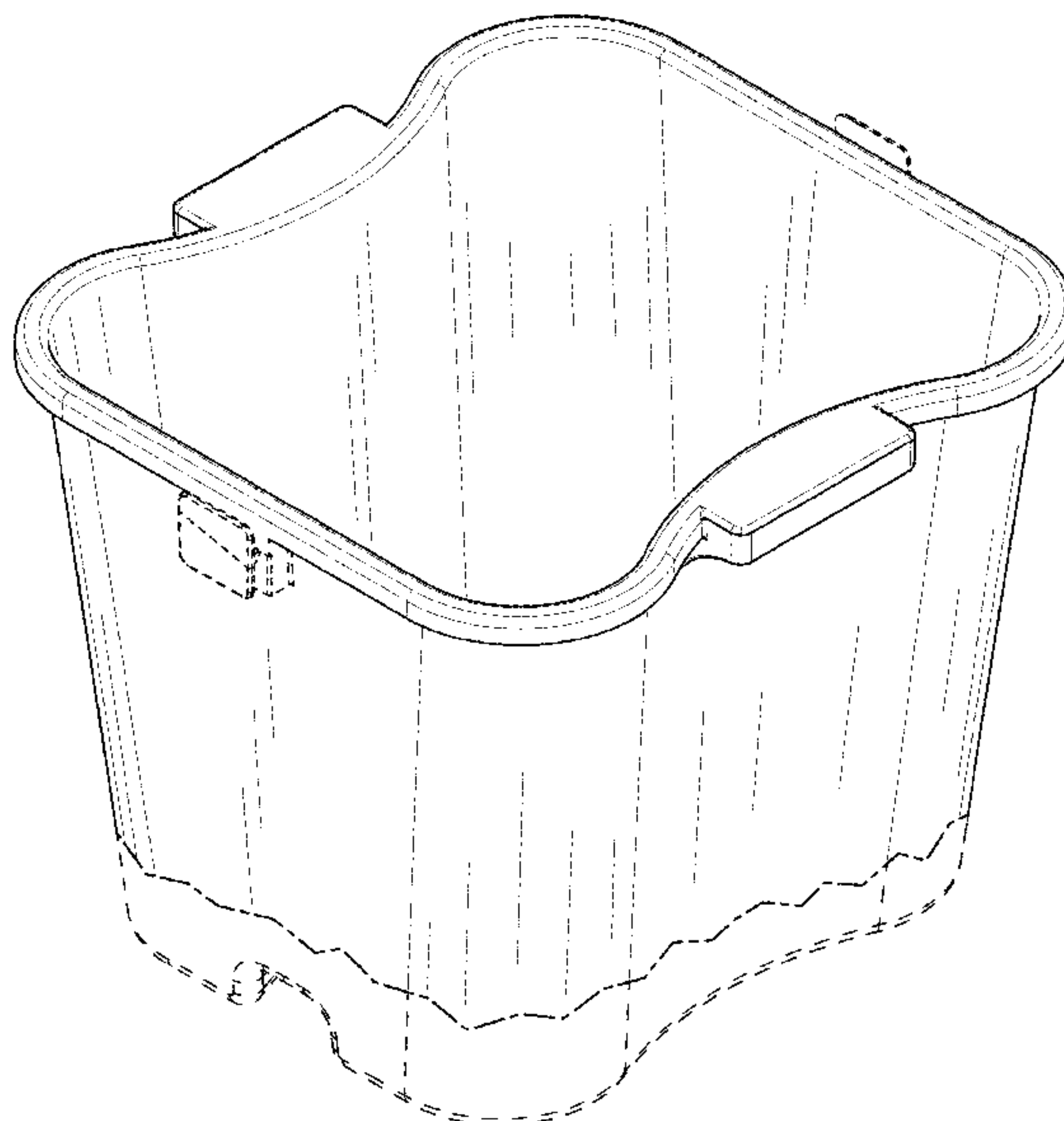
The ornamental design for a sanitation pail, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a sanitation pail according to the new design;
FIG. 2 is a front side elevation view of the sanitation pail of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear side elevation view of the sanitation pail of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of the sanitation pail of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the sanitation pail of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the sanitation pail of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the sanitation pail of FIG. 1.

