The ornamental design for a garment, as shown and described.

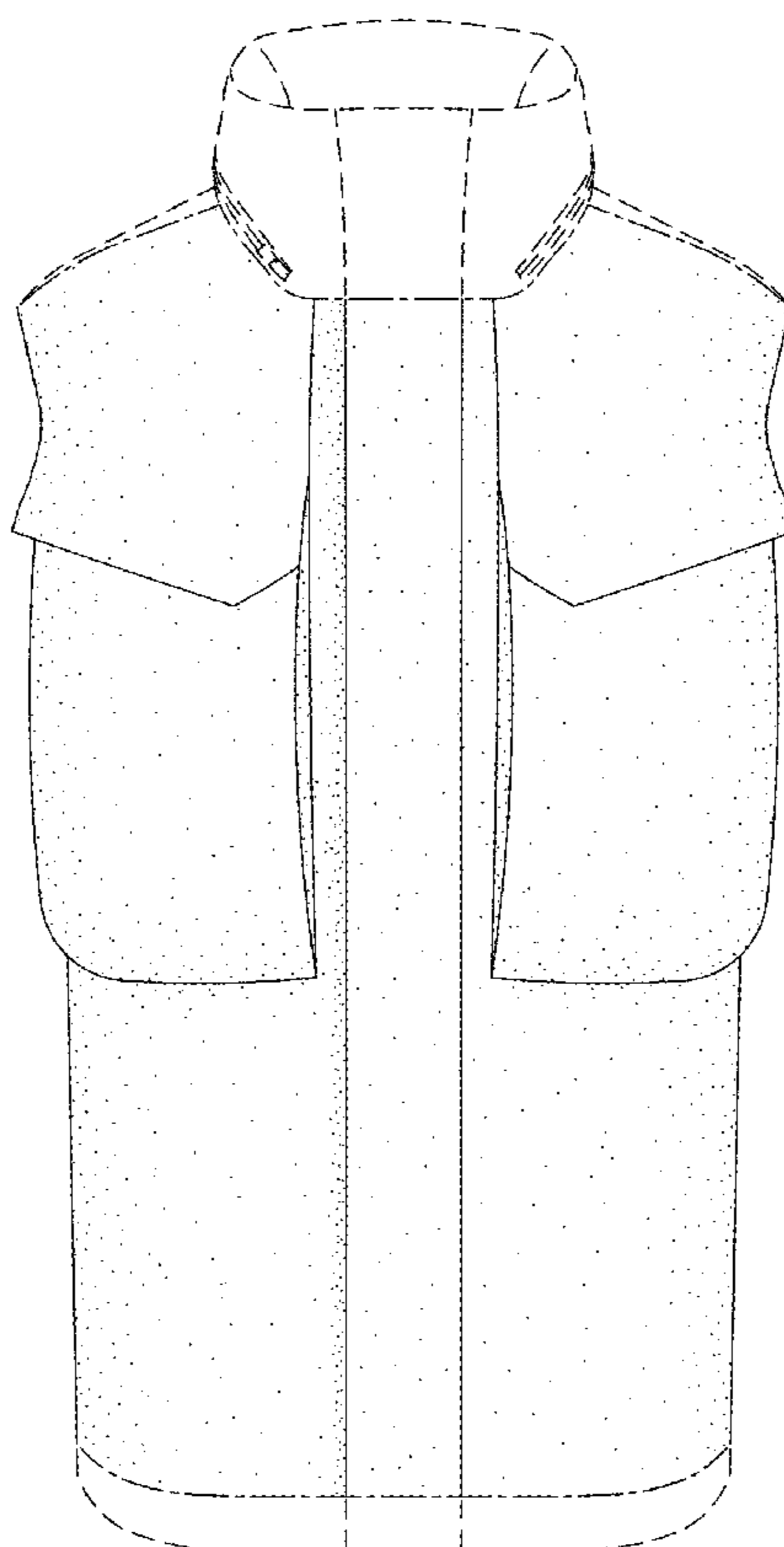
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a garment showing my design; FIG. 2 is a first side view thereof; FIG. 3 is a second side view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front first side perspective view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a front second side perspective view thereof. The long-and-short broken lines immediately adjacent shaded areas form an unclaimed boundary, and form no part of the claim. The even-length broken lines depict portions of the garment that form no part of the claimed design.

