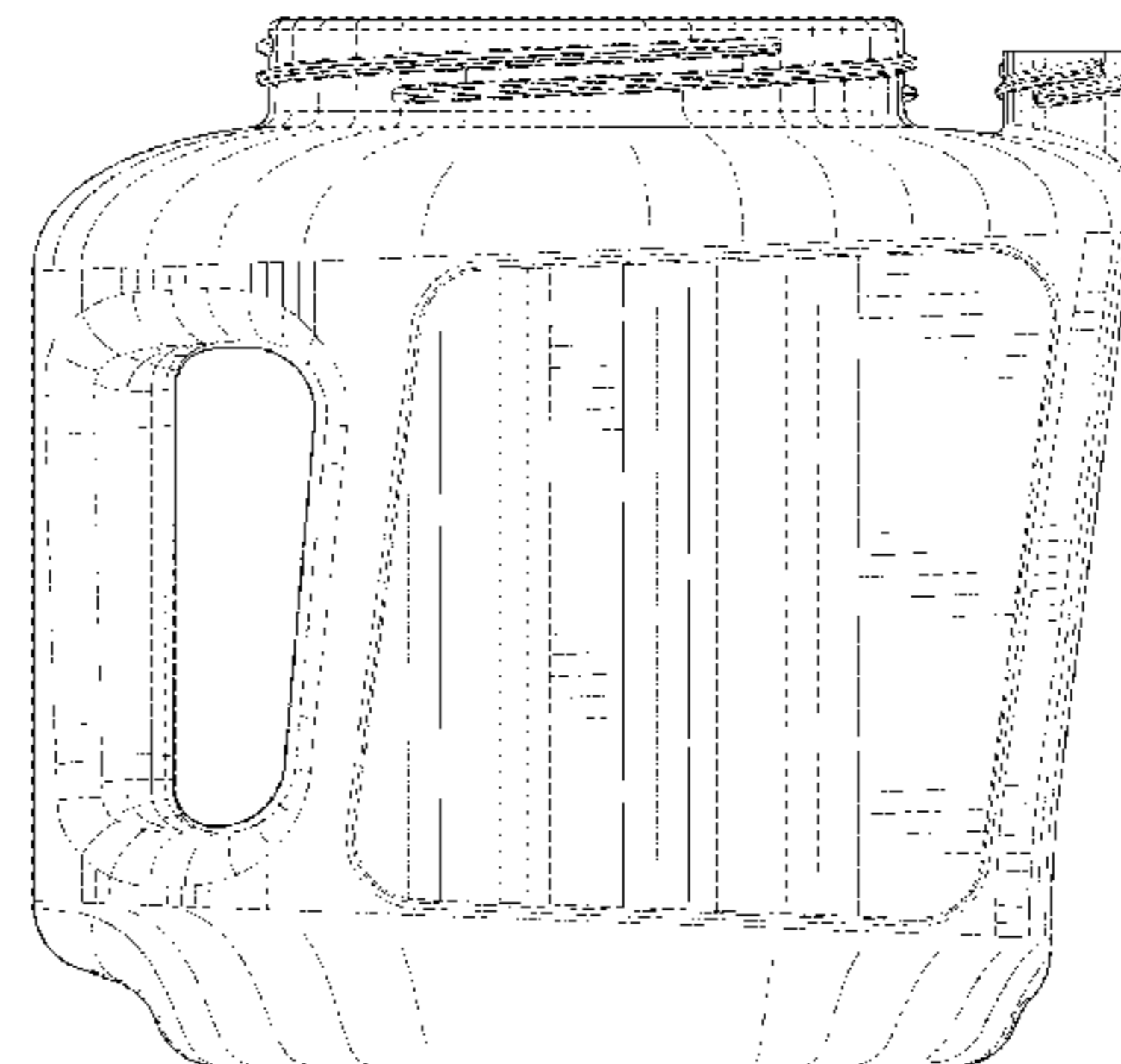
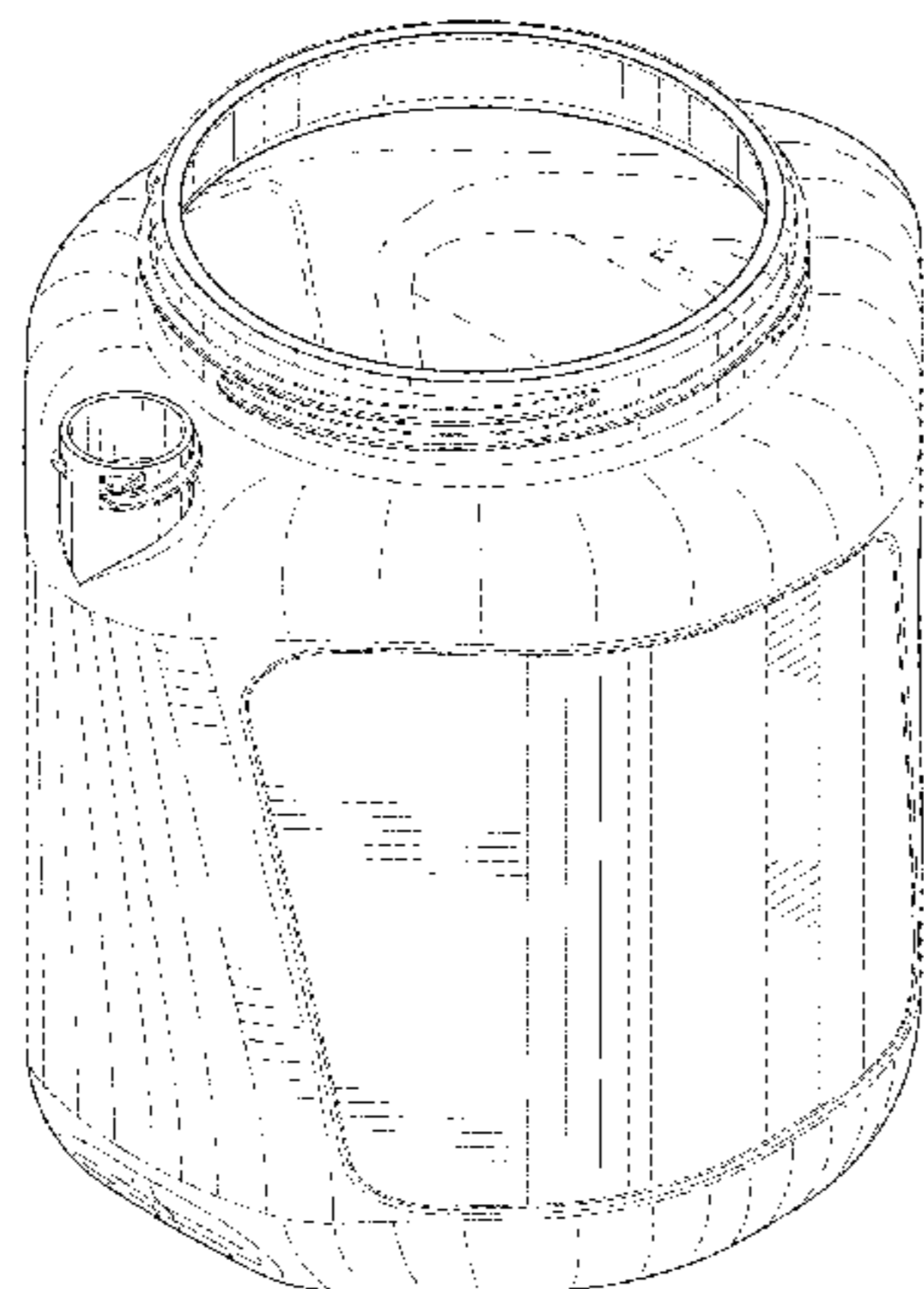
