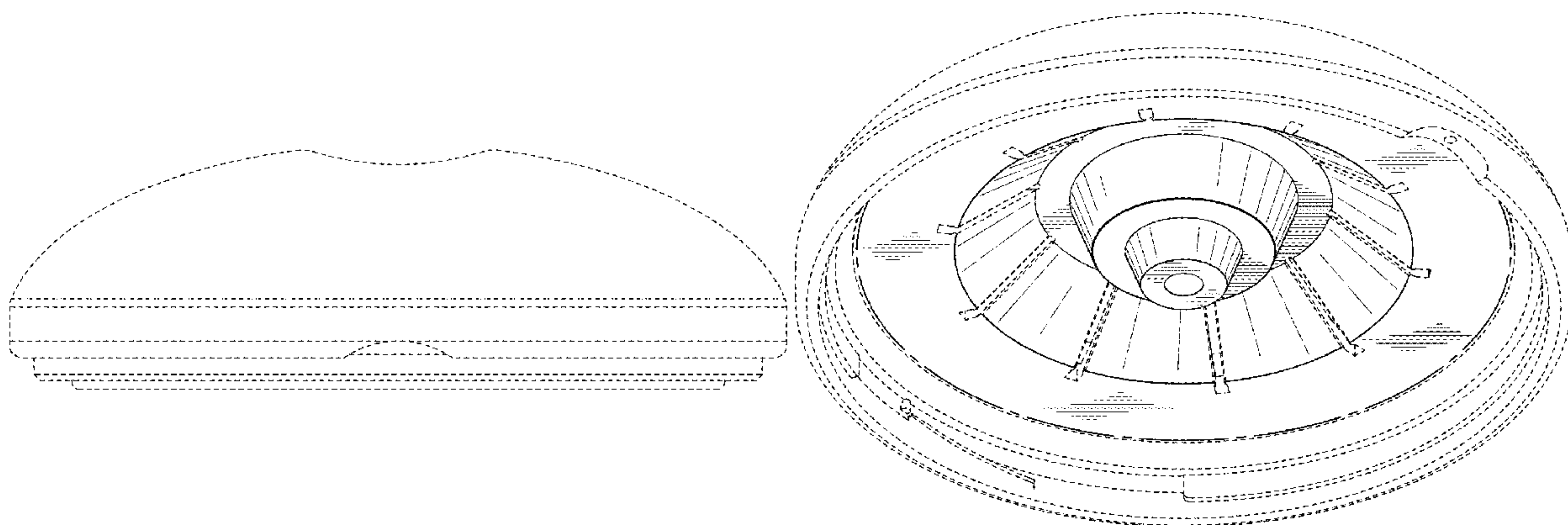


FIG. 18 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 15;

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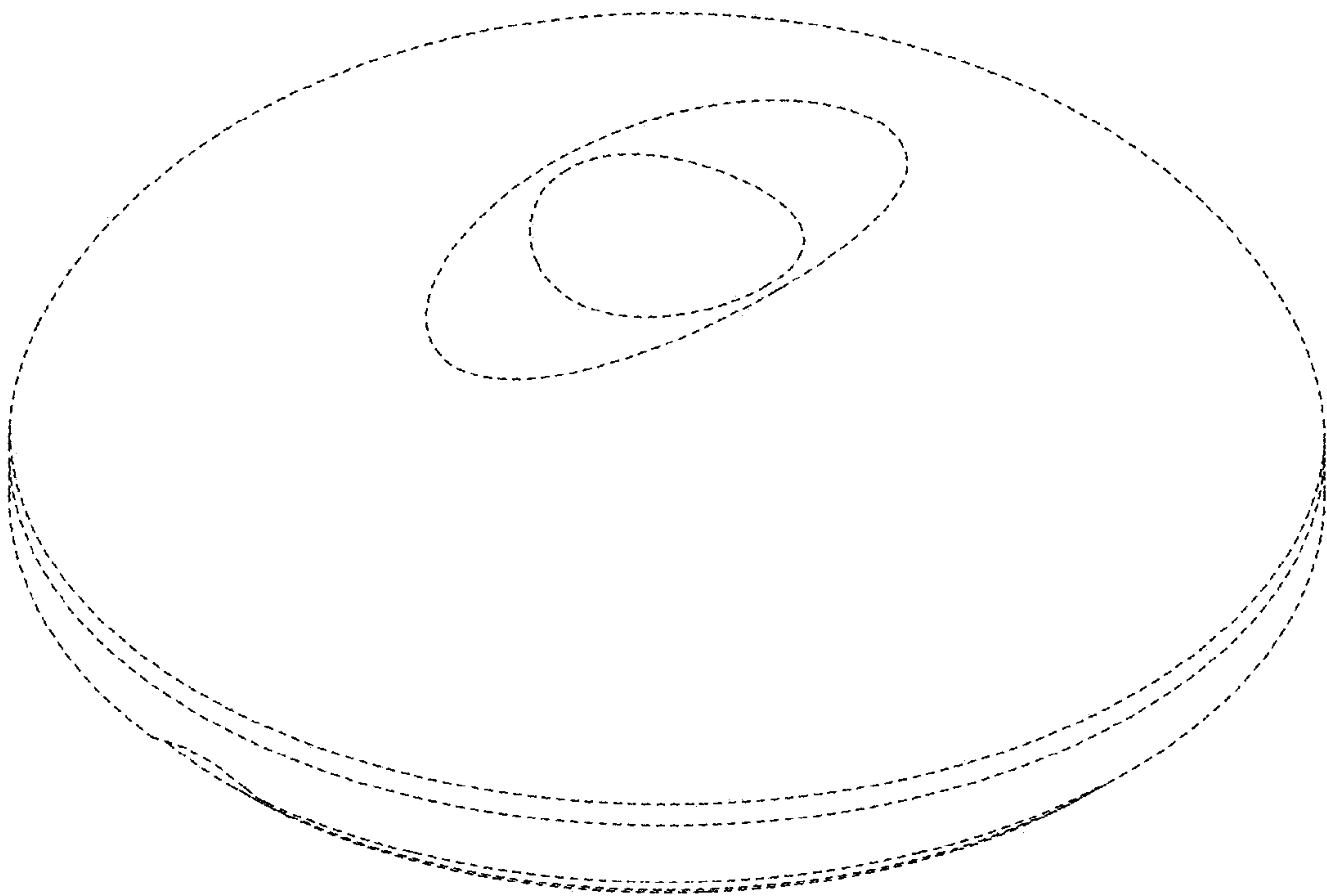

