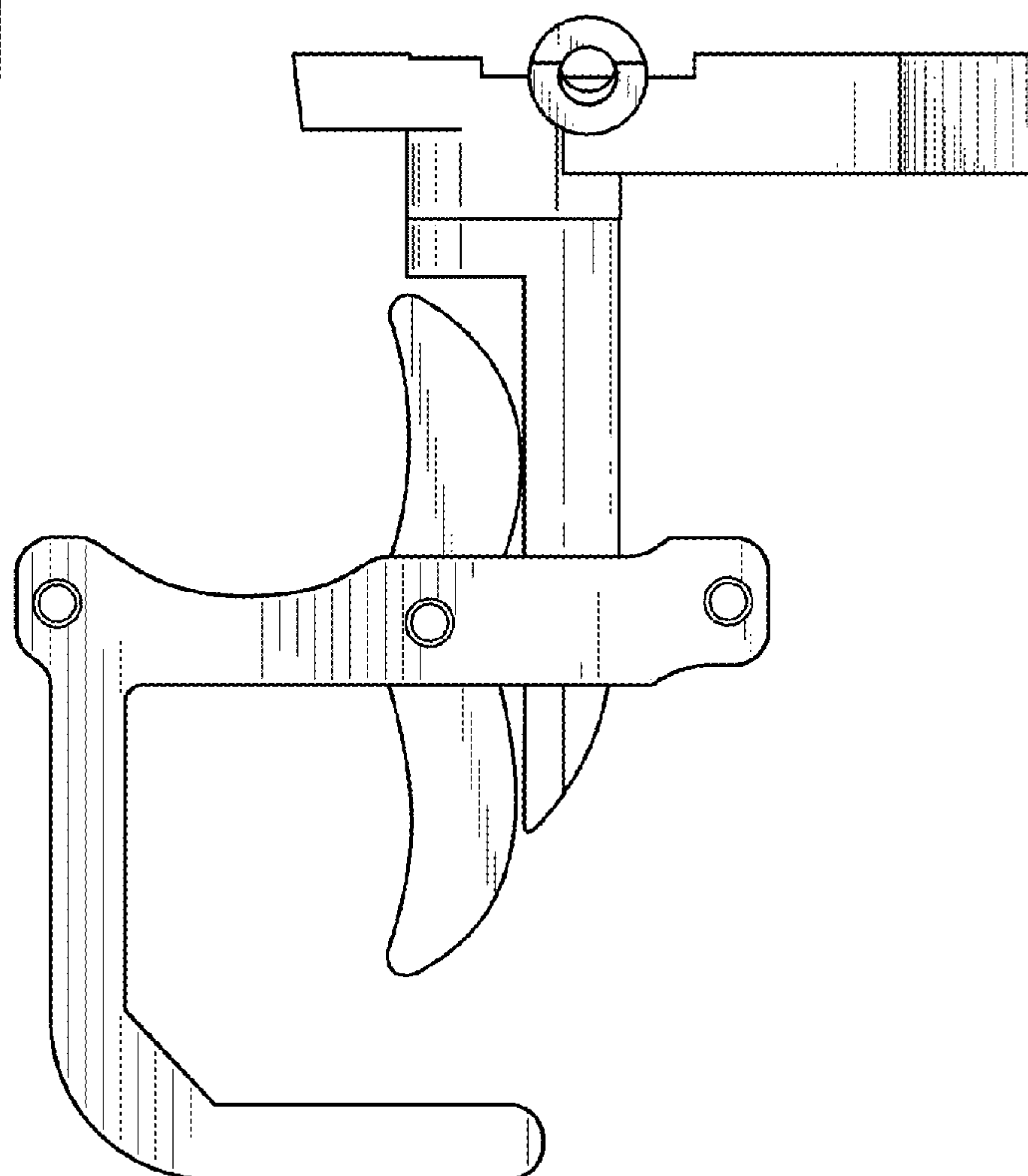
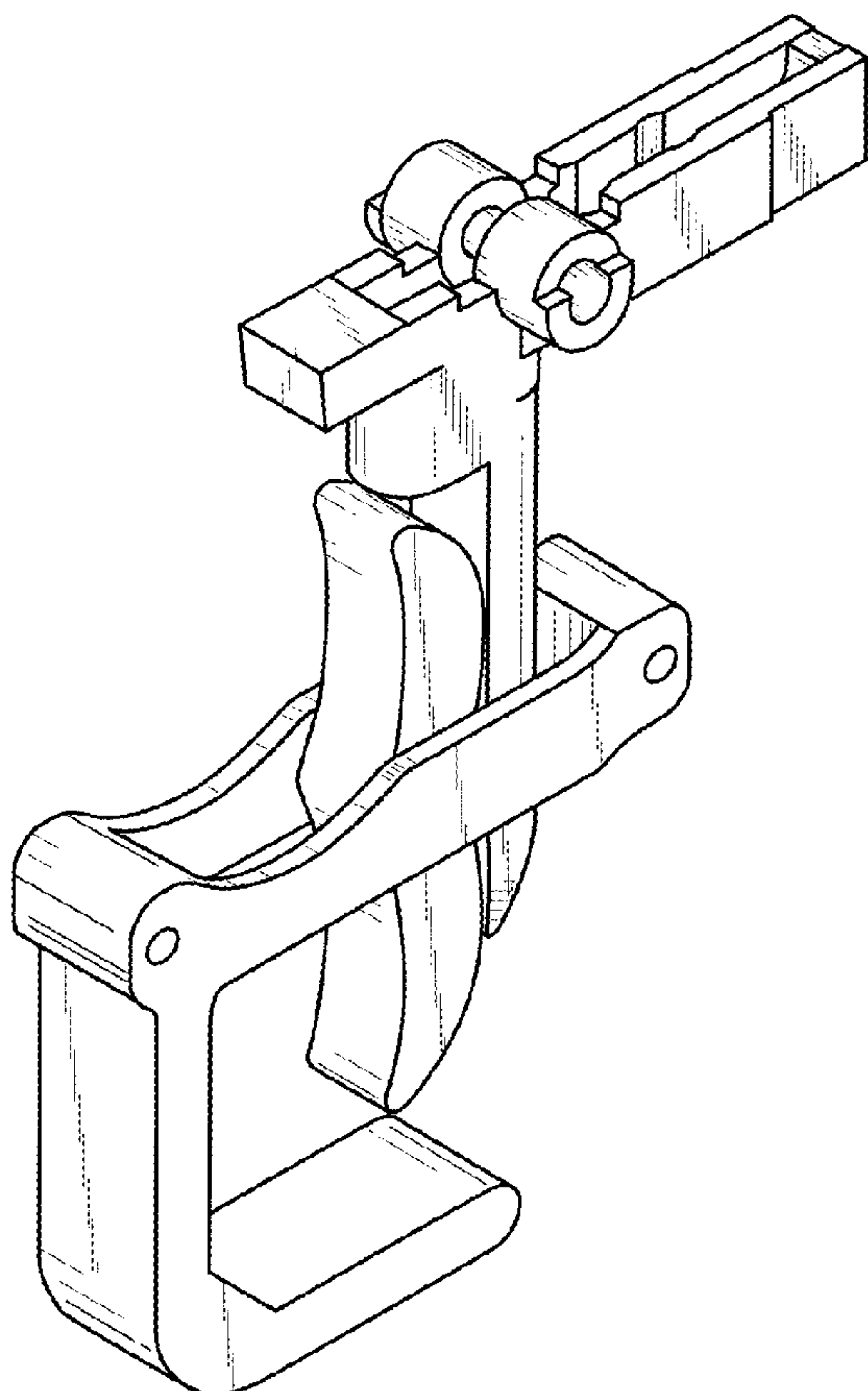
