of FIG. 1;

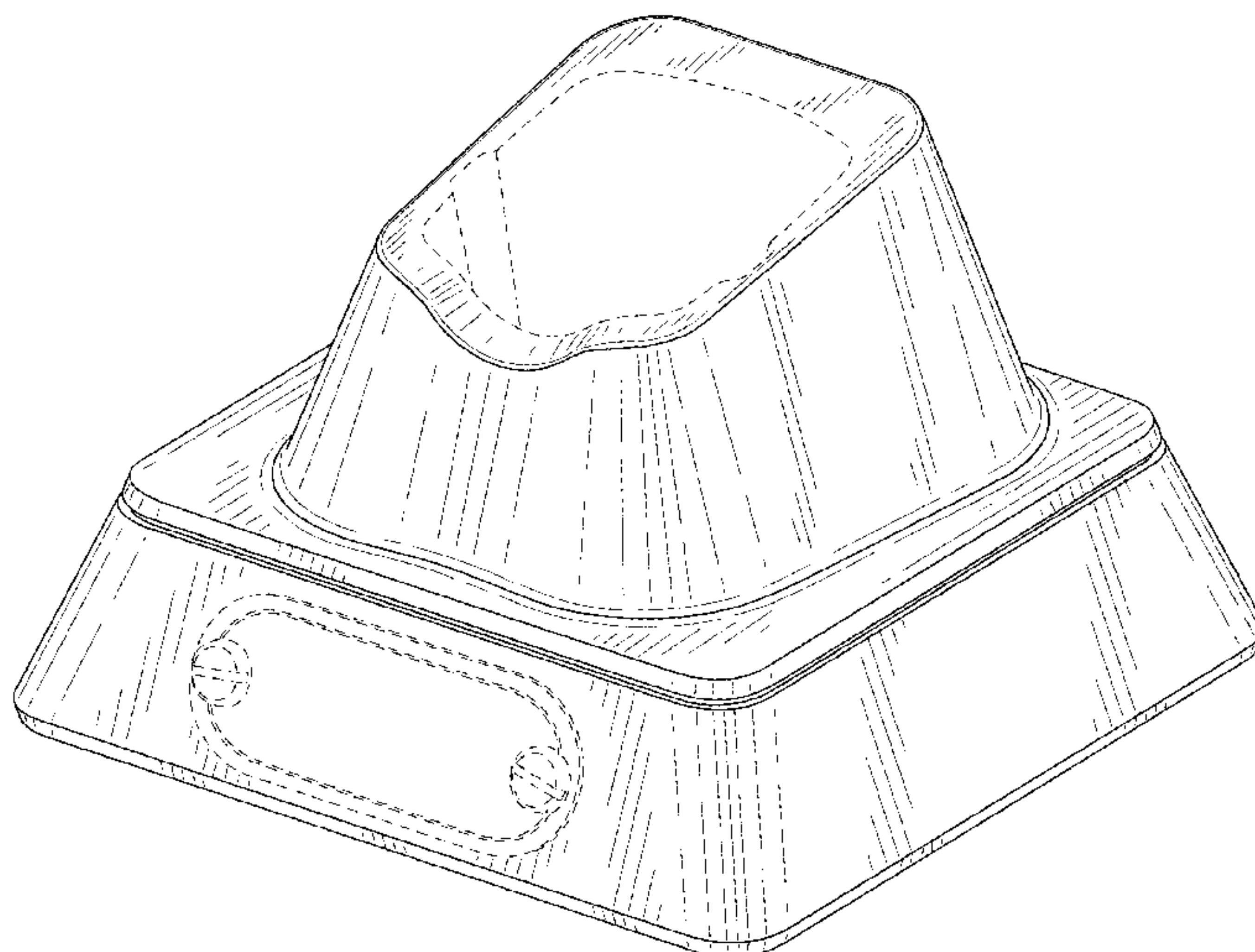
