FIG. 14 is an opposite side view thereof;

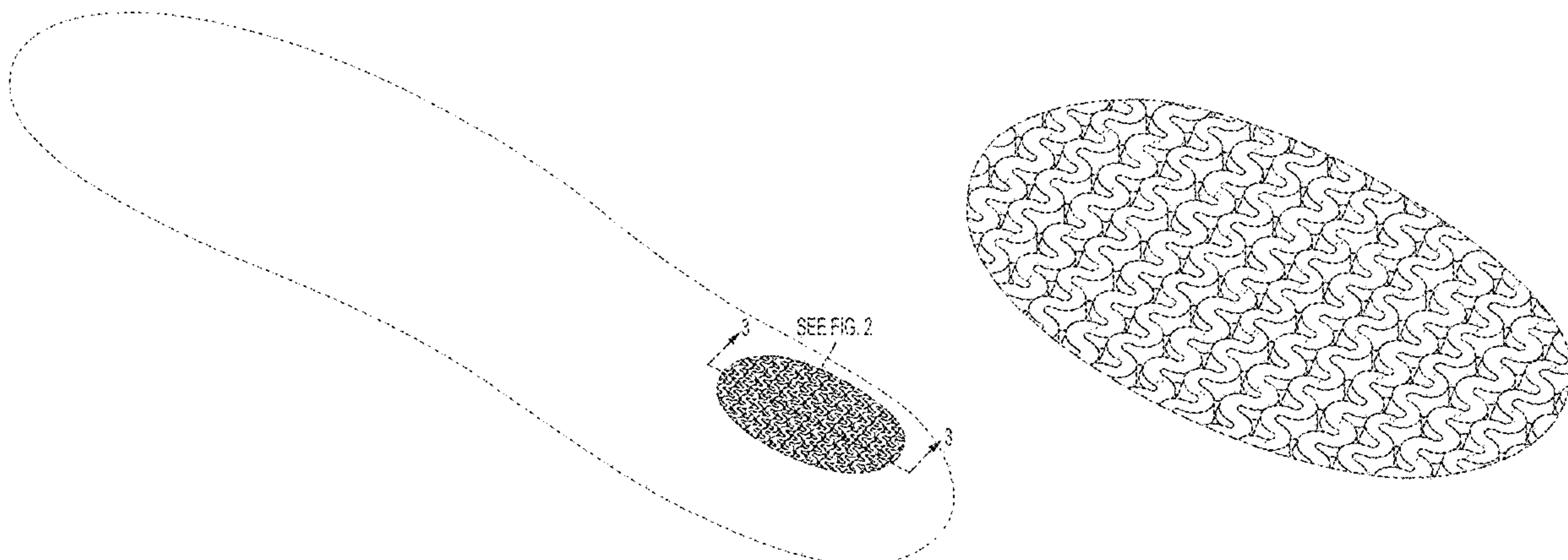
FIG. 15 is a front view thereof; and,

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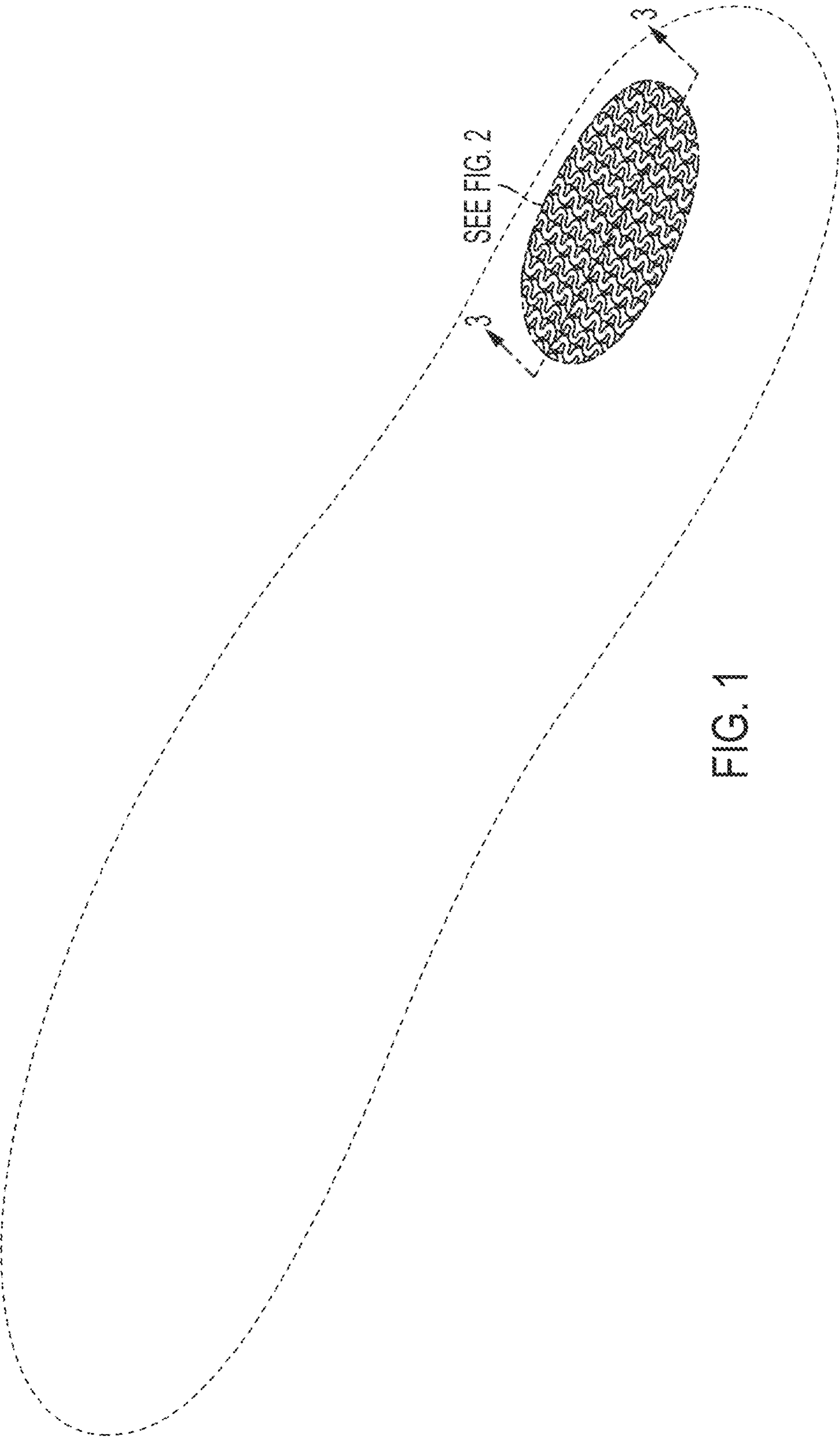