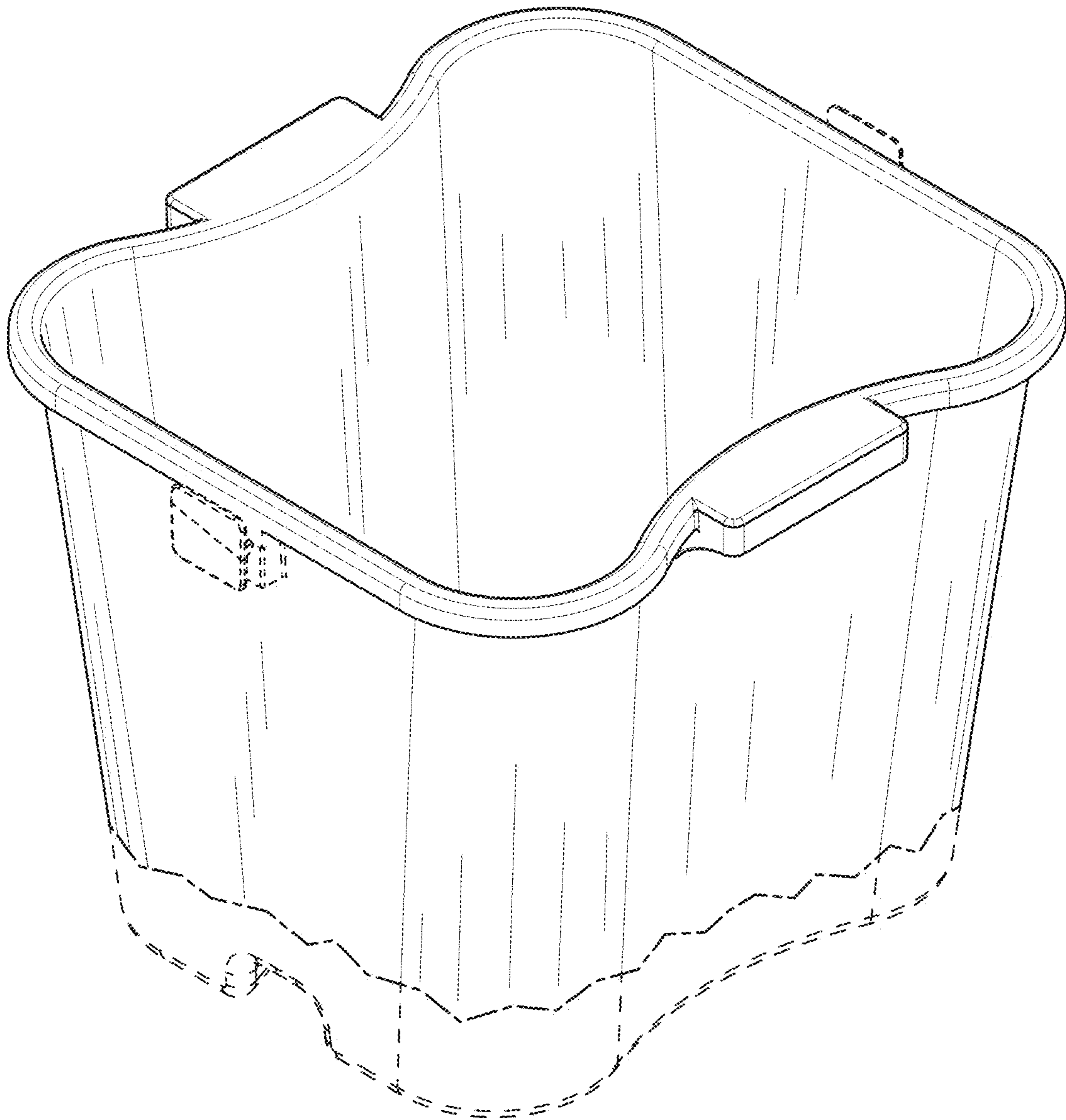