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of a storage container showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the storage container illustrated in FIG. 1;

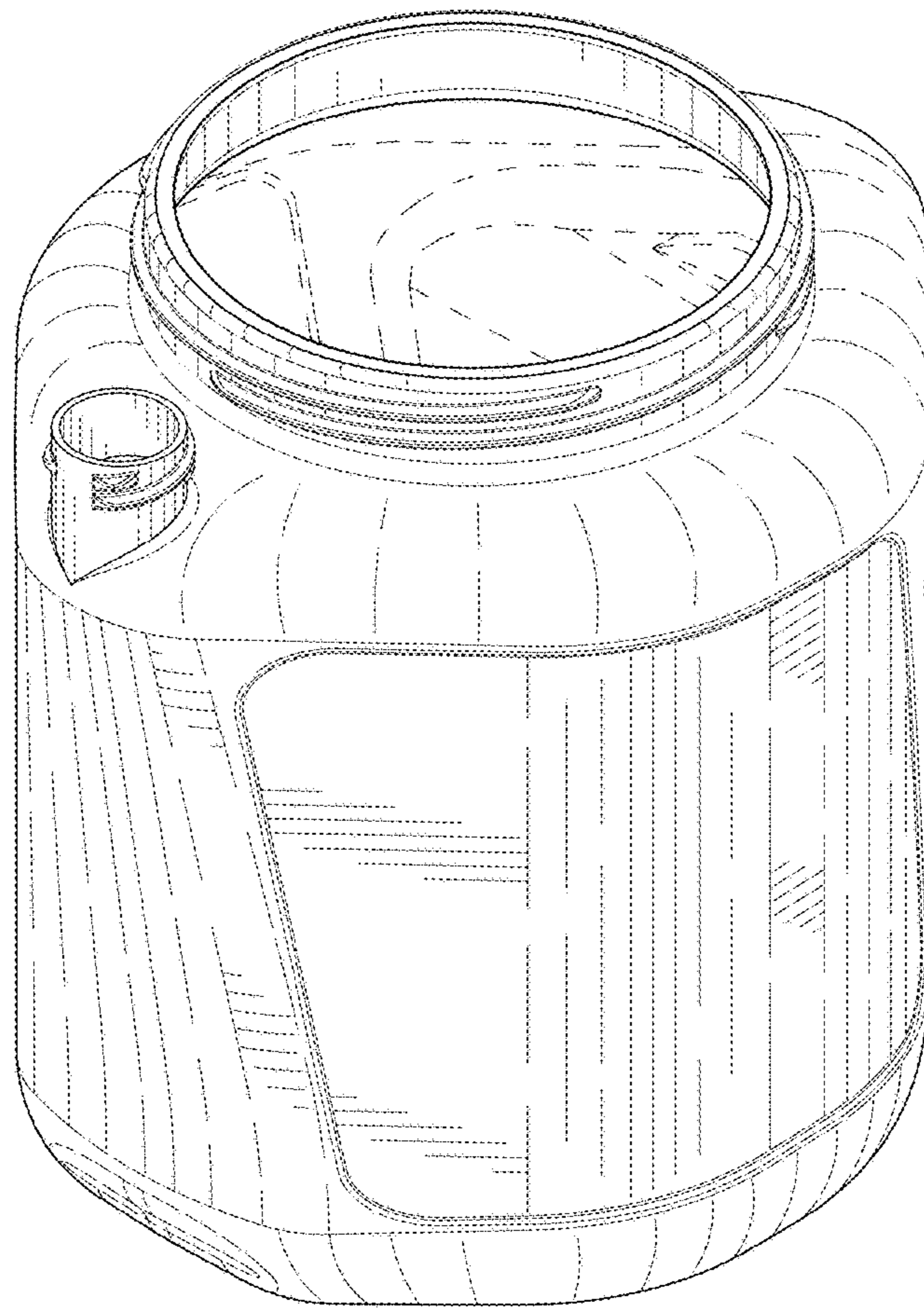

