FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a coffee table showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

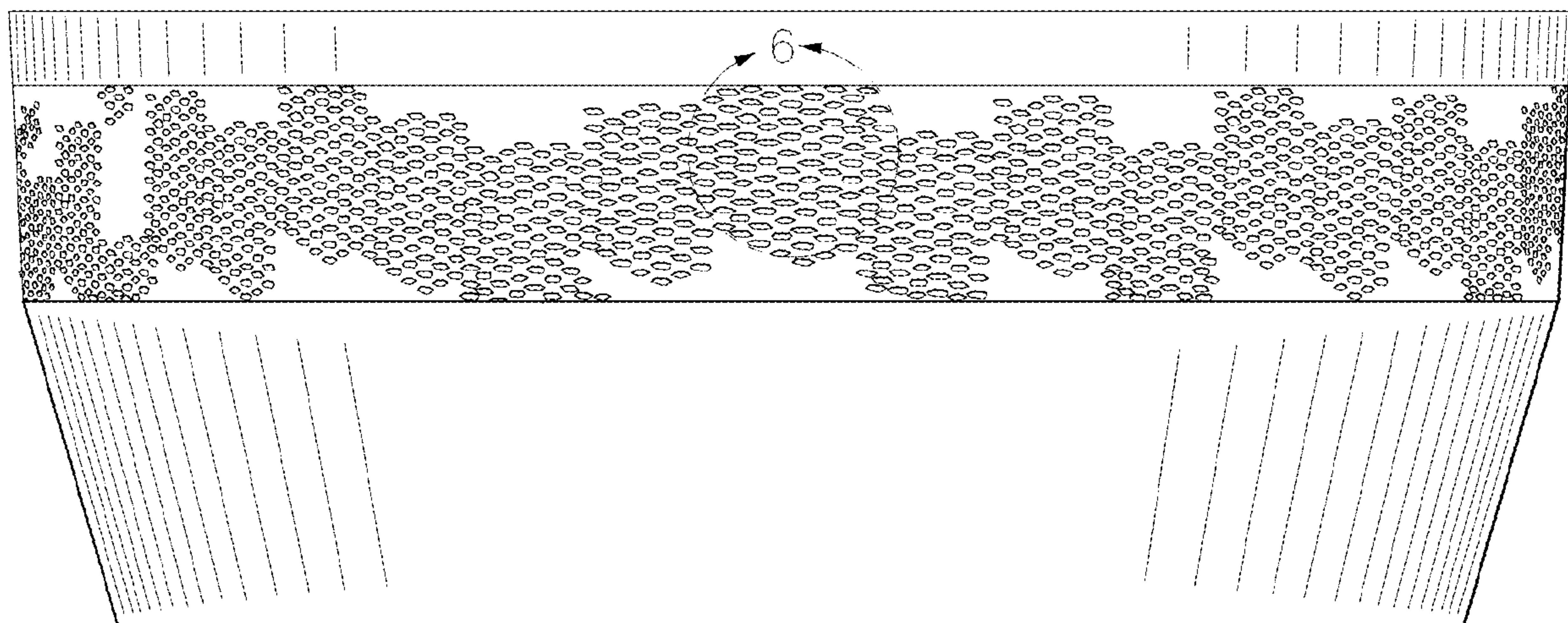

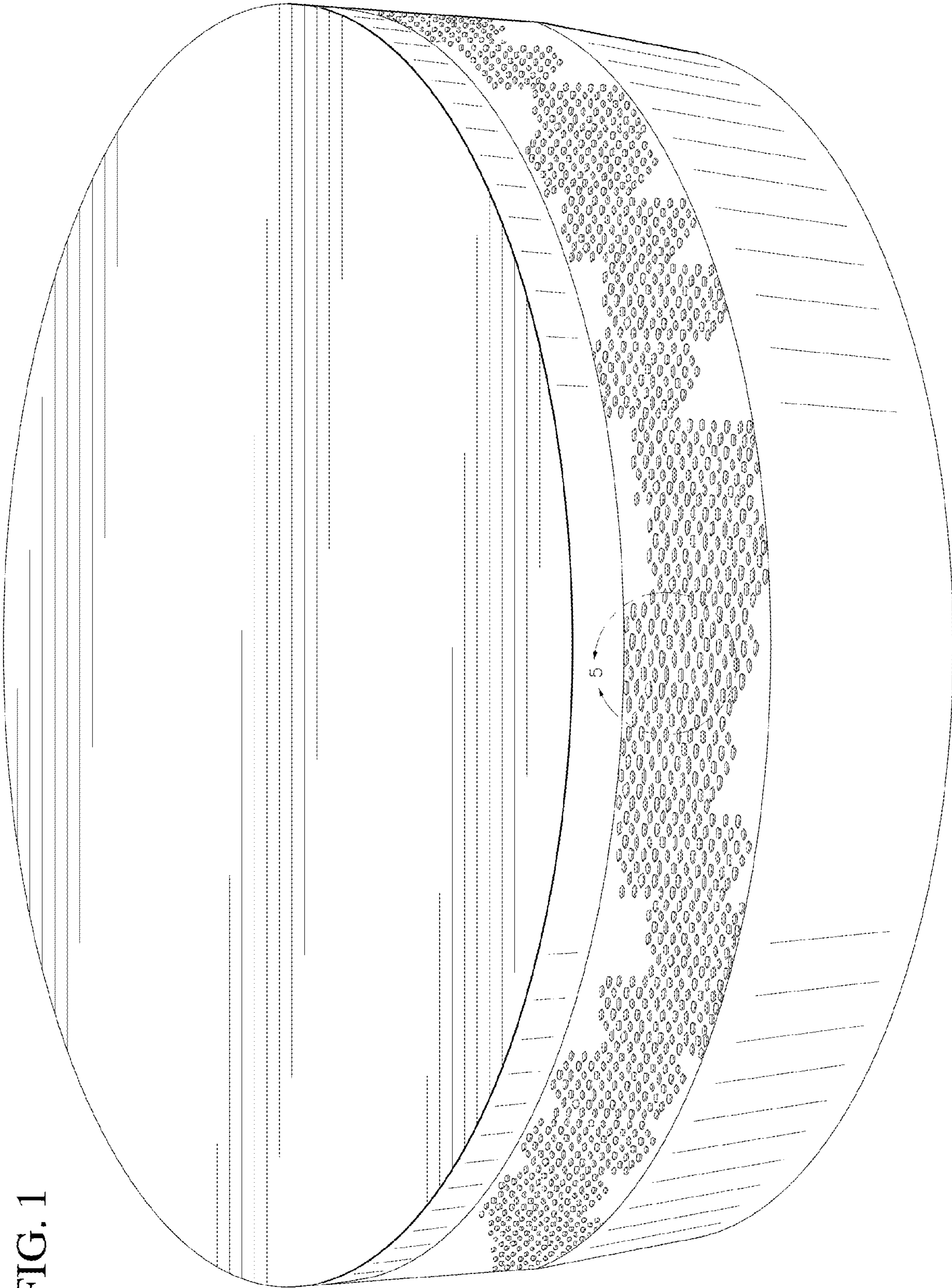