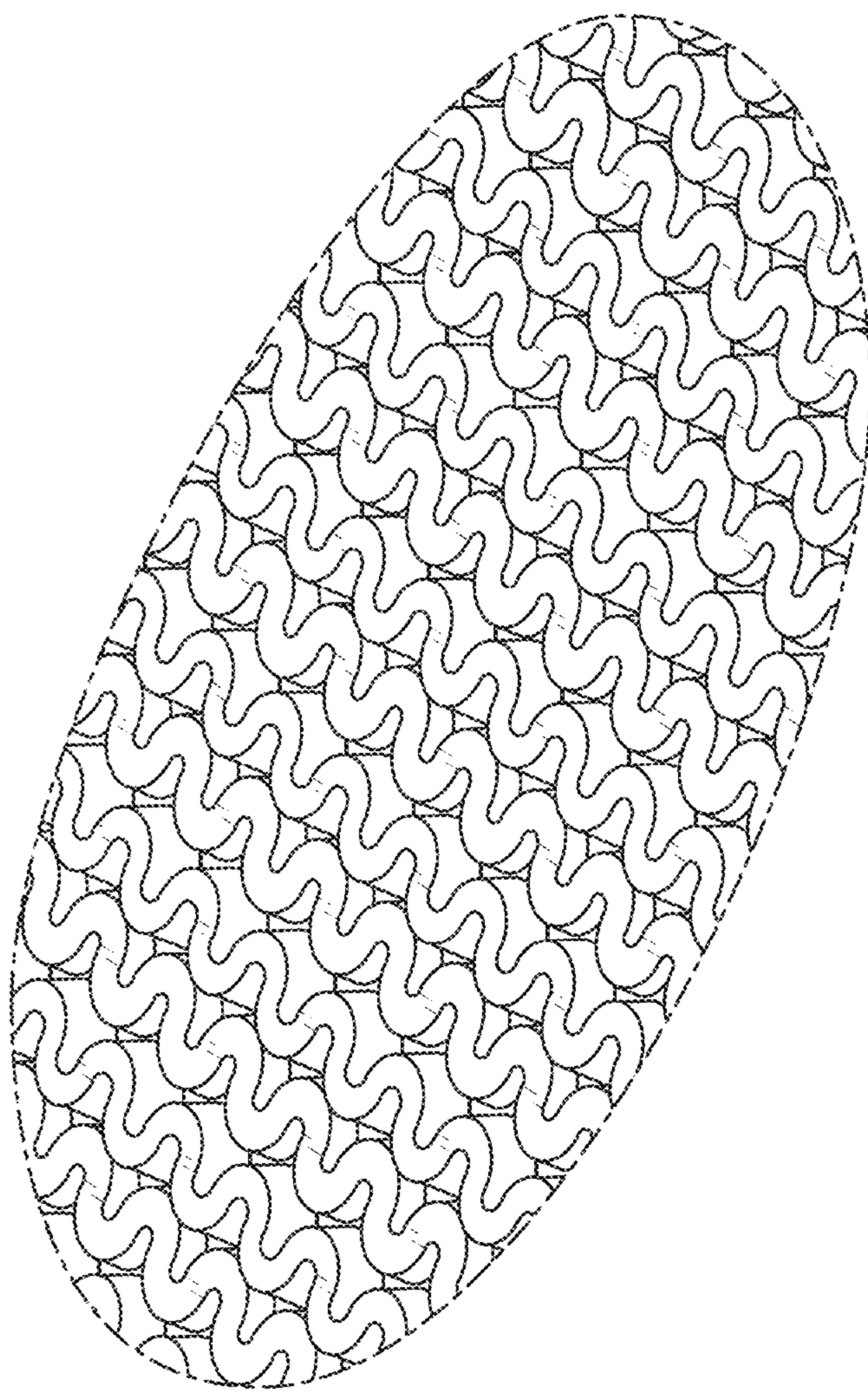

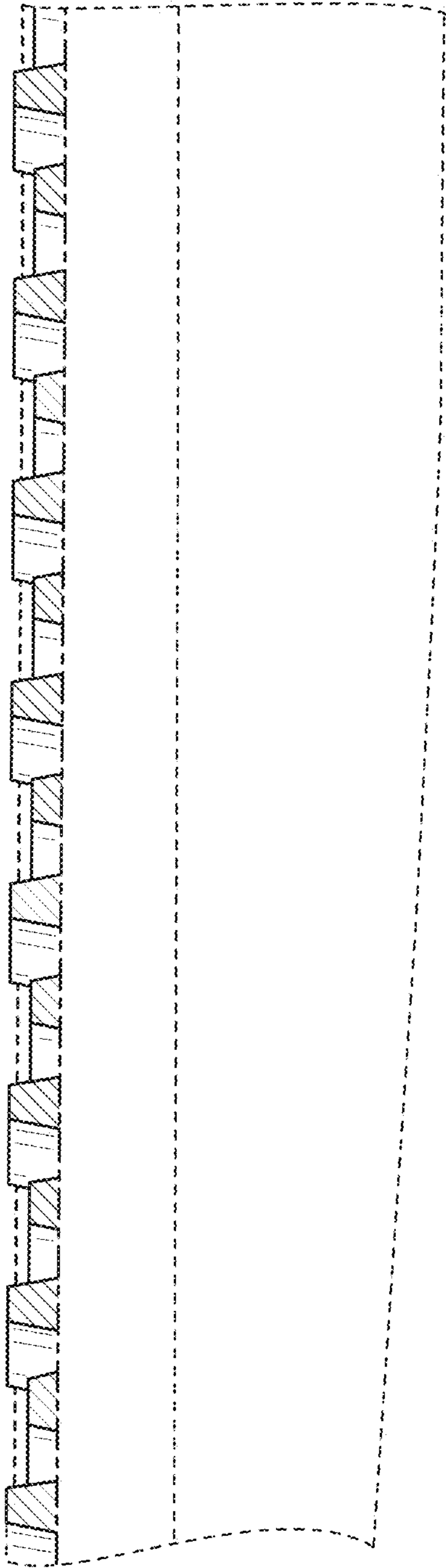

