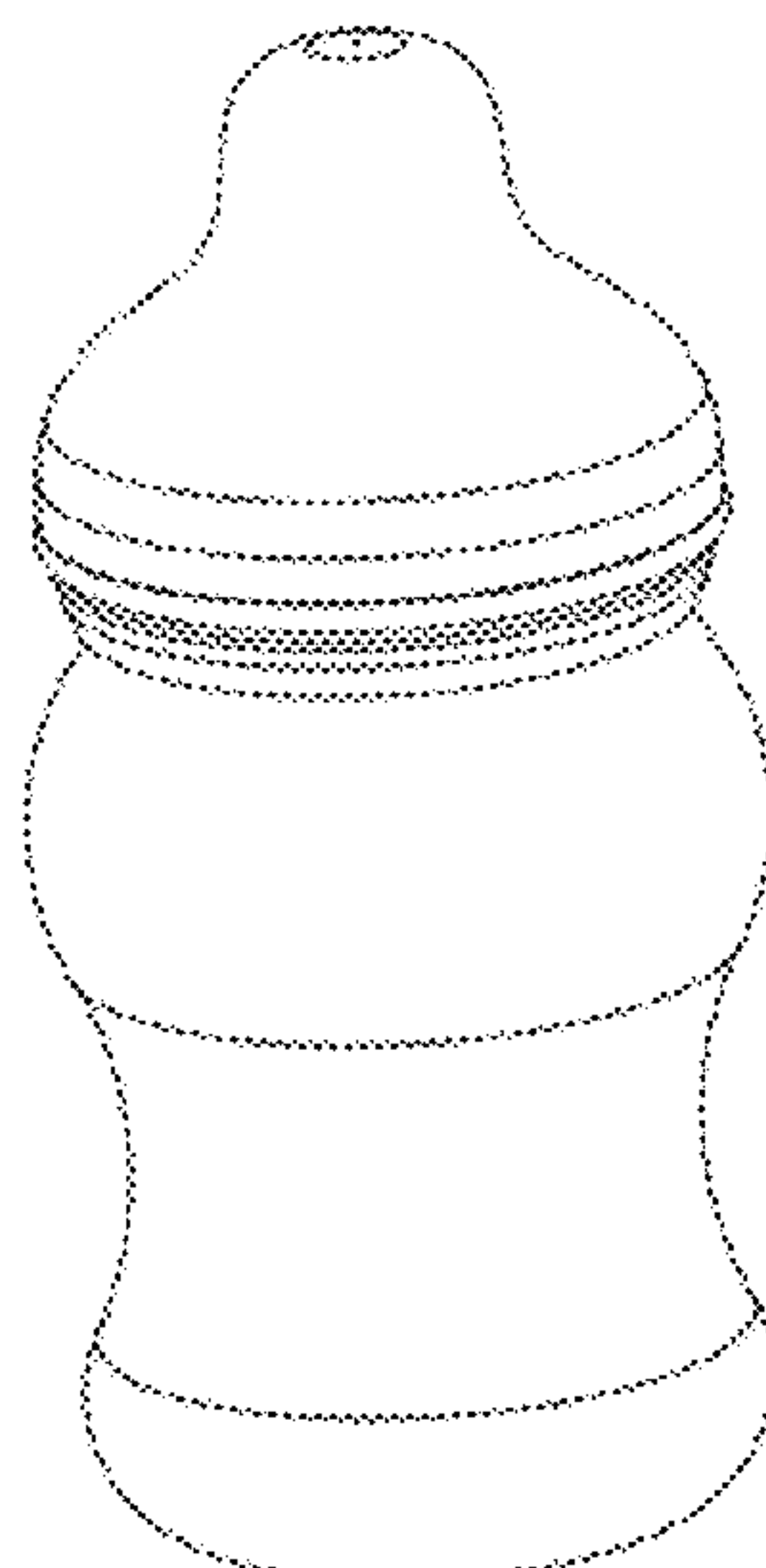
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a feeding bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a feeding bottle showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken lines in FIG. 7 indicate that the contour of the bottom of the feeding bottle does not form a part of the claimed invention.

