(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sneaker outer sole protector, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a sneaker outer sole protector, showing our new design and its attachment to the sole of a sneaker.

FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the sneaker outer sole protector of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof.

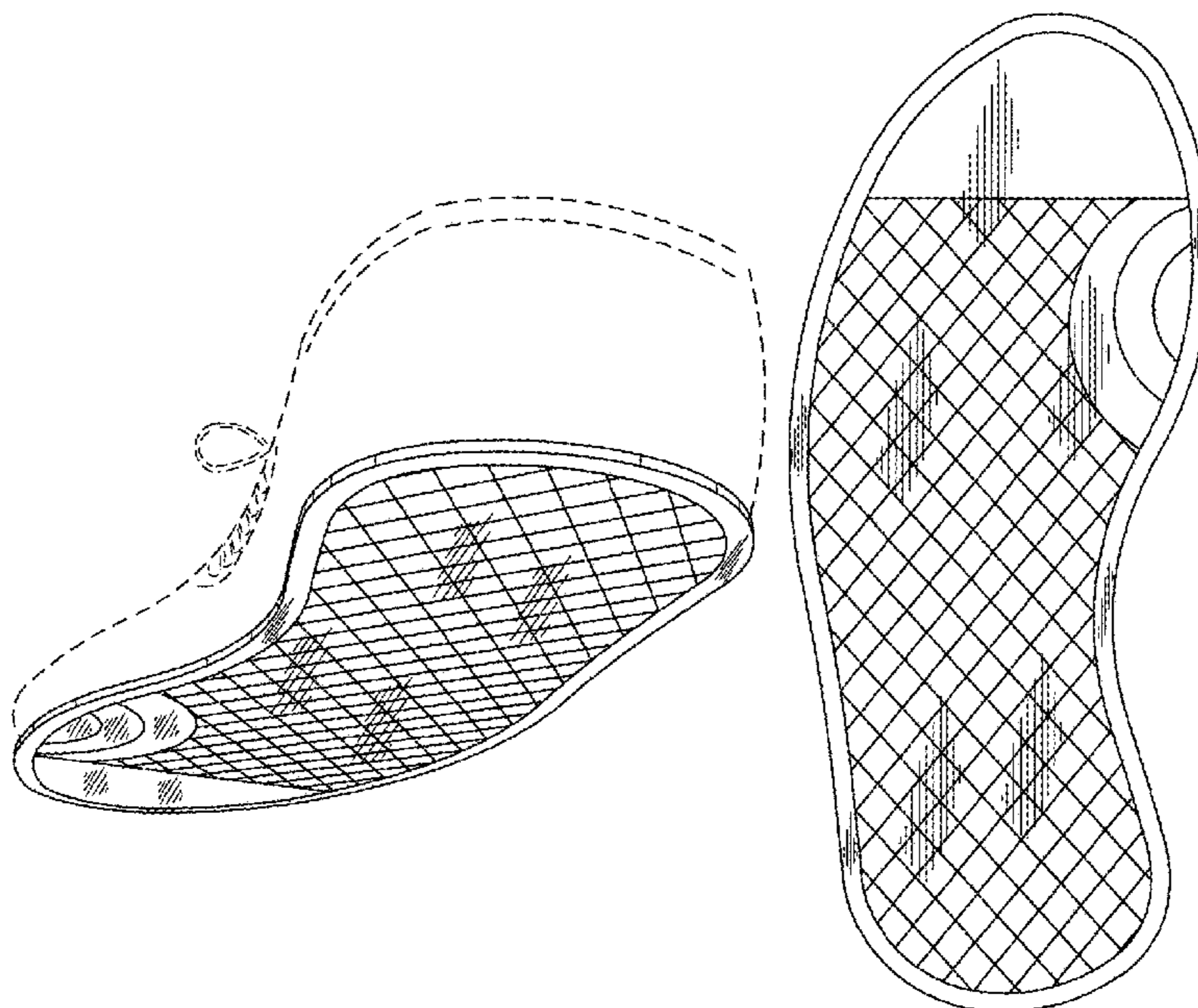
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational thereof.

