DESCRIPTION

view is identical to the front elevation view.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

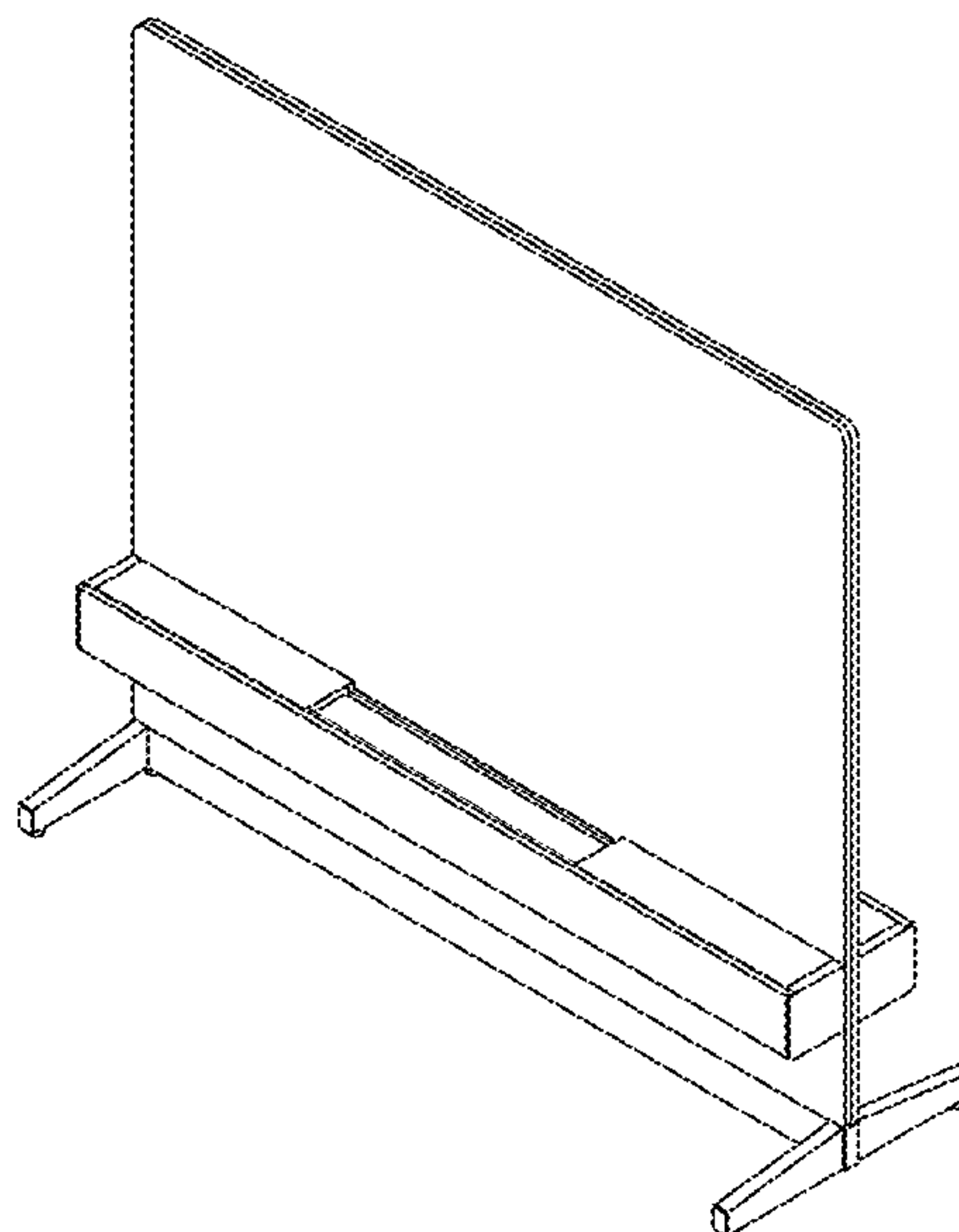
