(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a dog sweatshirt hood, as shown and described.

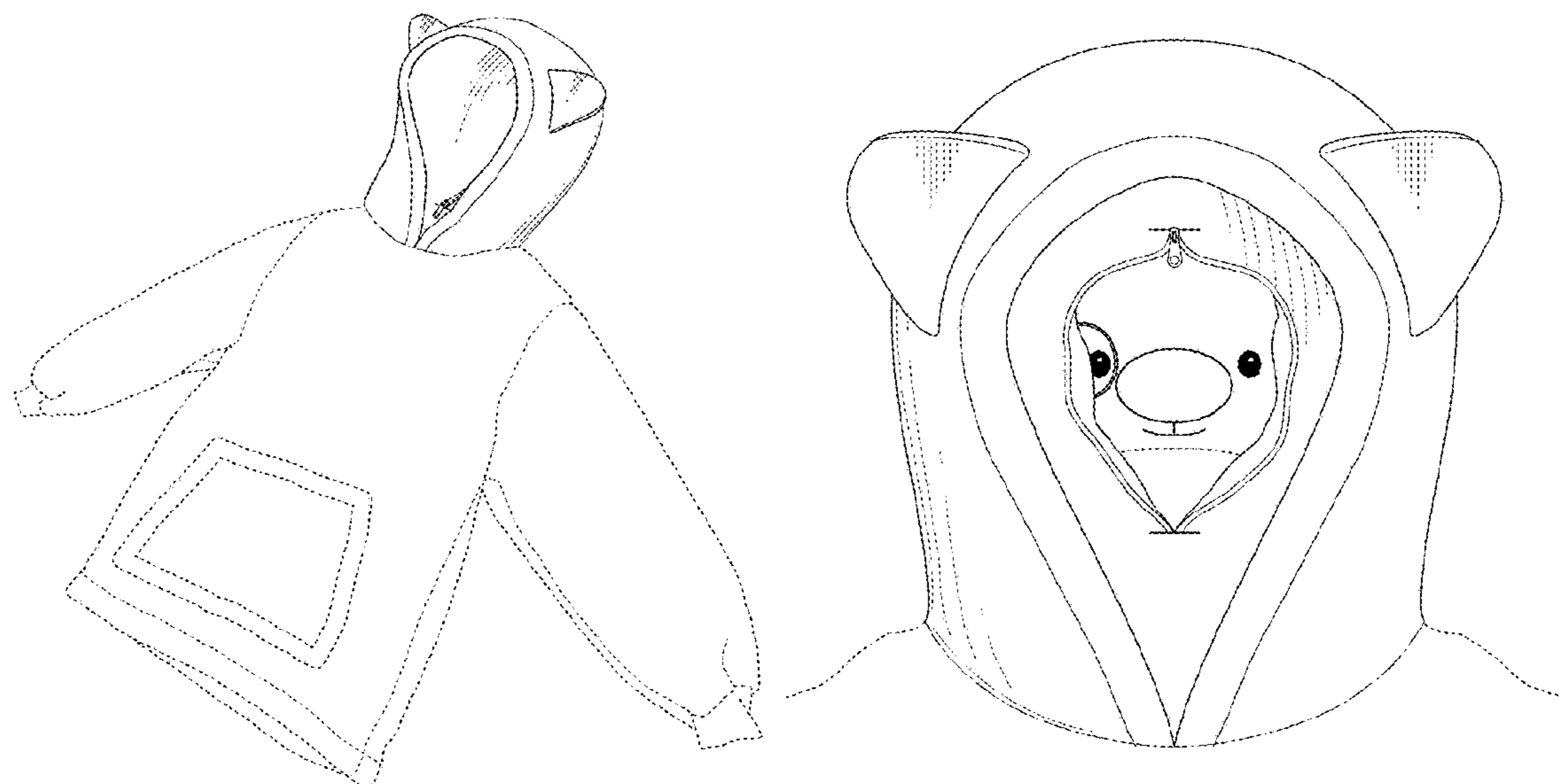
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dog sweatshirt hood; FIG. 2 is a front view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a top view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a right side view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a left side view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a front view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1 in a laid-flat position with a zipper in an open position; and, FIG. 8 is a front view of the dog sweatshirt hood of FIG. 1 with a zipper in an open position.

The zipper follows the curvature of the dog sweatshirt hood. The facial features are an applied motif that follows the curvature of the dog sweatshirt hood.

