FIG. 2 is a front view of the double bowl sink showing the façade design at the first side;

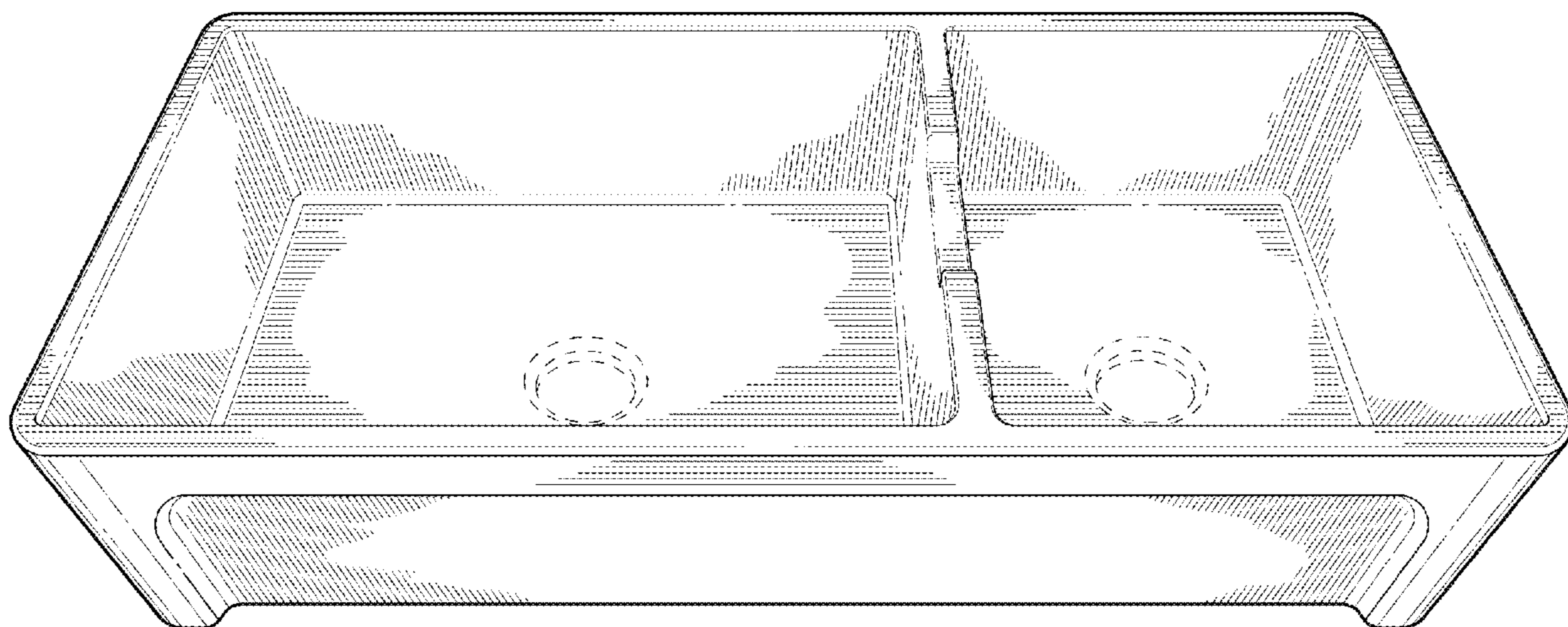
FIG. 3 is a back view of the double bowl sink showing a façade design at a second side;

The broken line portions of the sink represent the bounds of the claimed design and form no part of the claimed design. The bottom of the sink is flat and devoid of surface ornamentation and forms no part of the claimed design.

