(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a backpacker firearm stock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right, top perspective view of a backpacker firearm stock showing our new design in an extended configuration;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevation view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1;

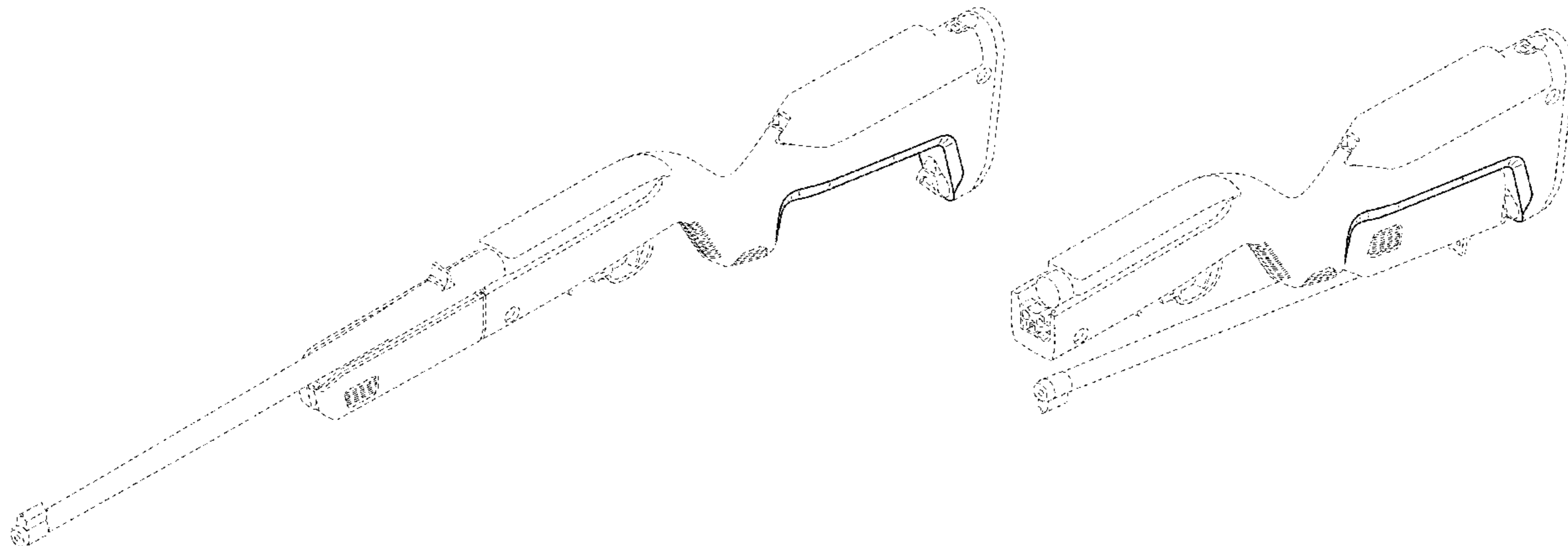
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is another front, right, top perspective view of the backpacker firearm stock of FIG. 1, but in a stowed configuration.

The shade lines in the Figures show contour and not surface ornamentation.

The broken lines in the Figures show portions of the backpacker firearm stock and environment that form no part of the claimed design.

