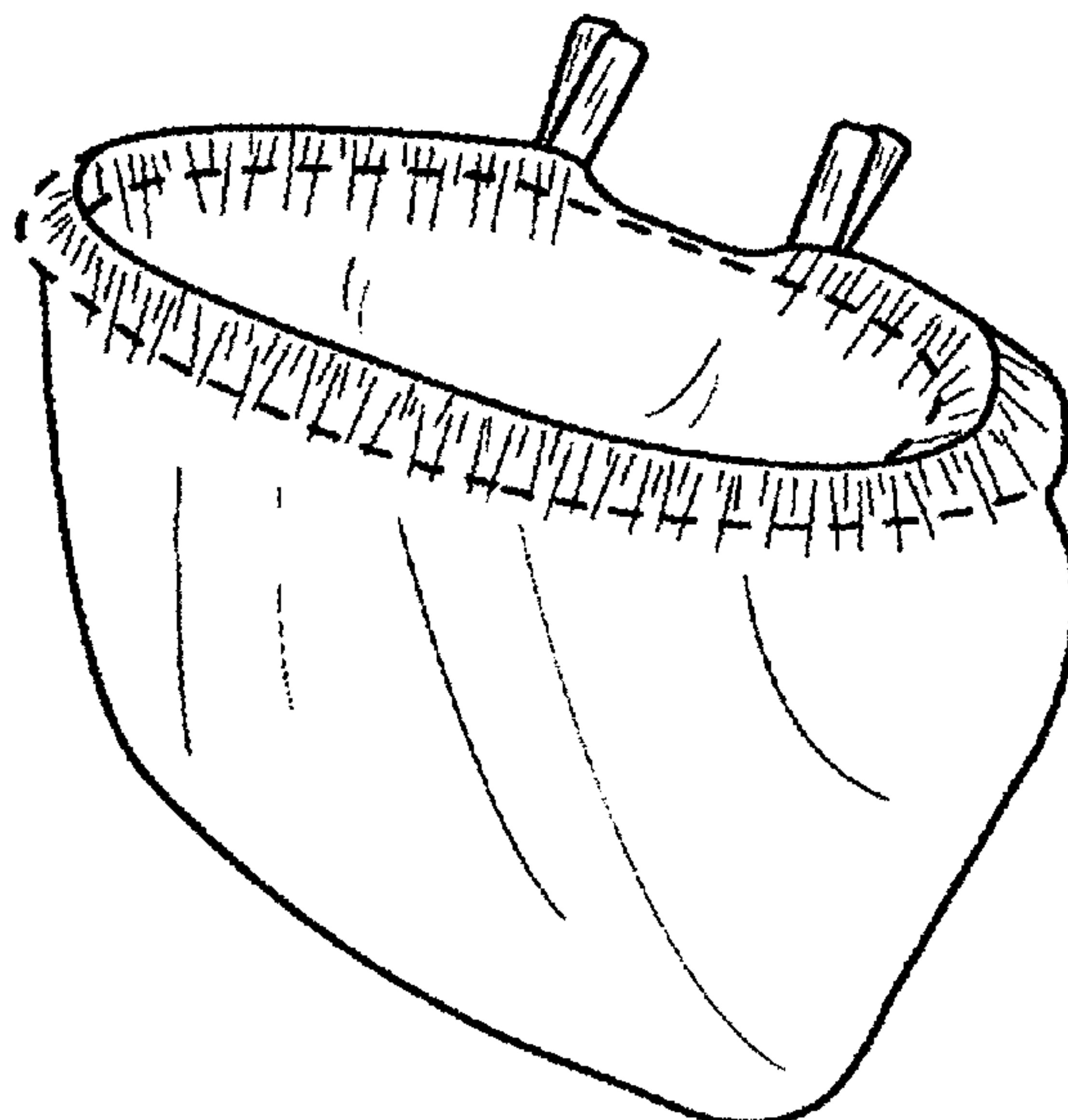
I claim the ornamental design for a