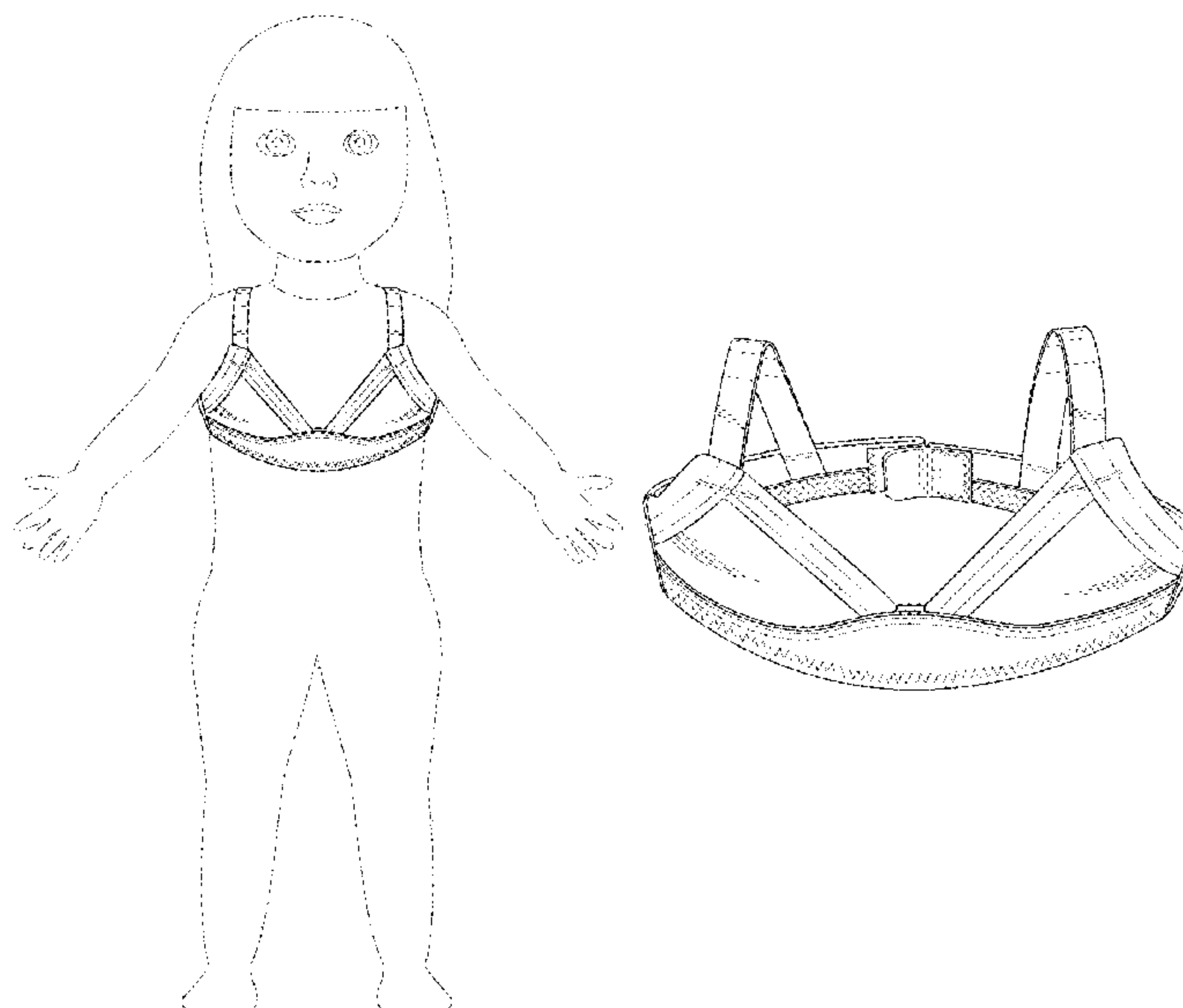
An ornamental design for an undergarment for an eighteen-inch doll, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of an undergarment