The dash-dot-dash broken line defines the bounds of the claim and forms no part of the claimed design. The even-length broken line along the hood portion of the dog sweatshirt hood depicts a feature line that forms no part of the claimed design. The even-length broken lines beyond the boundary line depicts portions of the dog sweatshirt hood that form no part of the claimed design.

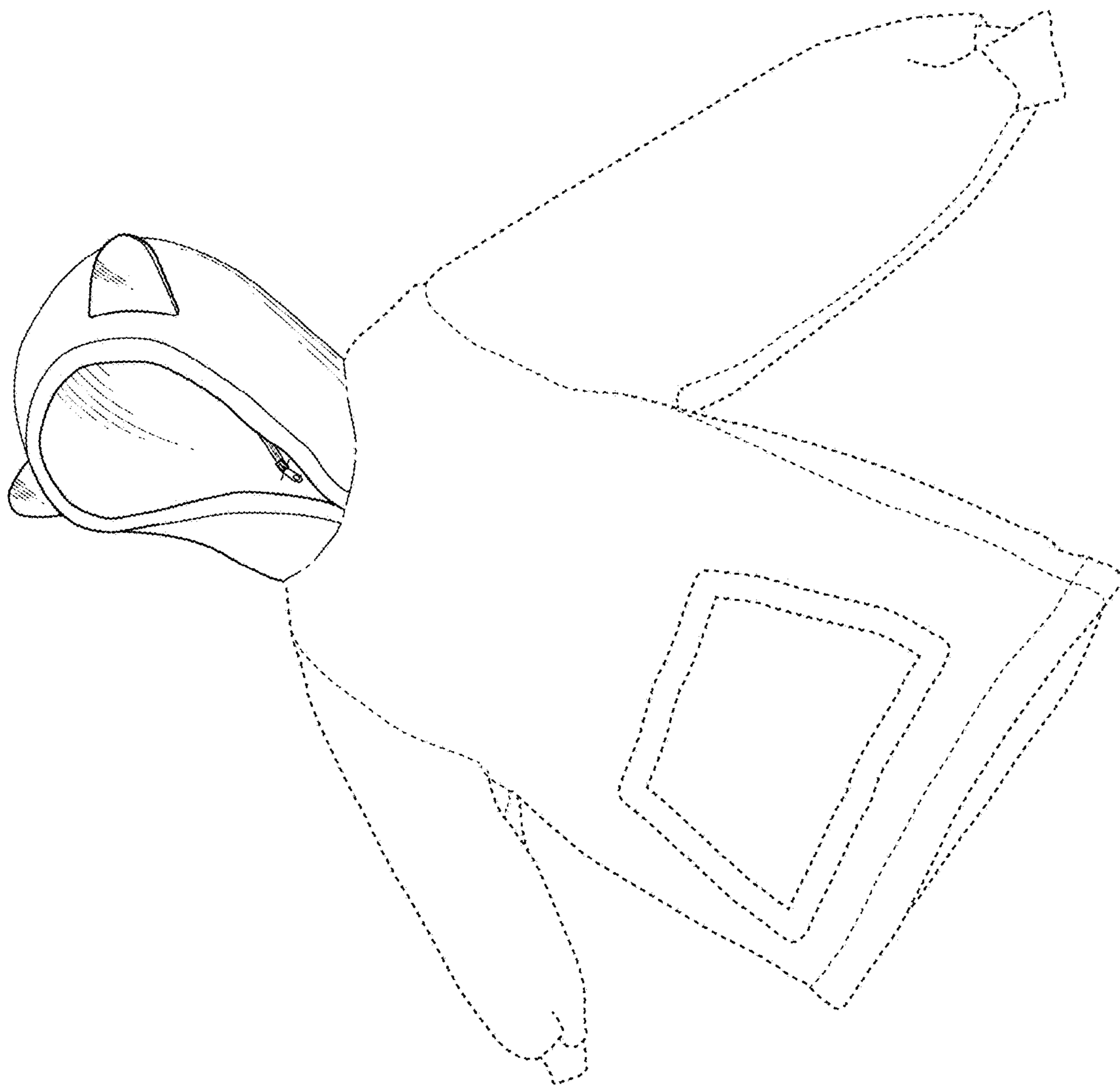

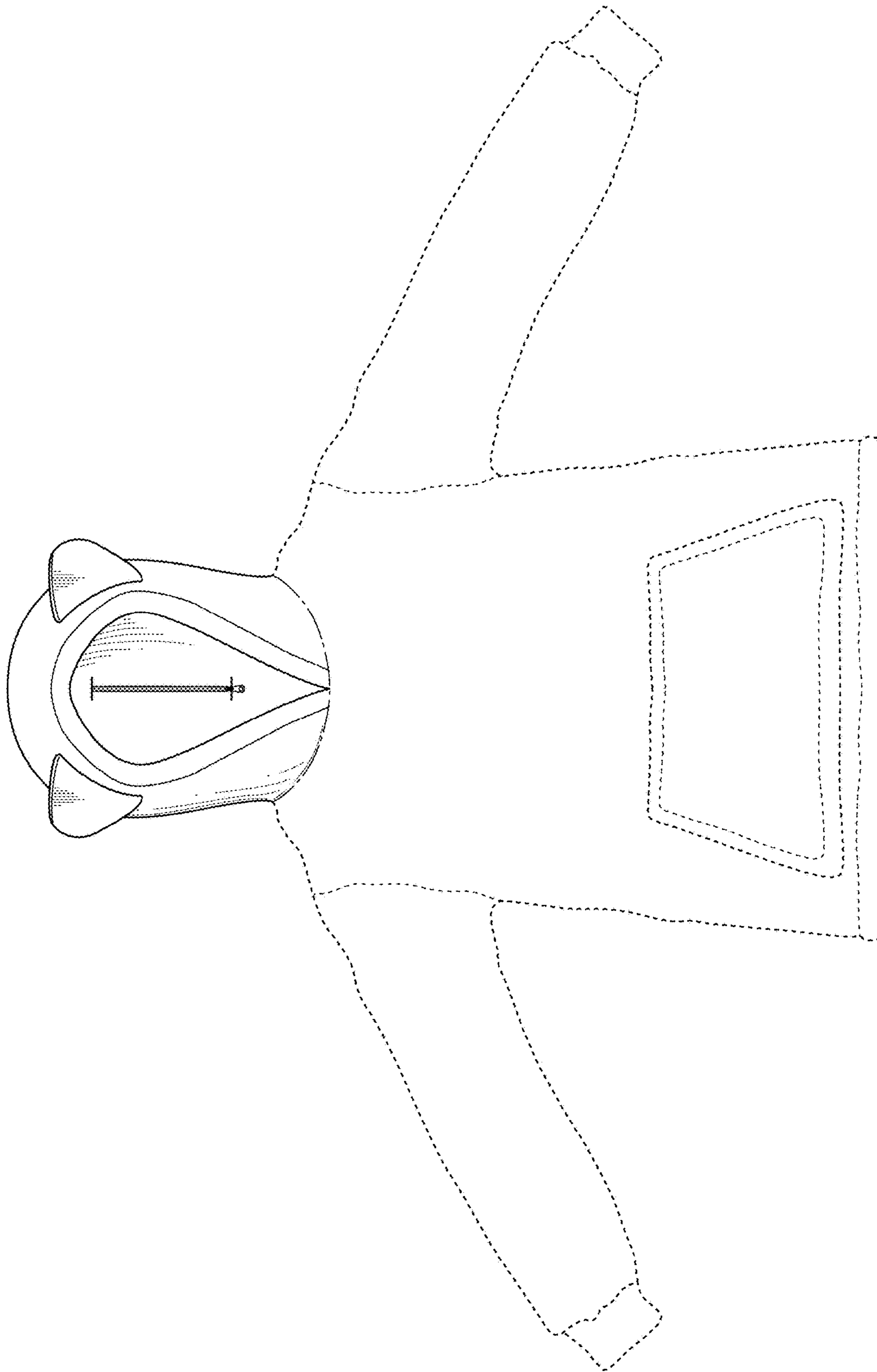

