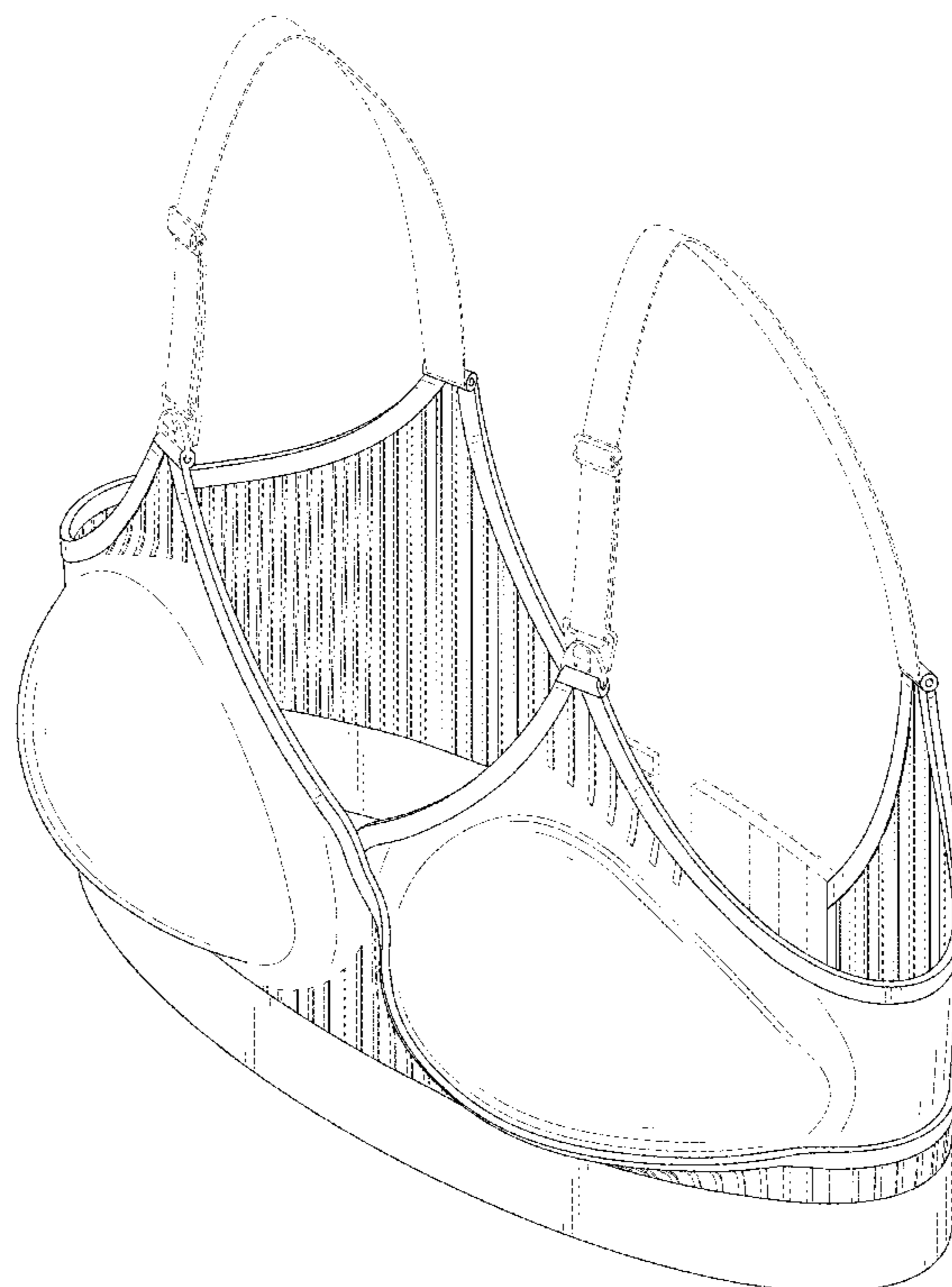
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a brassiere, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a first embodiment of a brassiere, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 9 is another front elevational view thereof showing the first embodiment of the brassiere when worn; FIG. 10 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a second embodiment of the brassiere; FIG. 11 is a bottom, rear, right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 13 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 14 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 16 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 17 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 18 is another front elevational view thereof showing the second embodiment of the brassiere when worn. The broken lines in the drawings show portions of the brassiere or environmental features which form no part of the claimed design.