FIG. 5 is an elevation view of a second end of the trimmer

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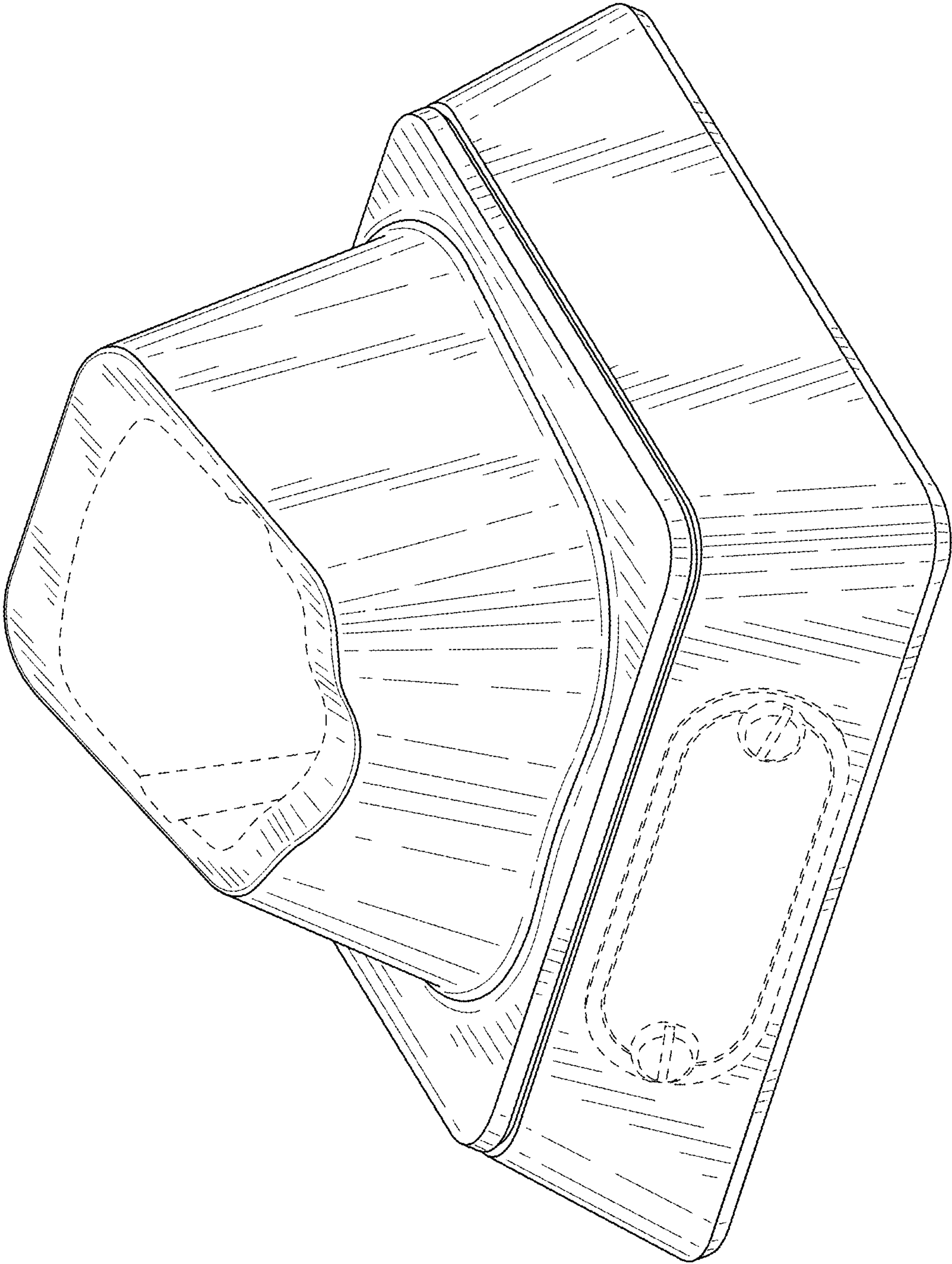

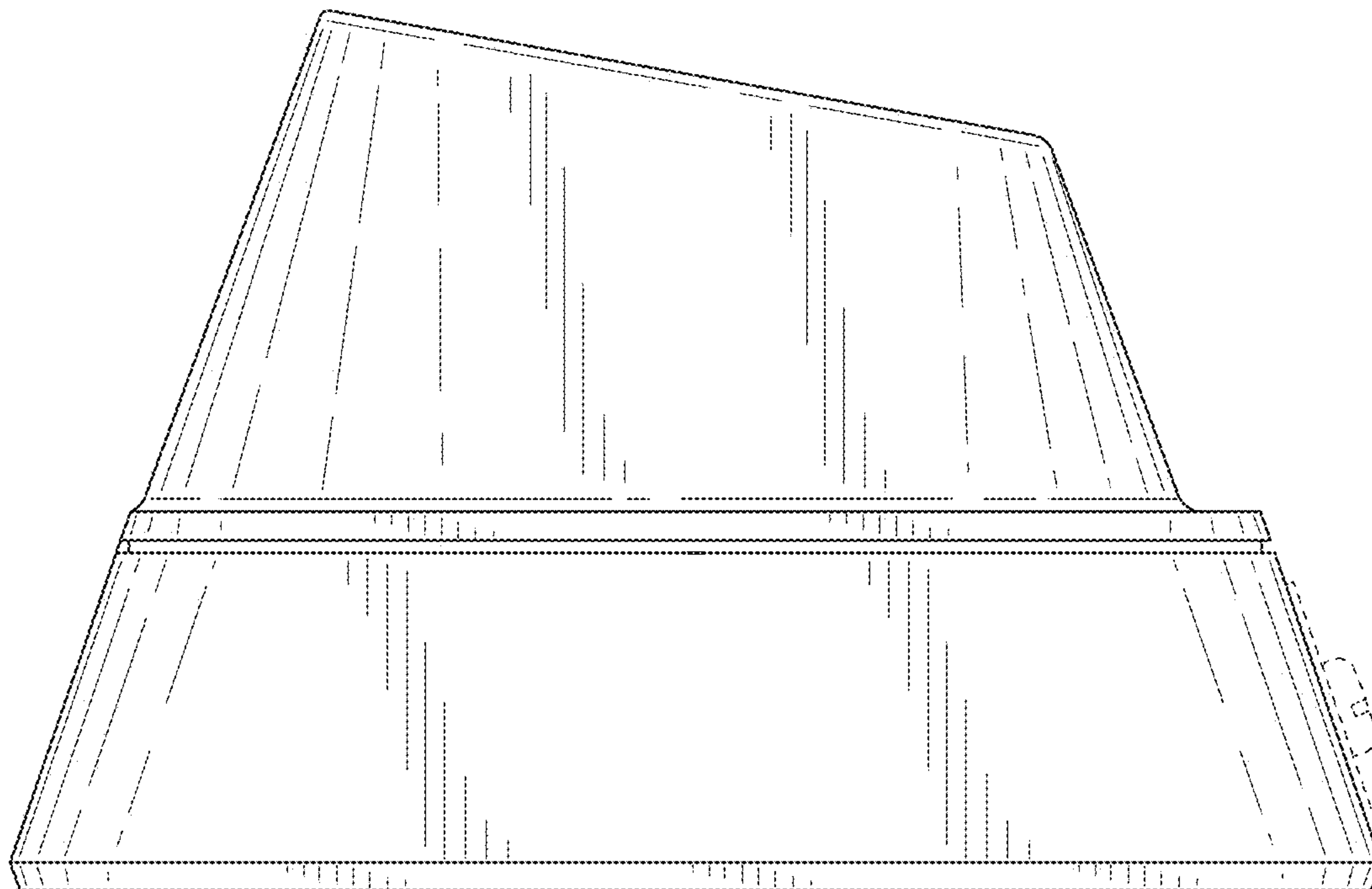

