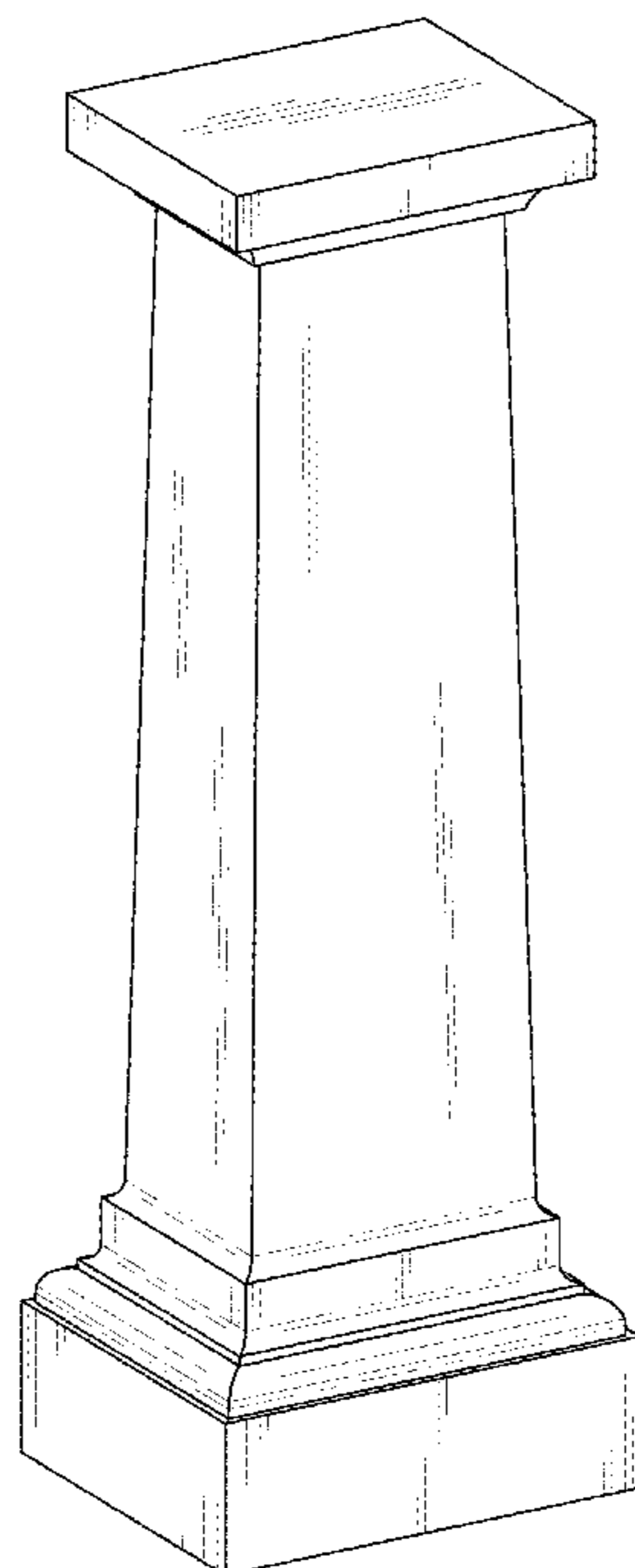

(57) **CLAIM**
The ornamental design for a mailbox post, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, left perspective view of a mailbox post, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken lines shown in the drawings represent portions of the mailbox post that form no part of the claimed design.