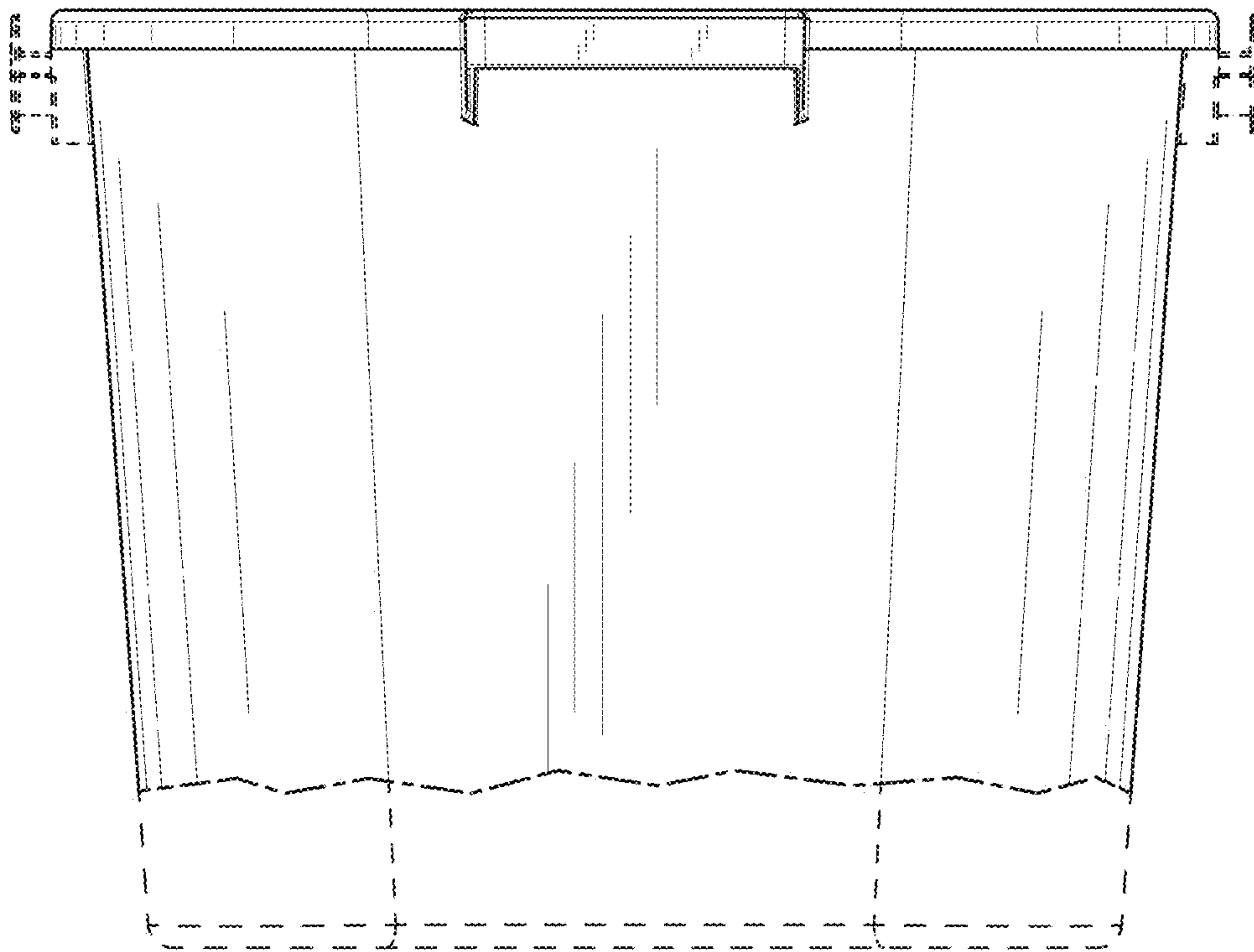