handlebar bag, as shown
and described.

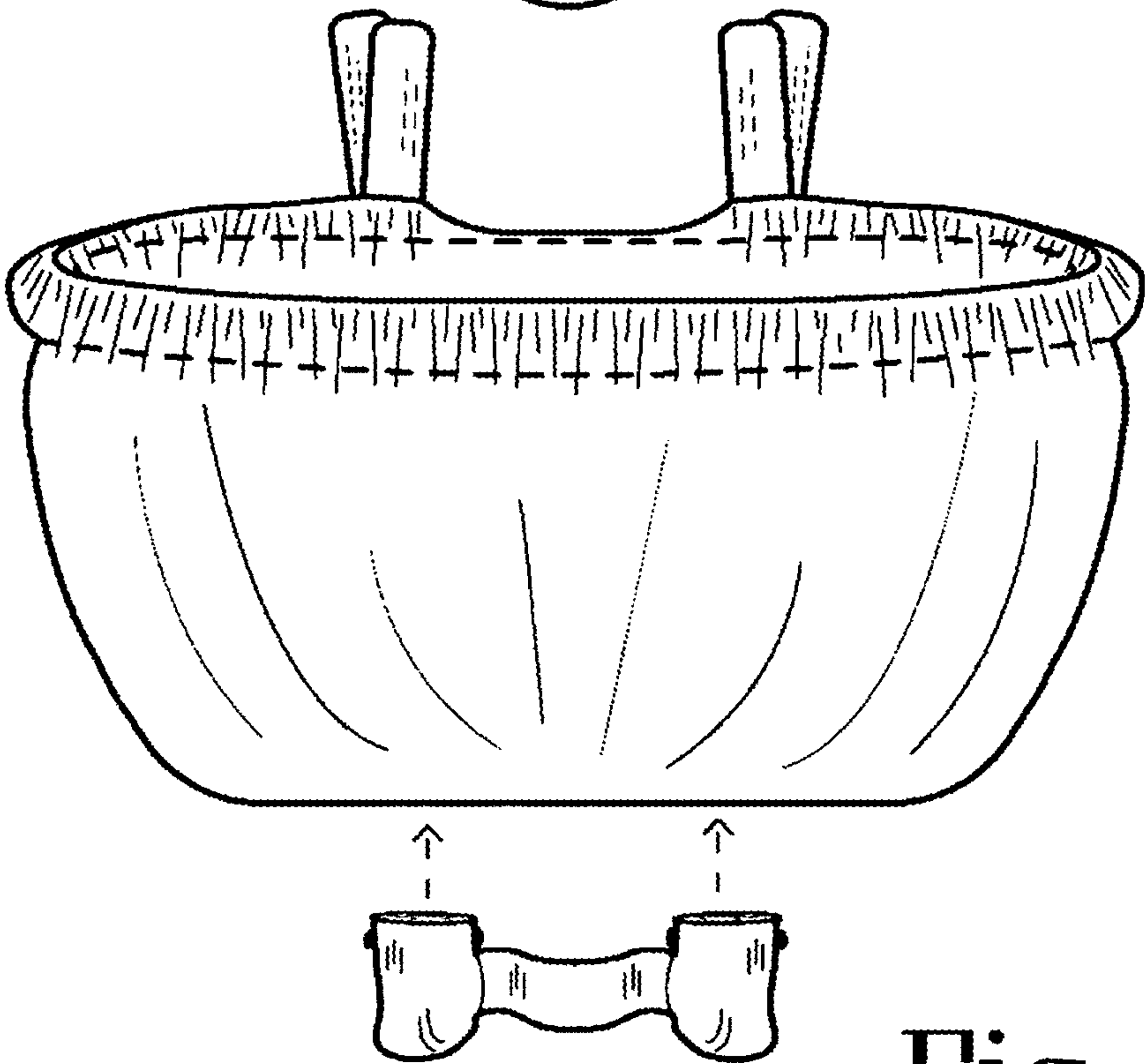
