FIG. 4 is a first side view of the golf bag hip pad of this invention;

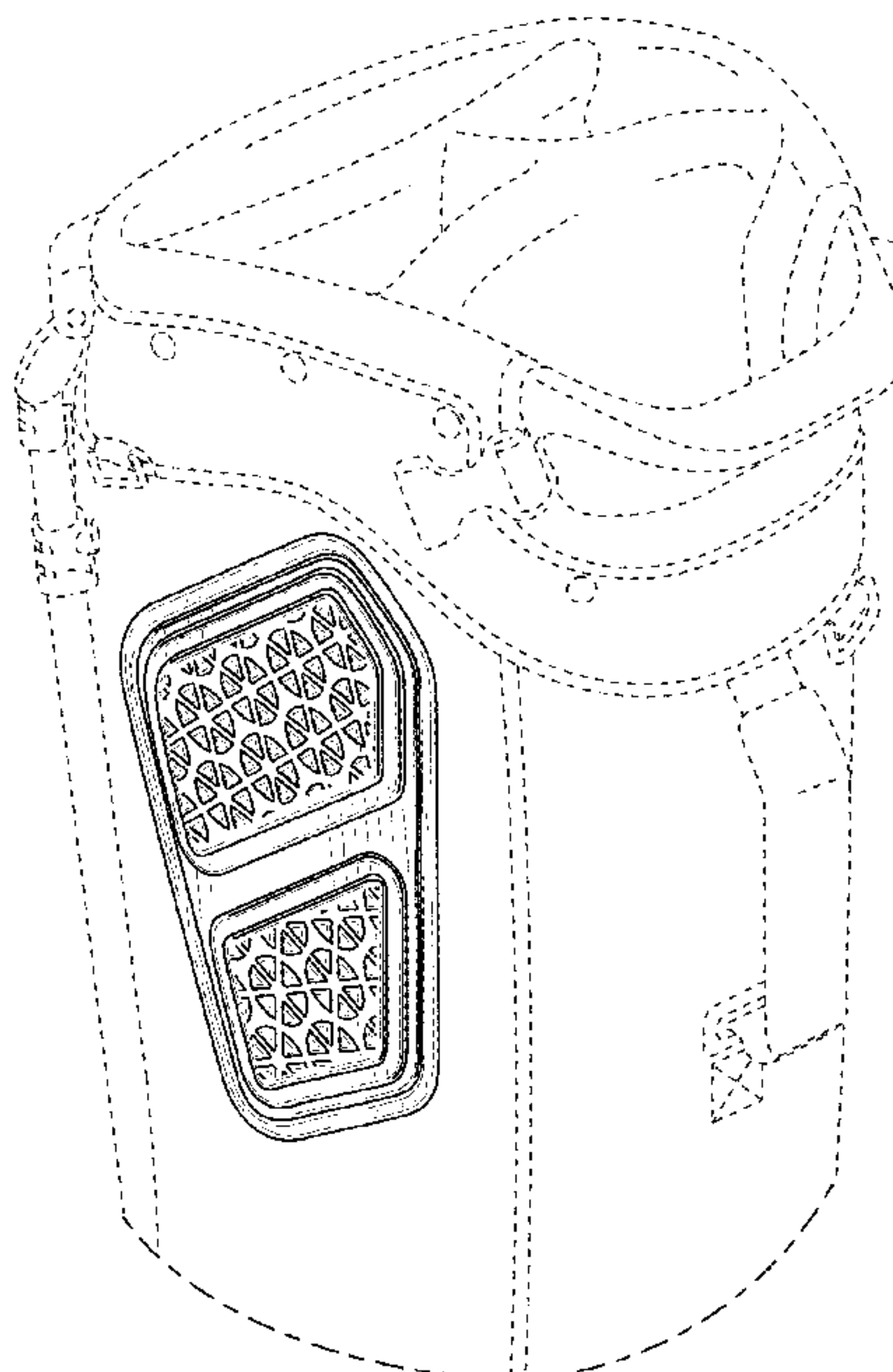
