(57) **CLAIM**

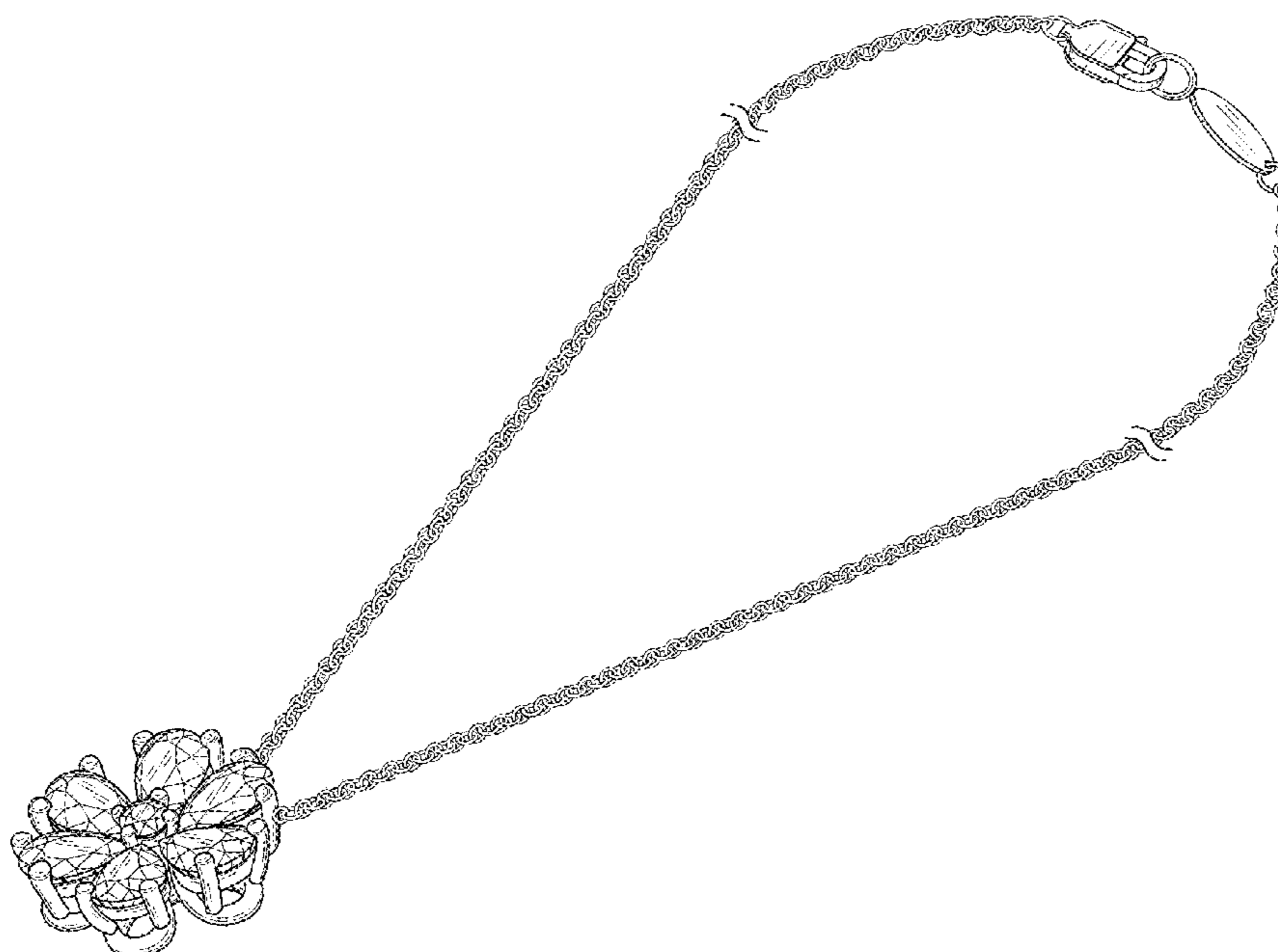
The ornamental design for a necklace with pendant, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a necklace with pendant showing his new design;