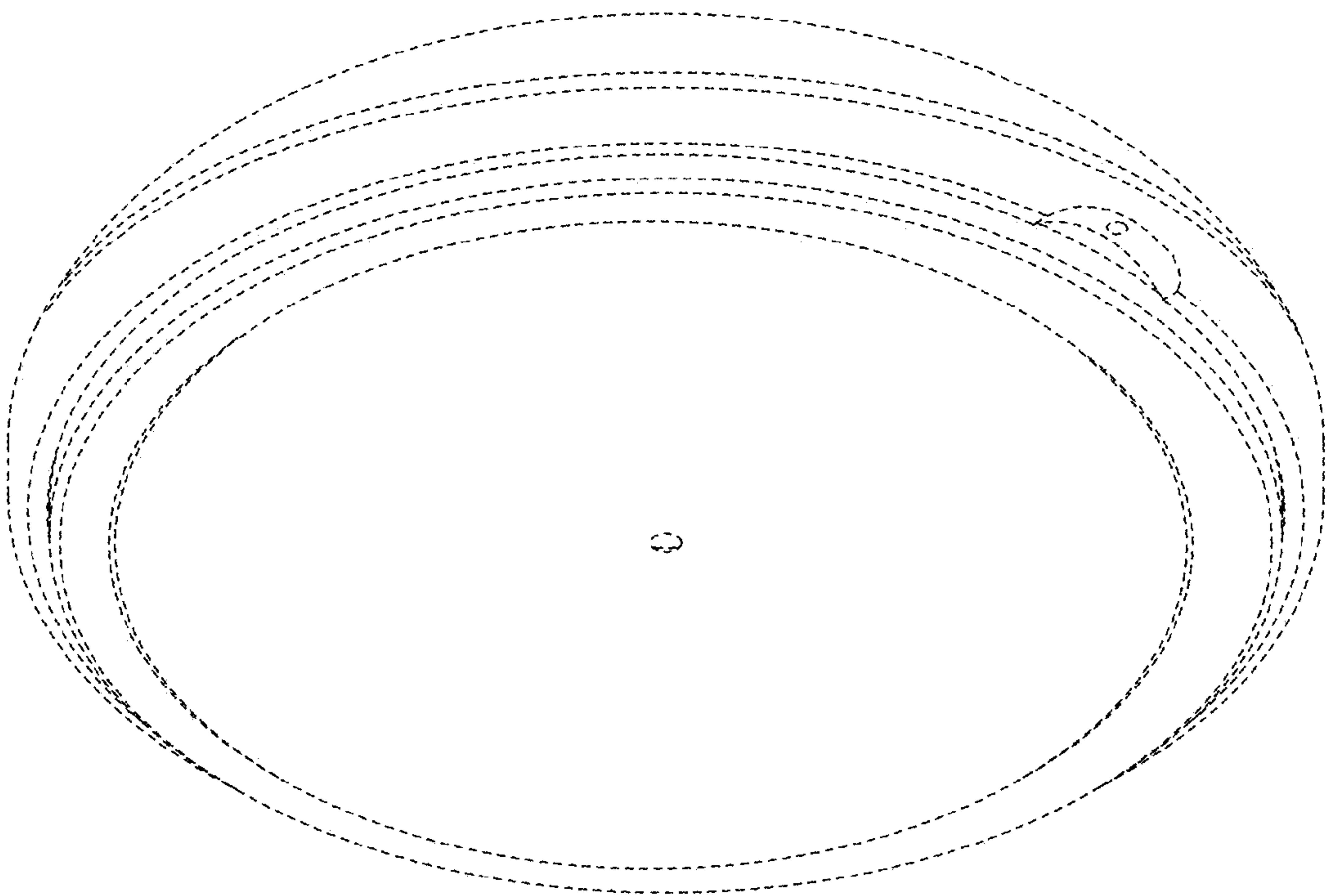

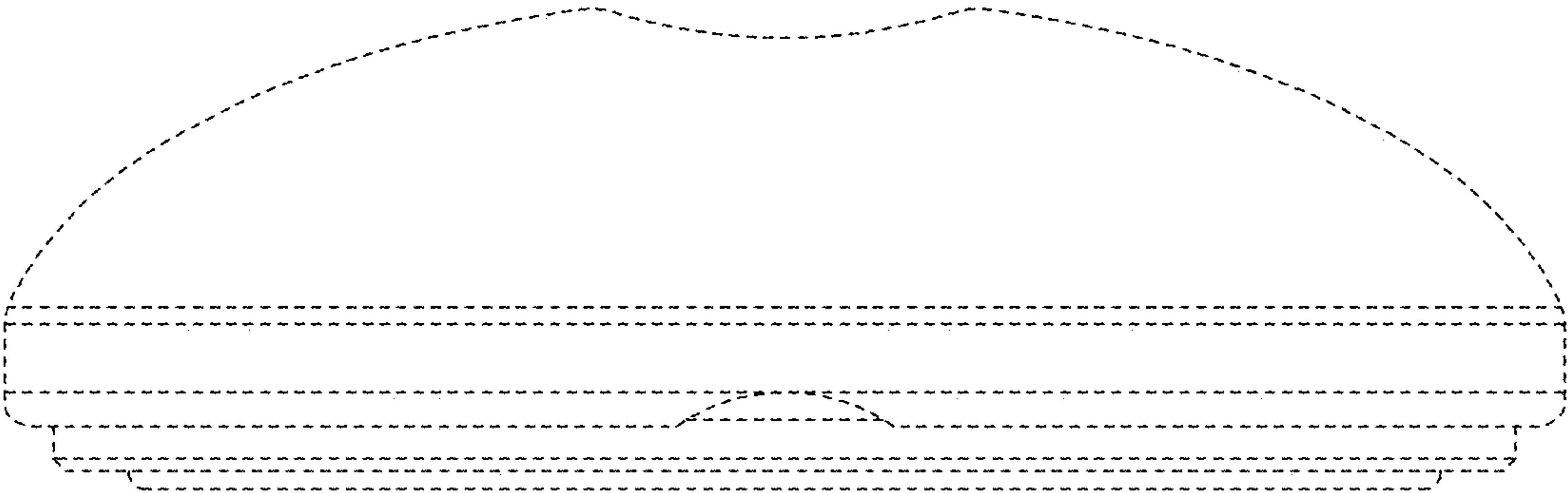

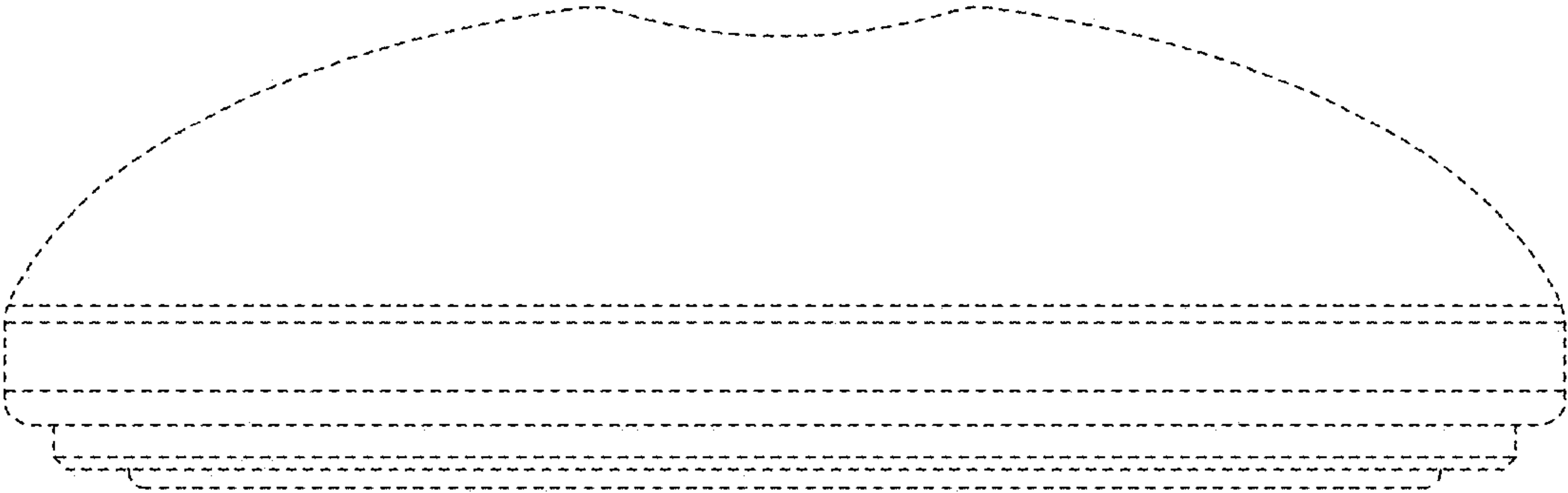

