DESCRIPTION

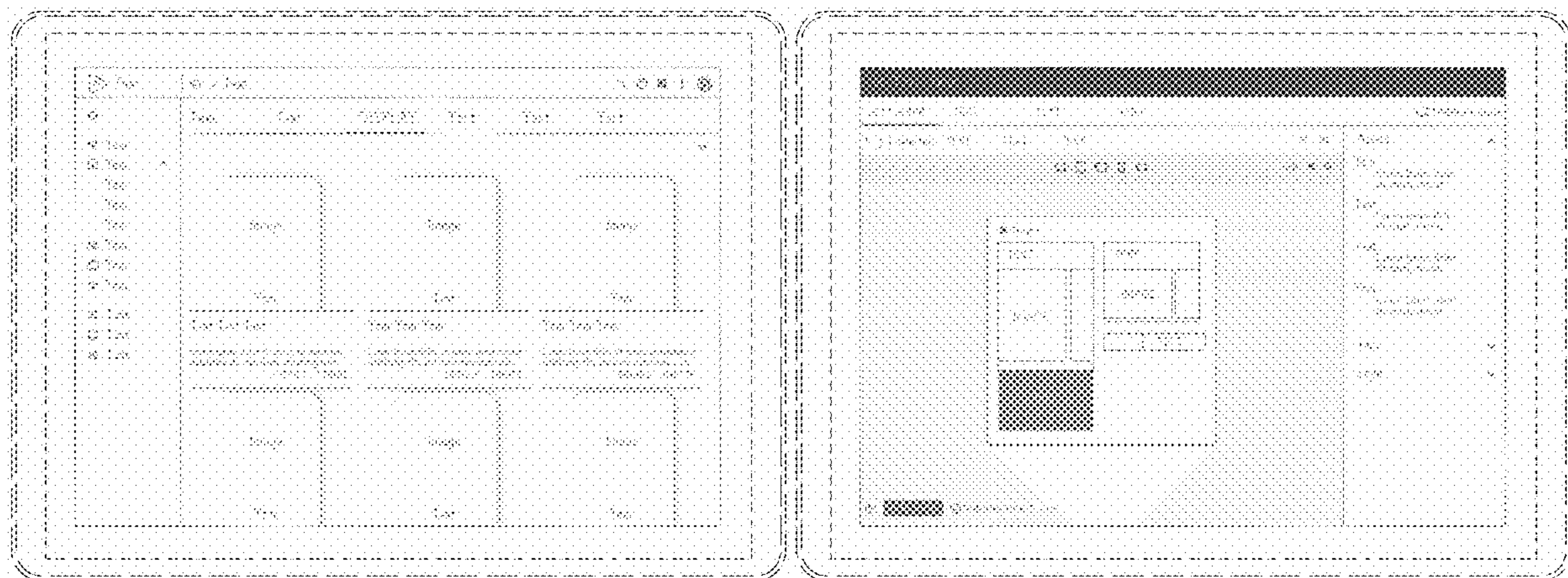
FIG. 1 is a front view of a computer display screen or portion
thereof with animated graphical user interface showing a
first image in a sequence according to the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a front view showing a second image thereof; and,
FIG. 3 is a front view showing a third image thereof.

The appearance of the transitional image sequentially transi-
tions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-3. The process
or period in which one image transitions to another image
forms no part of the claimed design.

The shading depicts a contrast in appearance.

The longer-dash broken lines at the periphery of the figures
show a portion of a computer and the intermediate-length
broken lines show the display screen of the computer. The
remaining broken lines illustrate features within the inter-
face. The broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