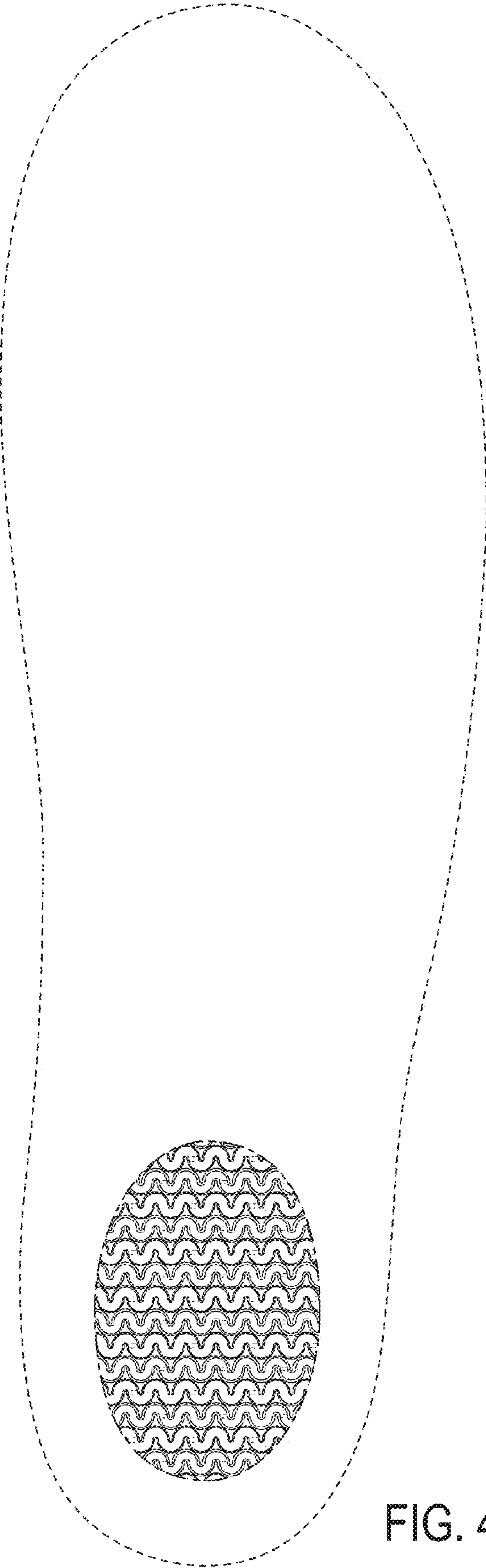

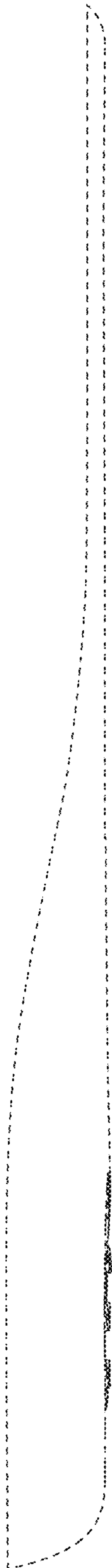
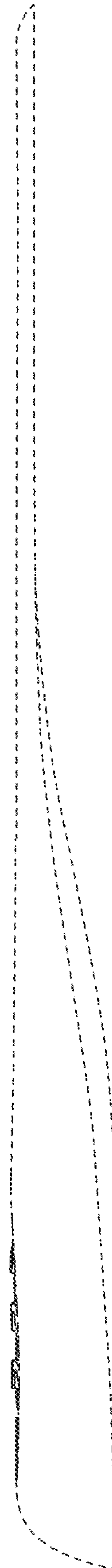