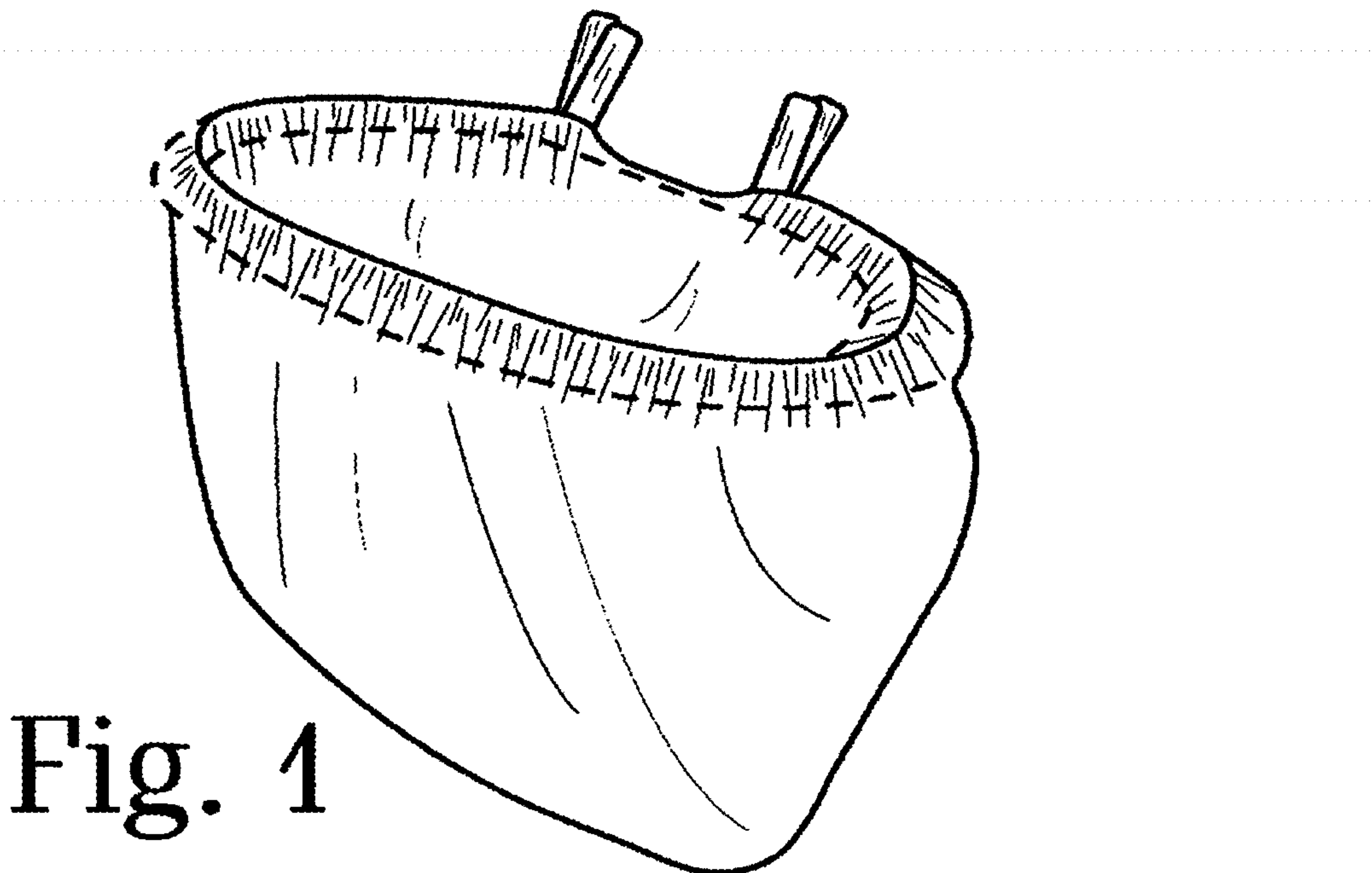
DESCRIPTION

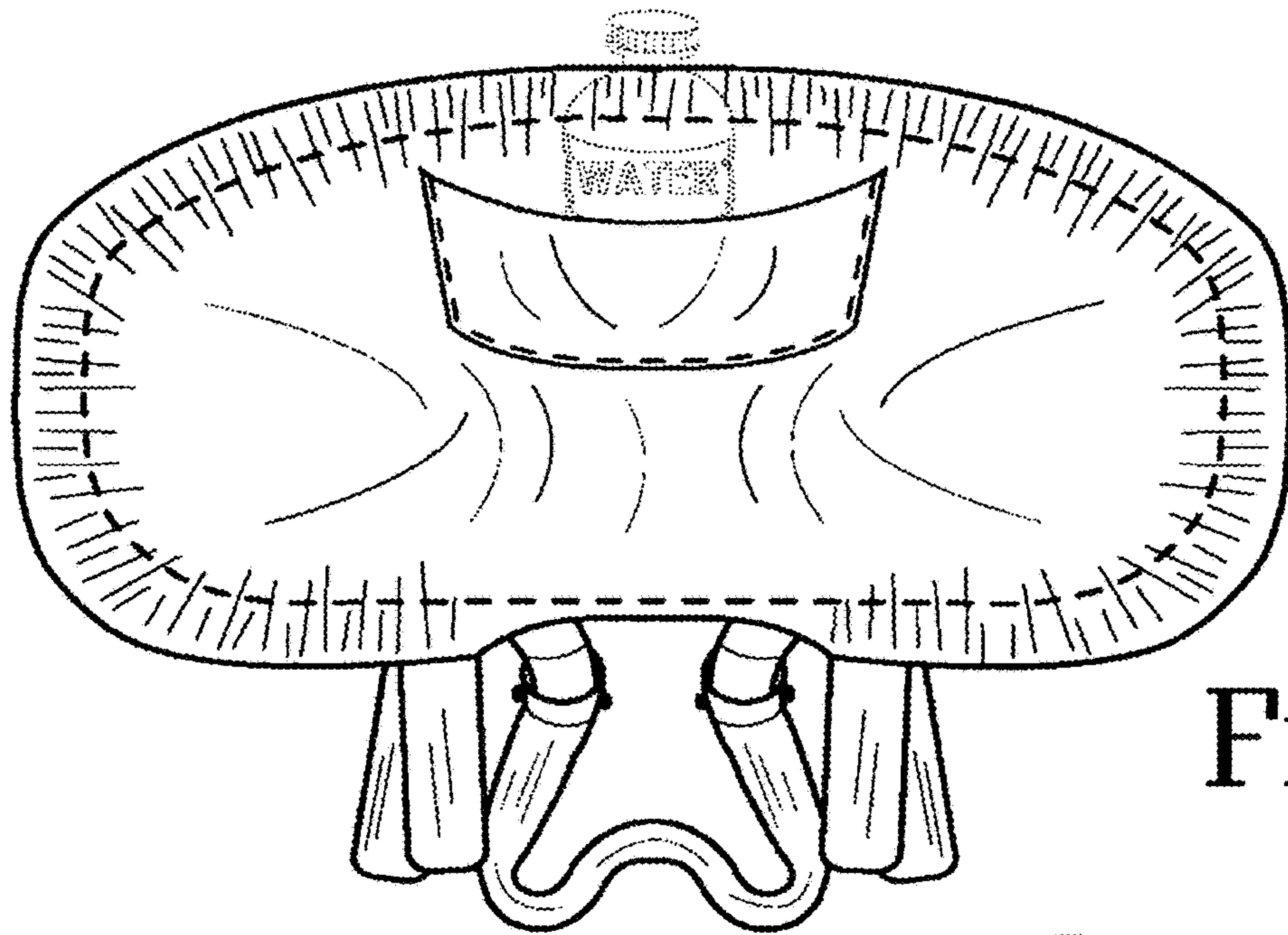