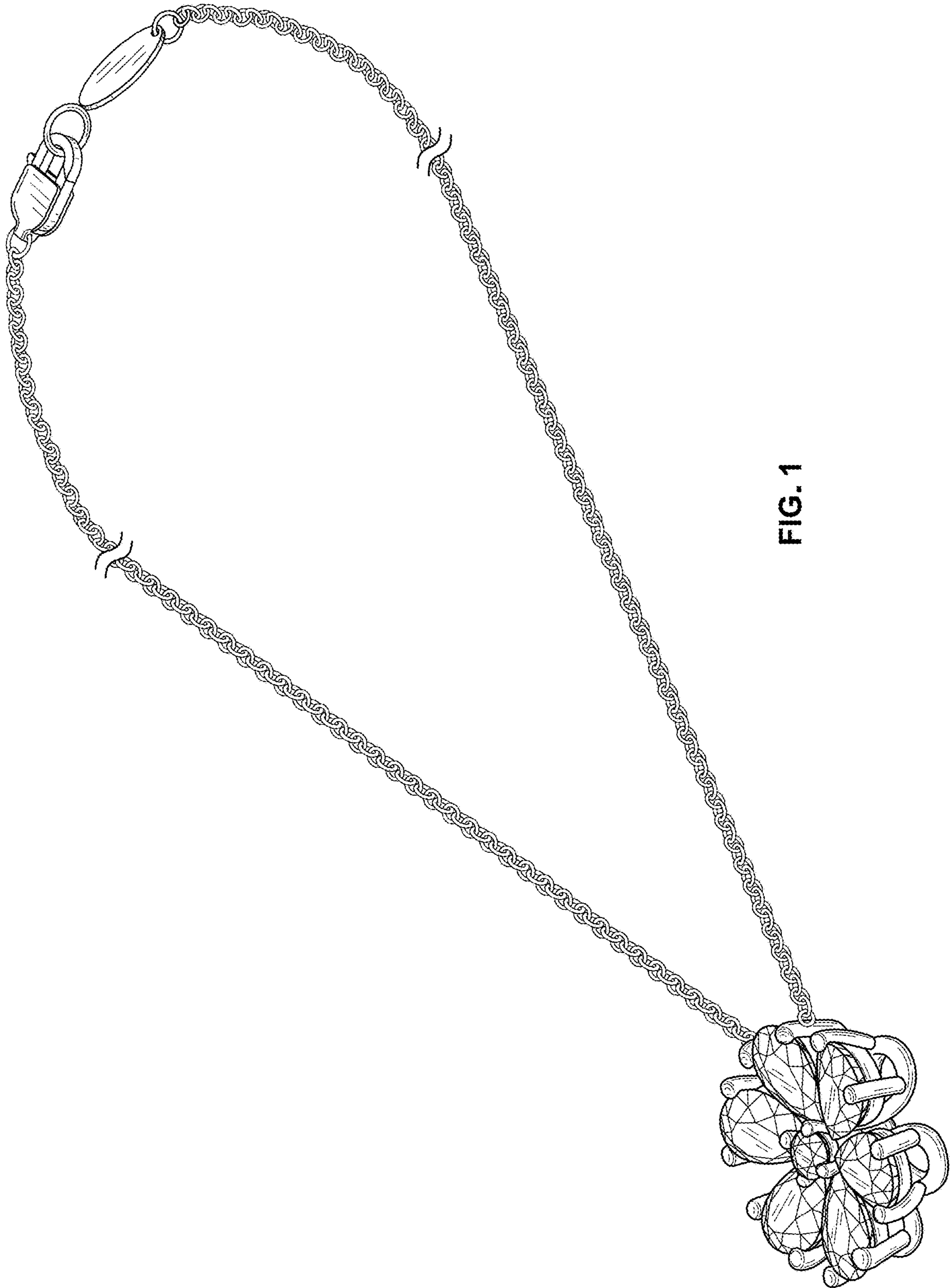

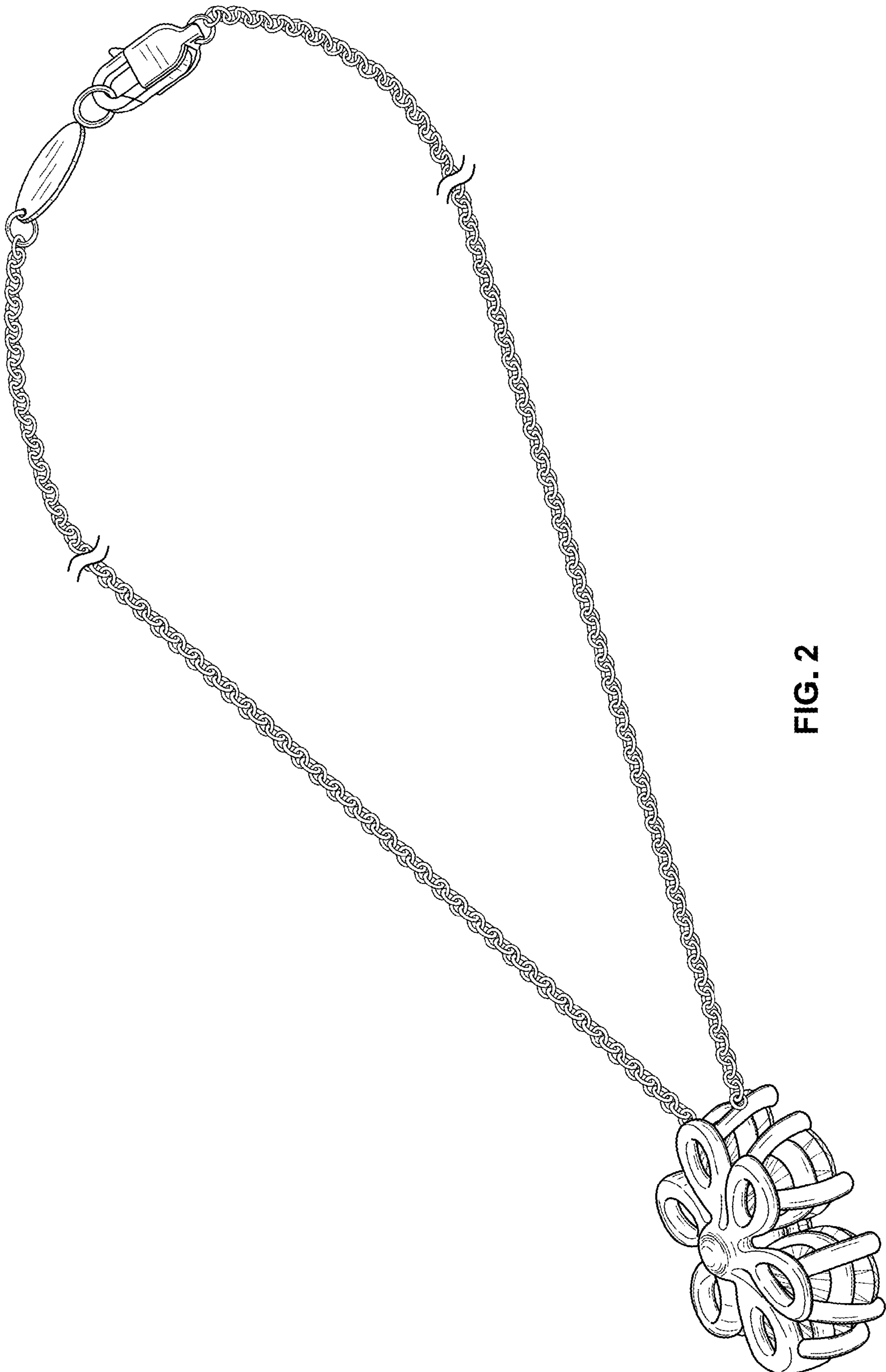