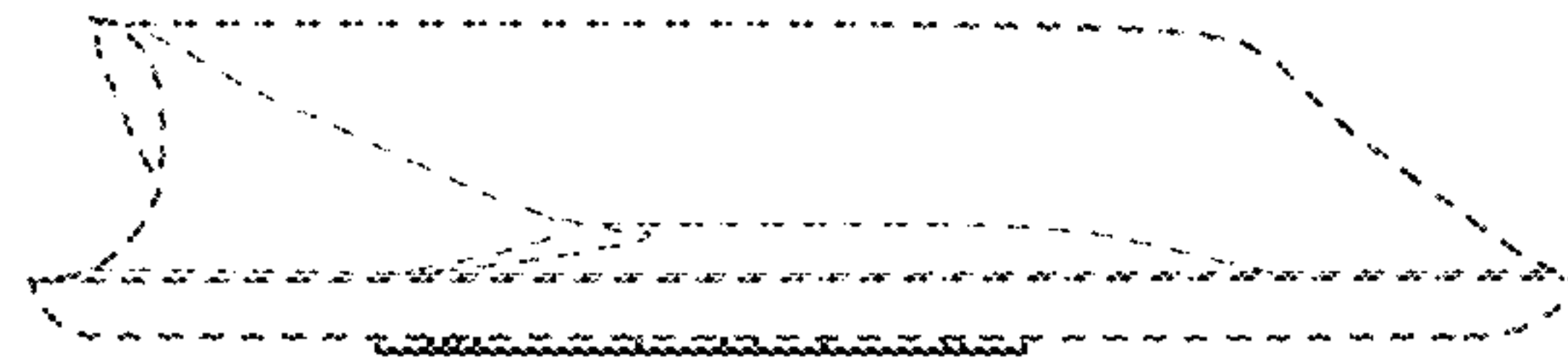

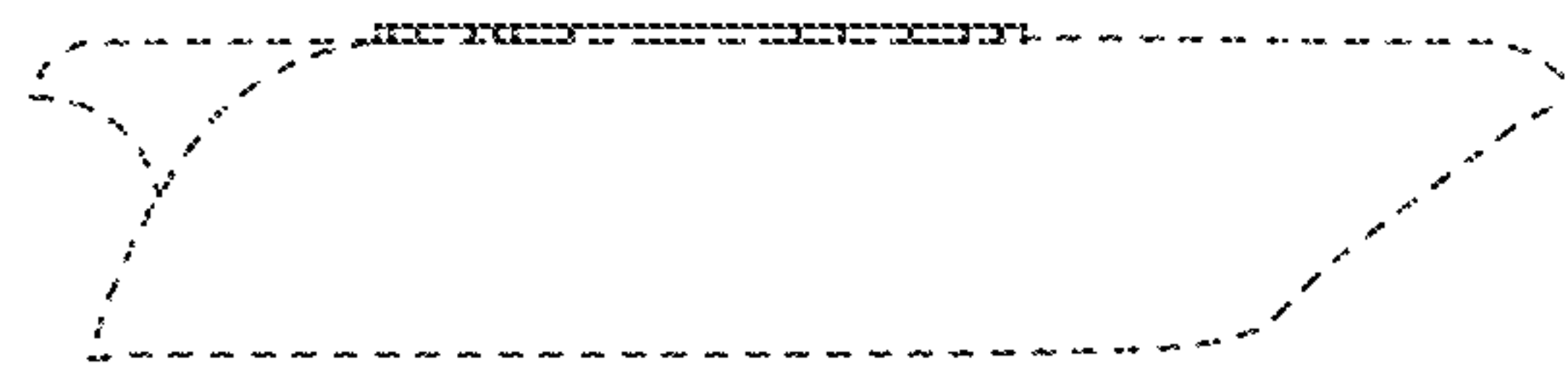

