FIG. 5 is an isolated view on an enlarged scale taken from FIG. 4;

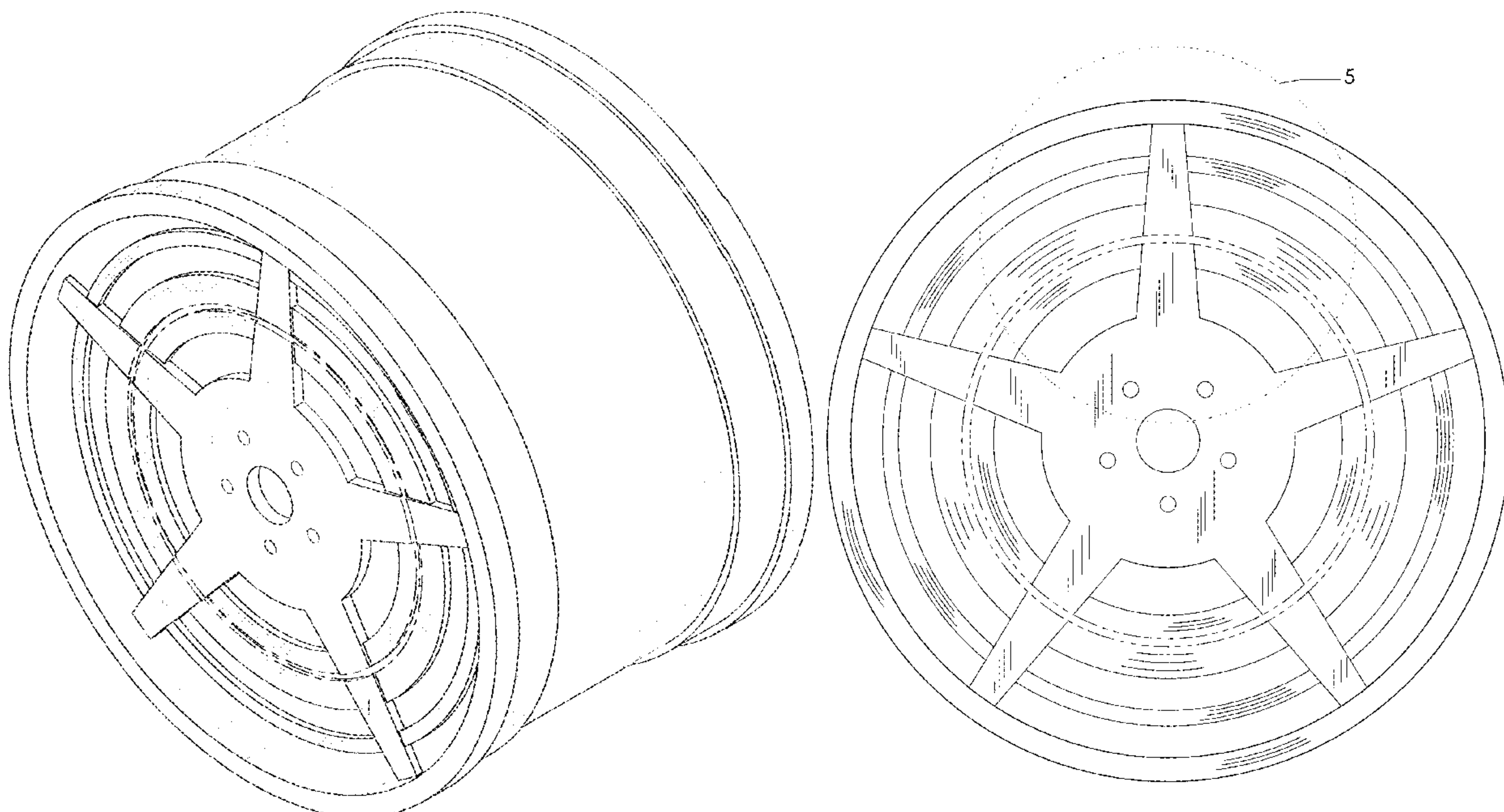
FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof;

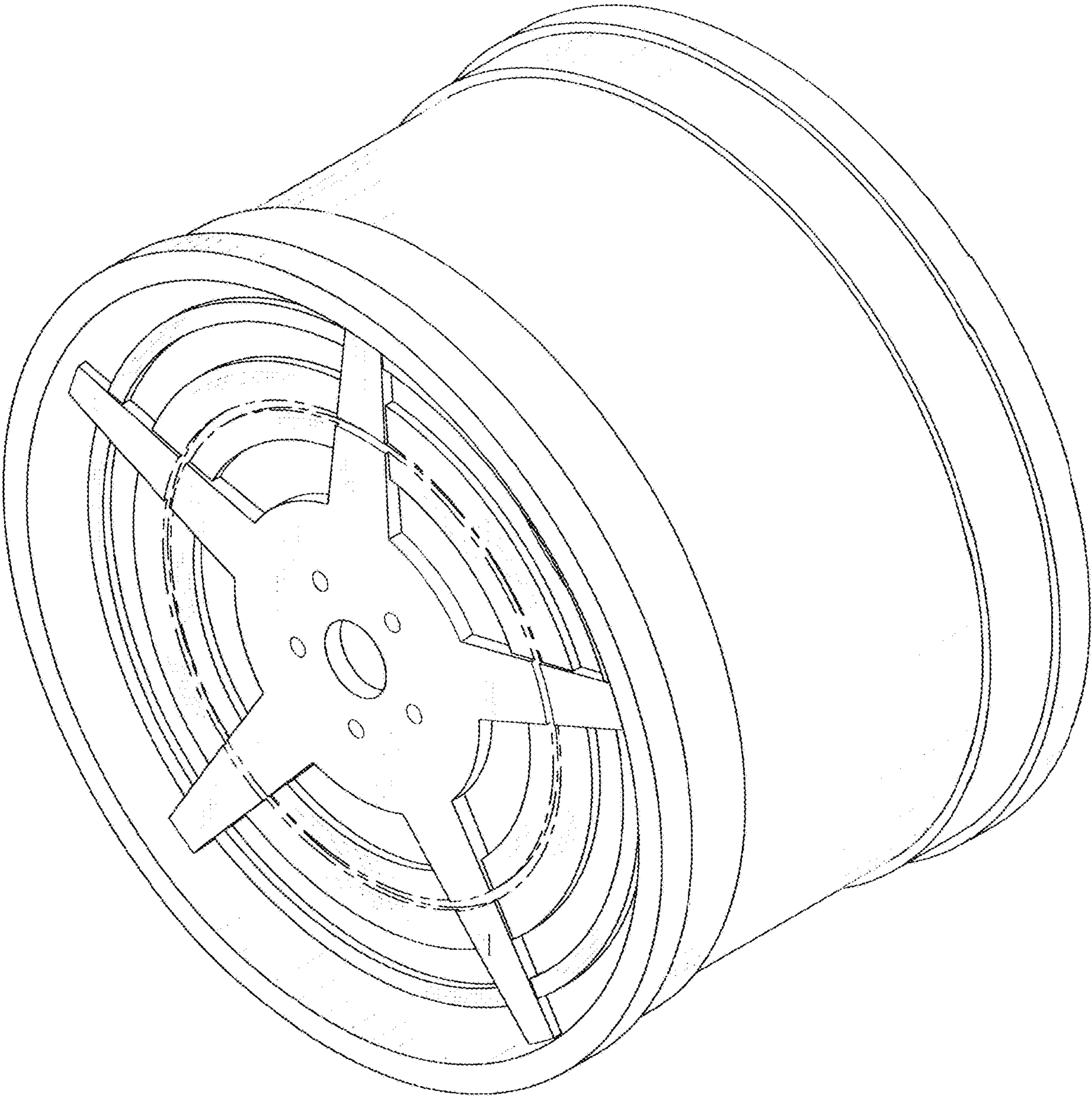