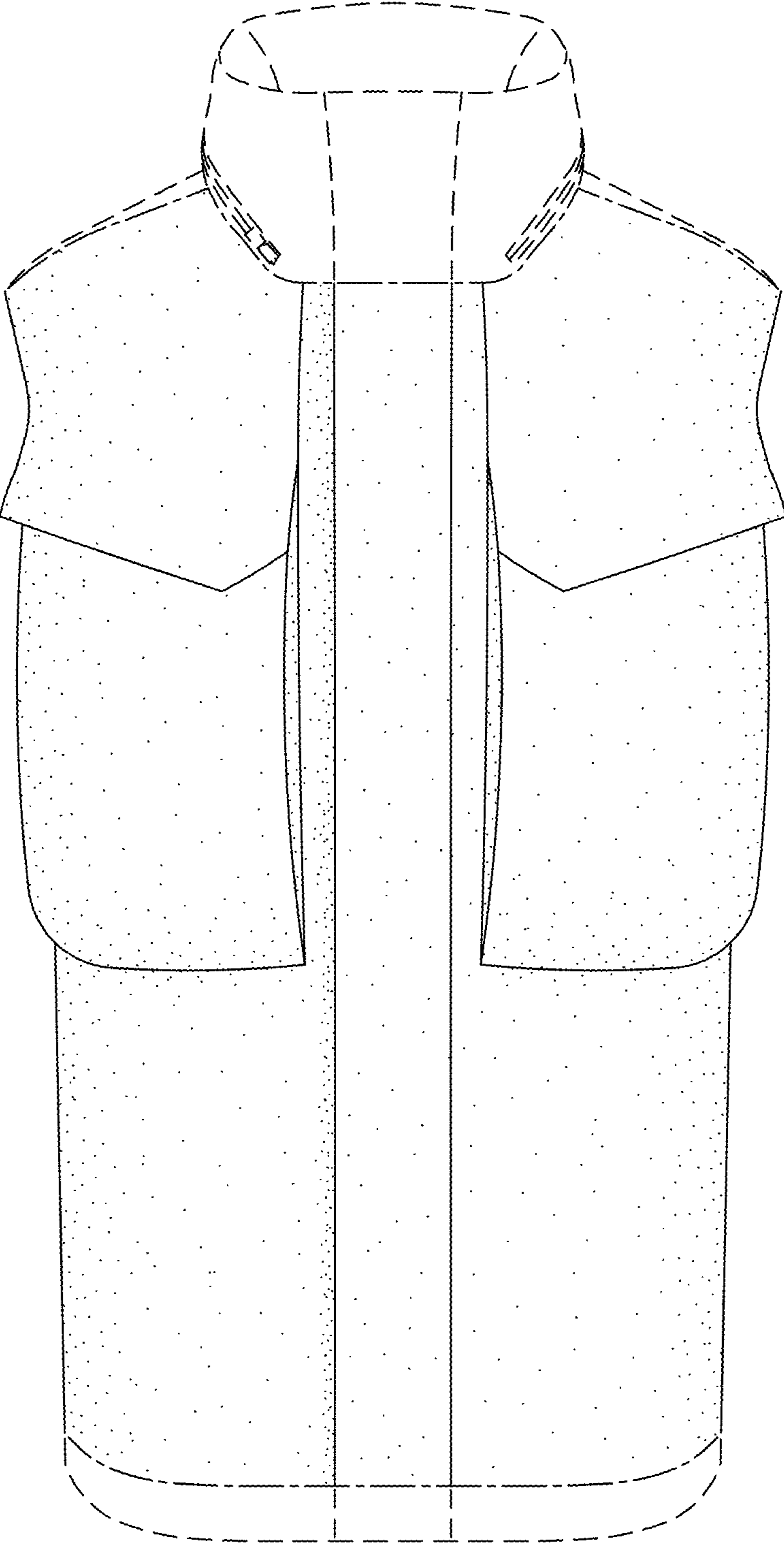