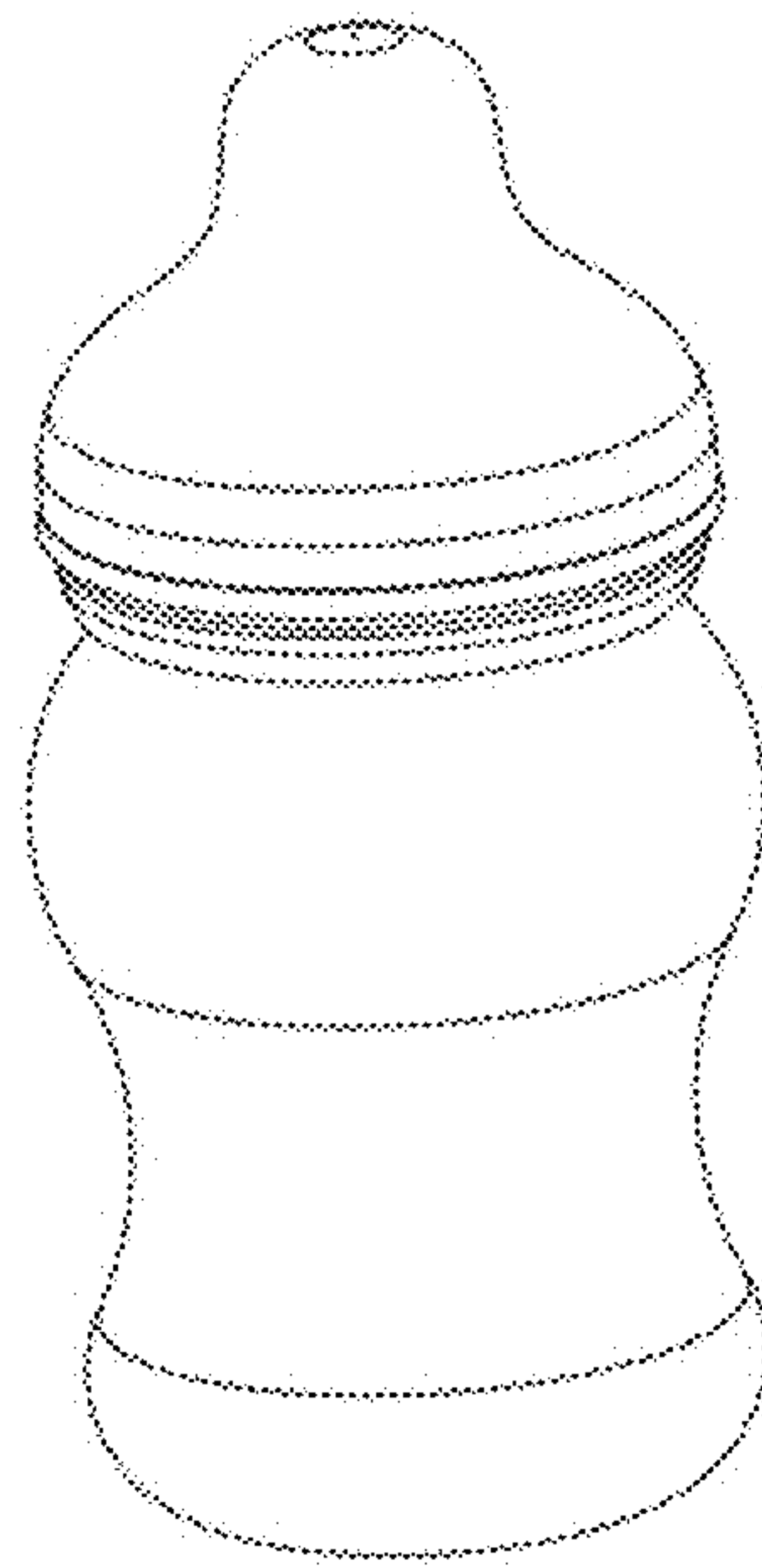