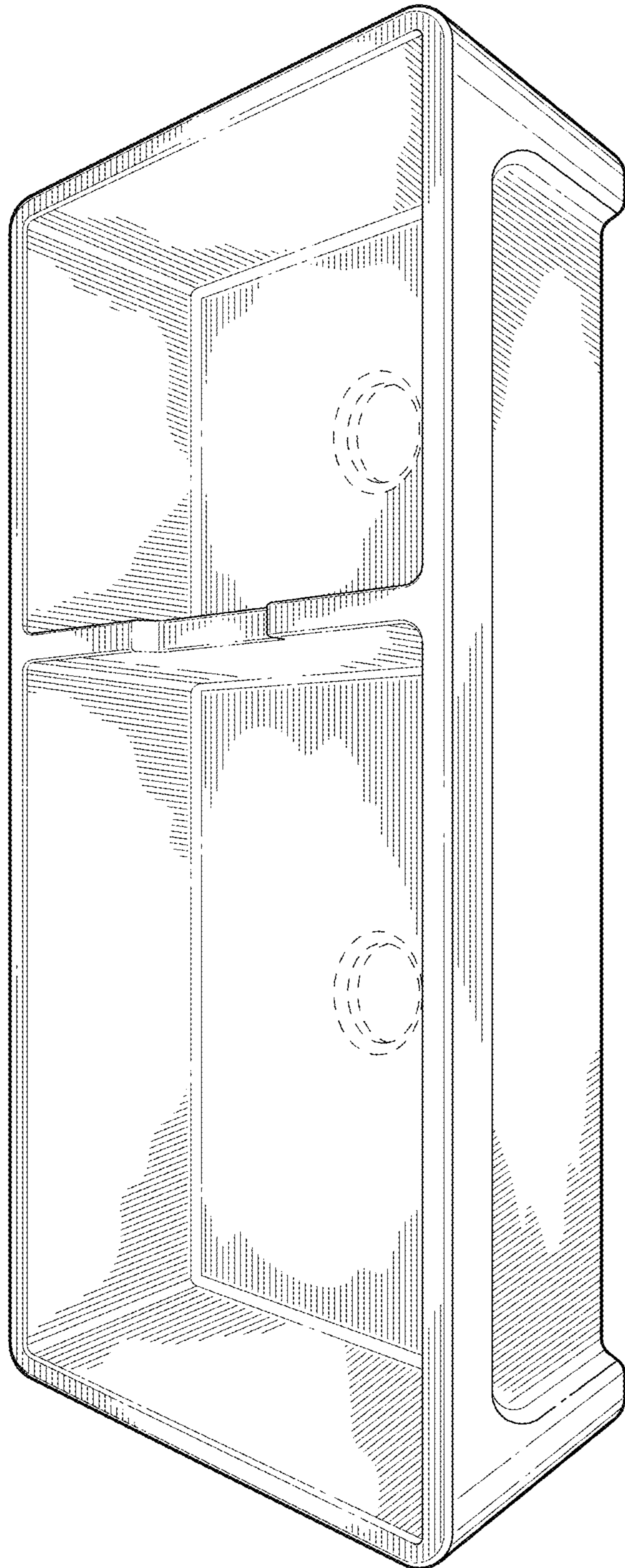

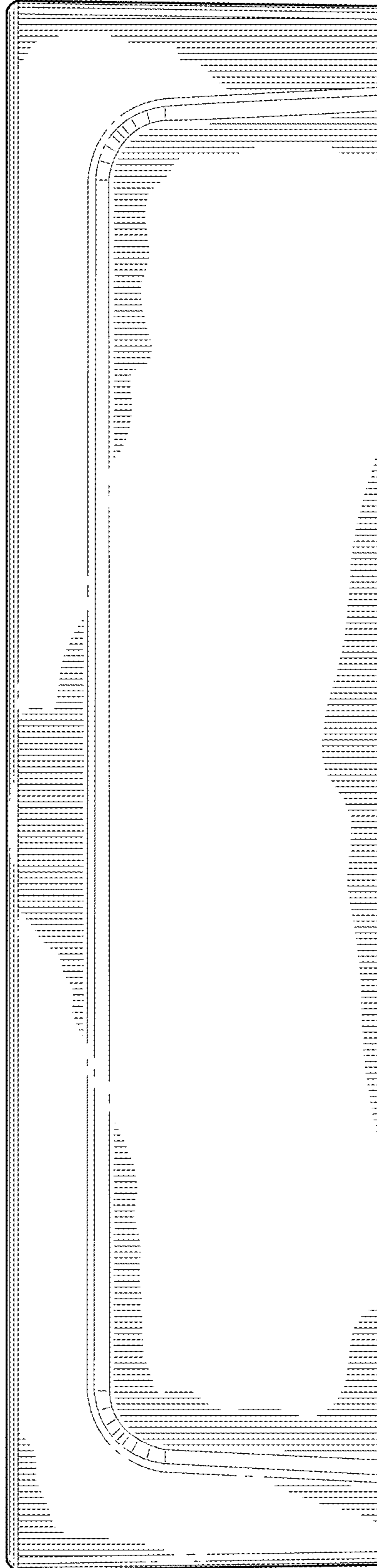

