(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a rearview device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a rearview device of the present disclosure;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of the rearview device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the rearview device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the rearview device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the rearview device of FIG. 1, enlarged for ease of illustration;

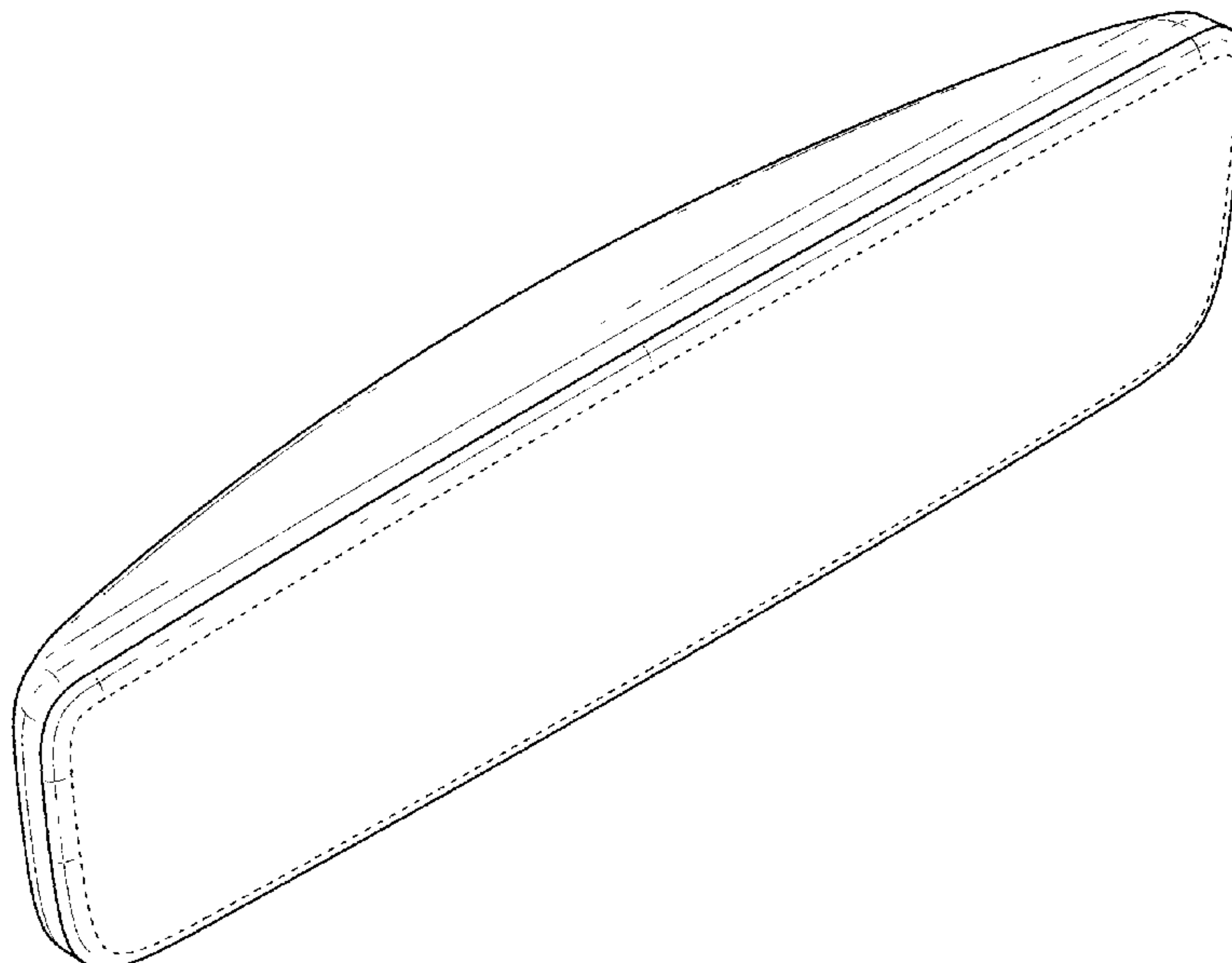
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the rearview device of FIG. 1, enlarged for ease of illustration;

