1.5 : Bottom

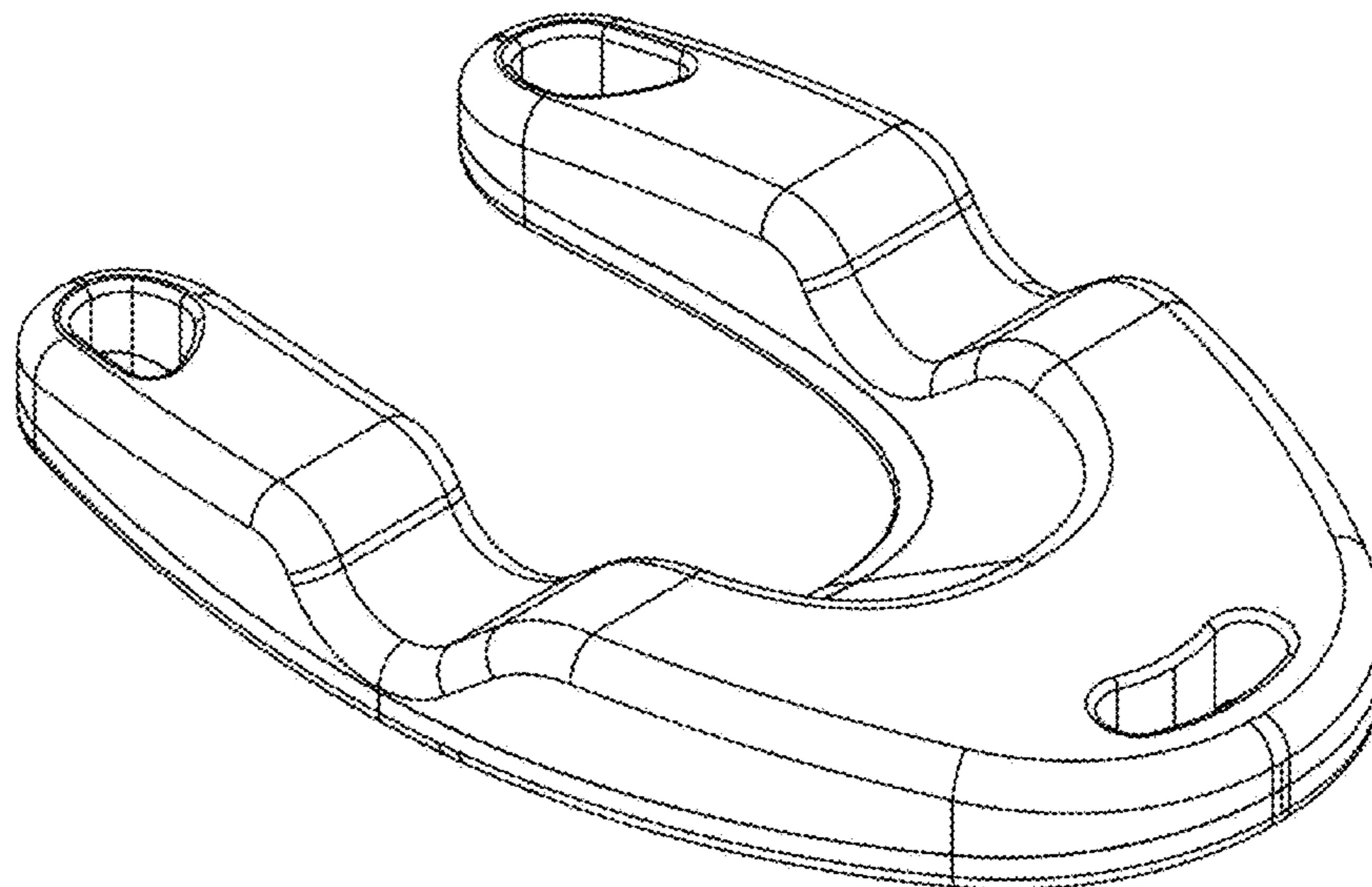
1.6 : Back

1.7 : Perspective view top