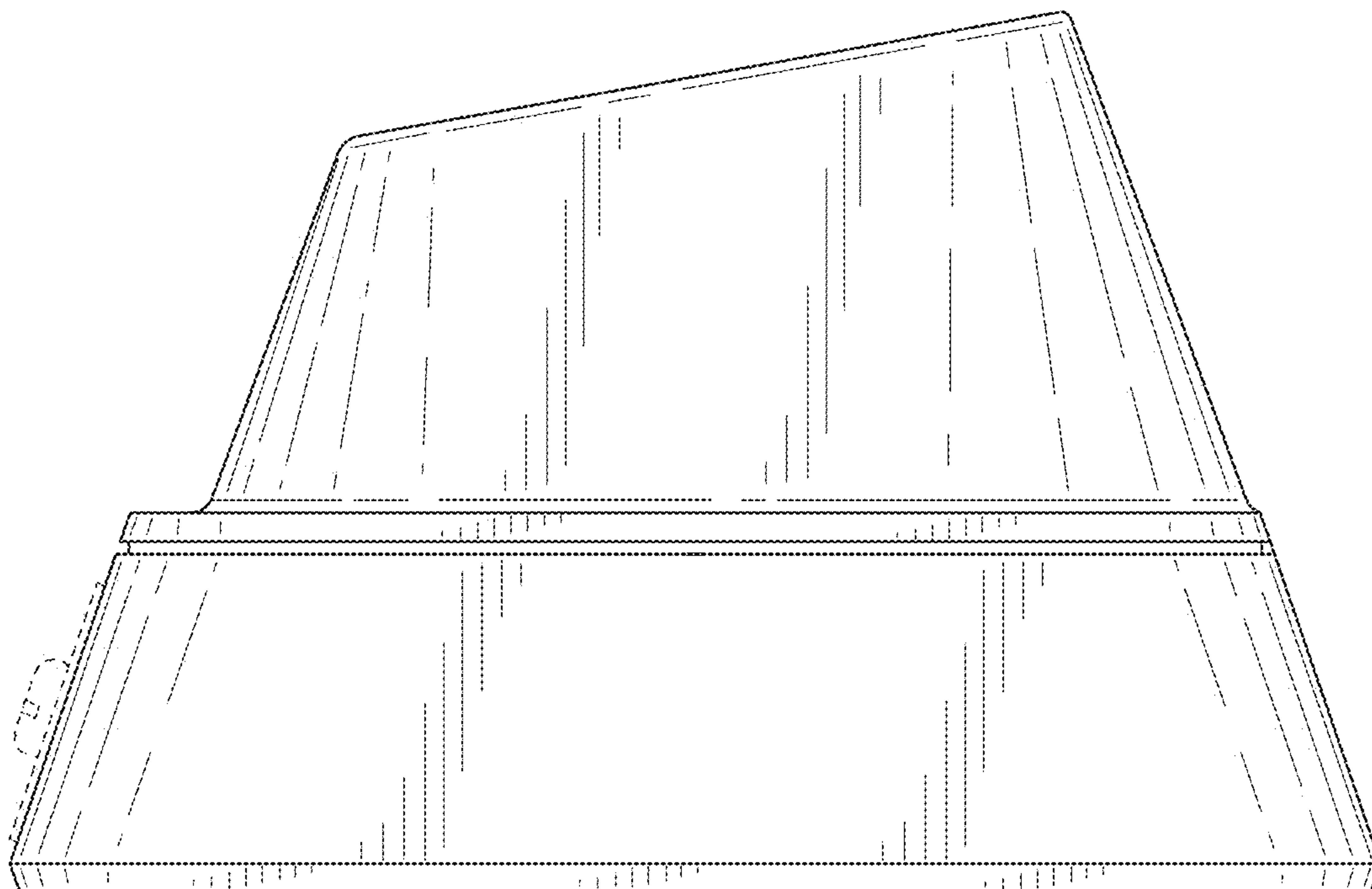