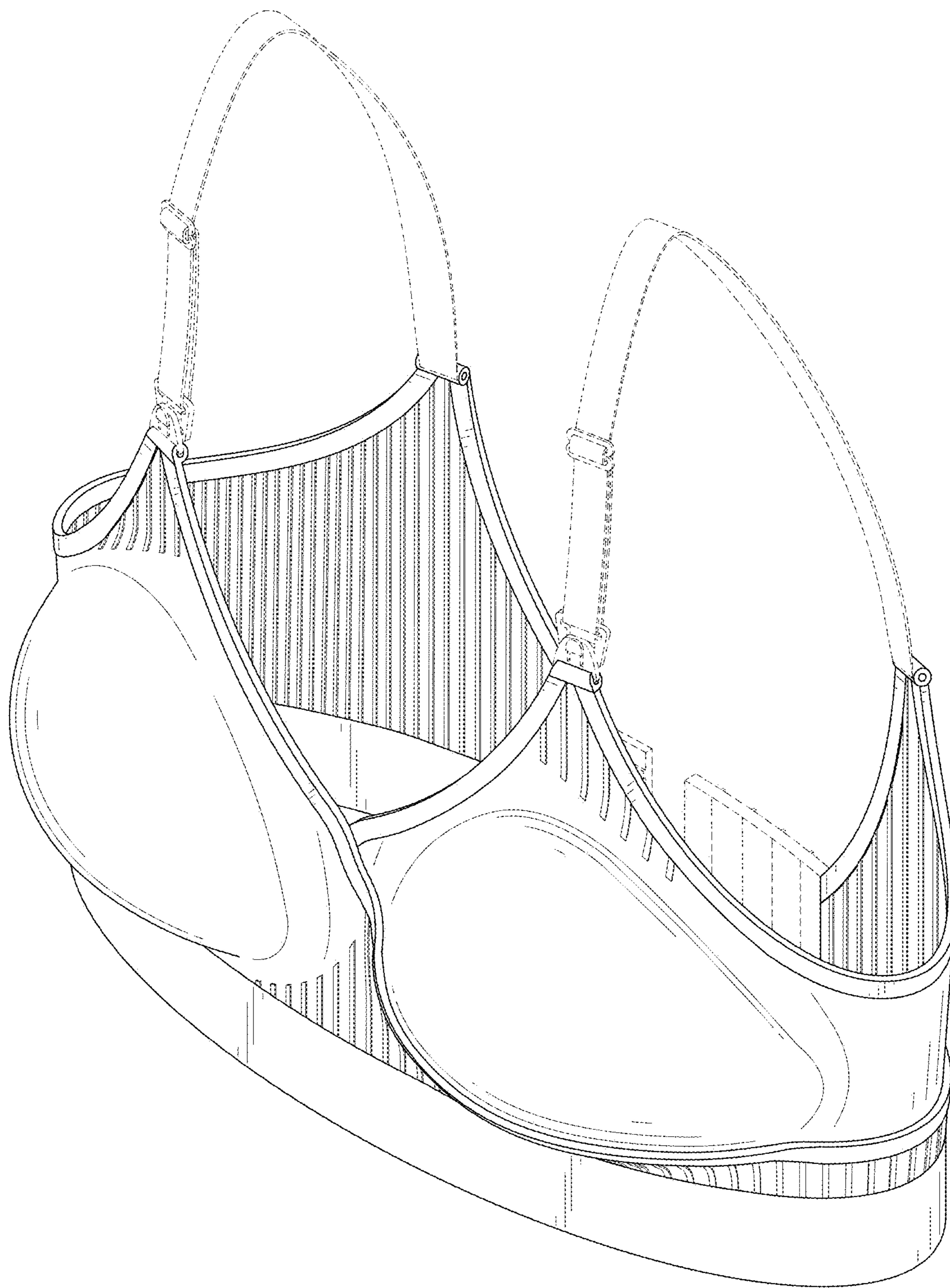

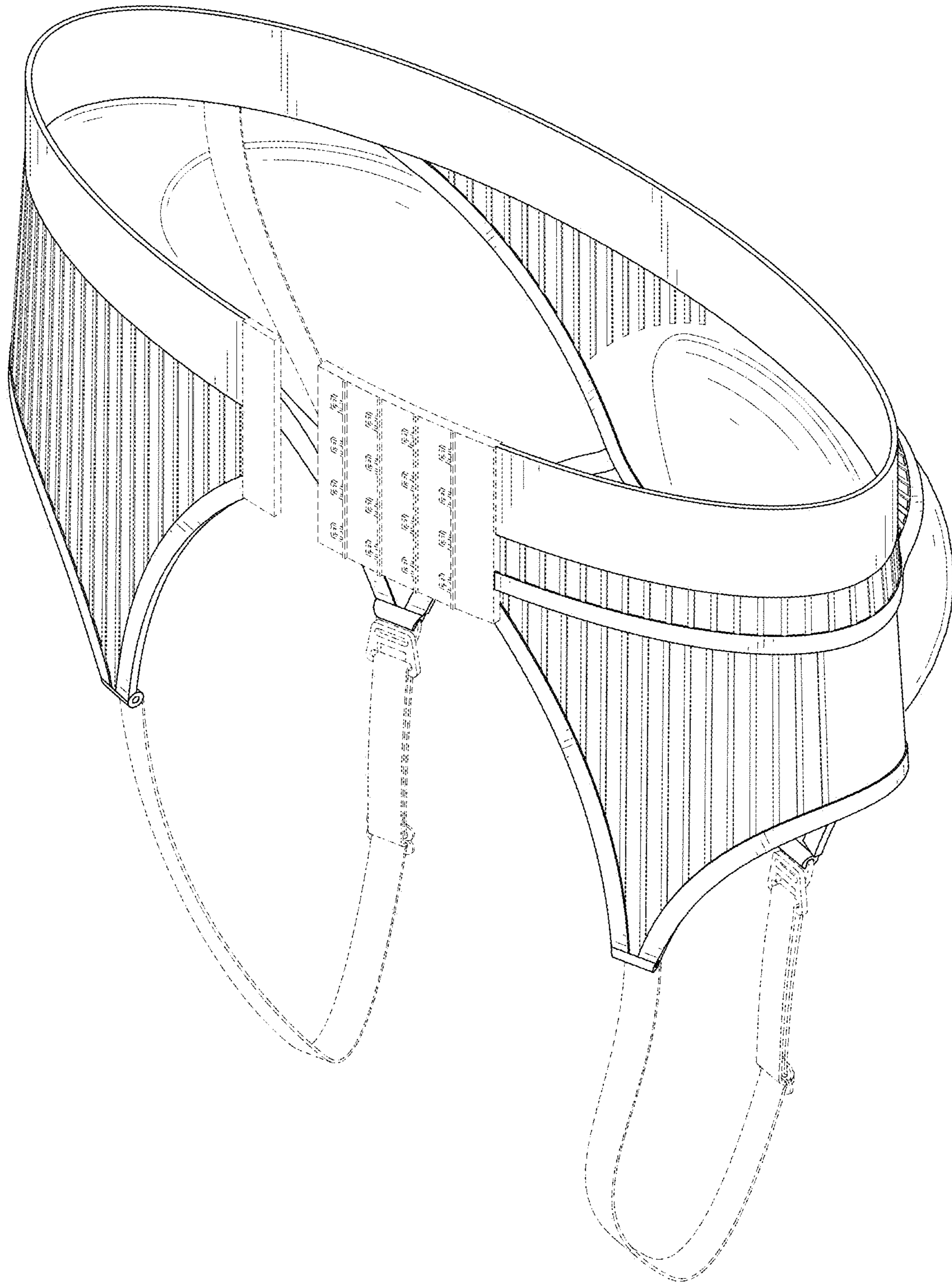

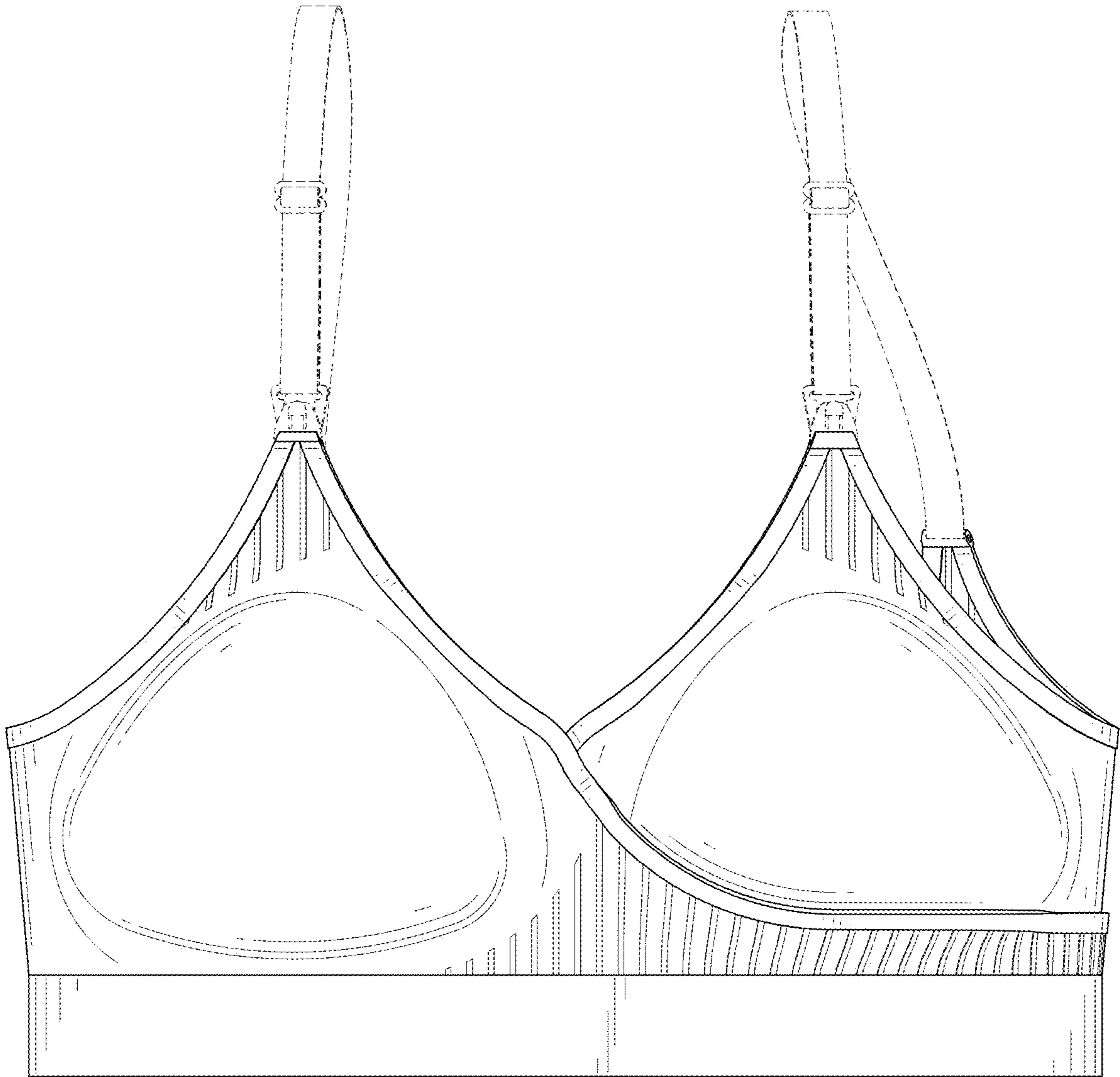