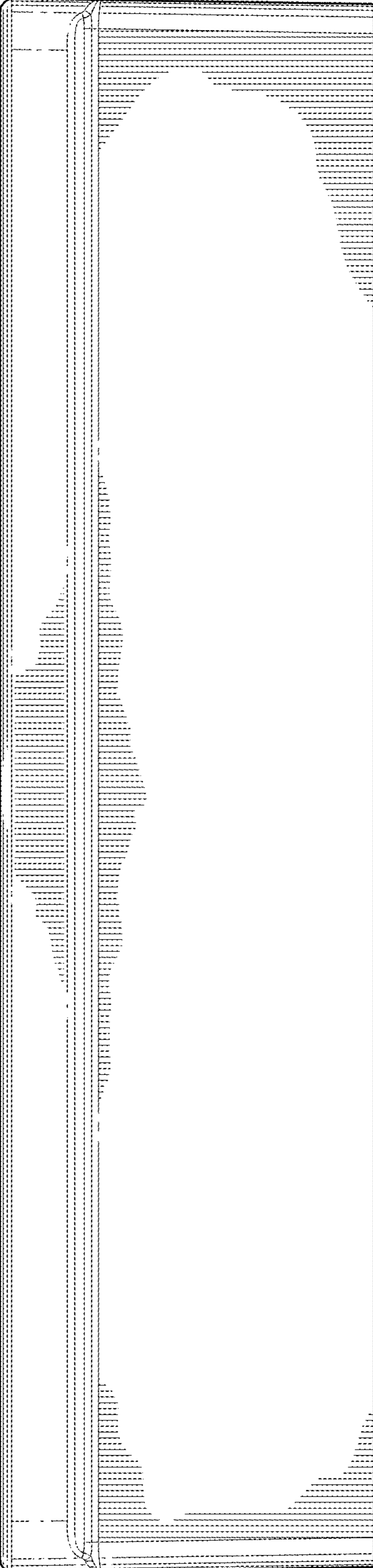