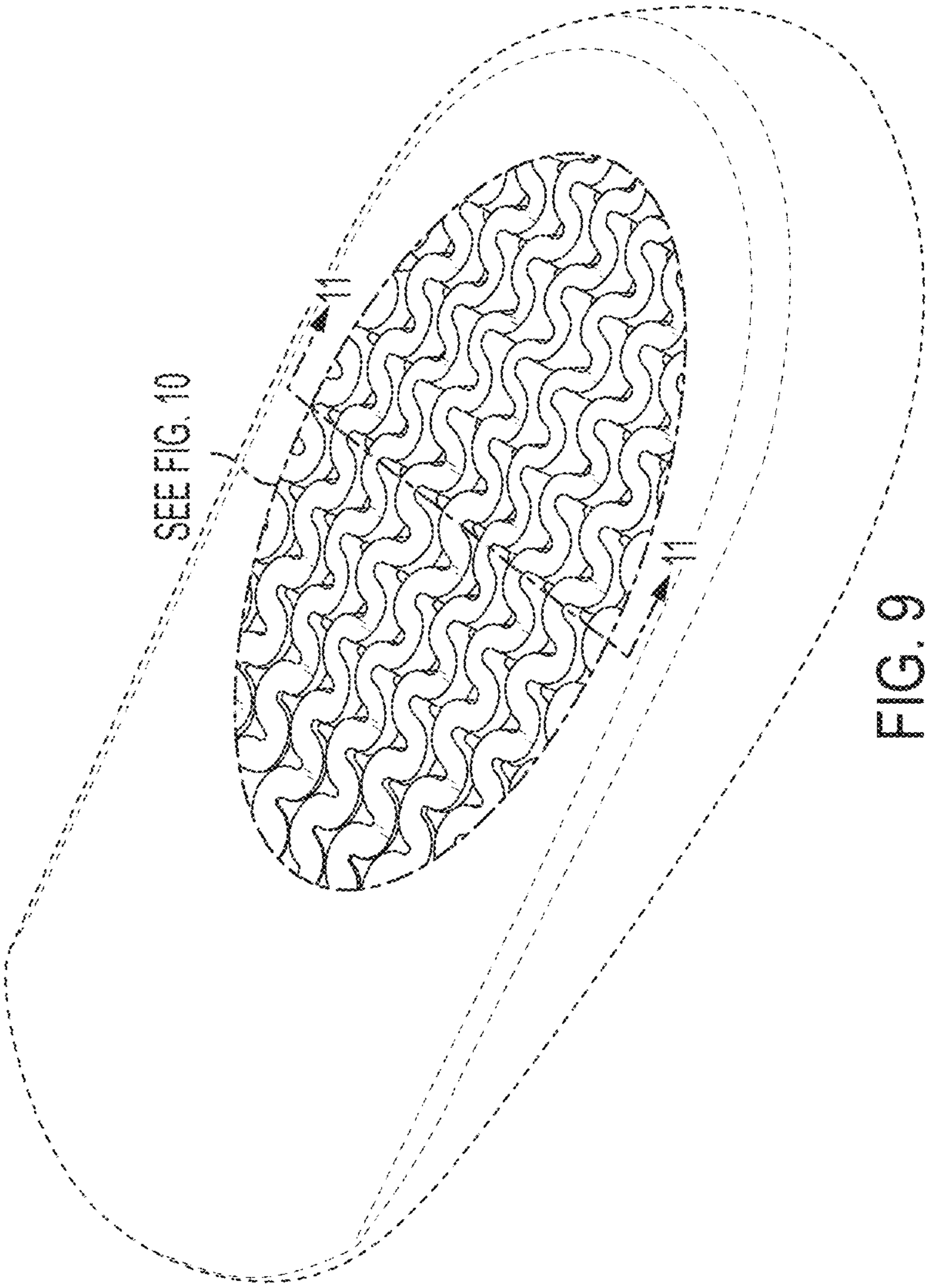

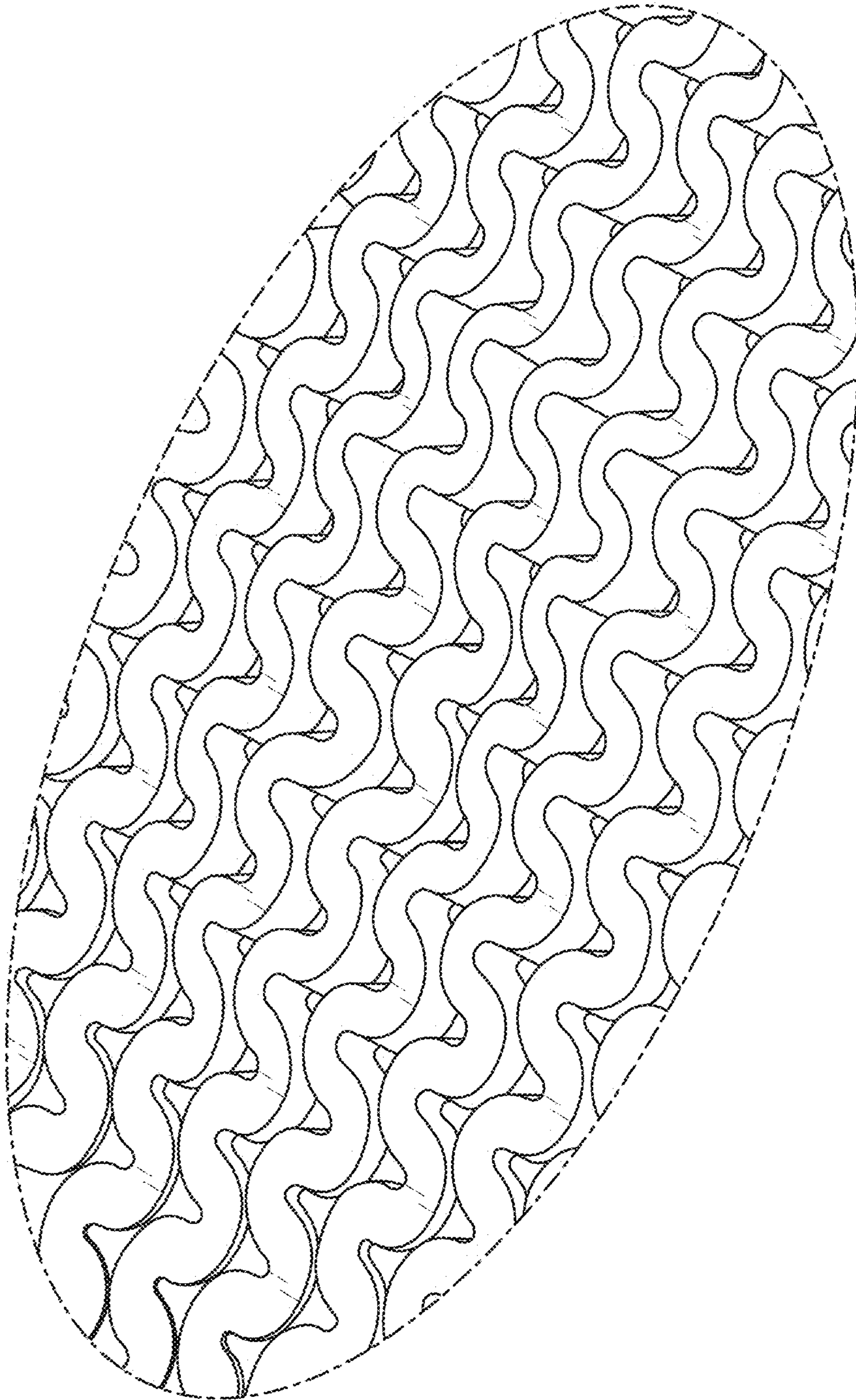

