DESCRIPTION

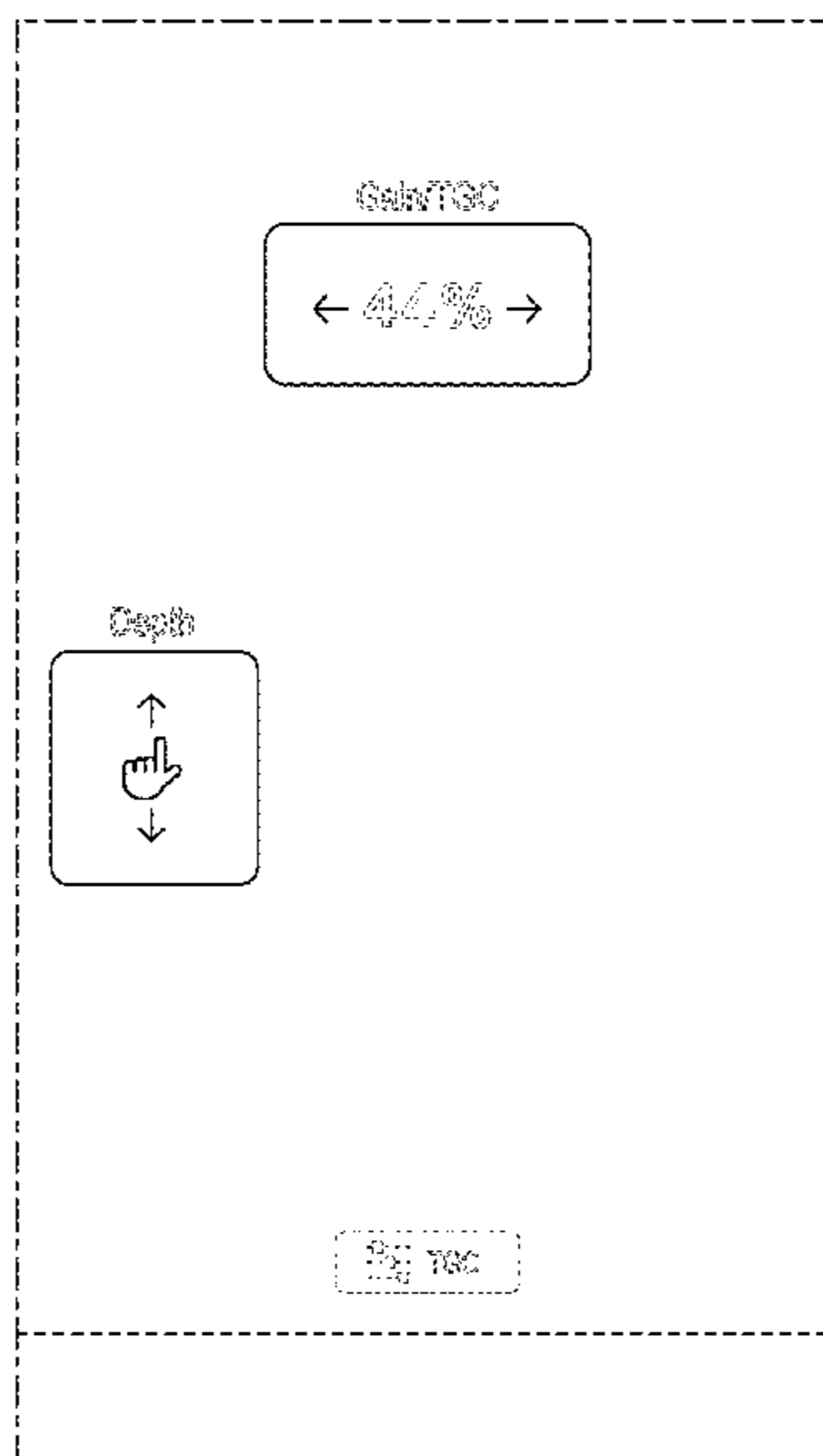