I claim the ornamental design for a rocking trigger for

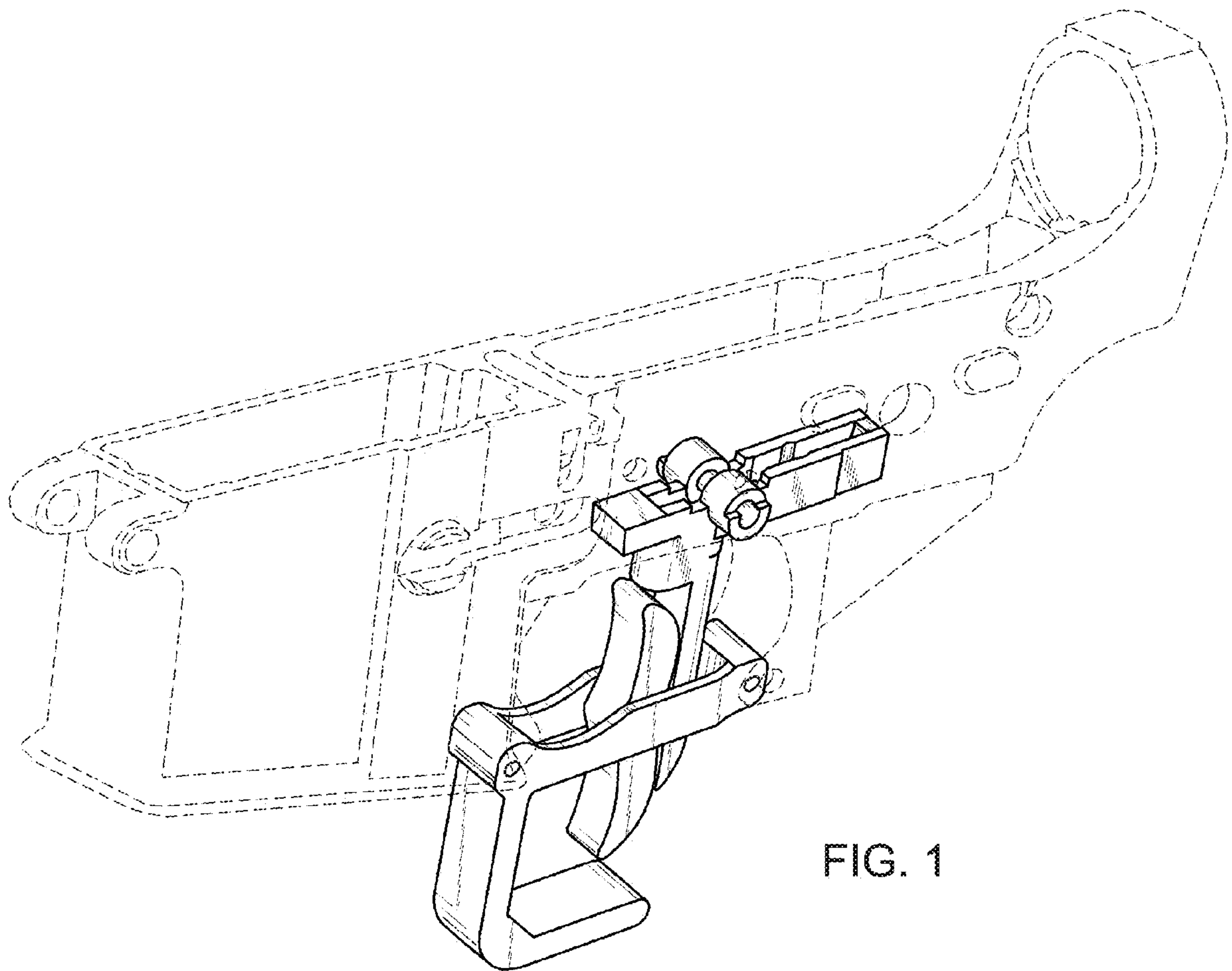

