(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is an enlarged top view thereof; and,

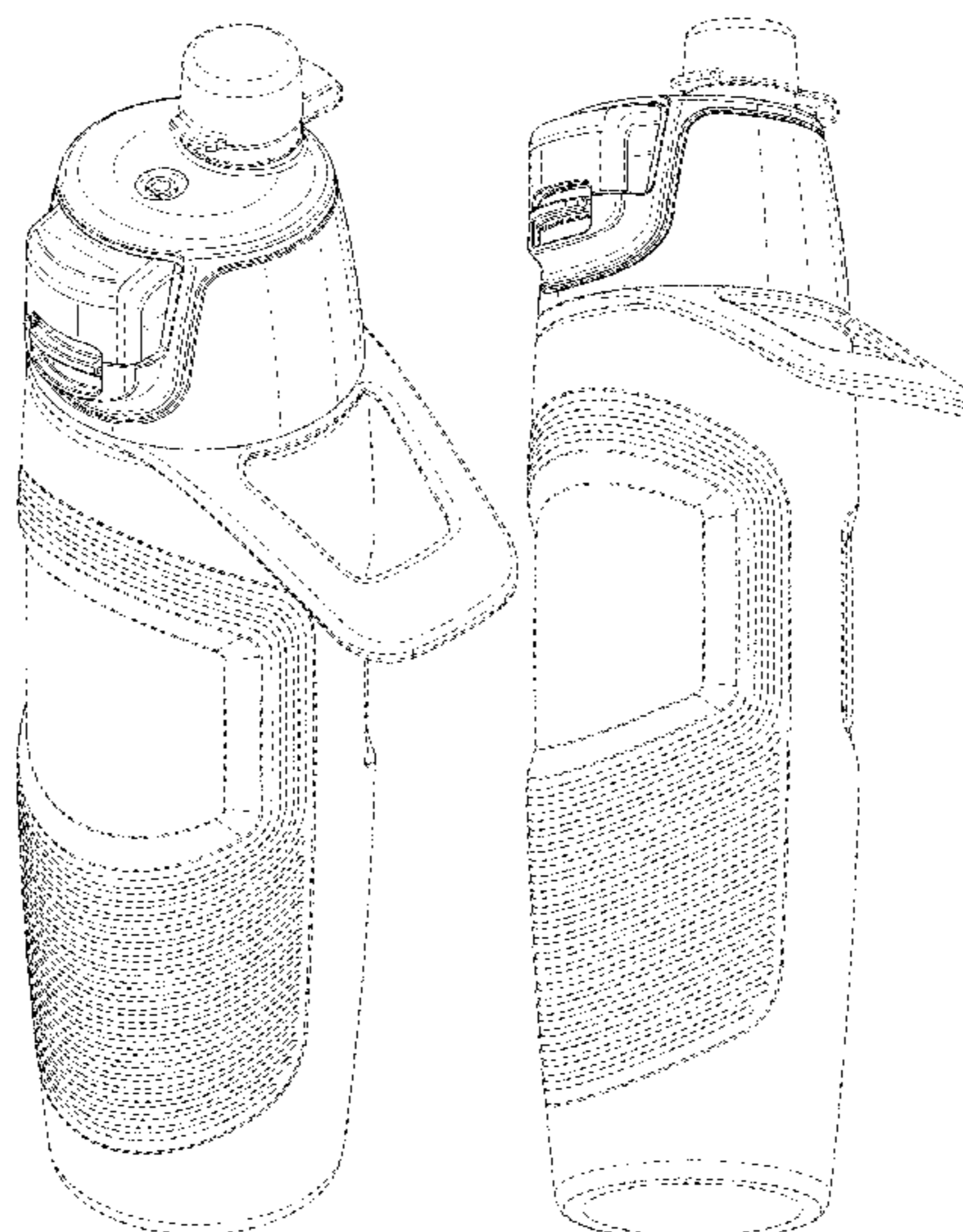
FIG. 8 is an enlarged bottom view thereof.

