FIG. 8 is an enlarged bottom view thereof.

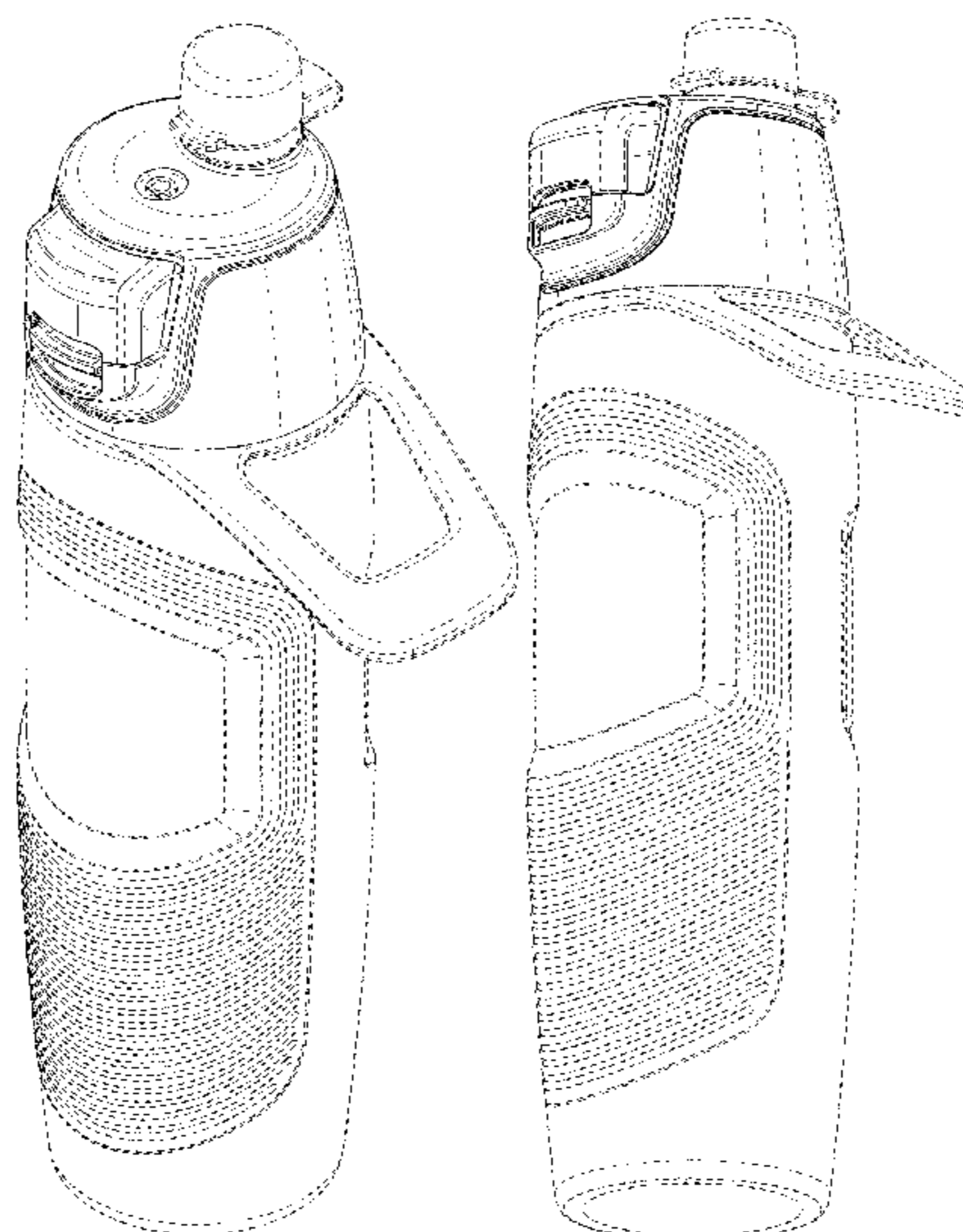

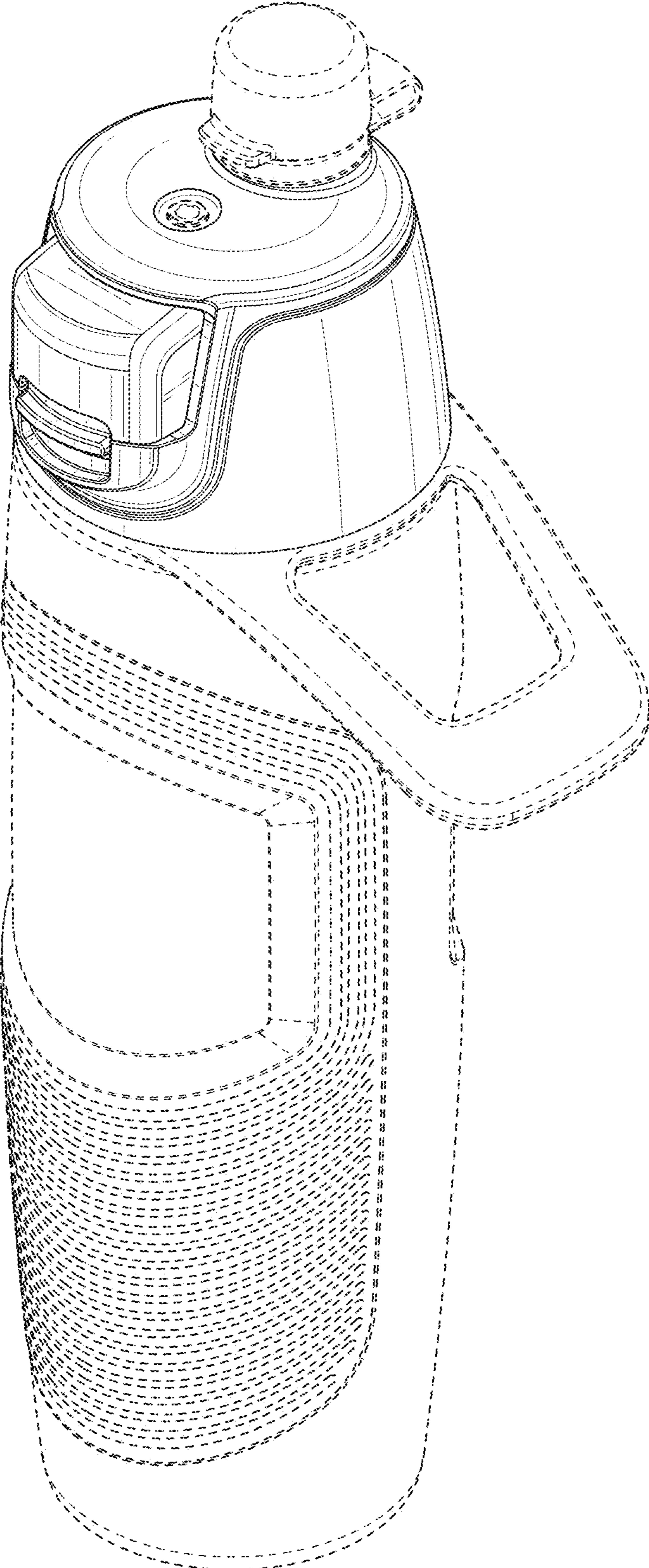