FIG. 5 is a second side view of the golf bag hip pad of this invention; and

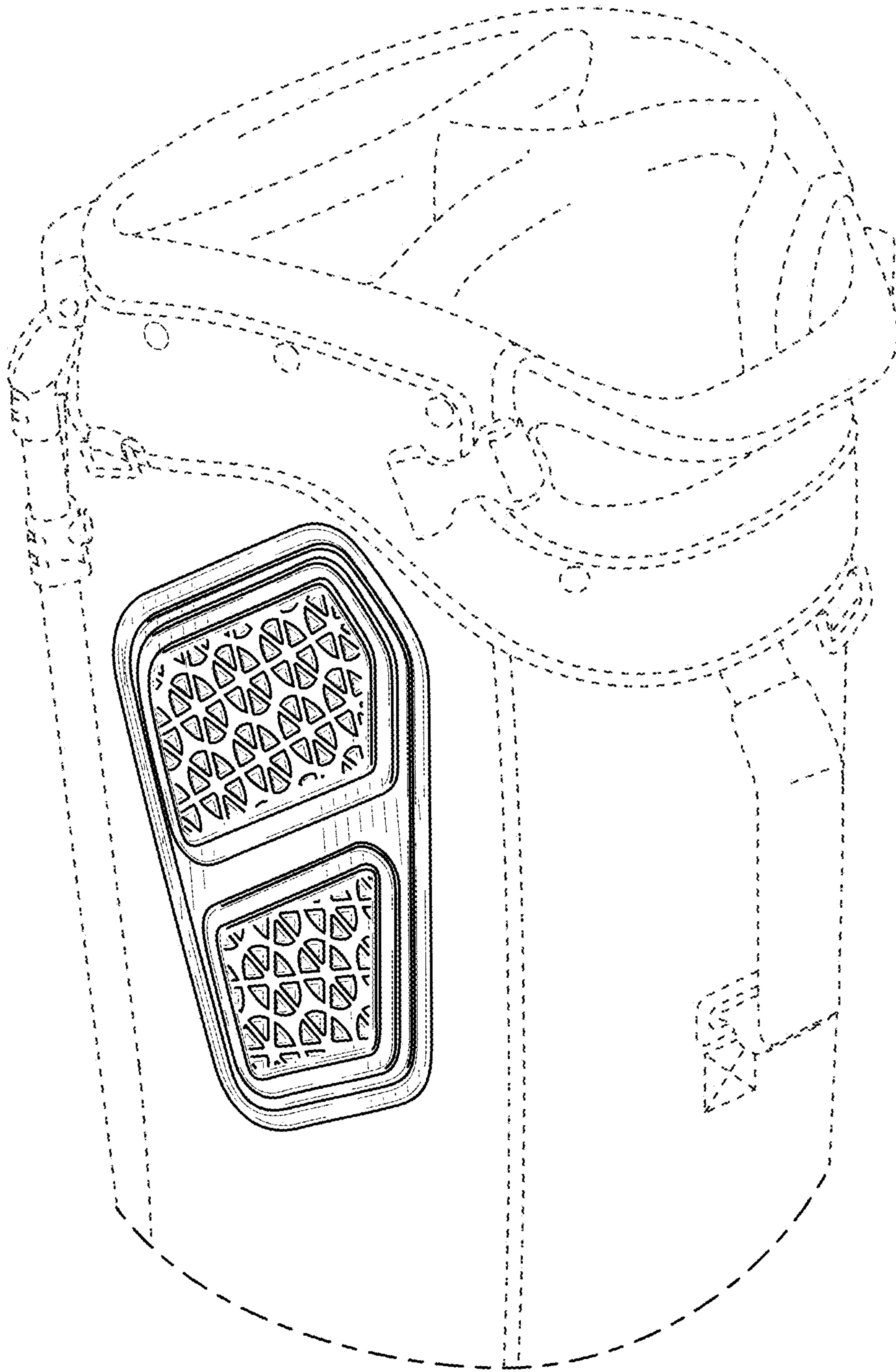