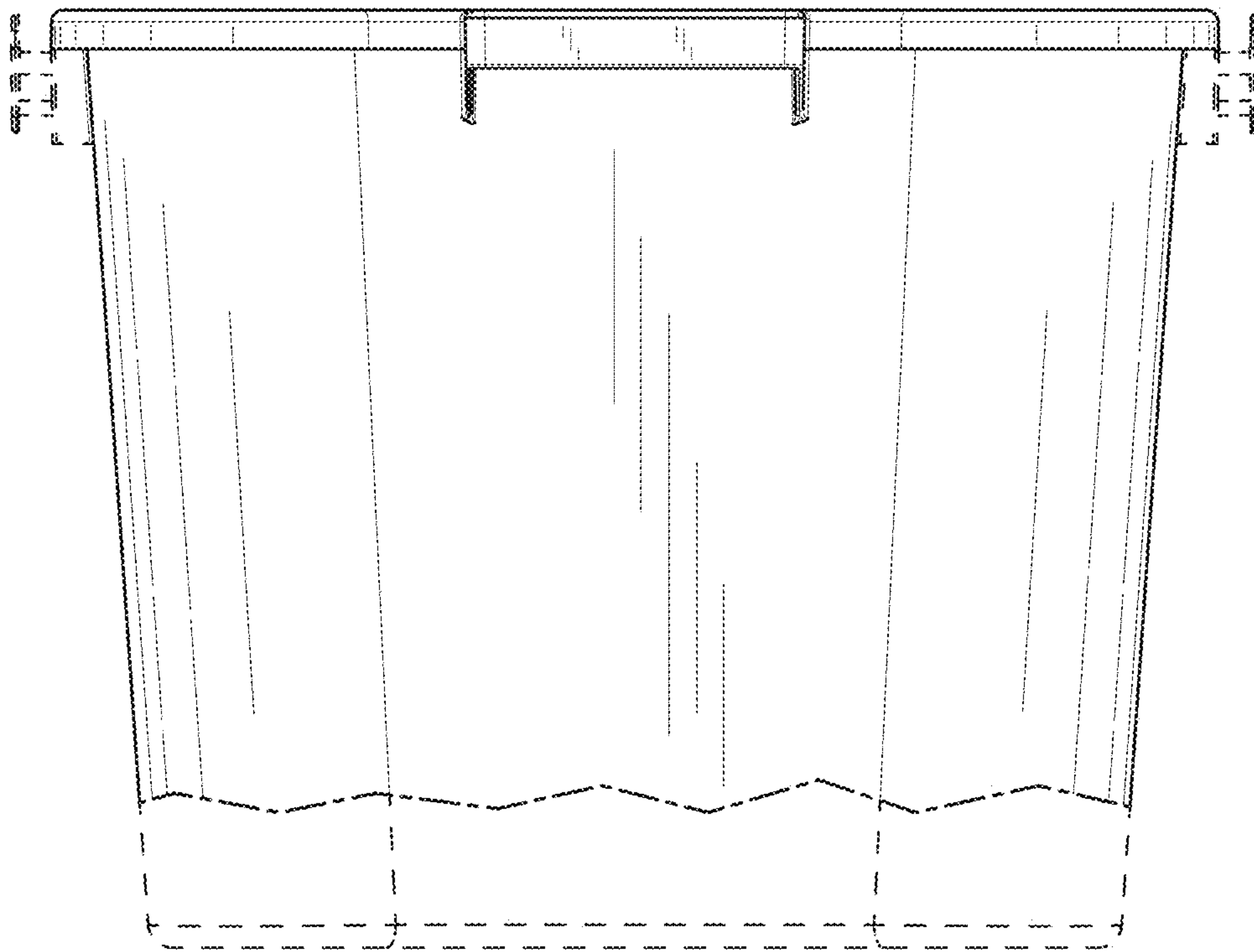

