FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

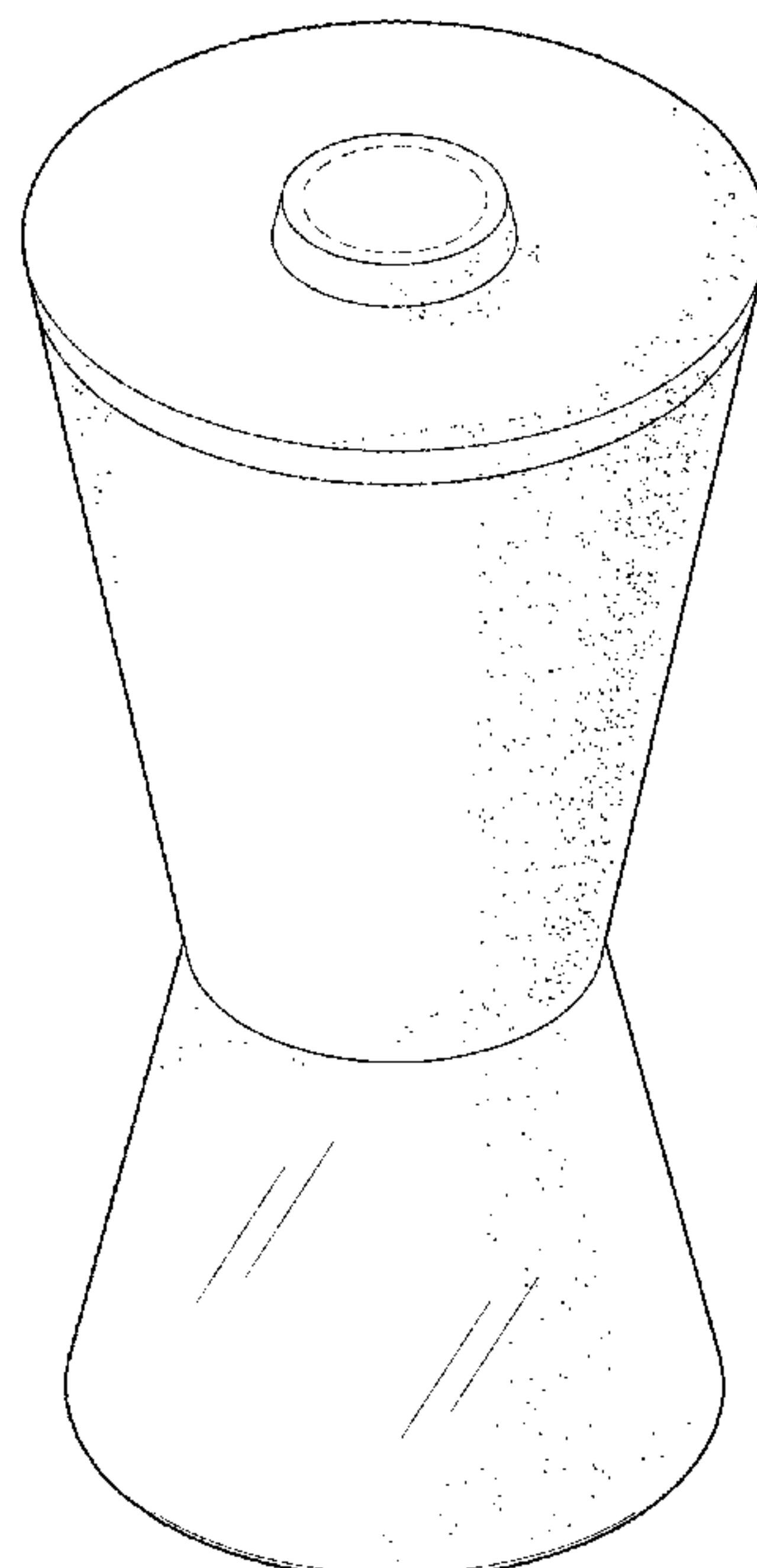
FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, the aerosolizer being rotationally symmetric such that all side views are the same as one another.