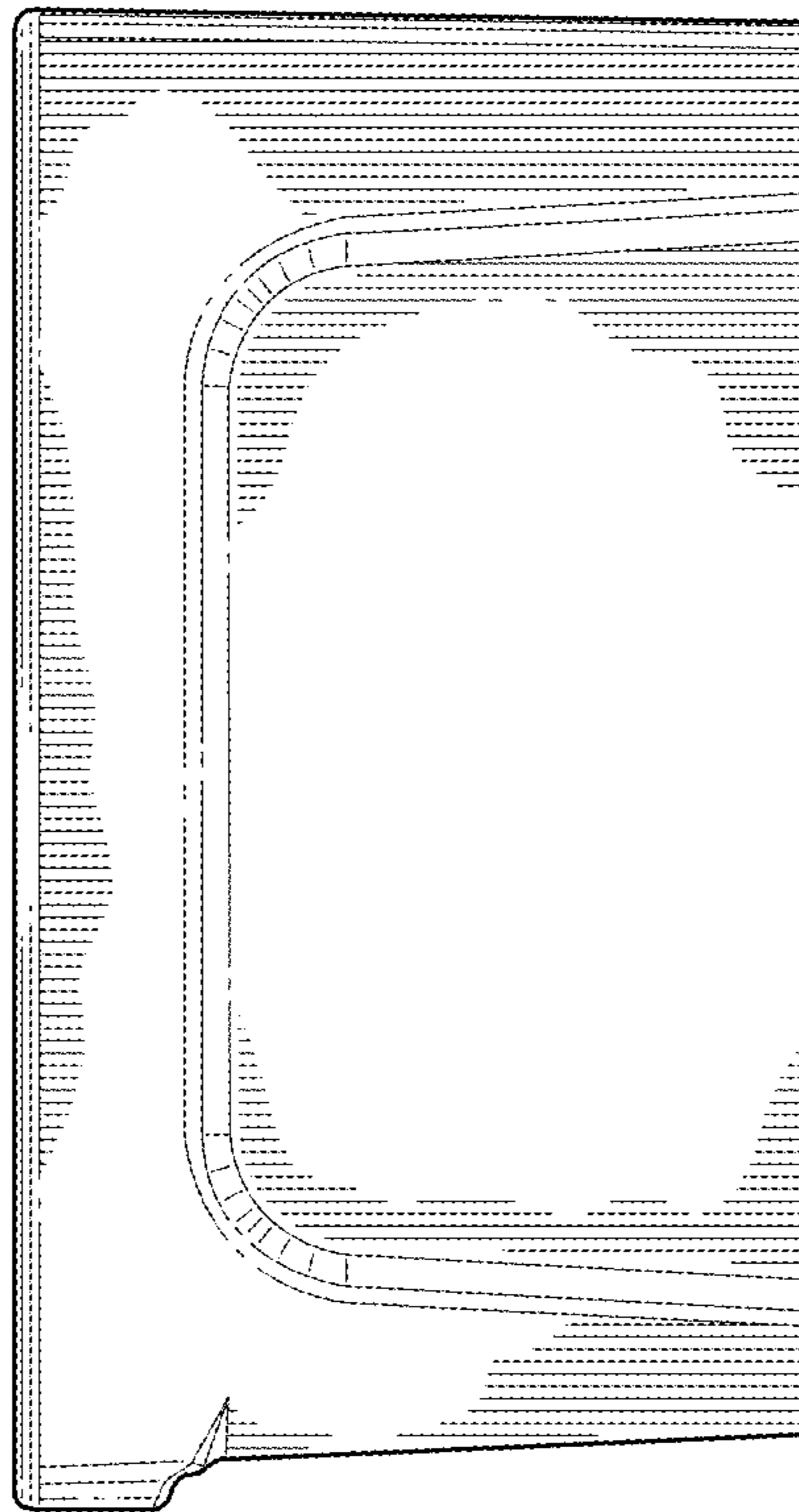

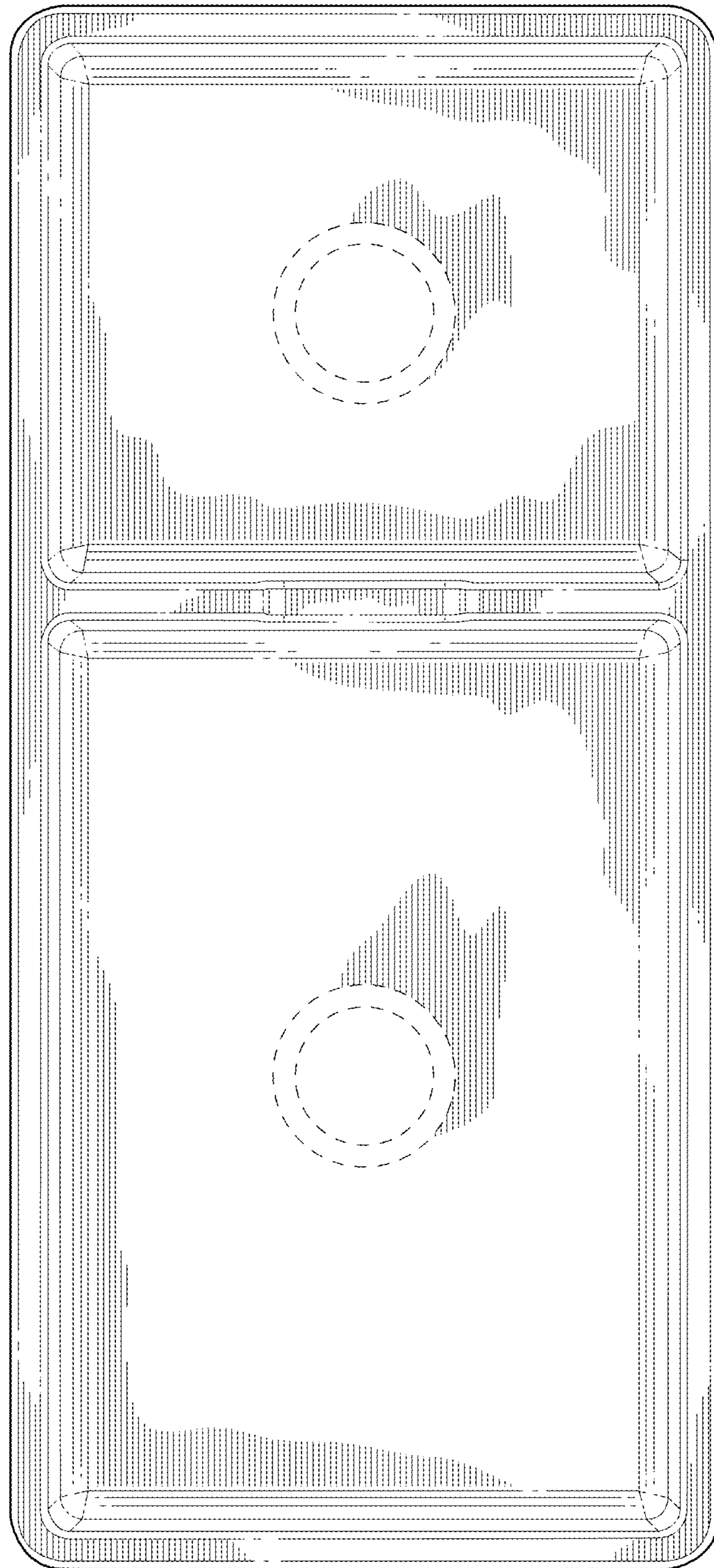