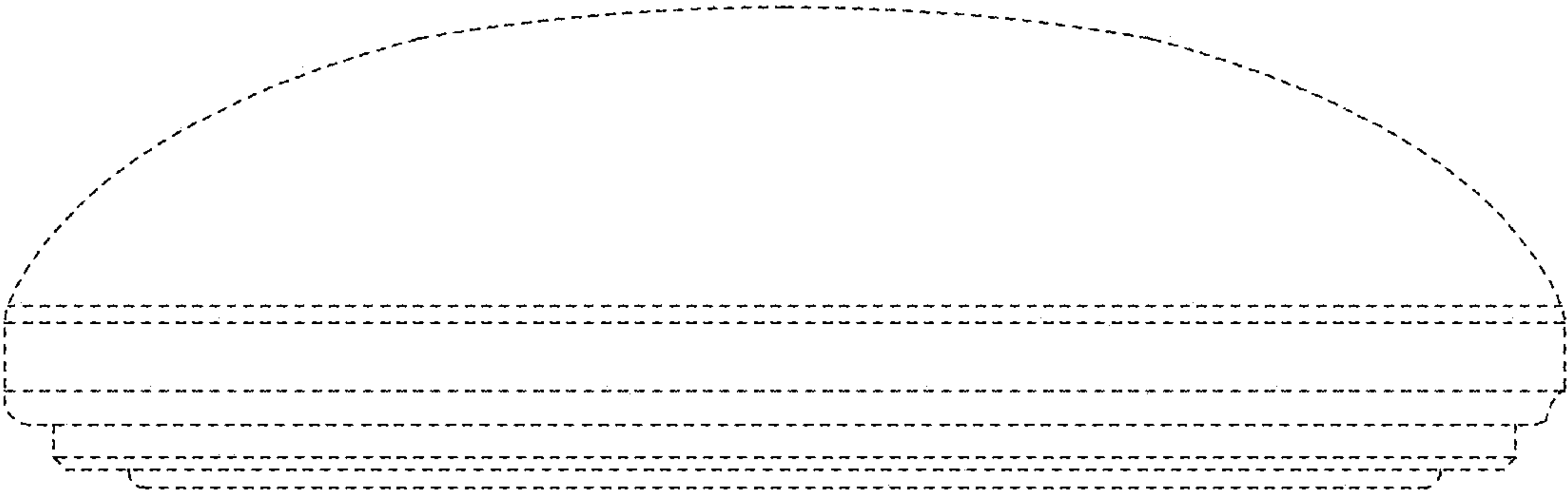

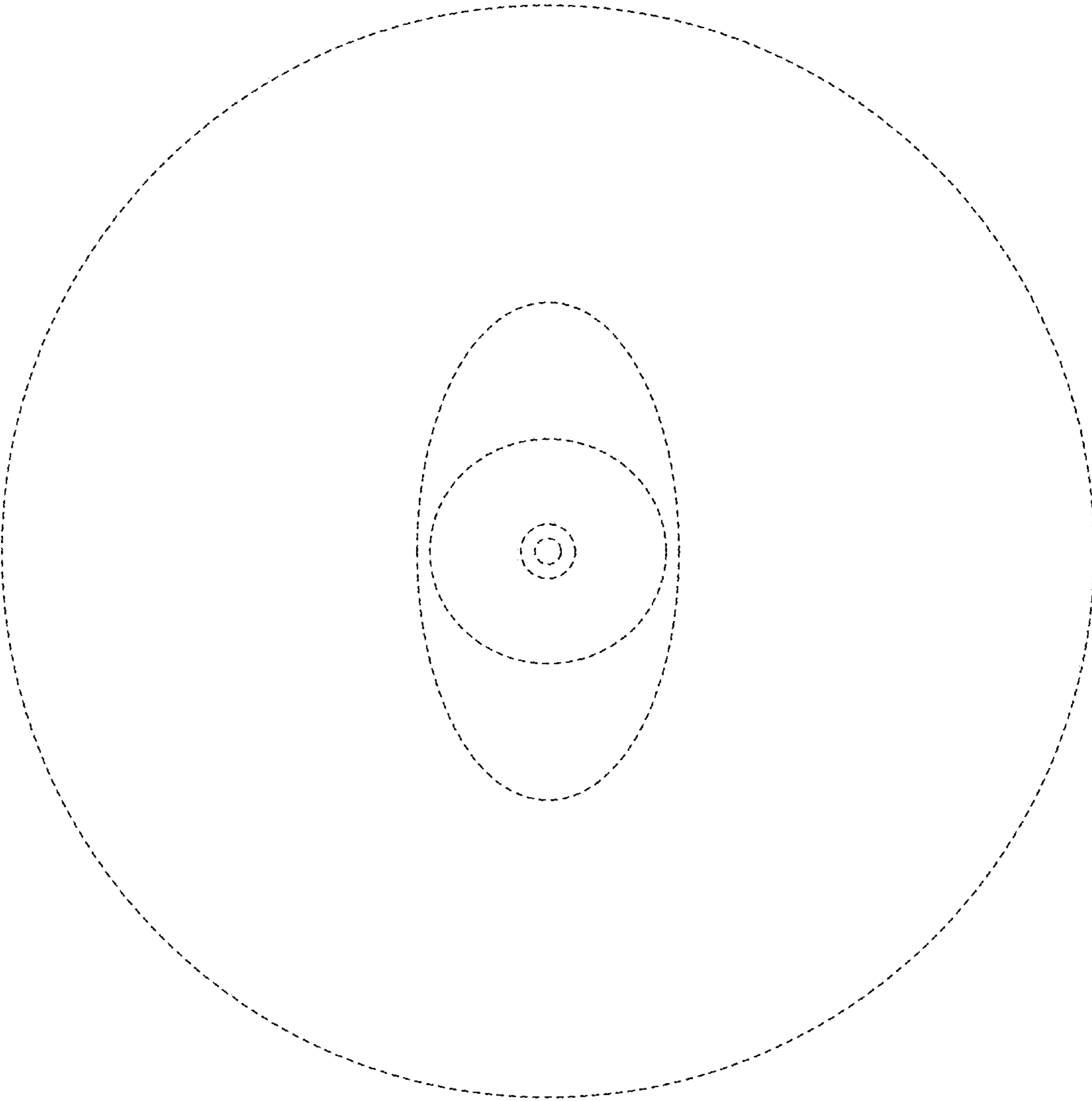

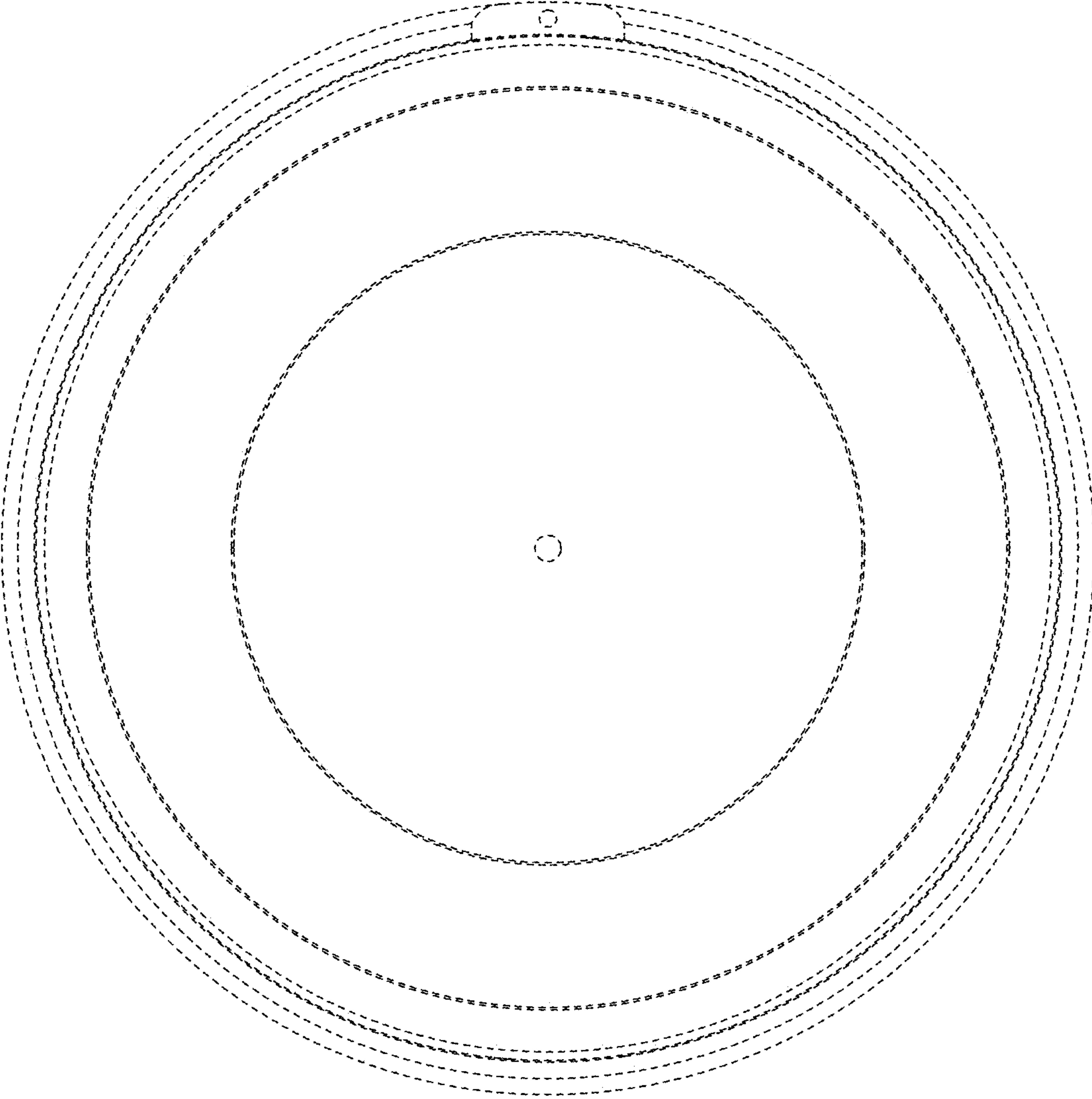