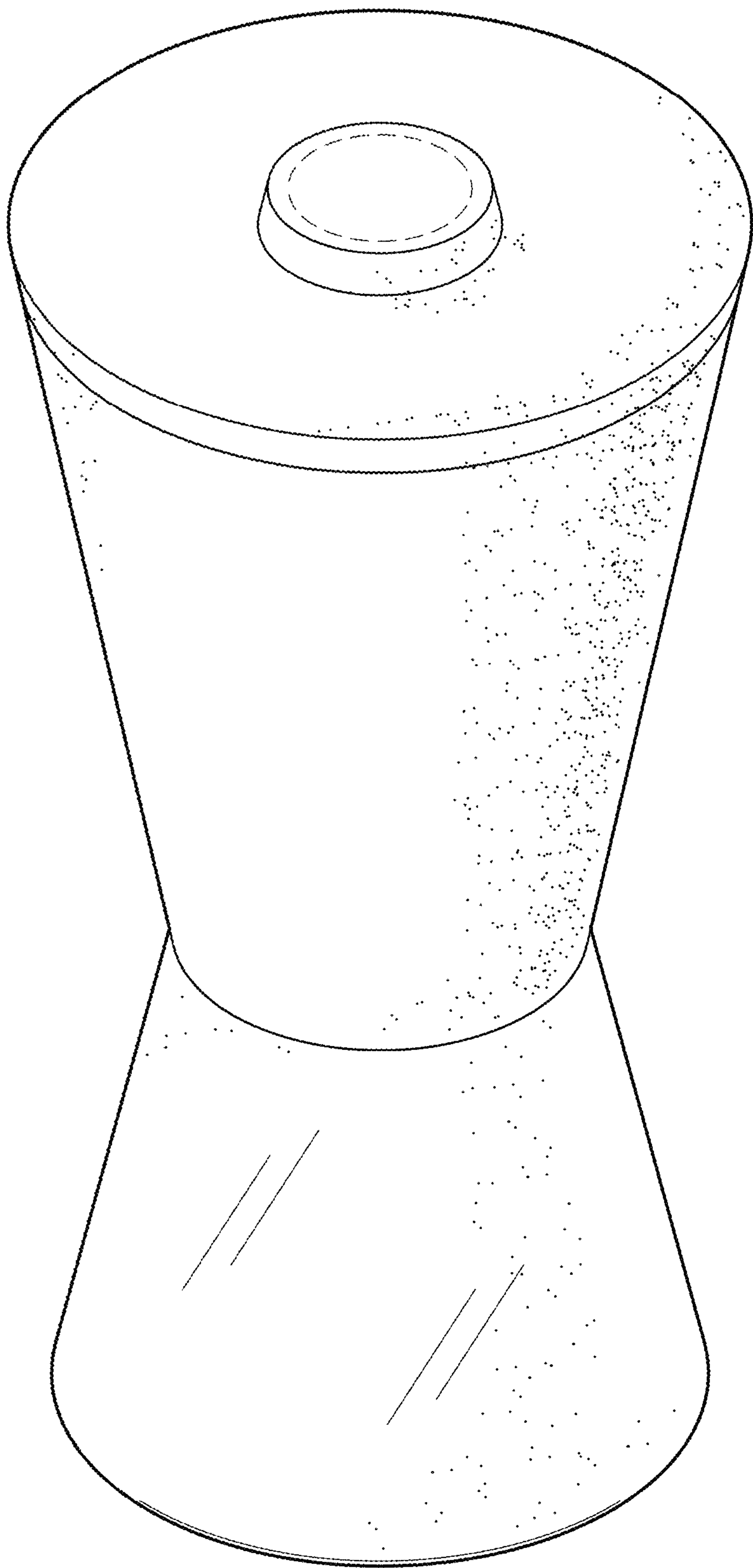