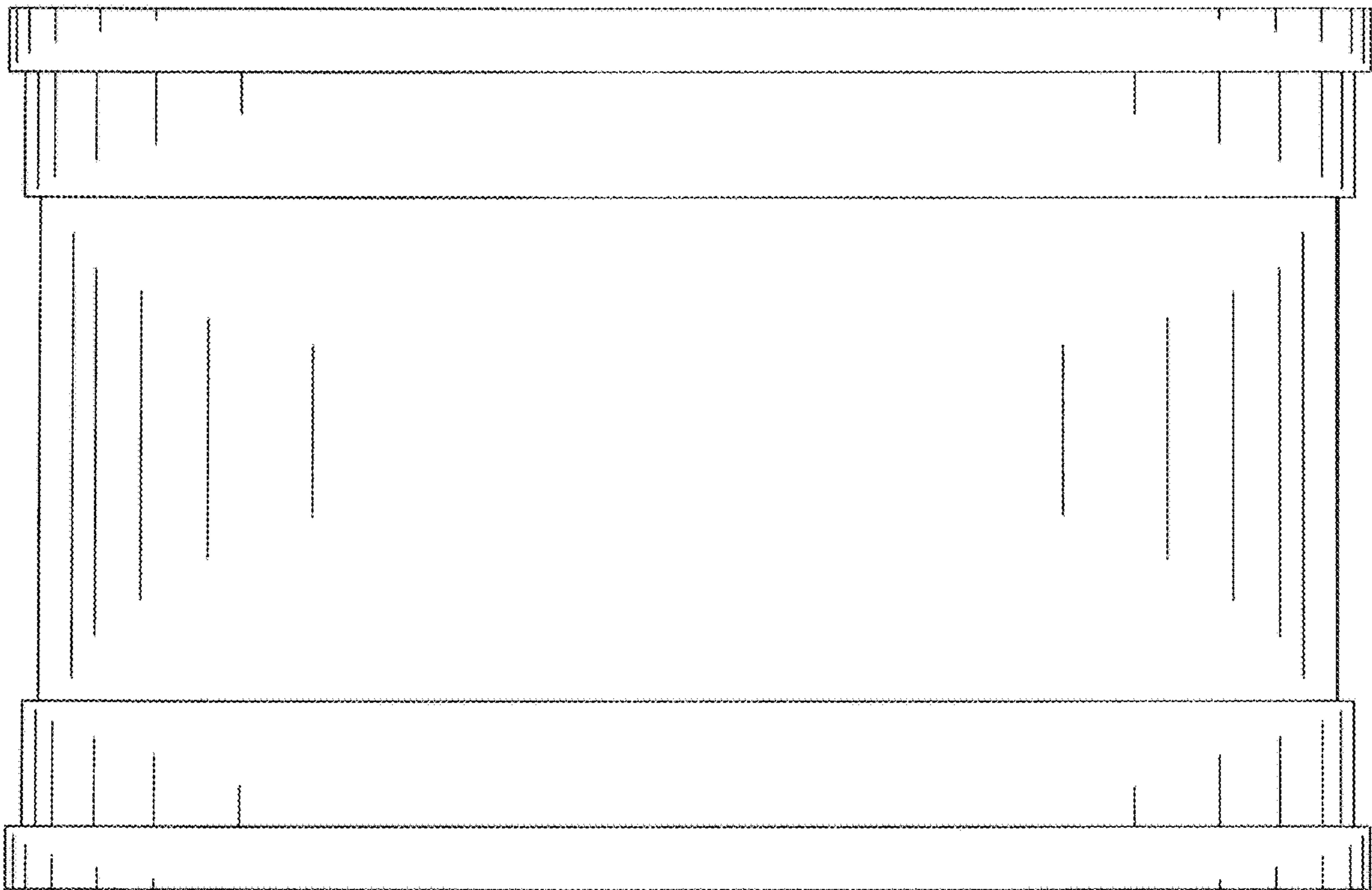

