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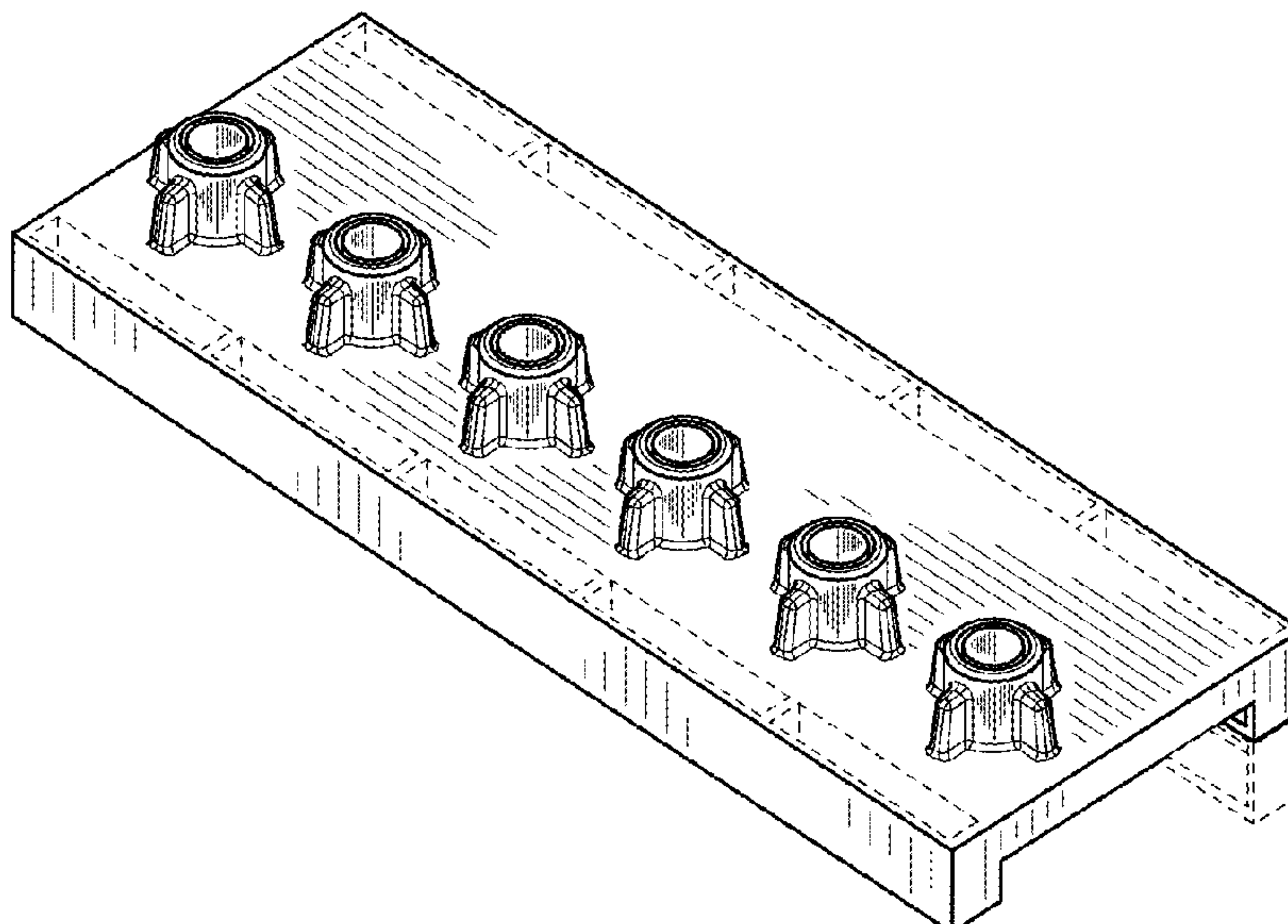