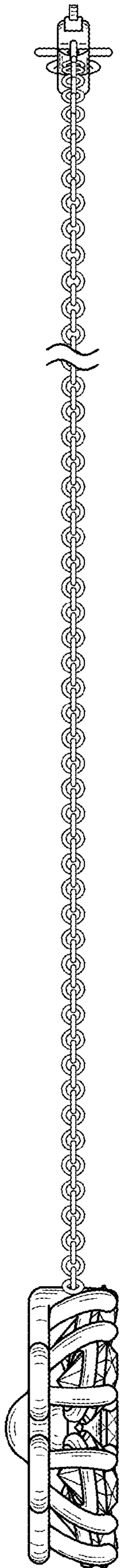

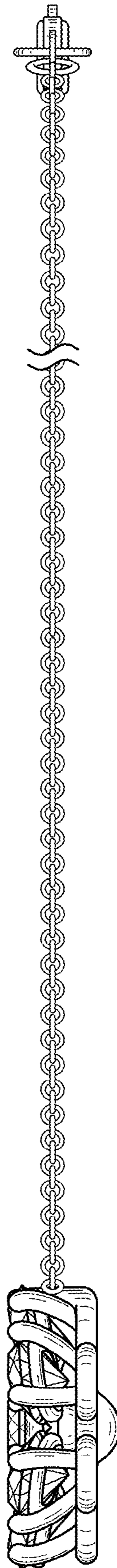