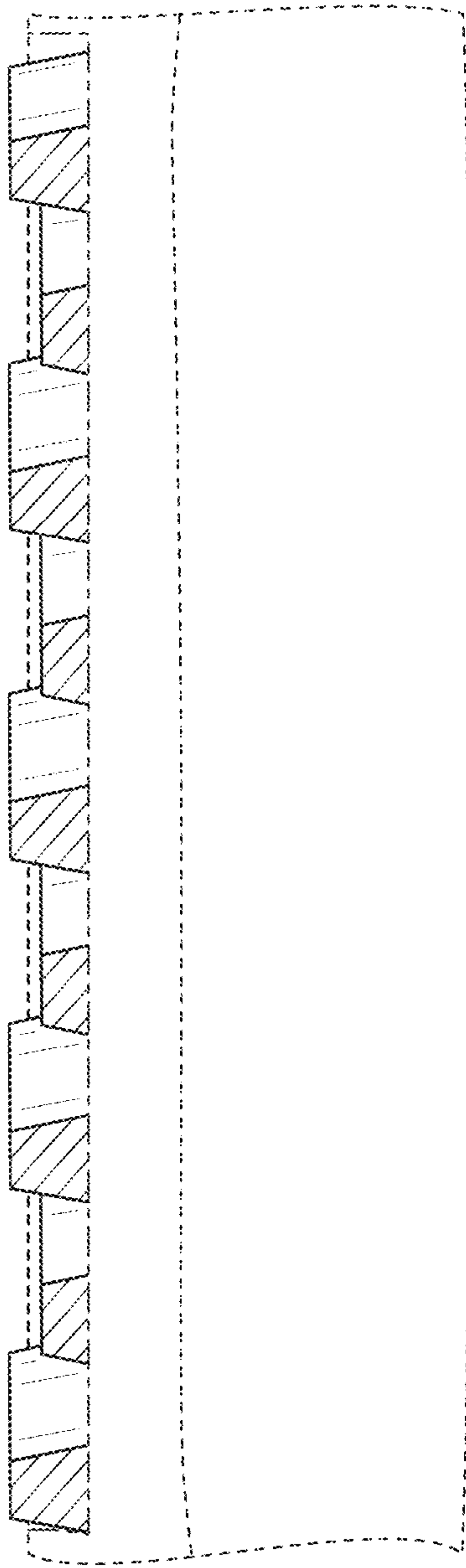

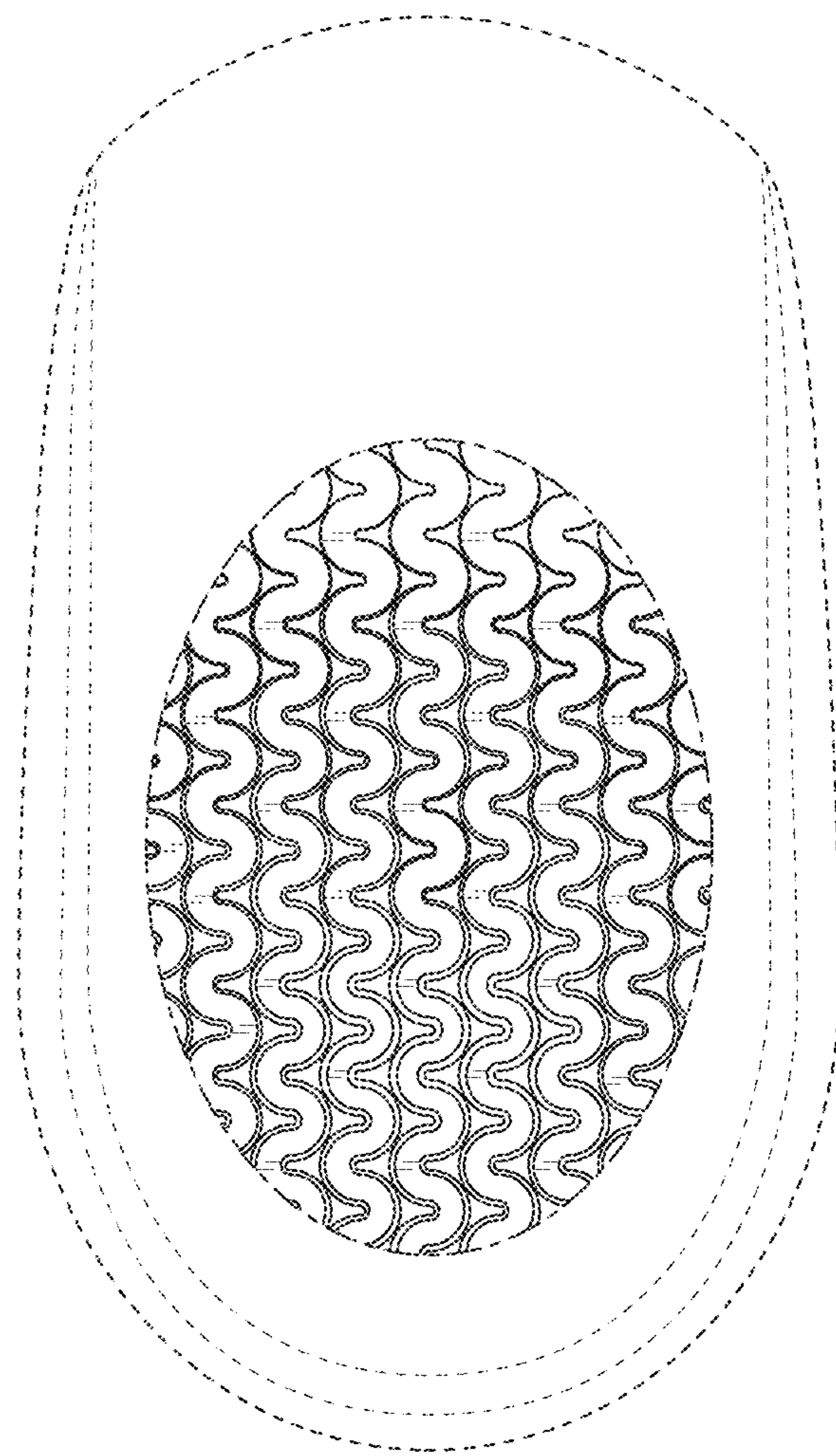