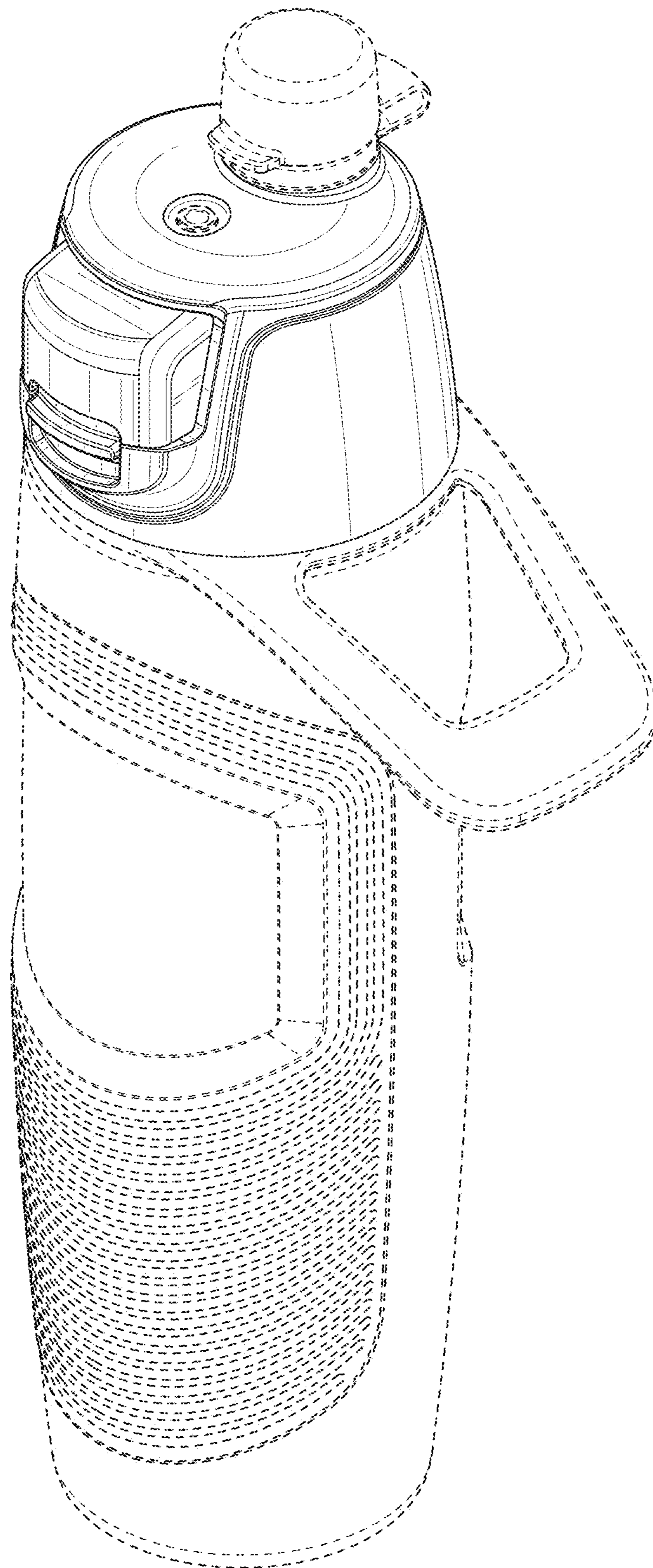