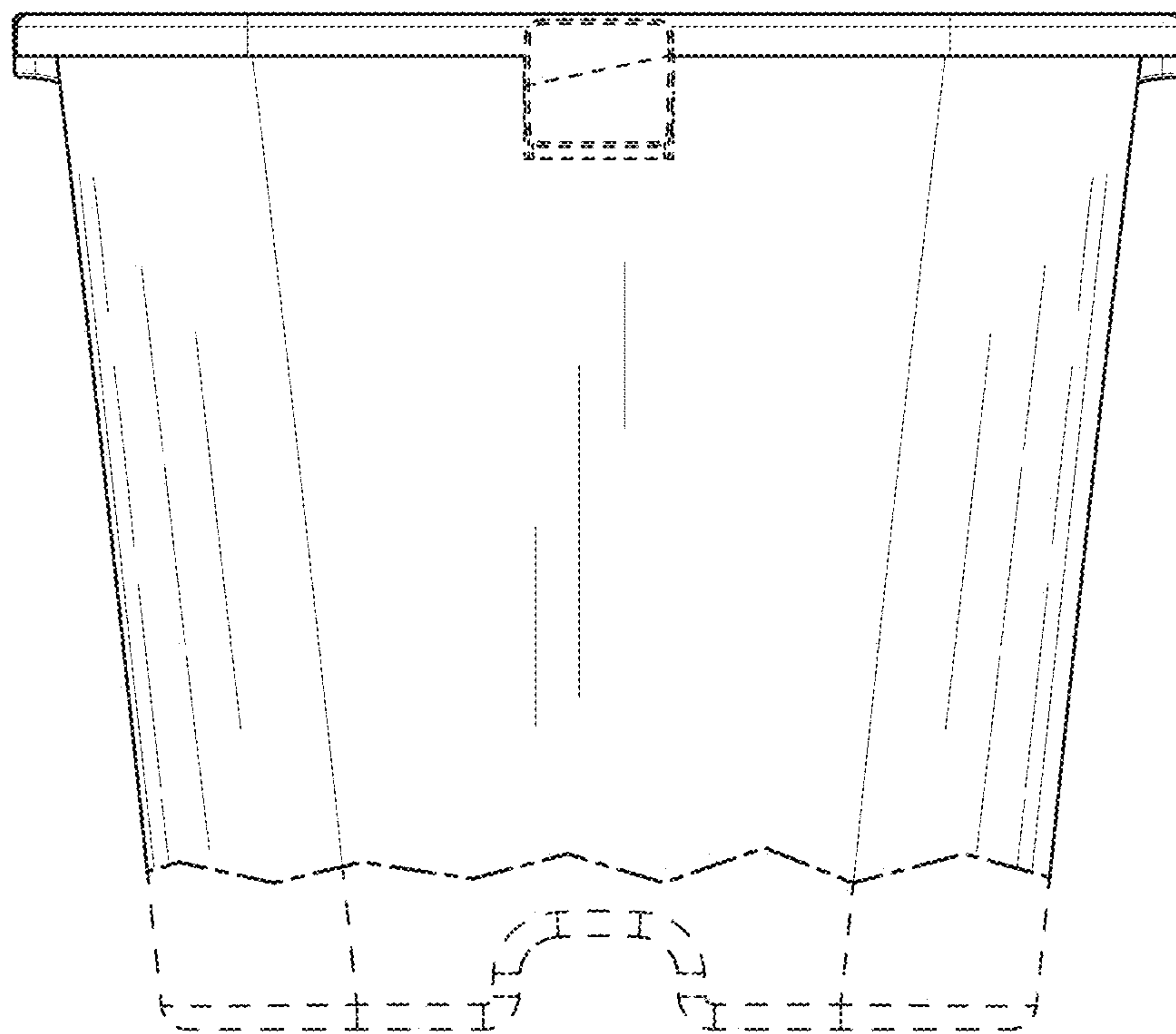