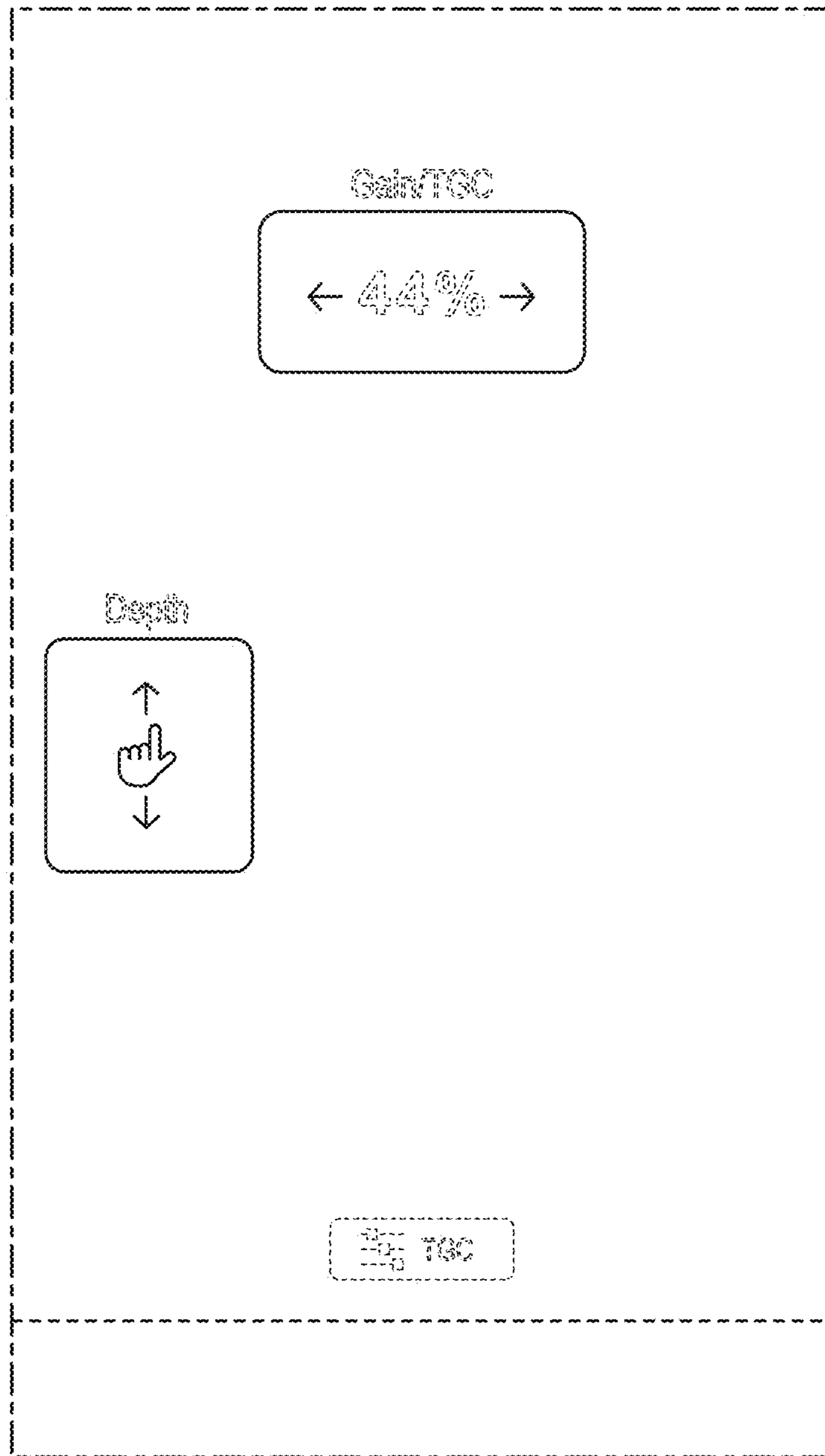