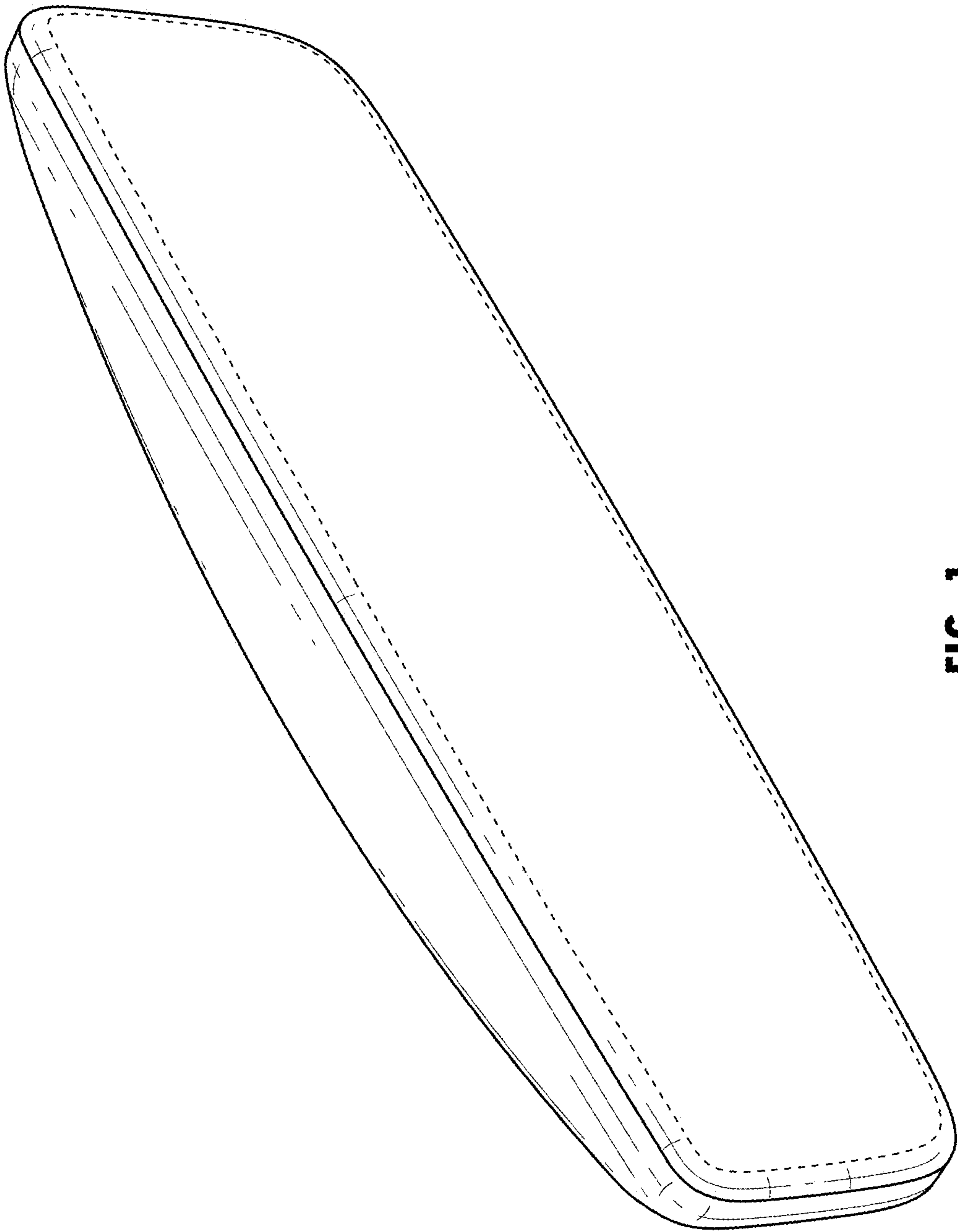

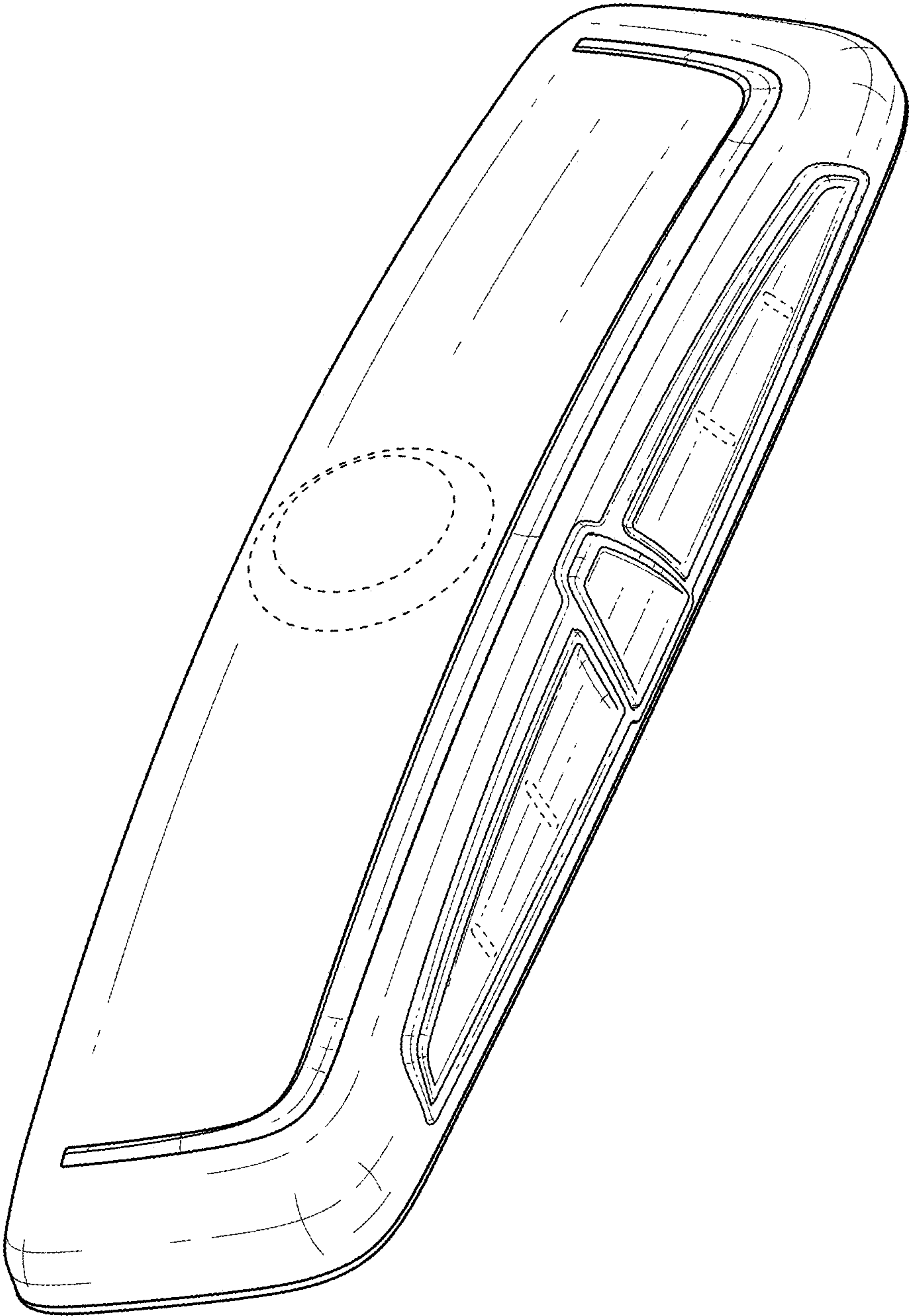

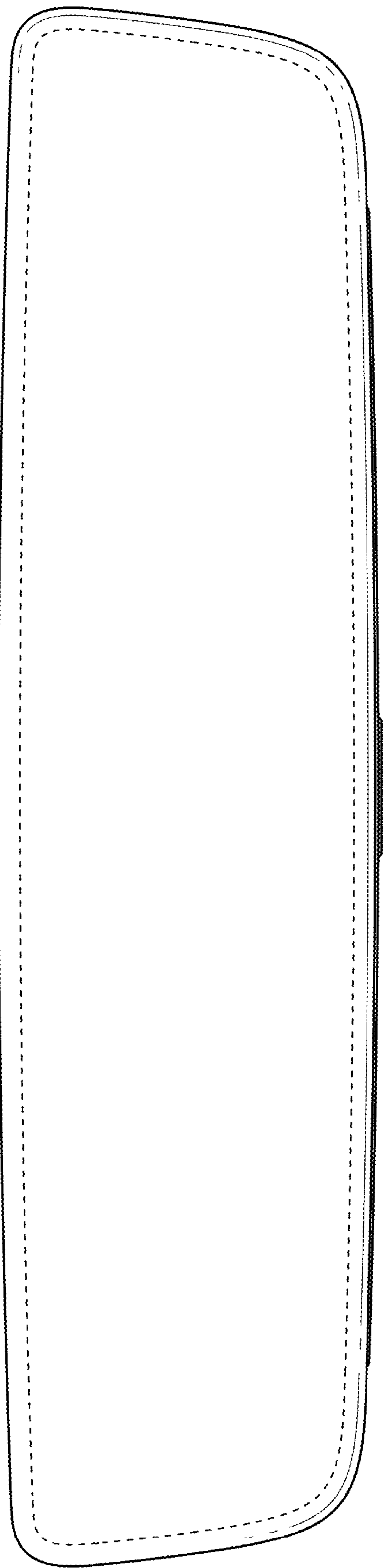

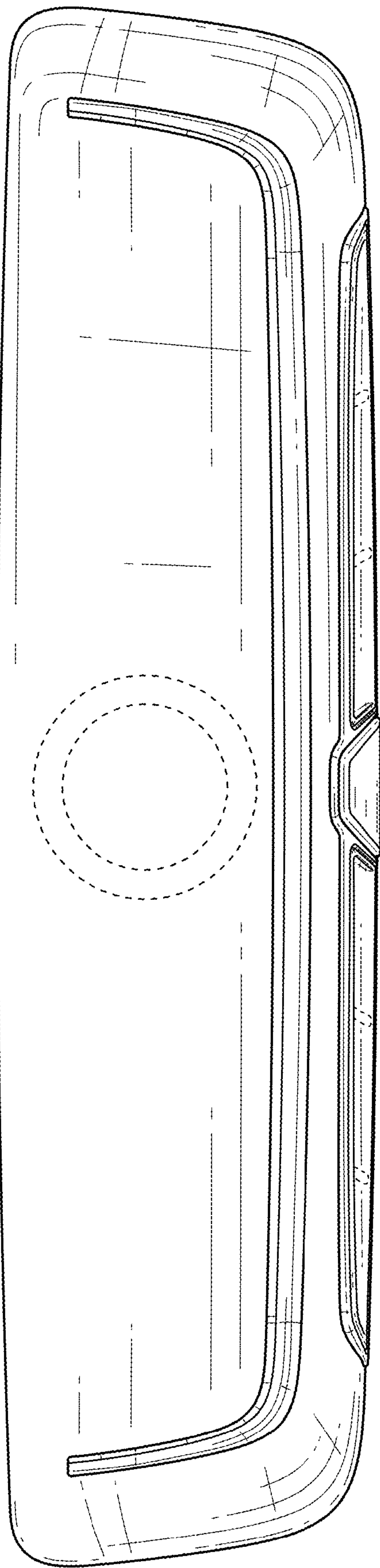