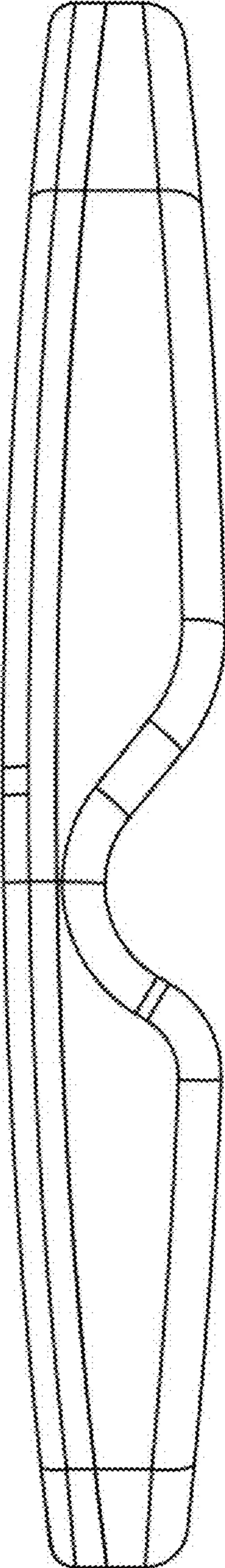
1.8 : Perspective view bottom