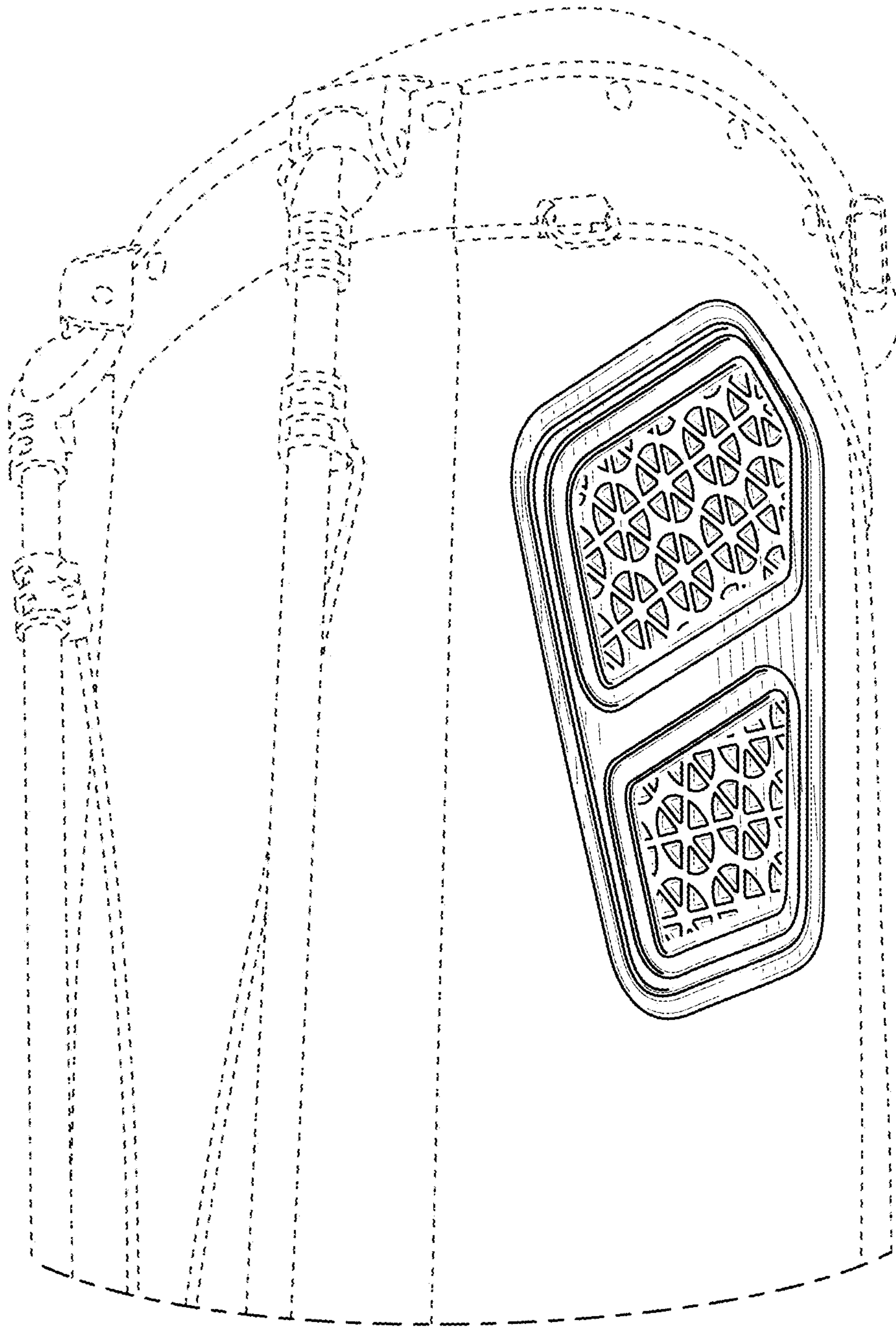

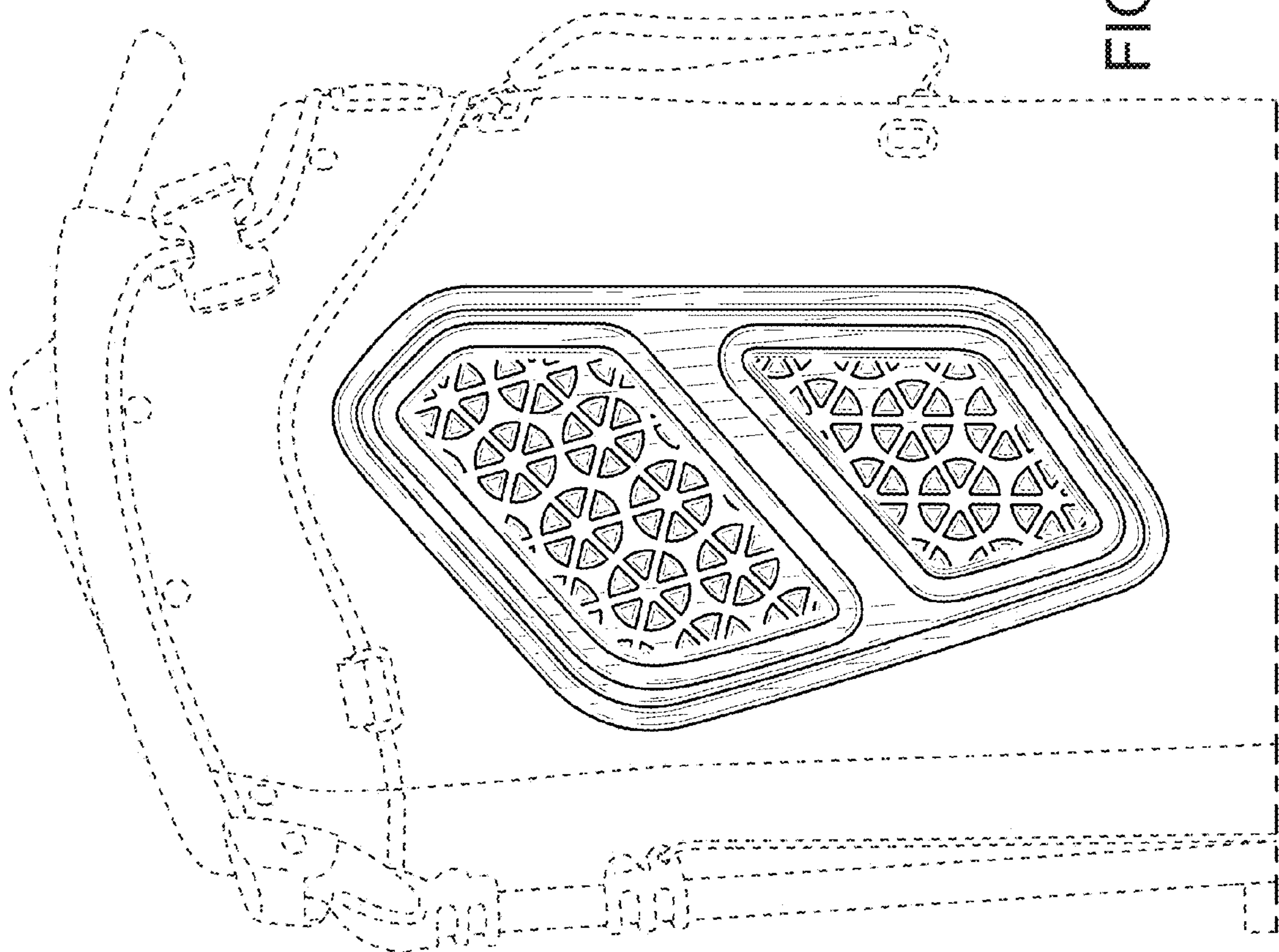