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a shelf pin hole jig showing my new design;

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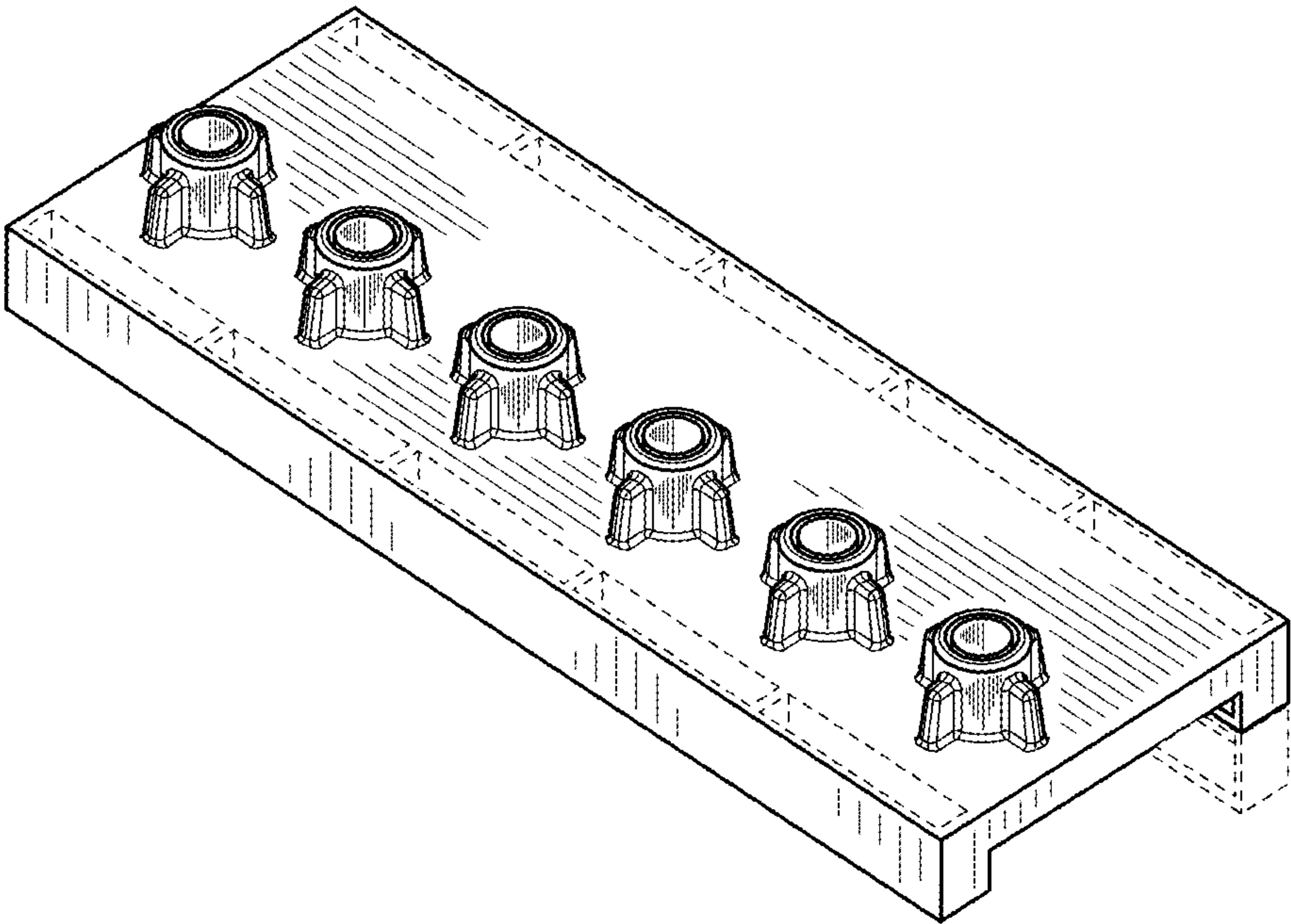

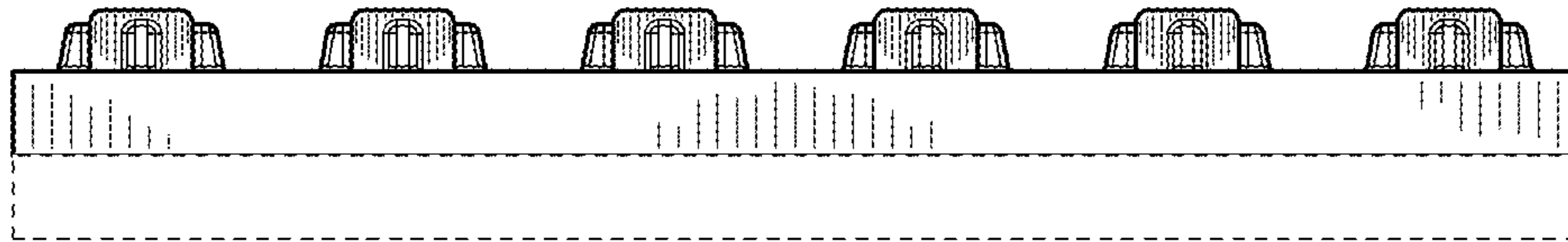