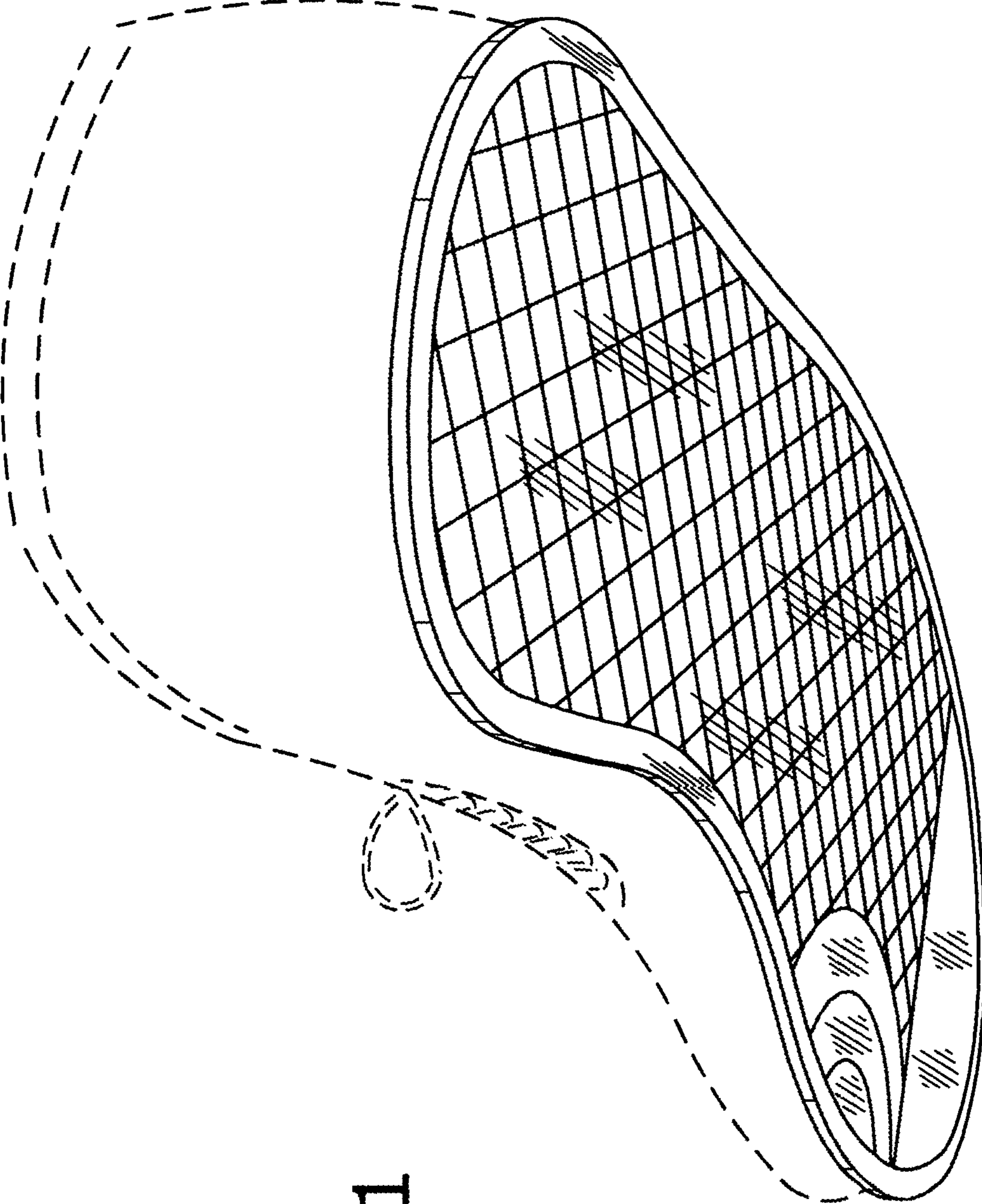