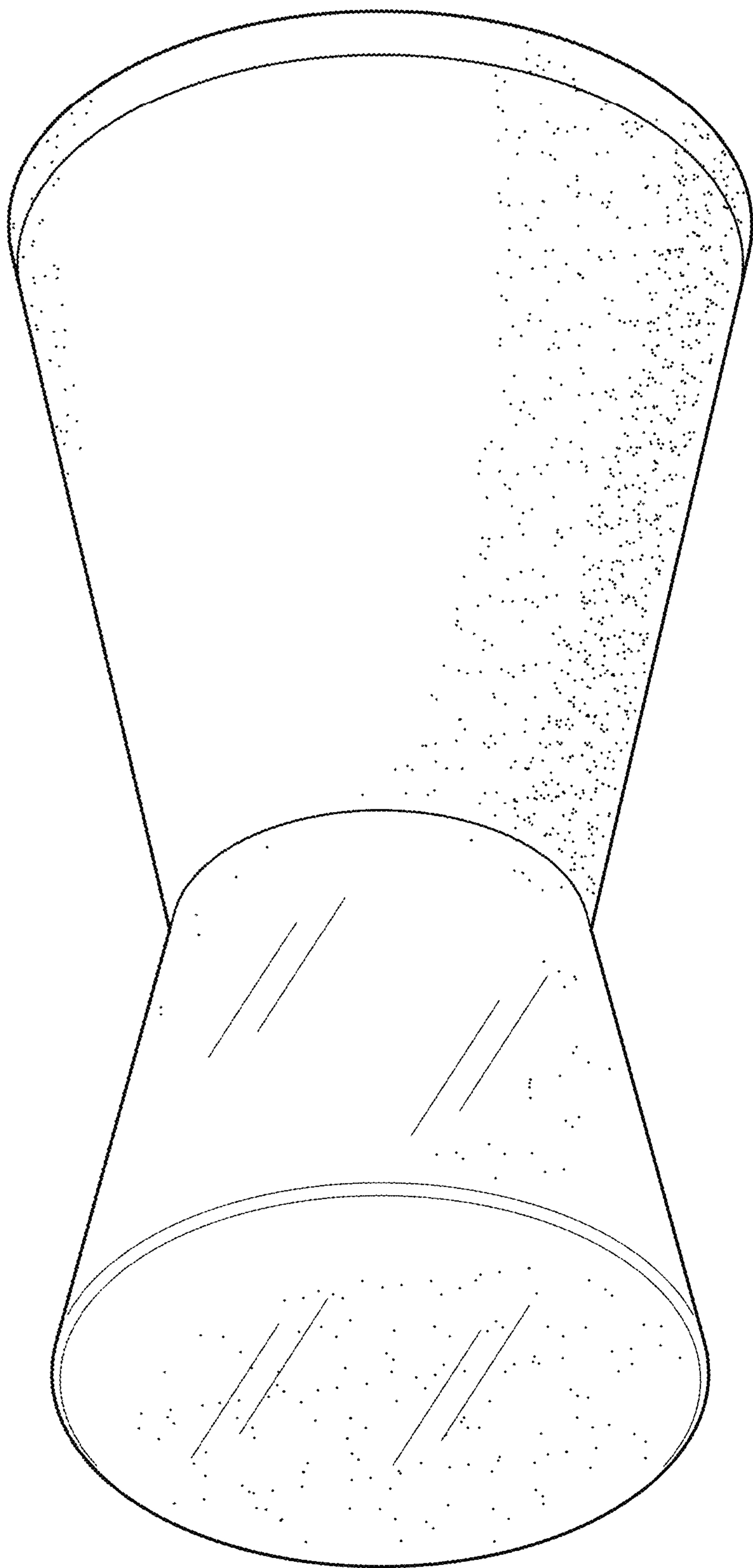