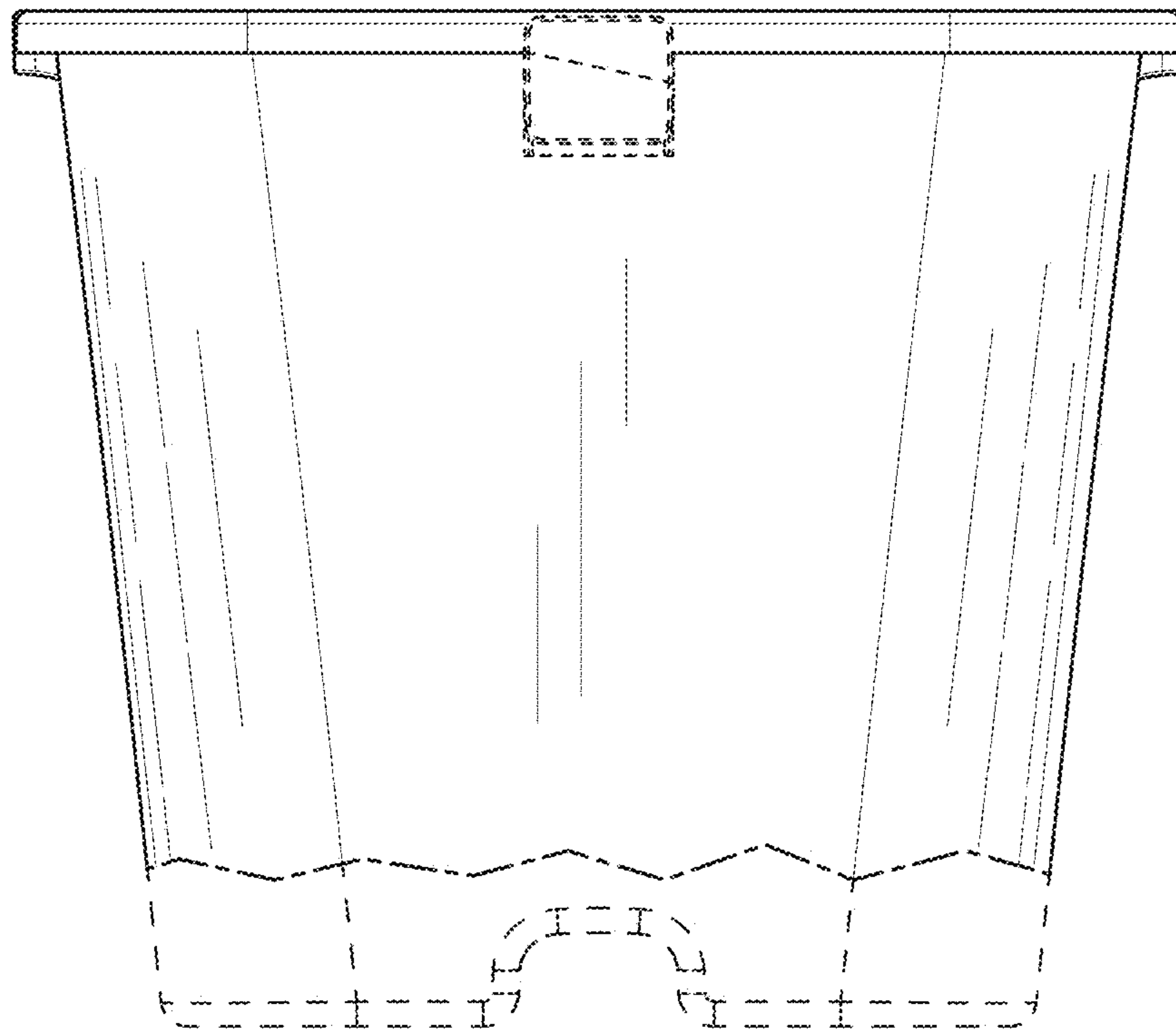