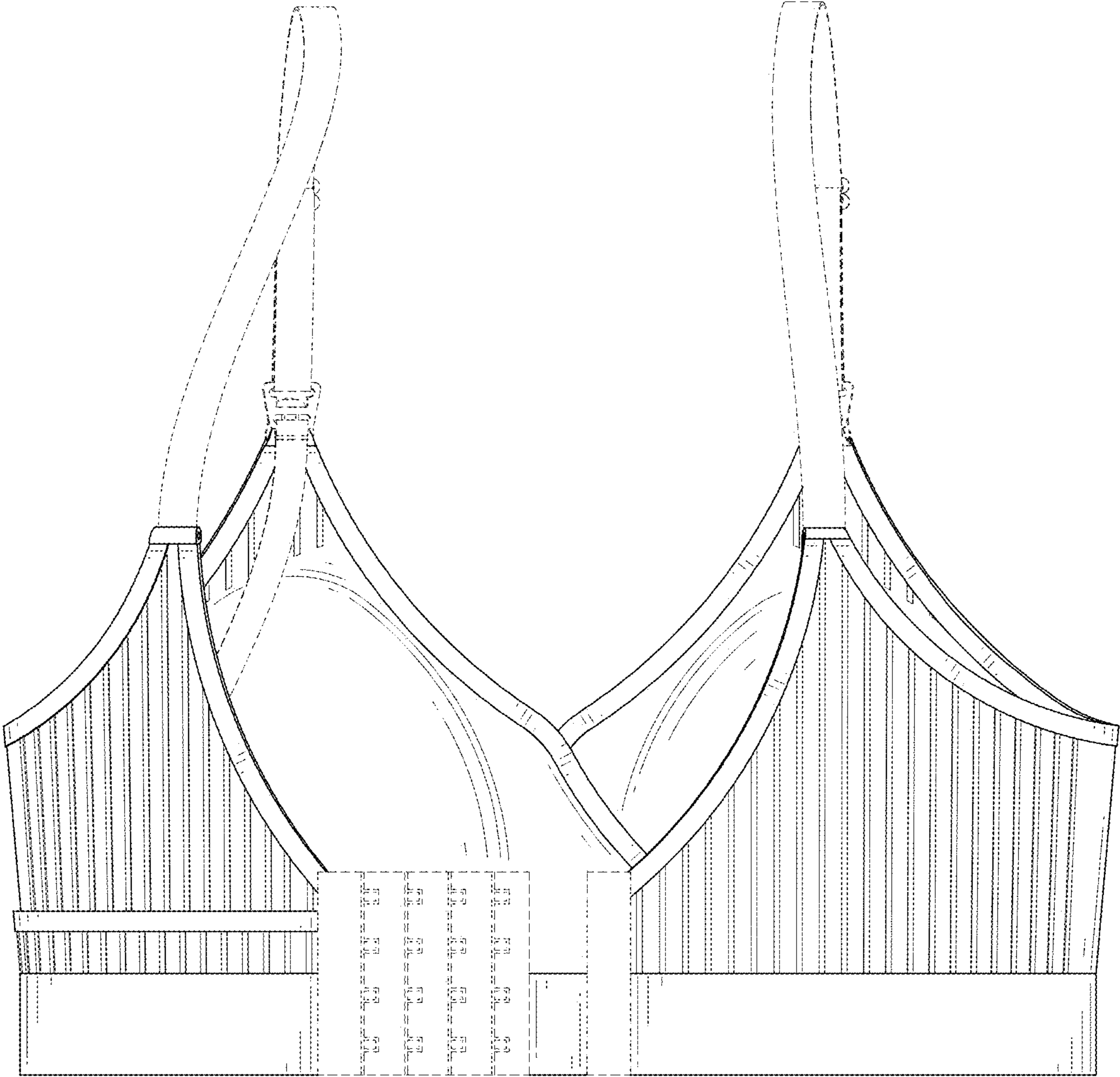

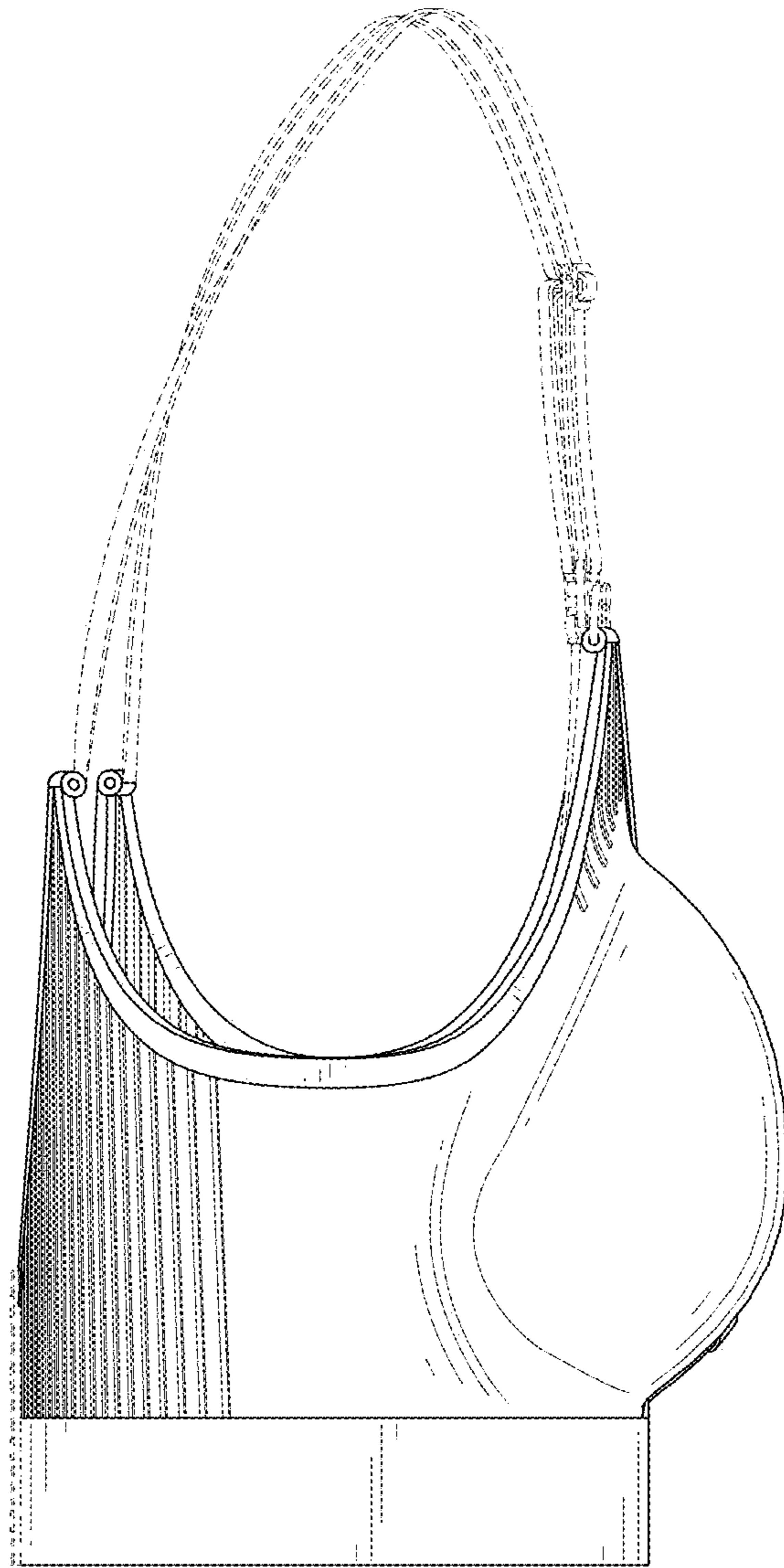

