my new design;

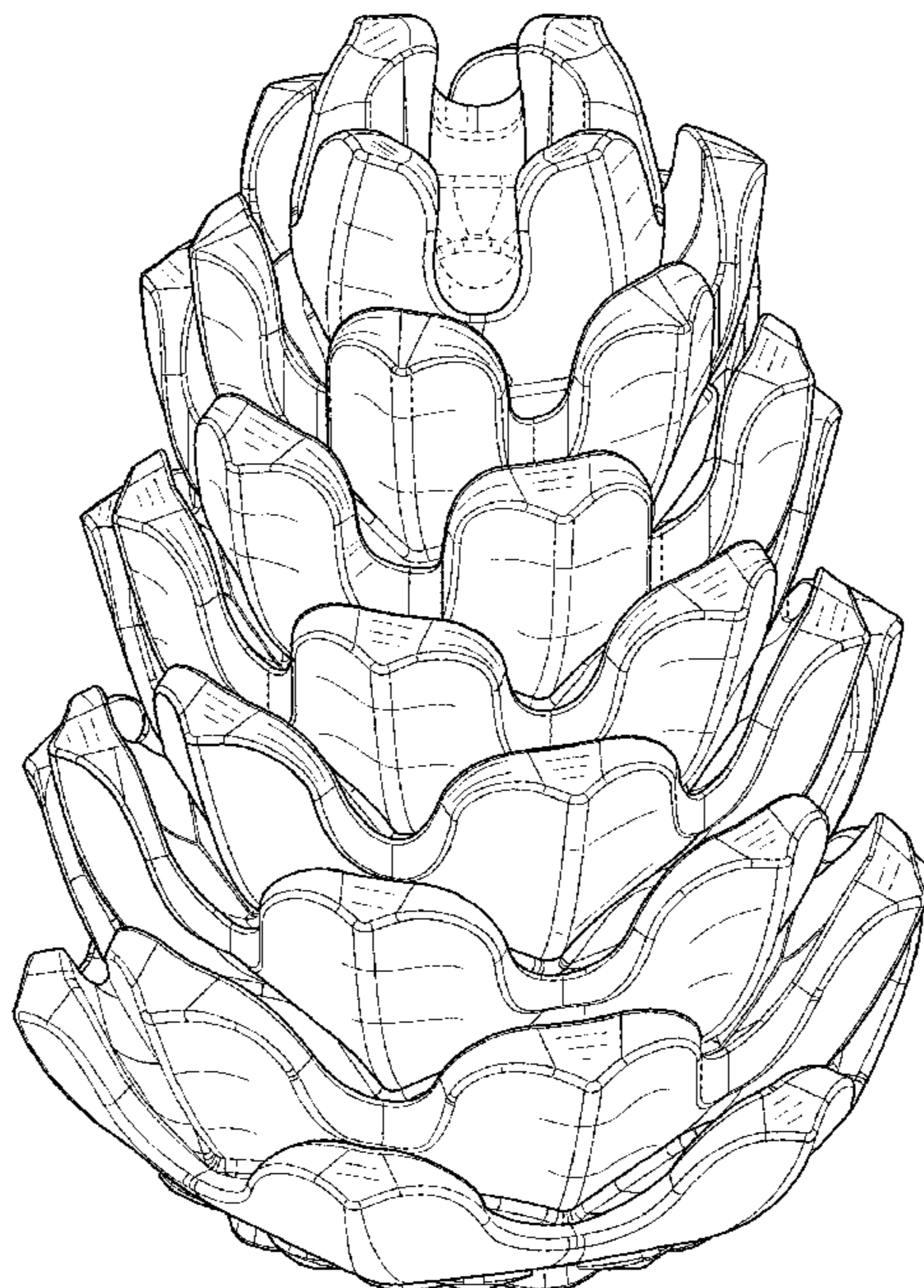