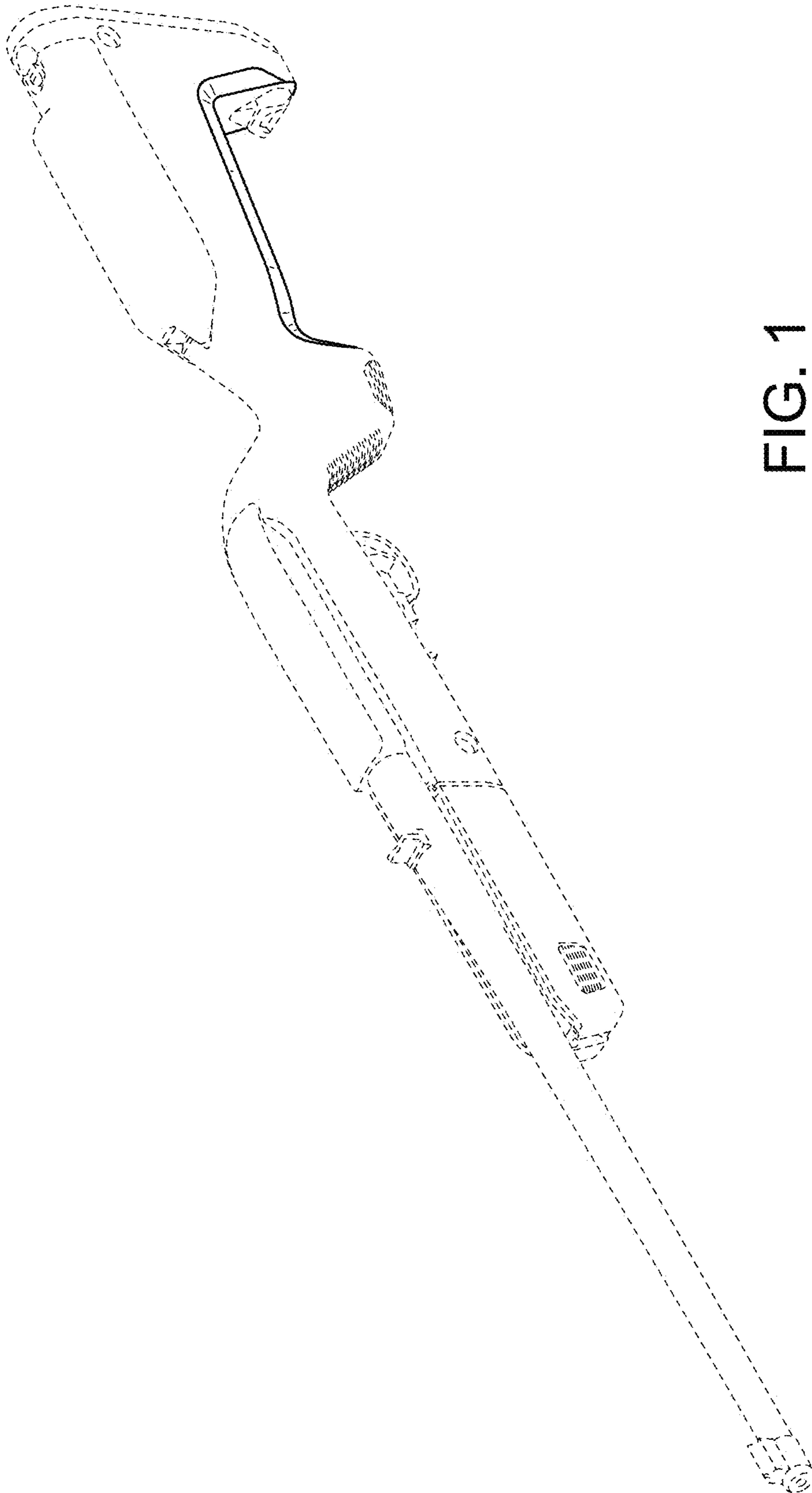

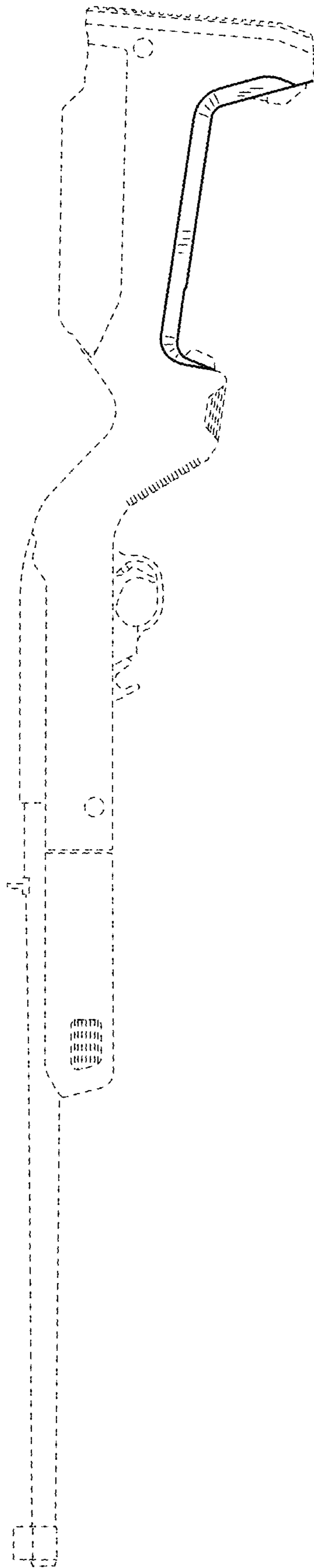