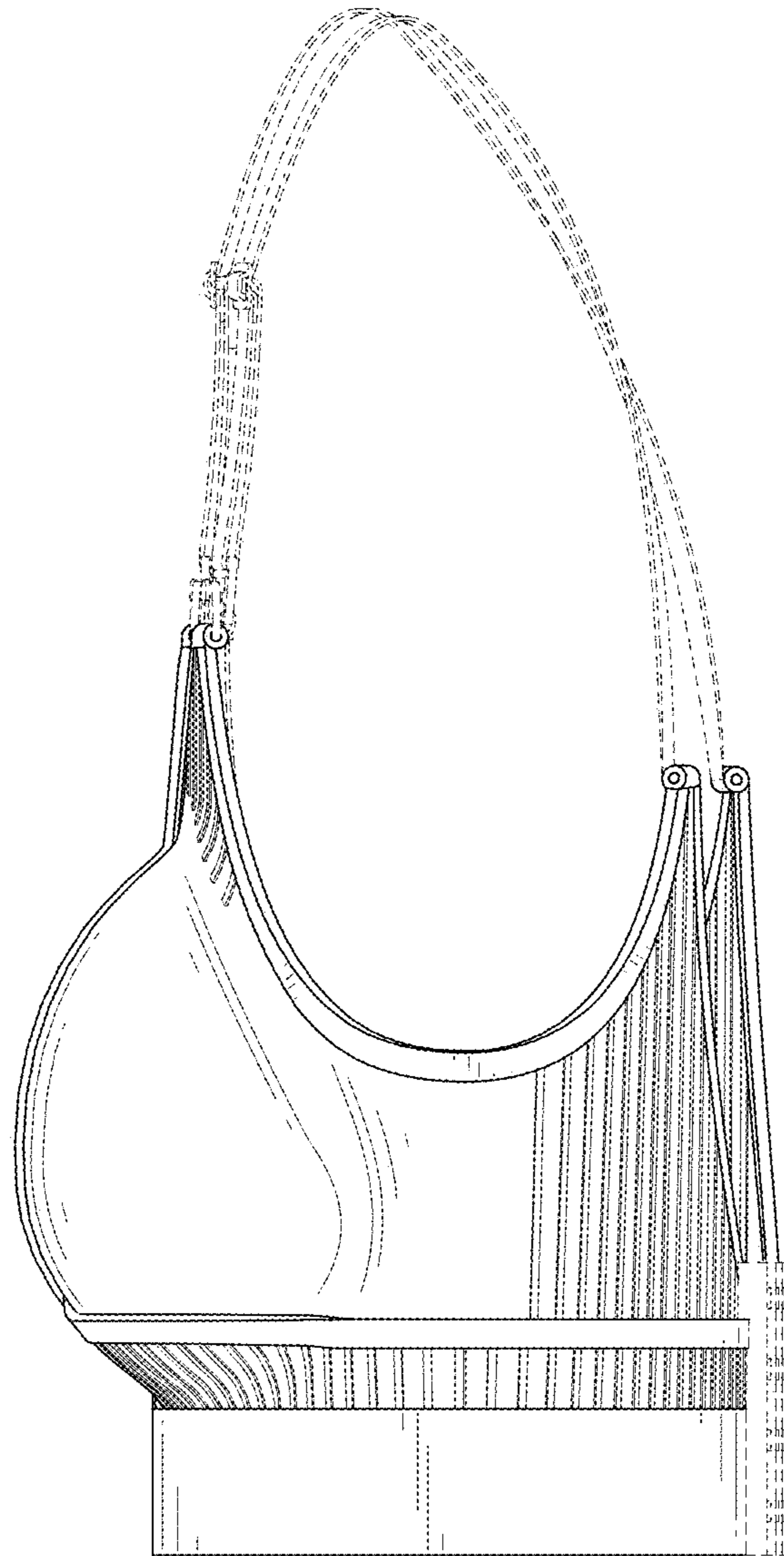

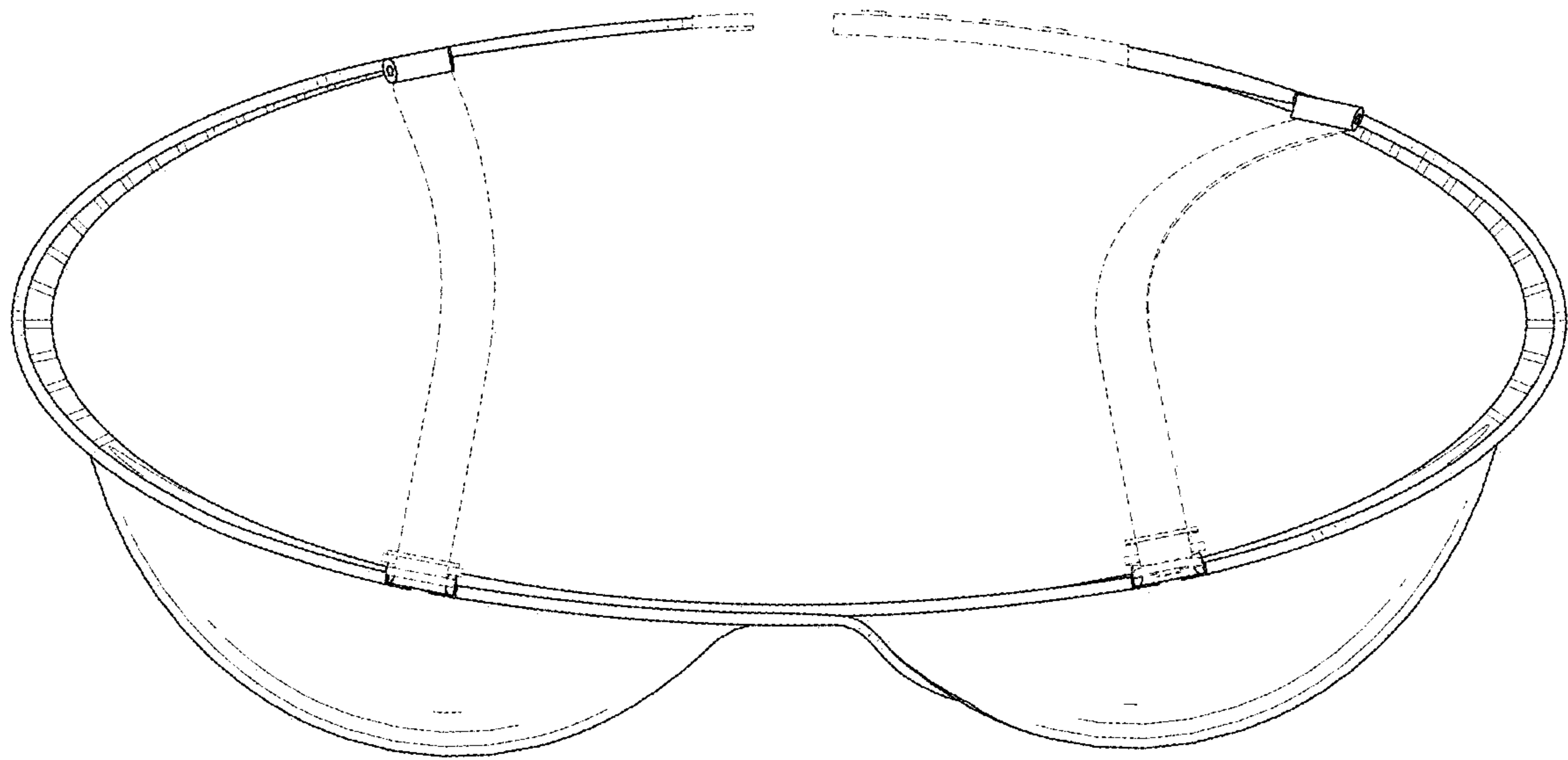

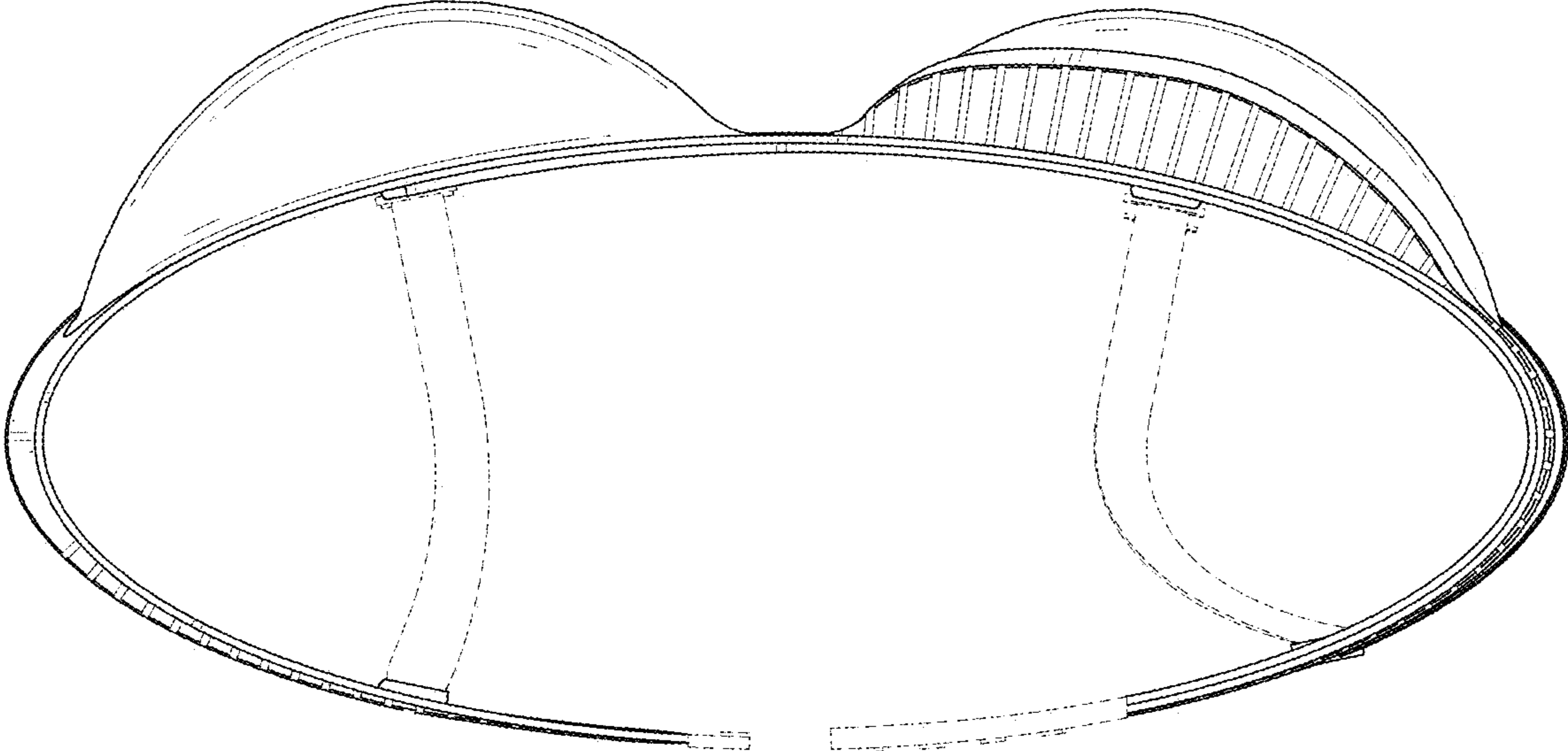