FIG. 2 is a front view, the back view being a mirror image;

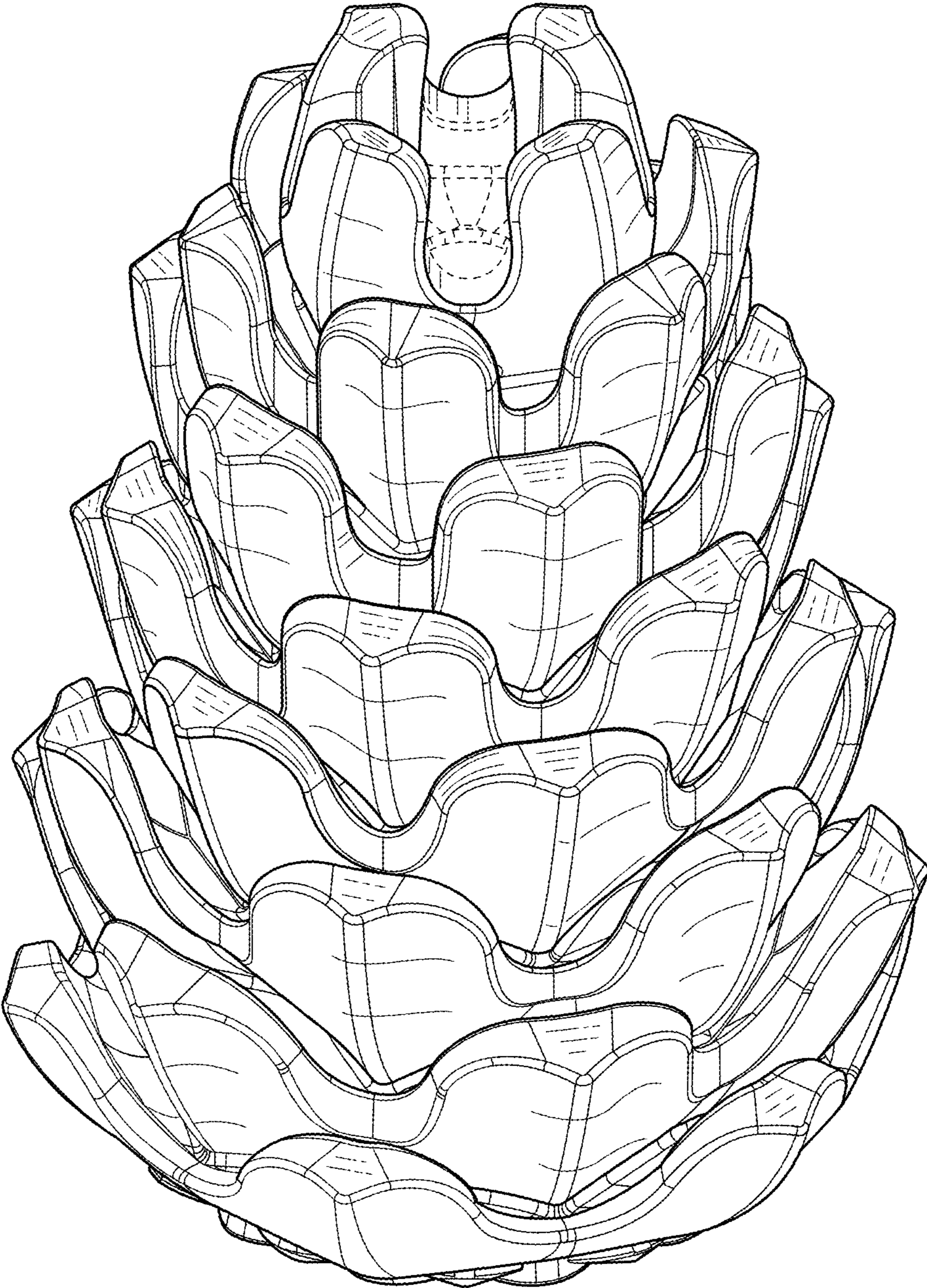