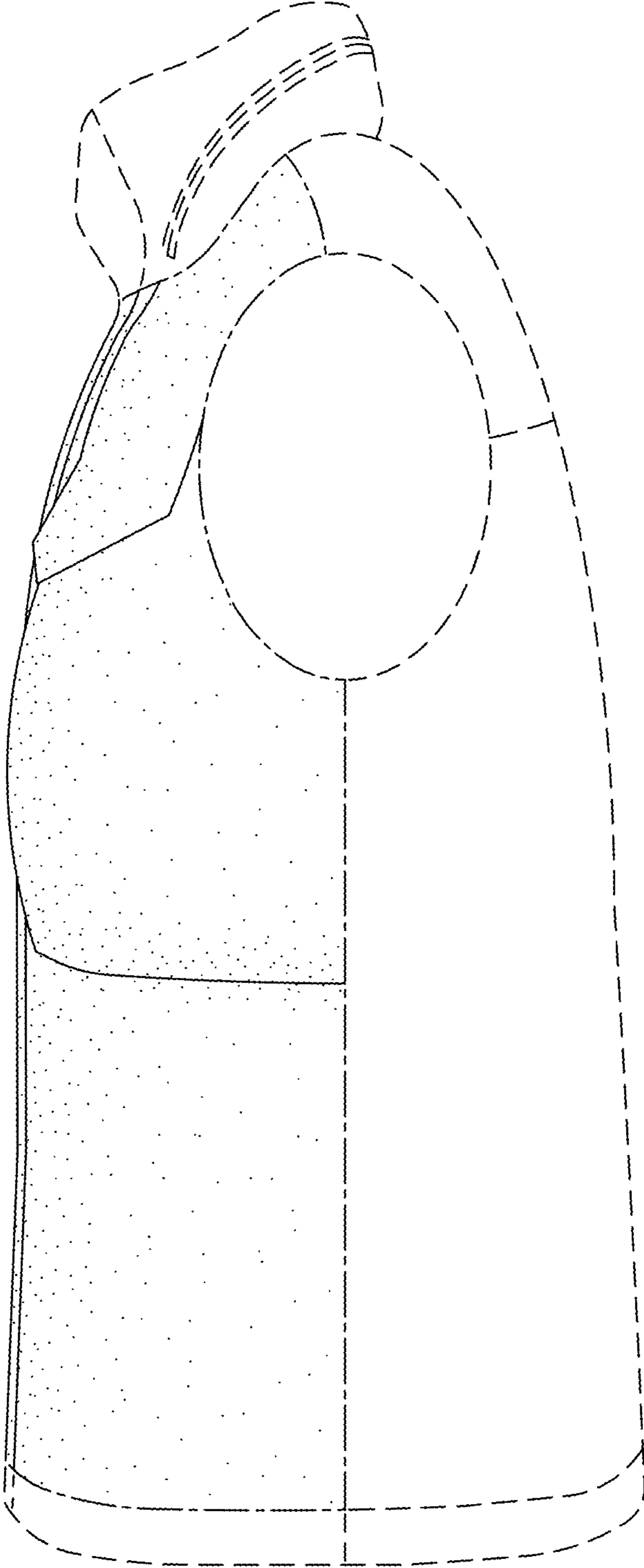