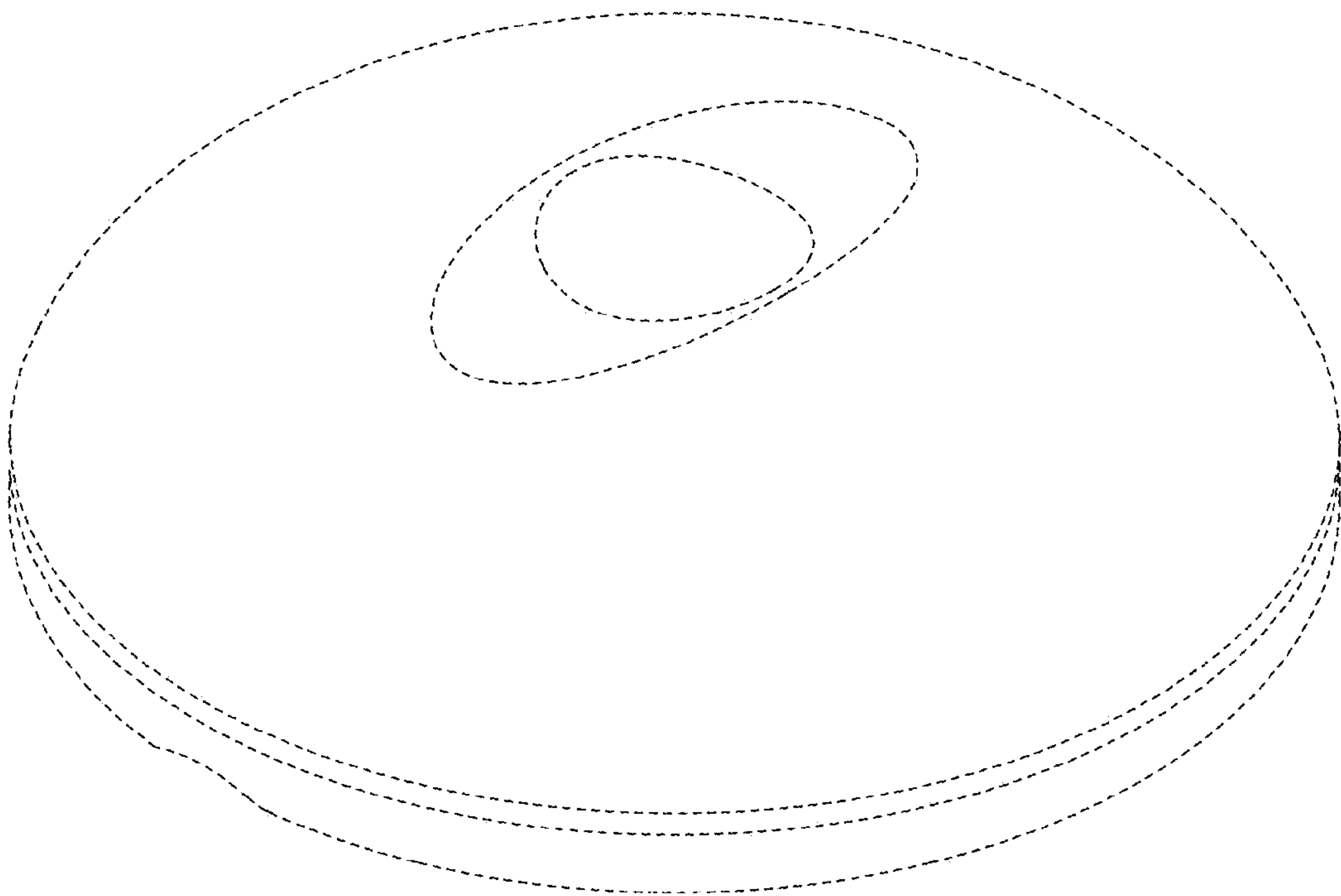

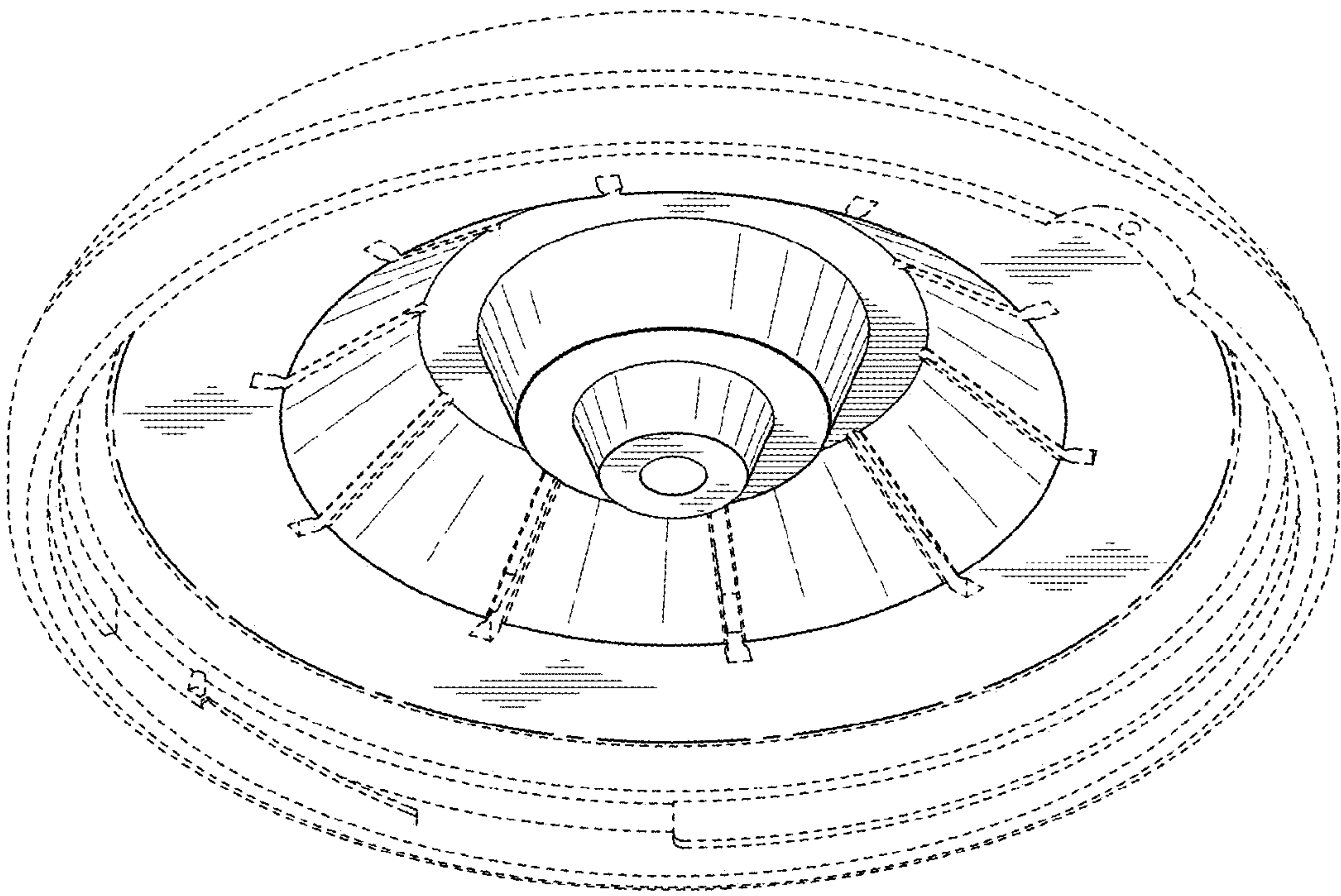

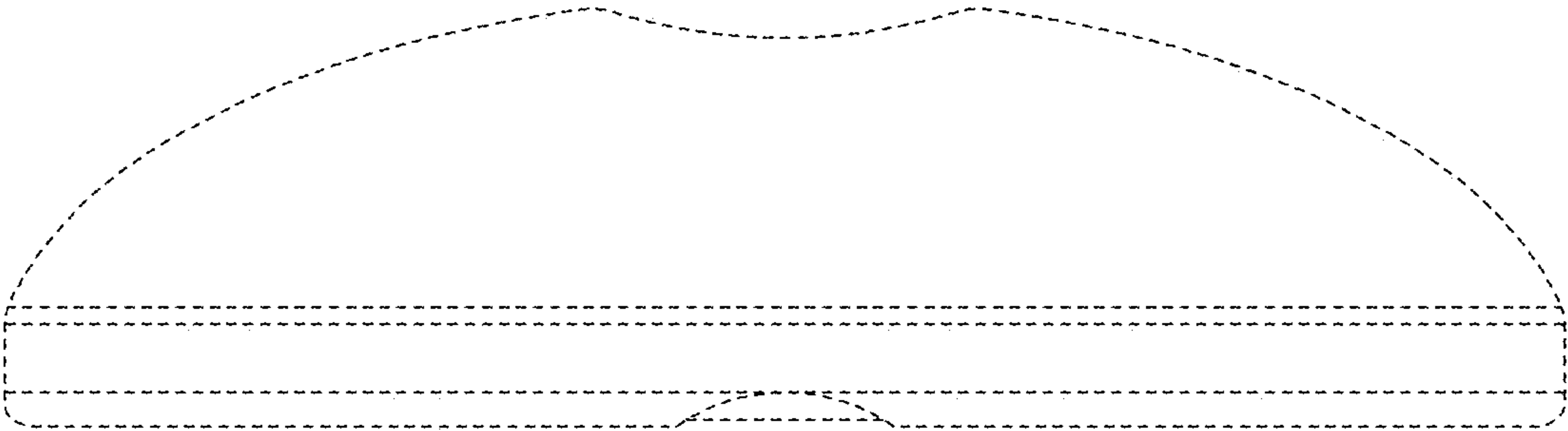