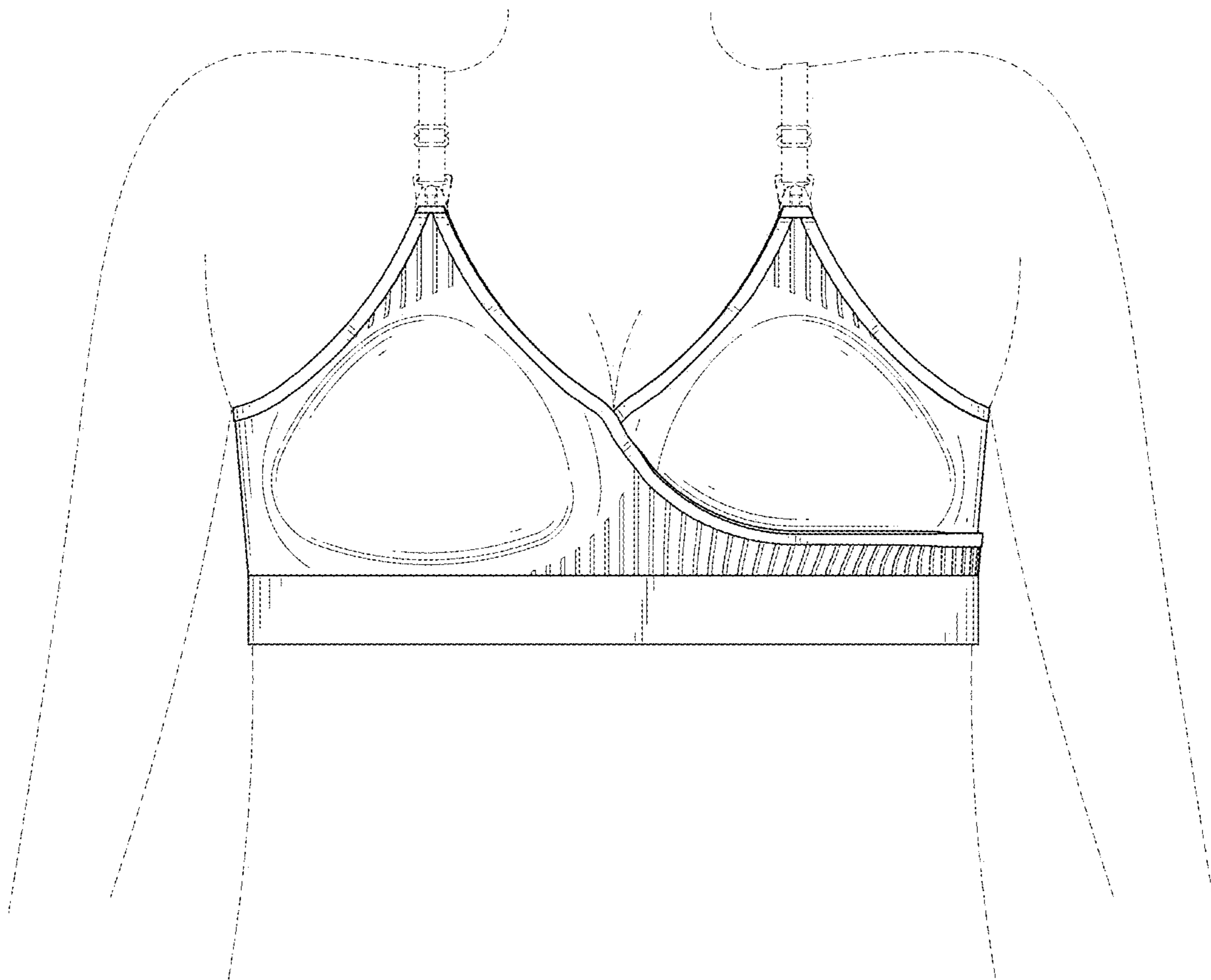

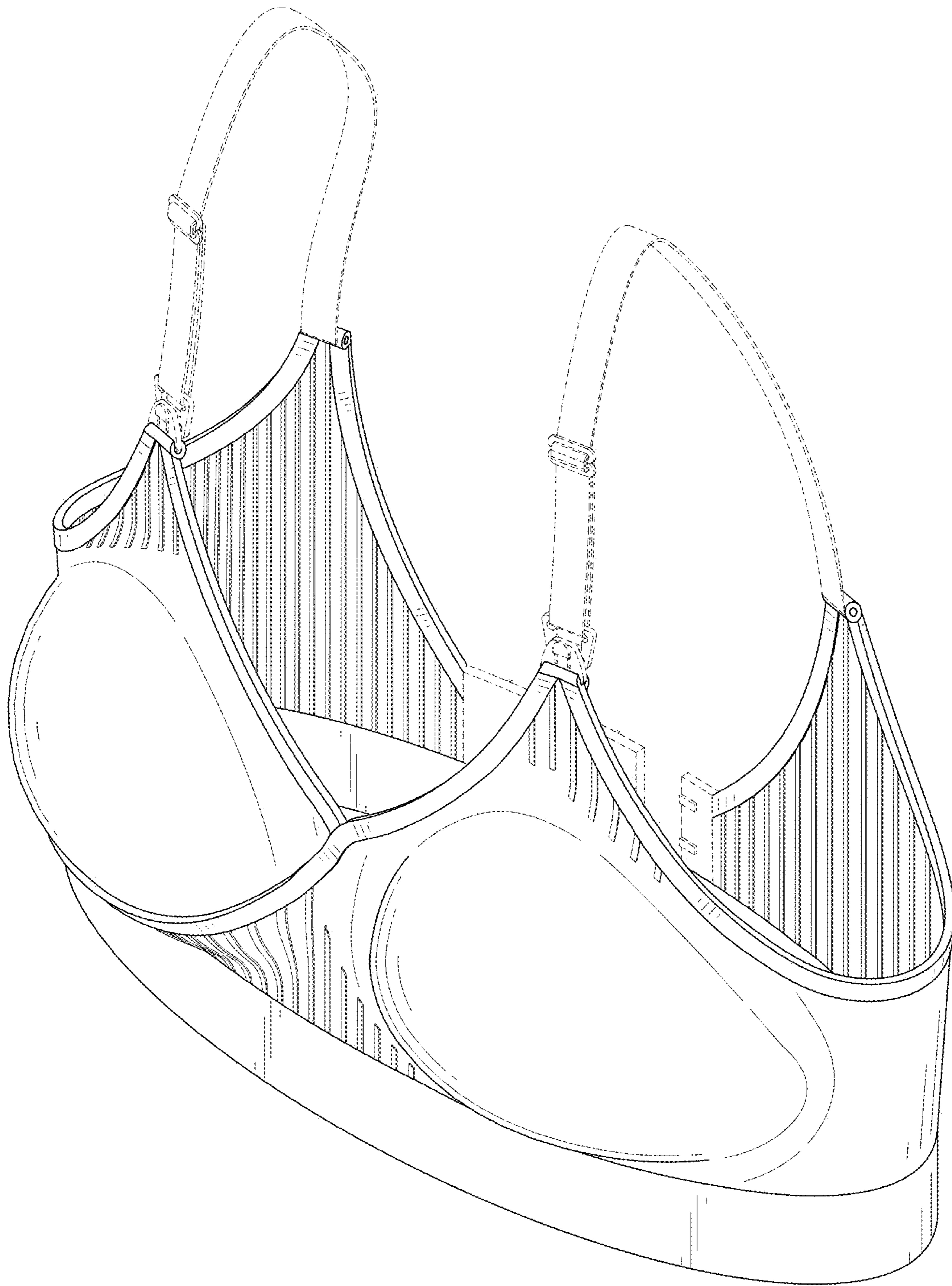