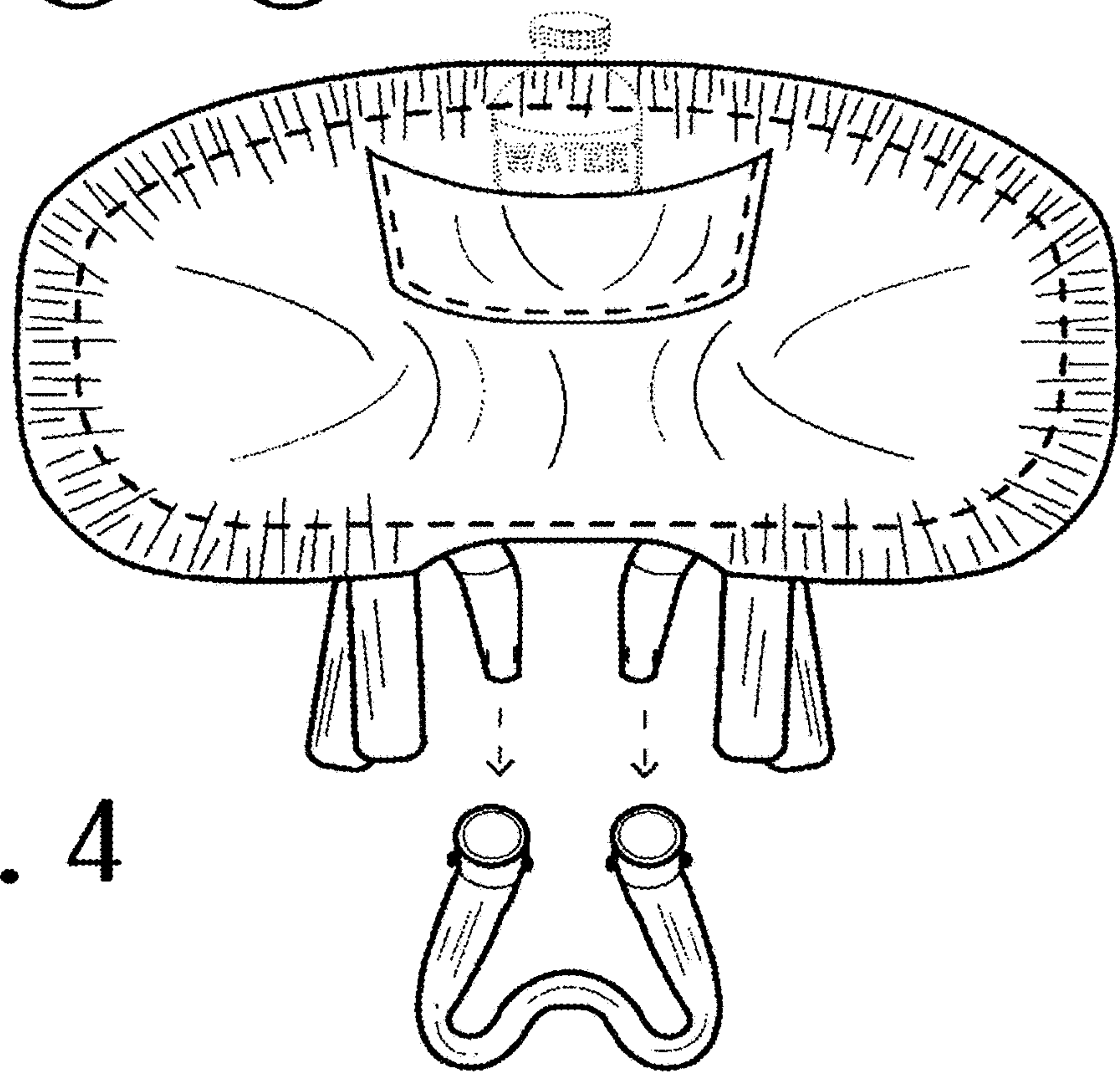