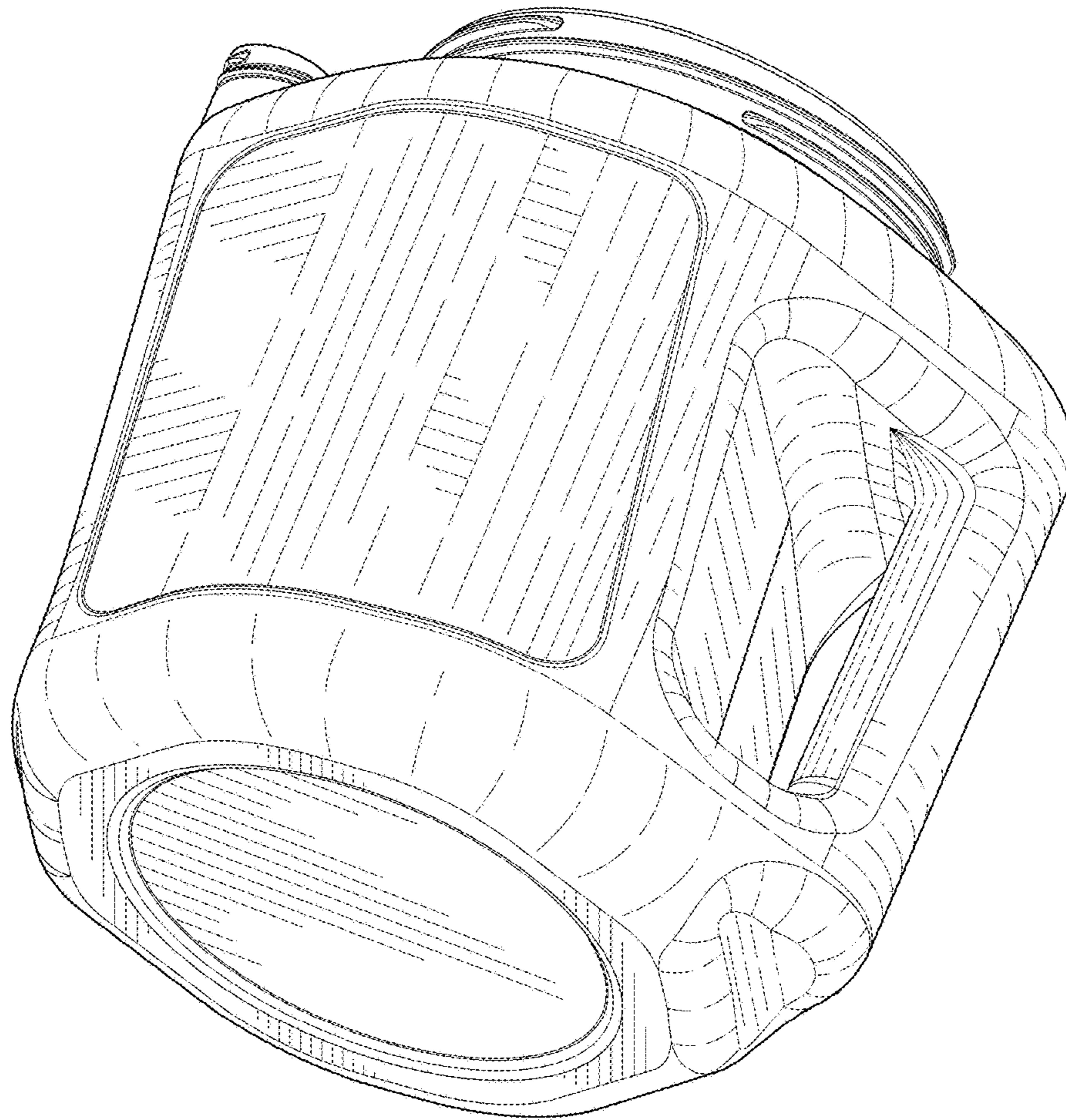

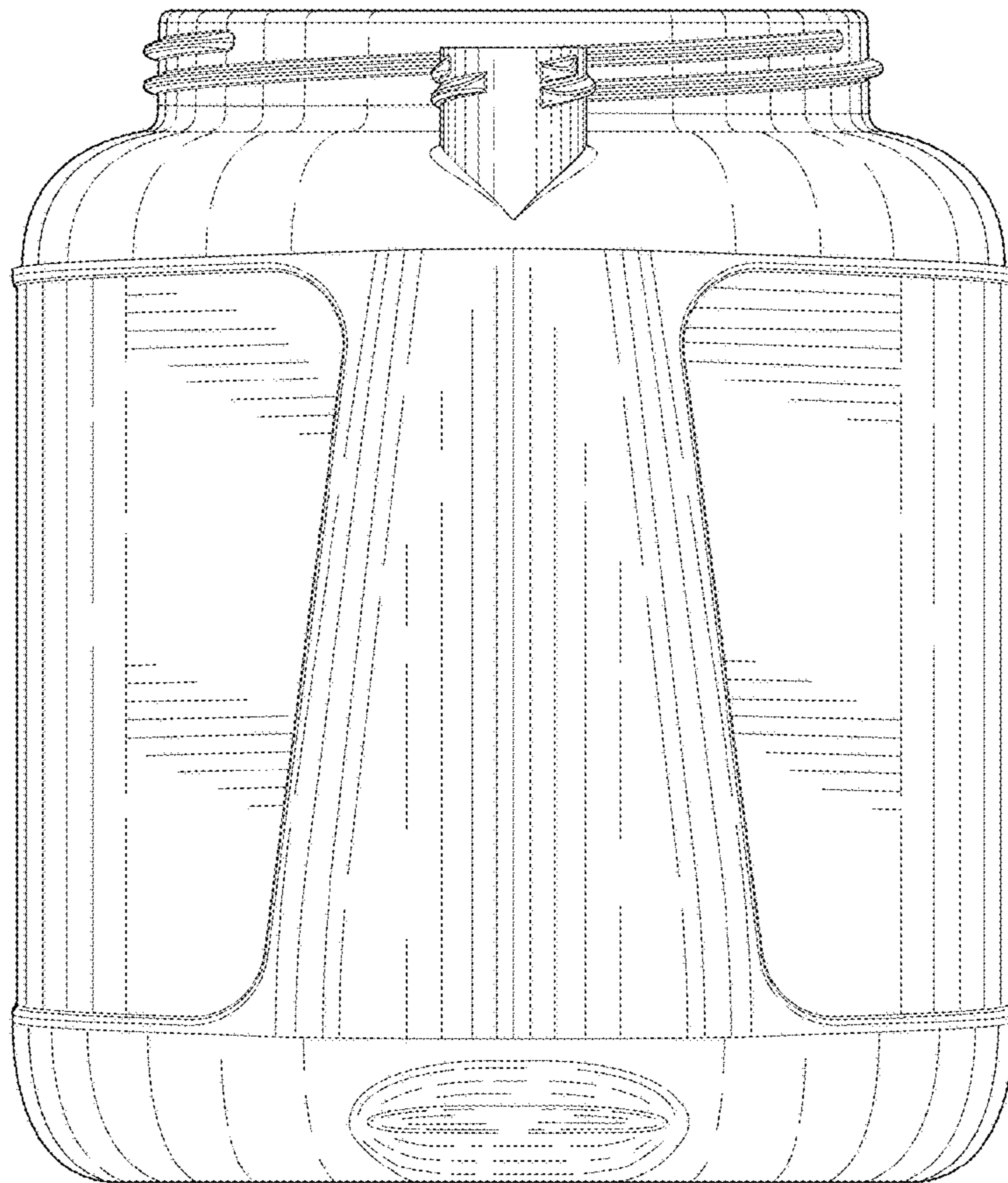