for an eighteen-inch doll, shown in a position of use;  
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of the undergarment for an eighteen-inch doll of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2 shown in an open position;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2 shown in an open position;

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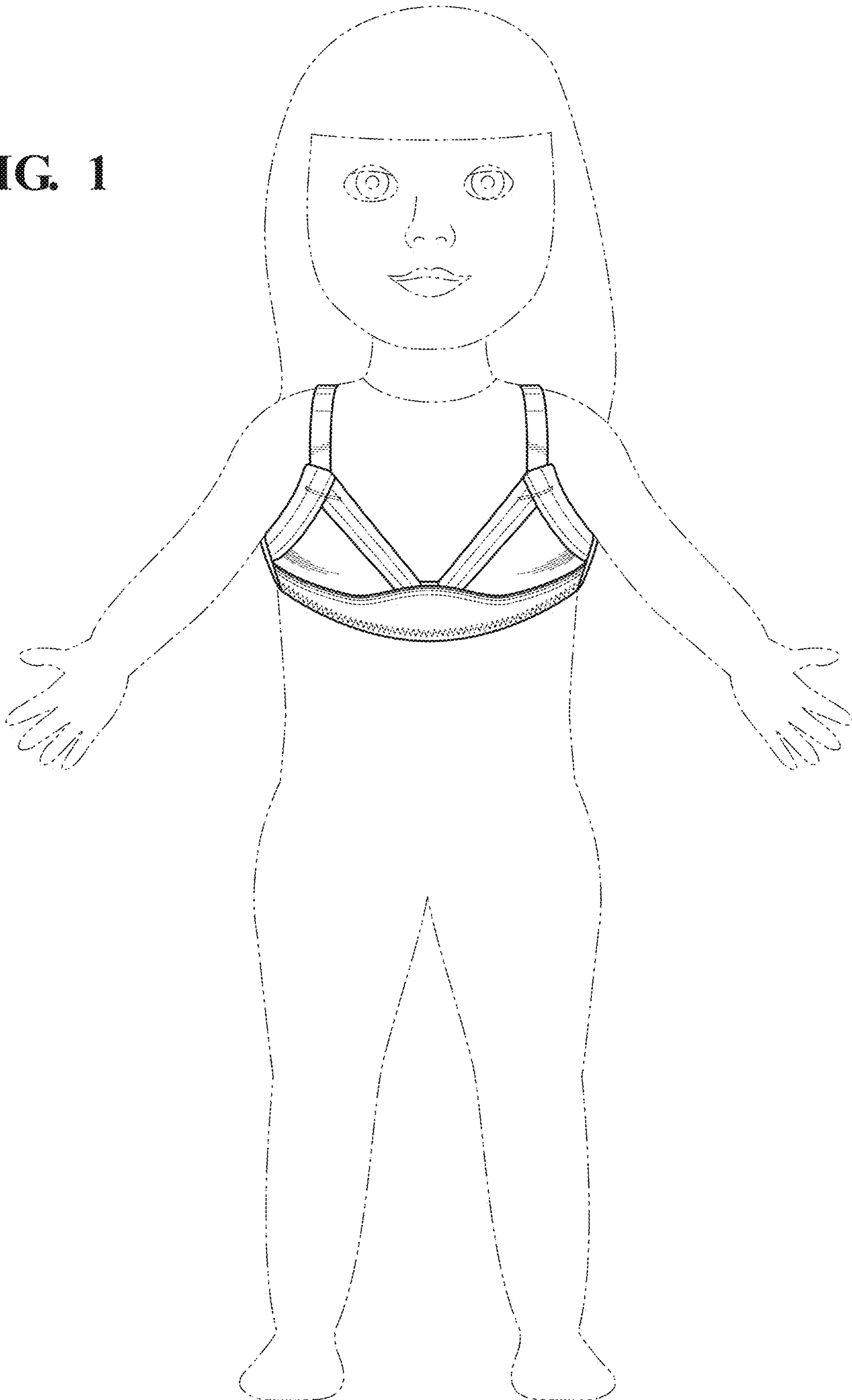

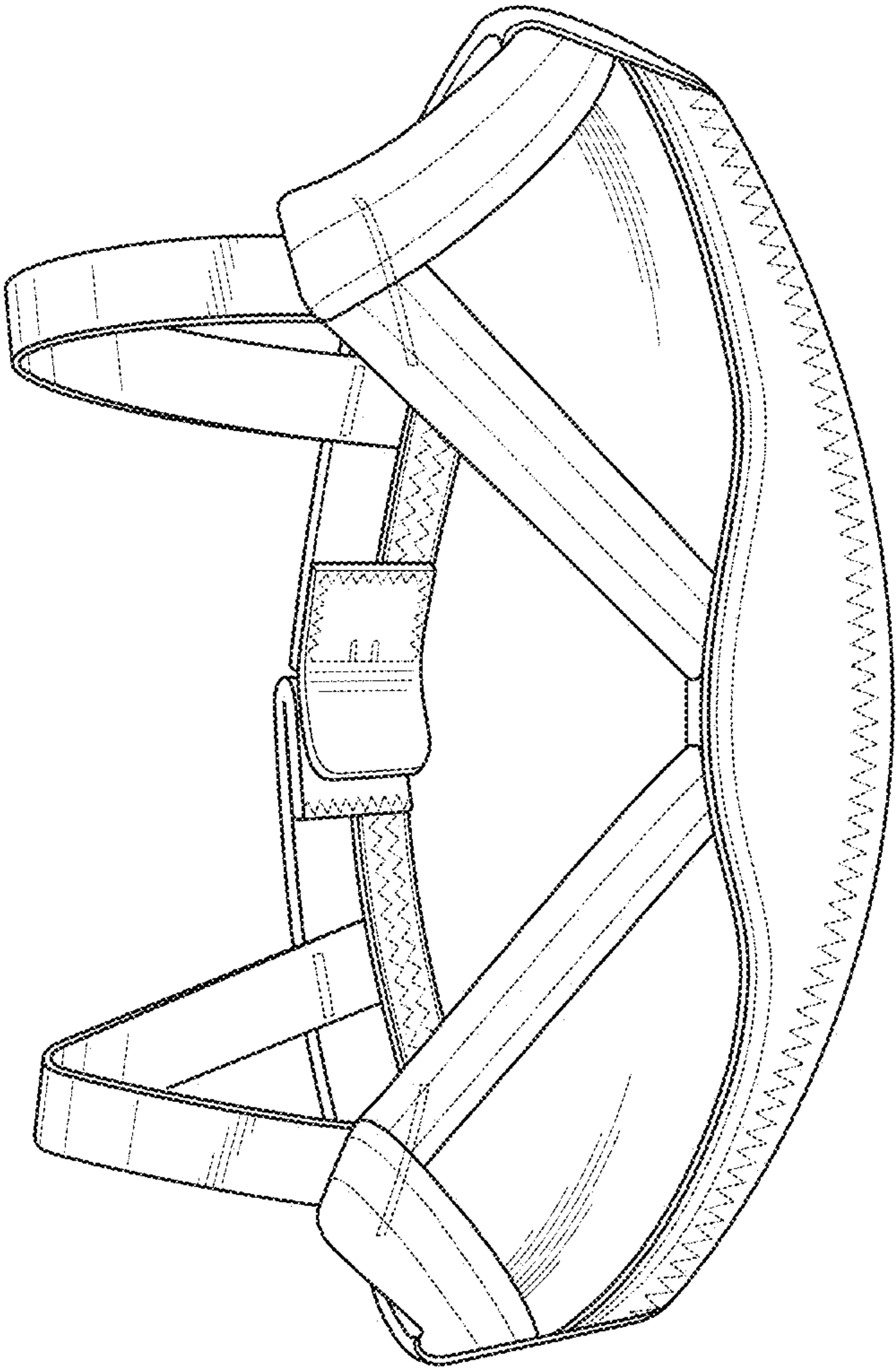

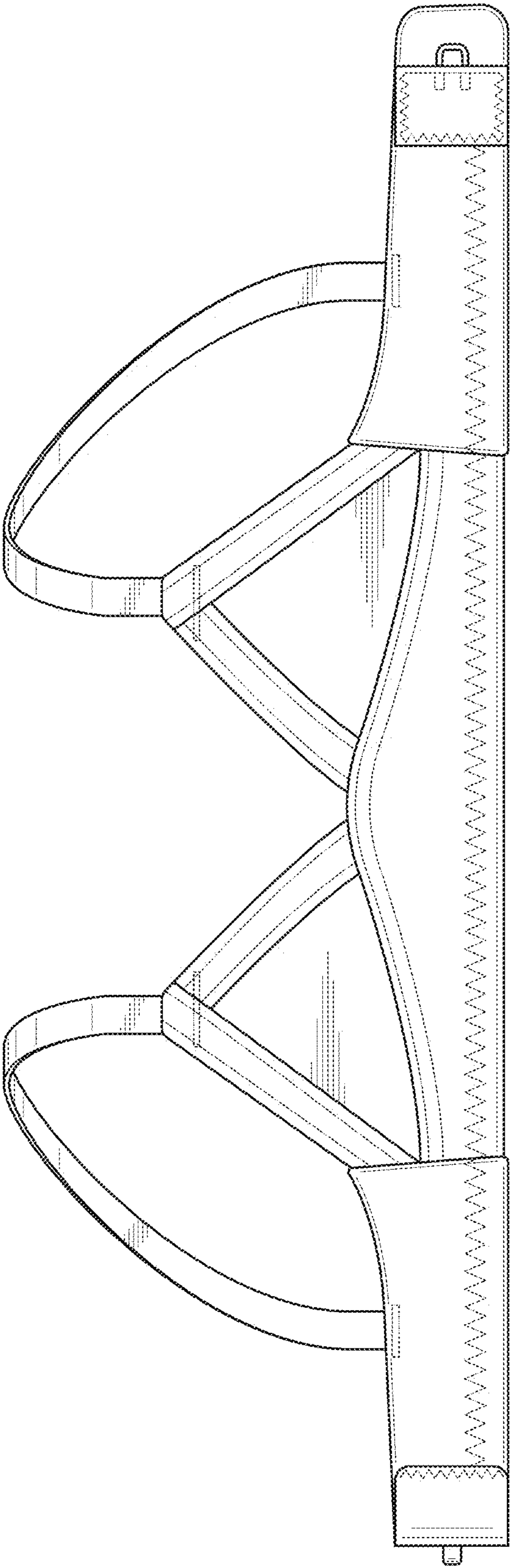
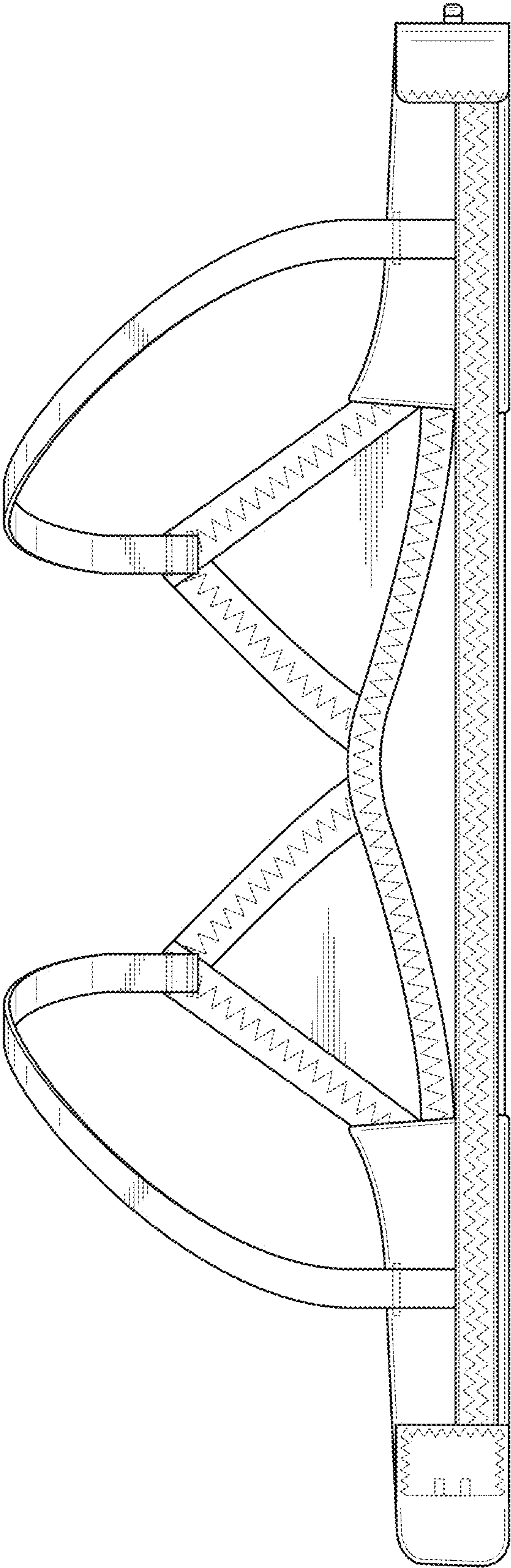