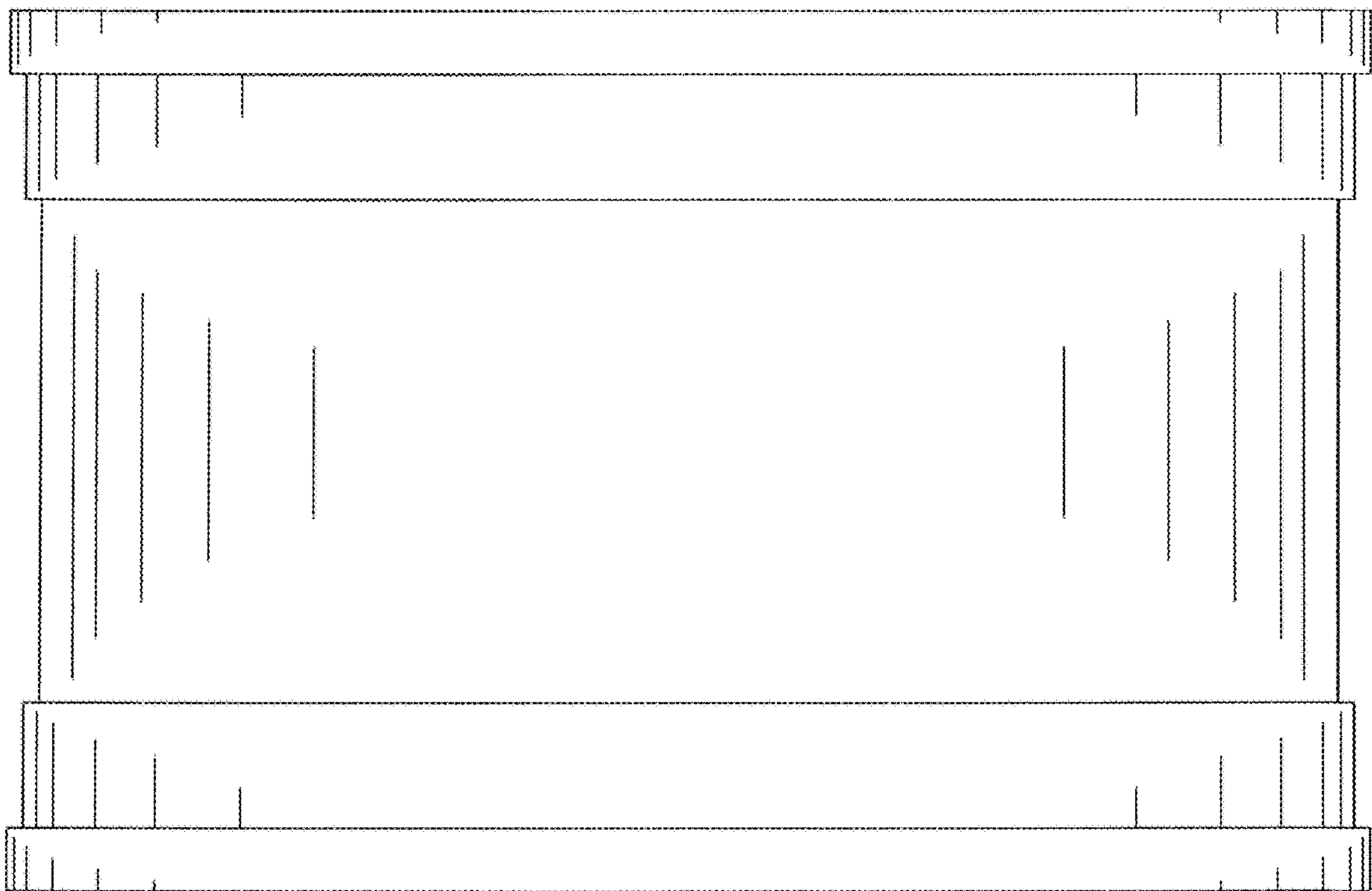