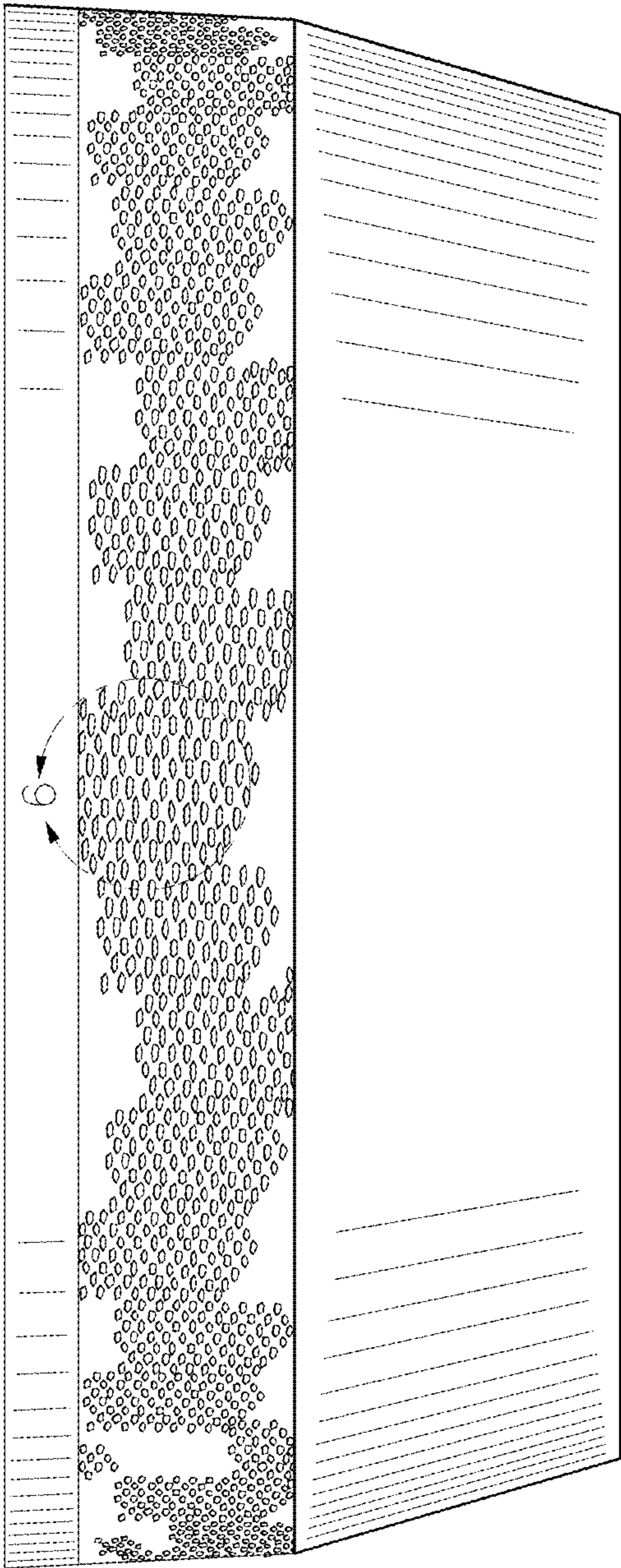

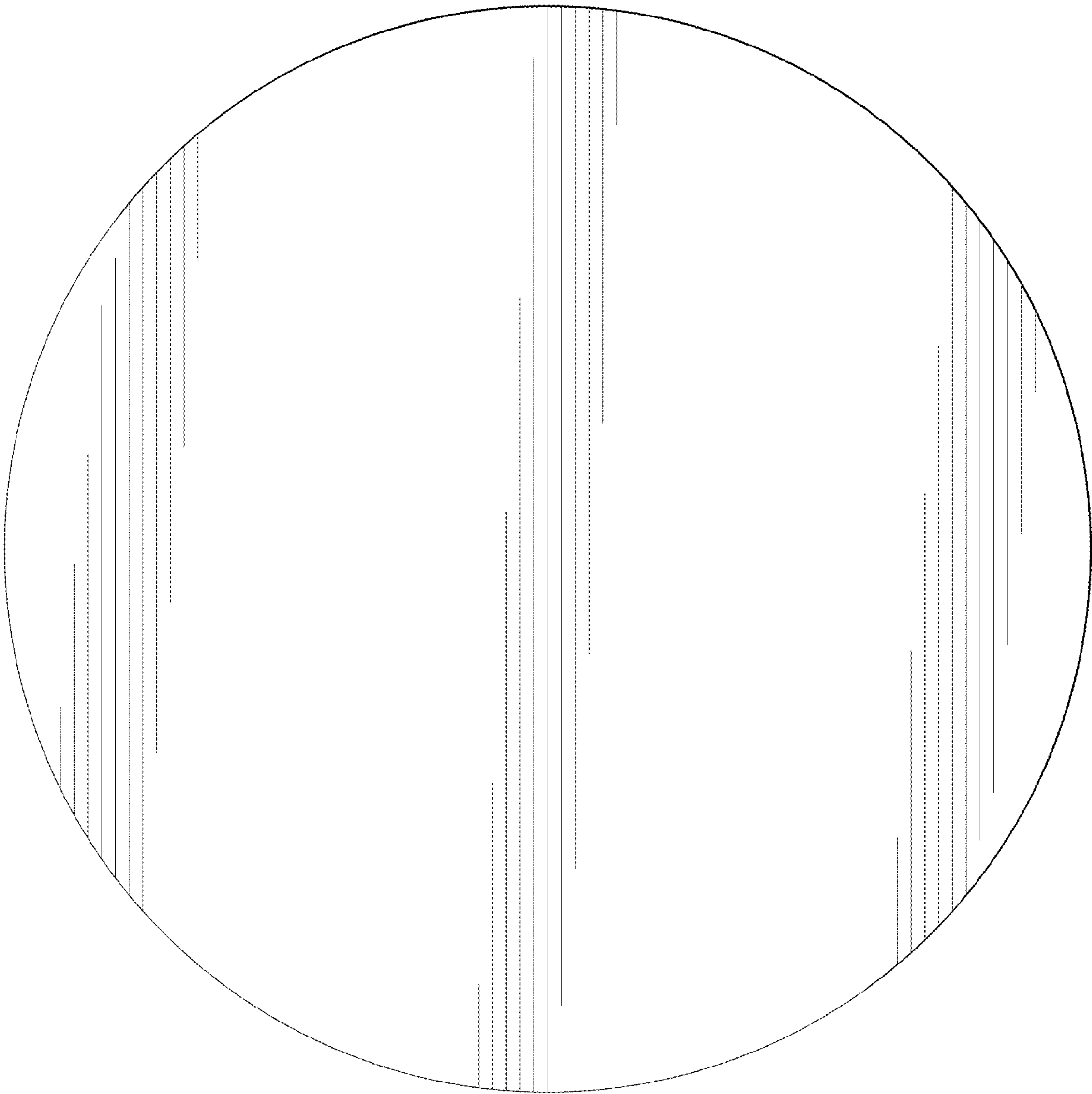