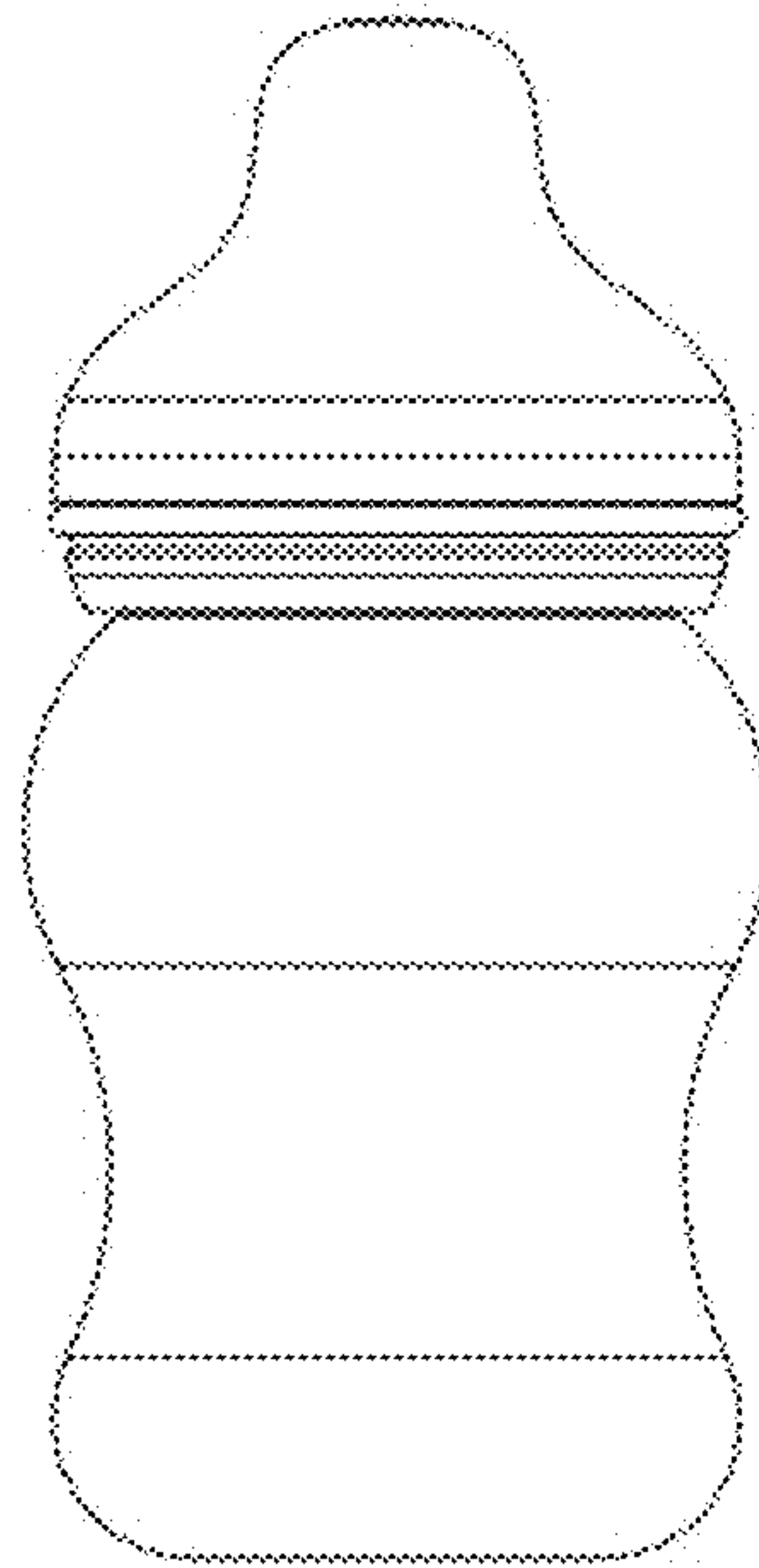