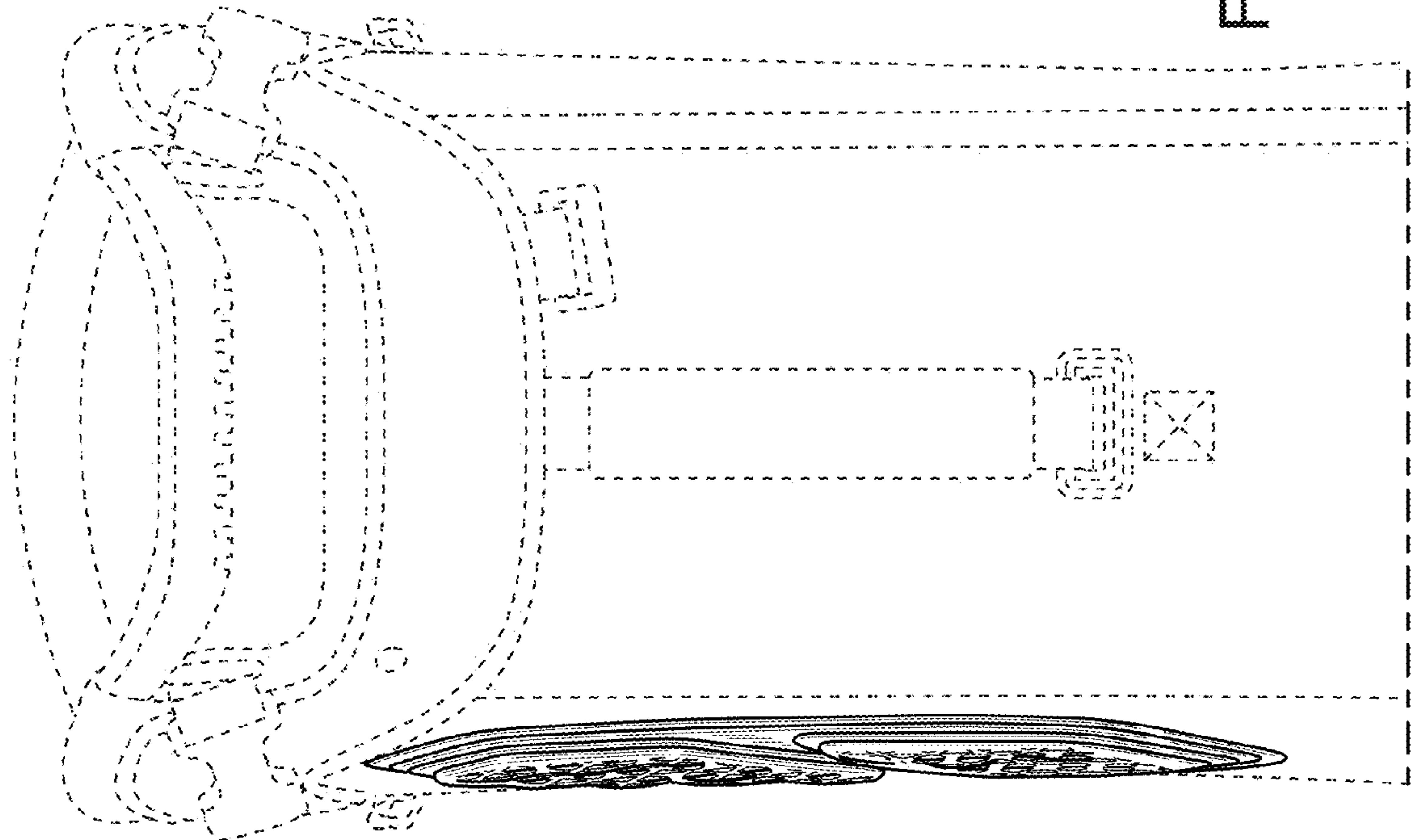