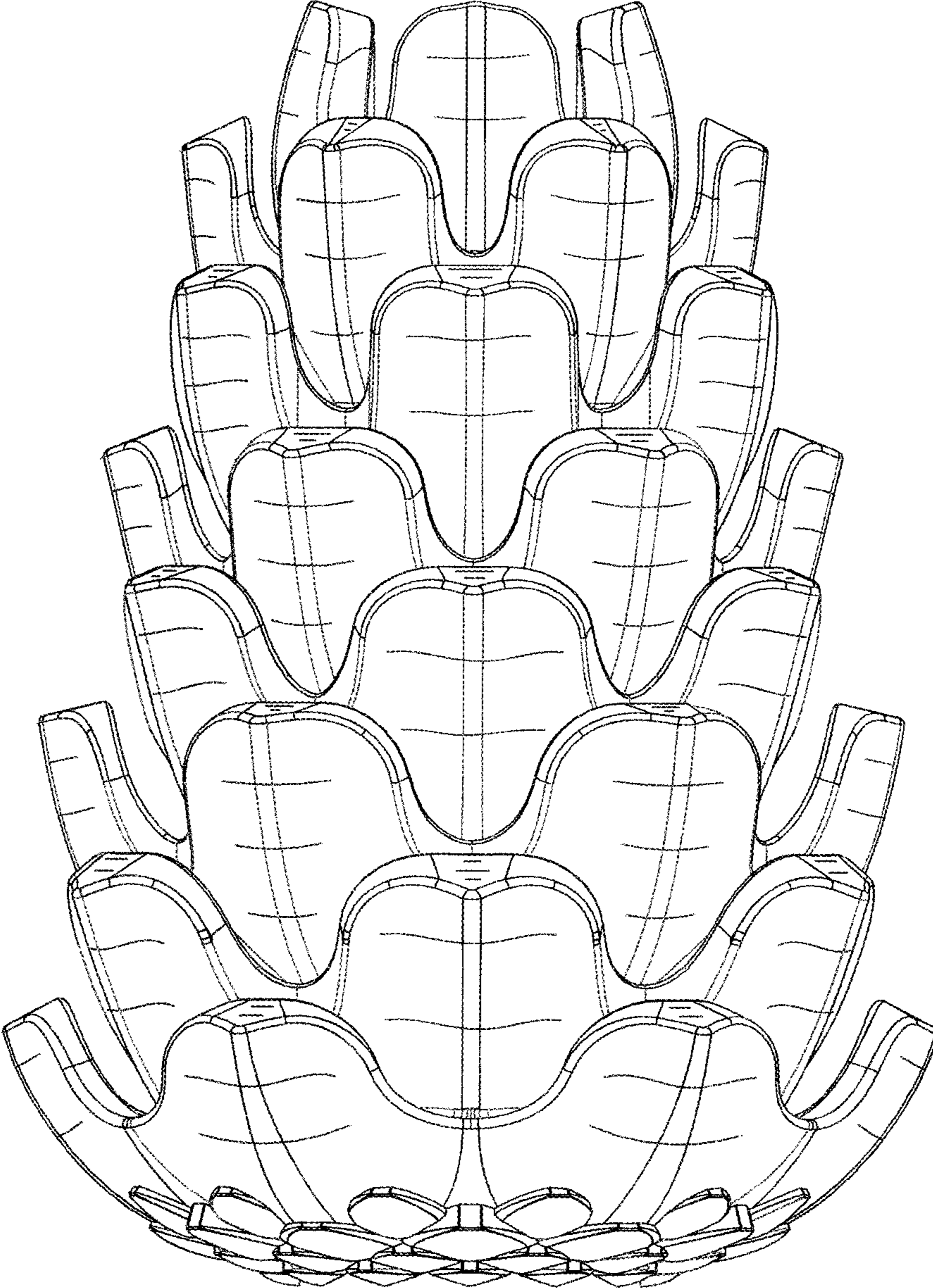

