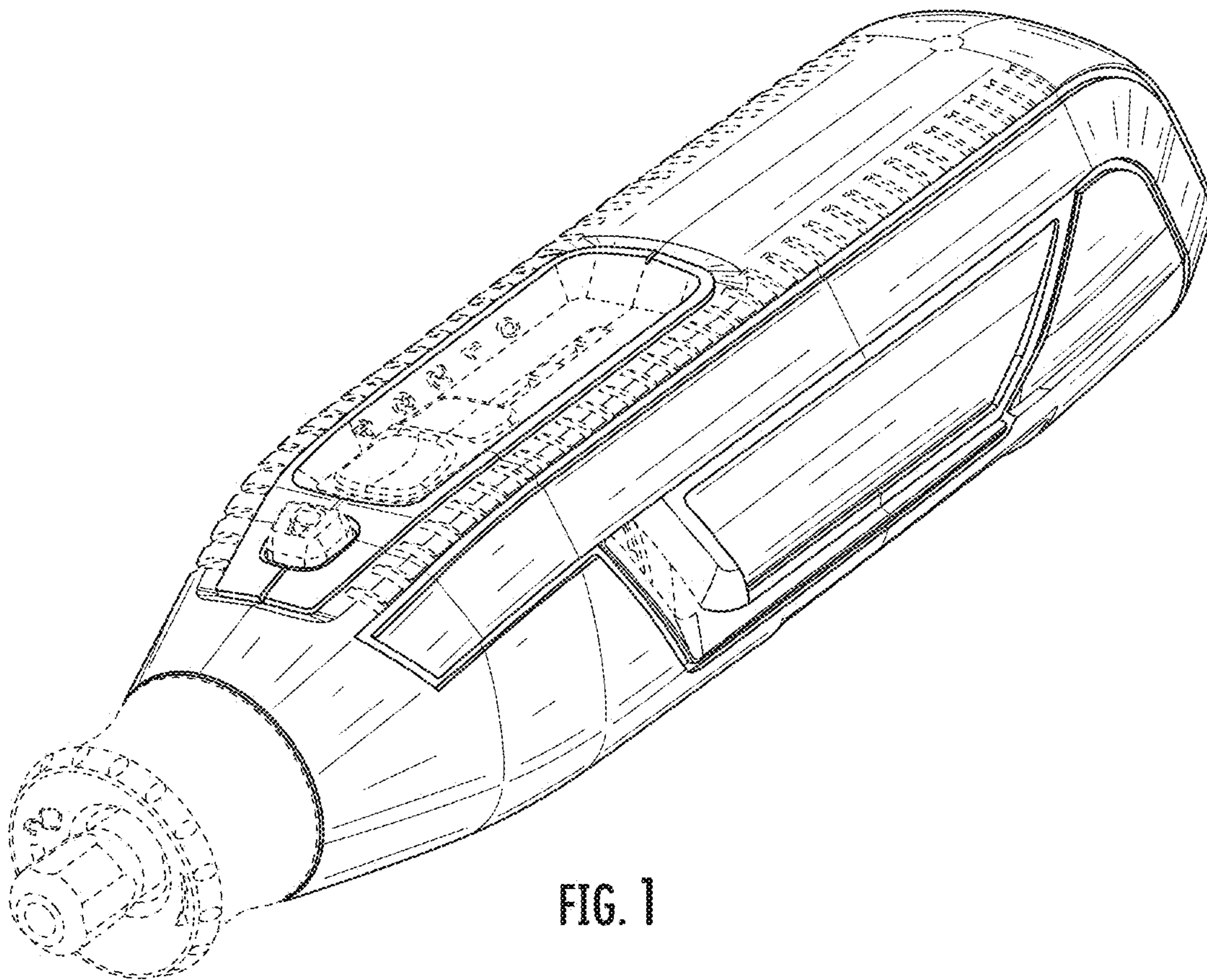
CLAIM

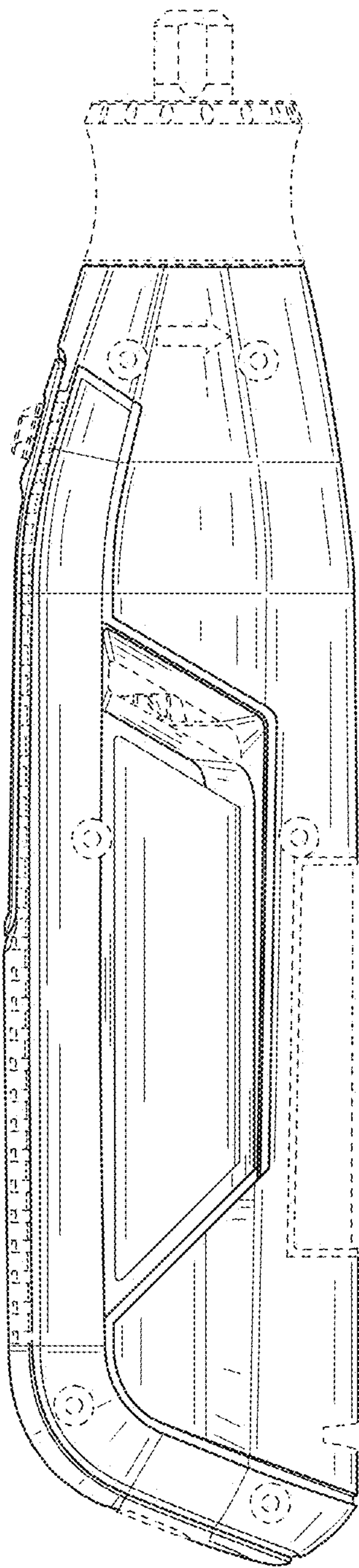