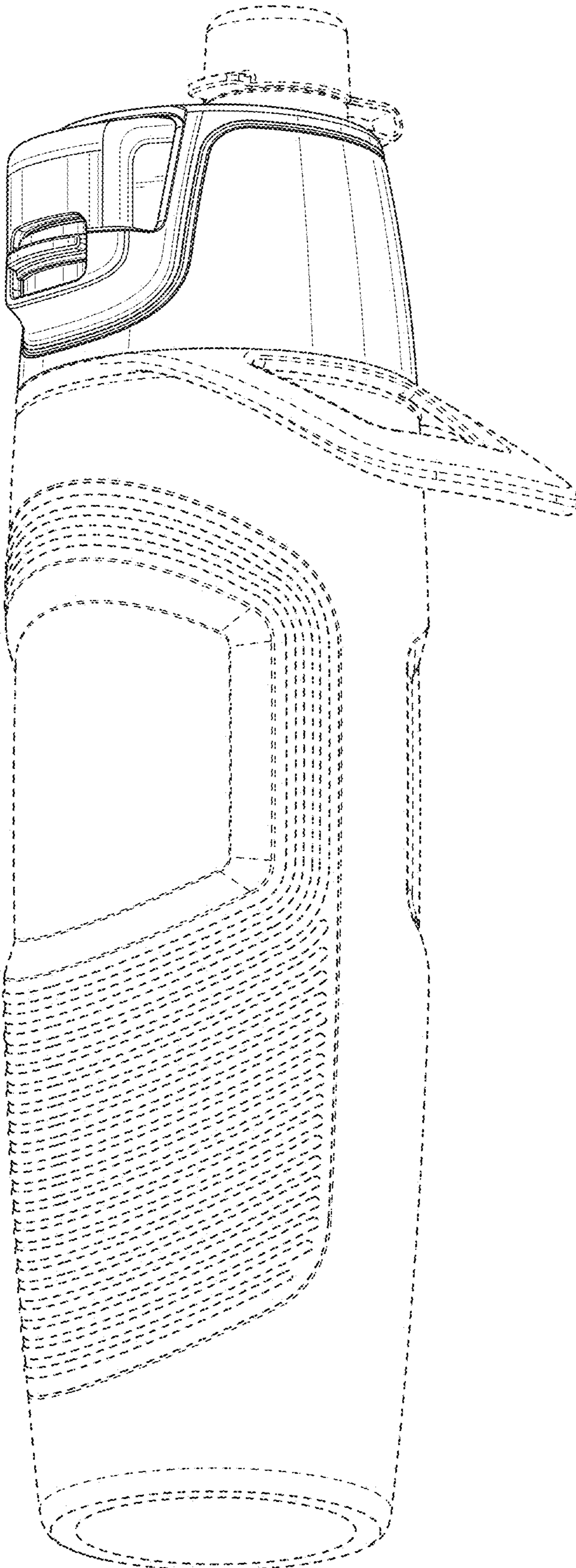

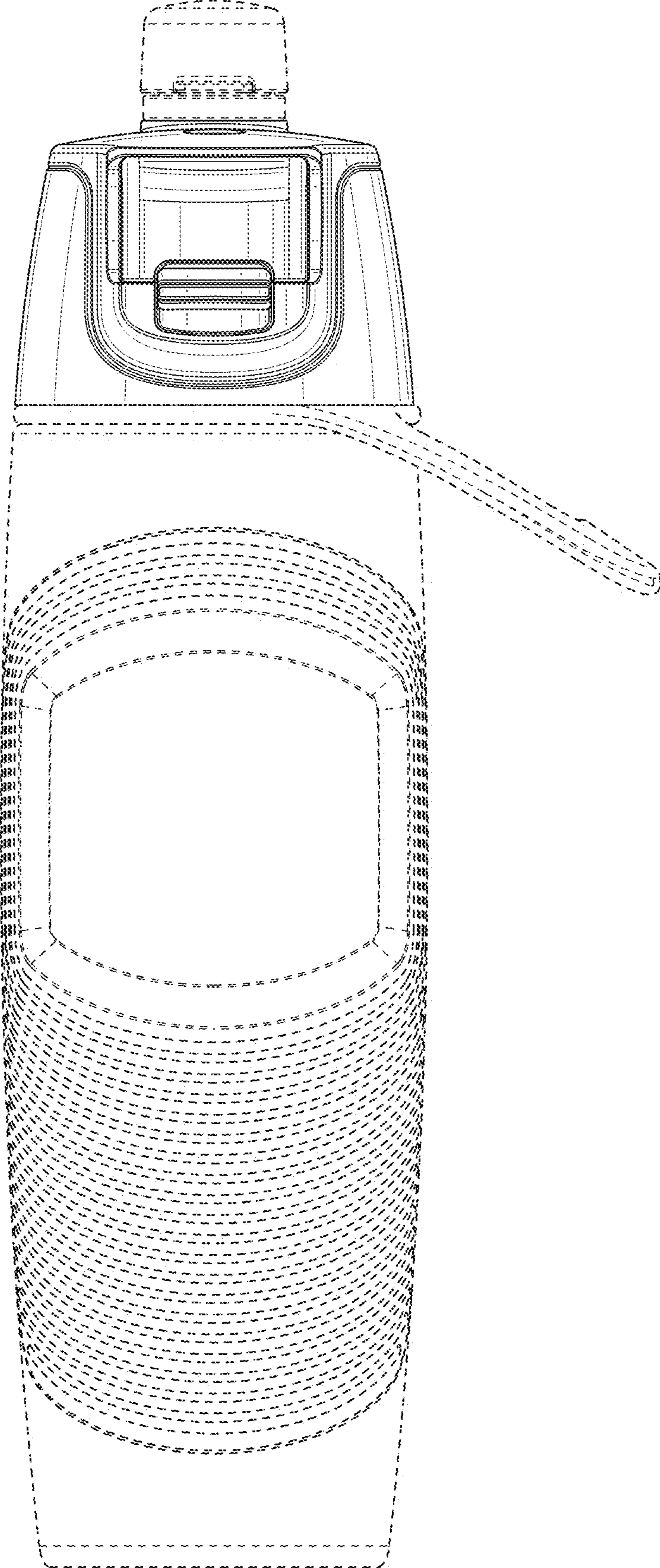

