**DESCRIPTION**

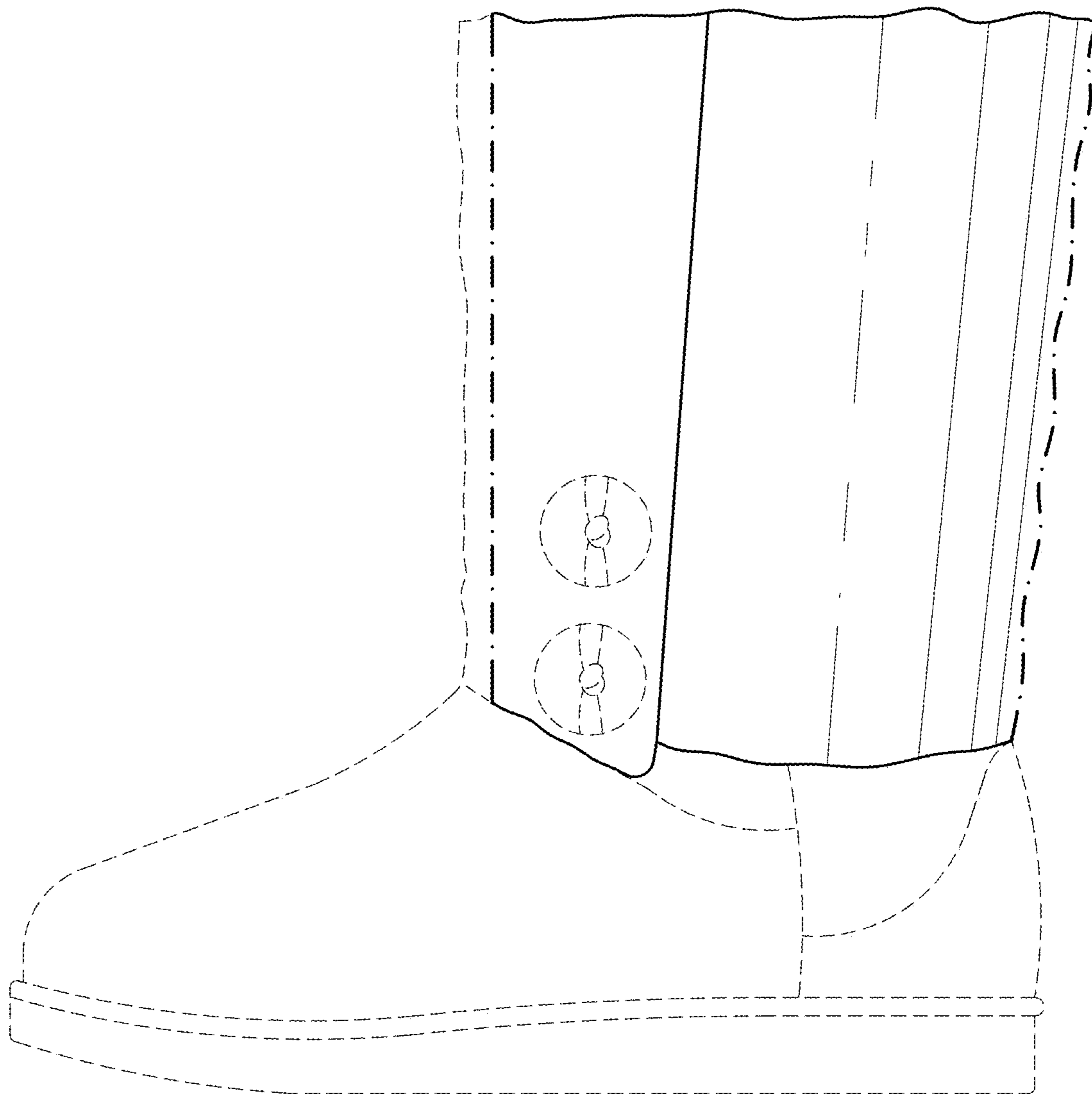
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a boot upper according to the present invention; and,