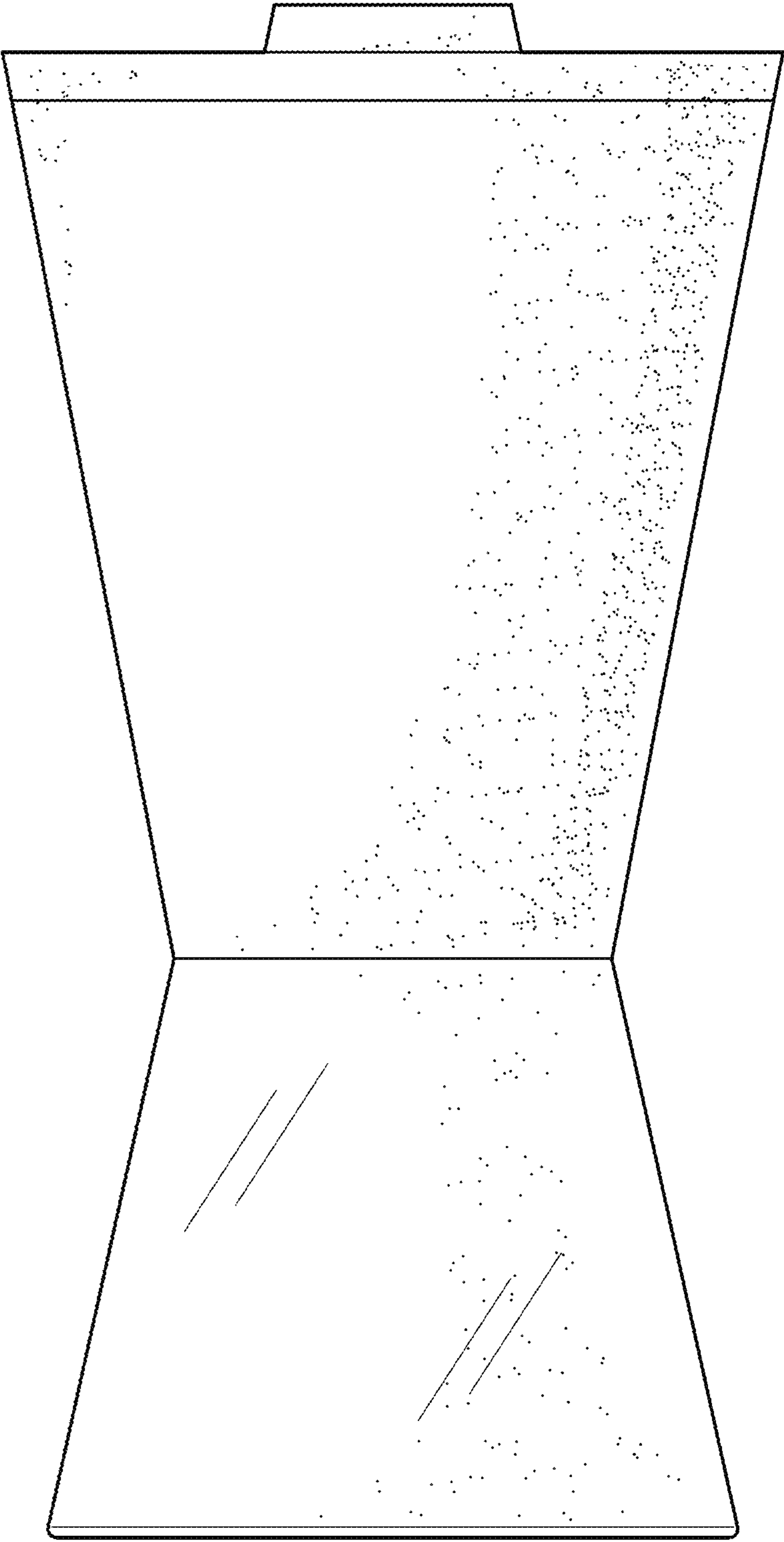