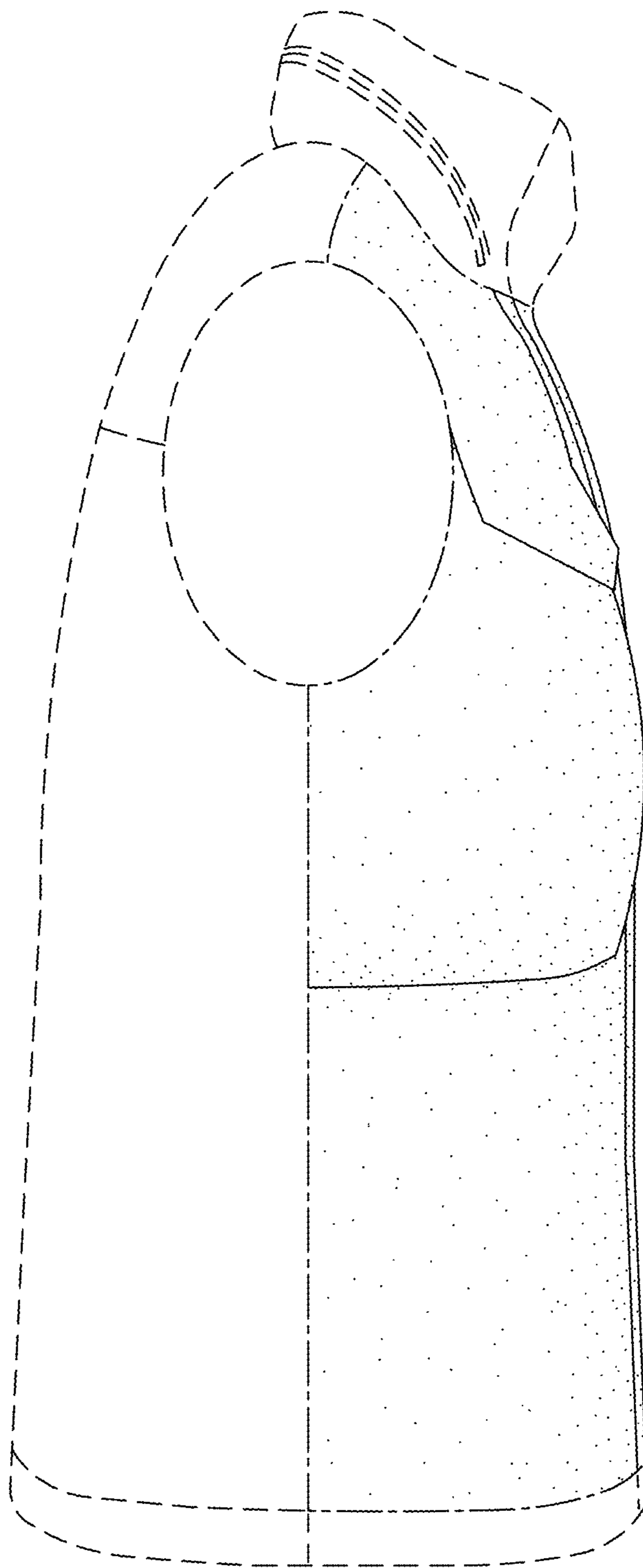

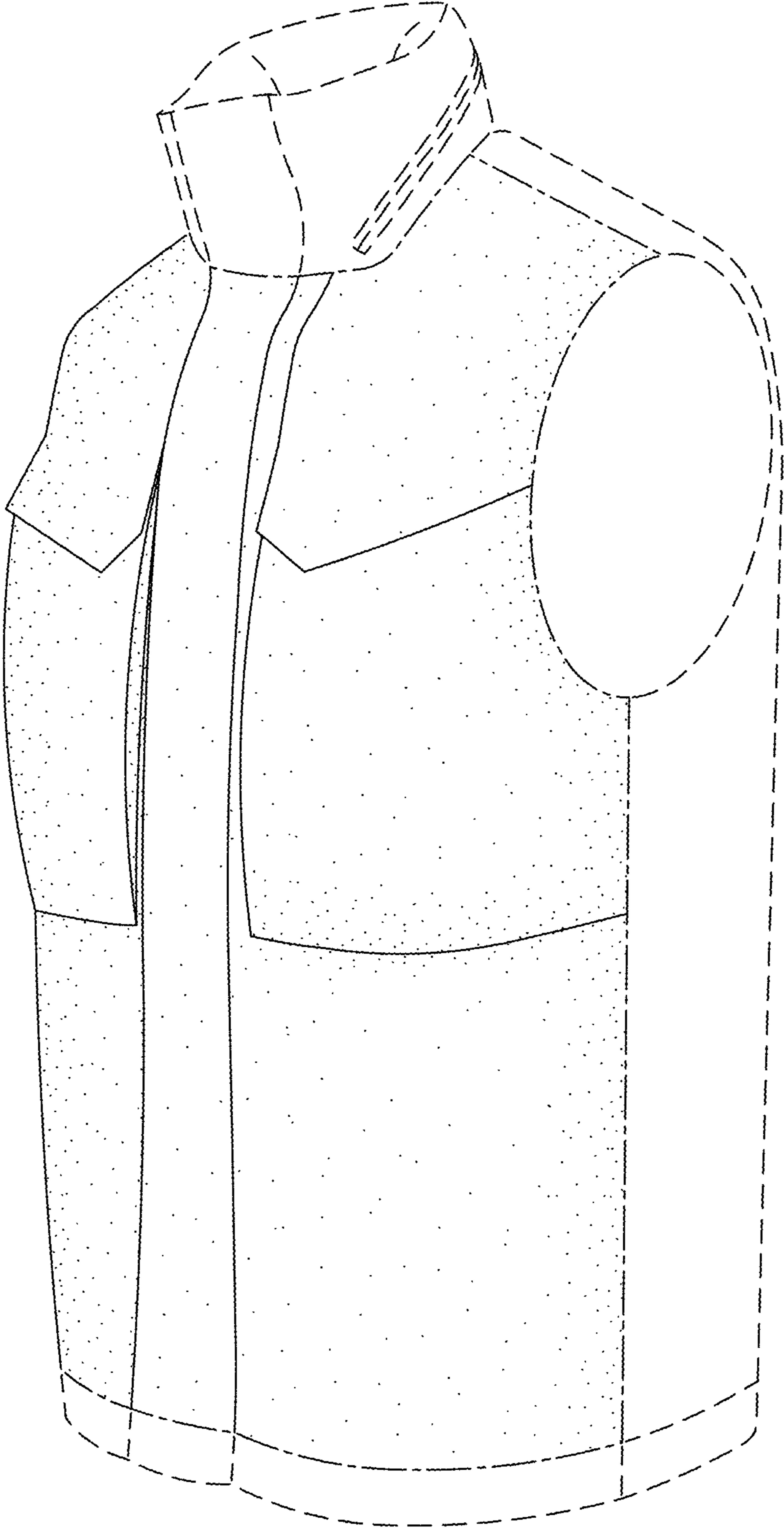