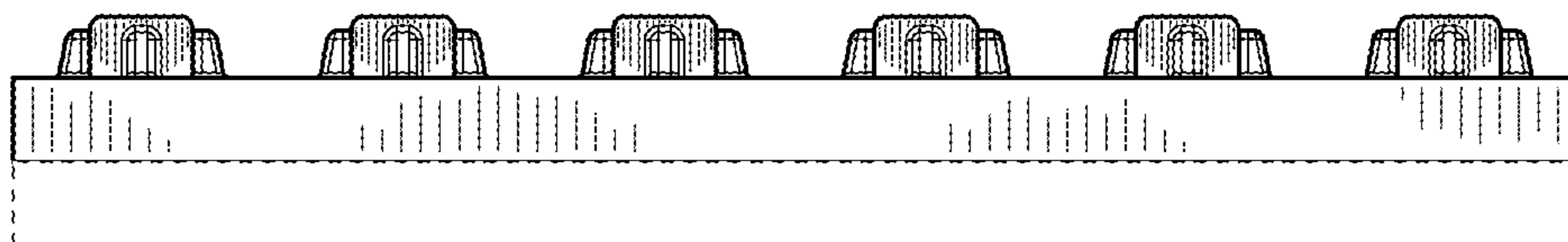

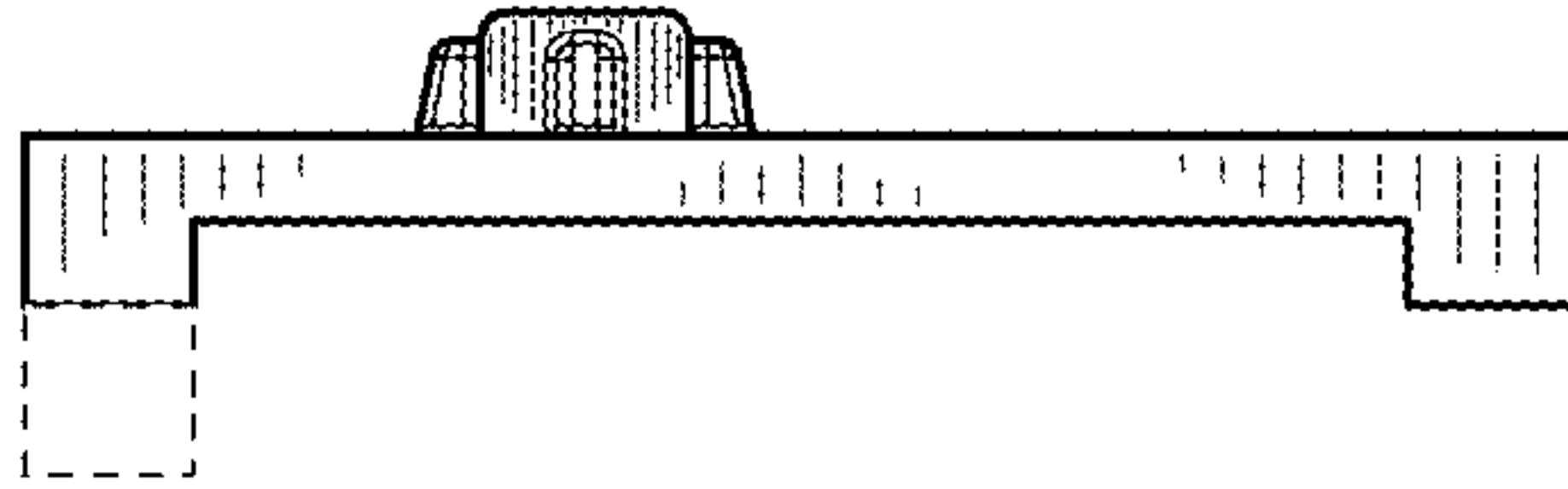