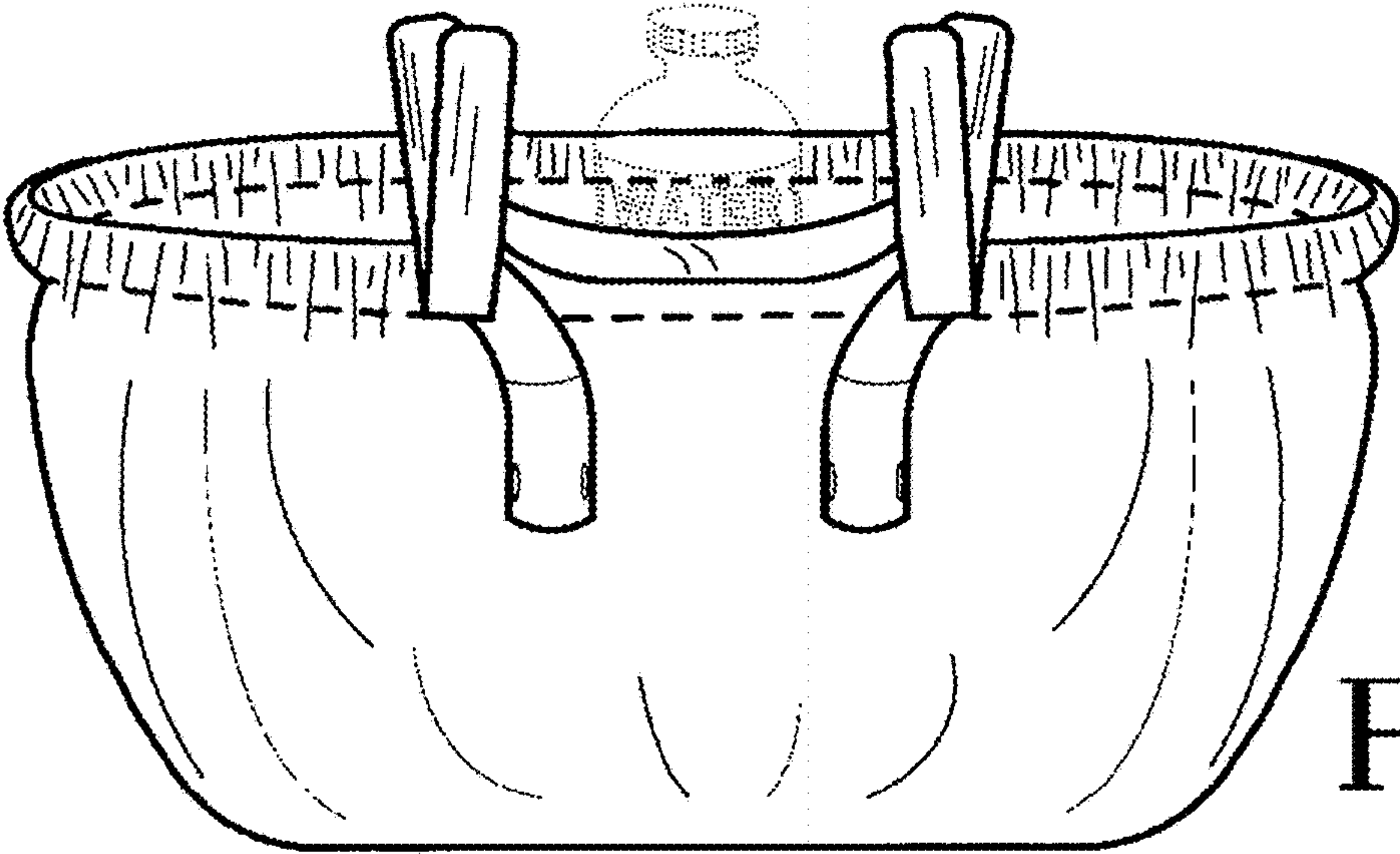
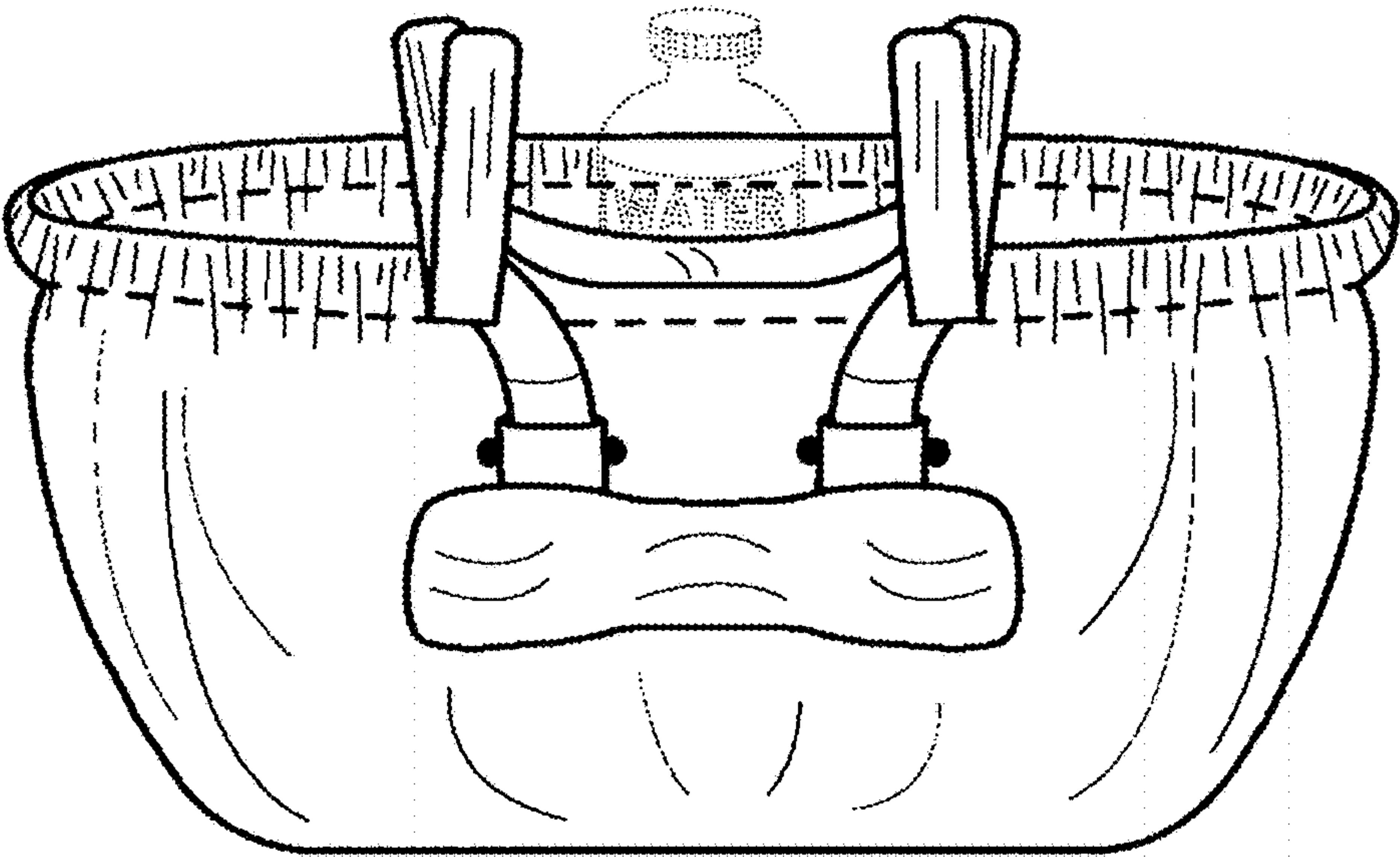