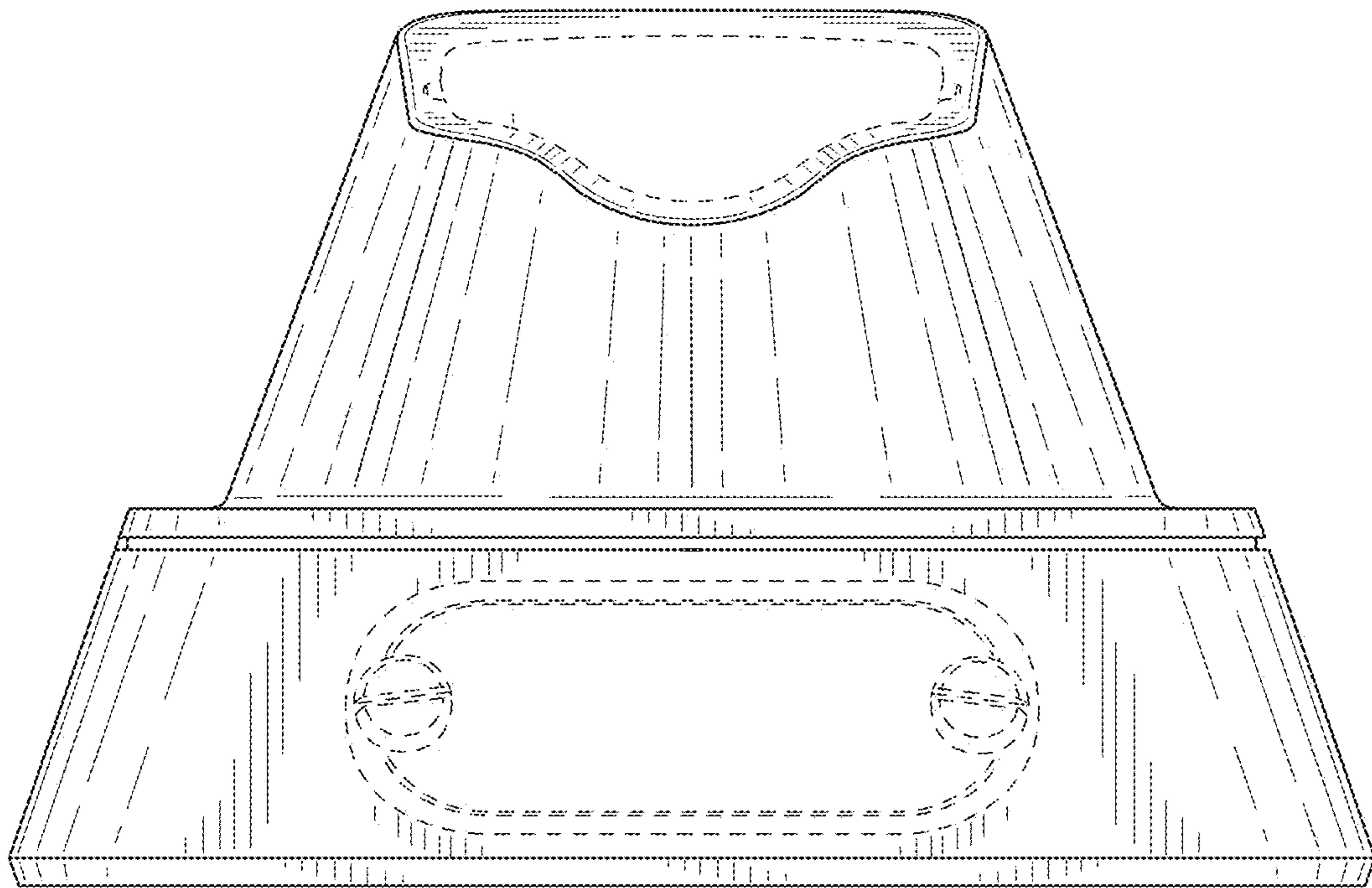