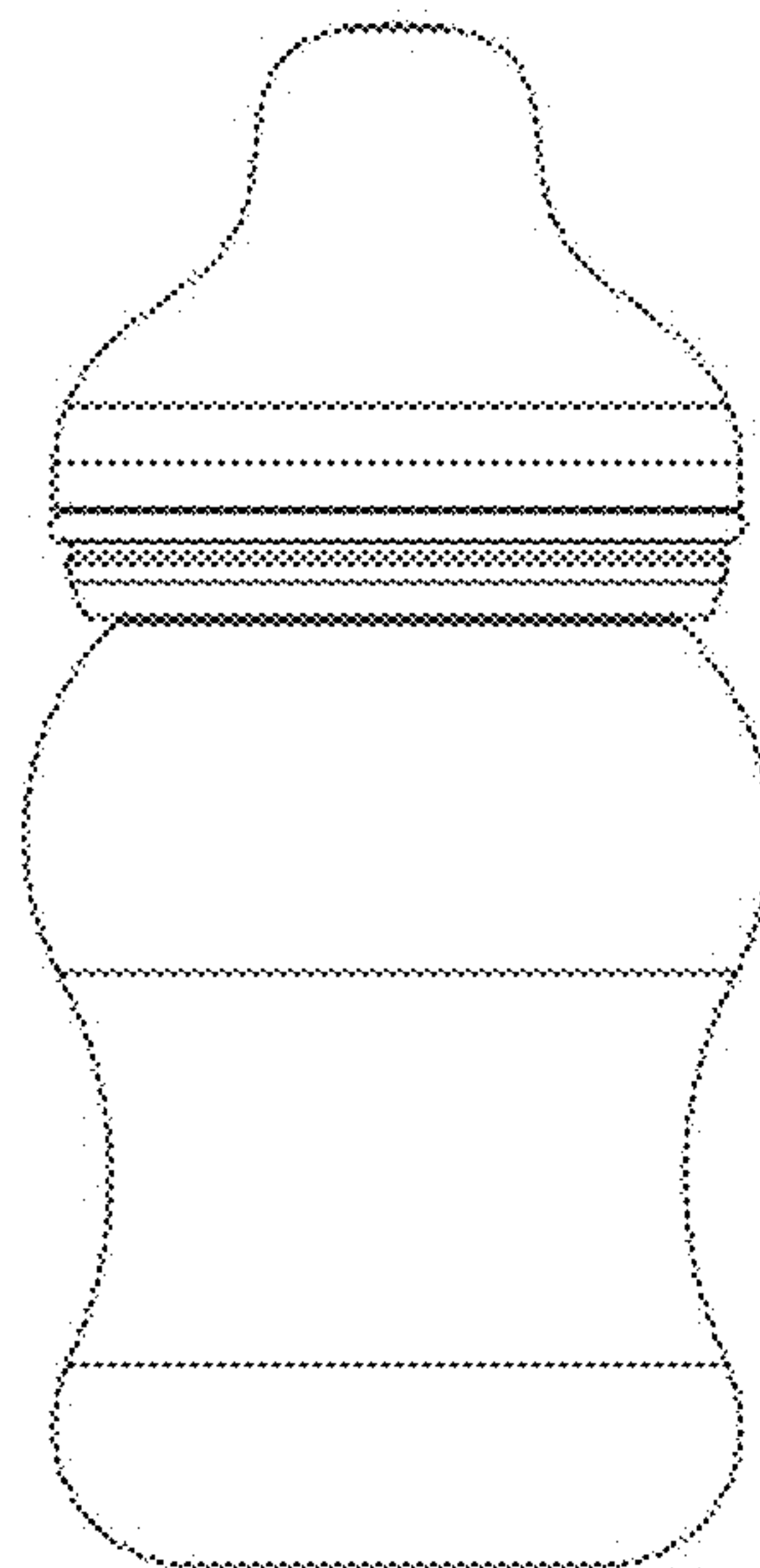