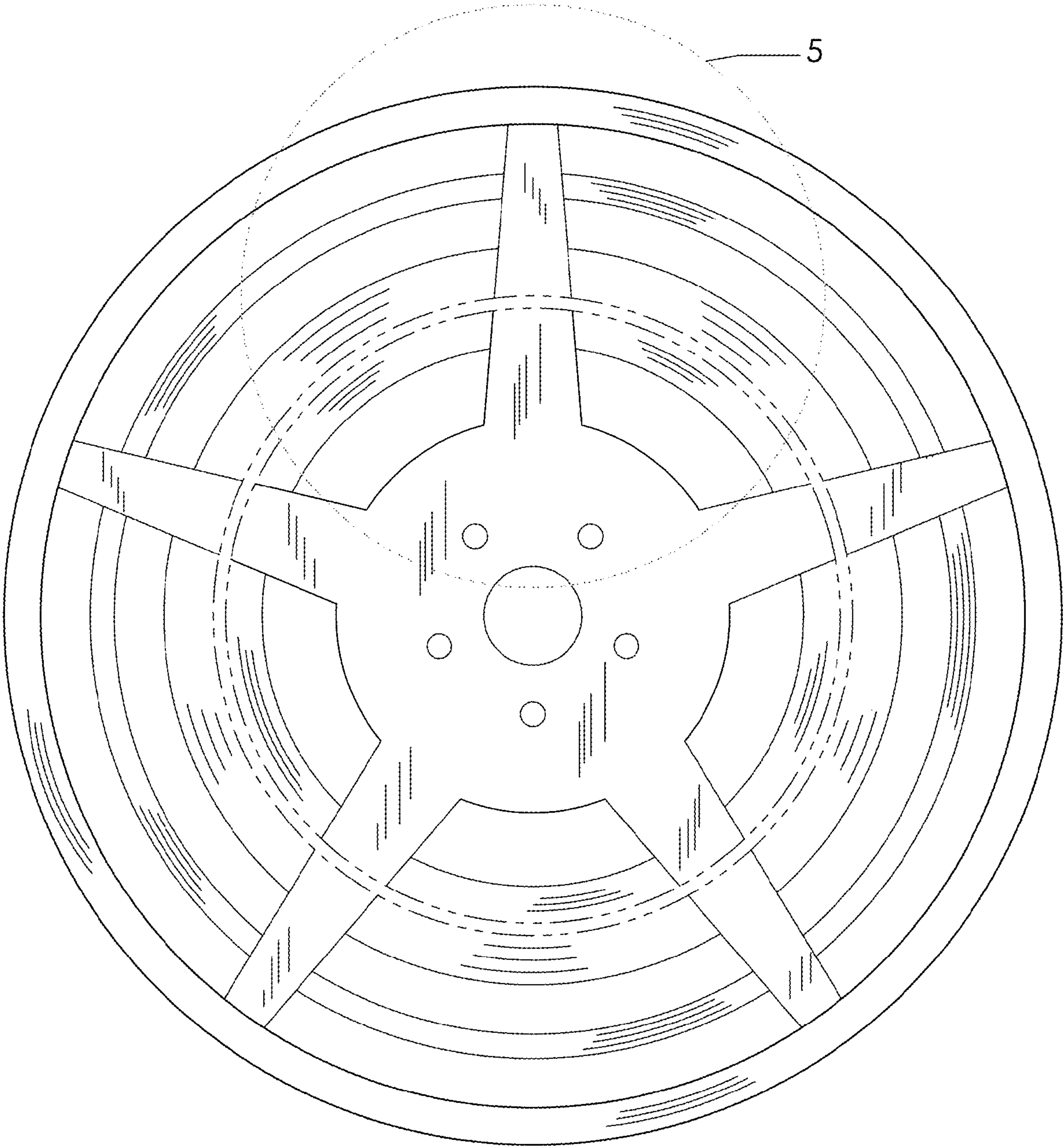

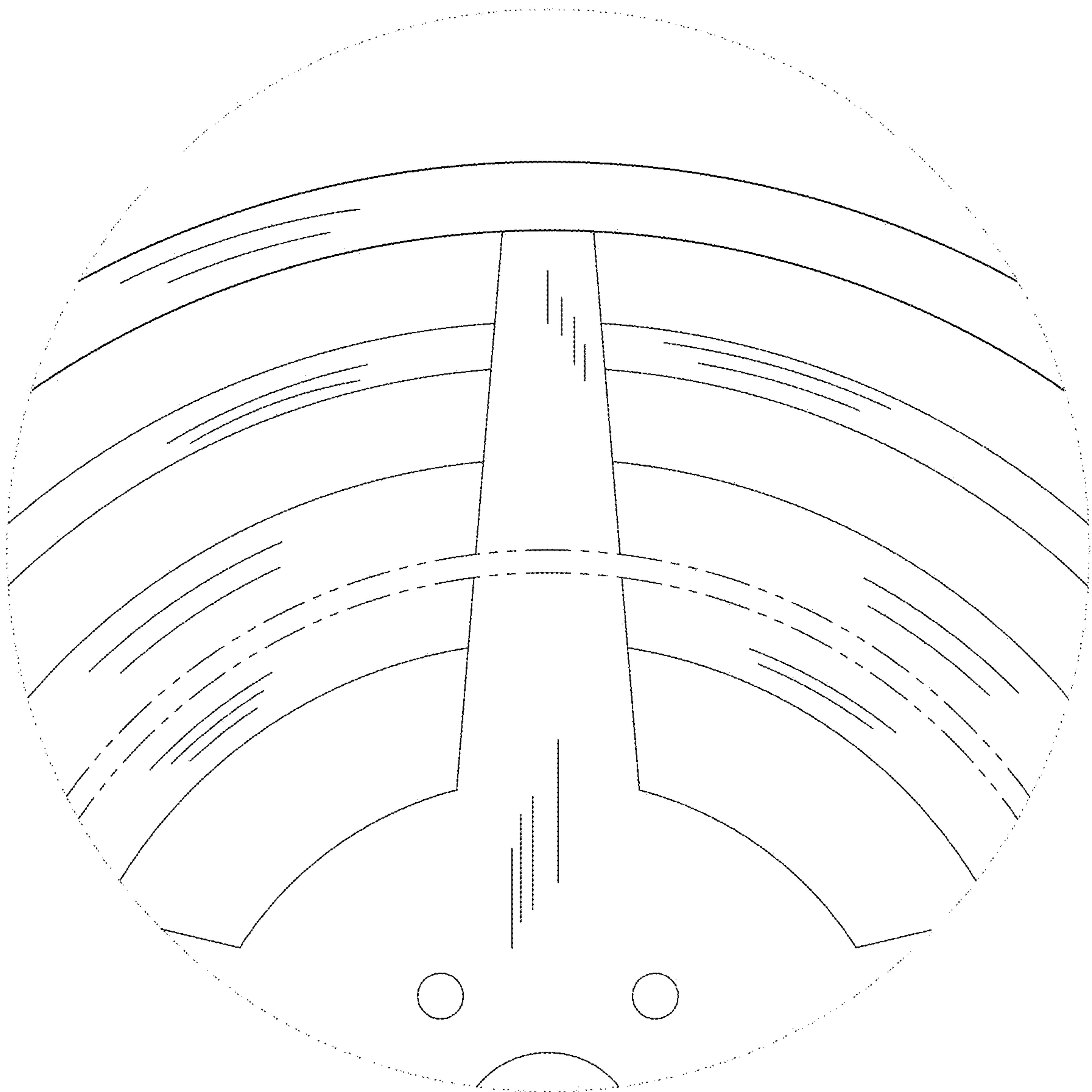