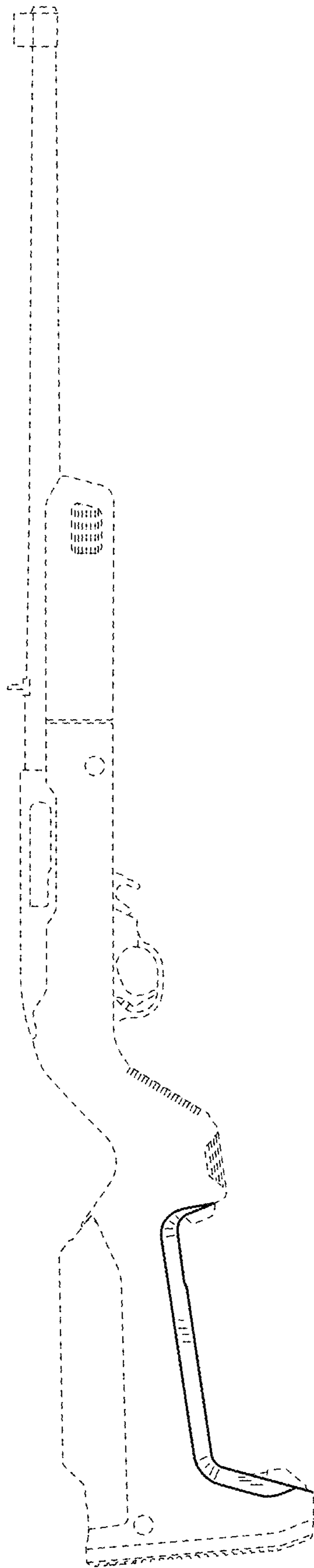

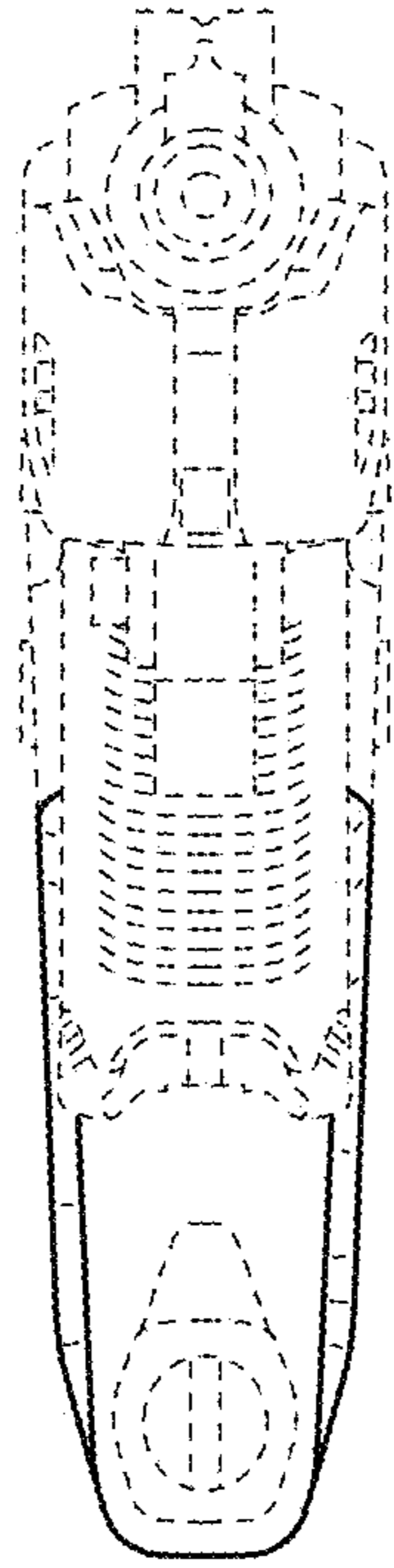