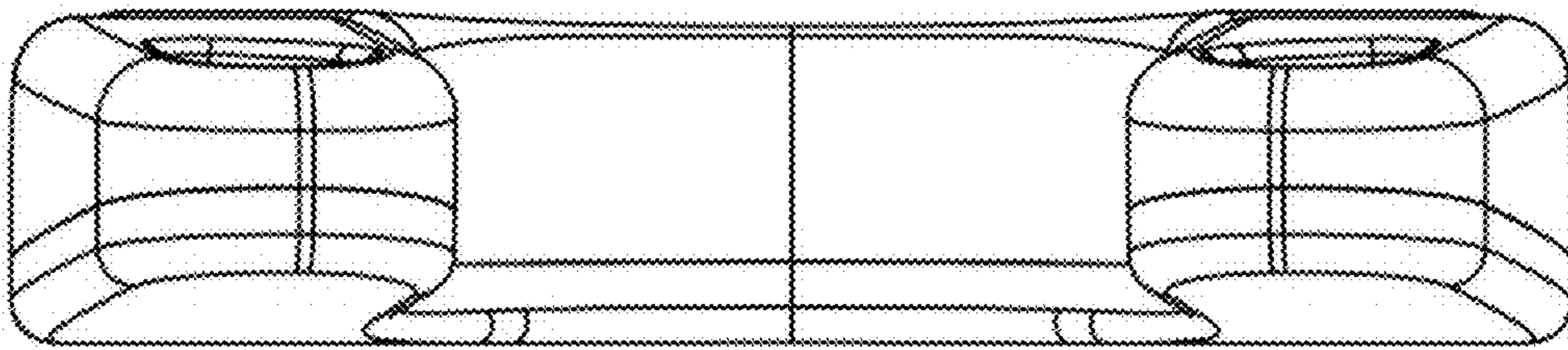

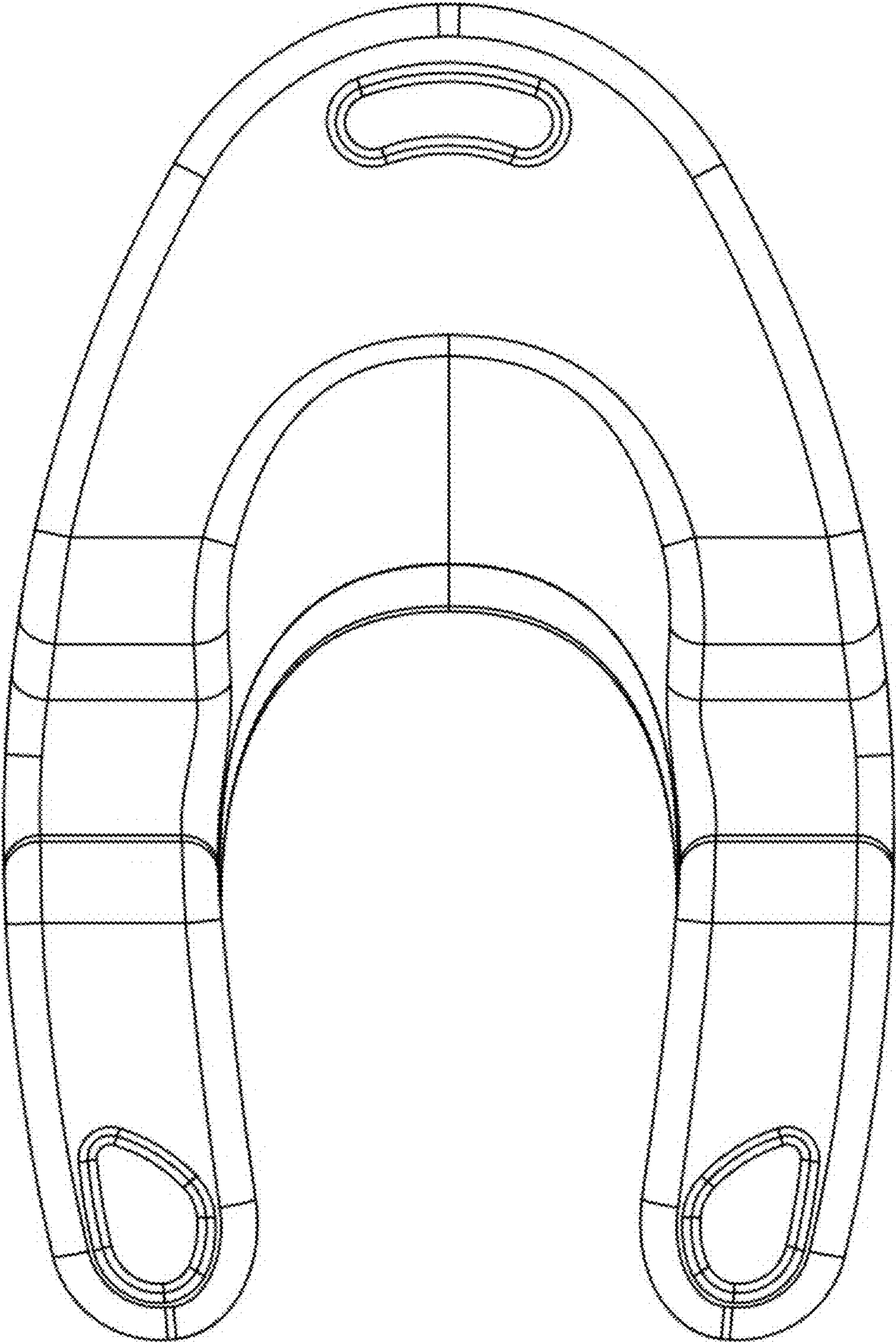