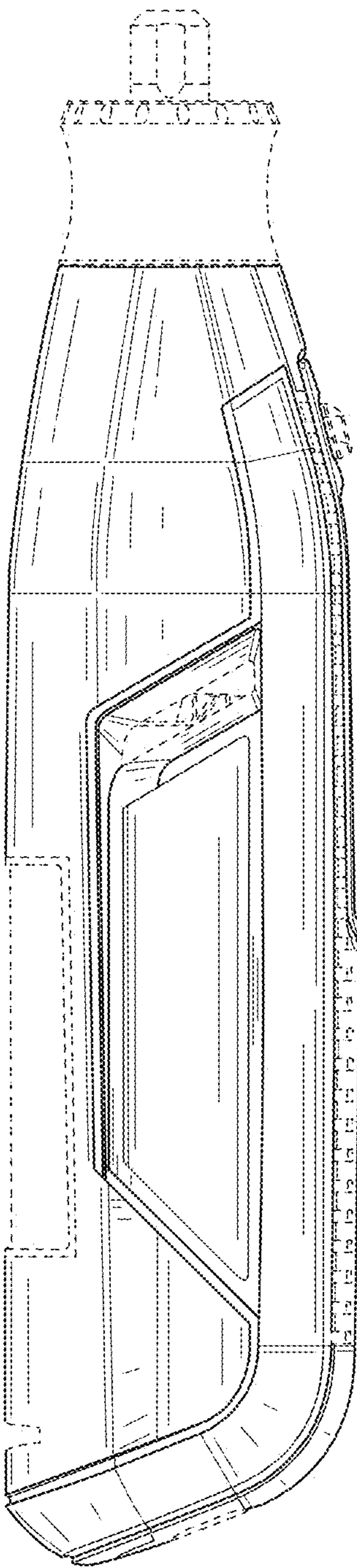

