(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an electronic device with graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of an electronic device having a display screen with graphical user interface applied to the display screen showing the claimed design; and, FIG. 2 is a front view of an alternative electronic device showing the graphical user interface of FIG. 1 applied thereto.

The dot-dash broken lines in FIG. 1 illustrate an electronic device. The dot-dash broken lines in FIG. 2 illustrate an alternative electronic device. The dashed broken-line perimeter surrounding the icons in the figures illustrates the perimeter of the display screen of the electronic device and the alternative electronic device. All remaining dashed broken lines in the figures show portions of the graphical user interface. The dashed broken lines and dot-dash broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

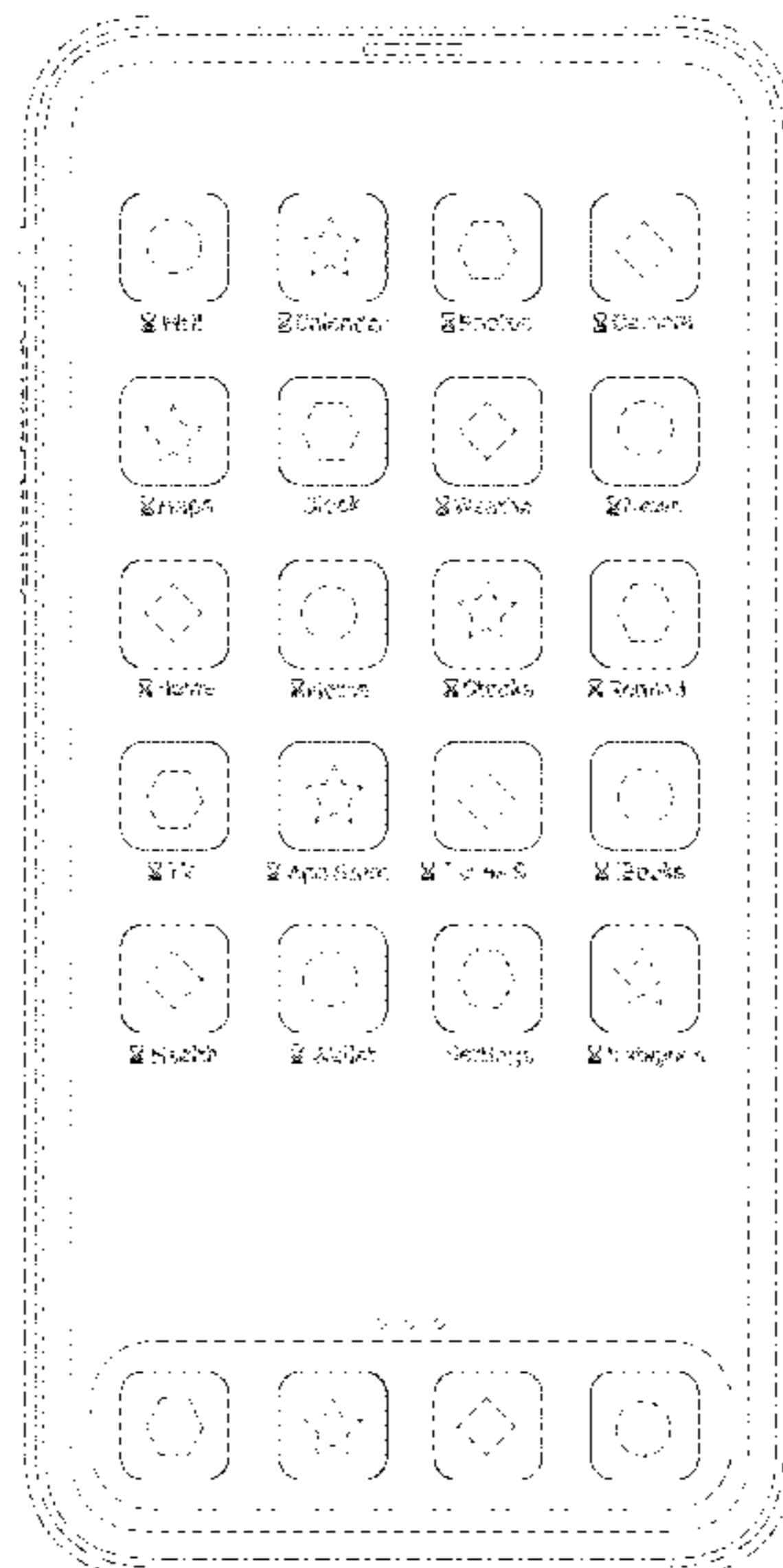

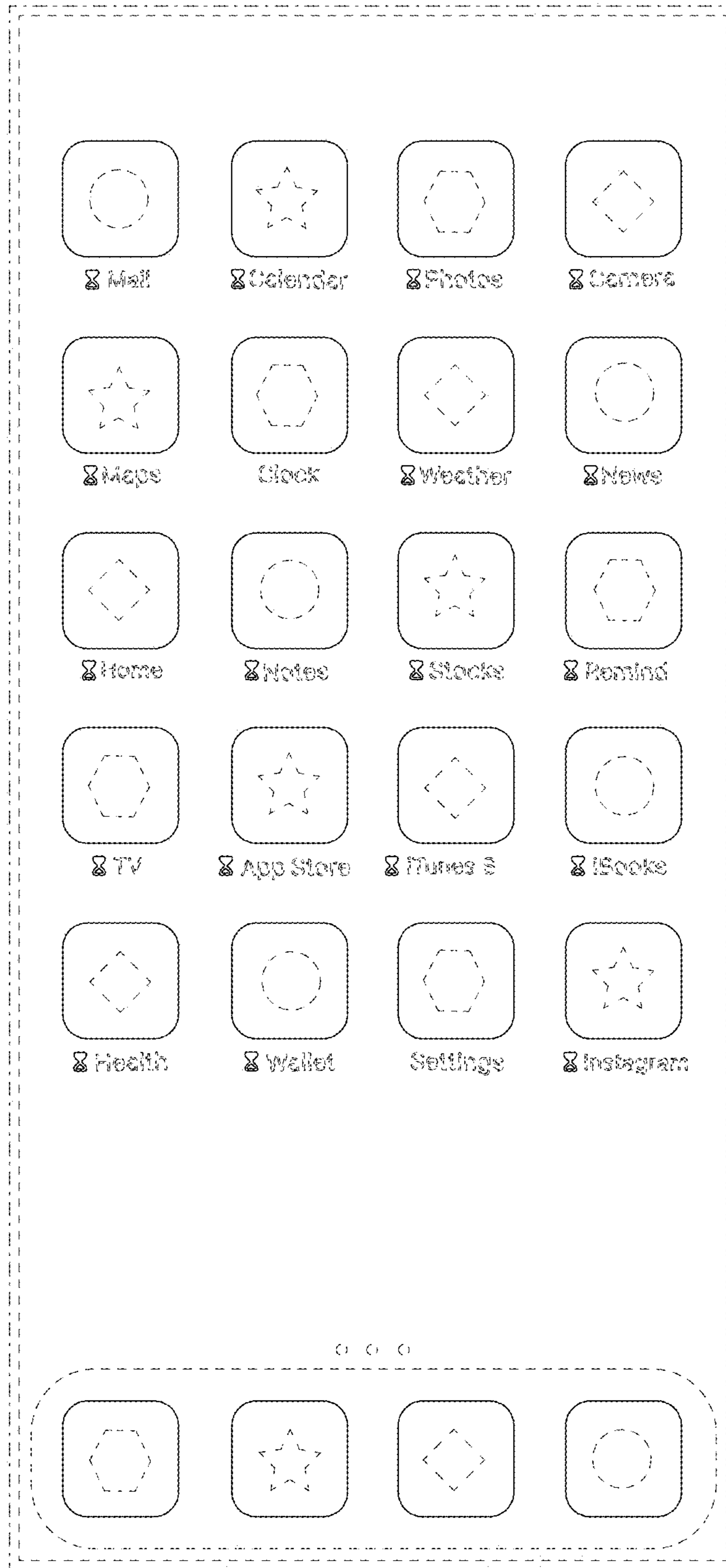

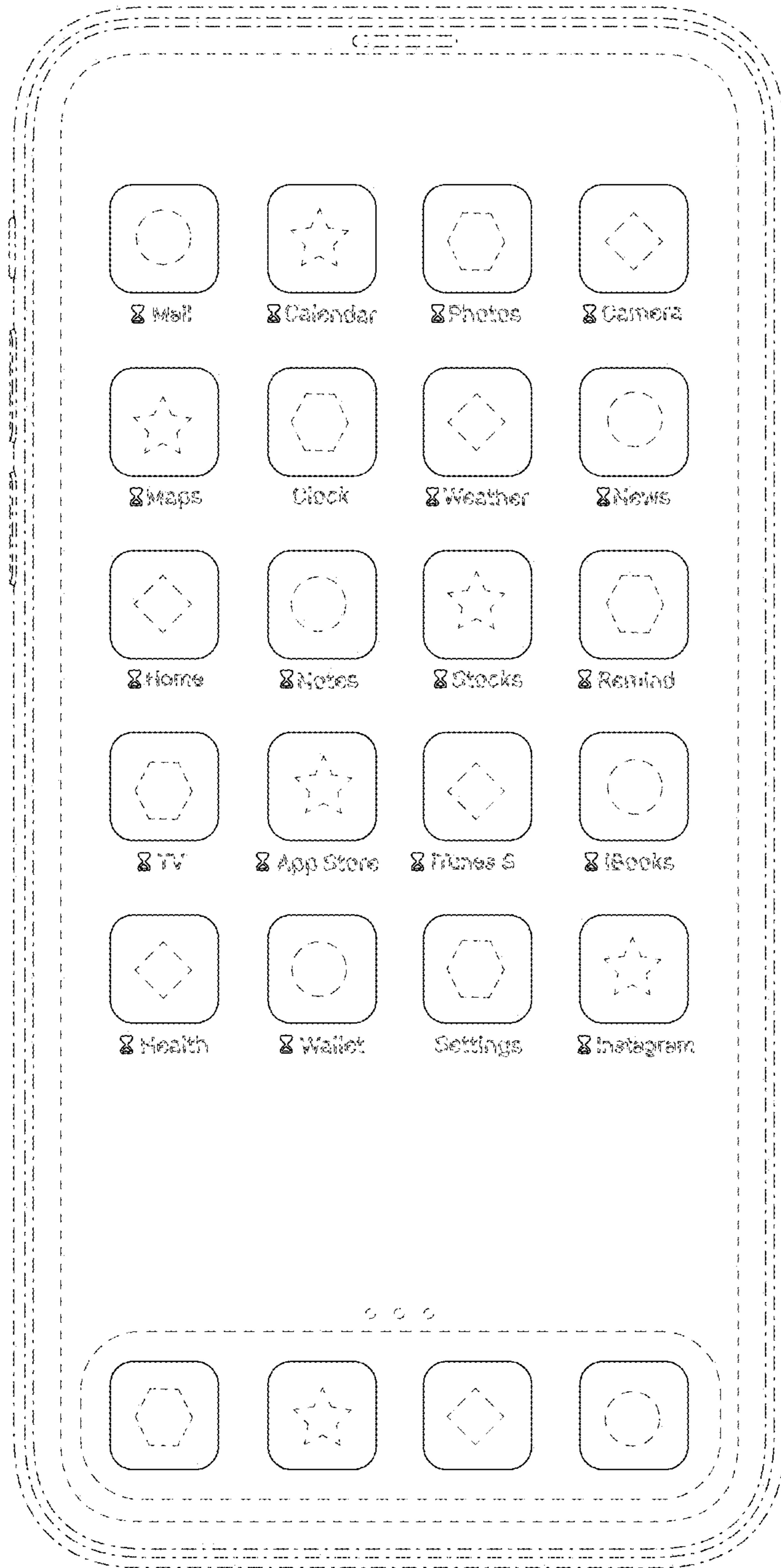