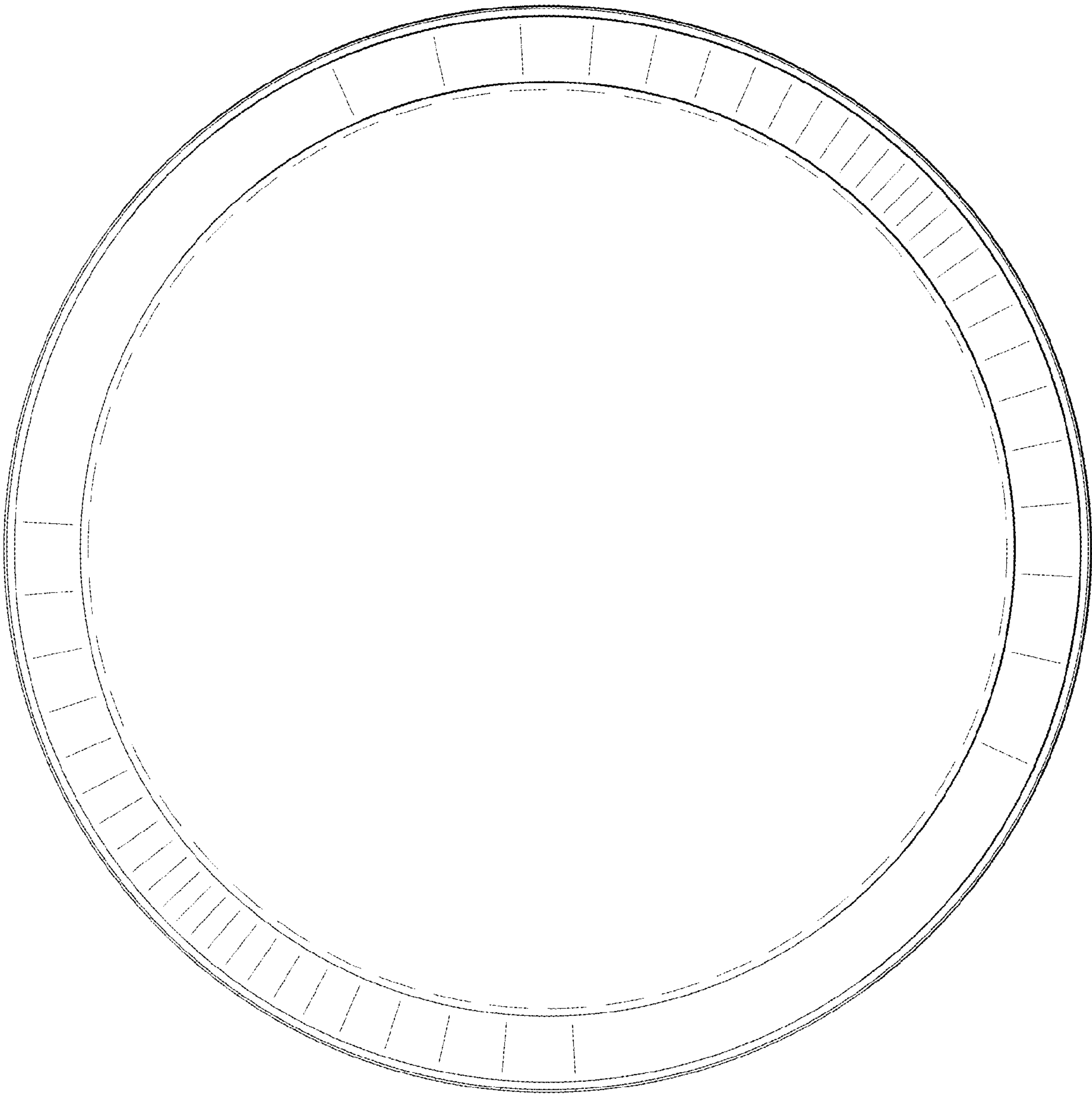