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view taken along the line 6-6 in

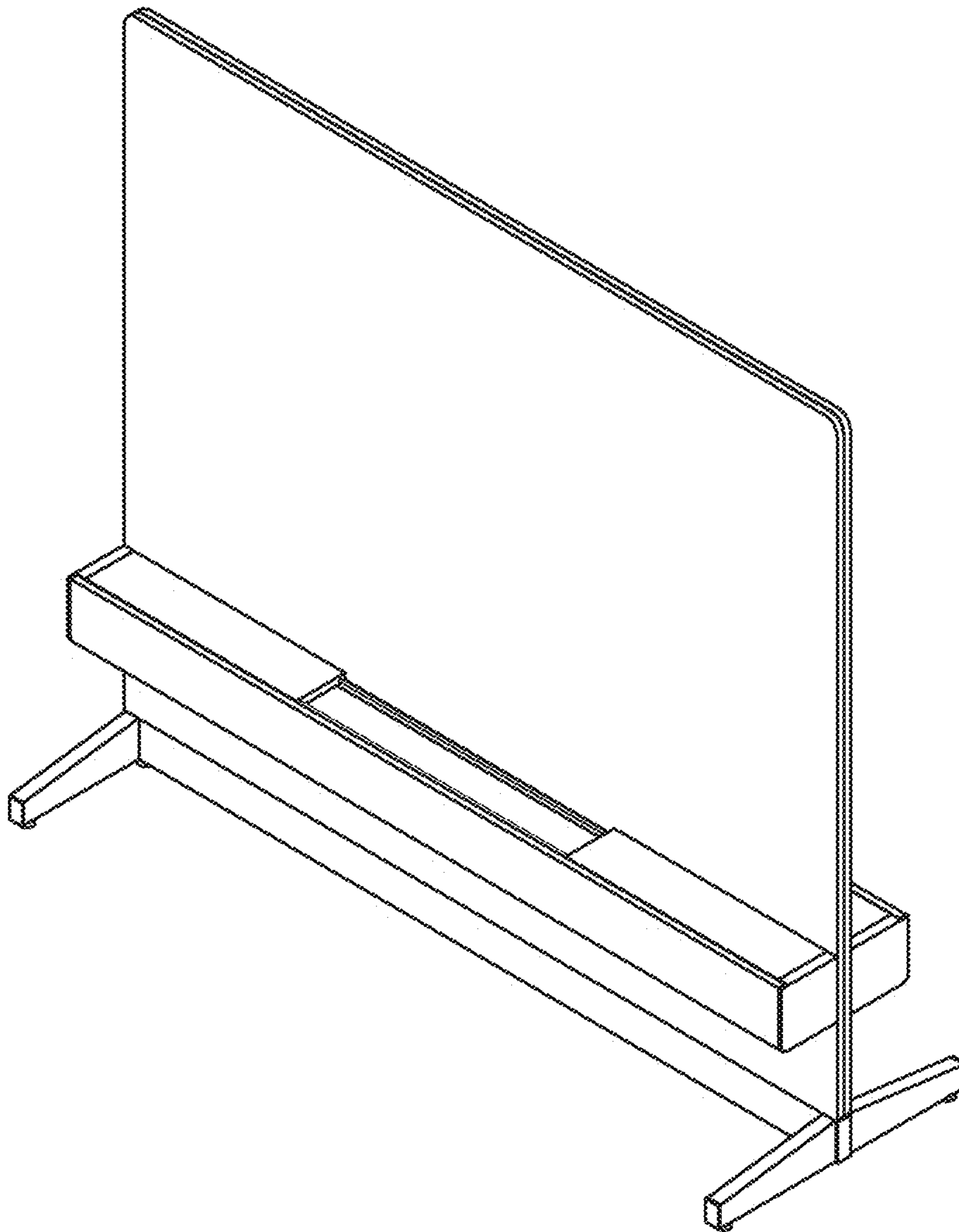