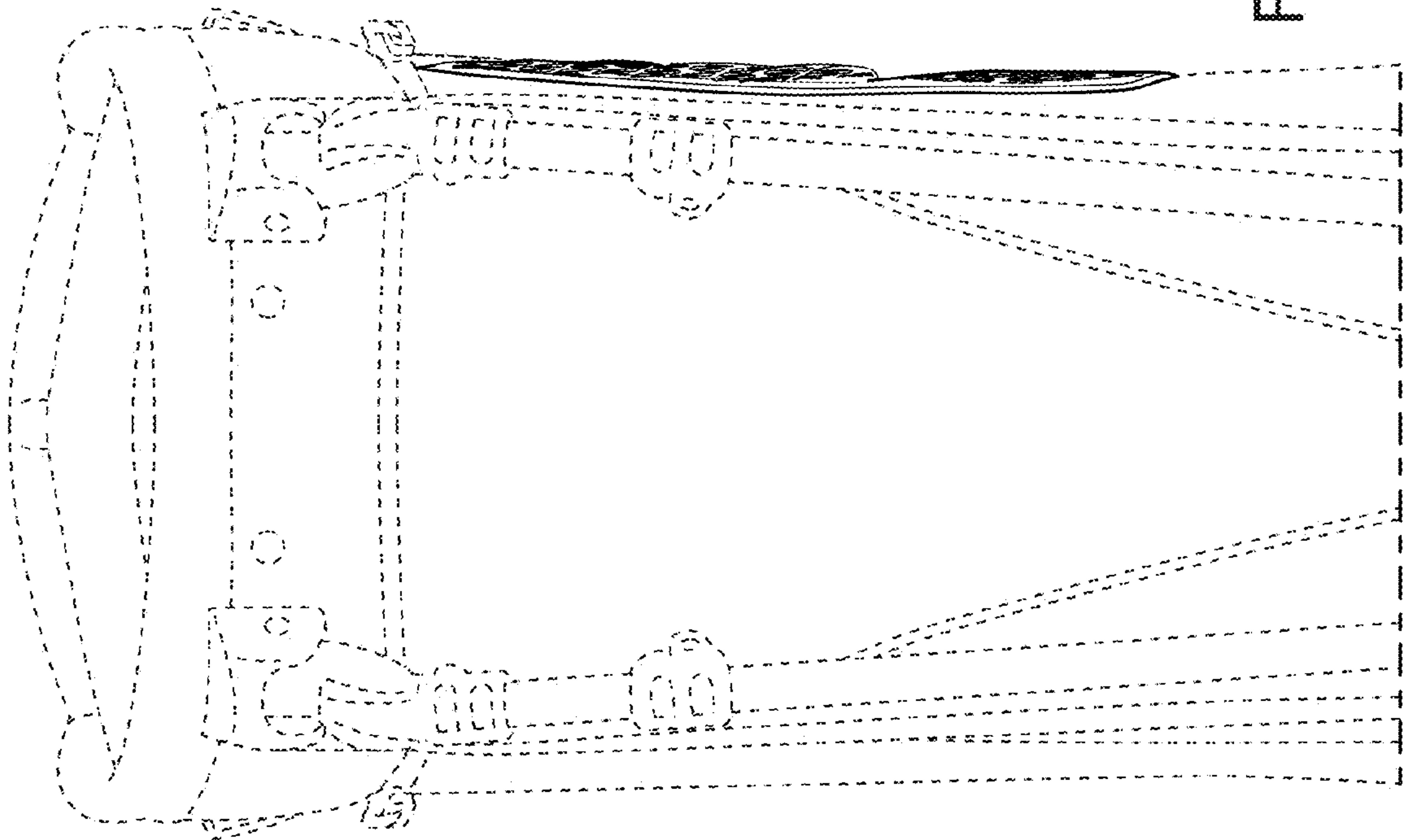

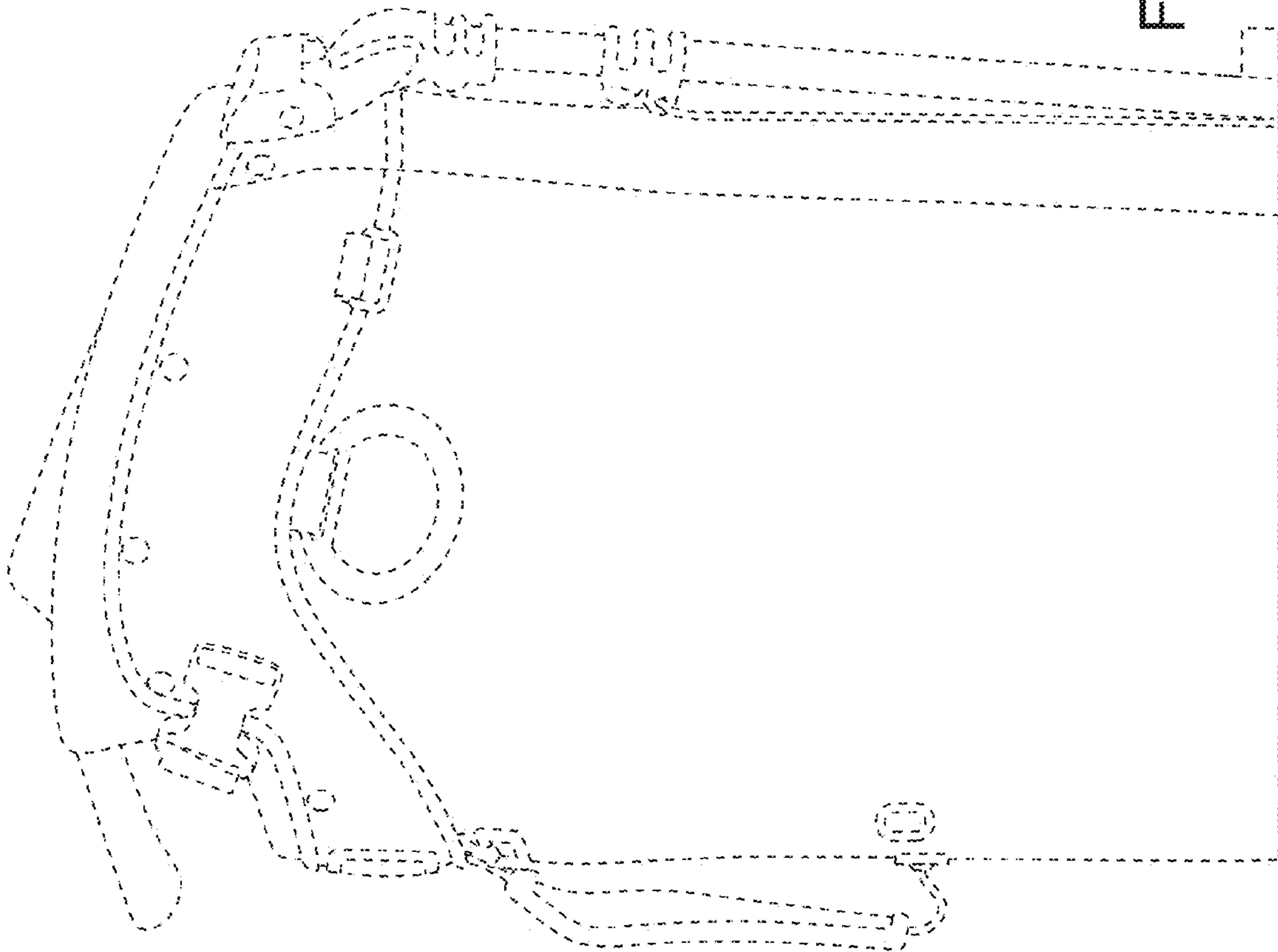