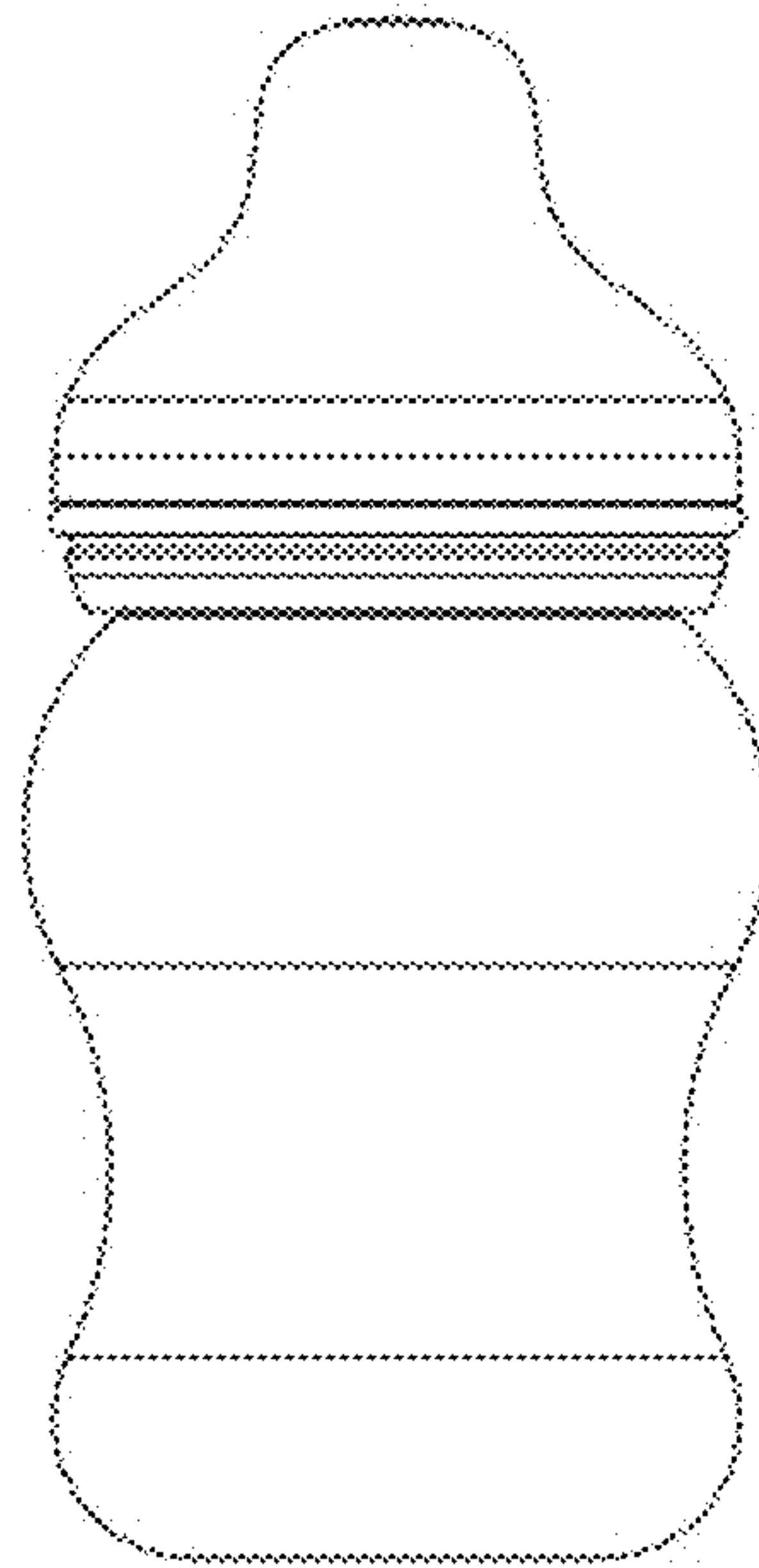