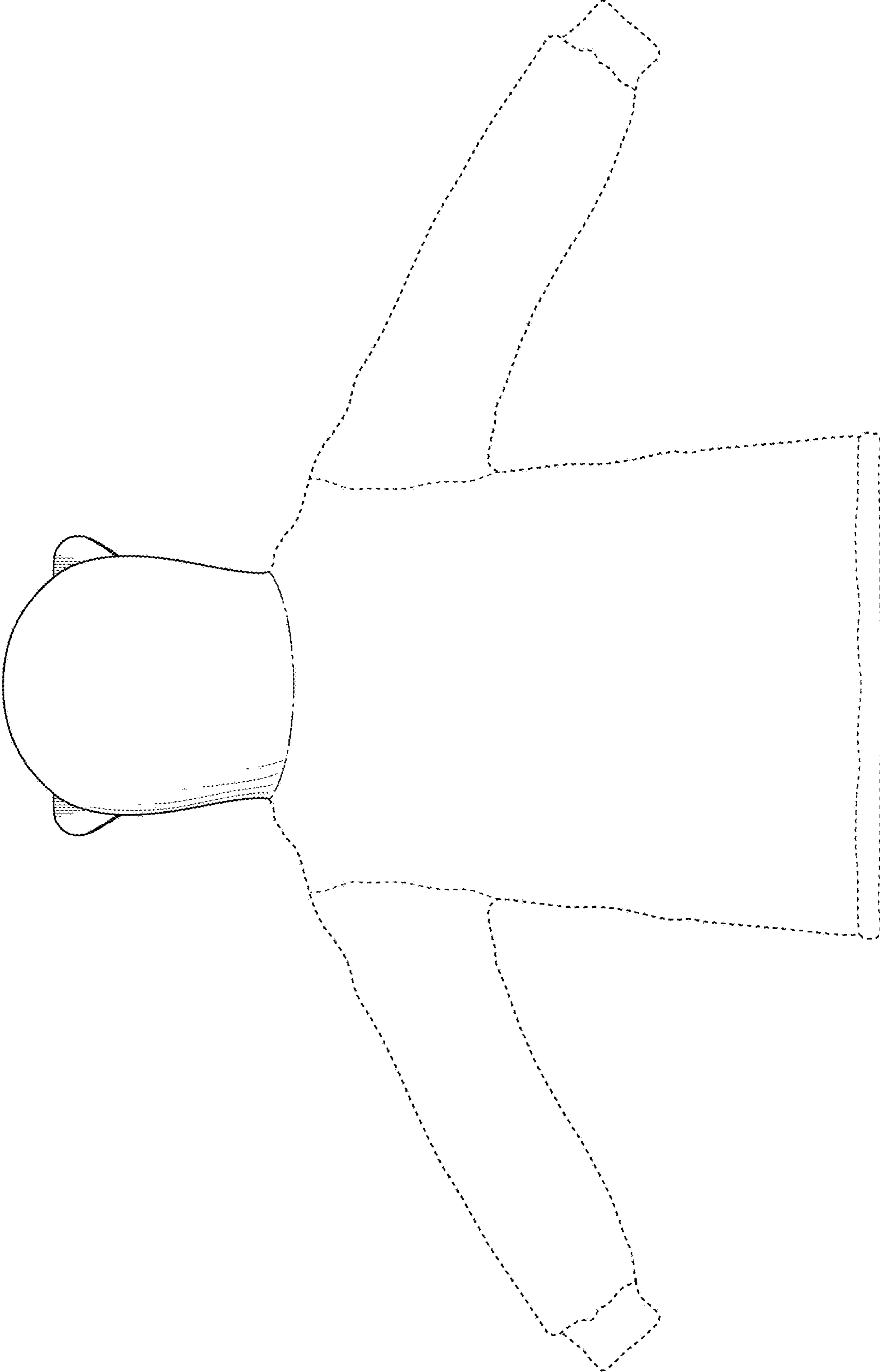

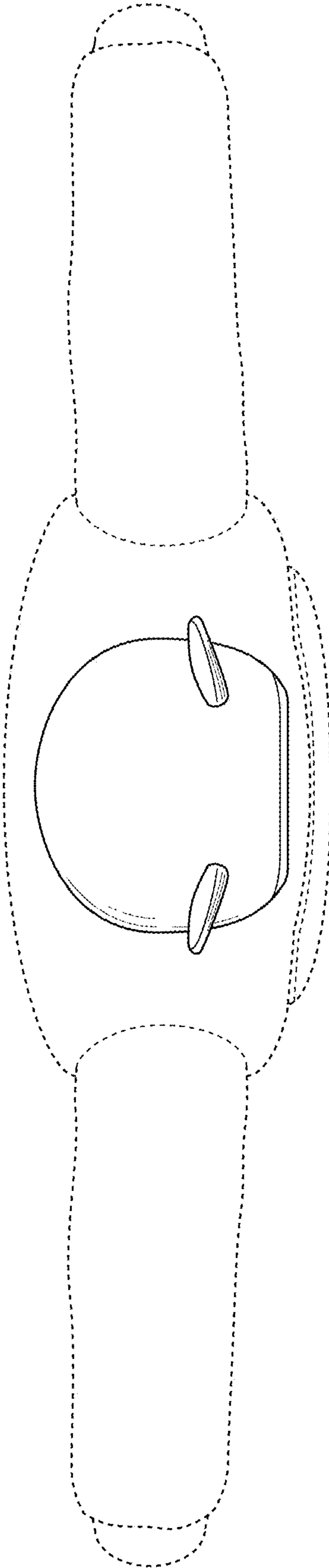

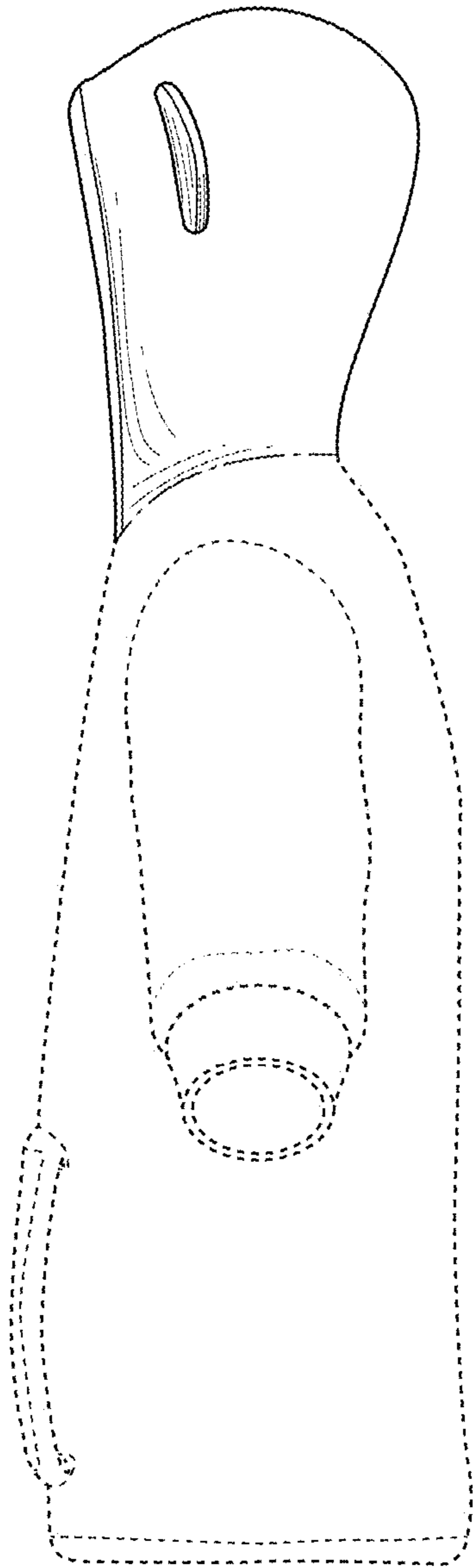