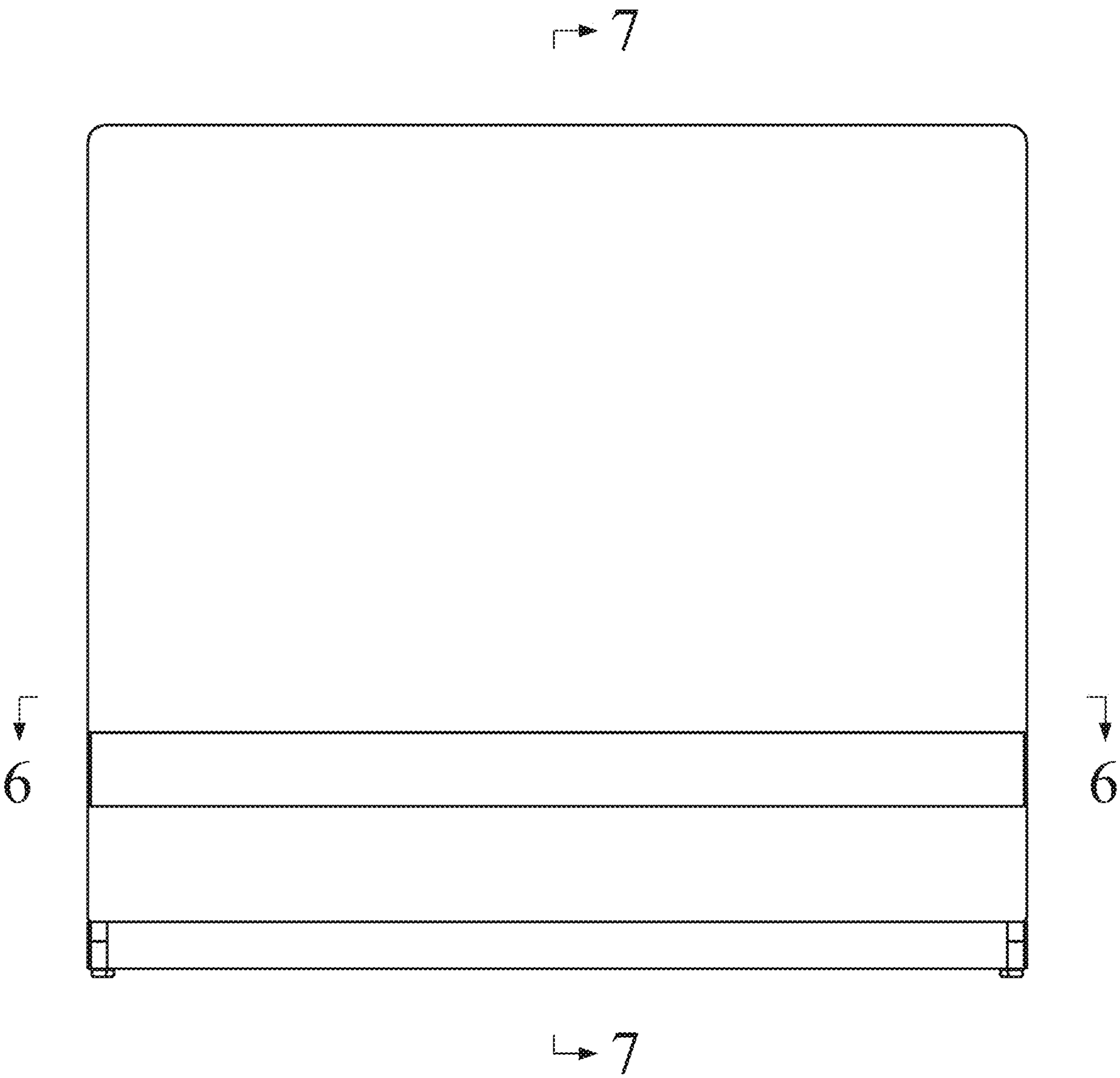

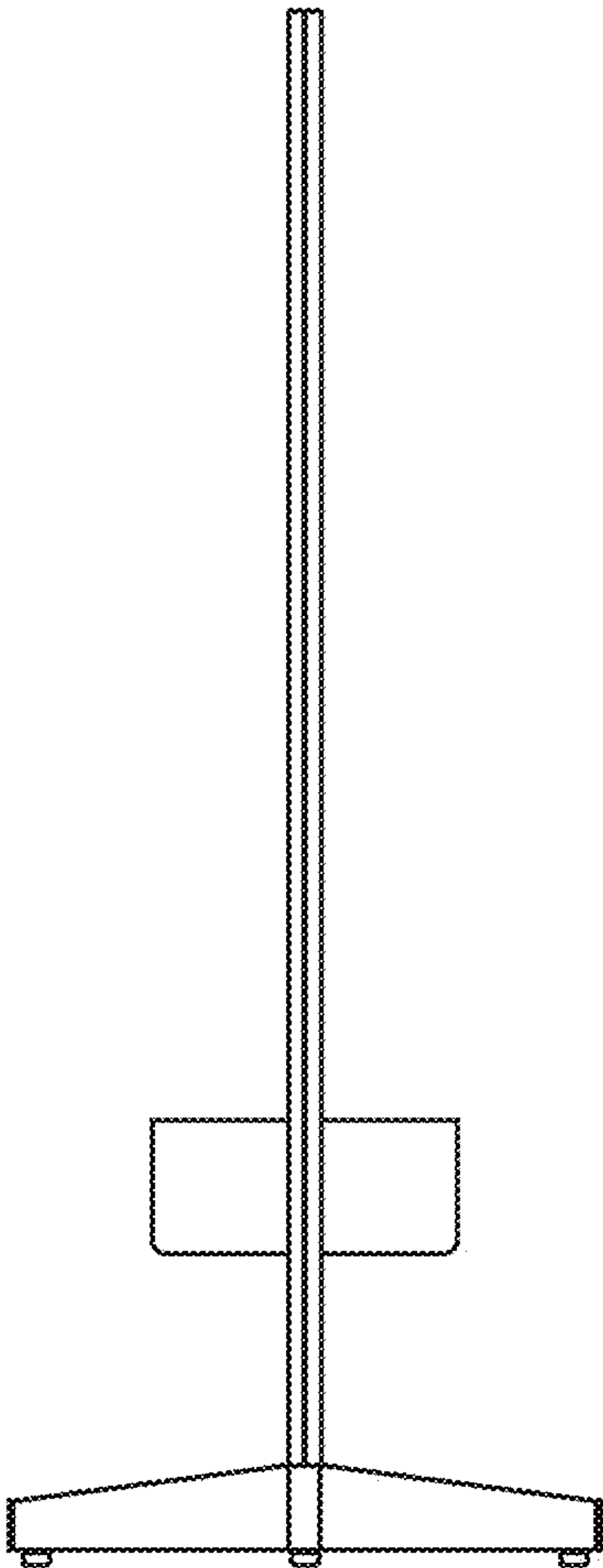