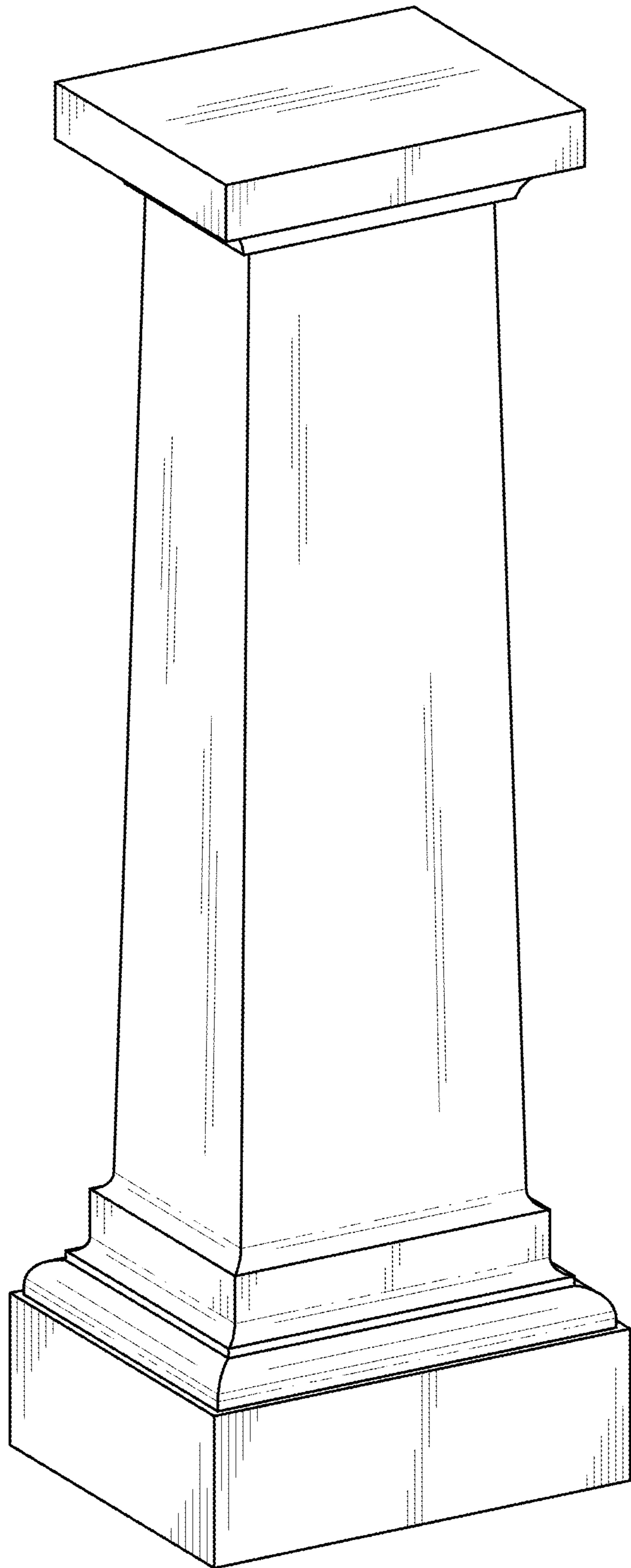