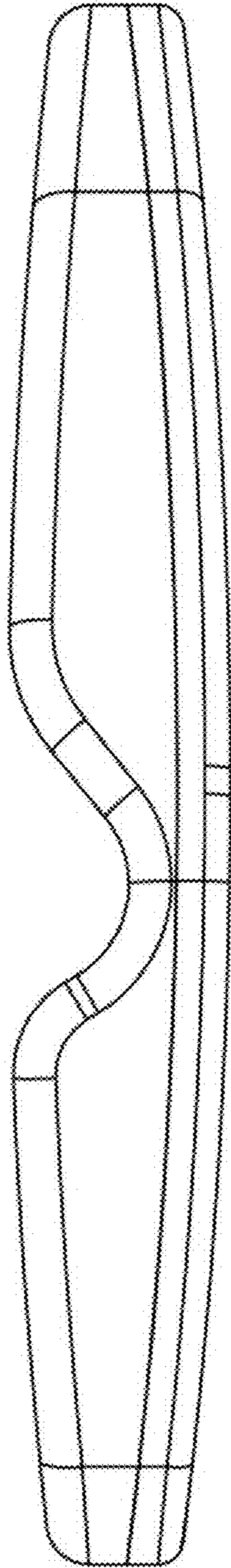

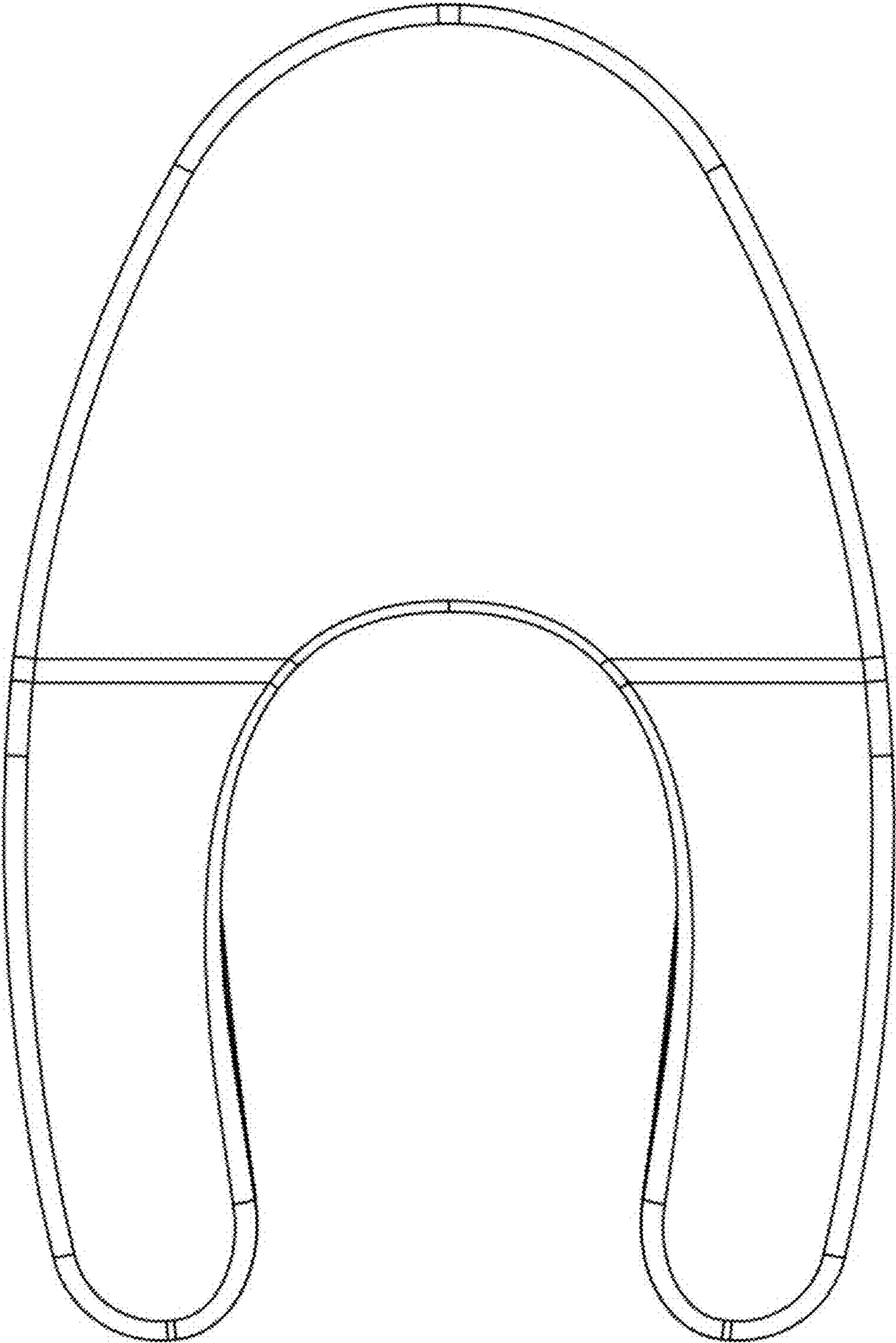