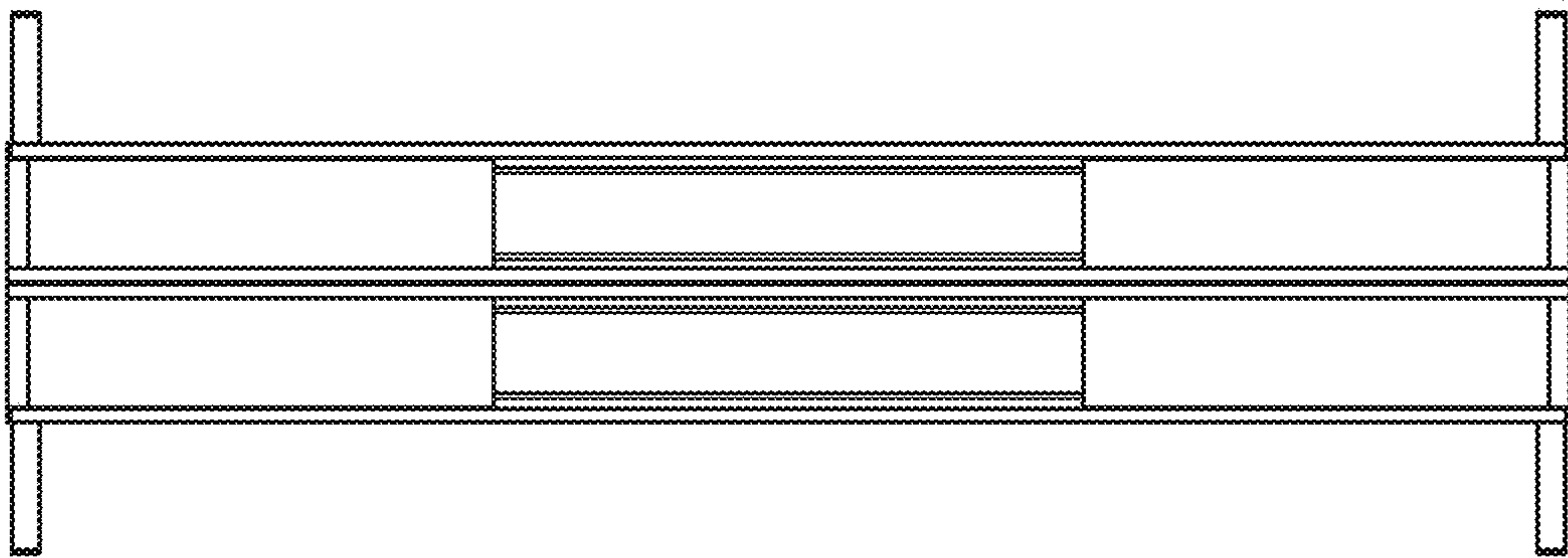

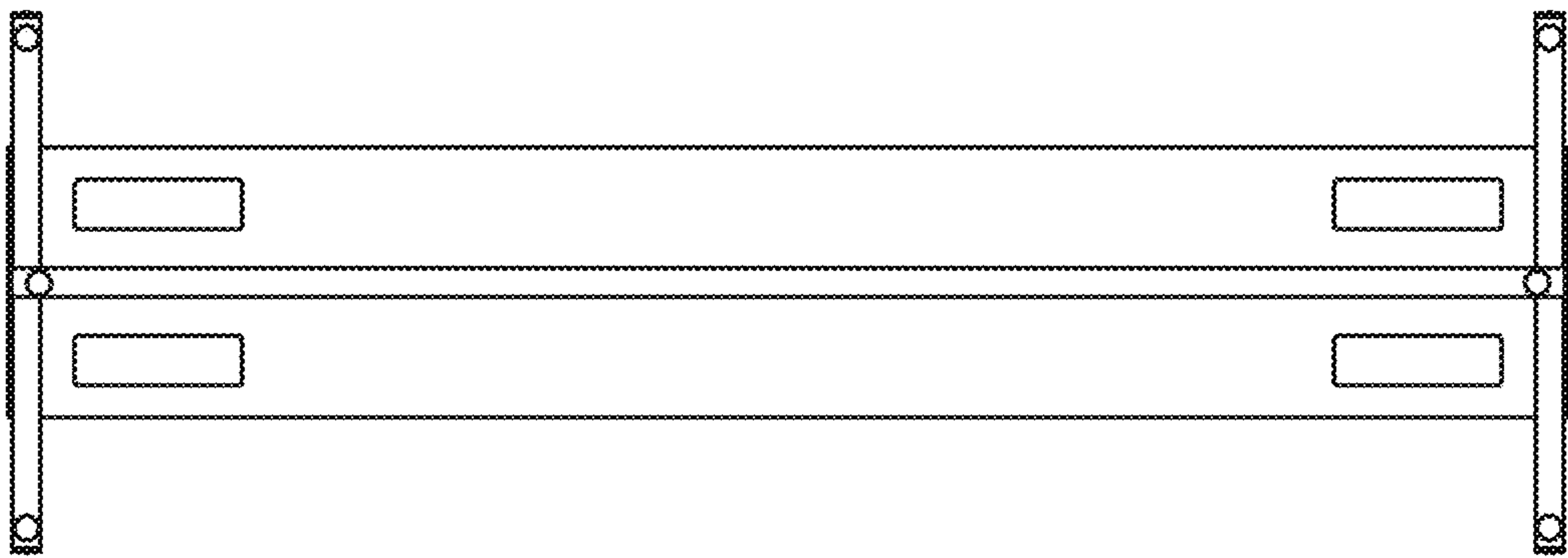