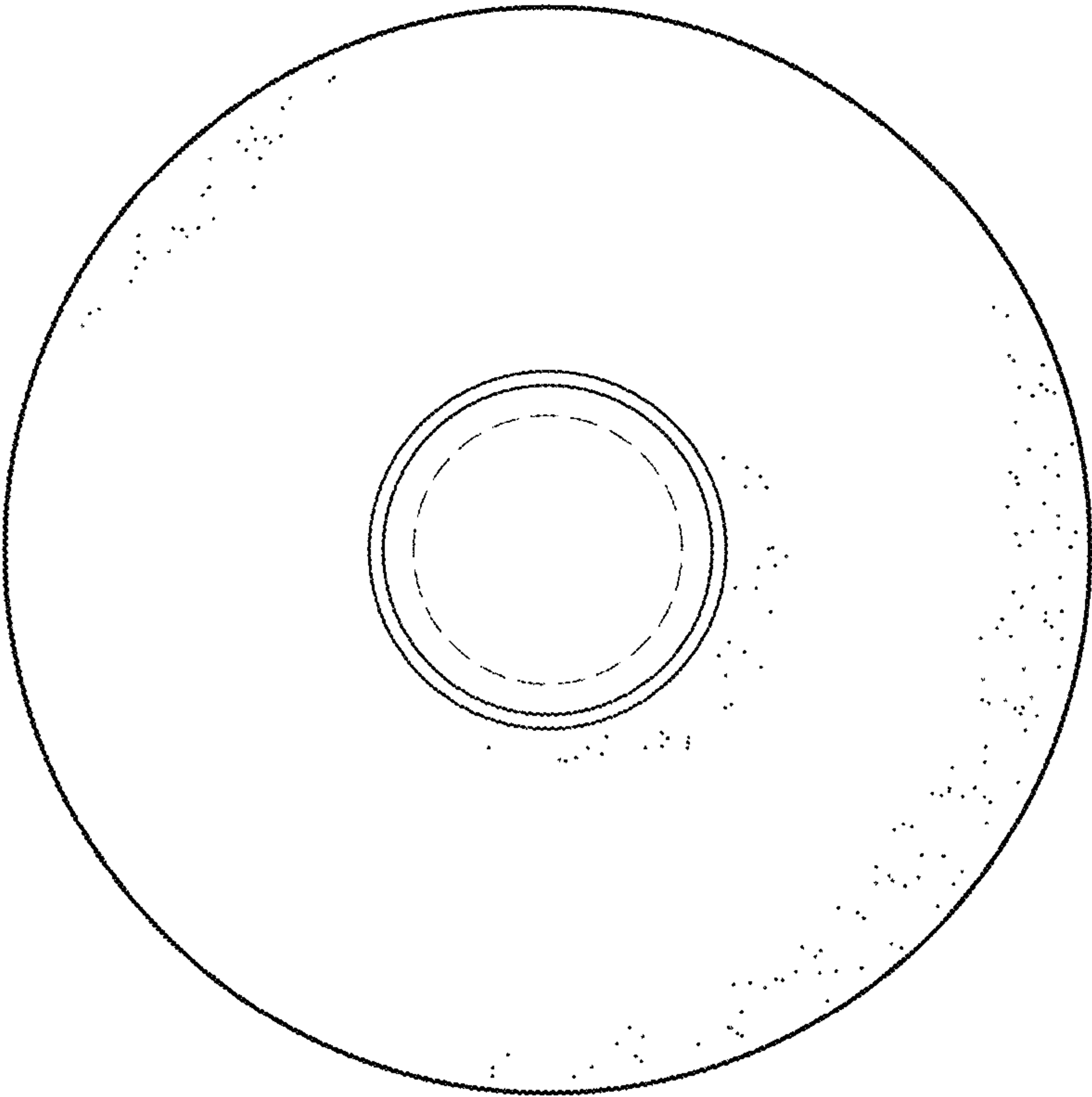