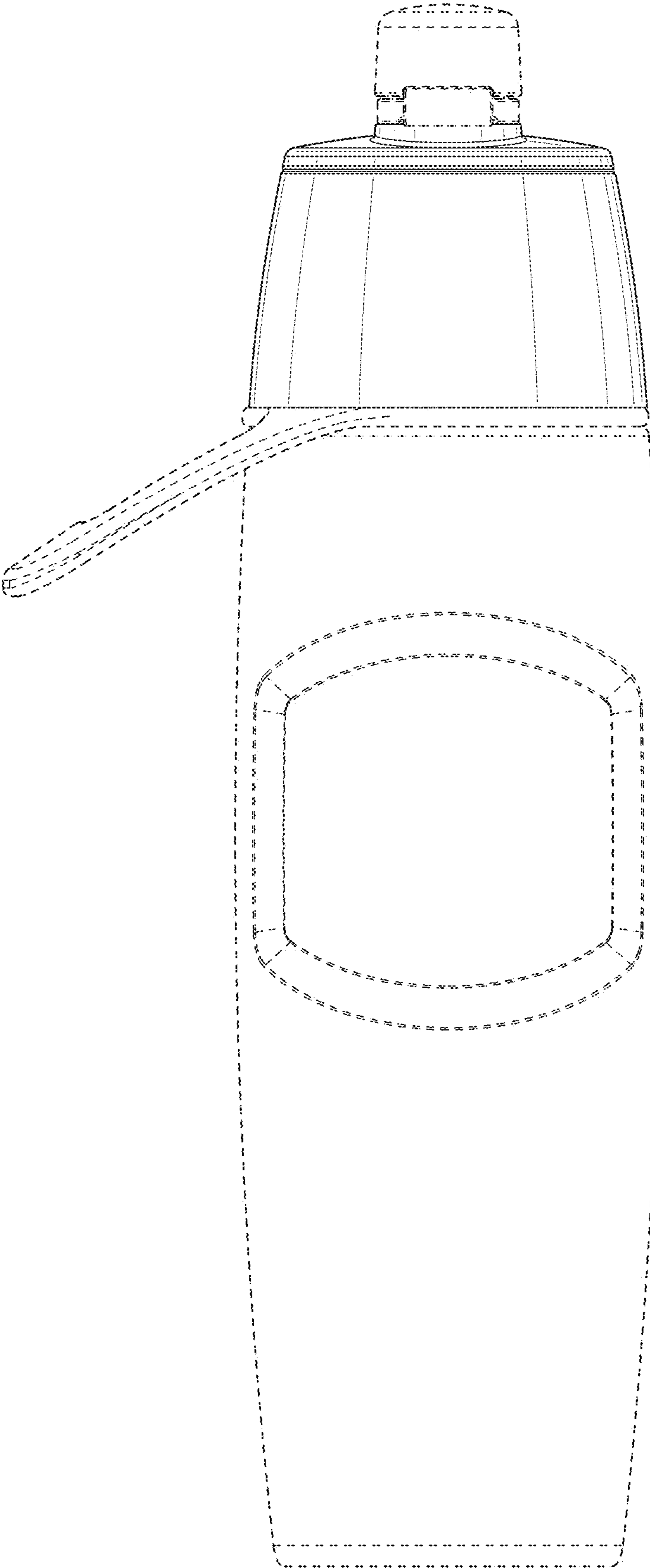