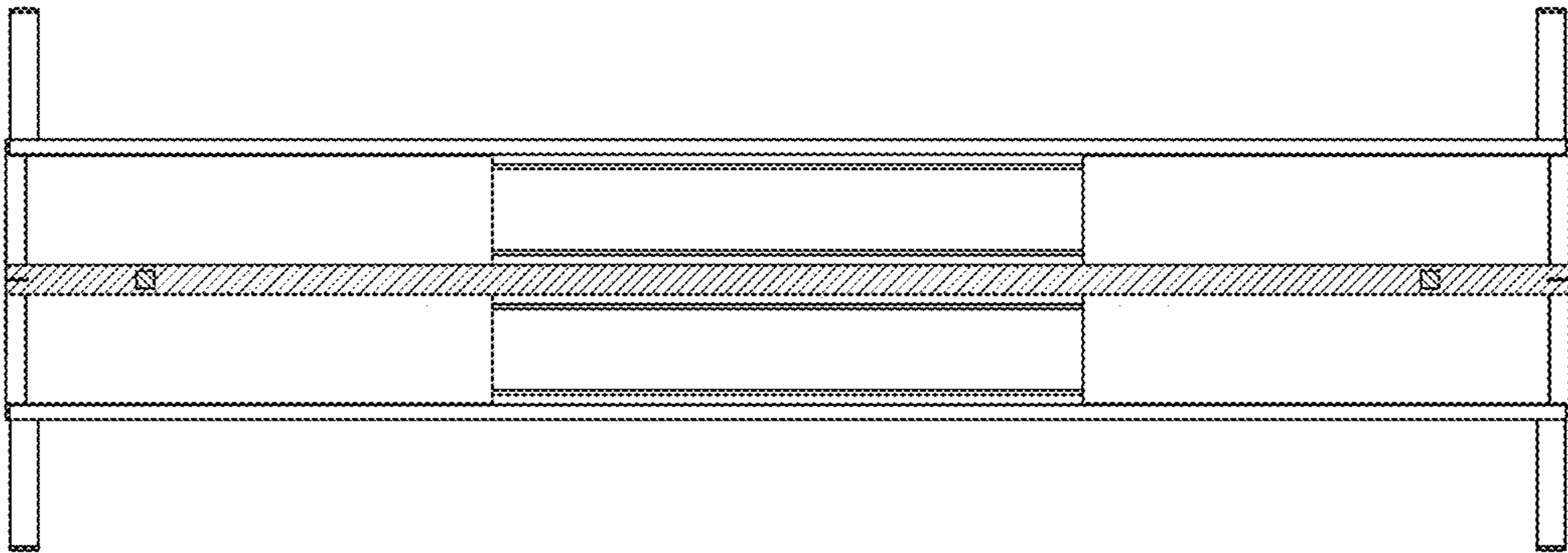

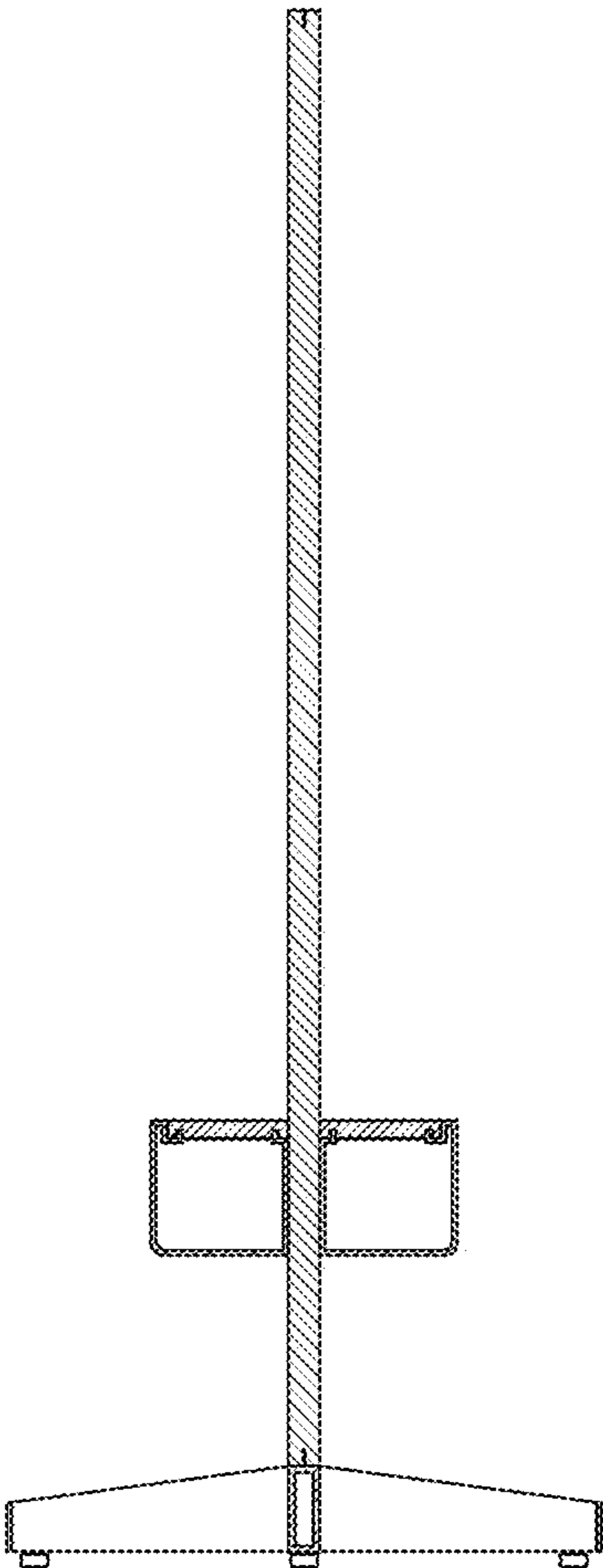