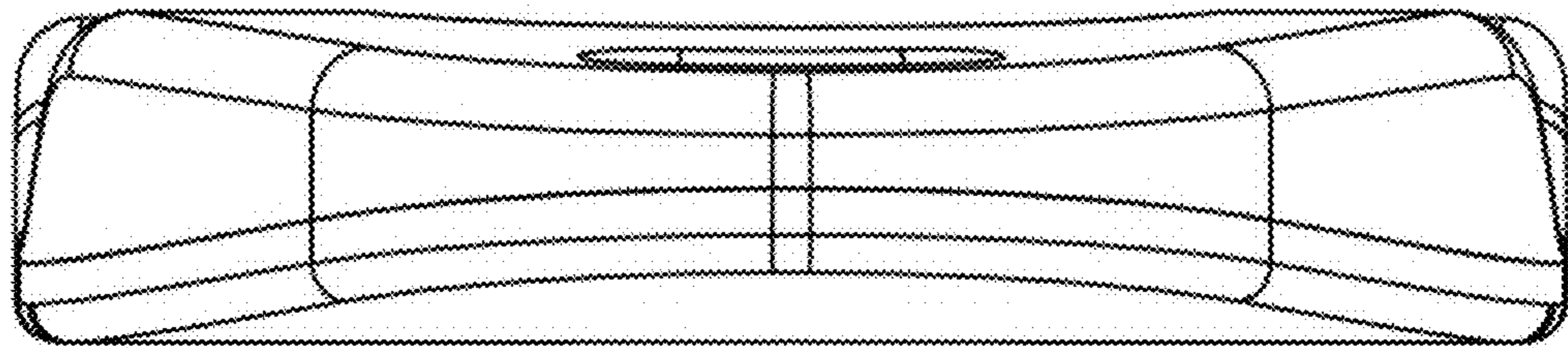

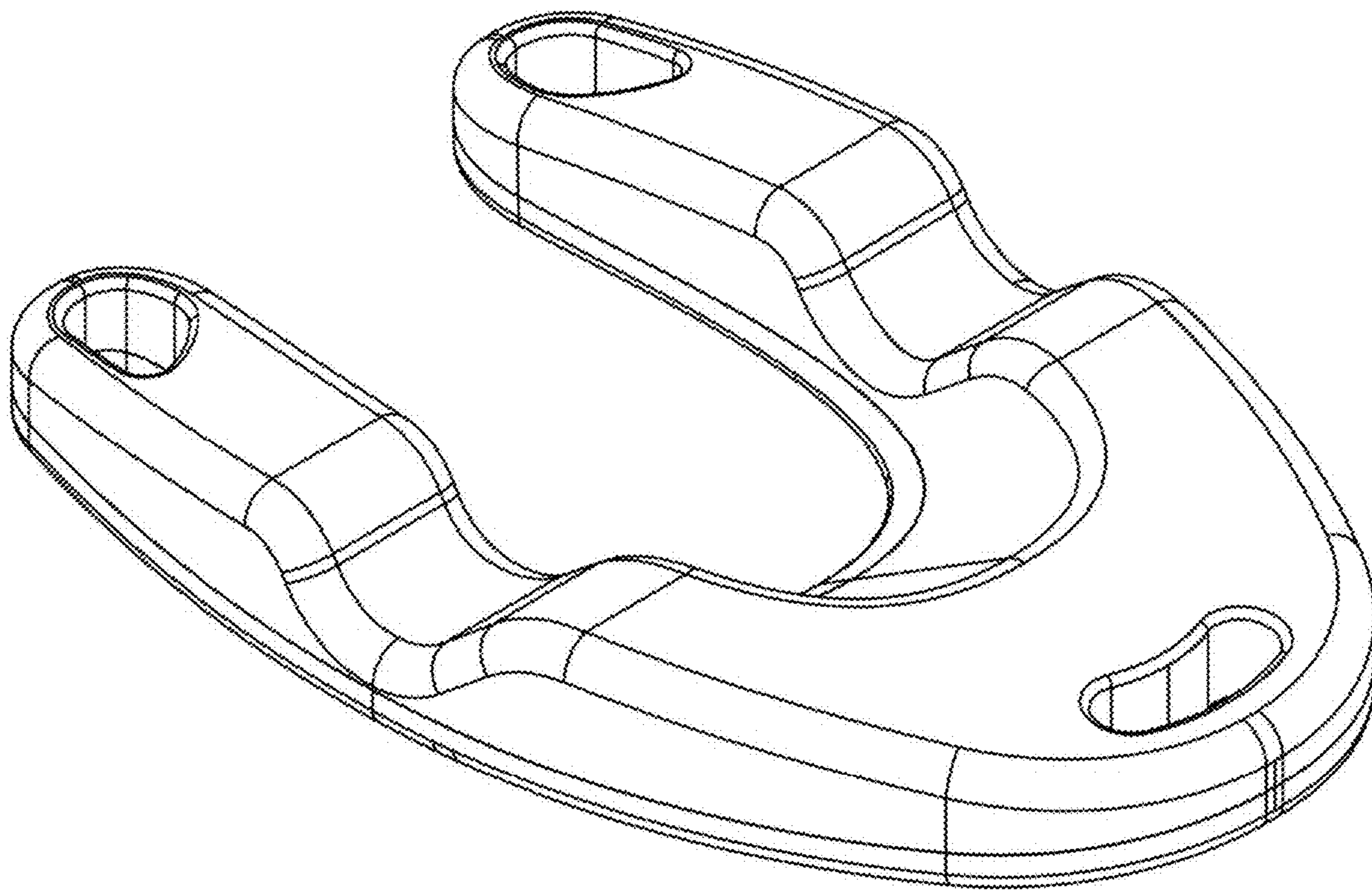