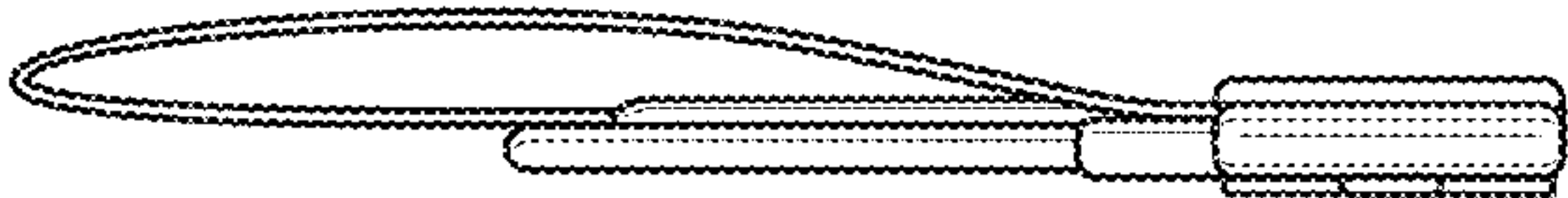

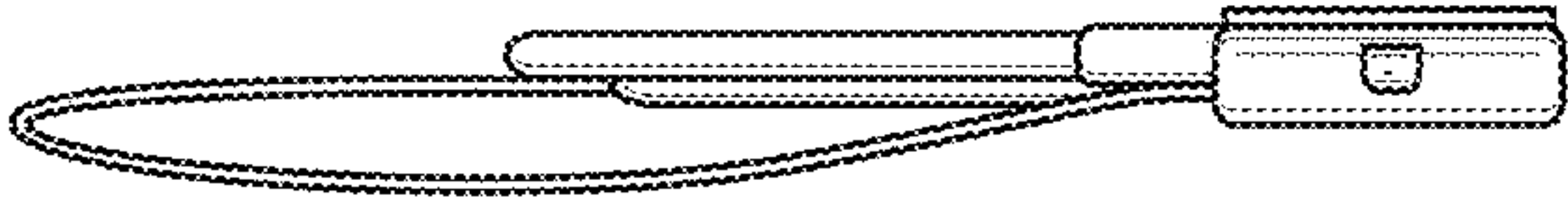

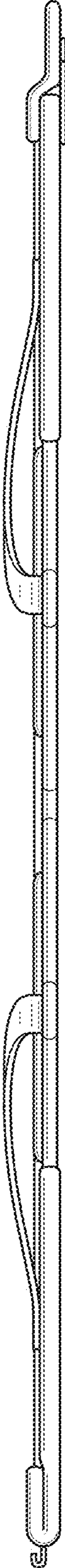

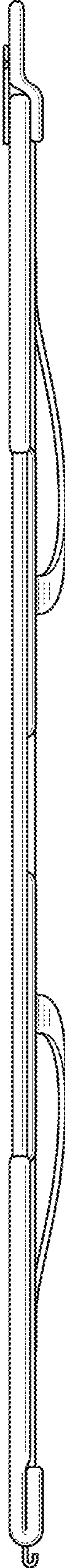