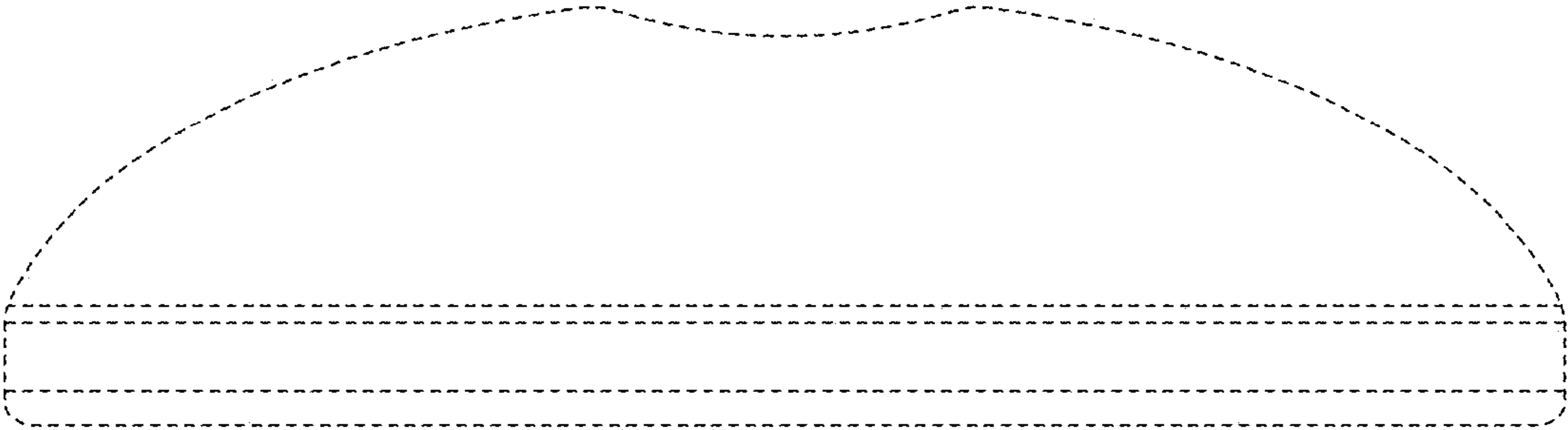

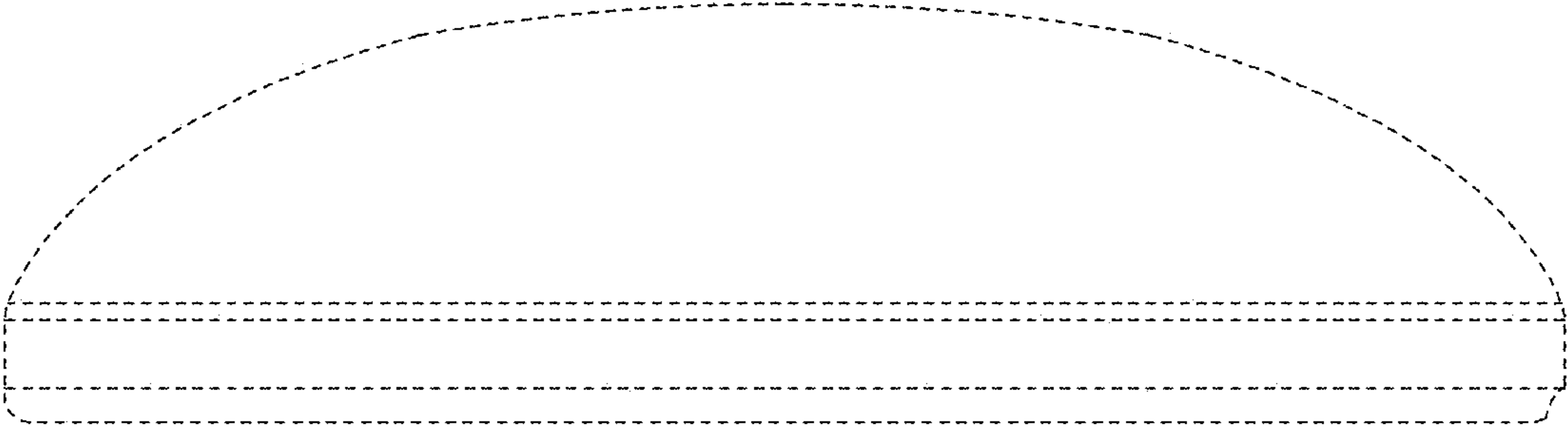

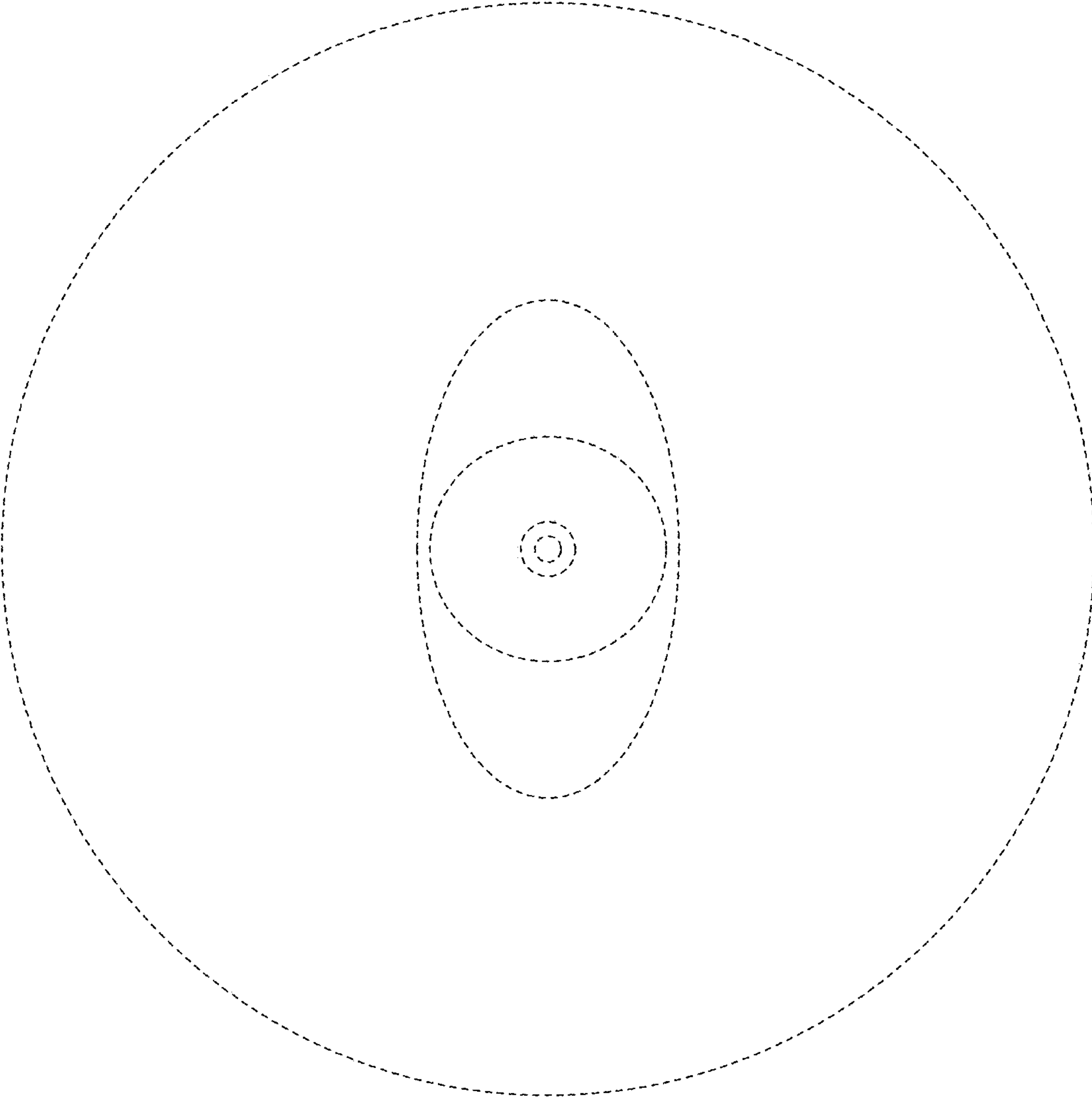