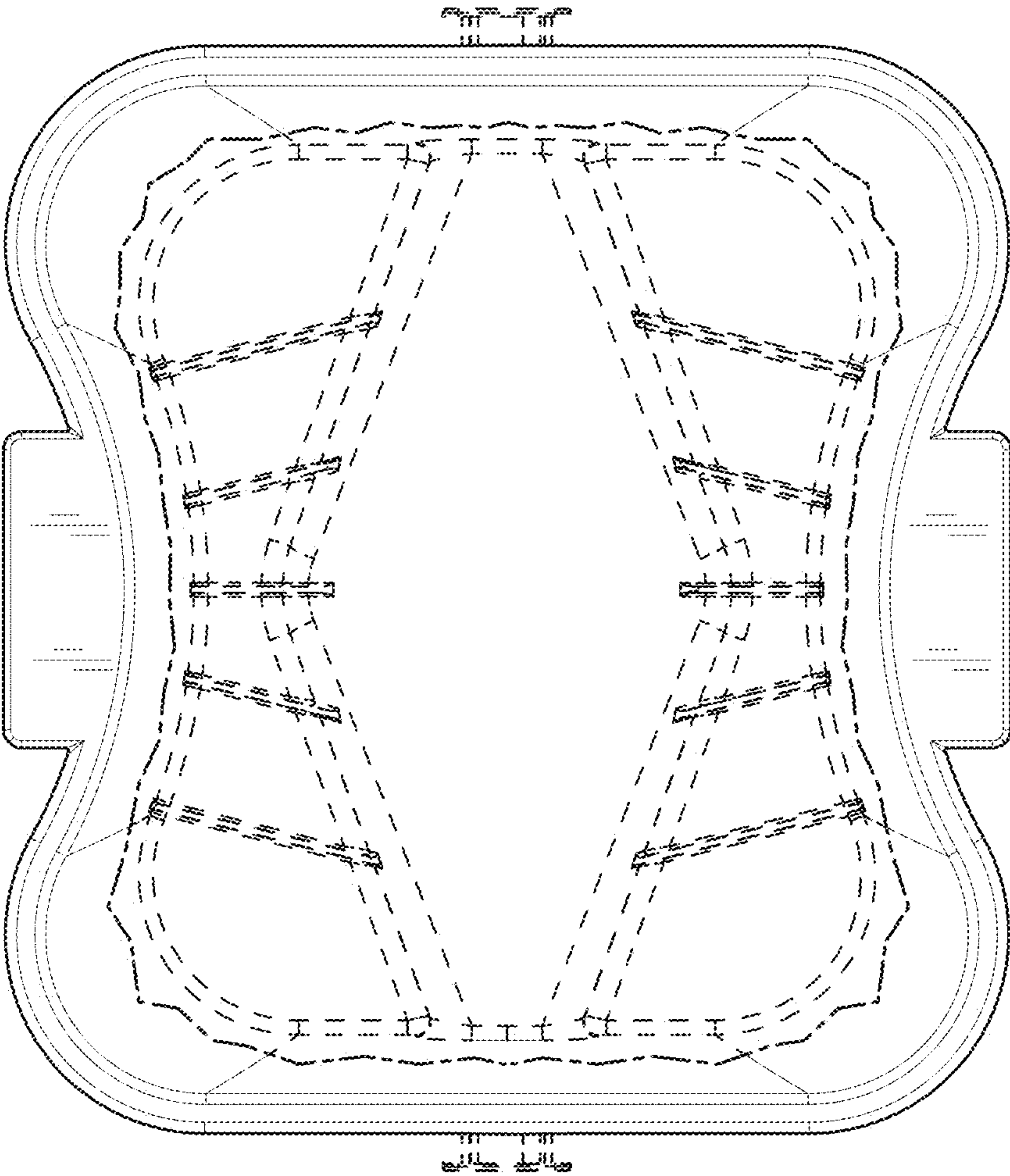