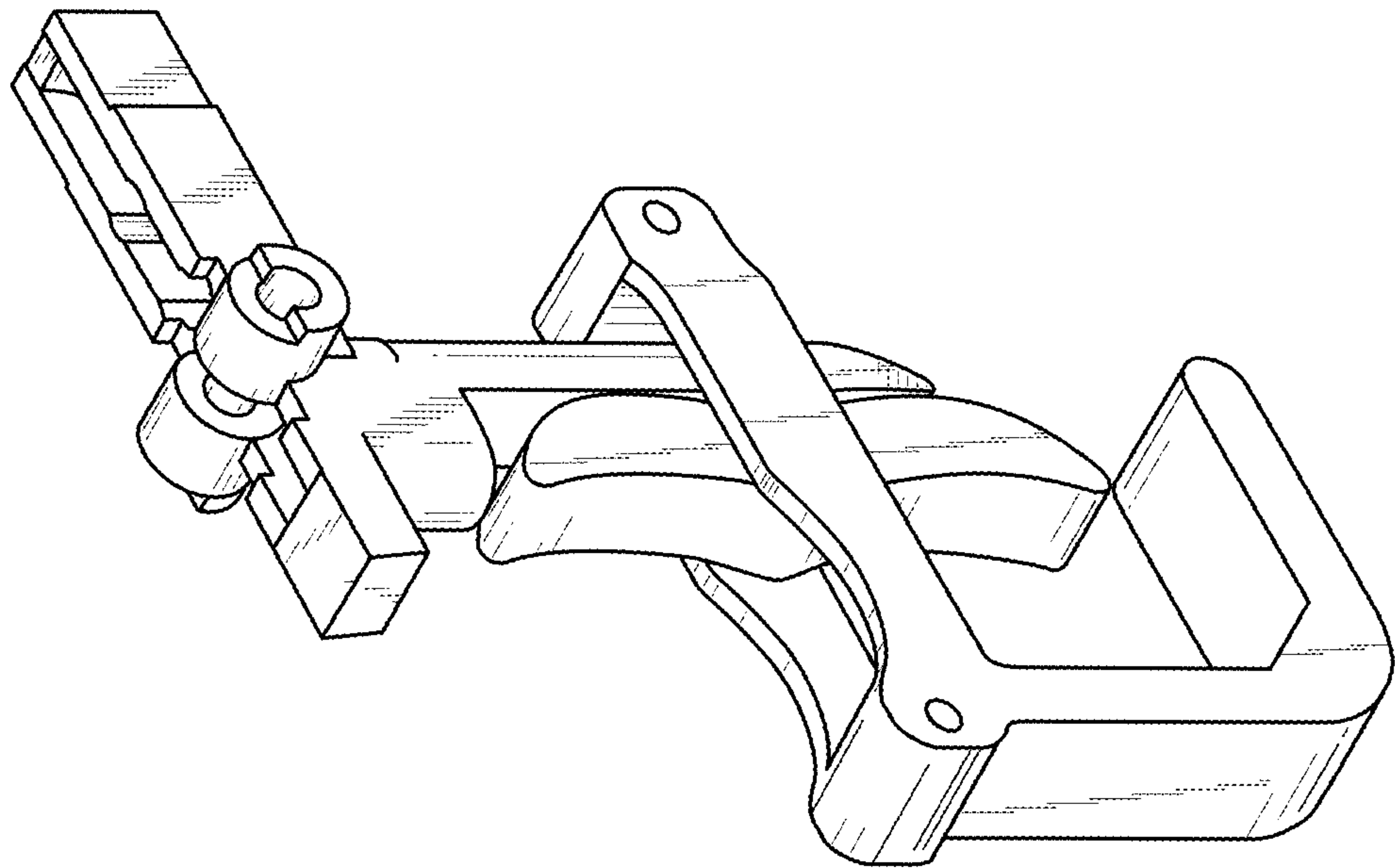

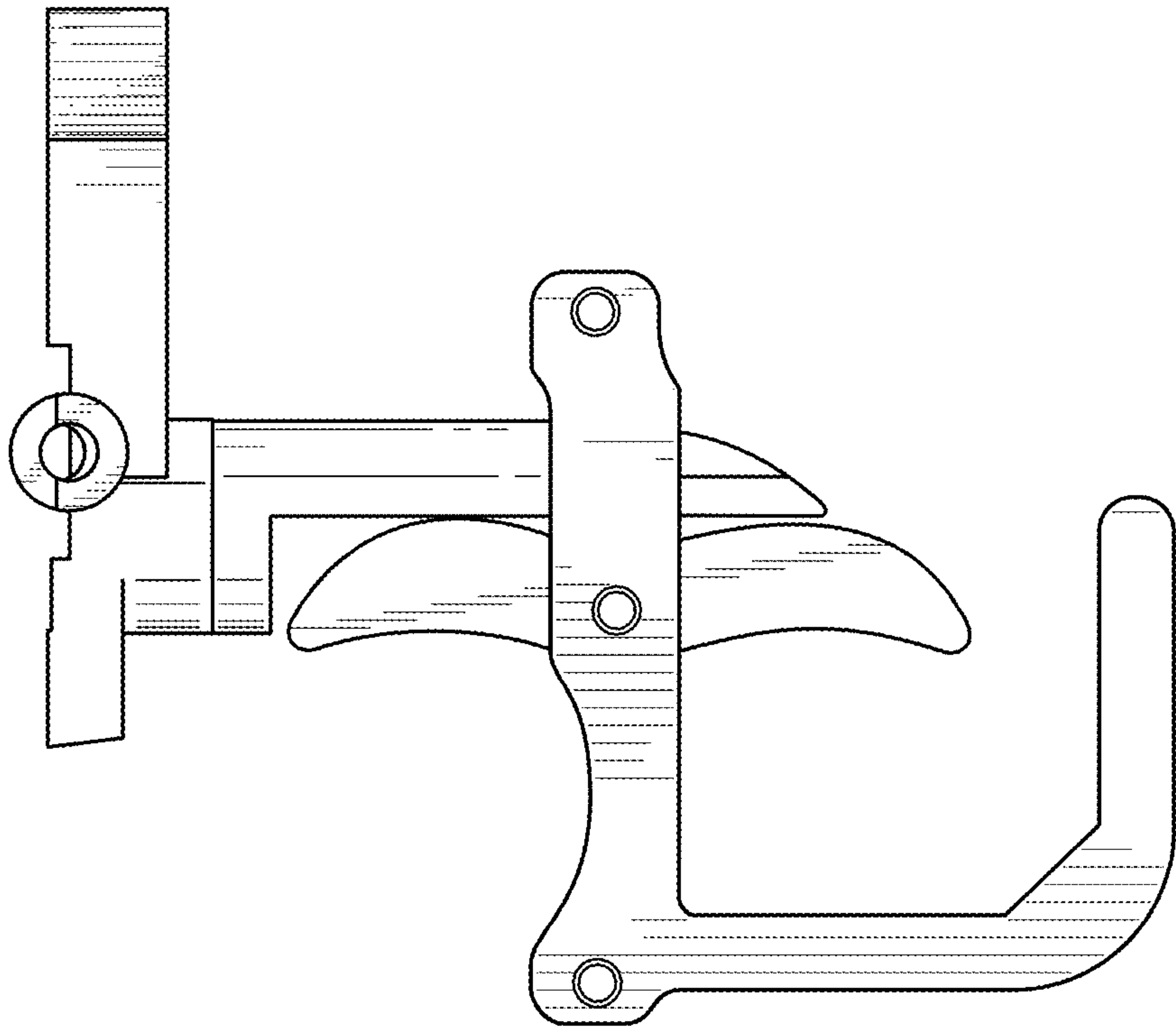