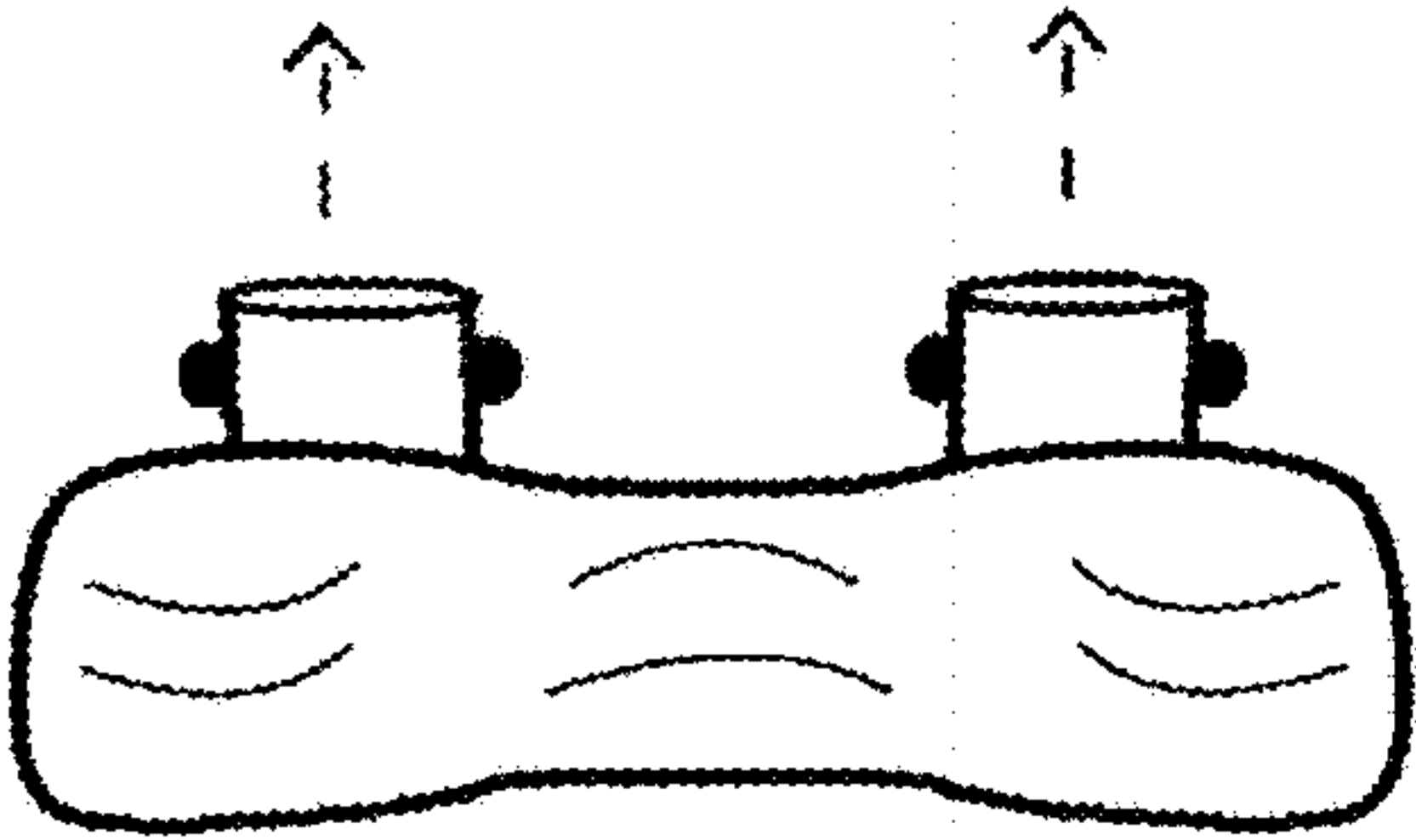

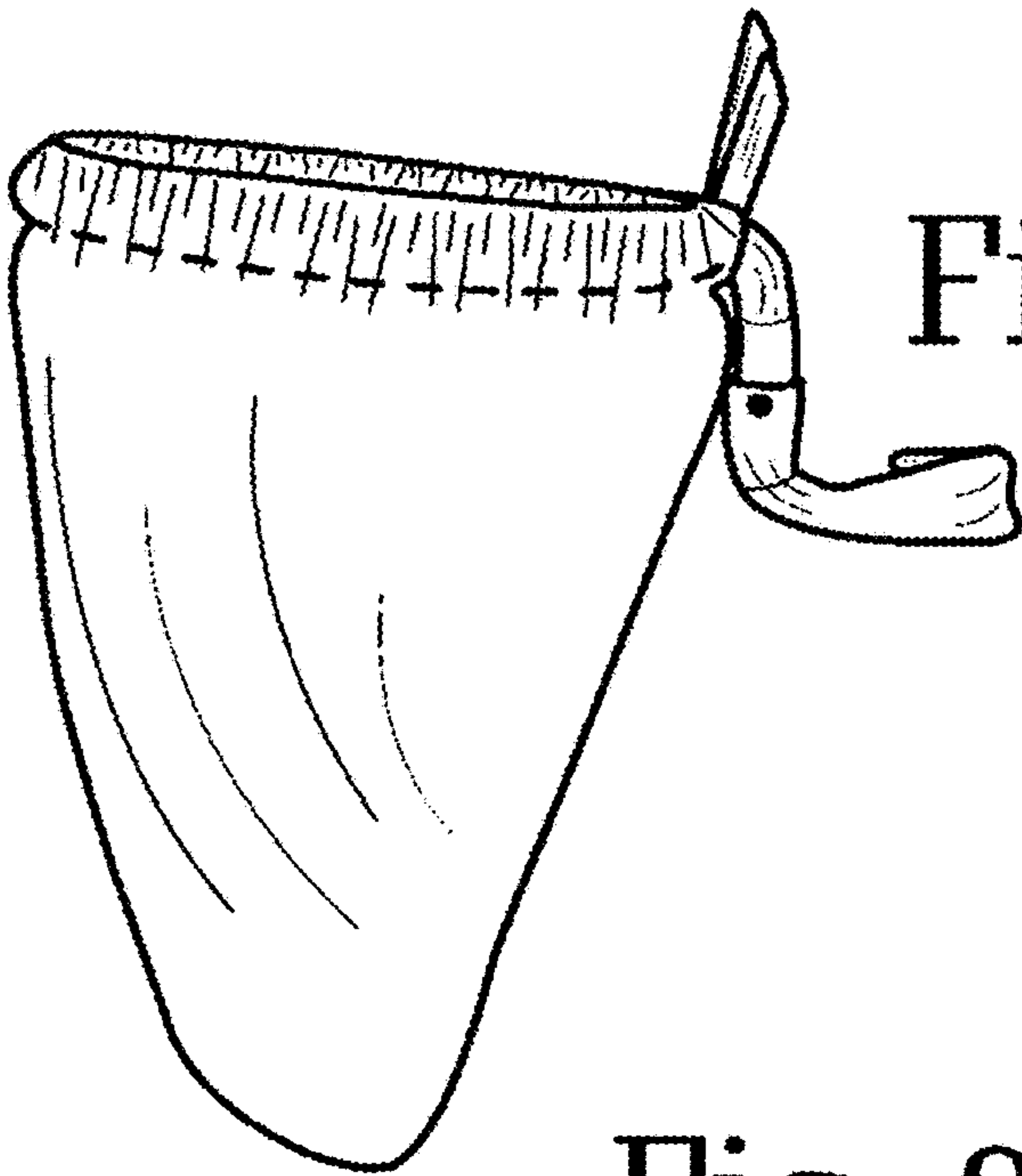