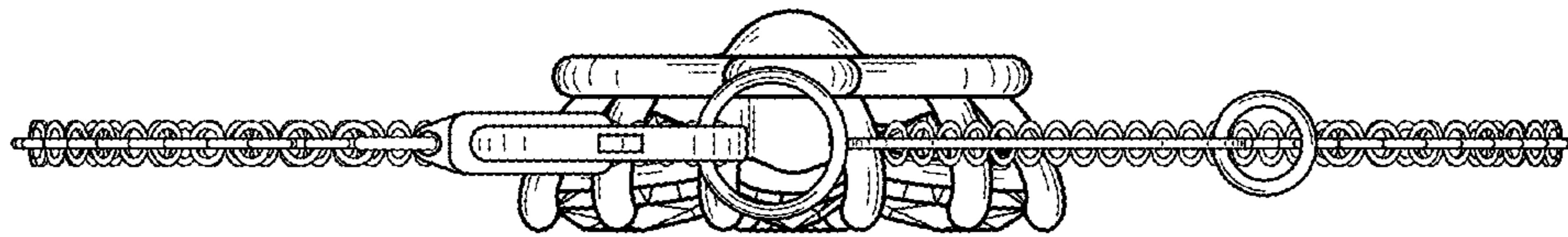

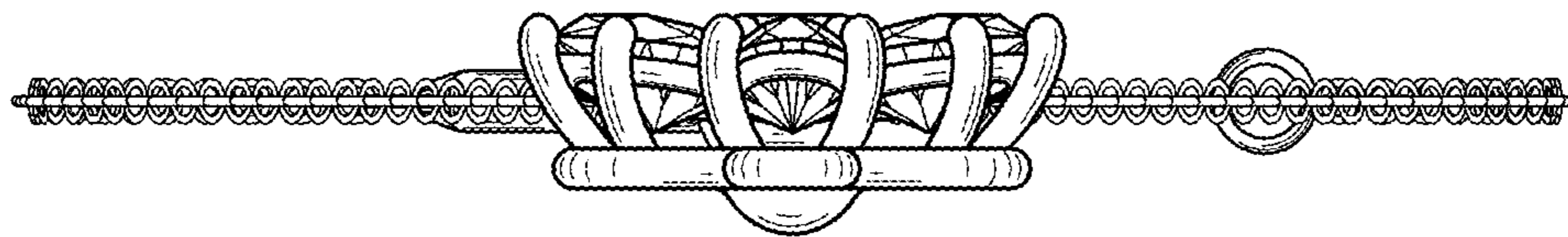