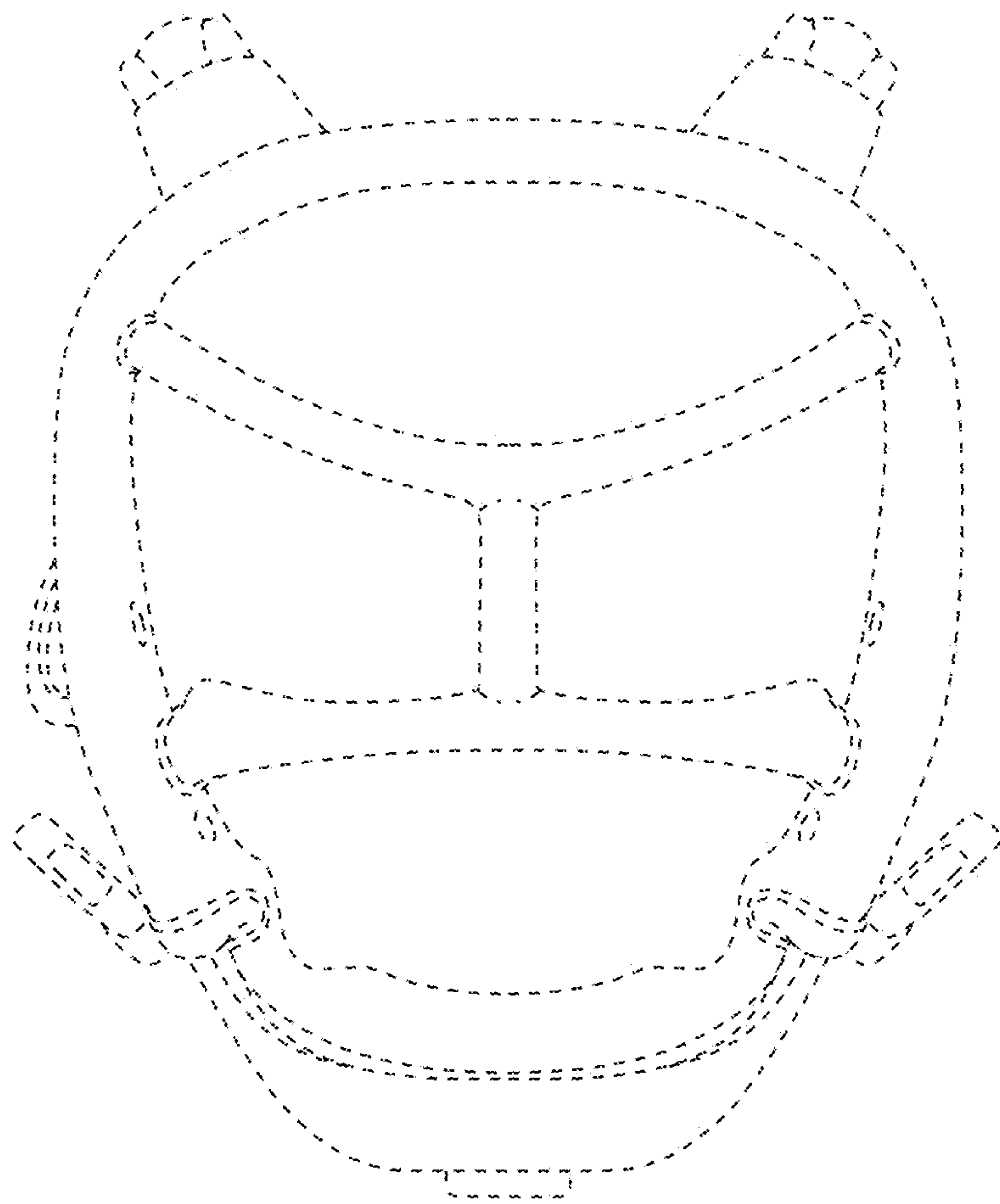