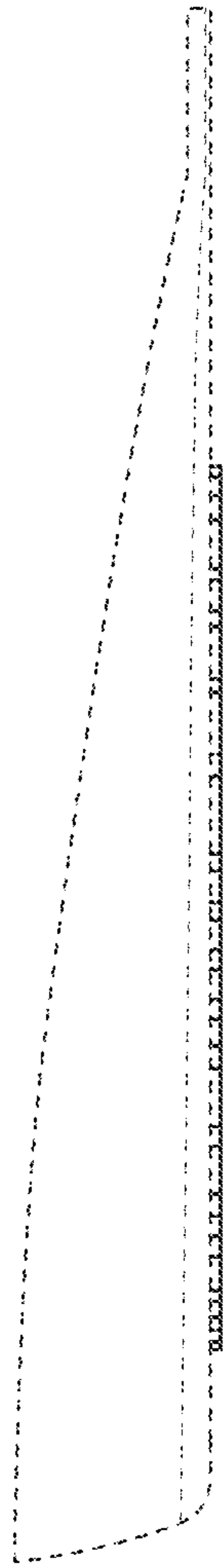

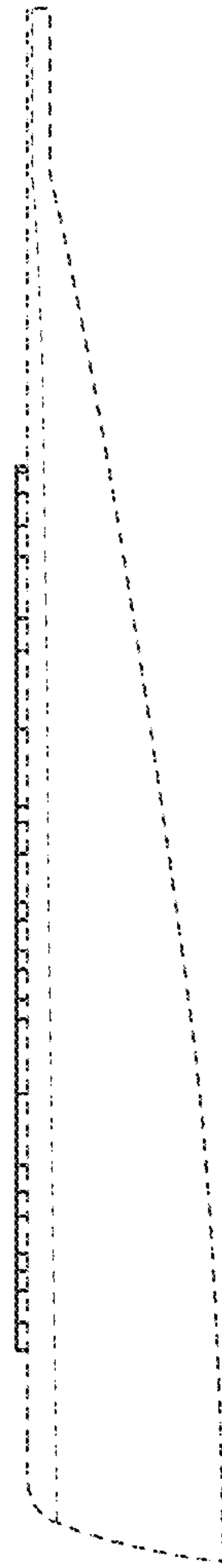