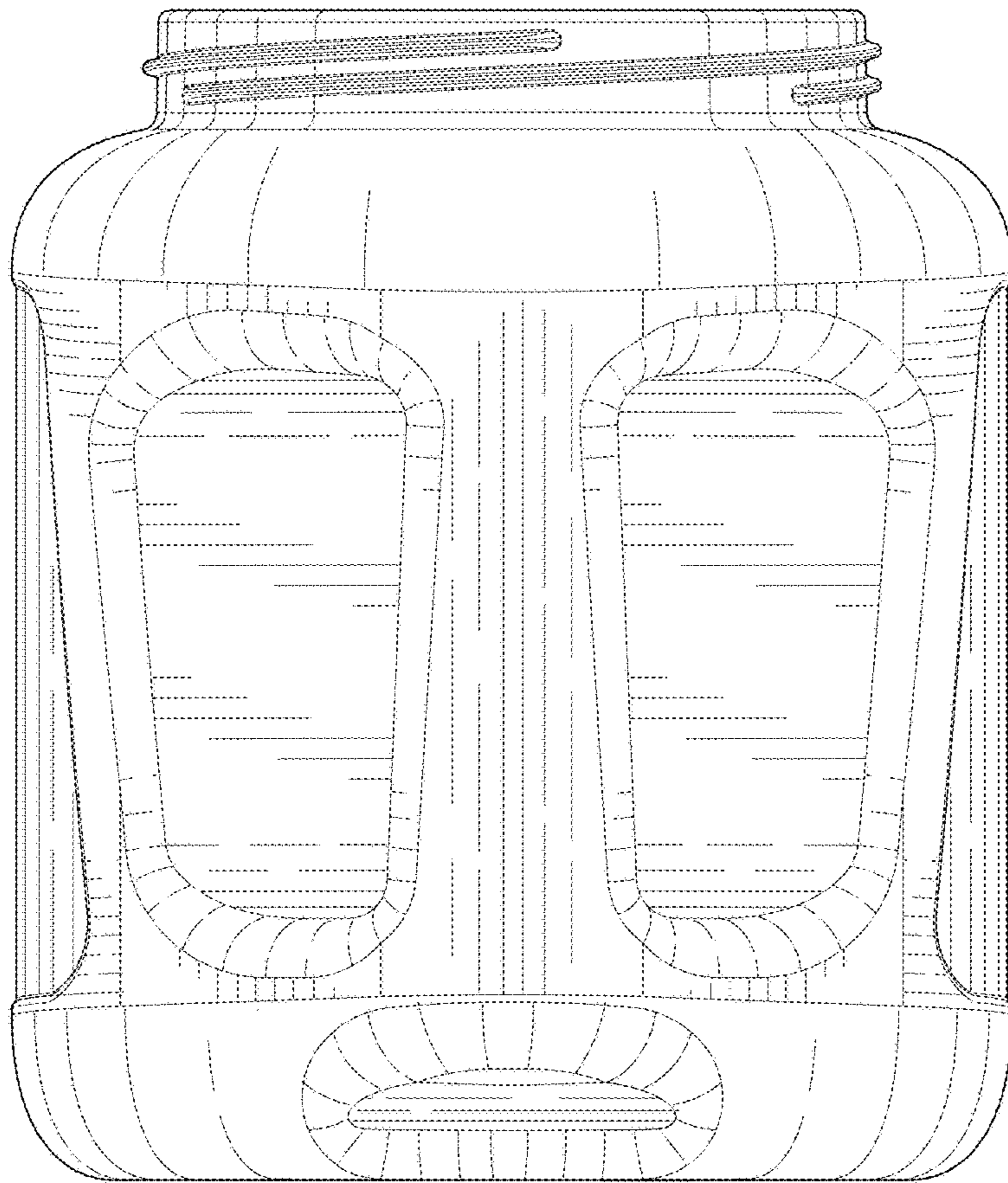