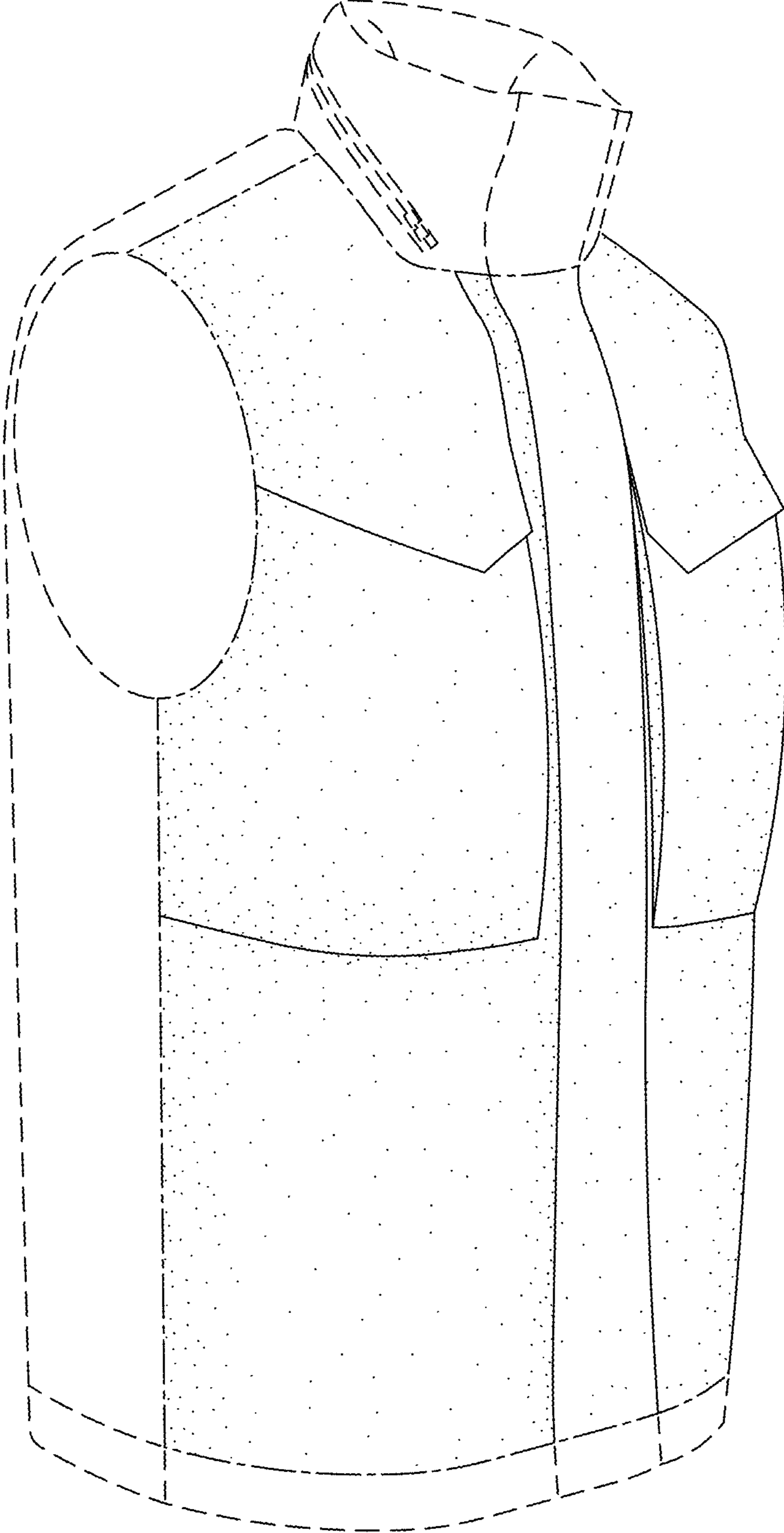