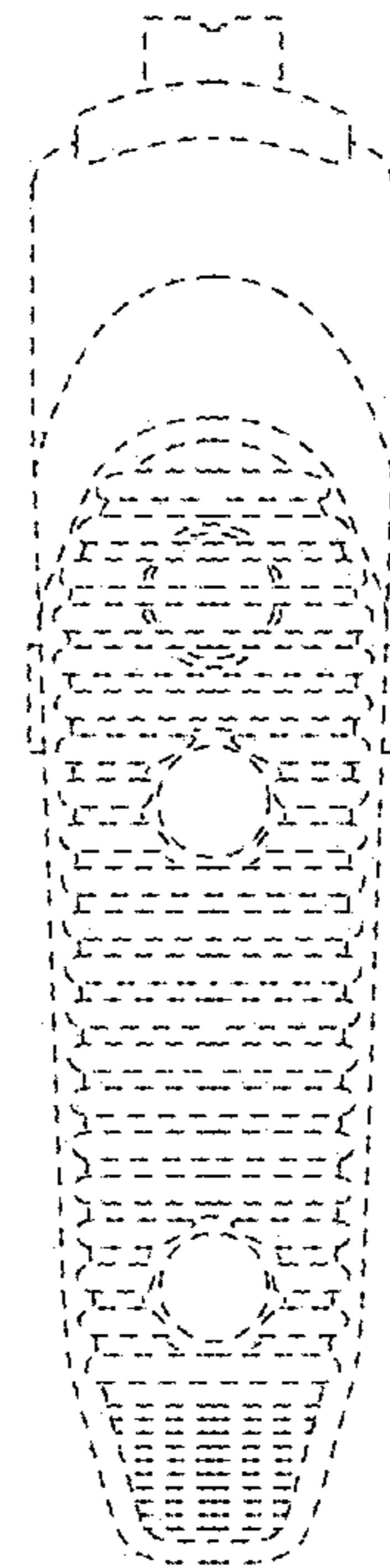

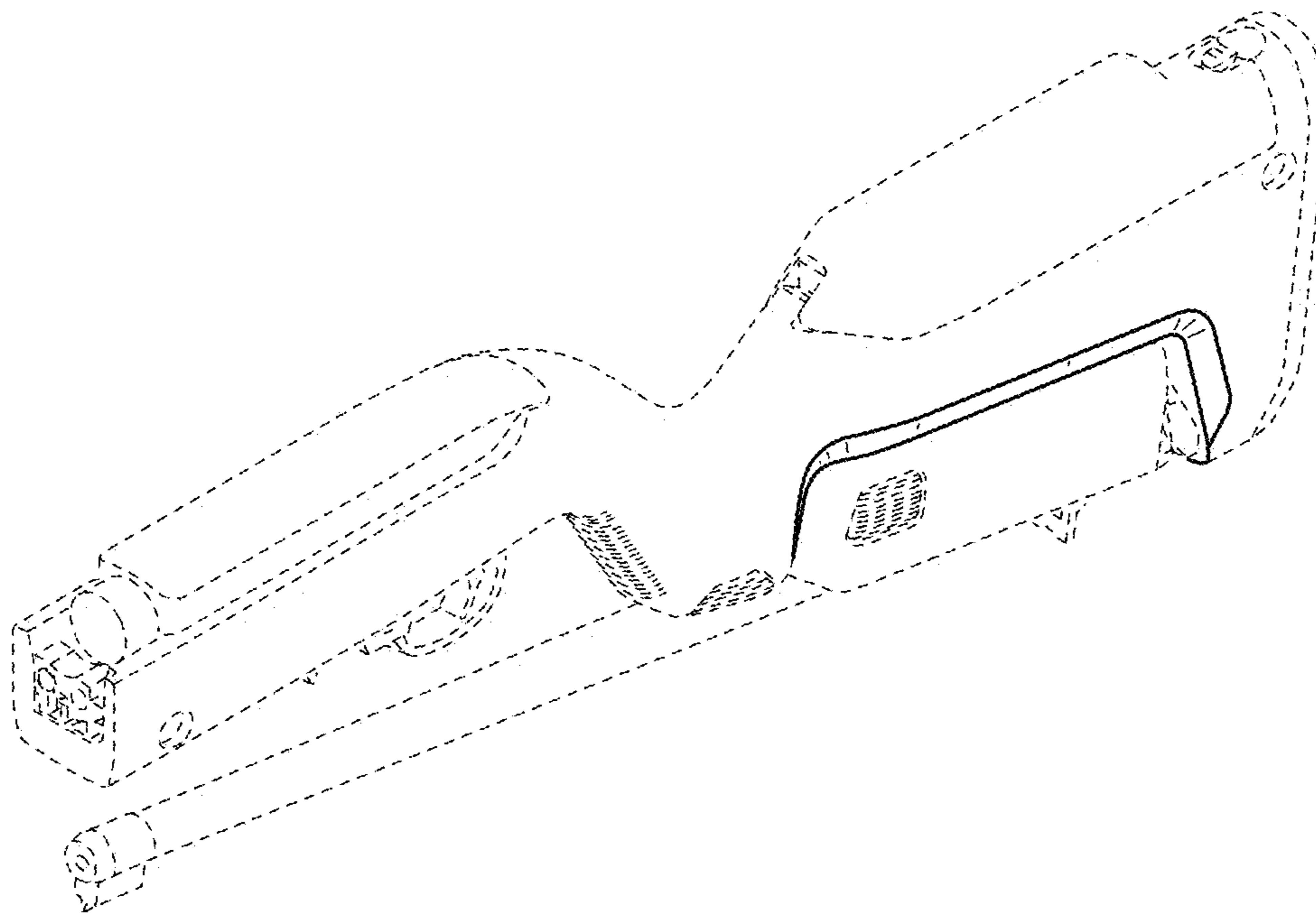