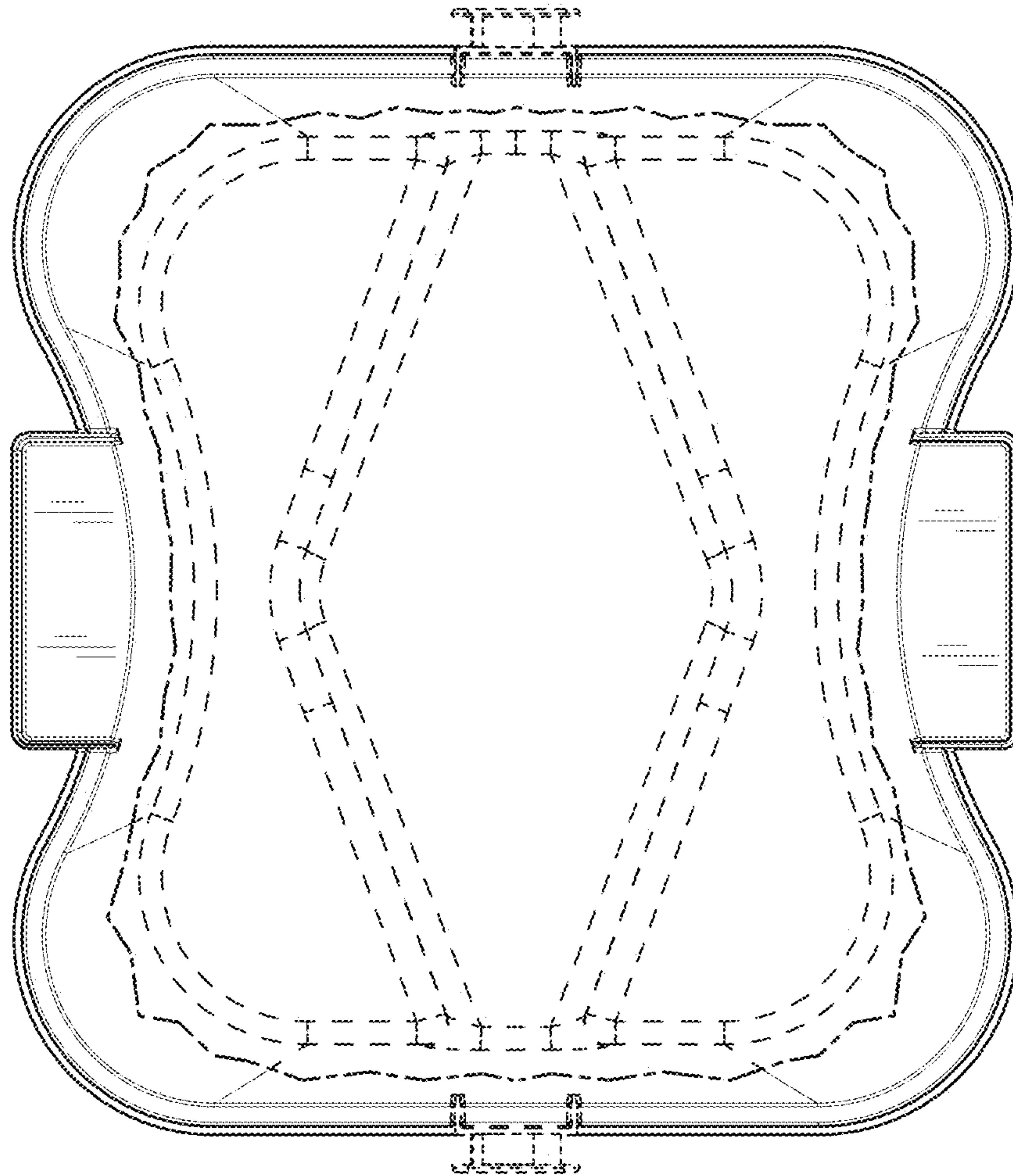