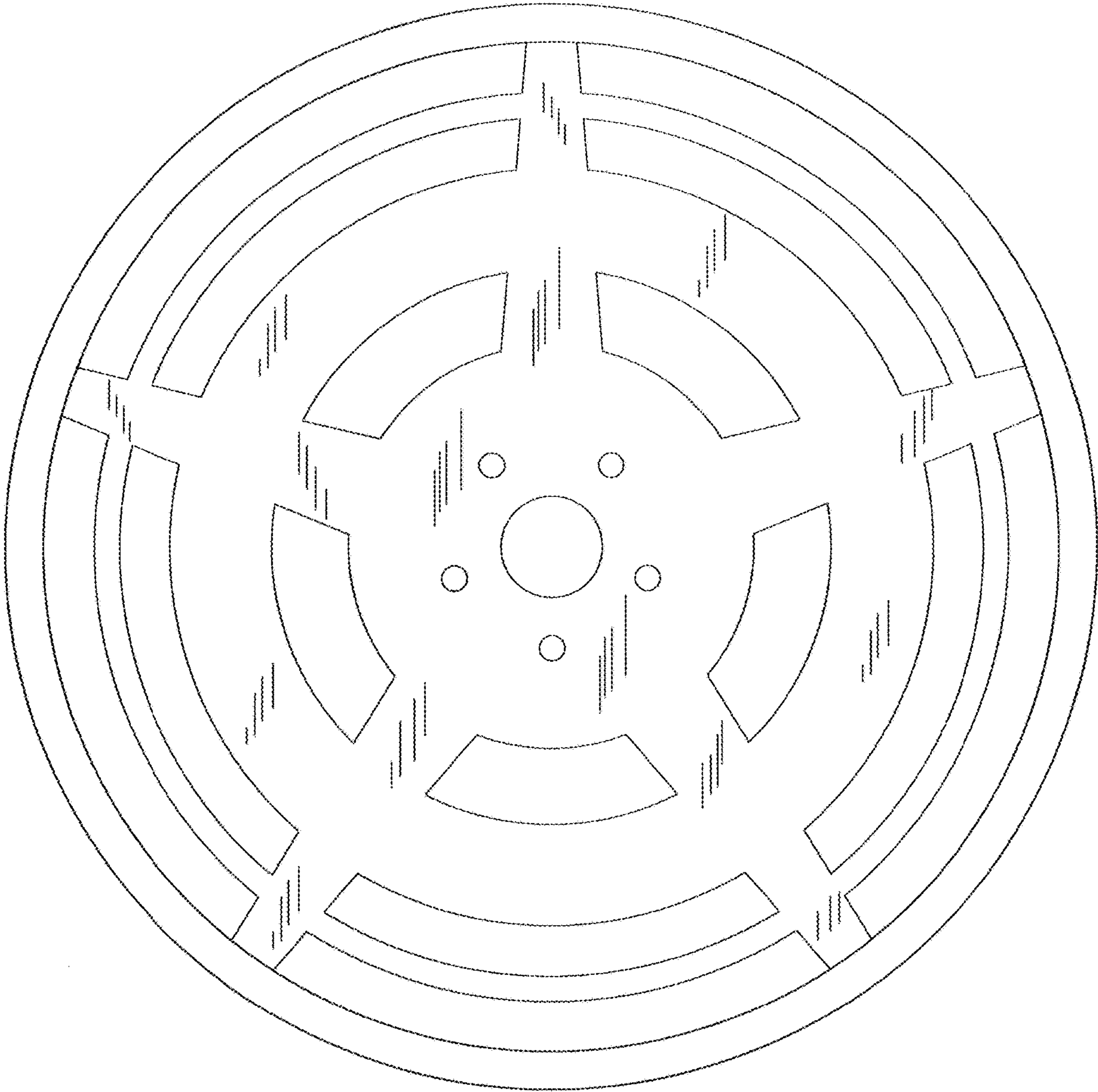