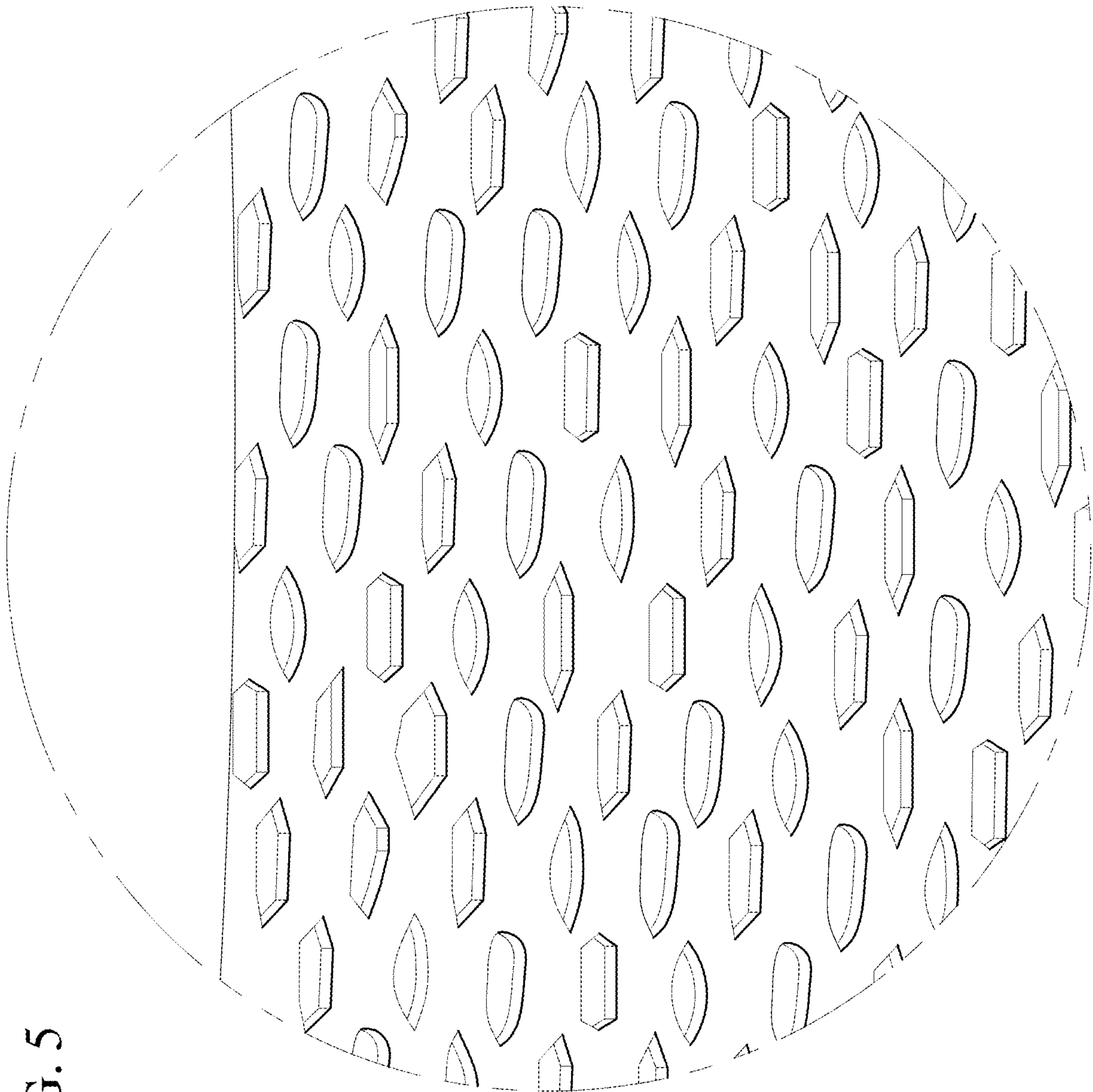

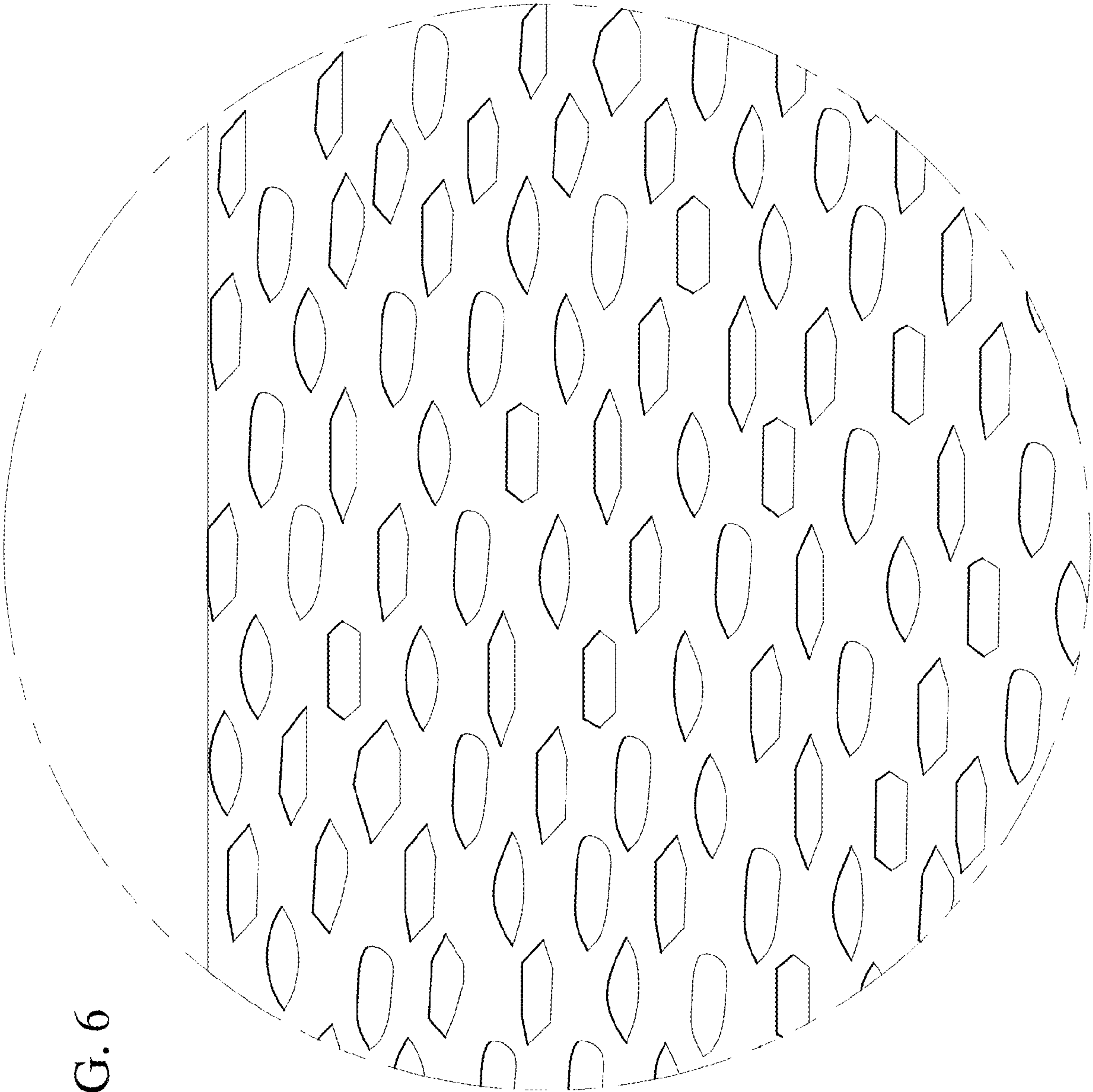