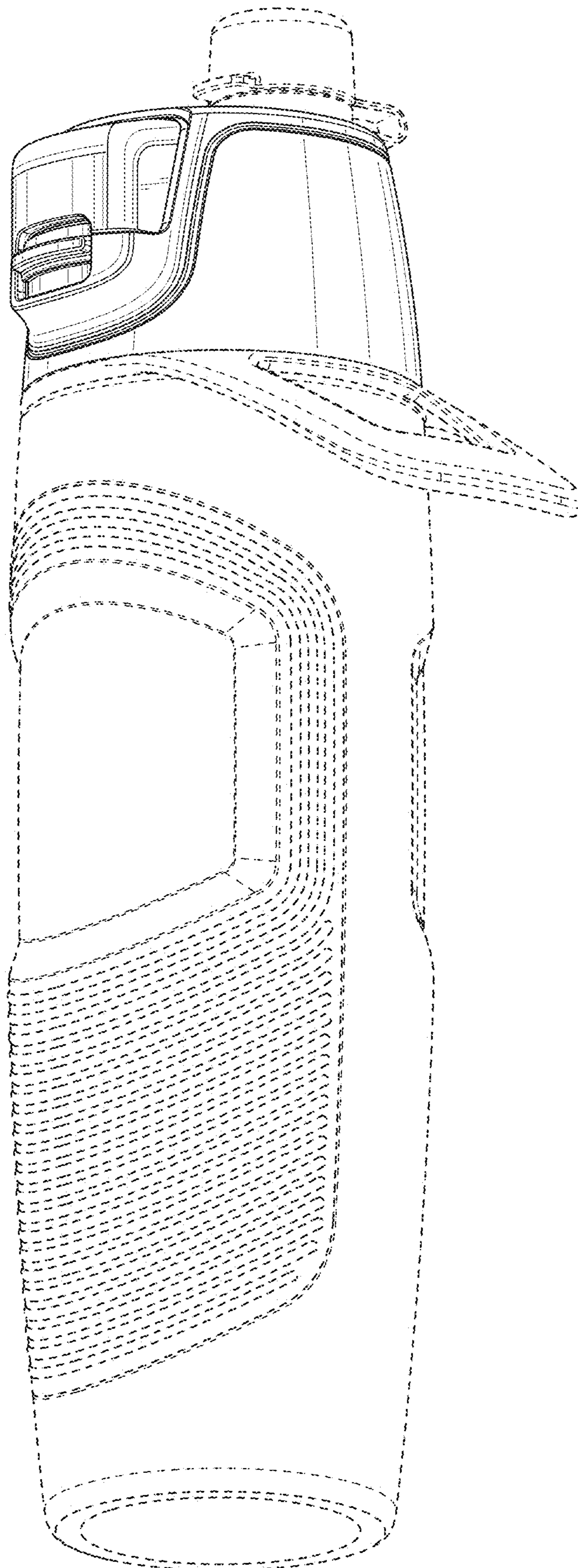