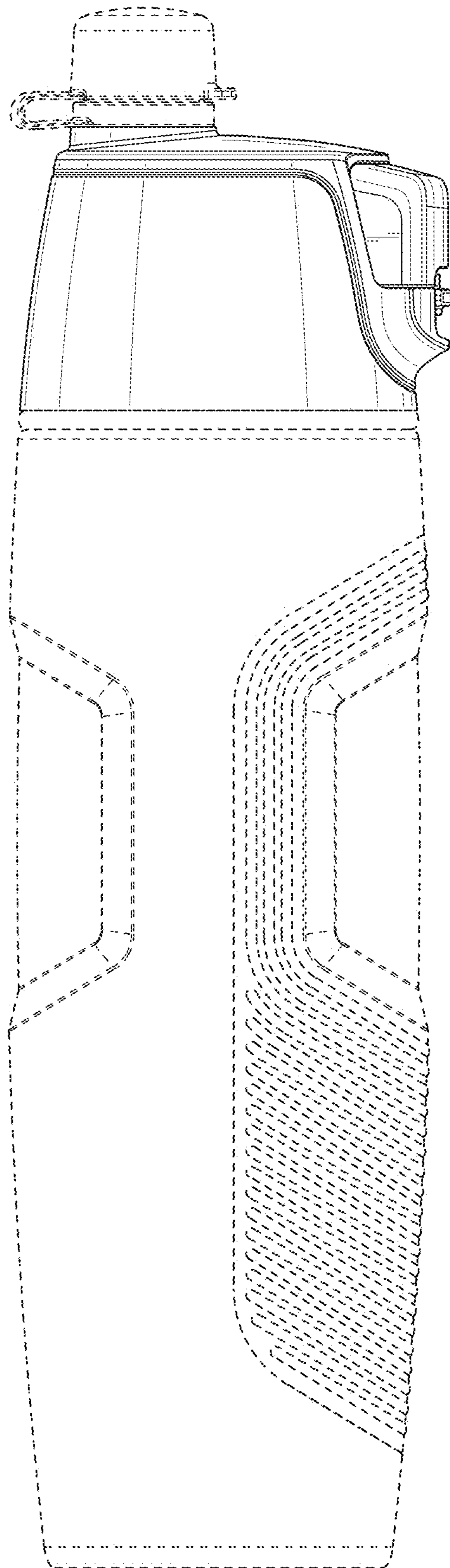