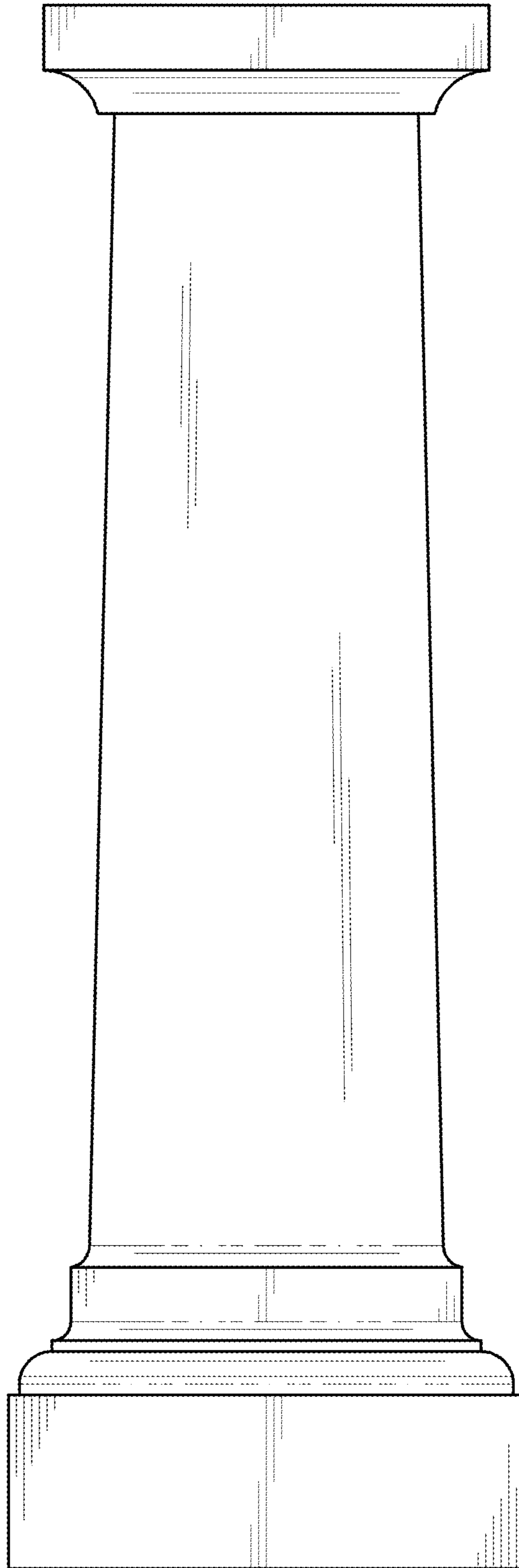