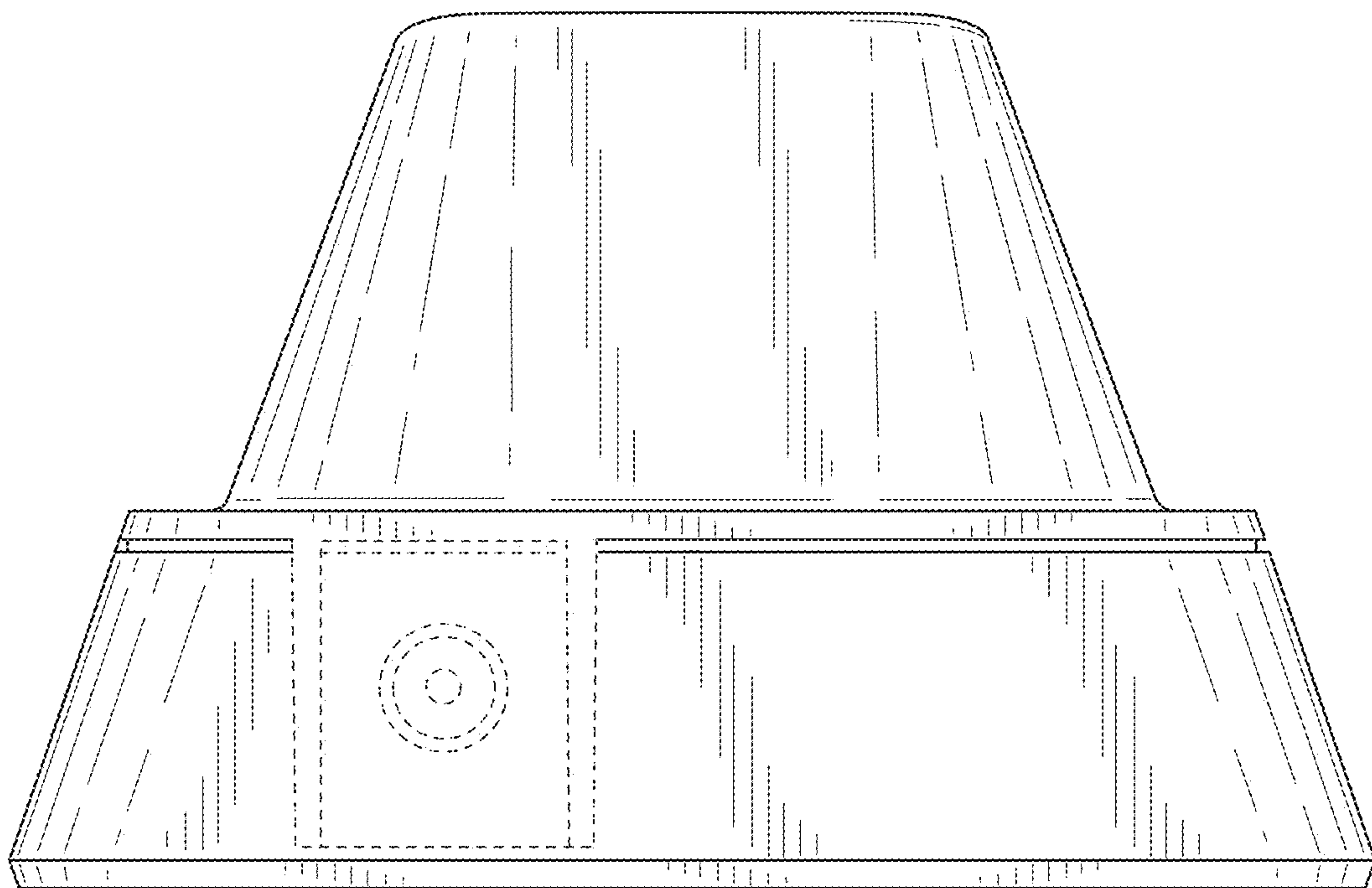

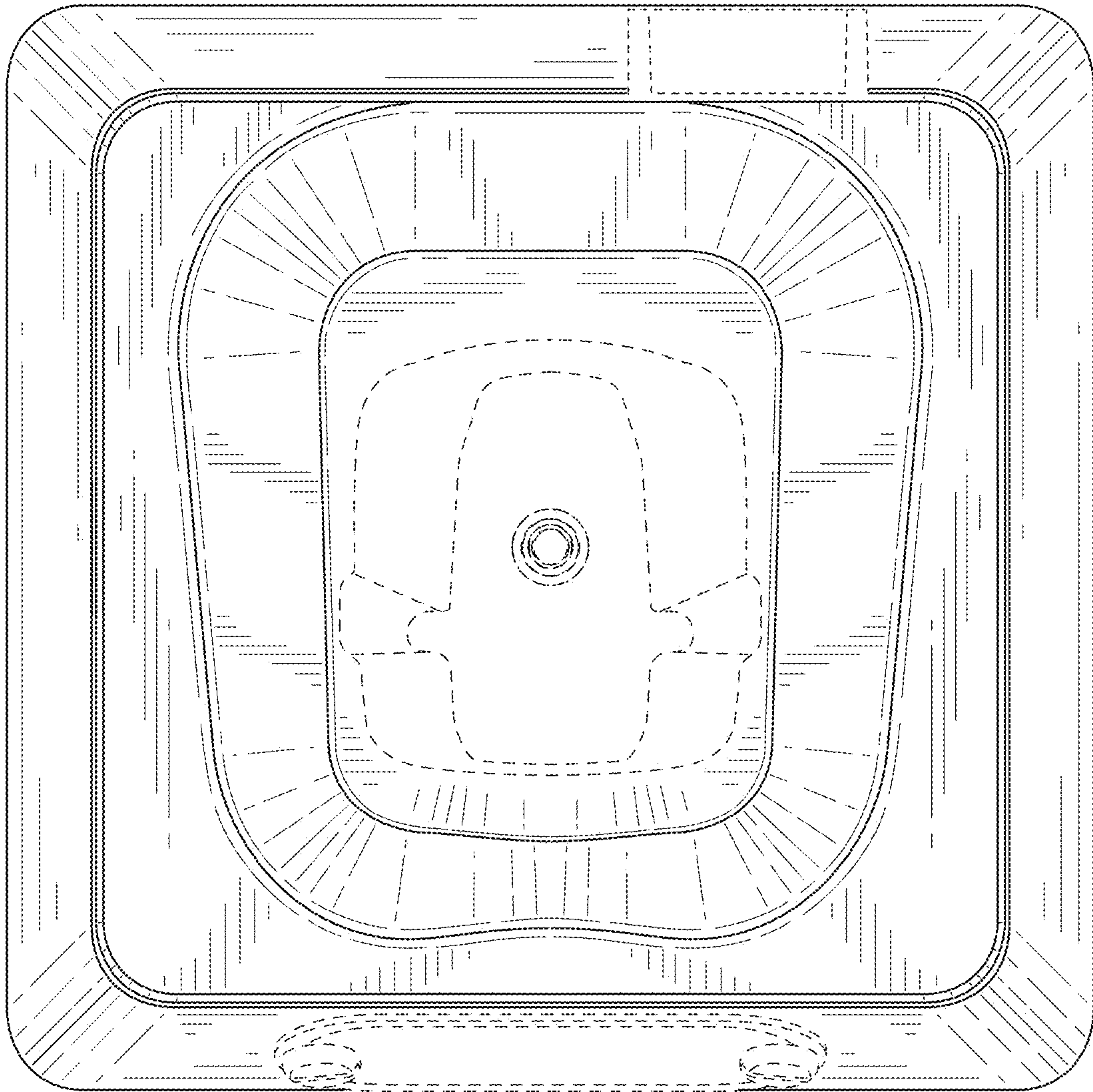