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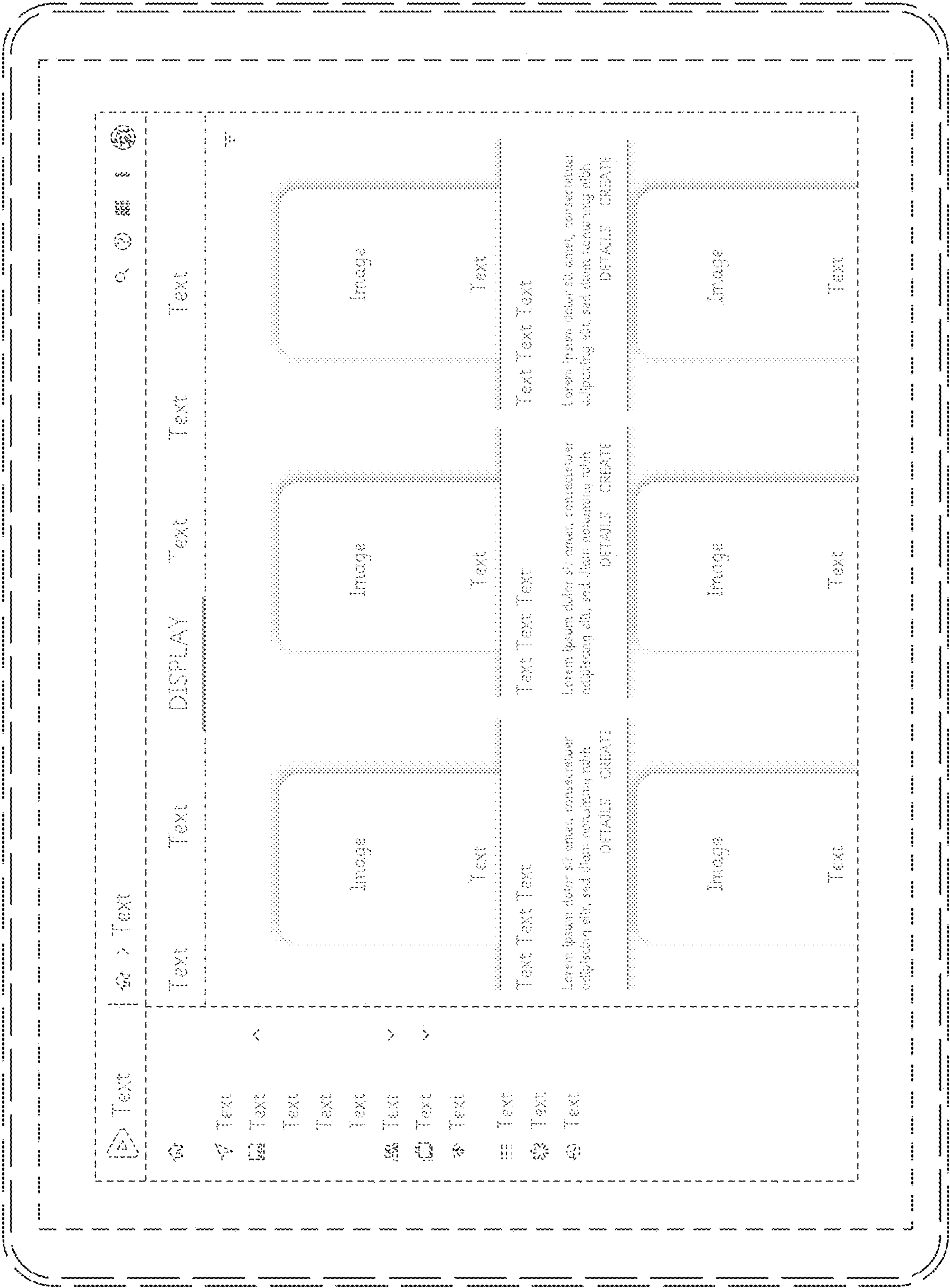

