DESCRIPTION

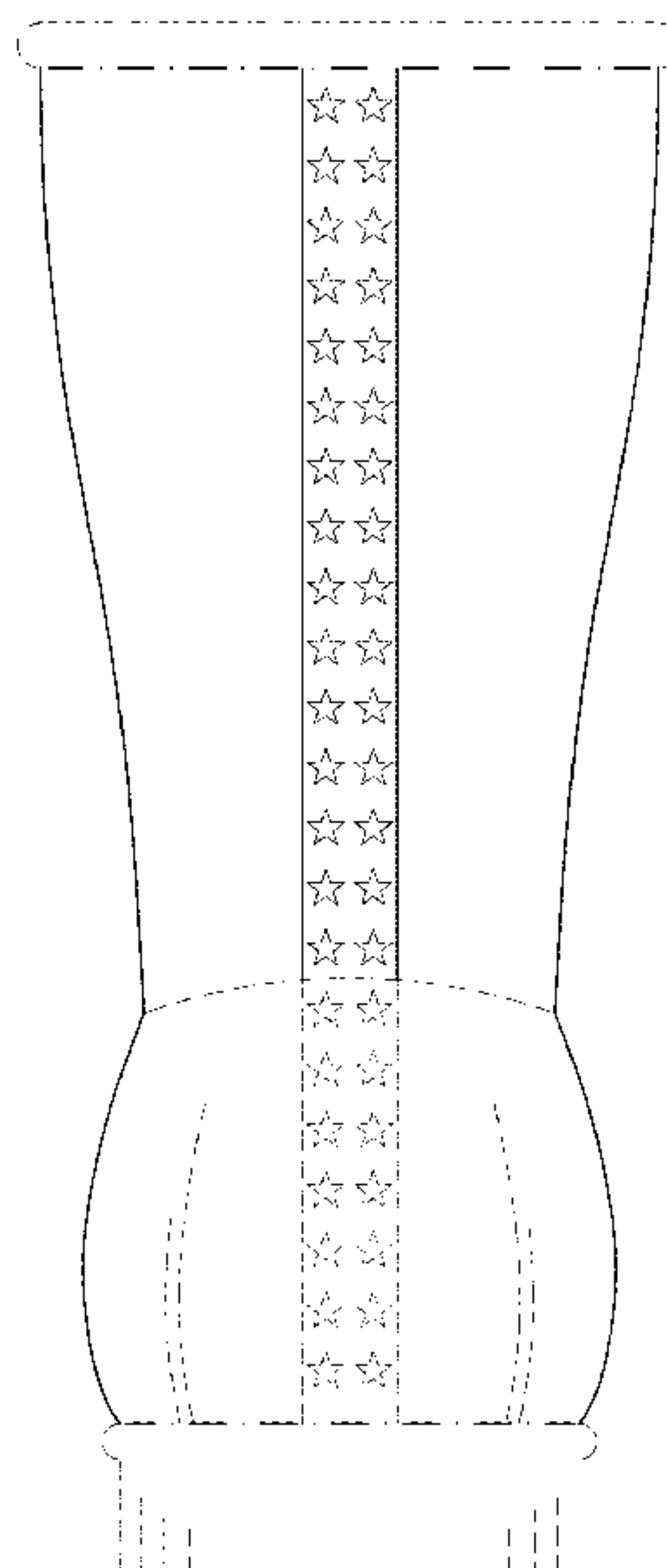