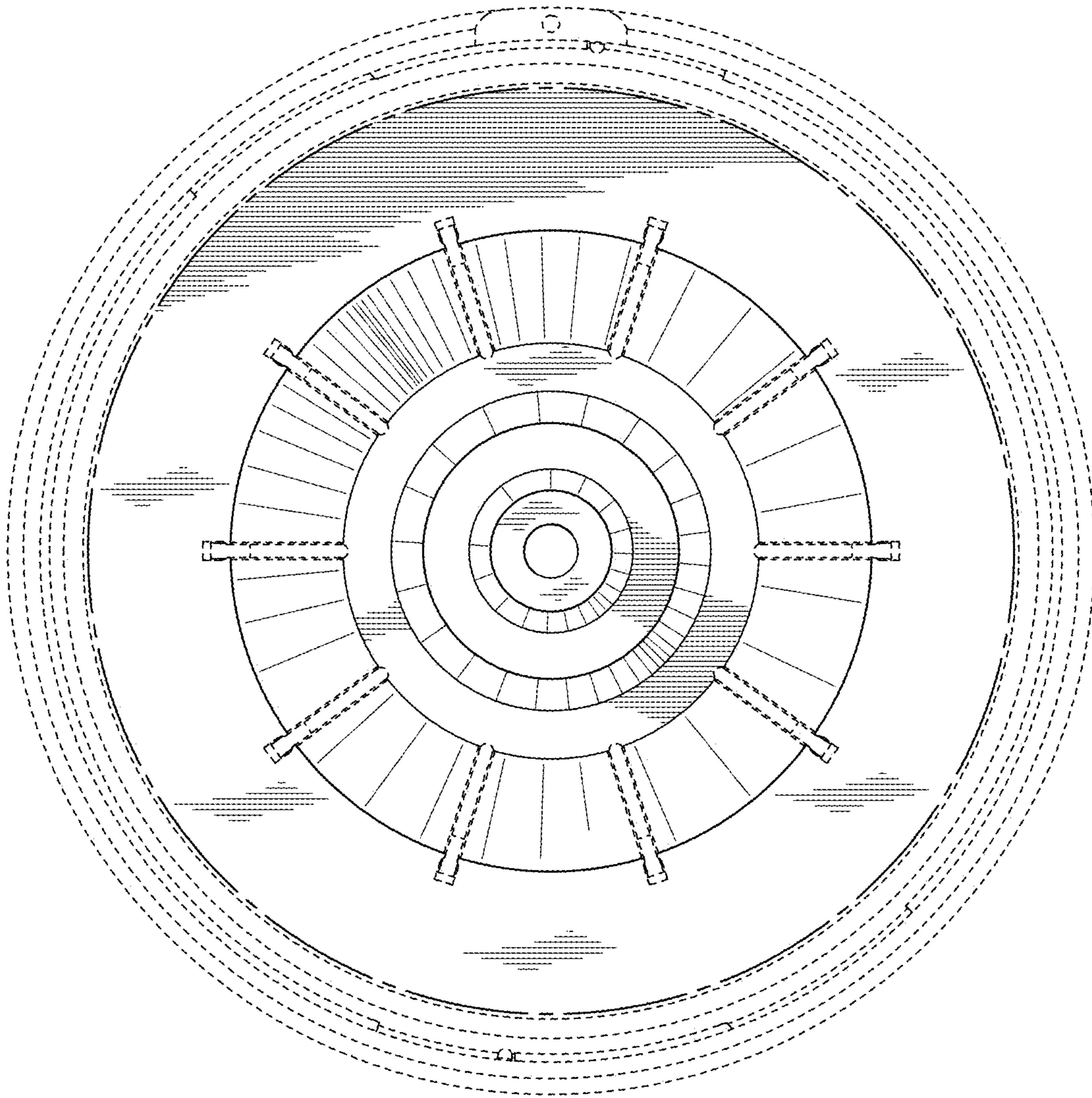

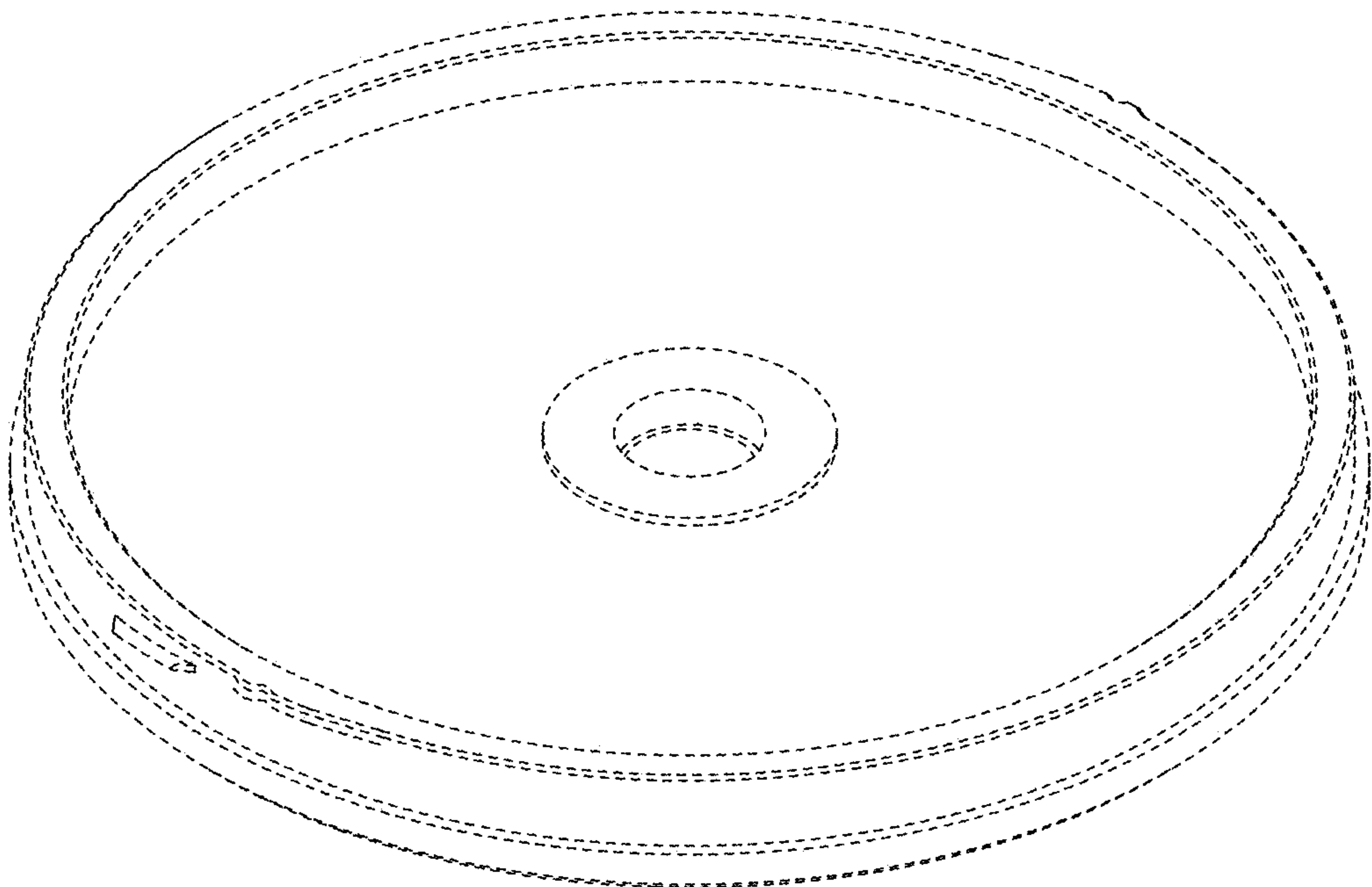

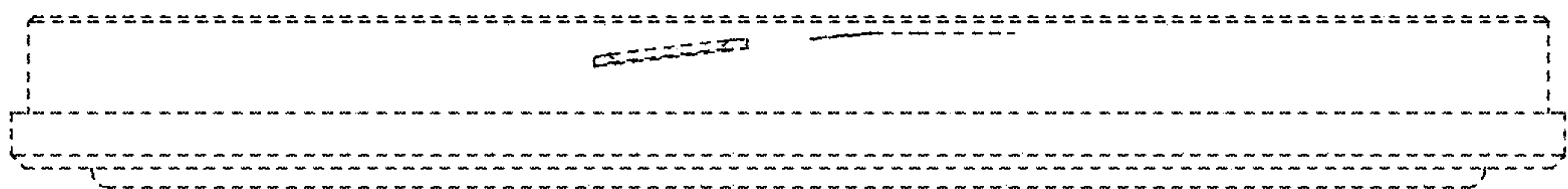