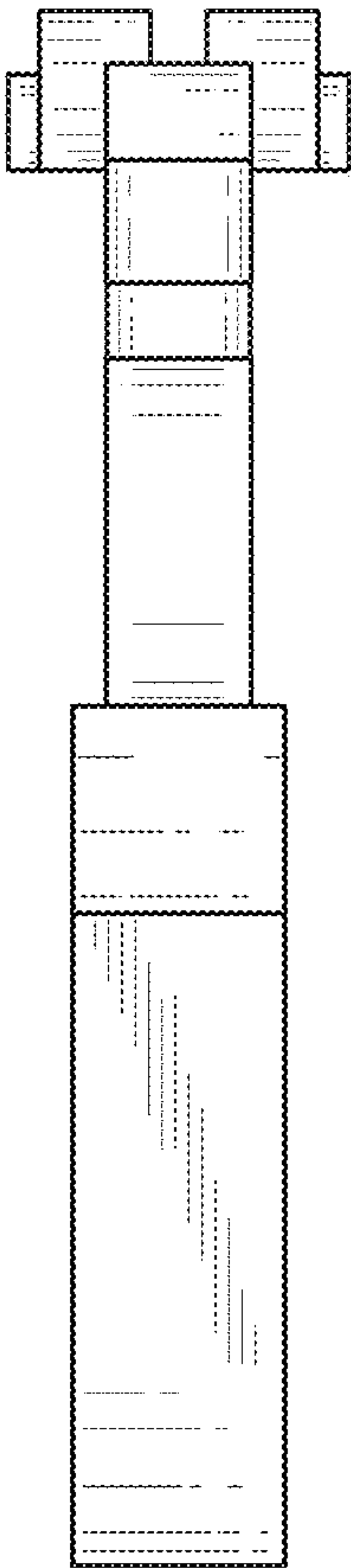