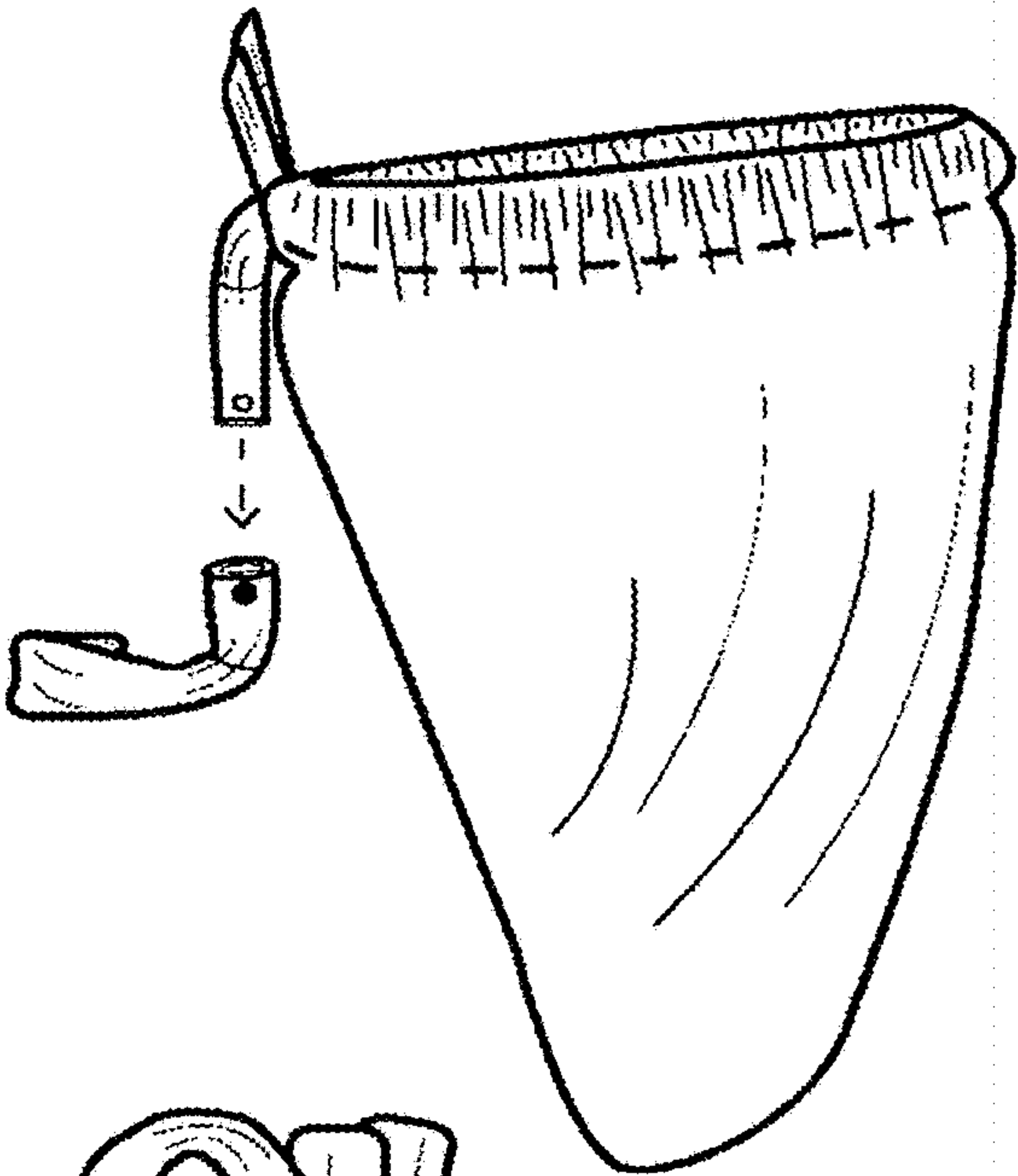

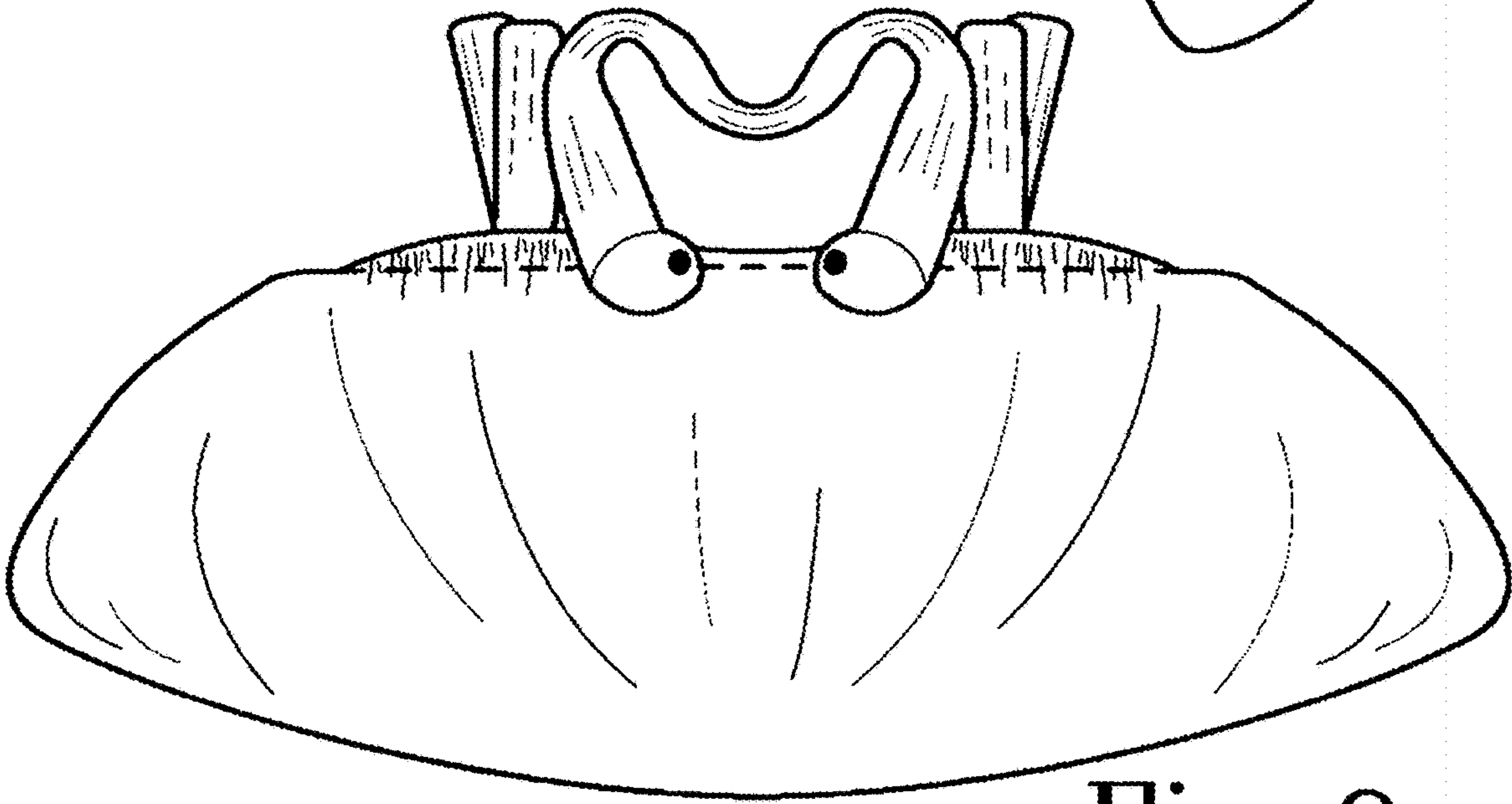

