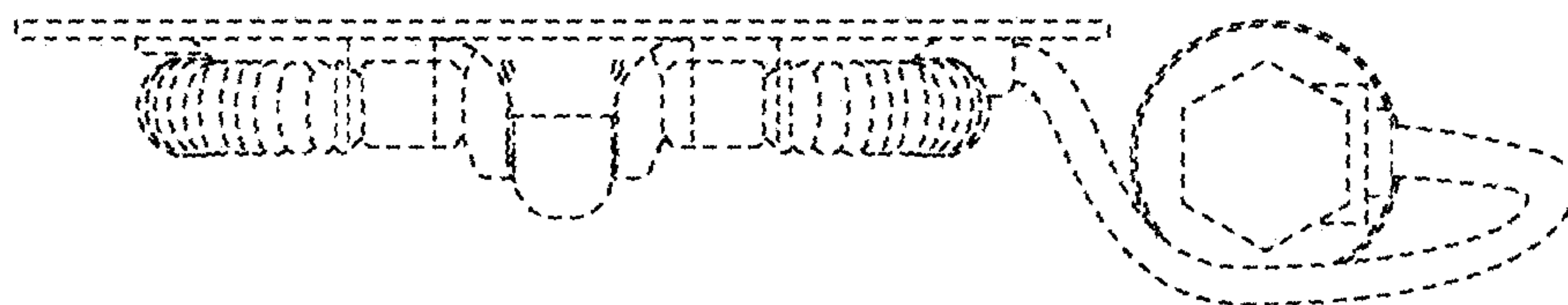

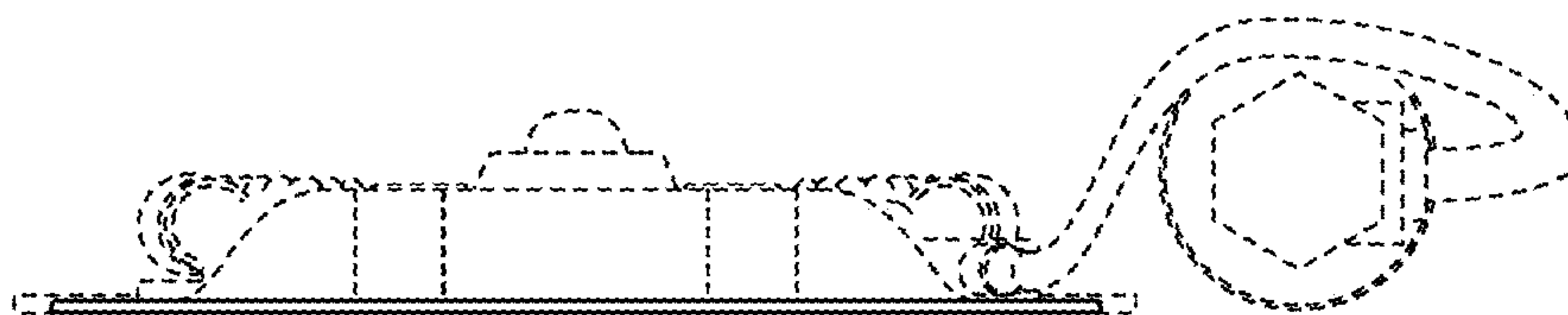