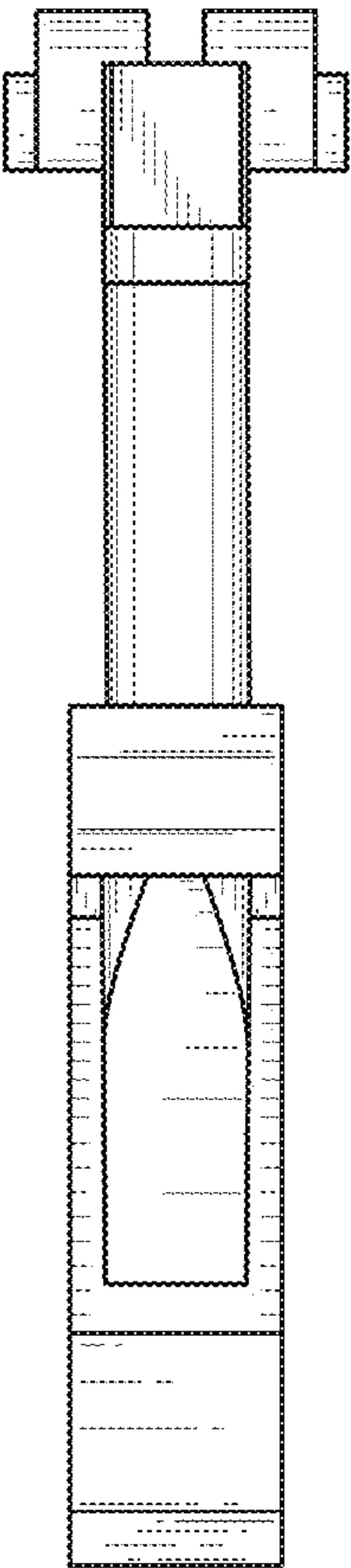

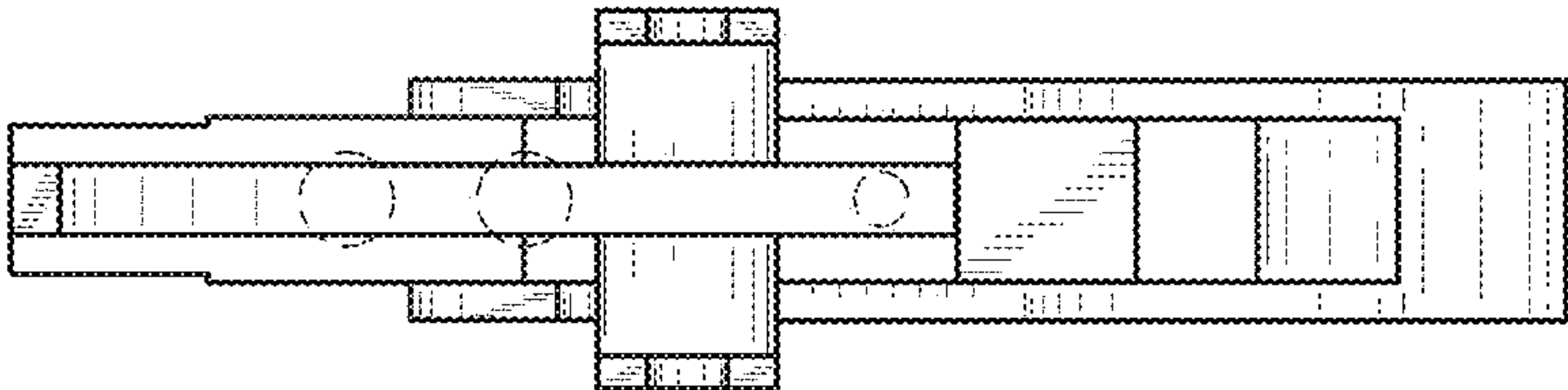