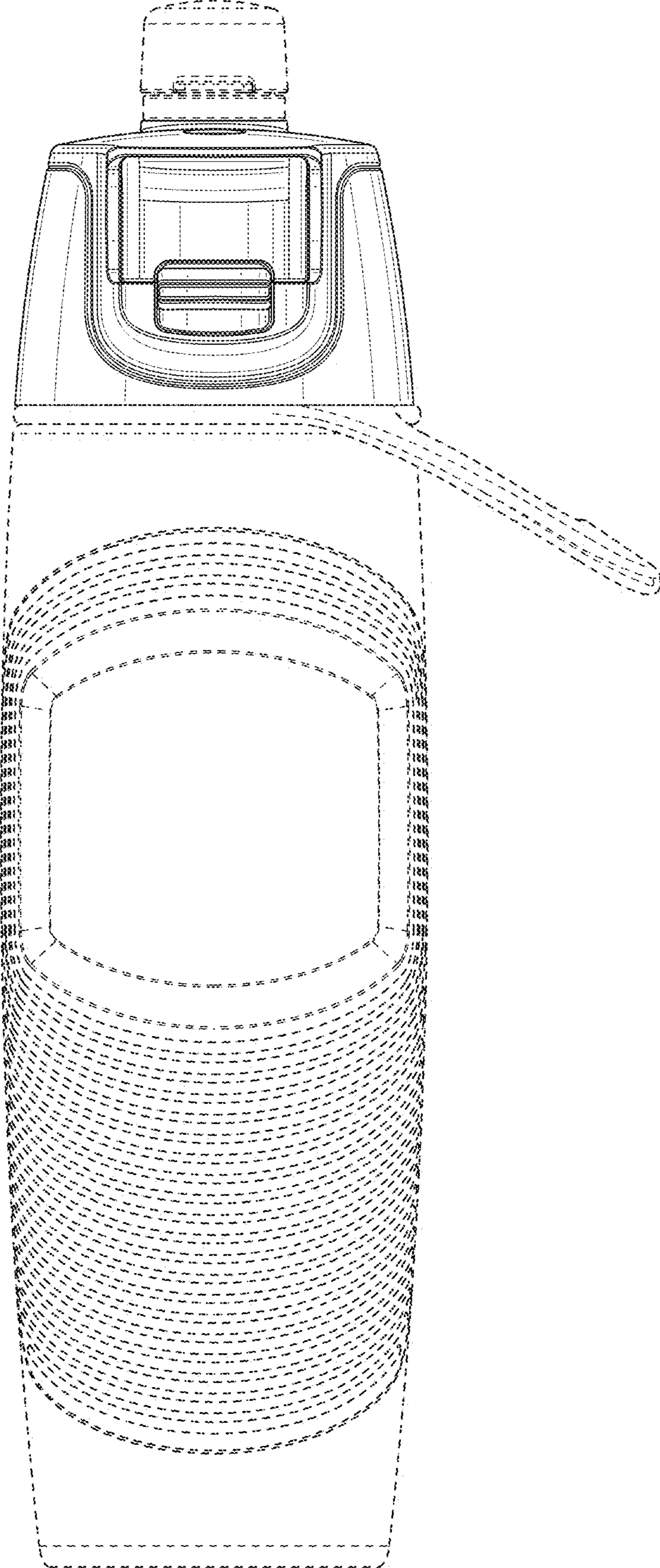

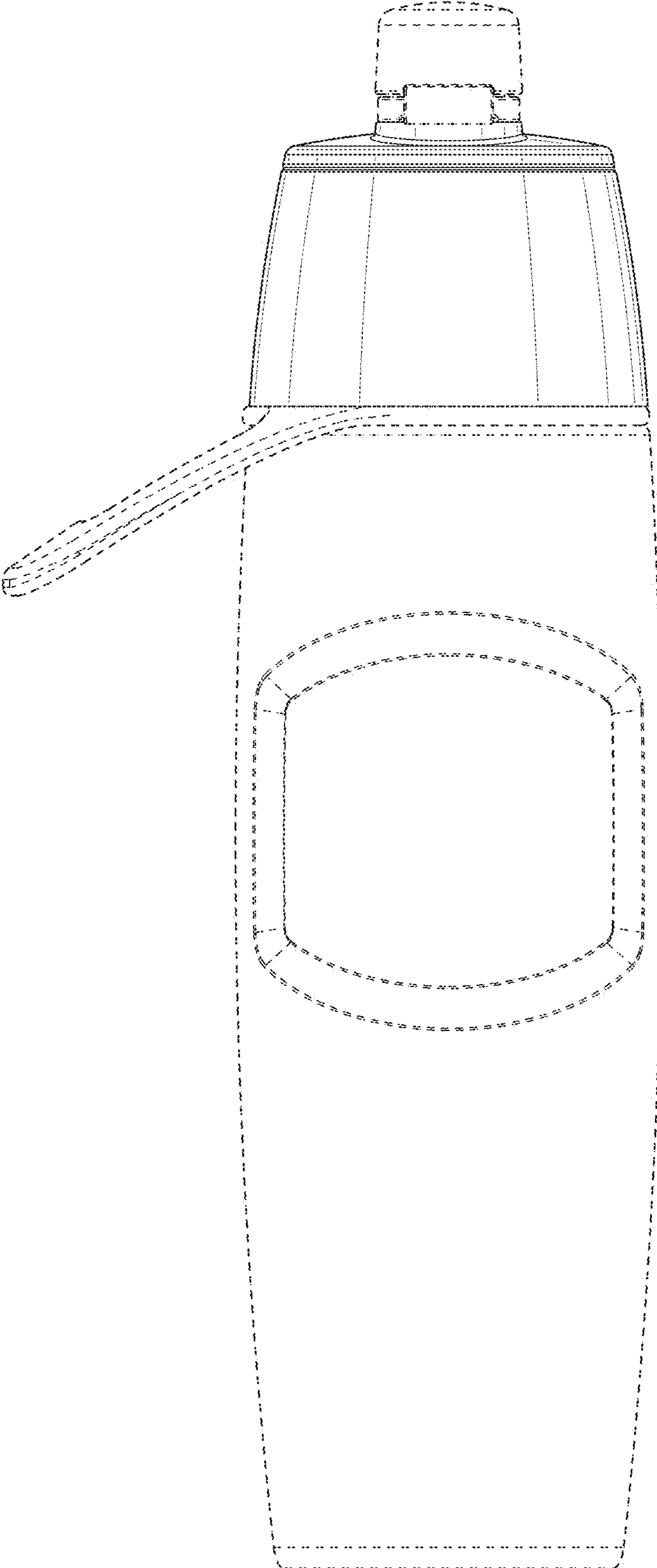