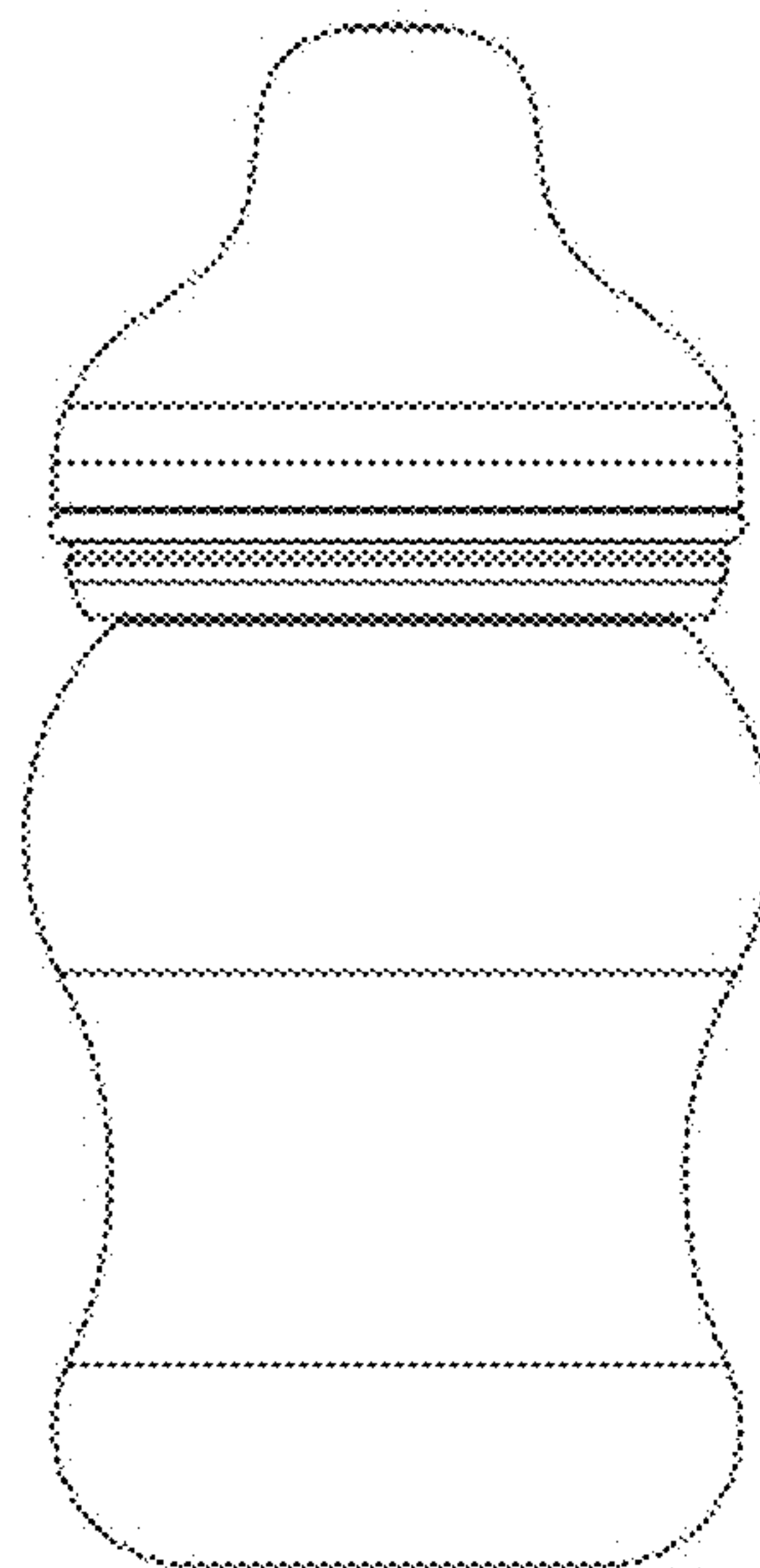