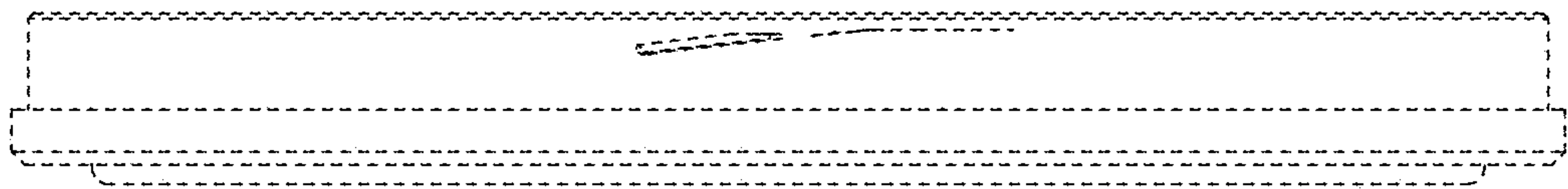

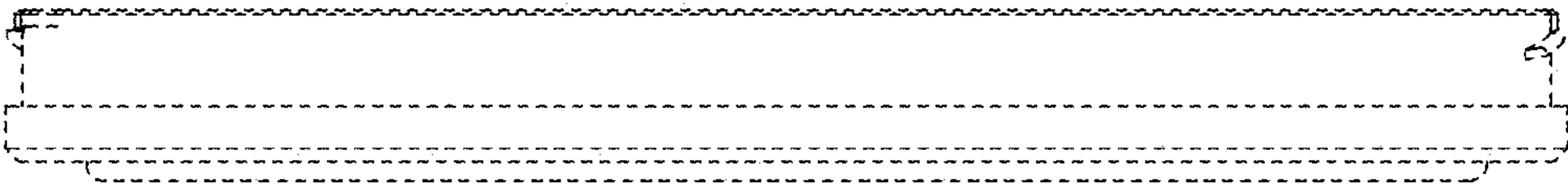

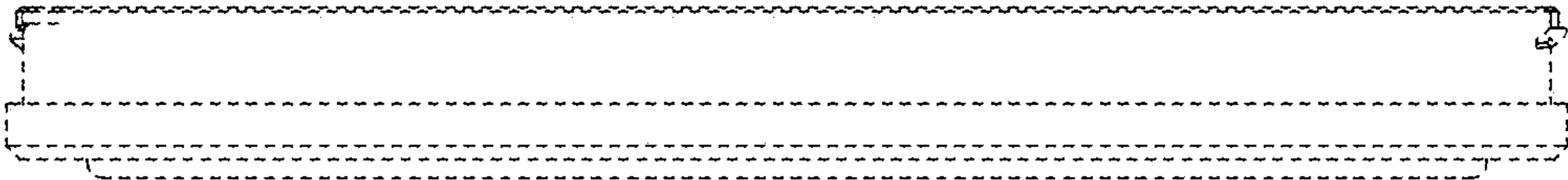