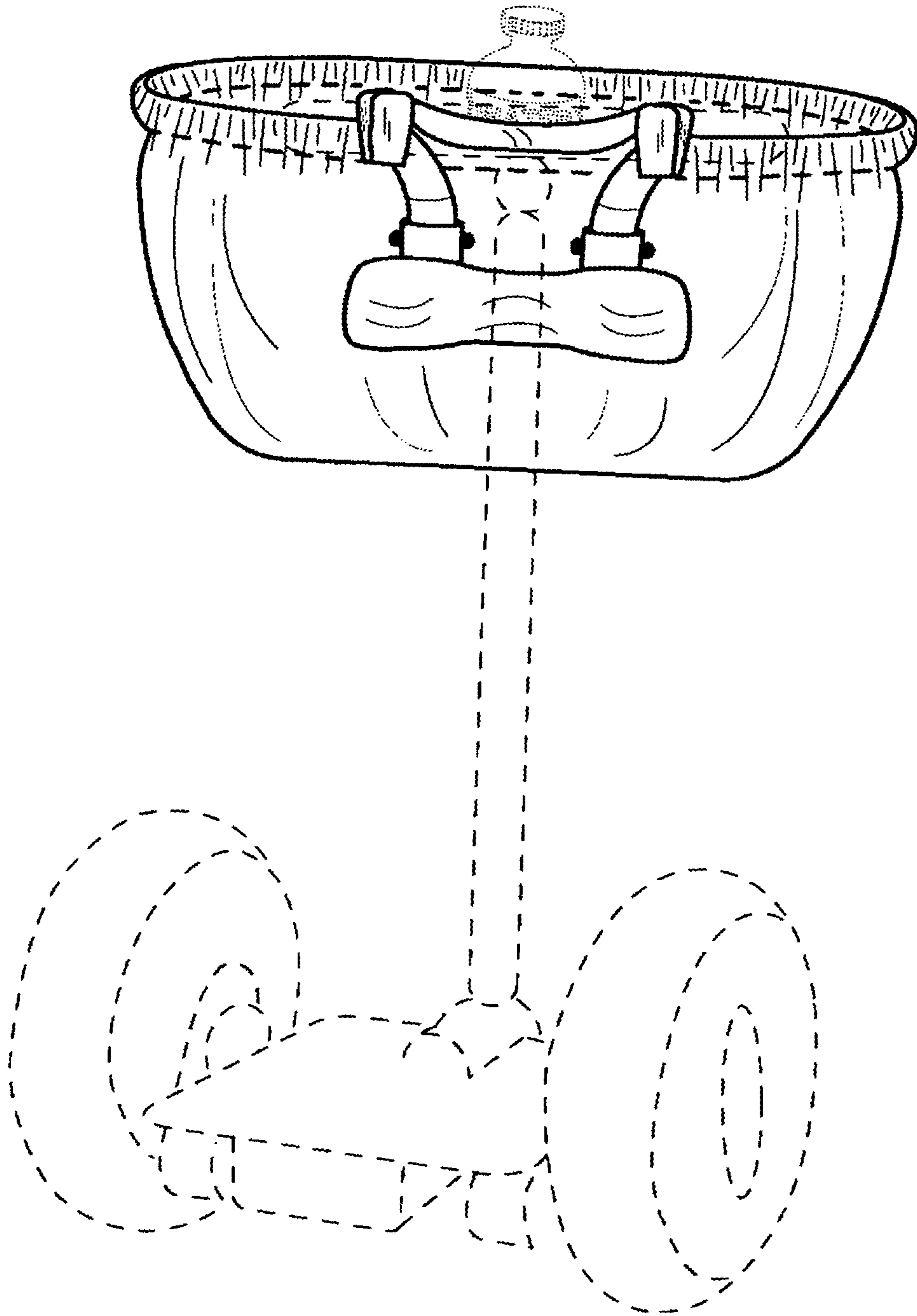

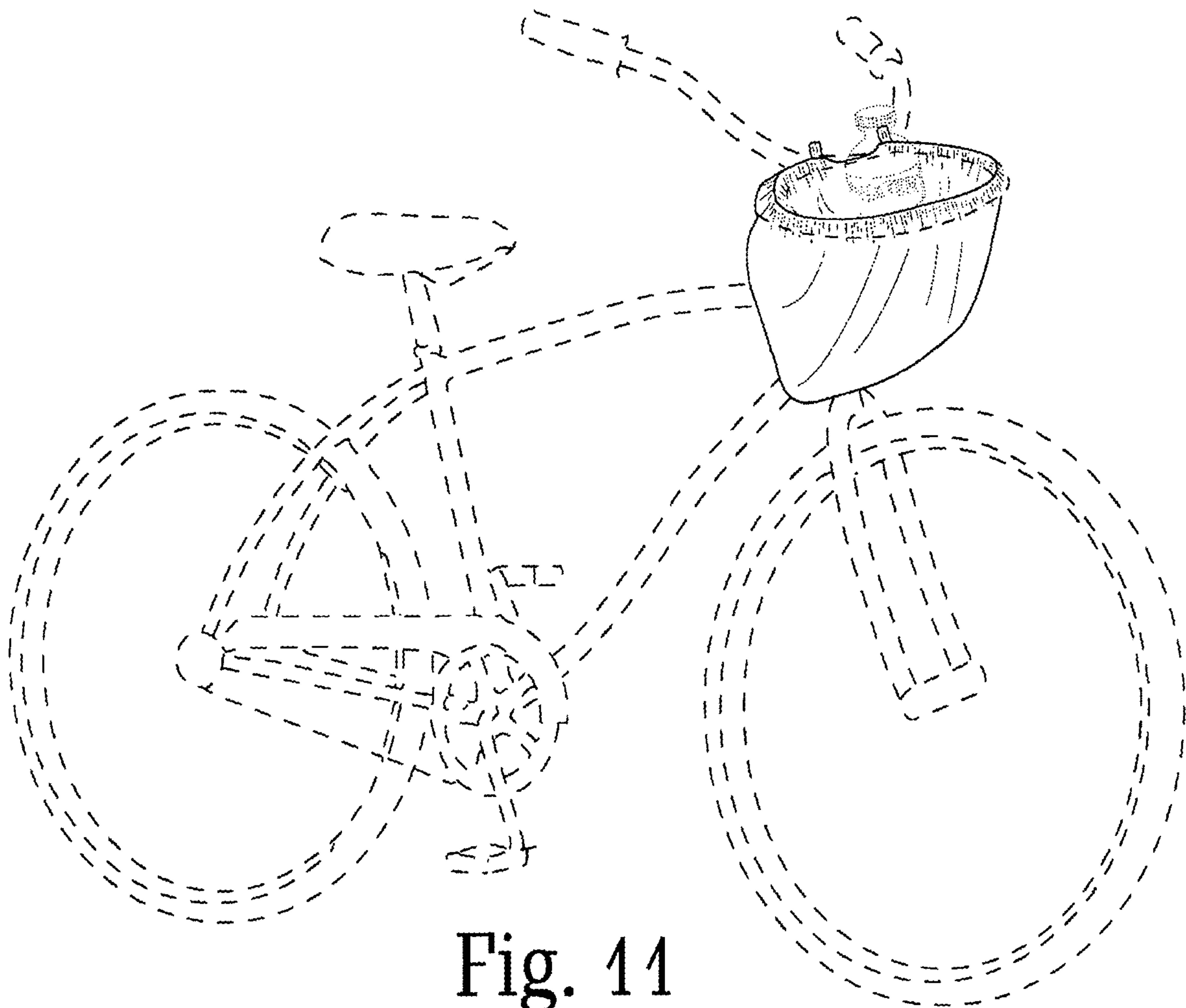