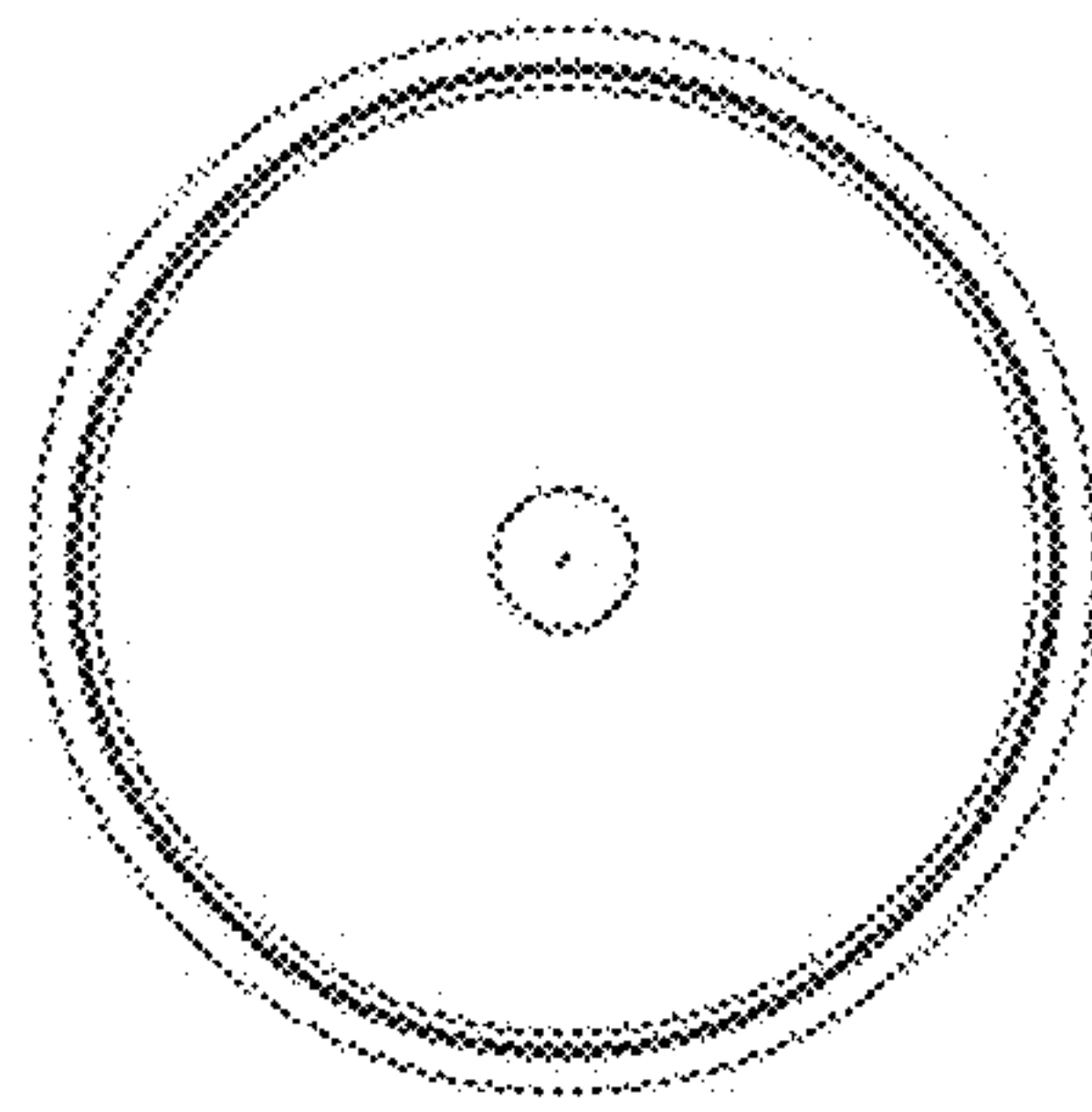