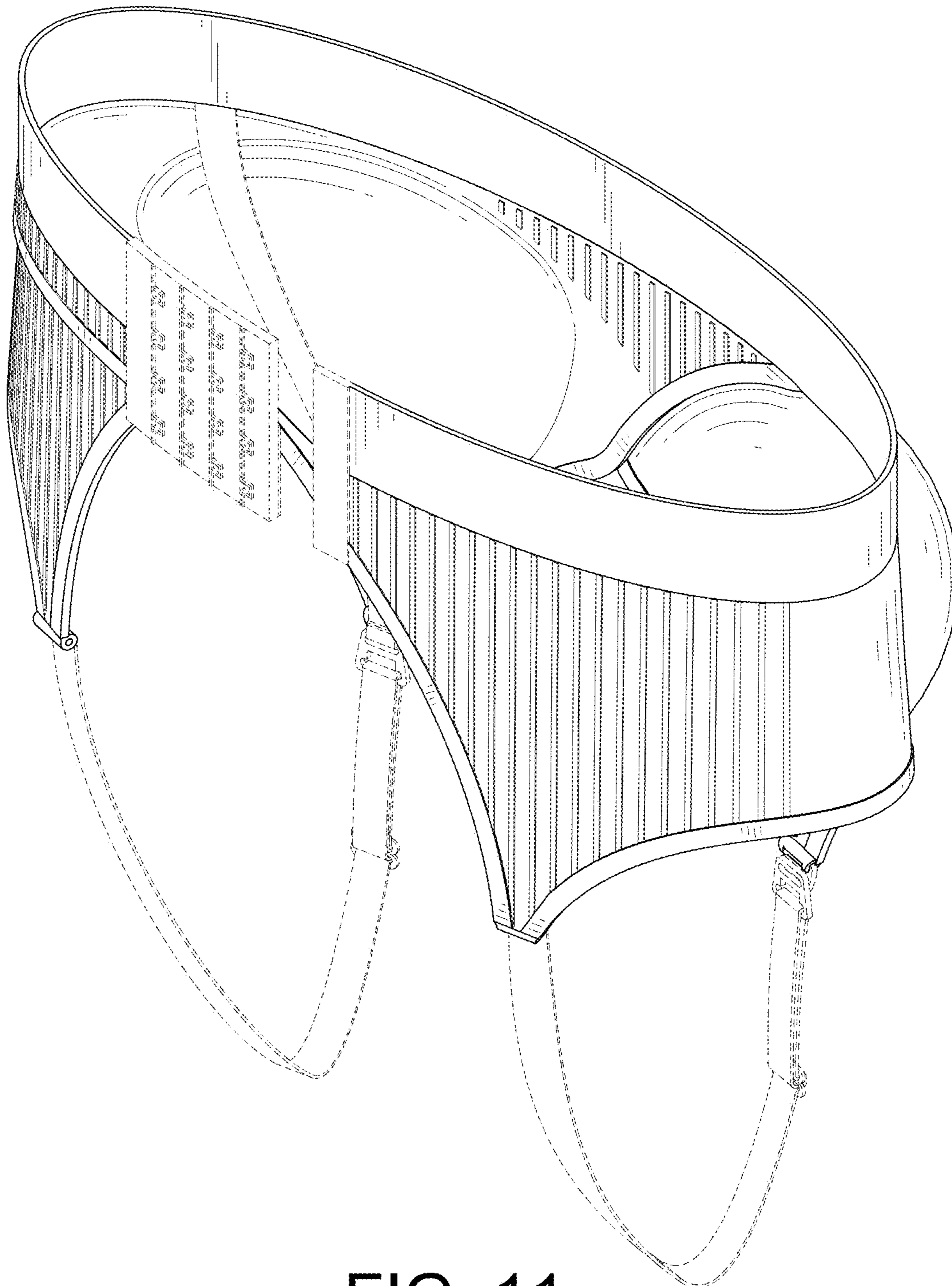

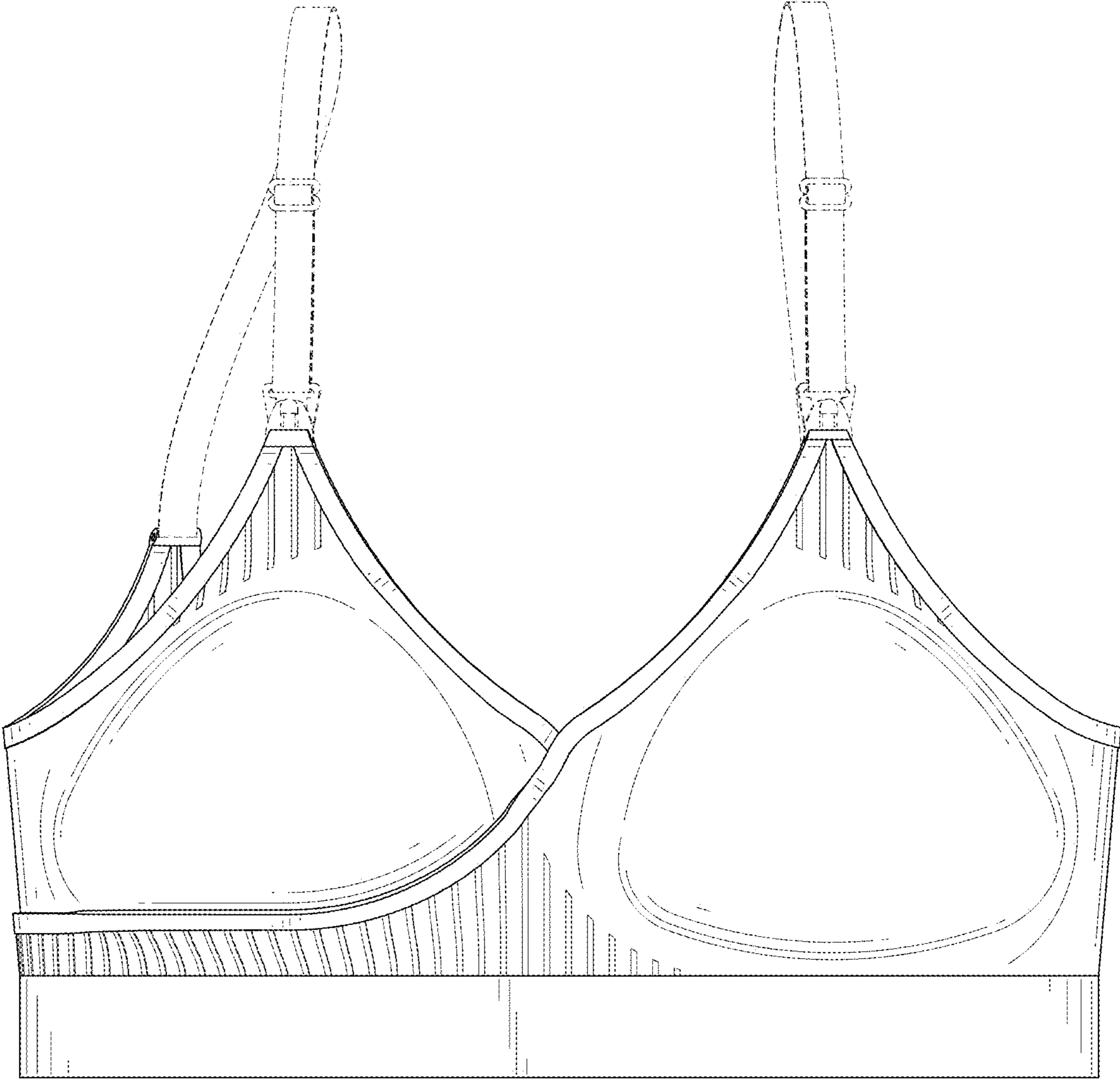

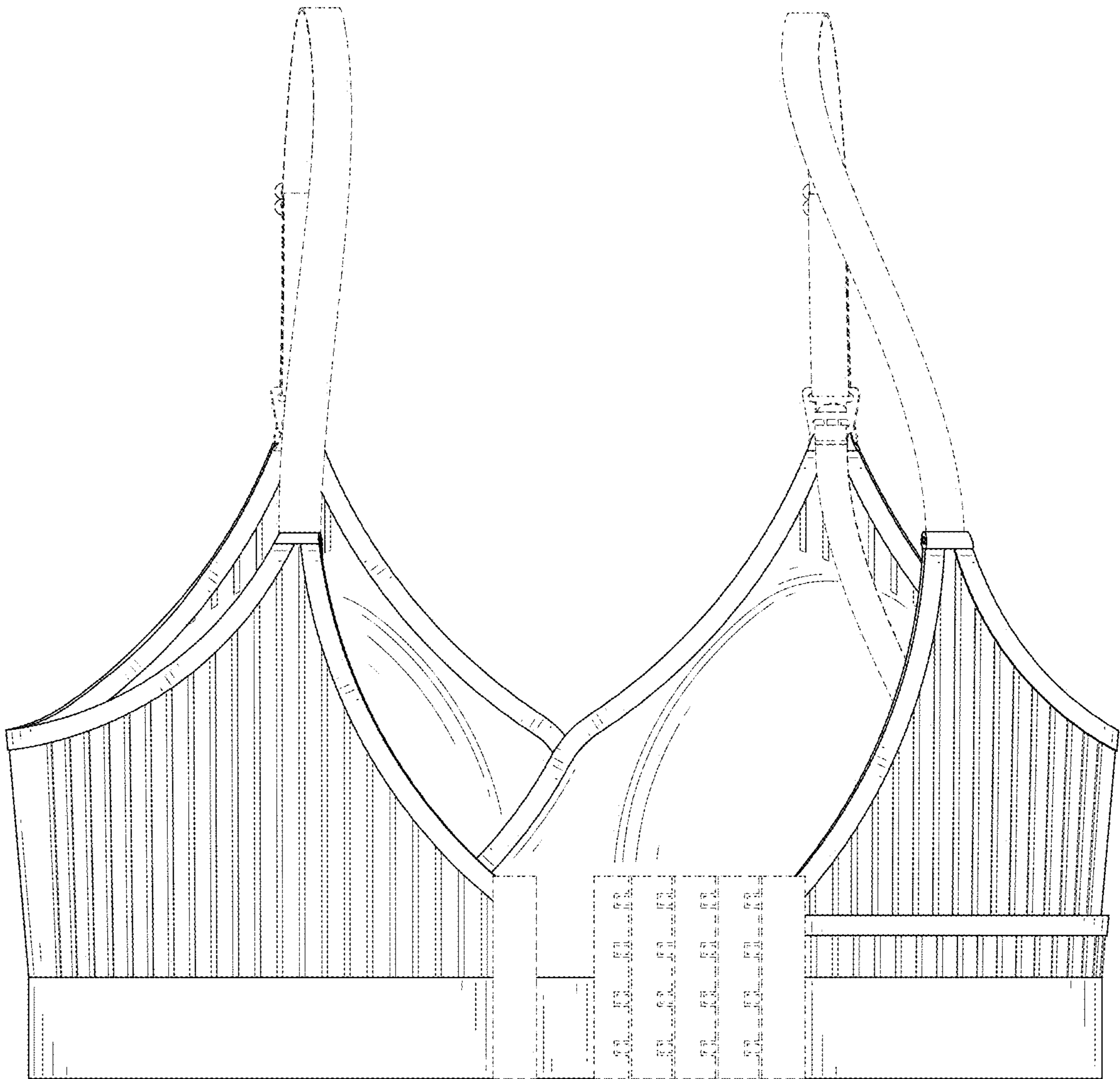