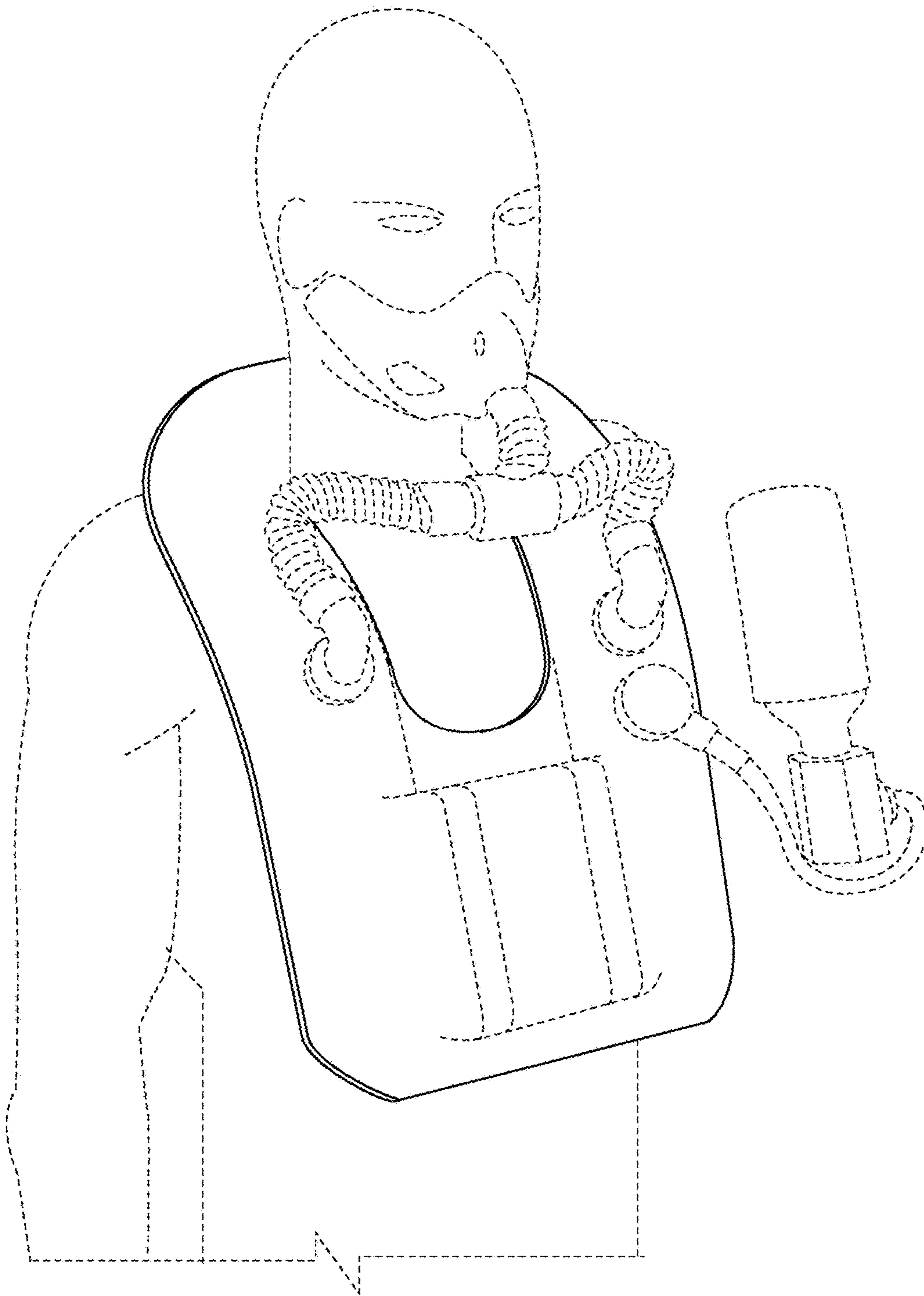

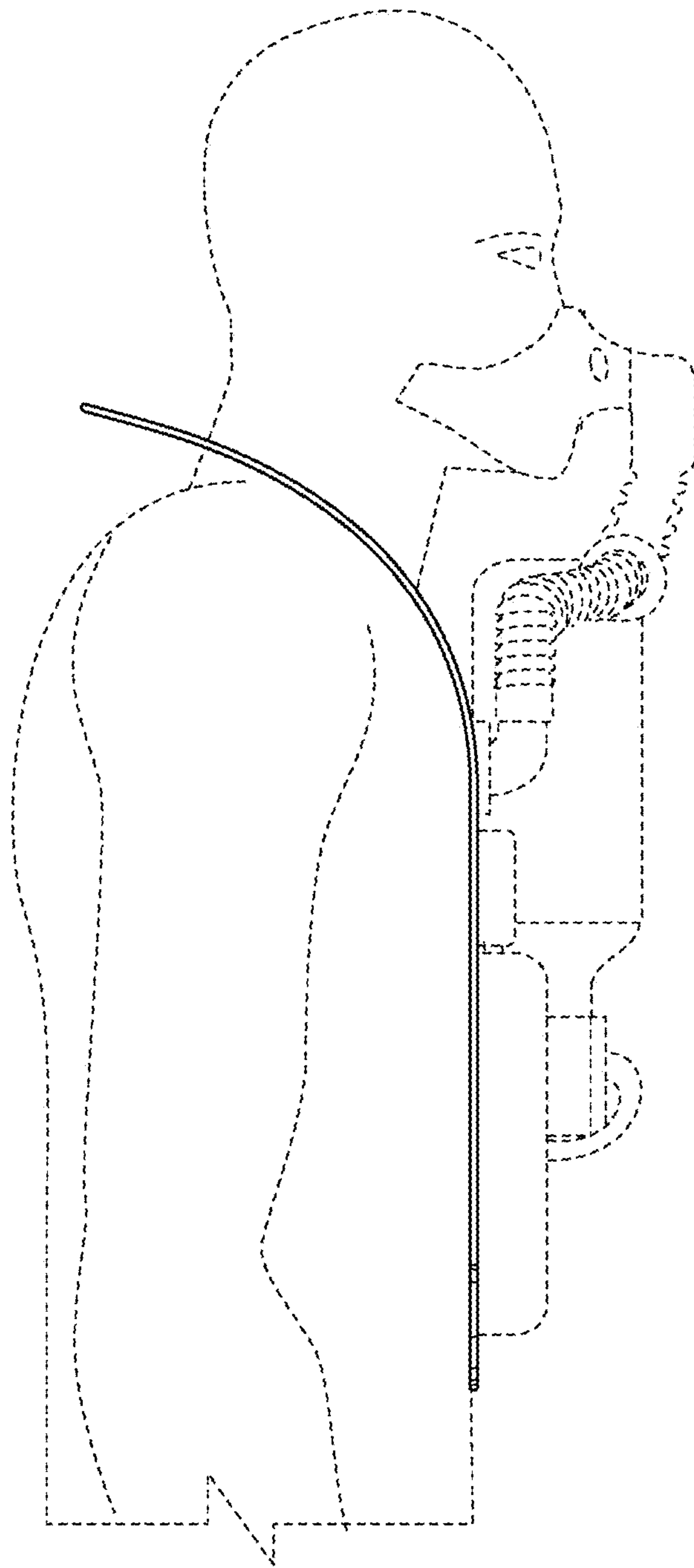