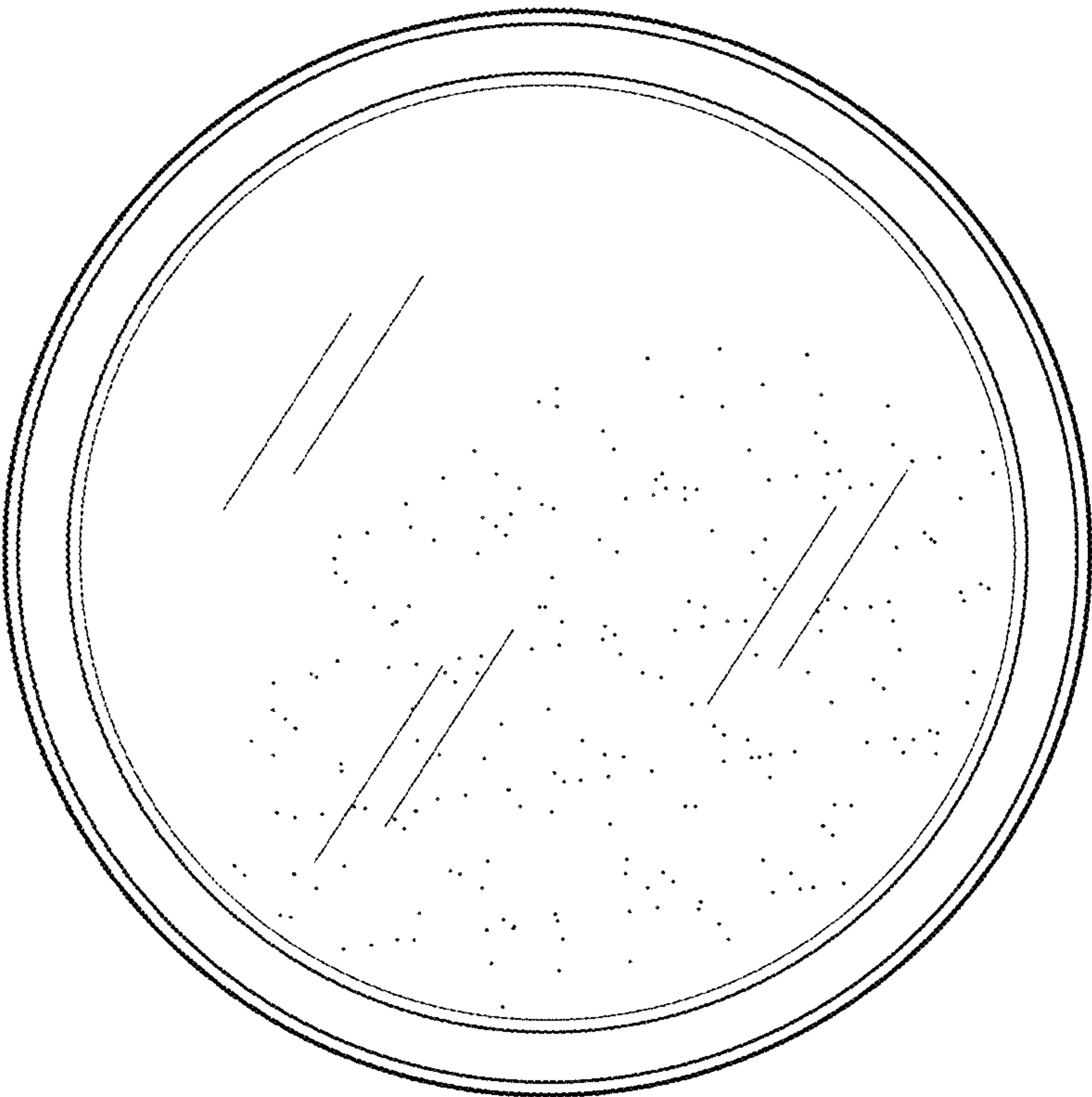