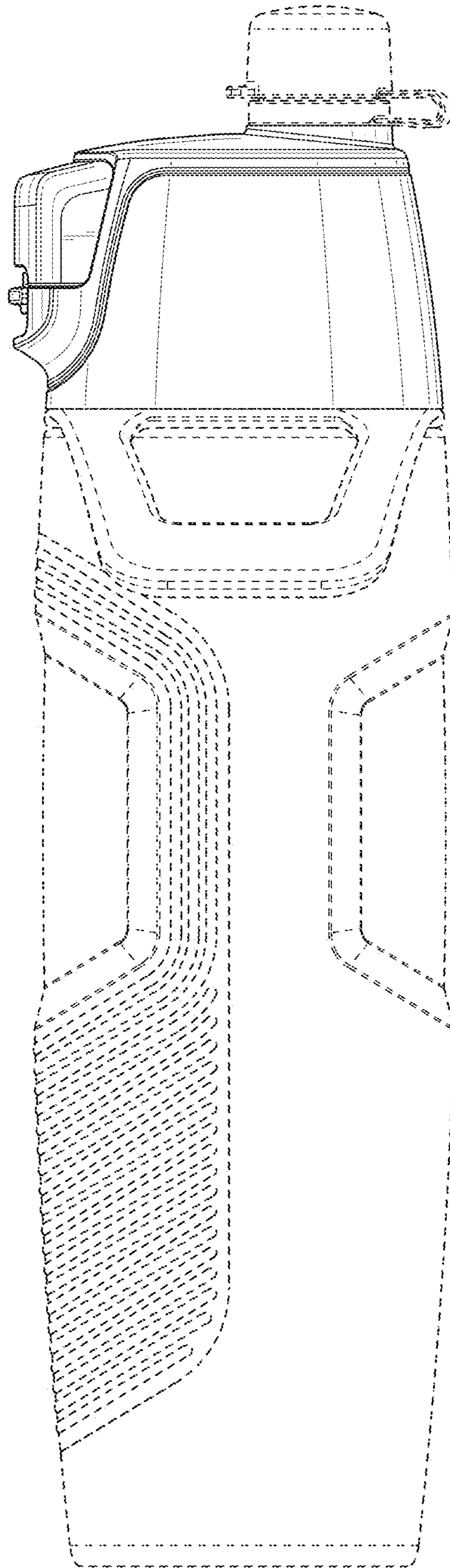

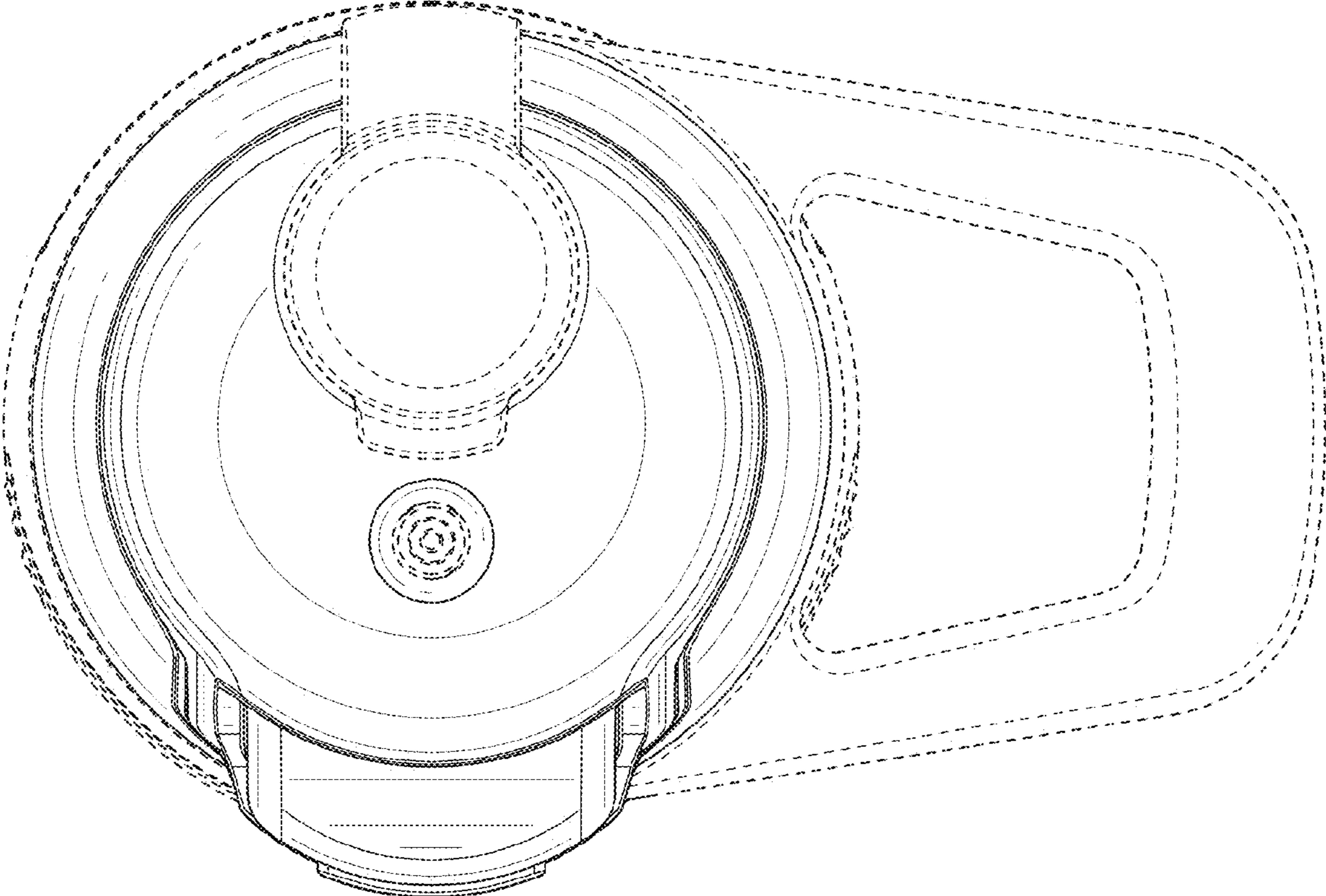