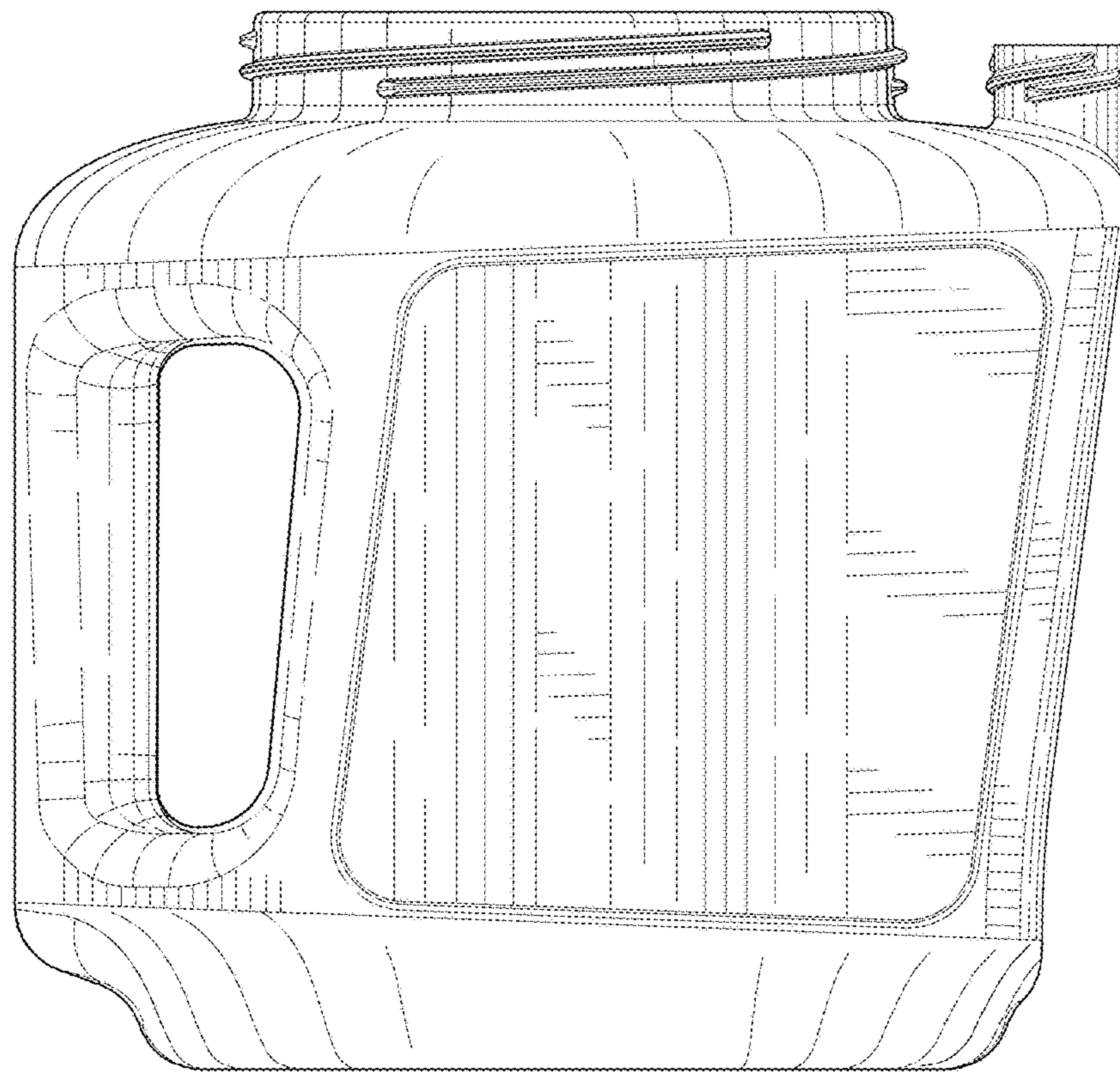

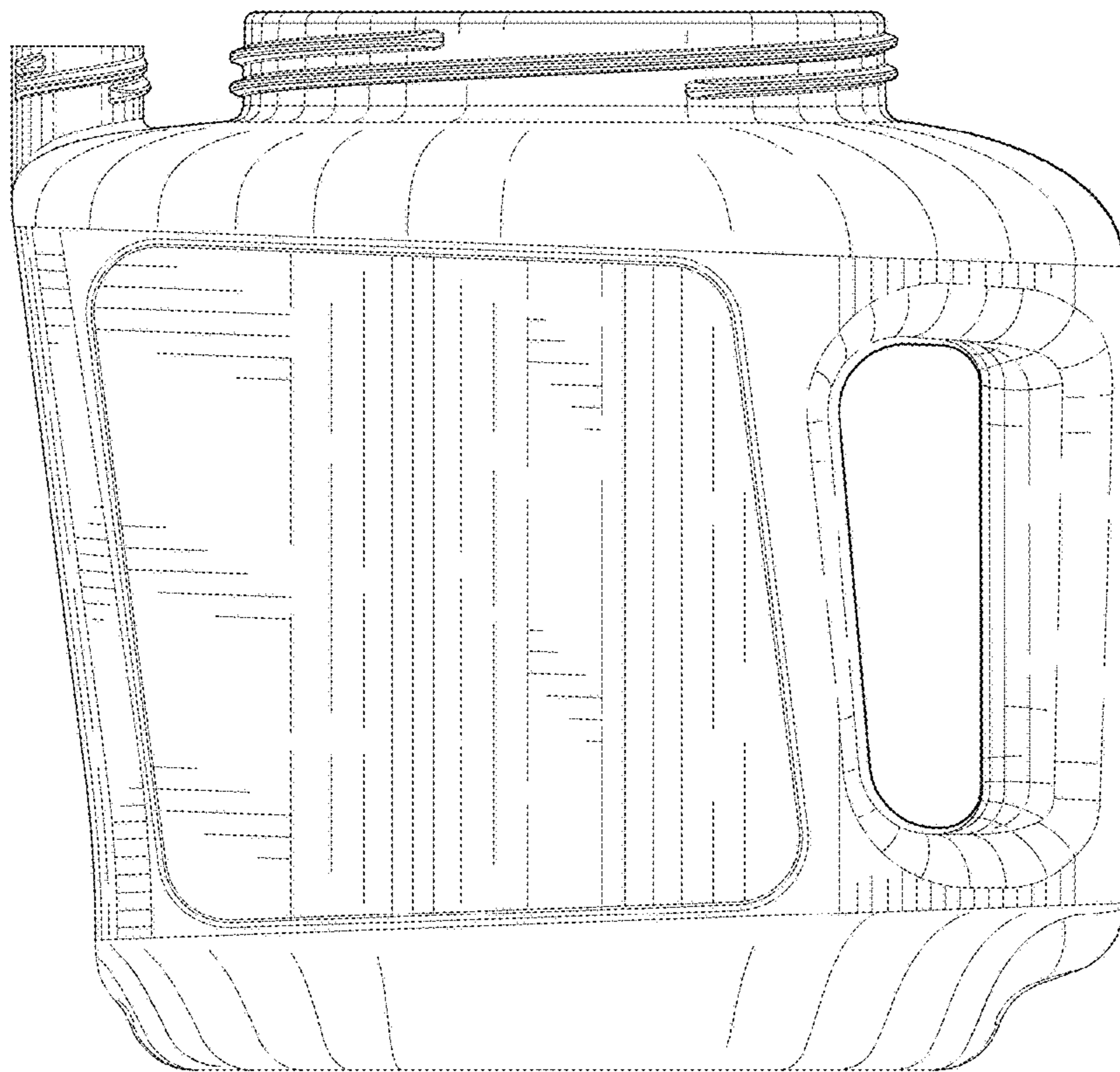