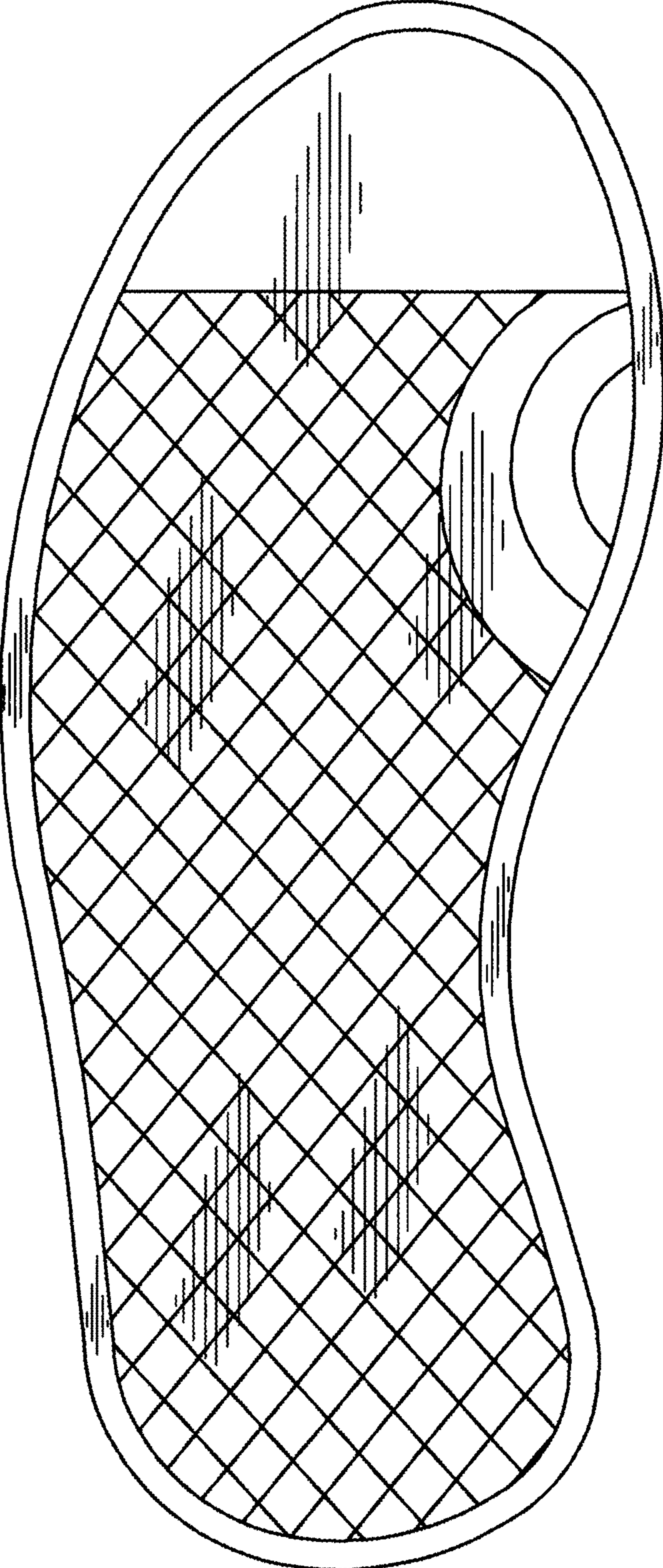

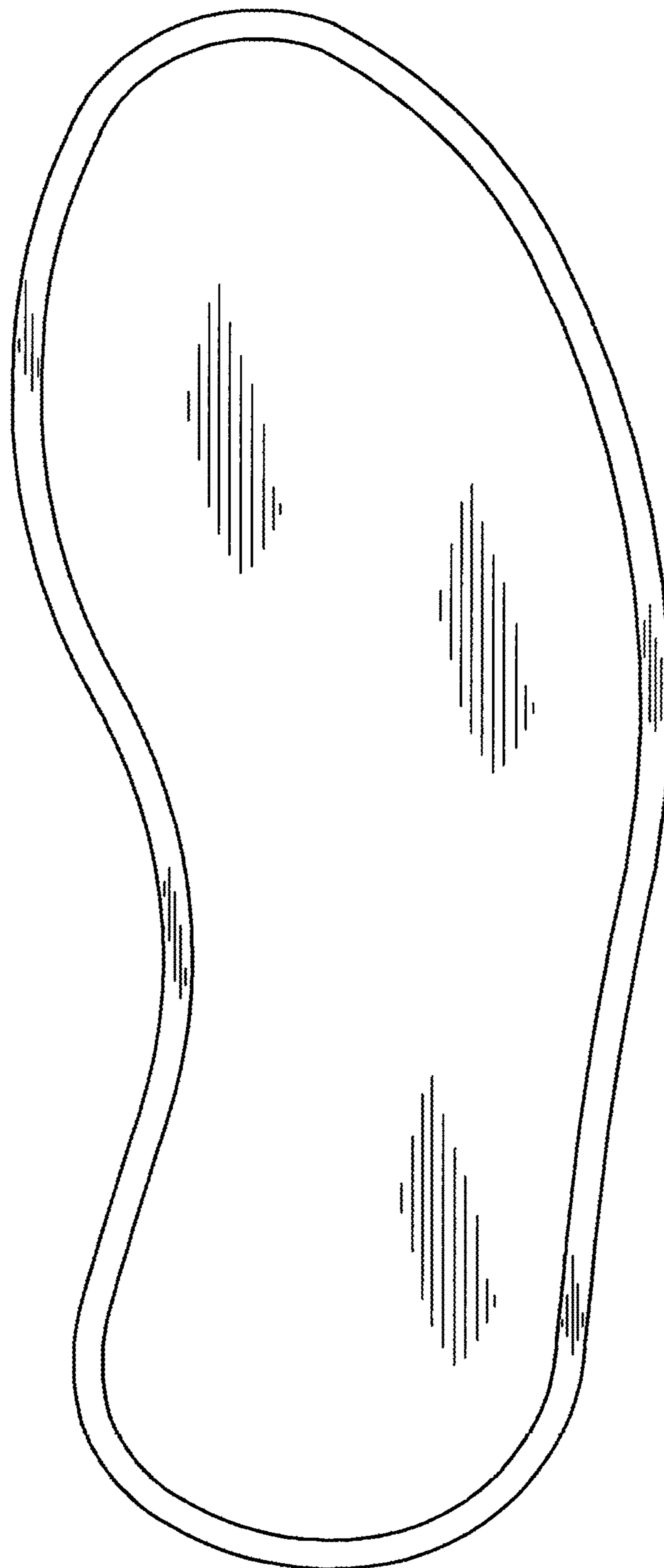