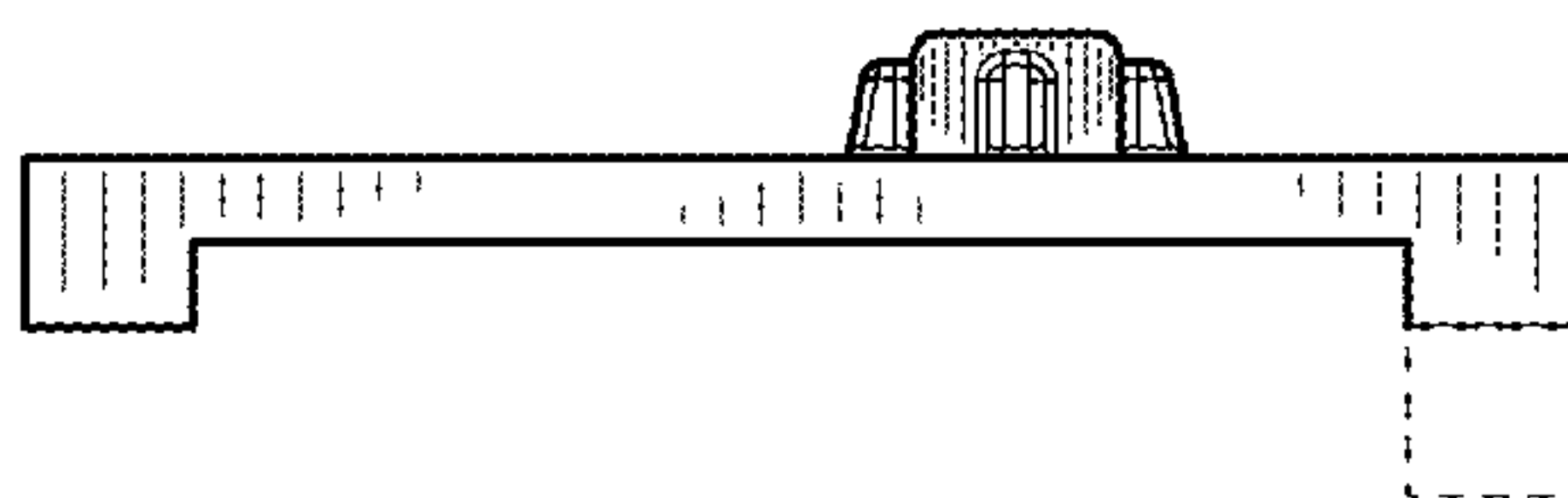

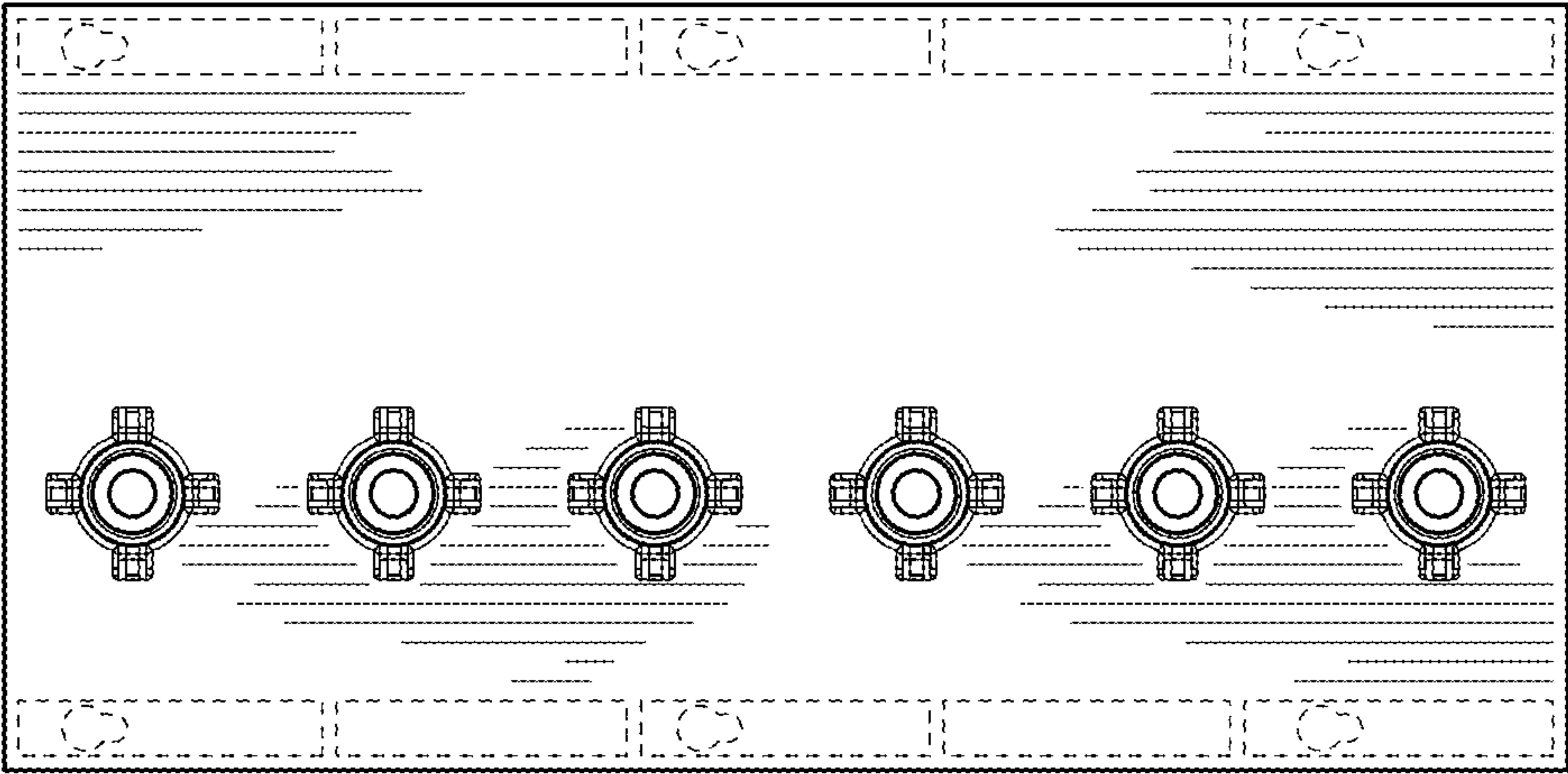