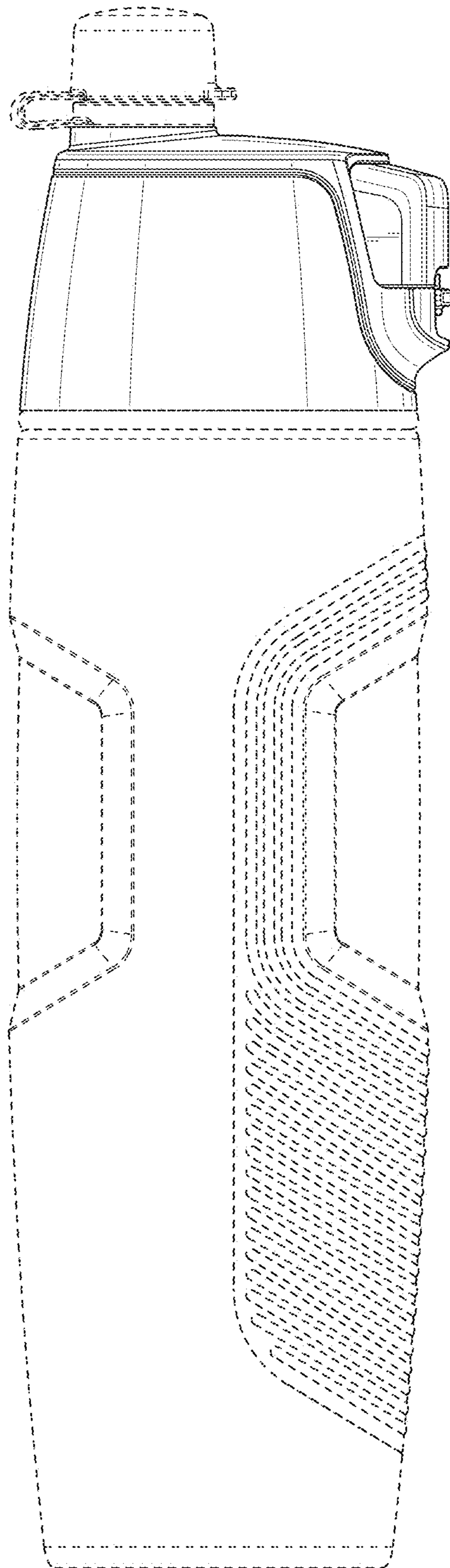