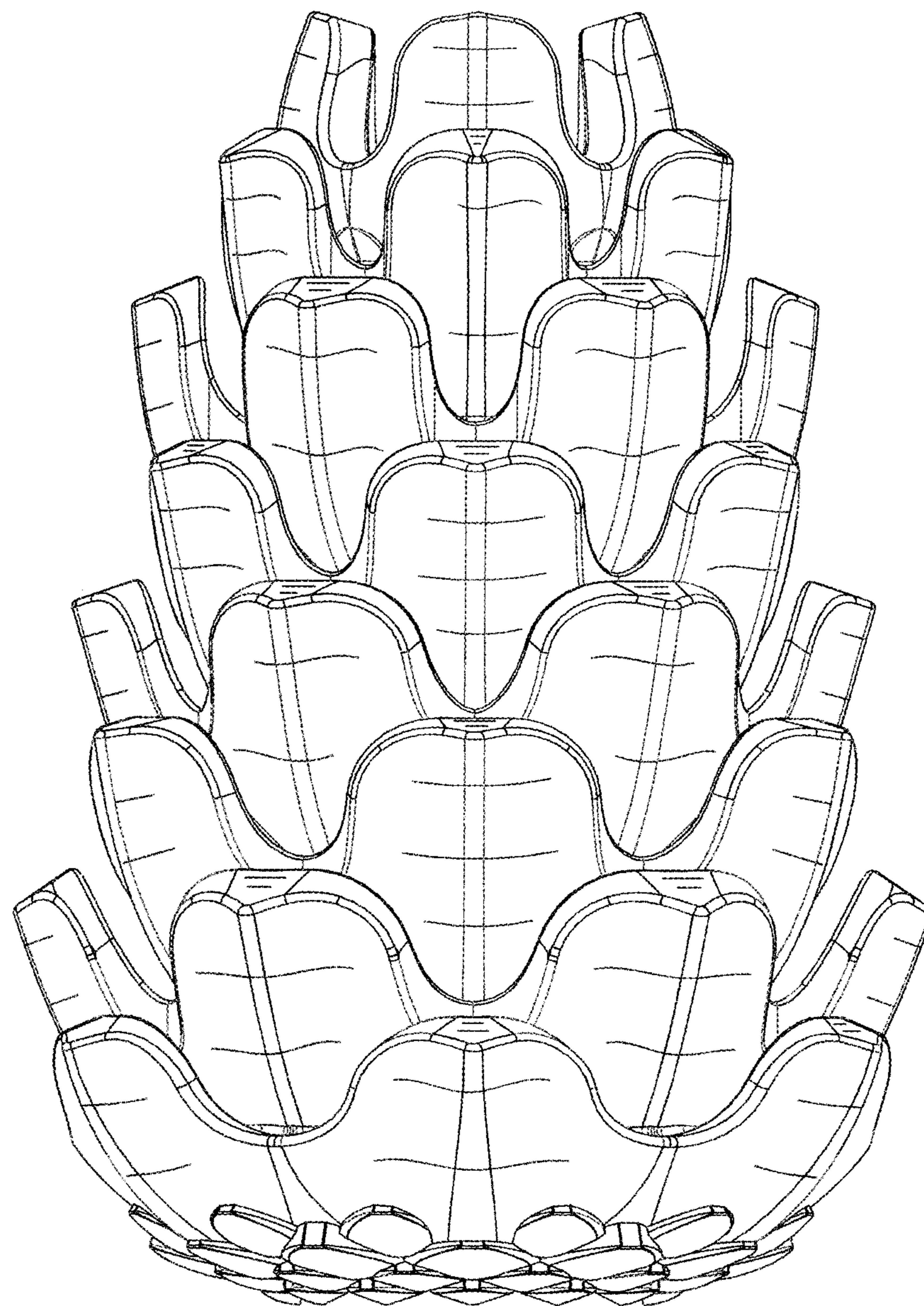

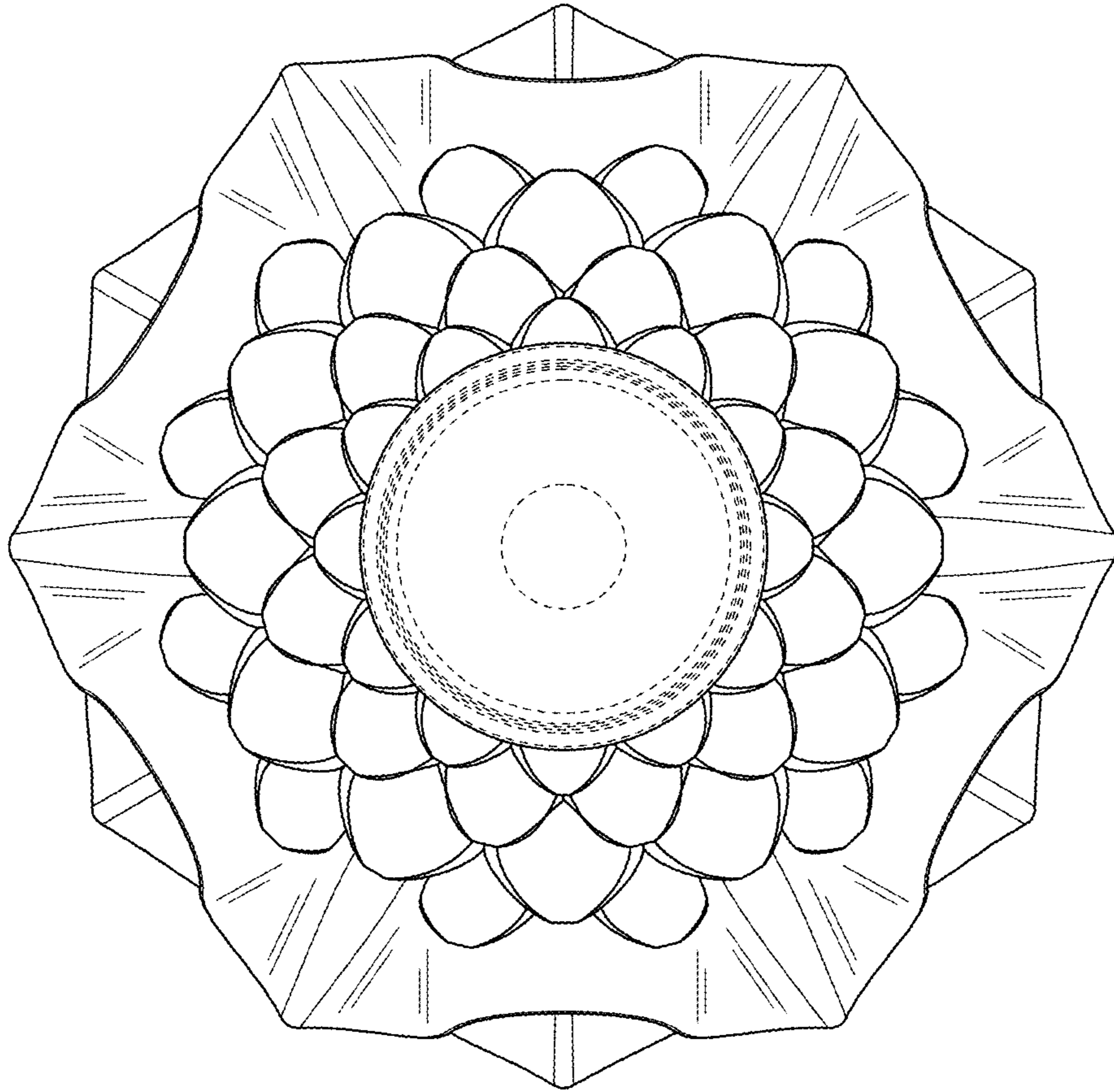