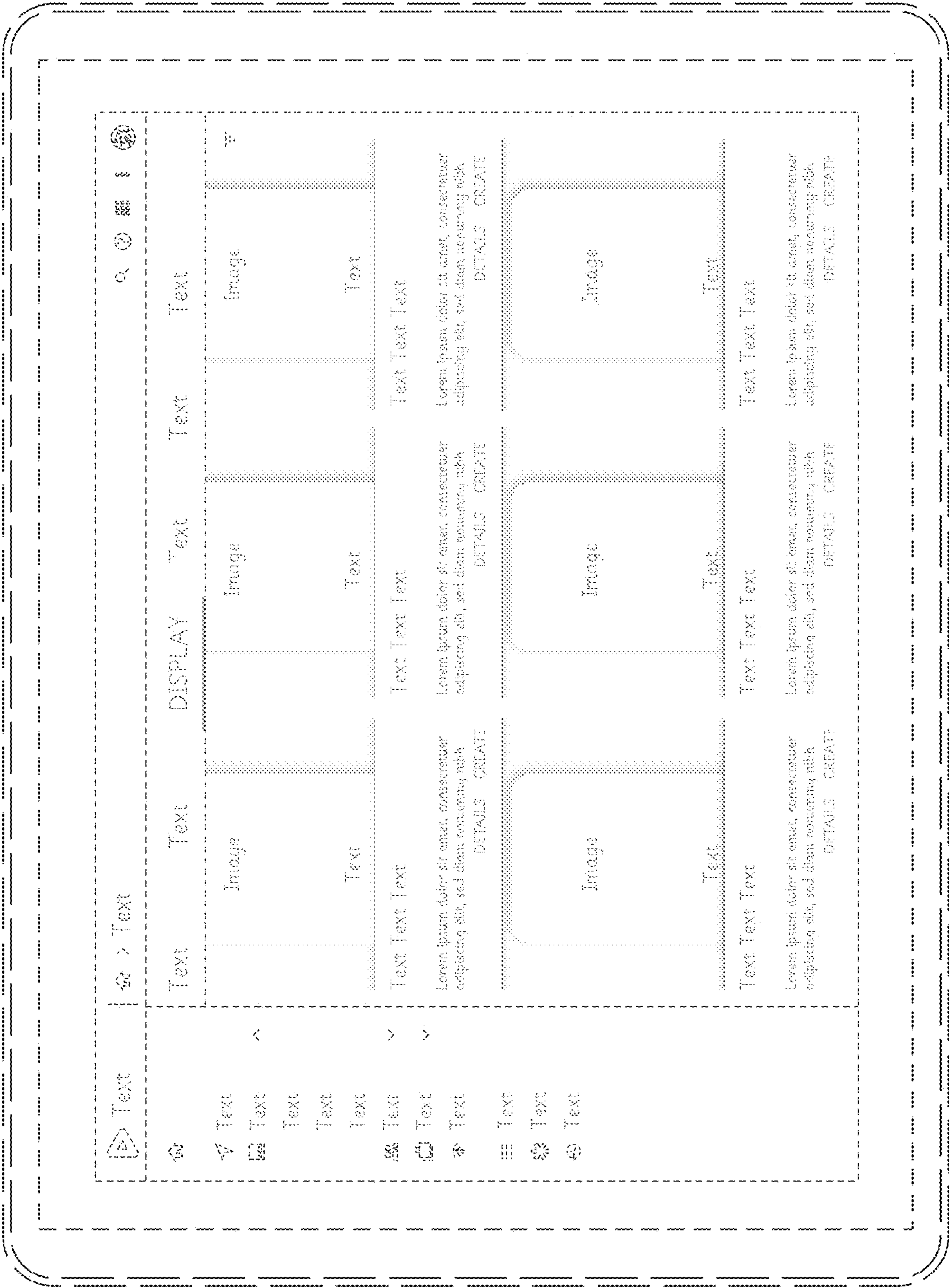

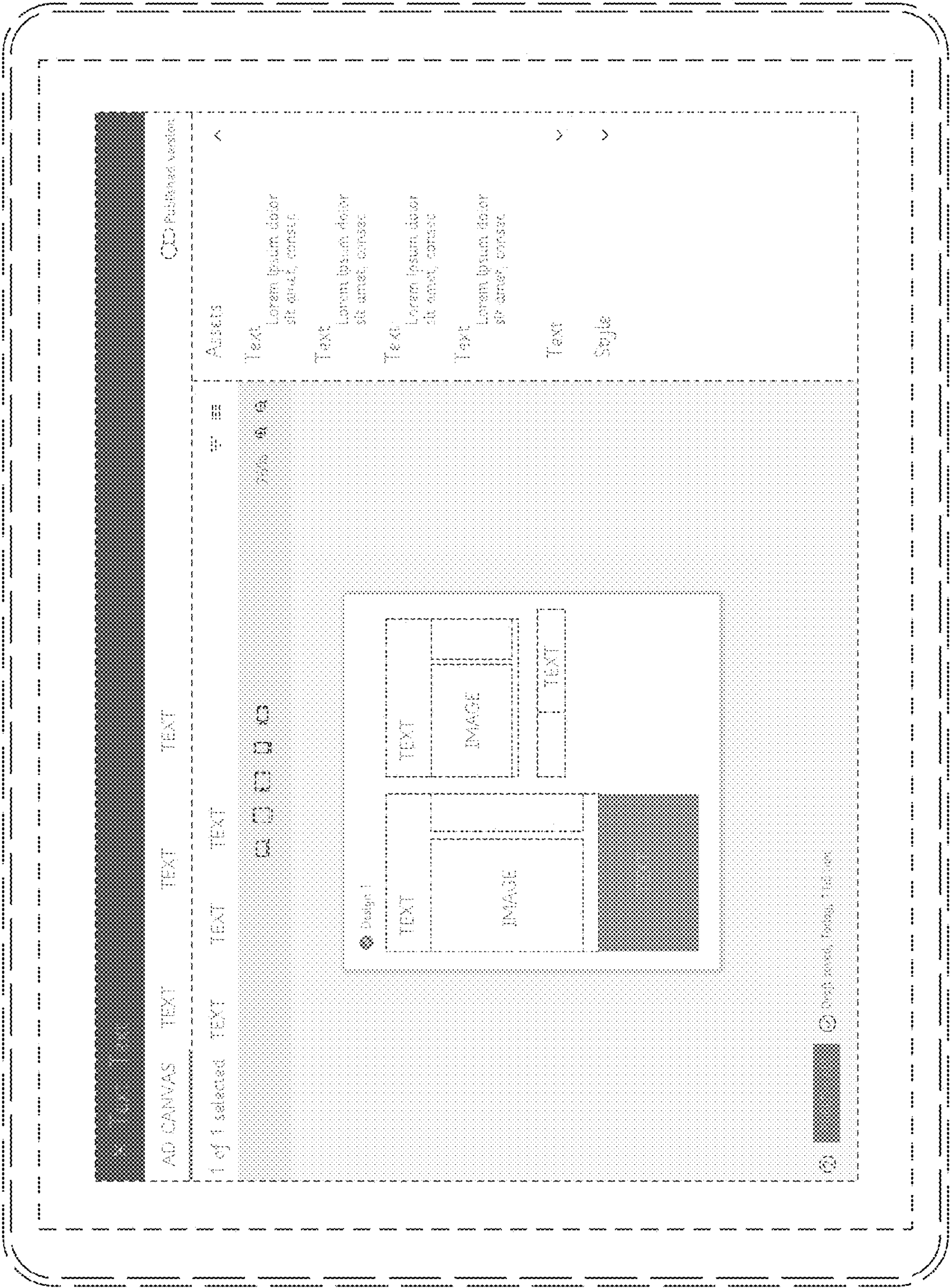