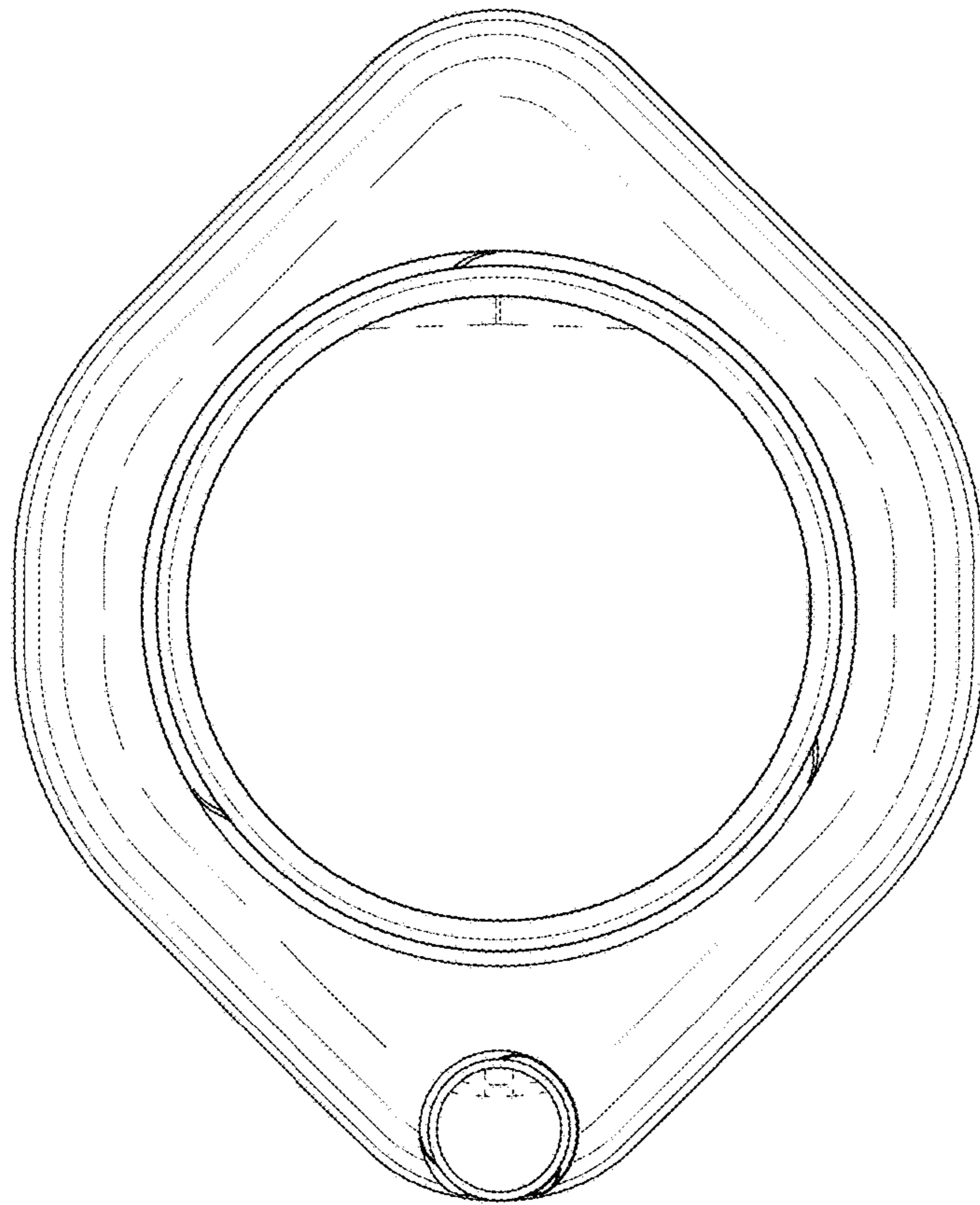

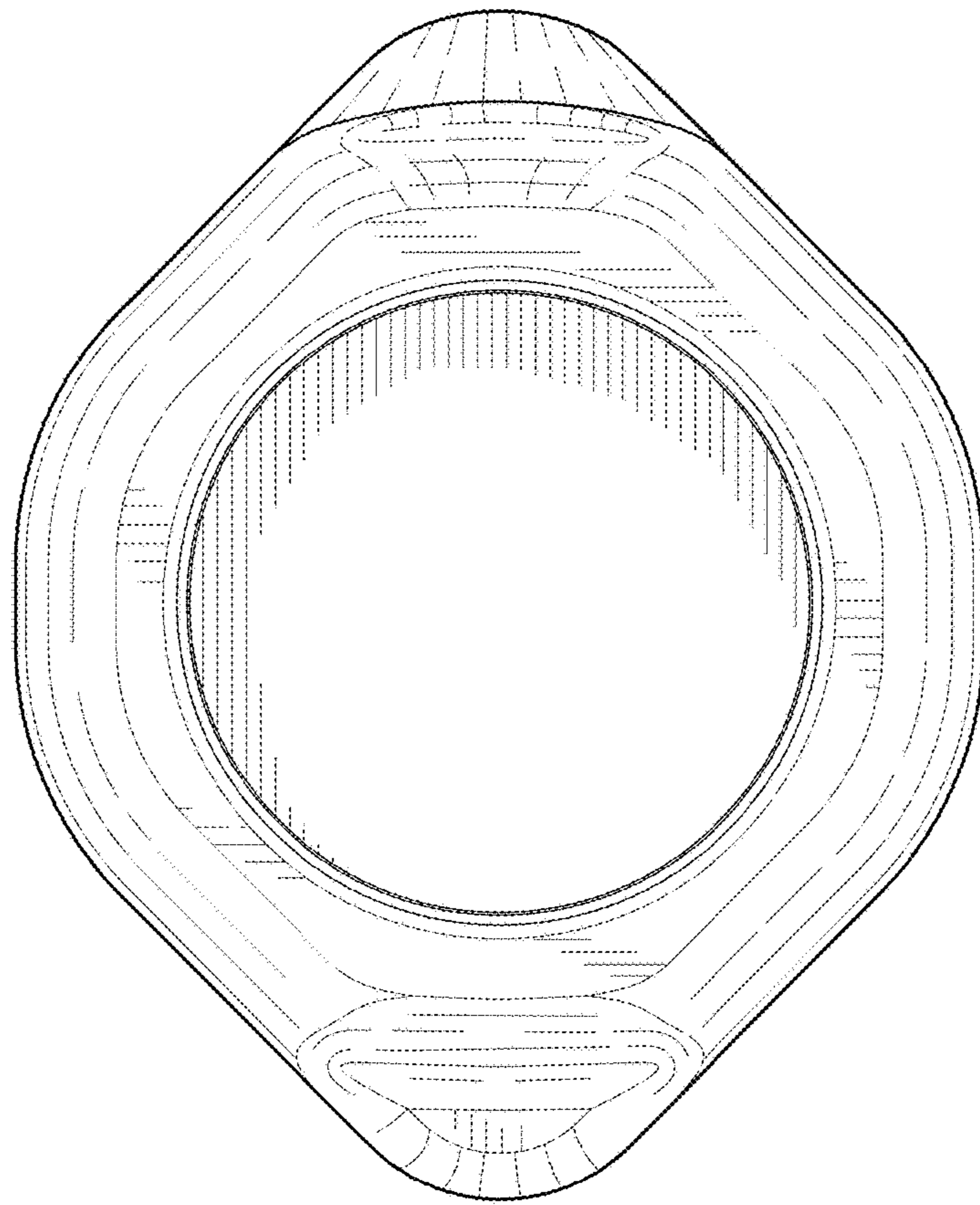