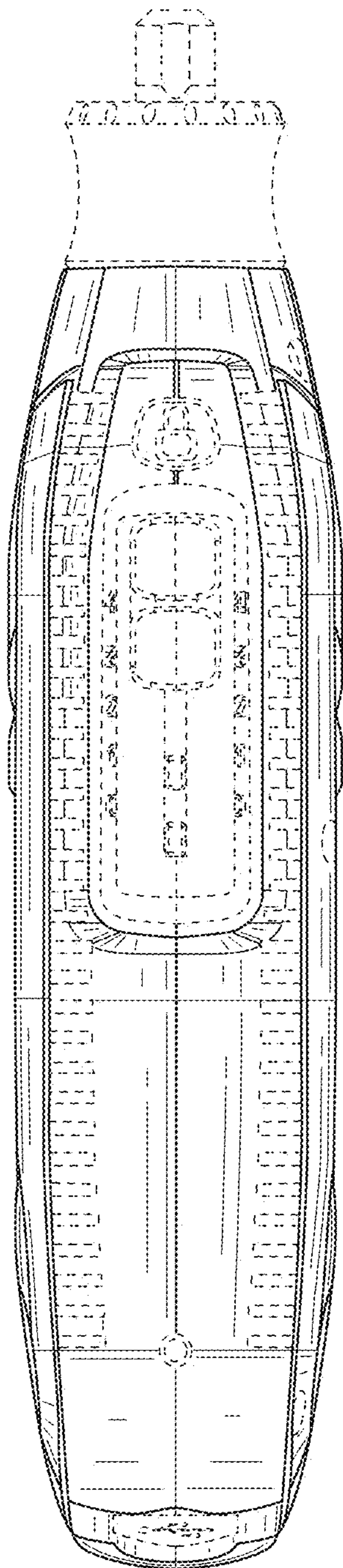

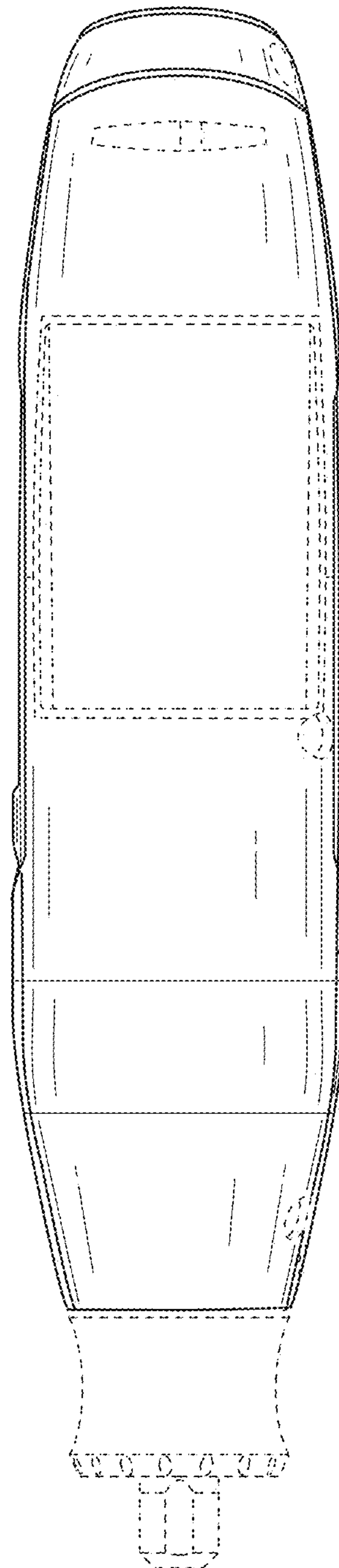