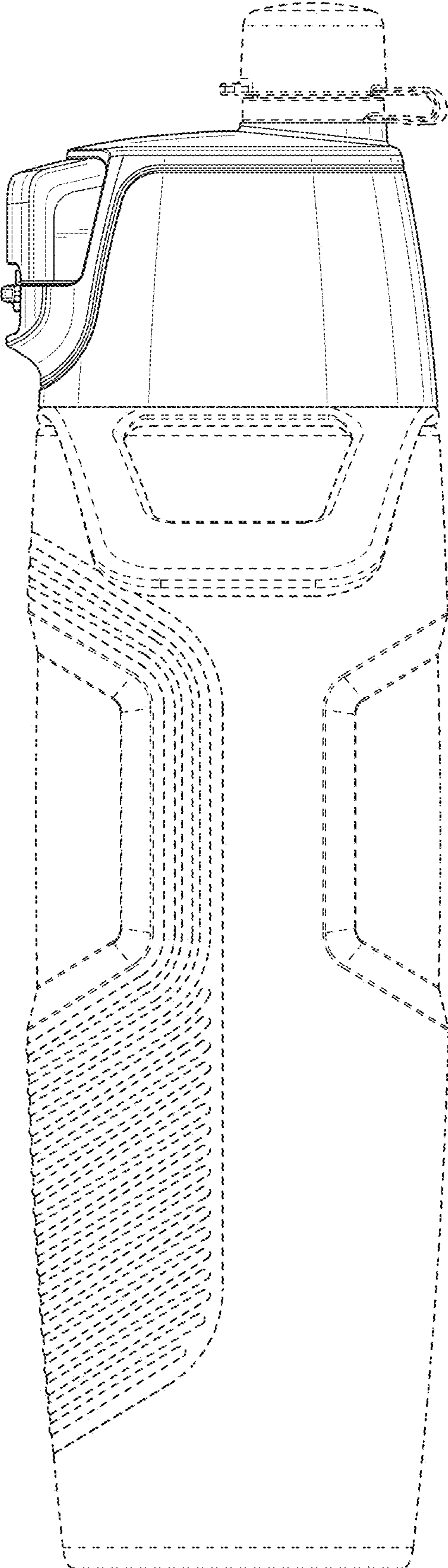

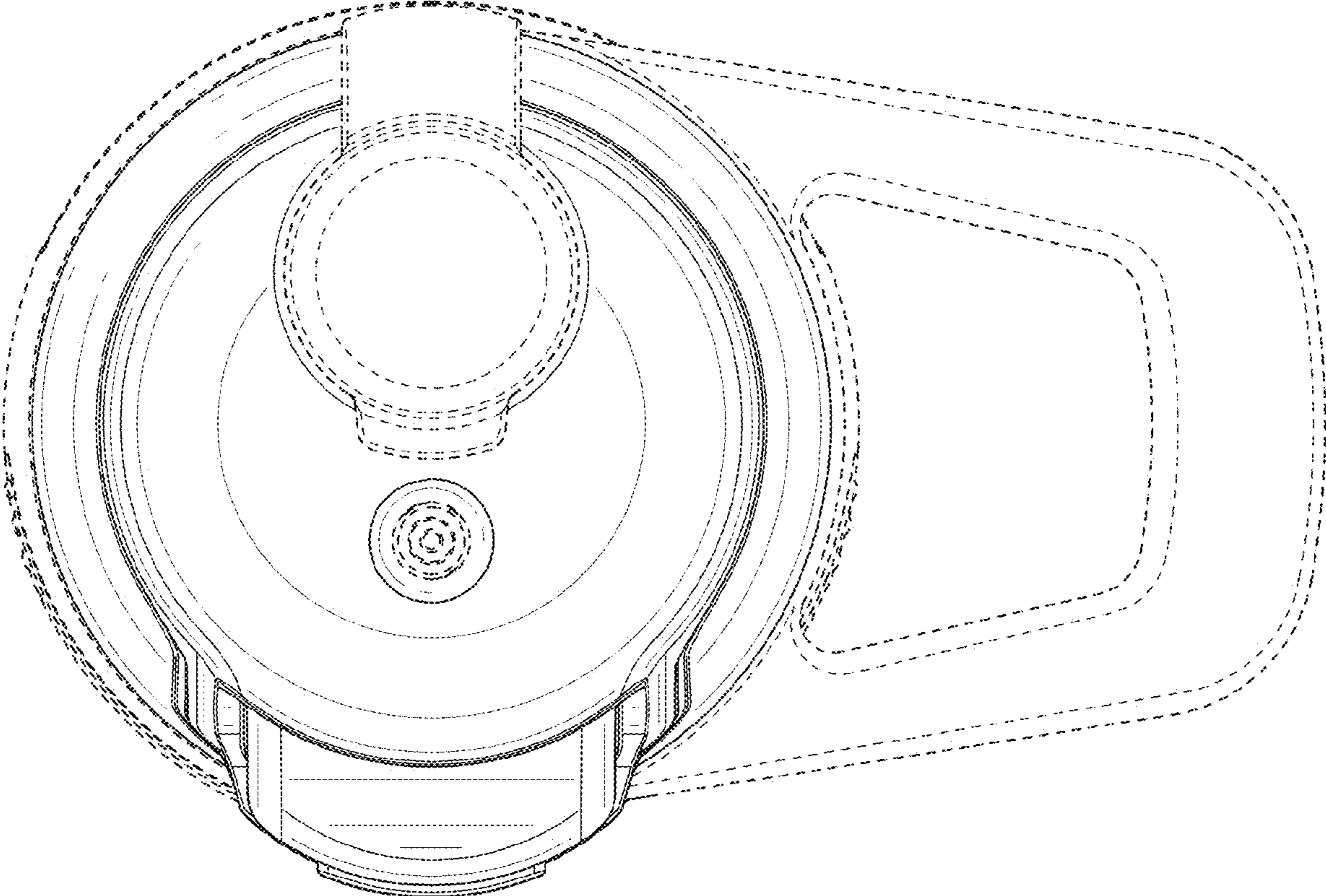