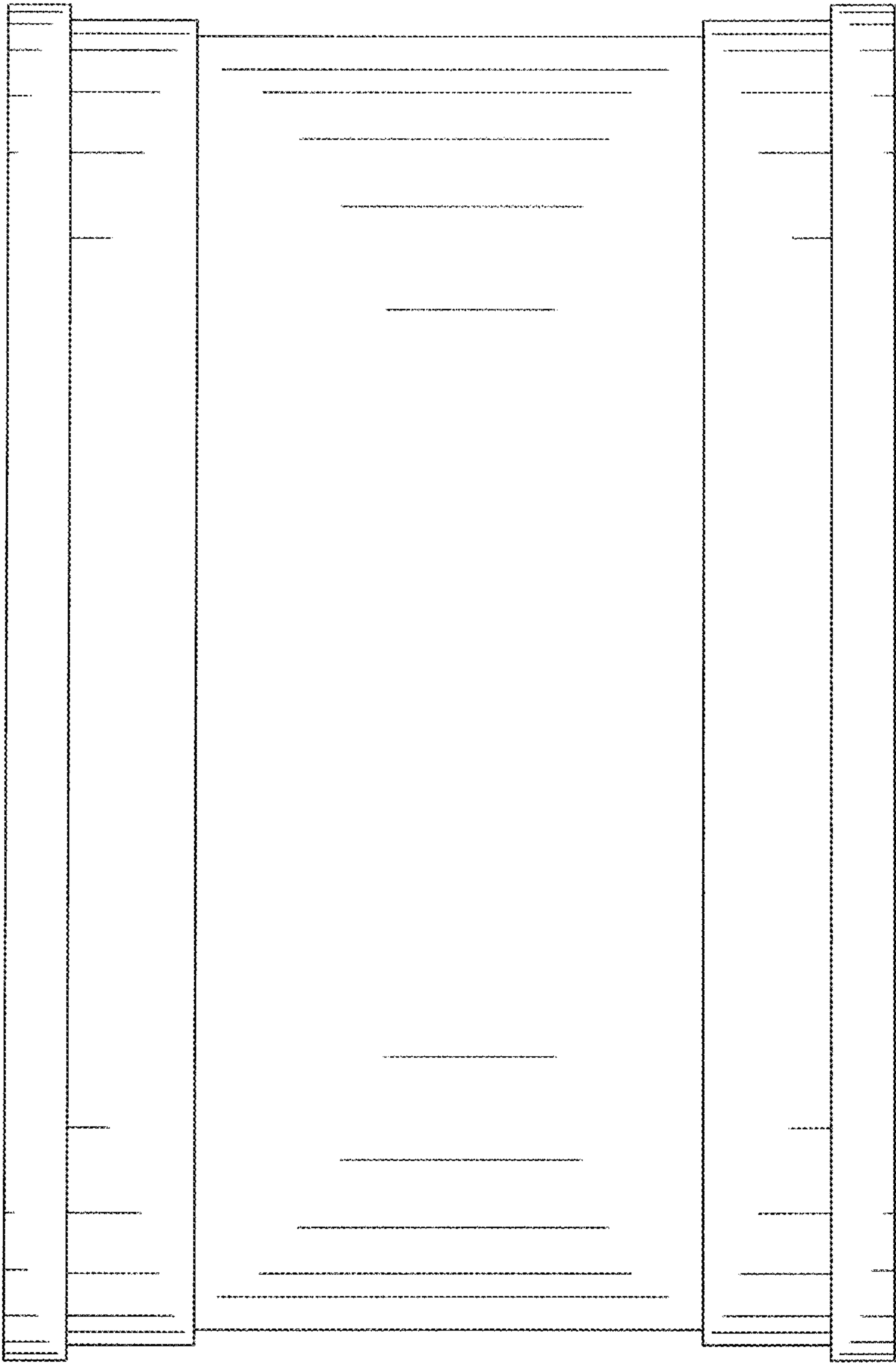

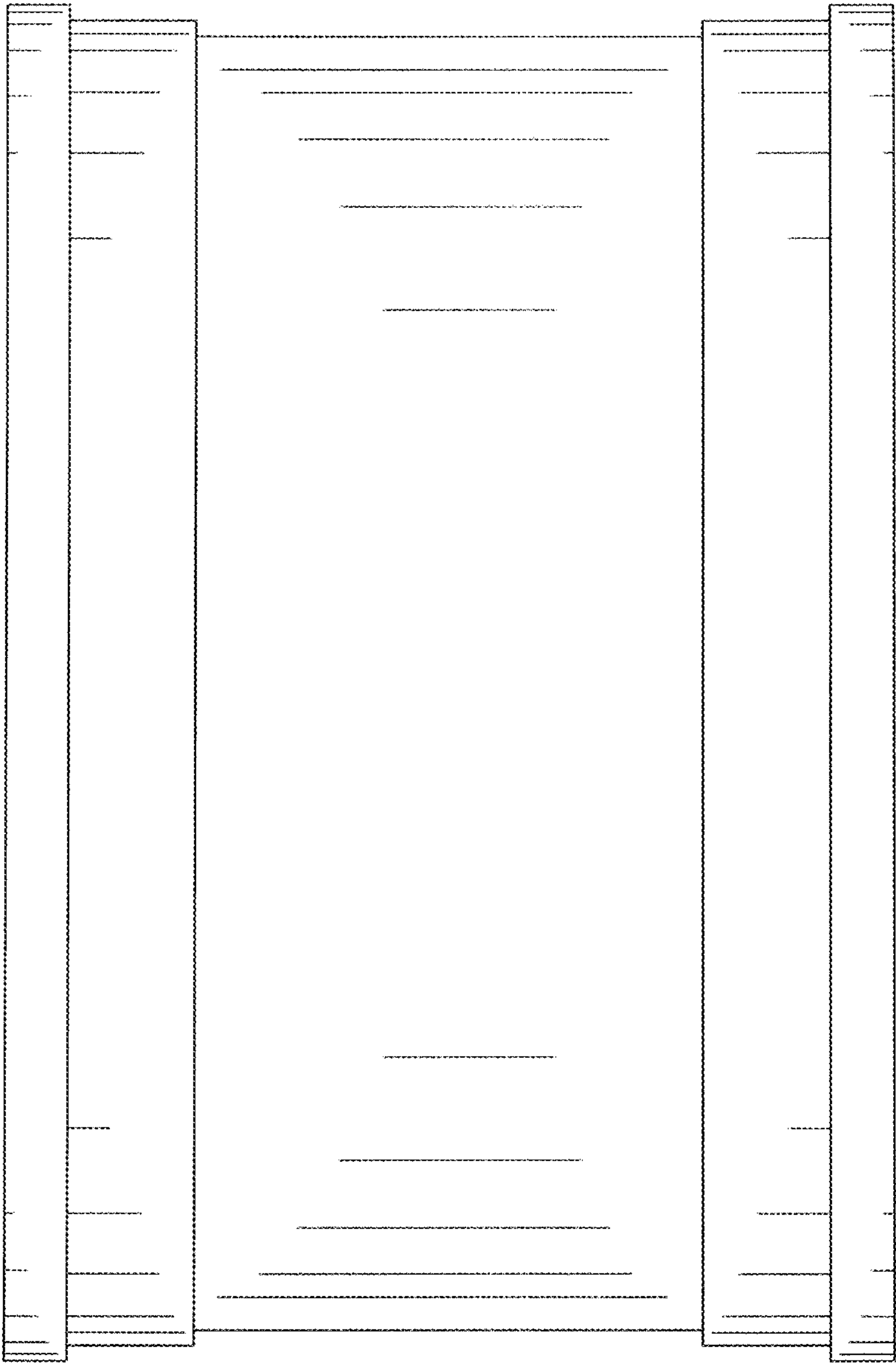