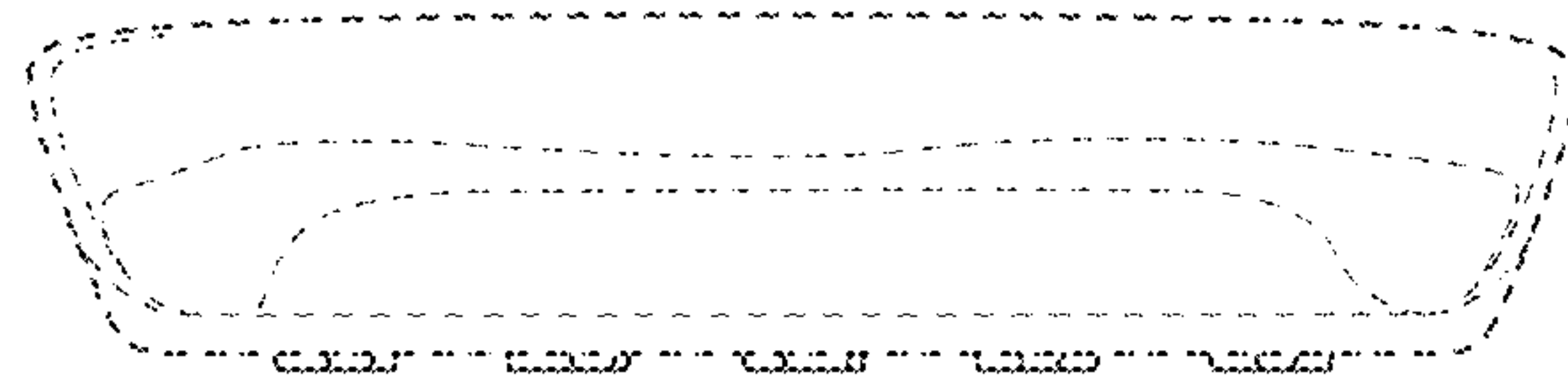

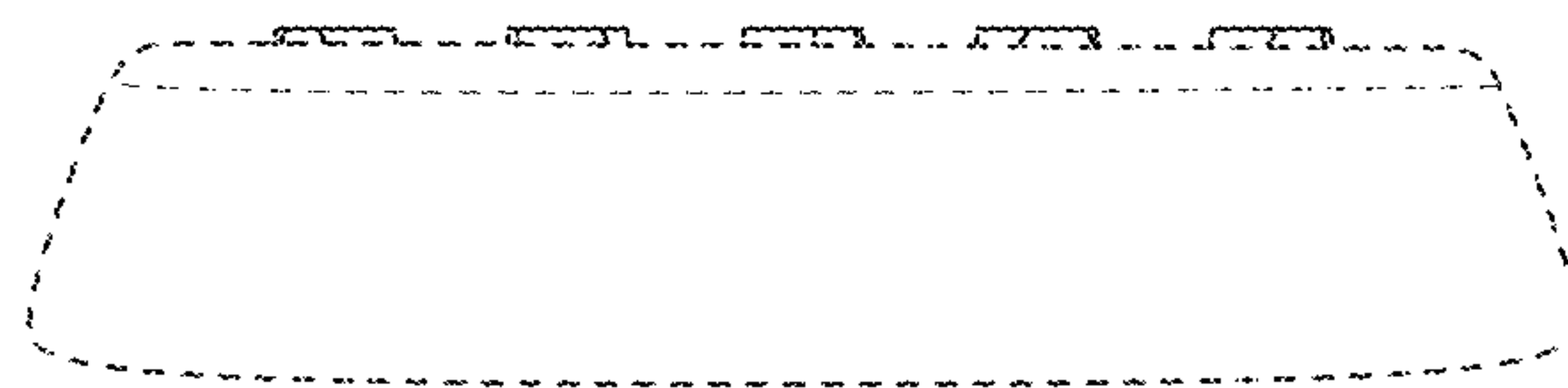