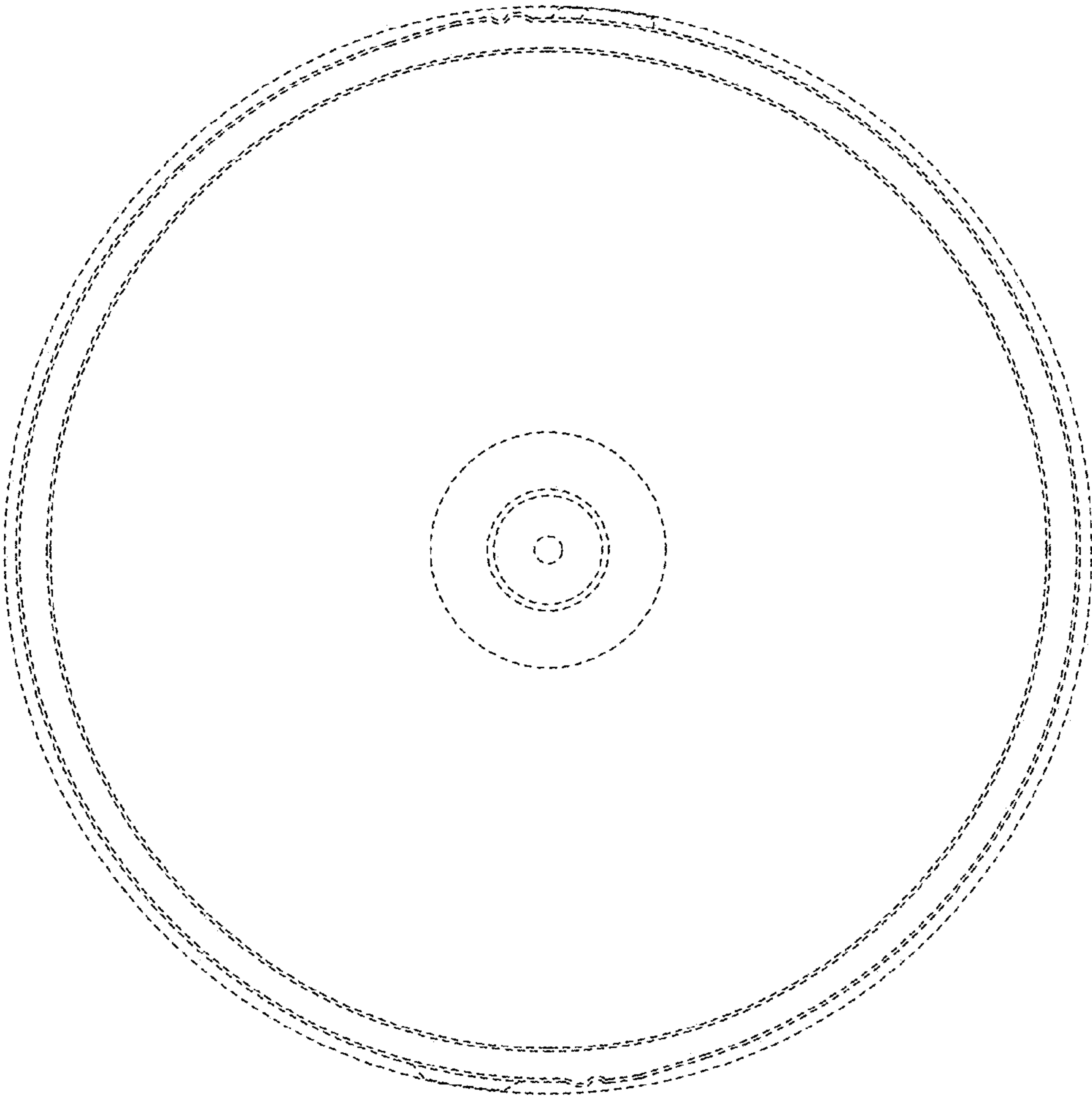

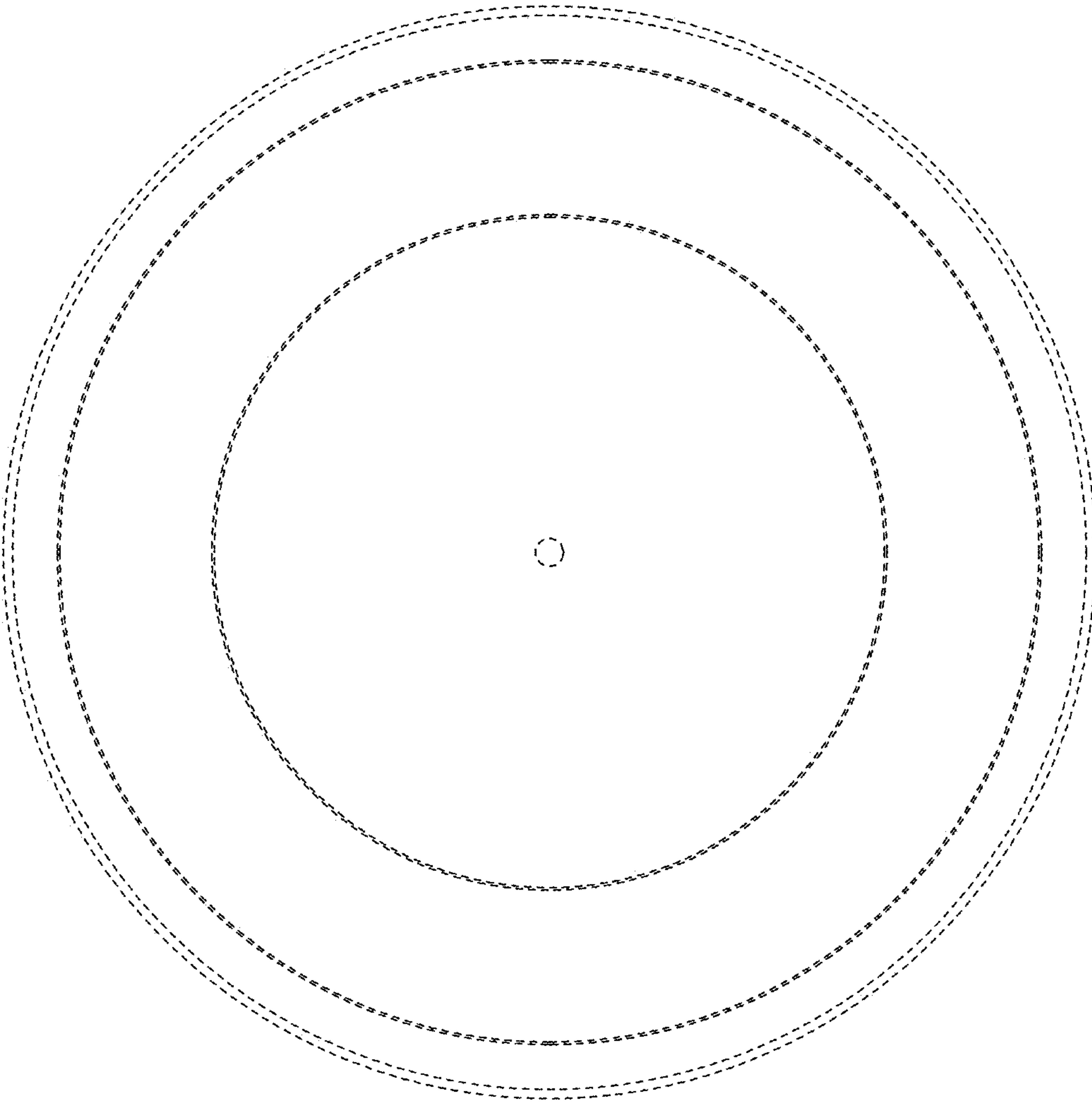

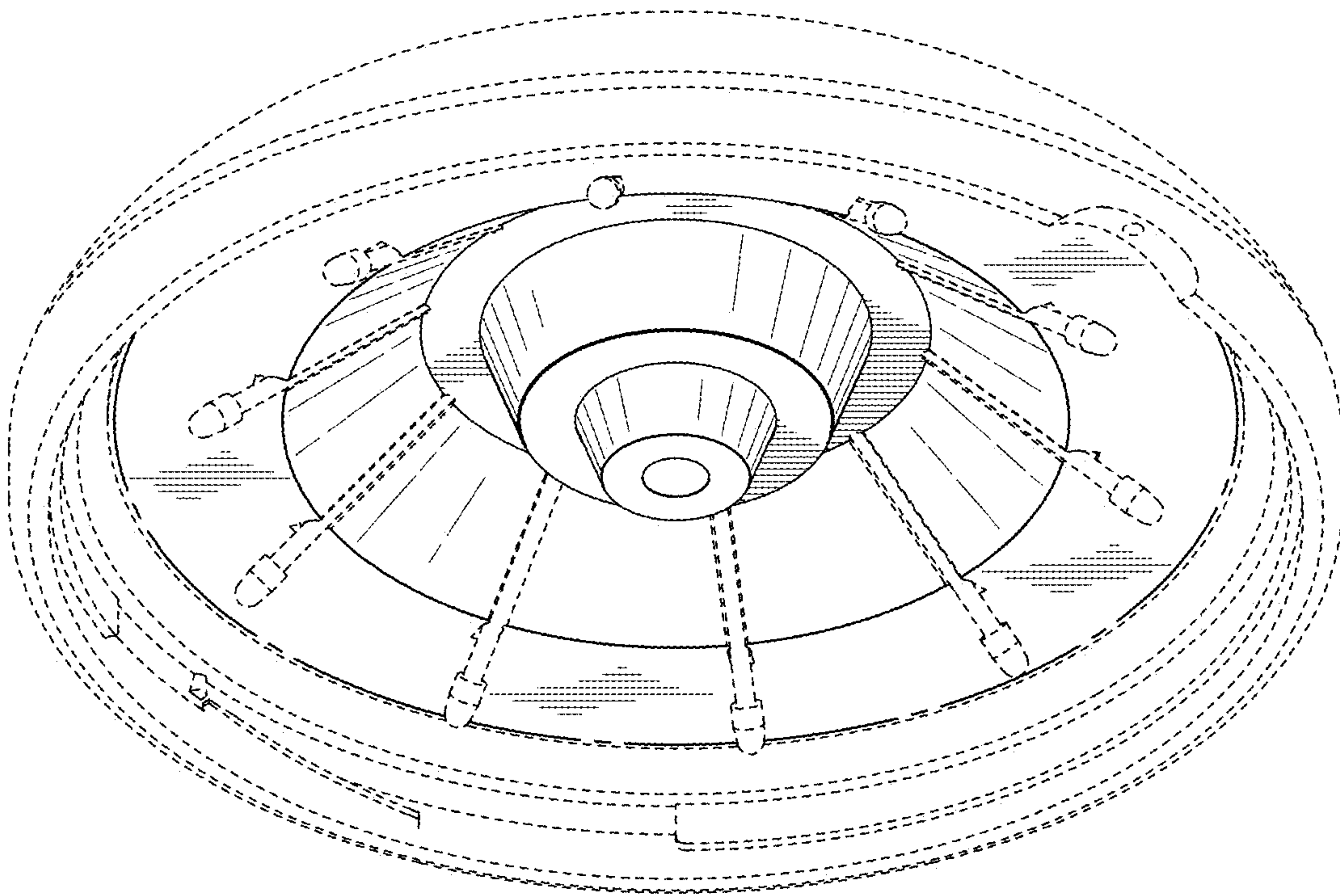