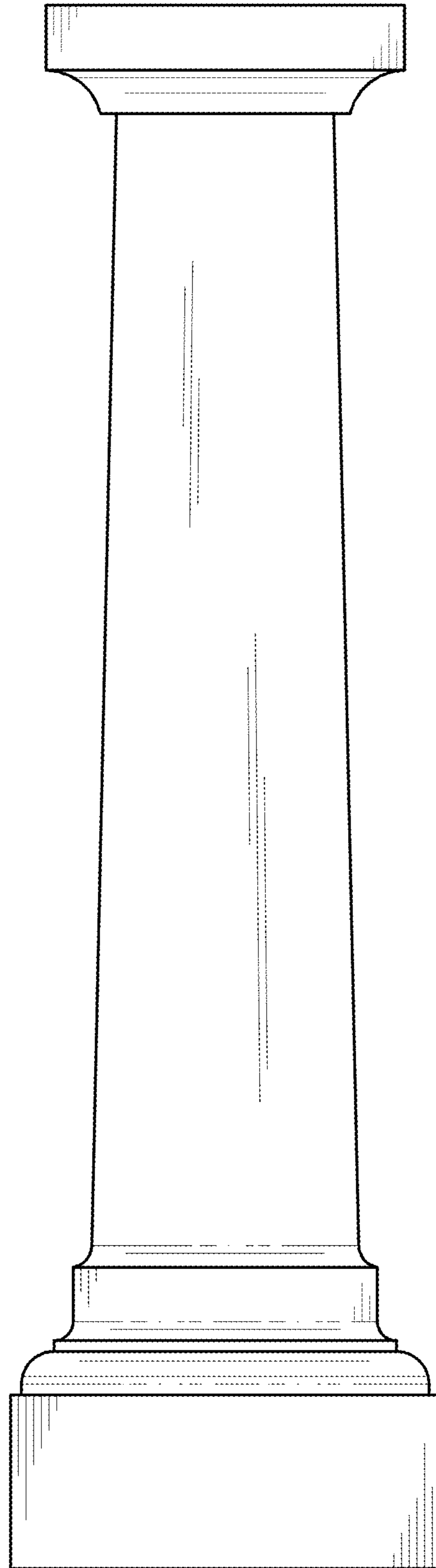

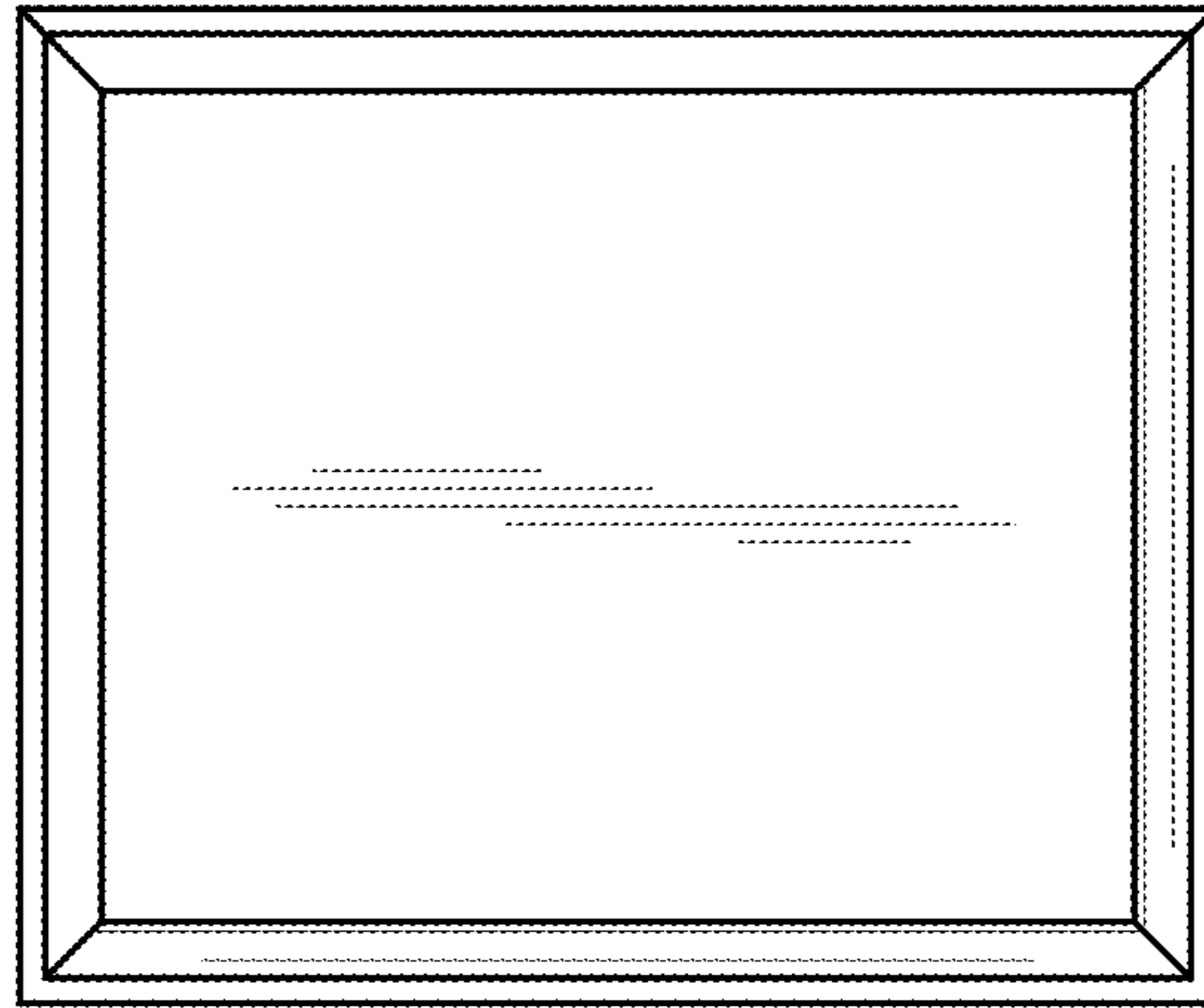