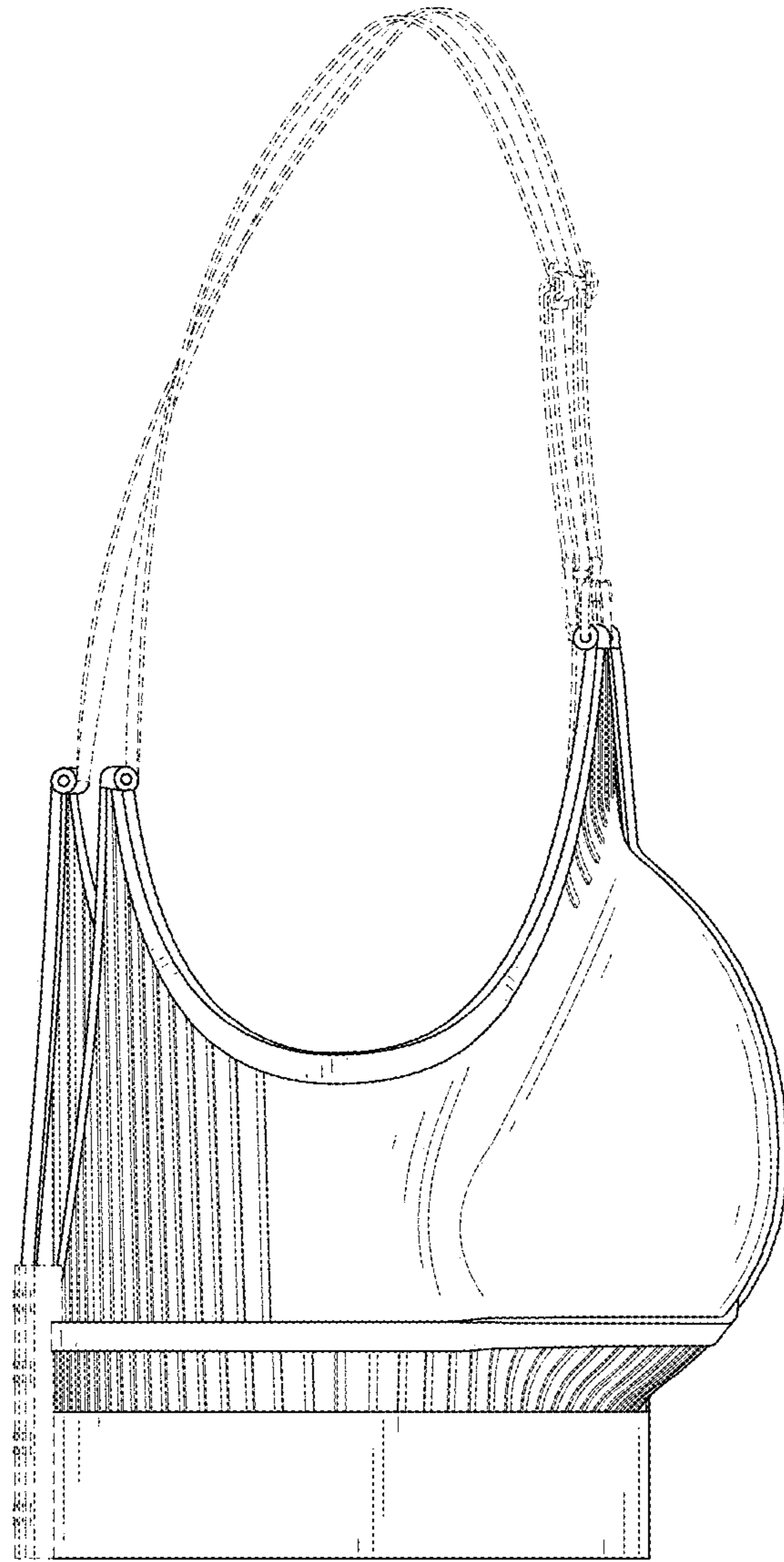

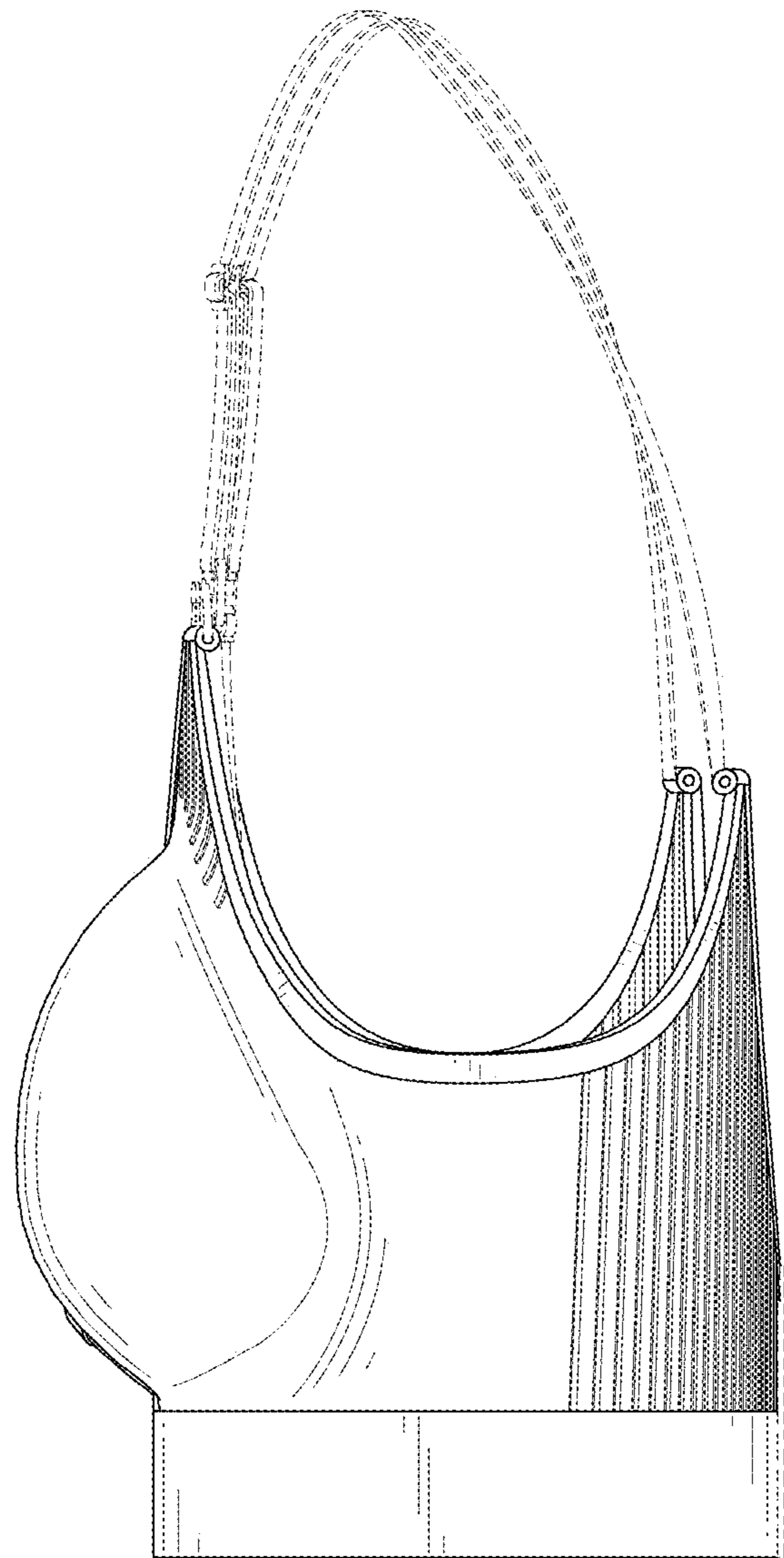