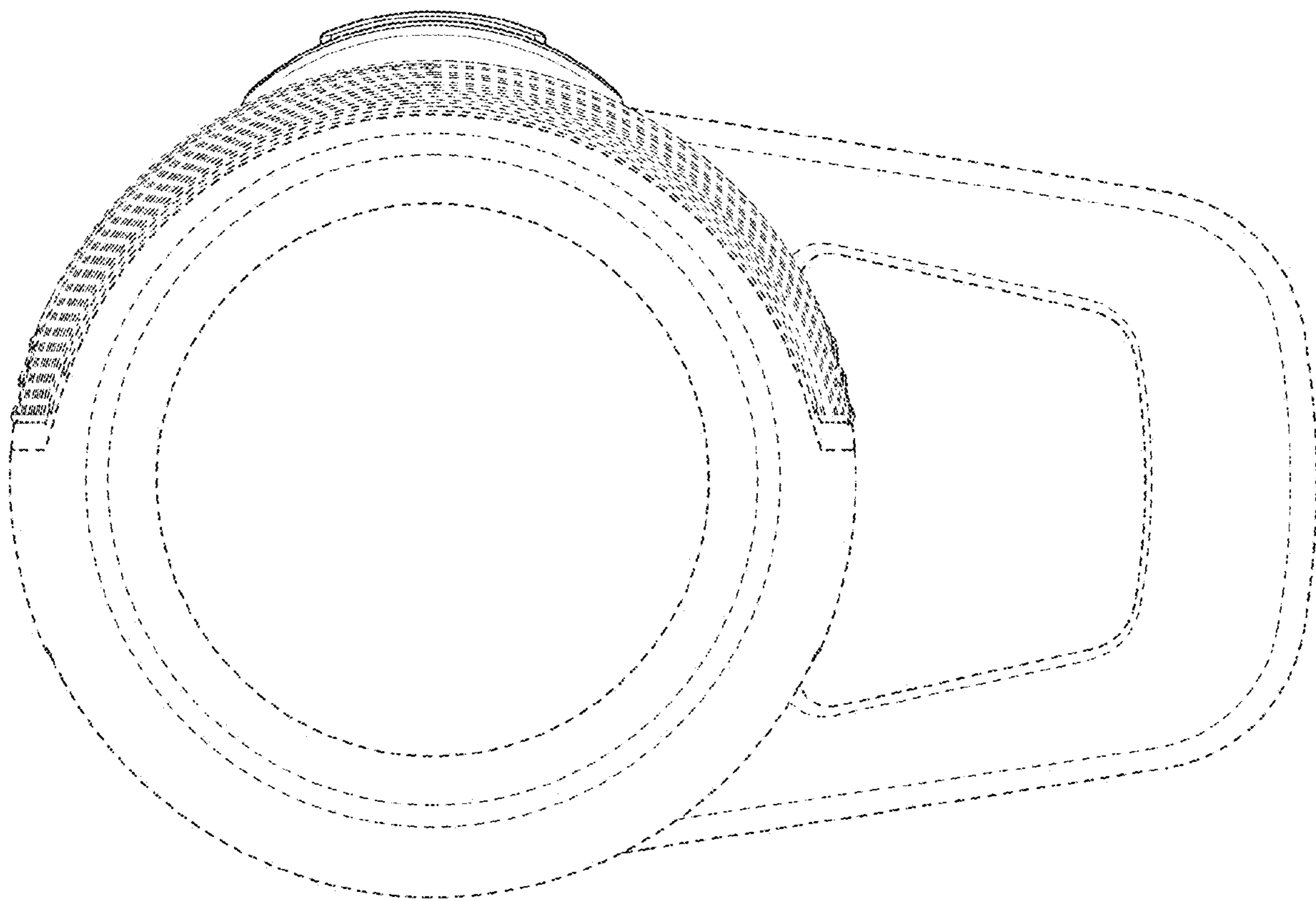