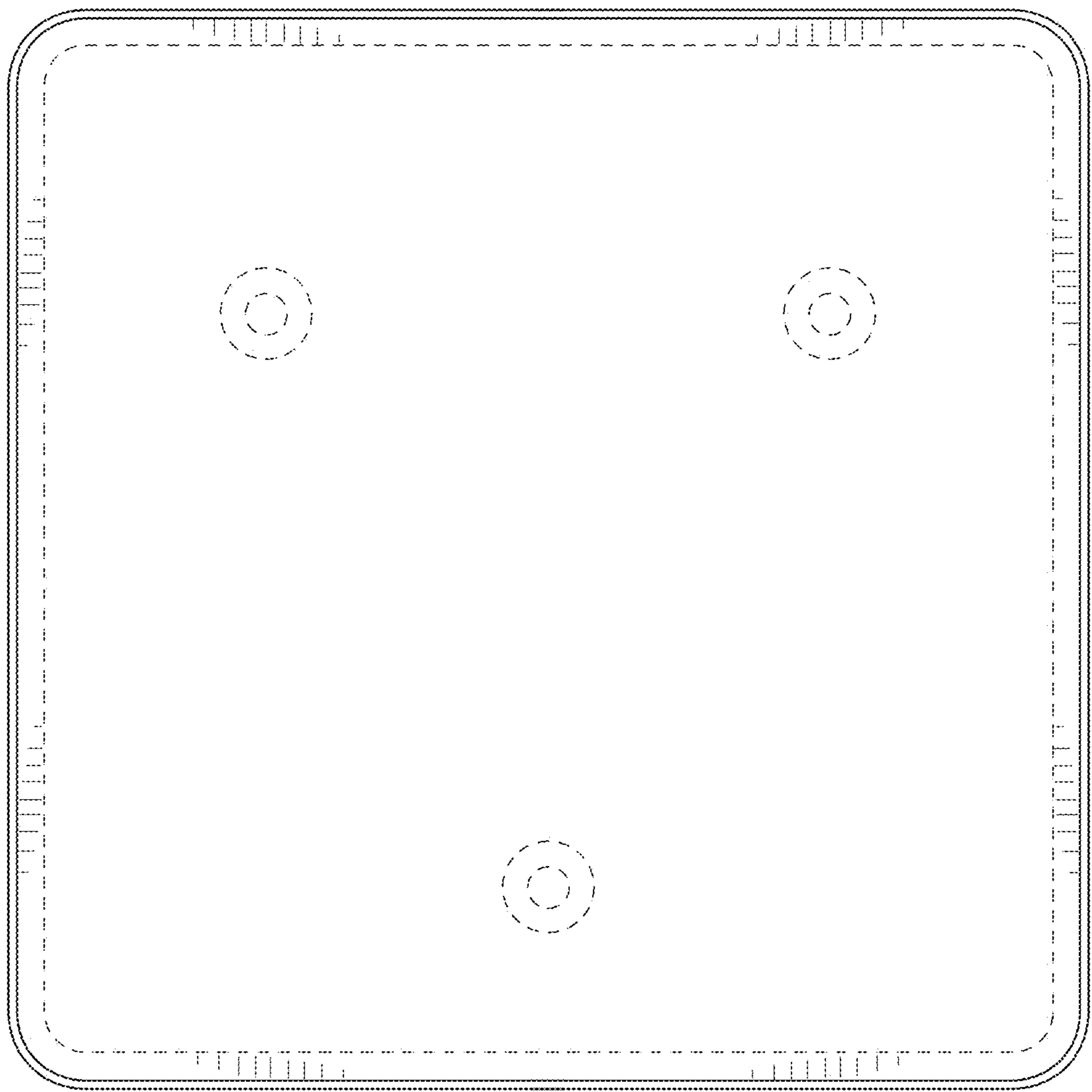