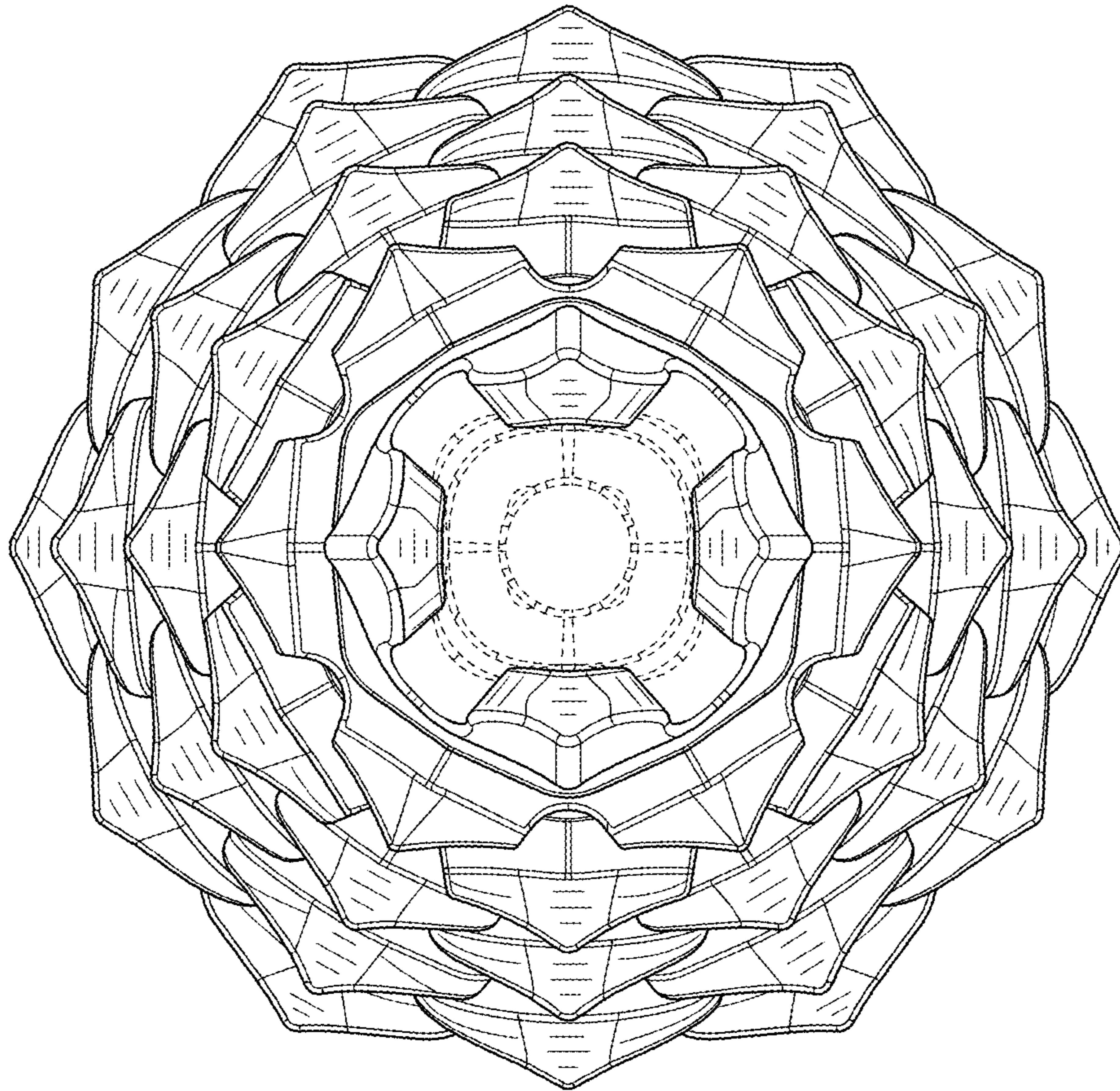