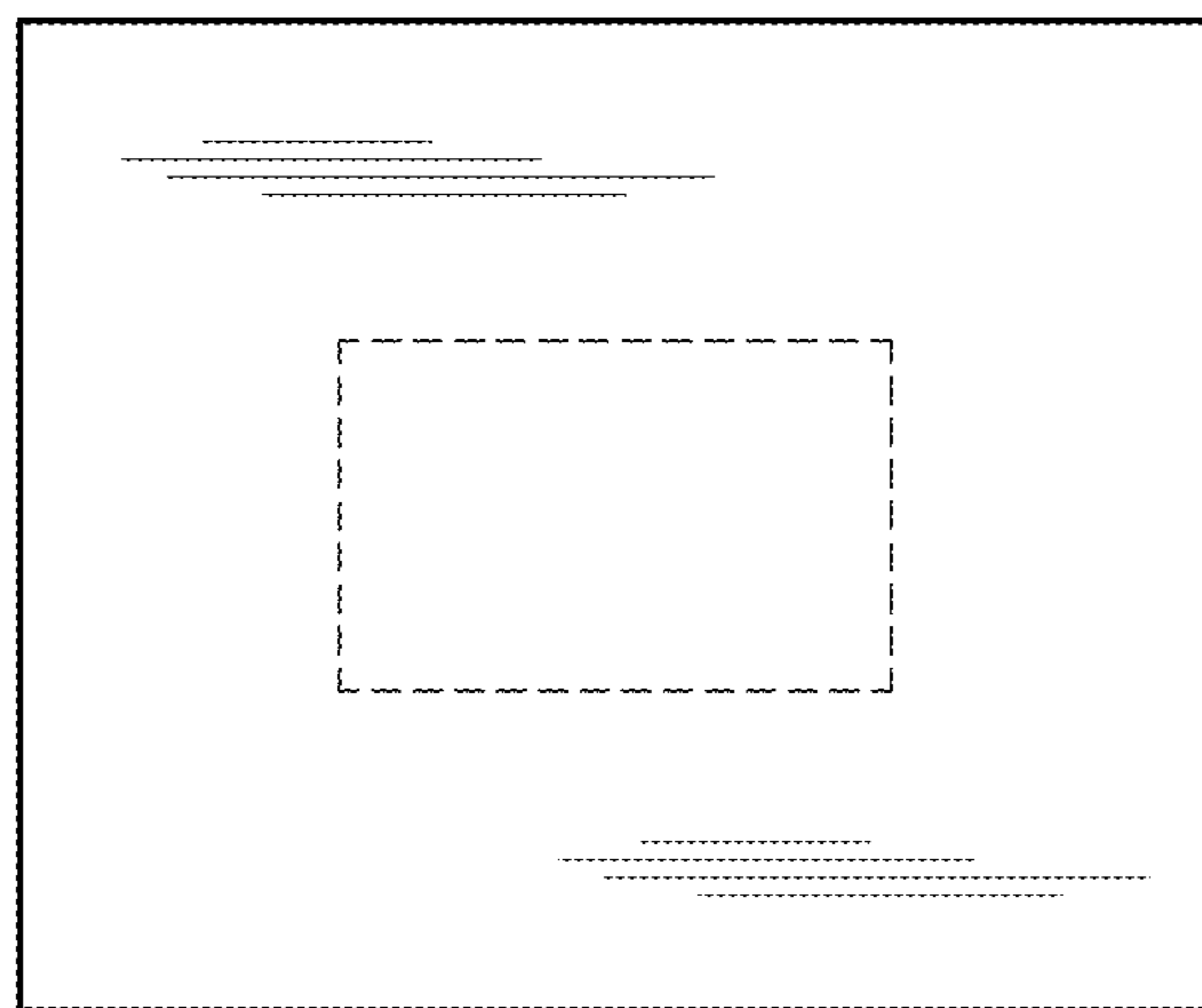