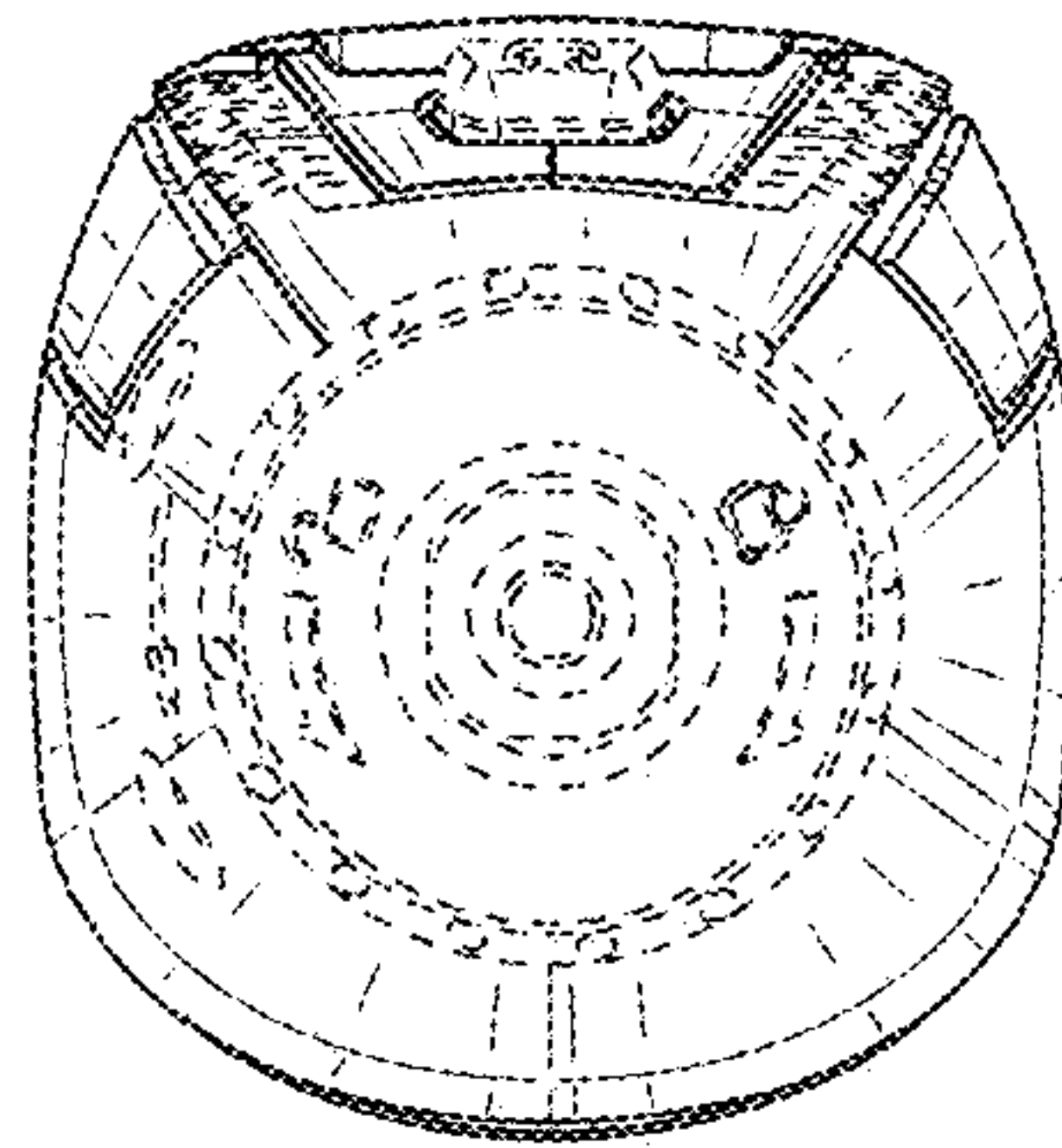

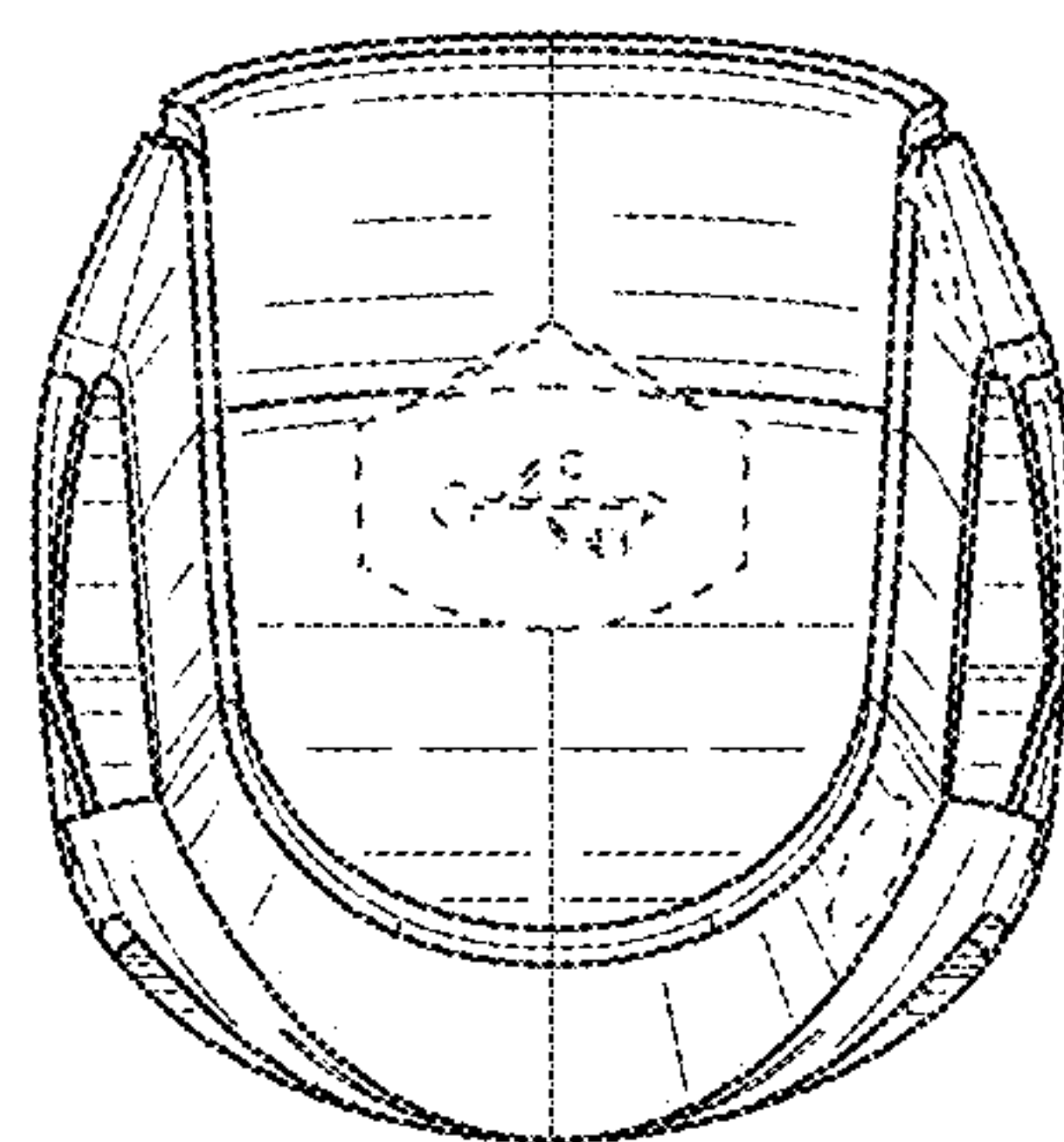