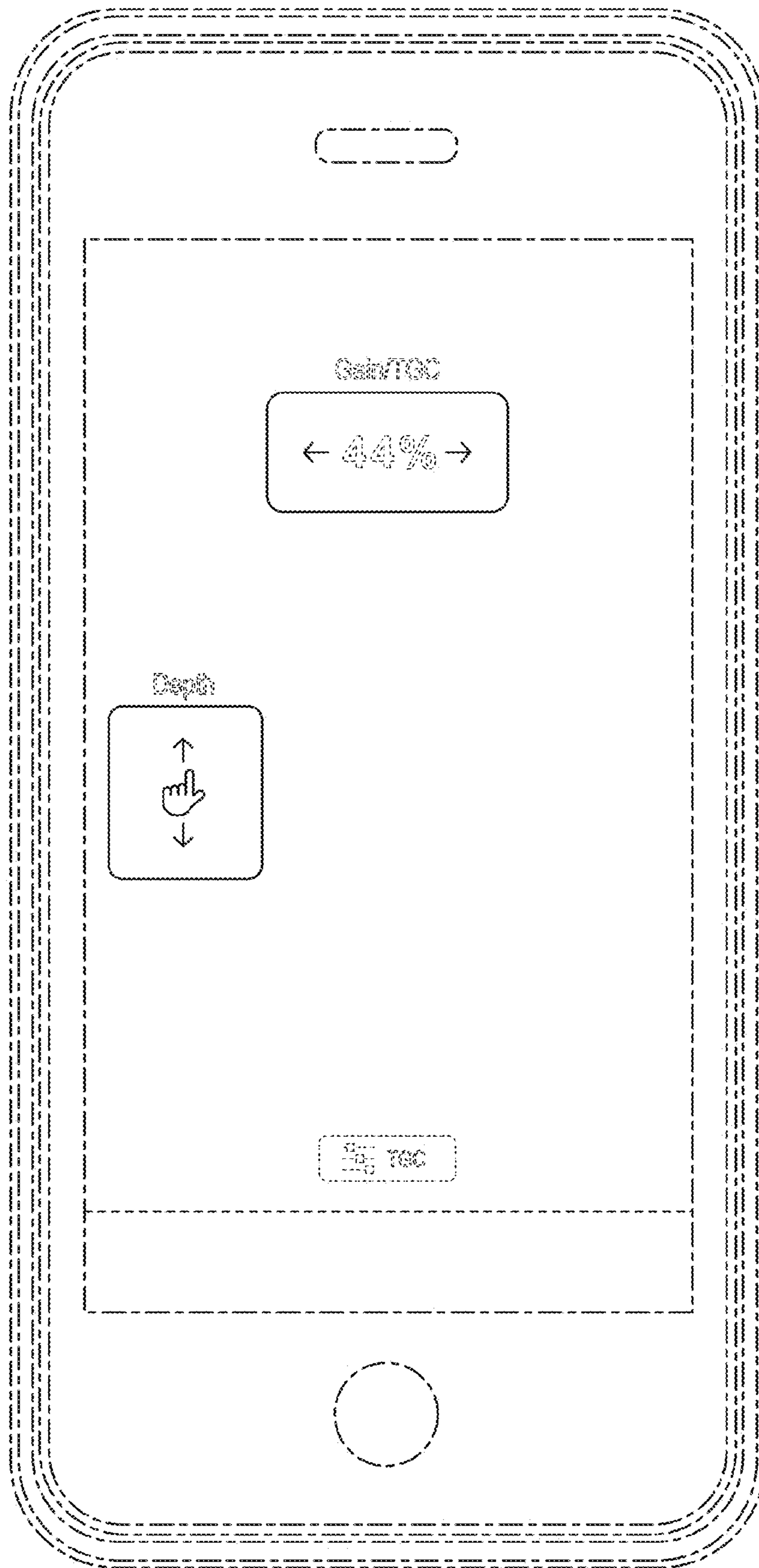