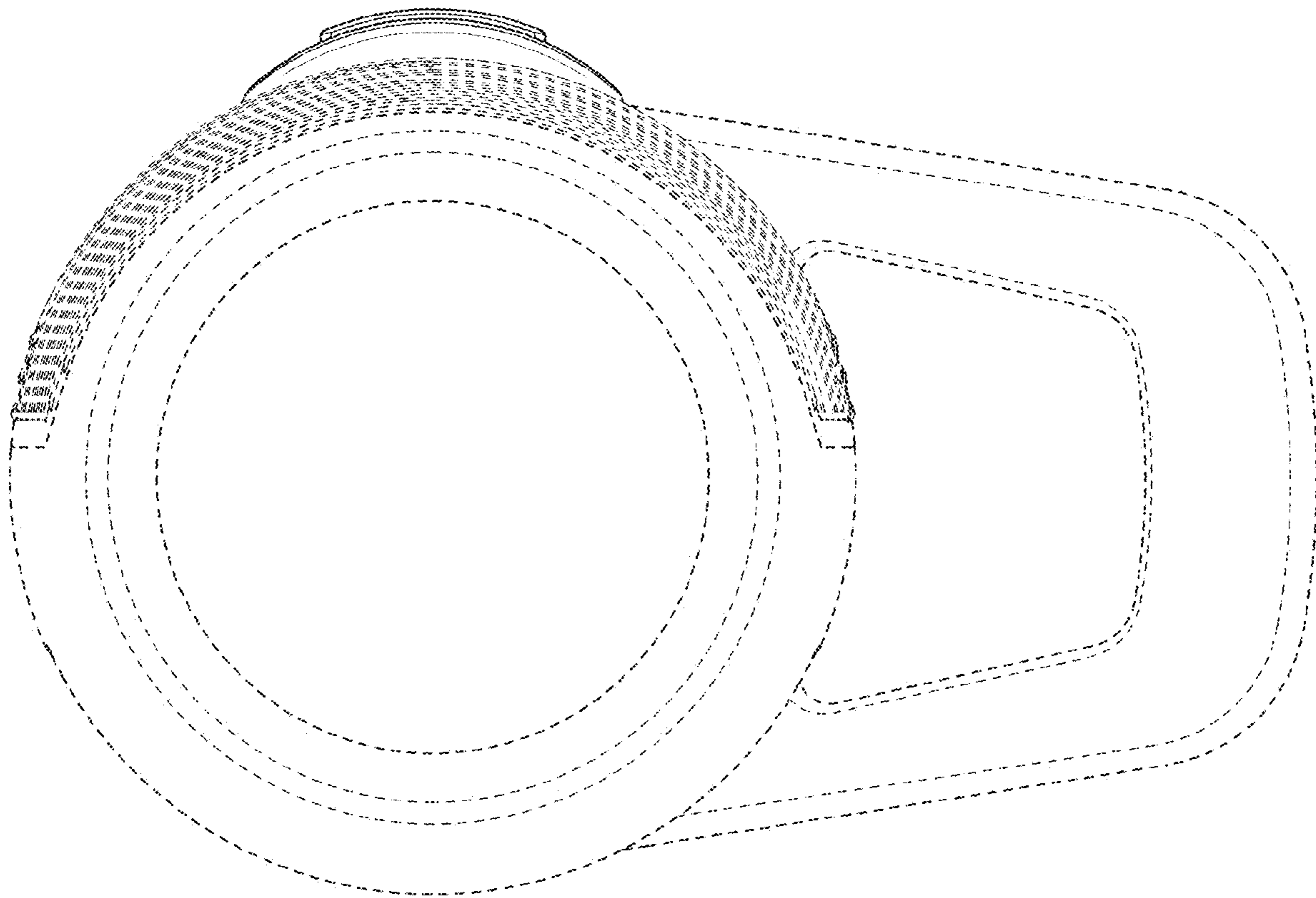