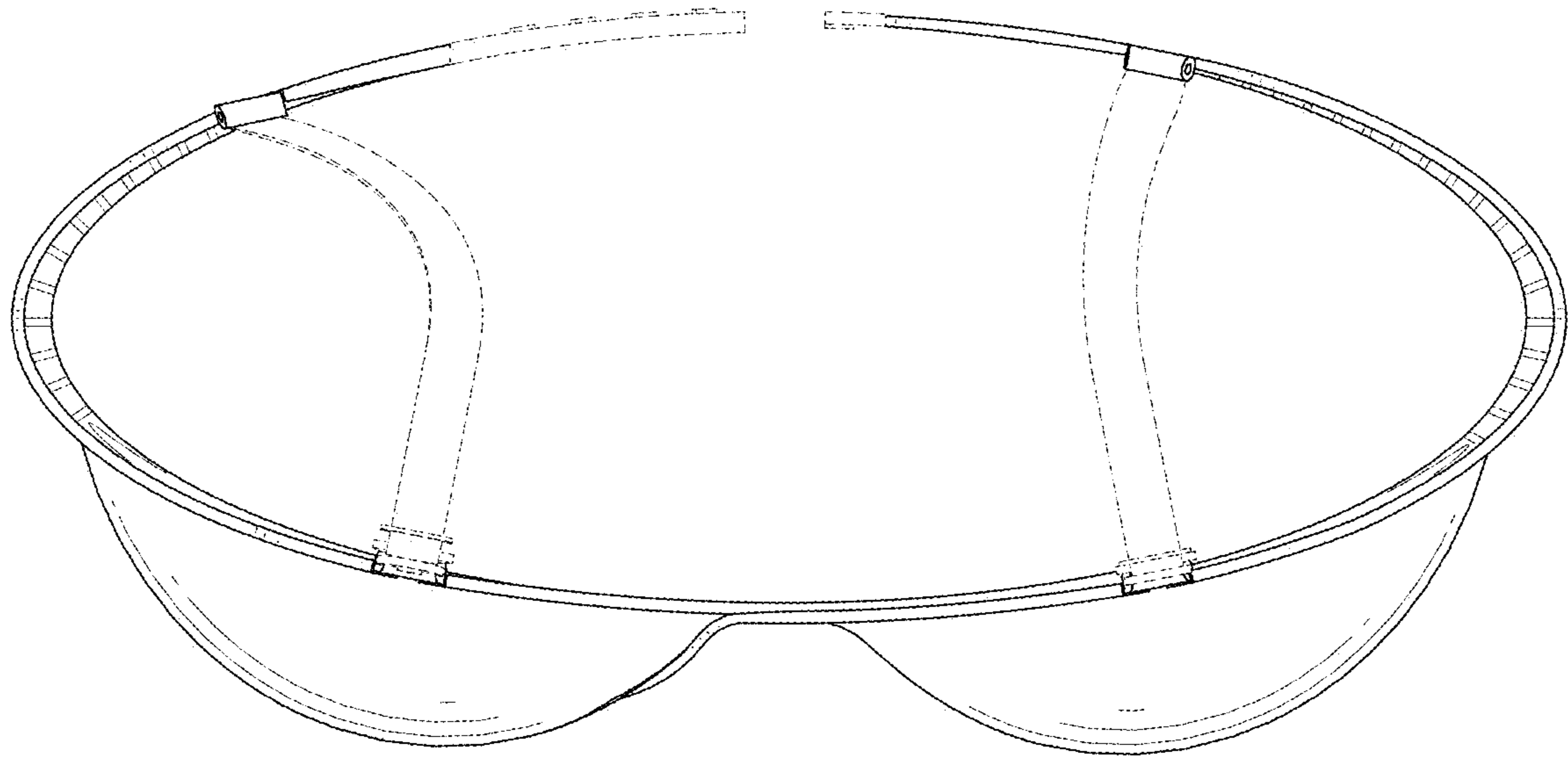

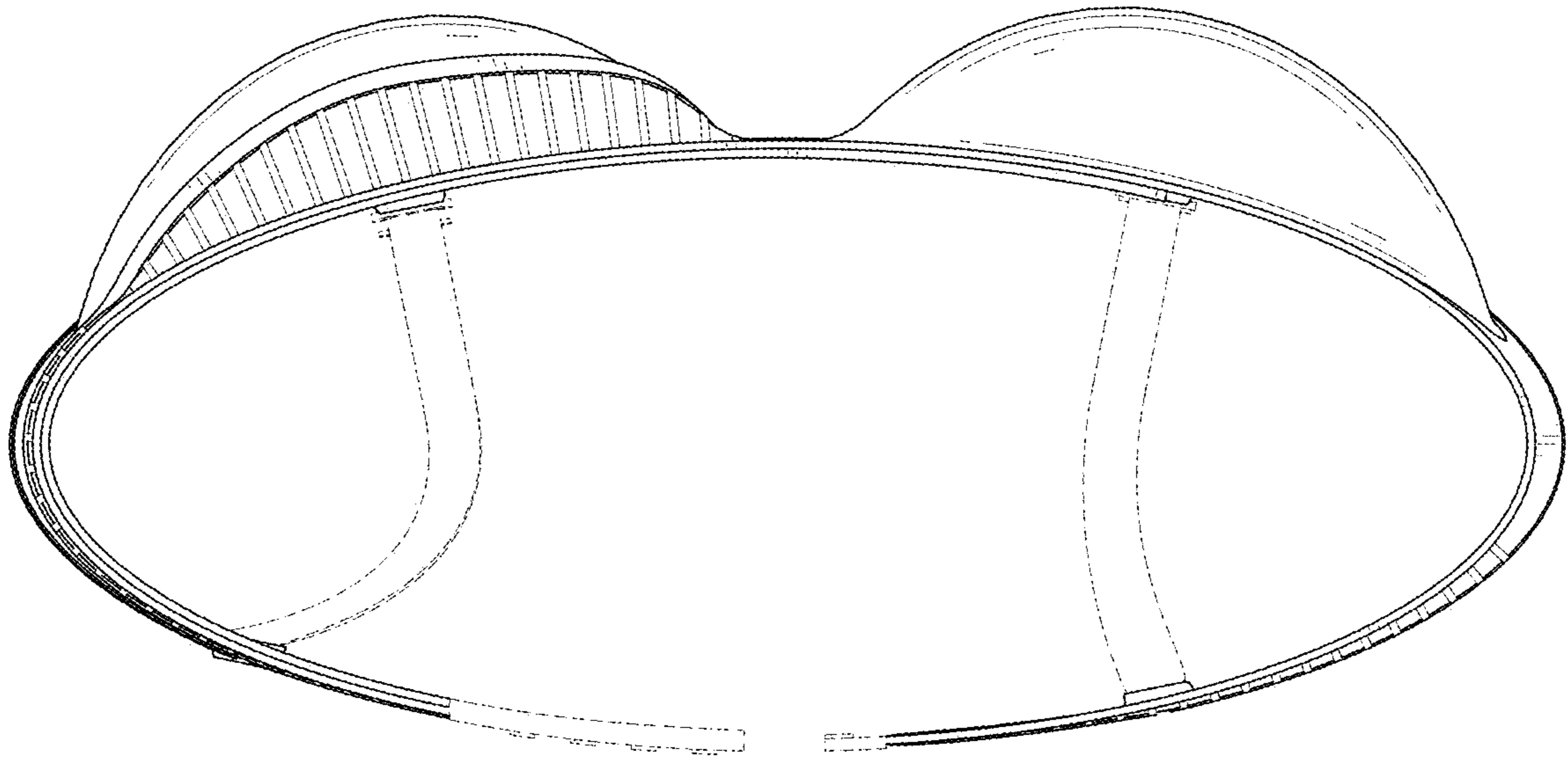

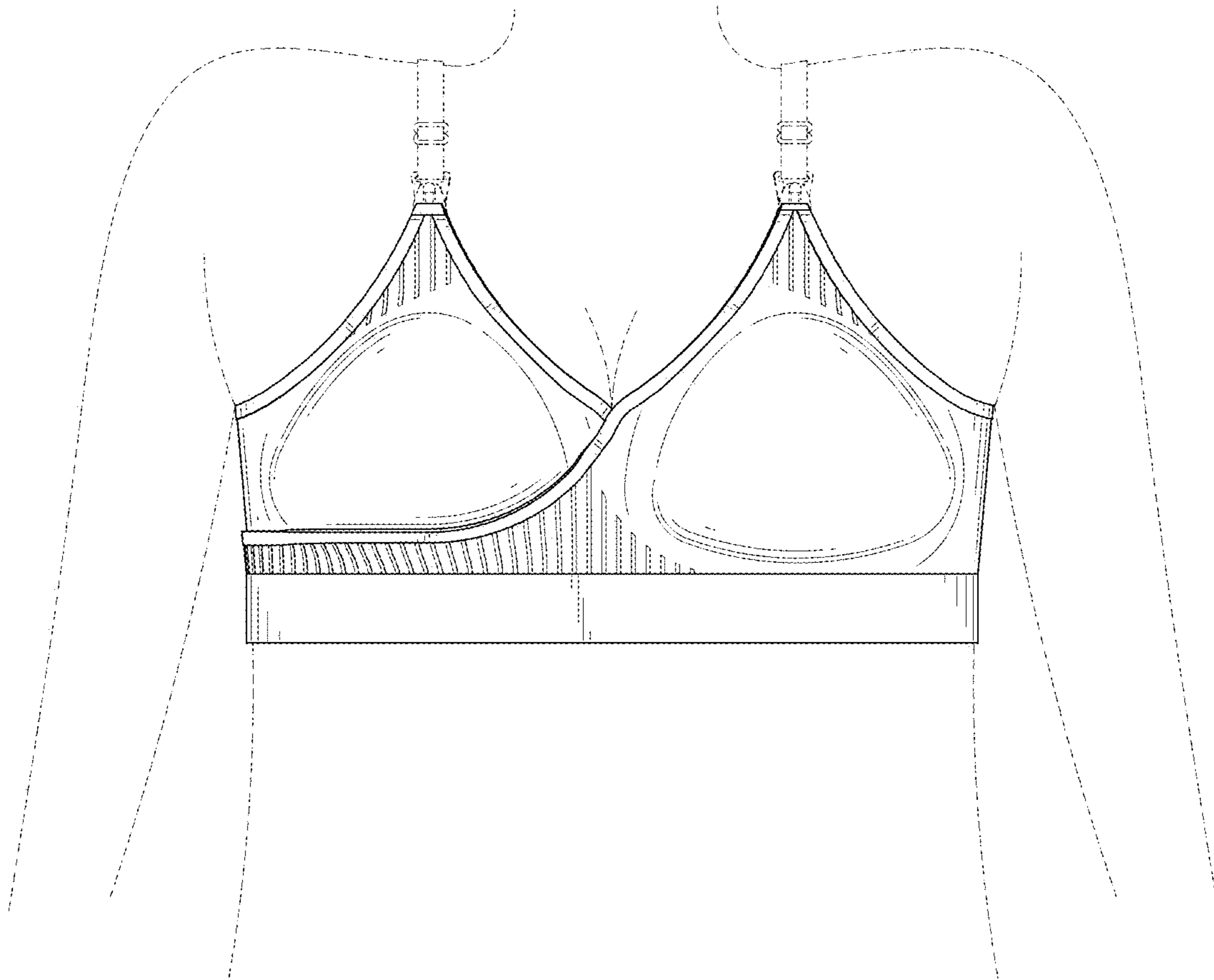