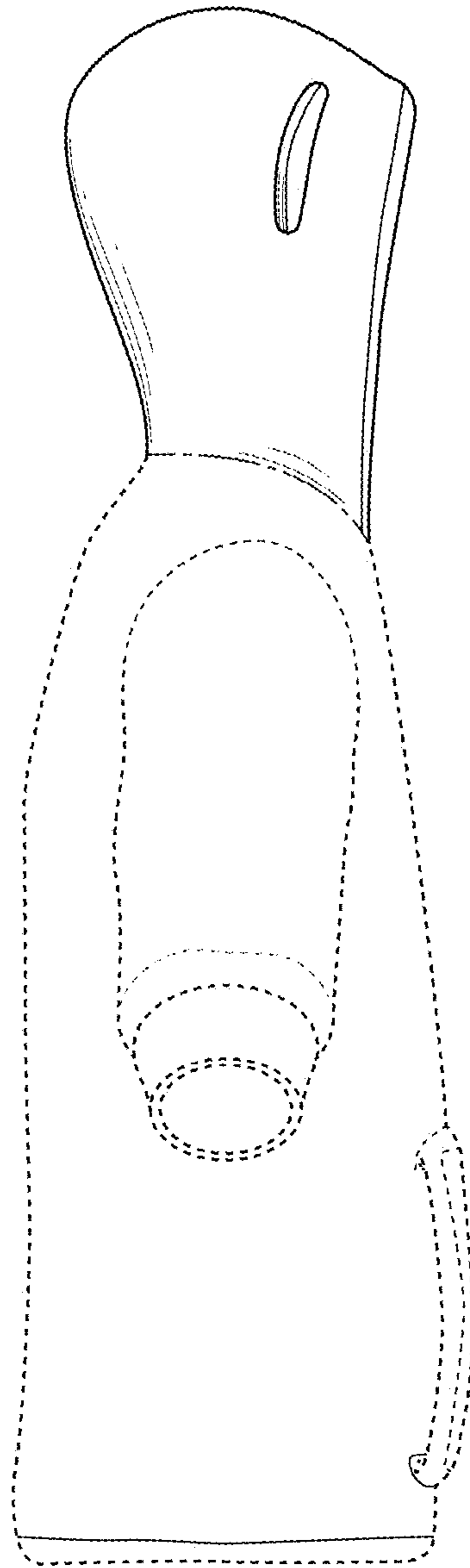

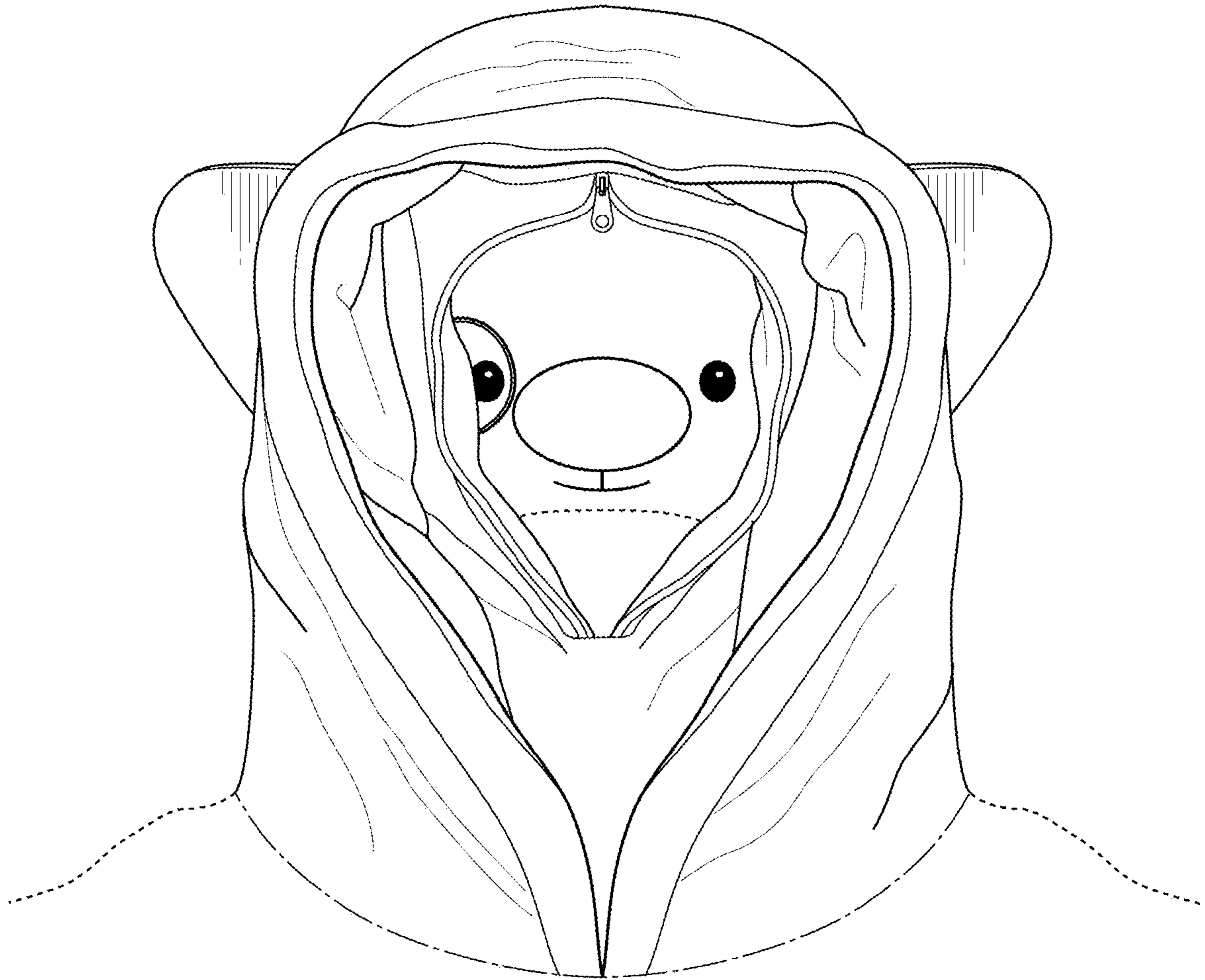

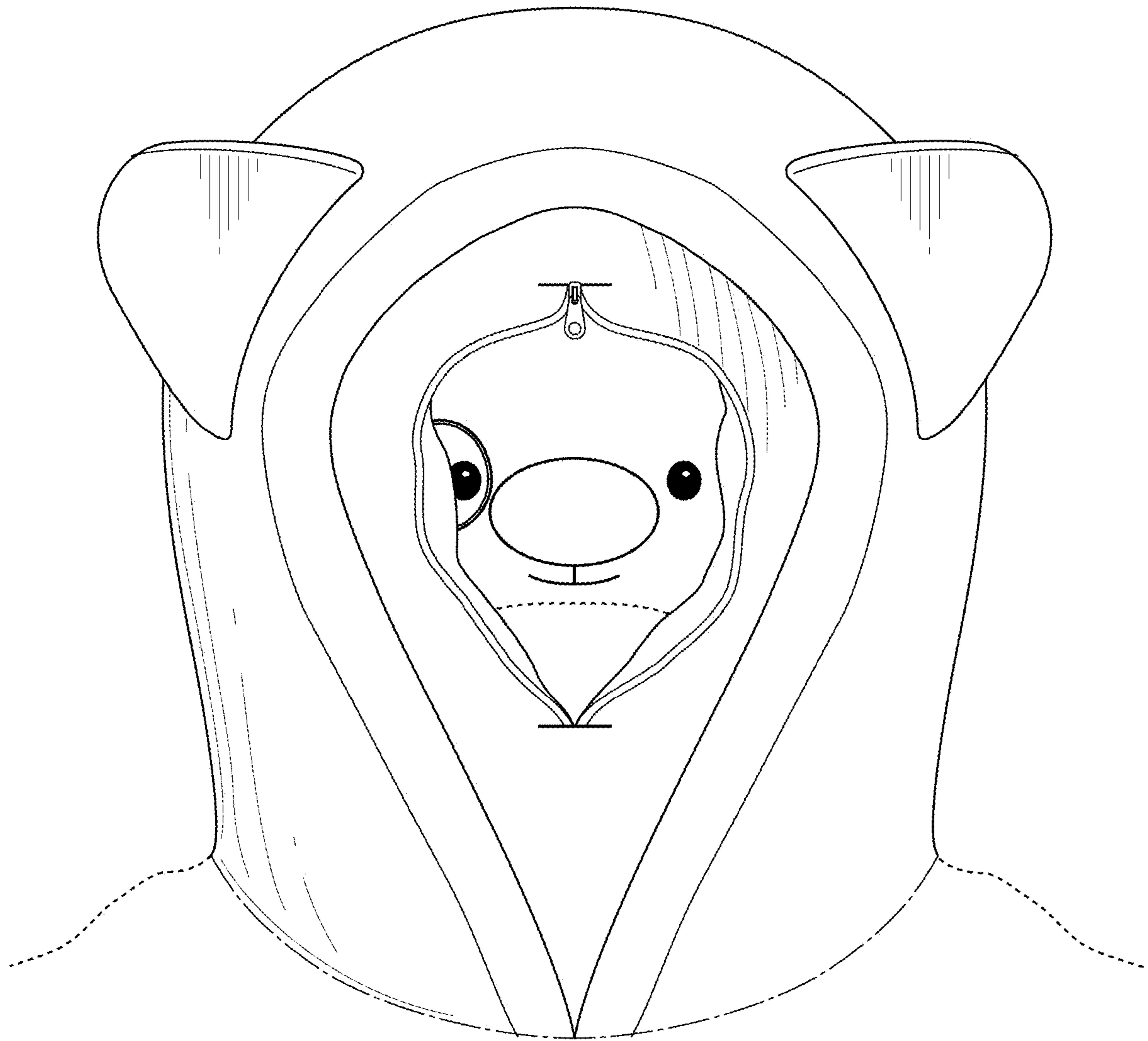