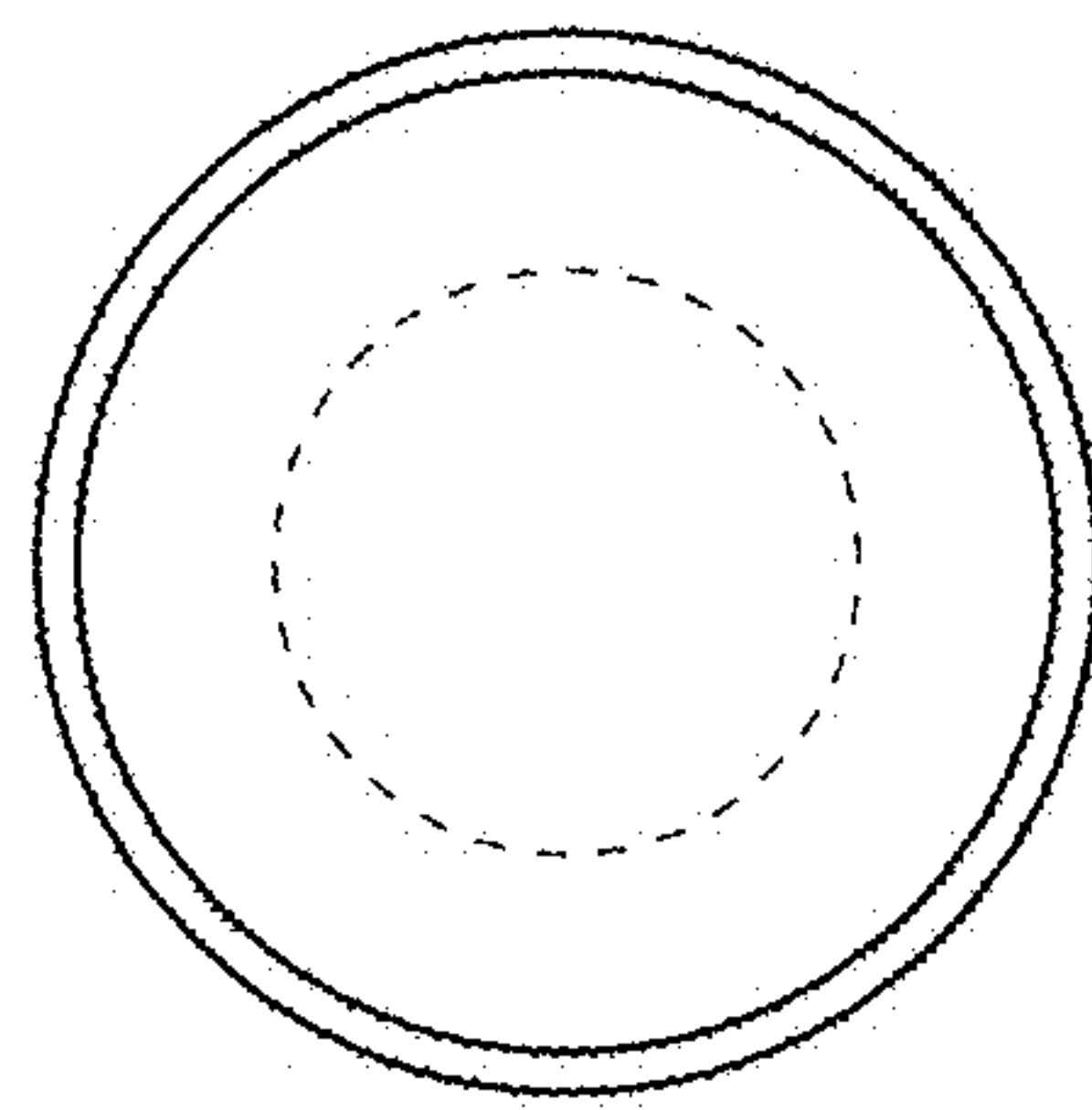