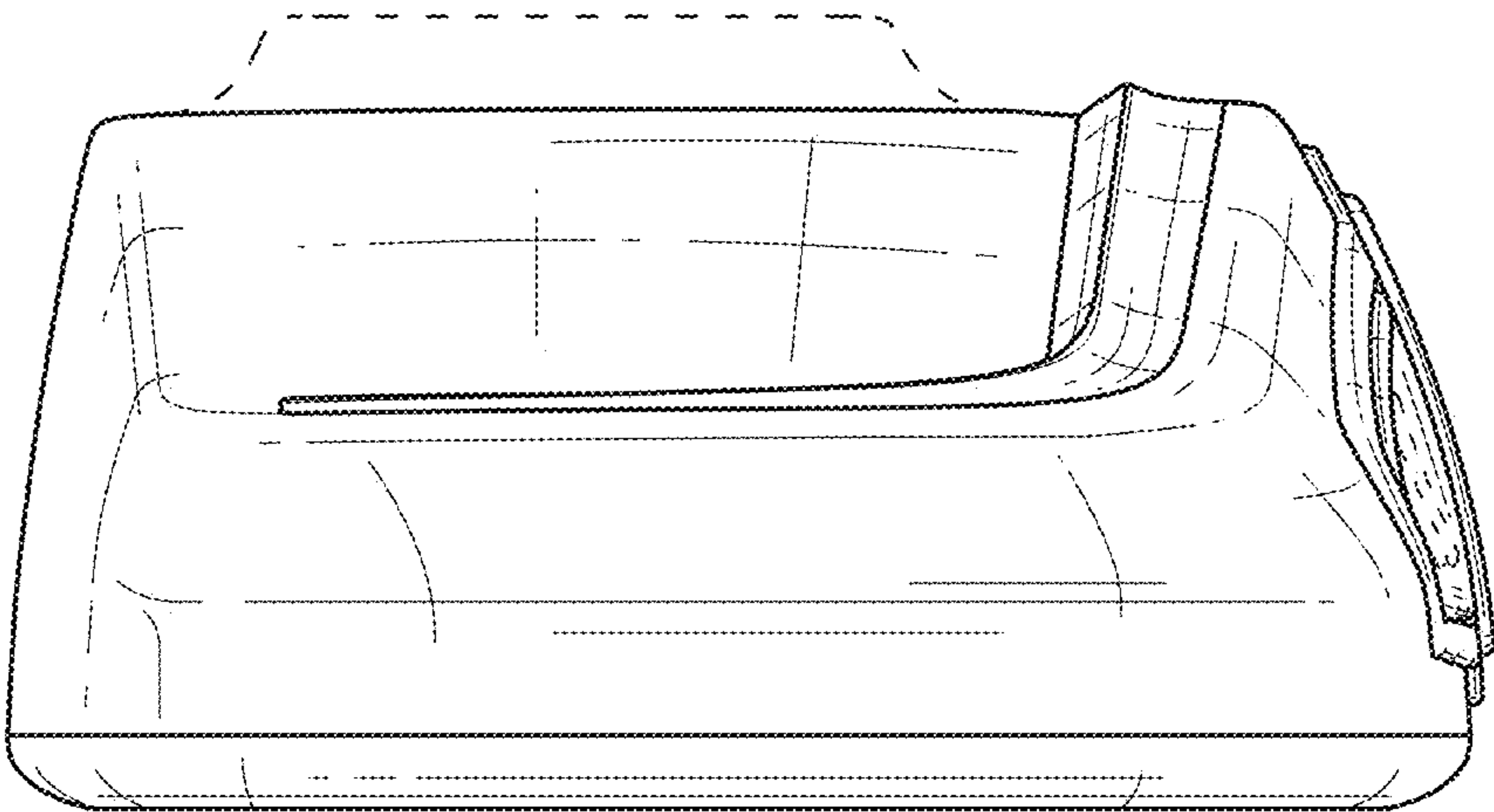

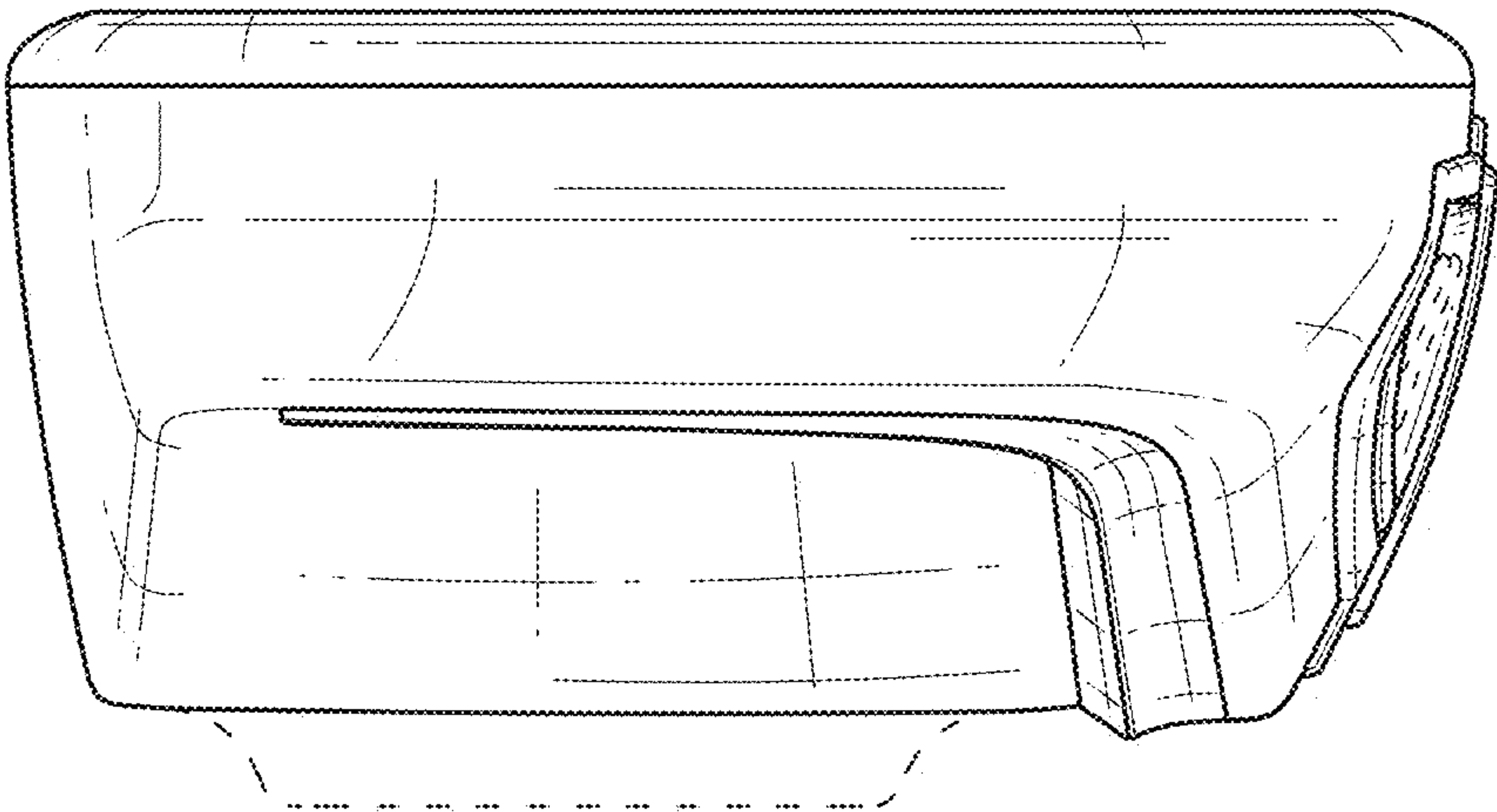

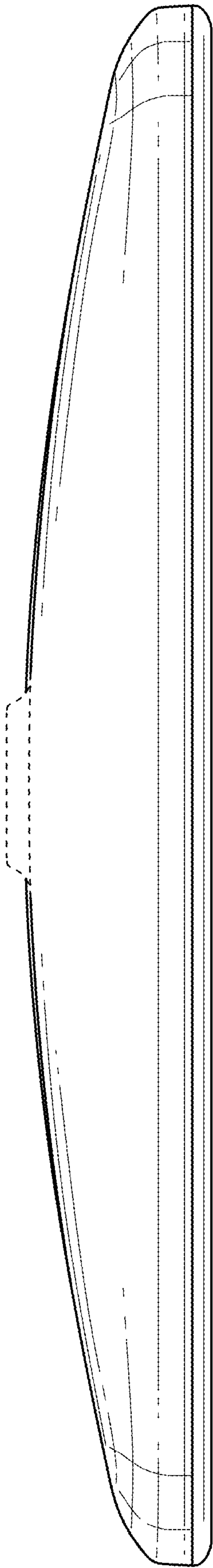

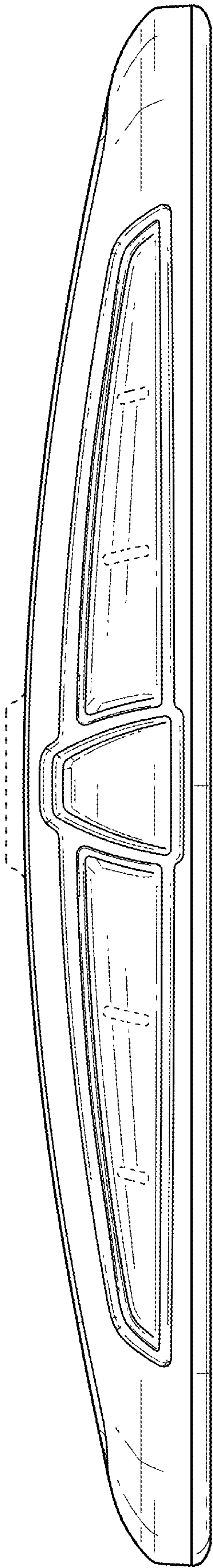