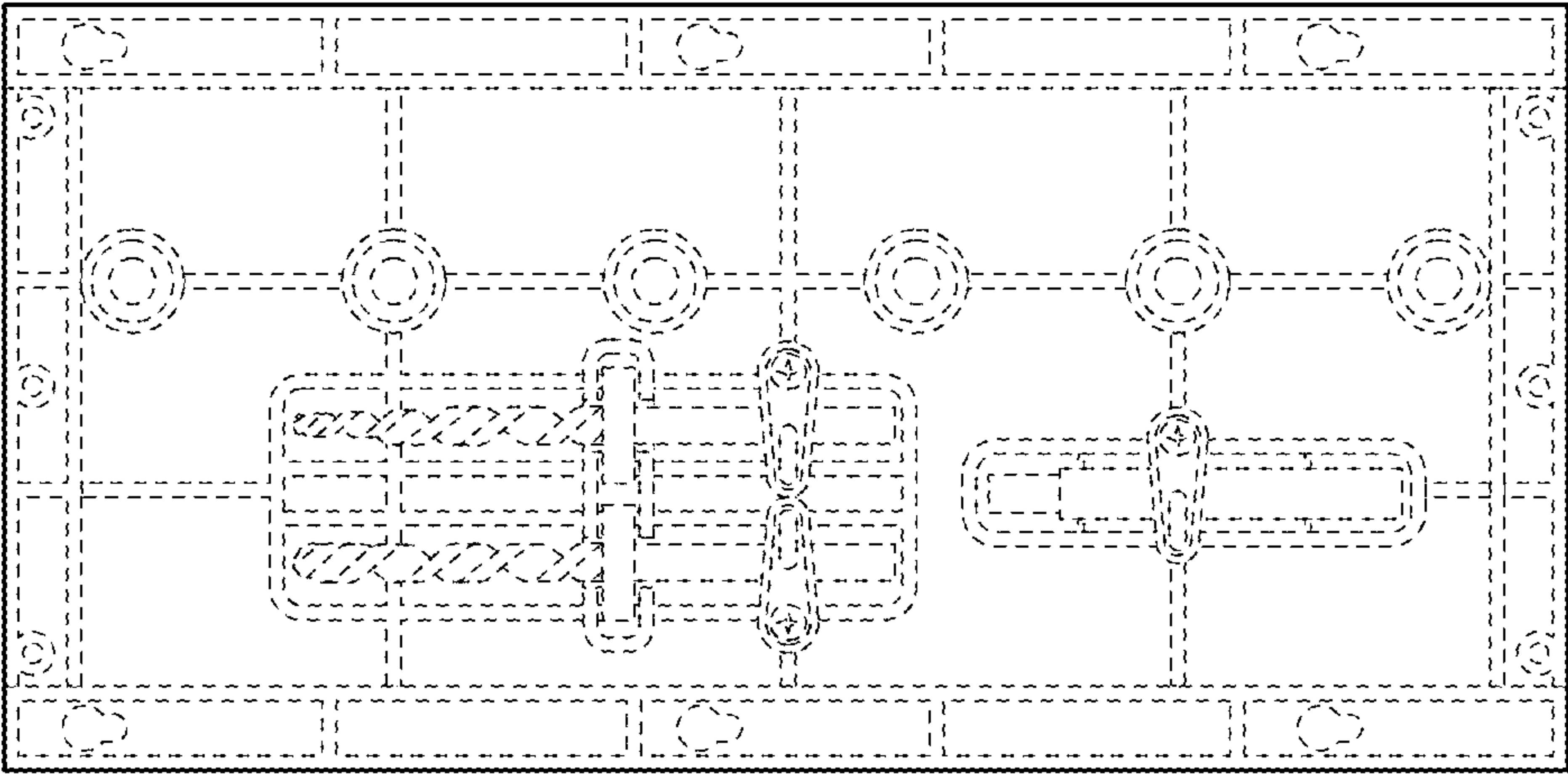

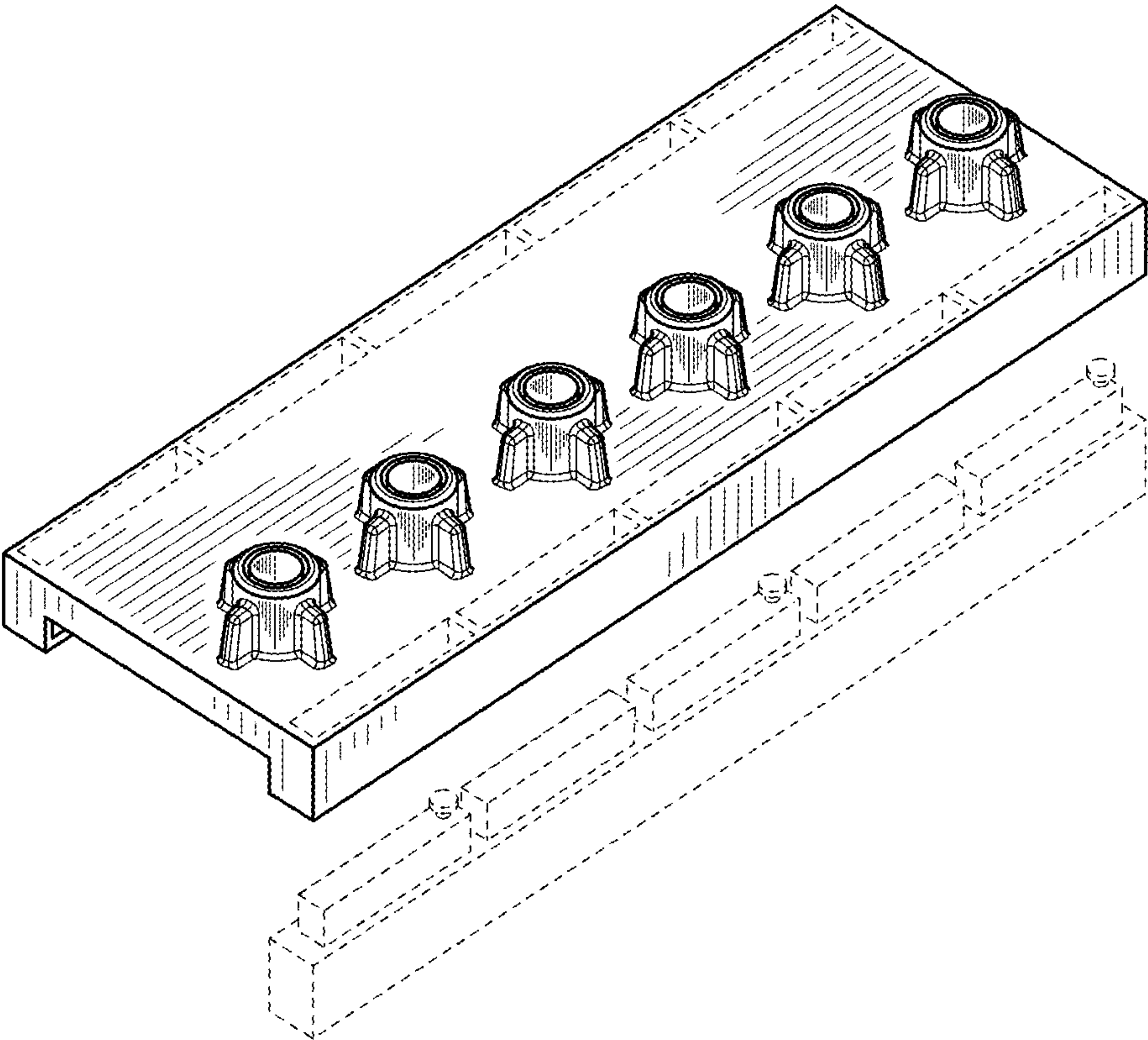
