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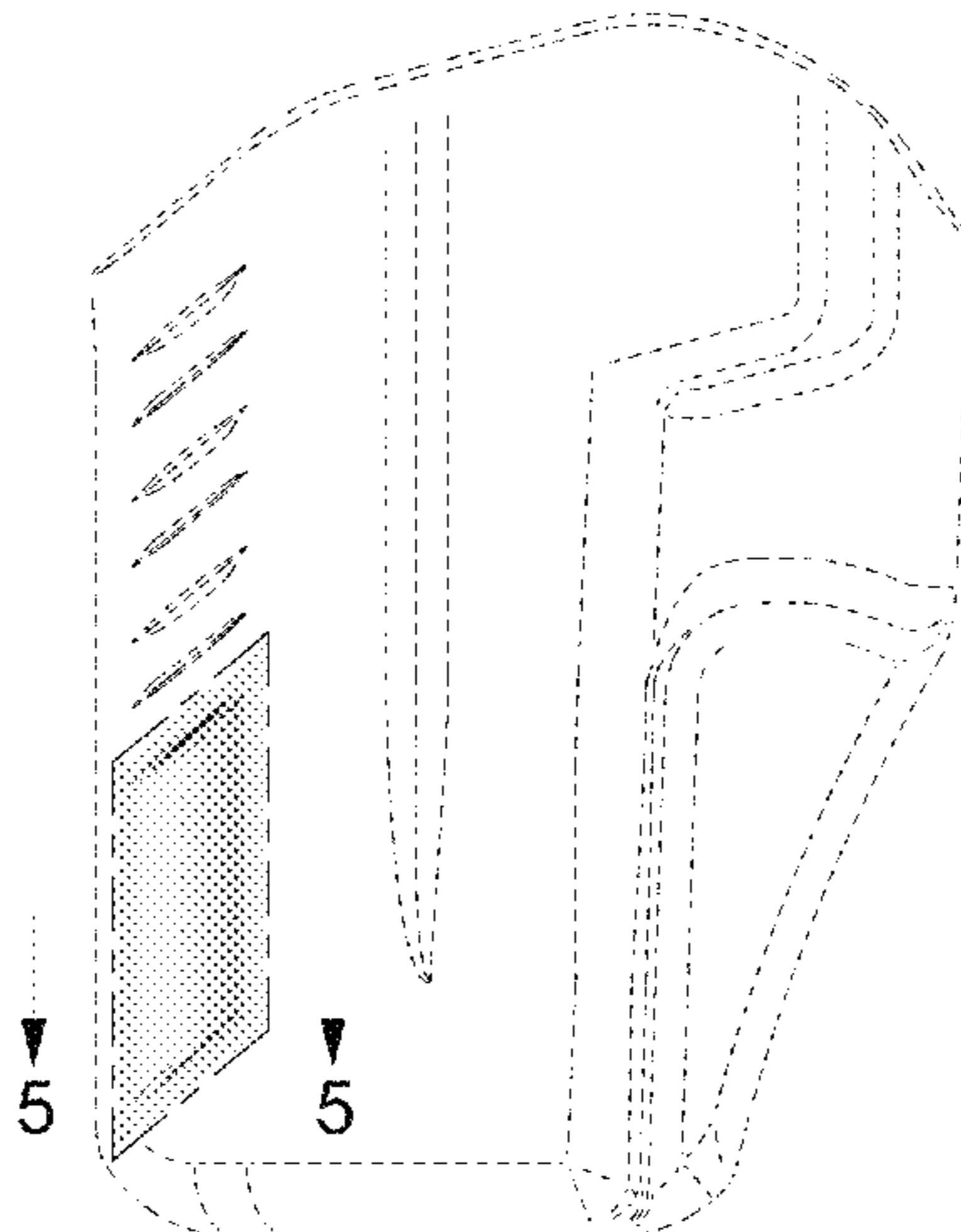

CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a holster, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of the holster showing the new invention;

FIG. 2 is a side and bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an opposite side and bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an opposite side perspective view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view show along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

The top view appearance of the holster is not shown in the drawing and forms no part of the claimed design.

Broken lines shown in the drawings form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines having alternating short and long dash lengths in the drawings depict boundaries between claimed and non-claimed subject matter. The boundaries themselves form no part of the claimed design.

The broken lines having equal dash lengths in the drawings illustrate structure and/or features that form no part of the claimed design.

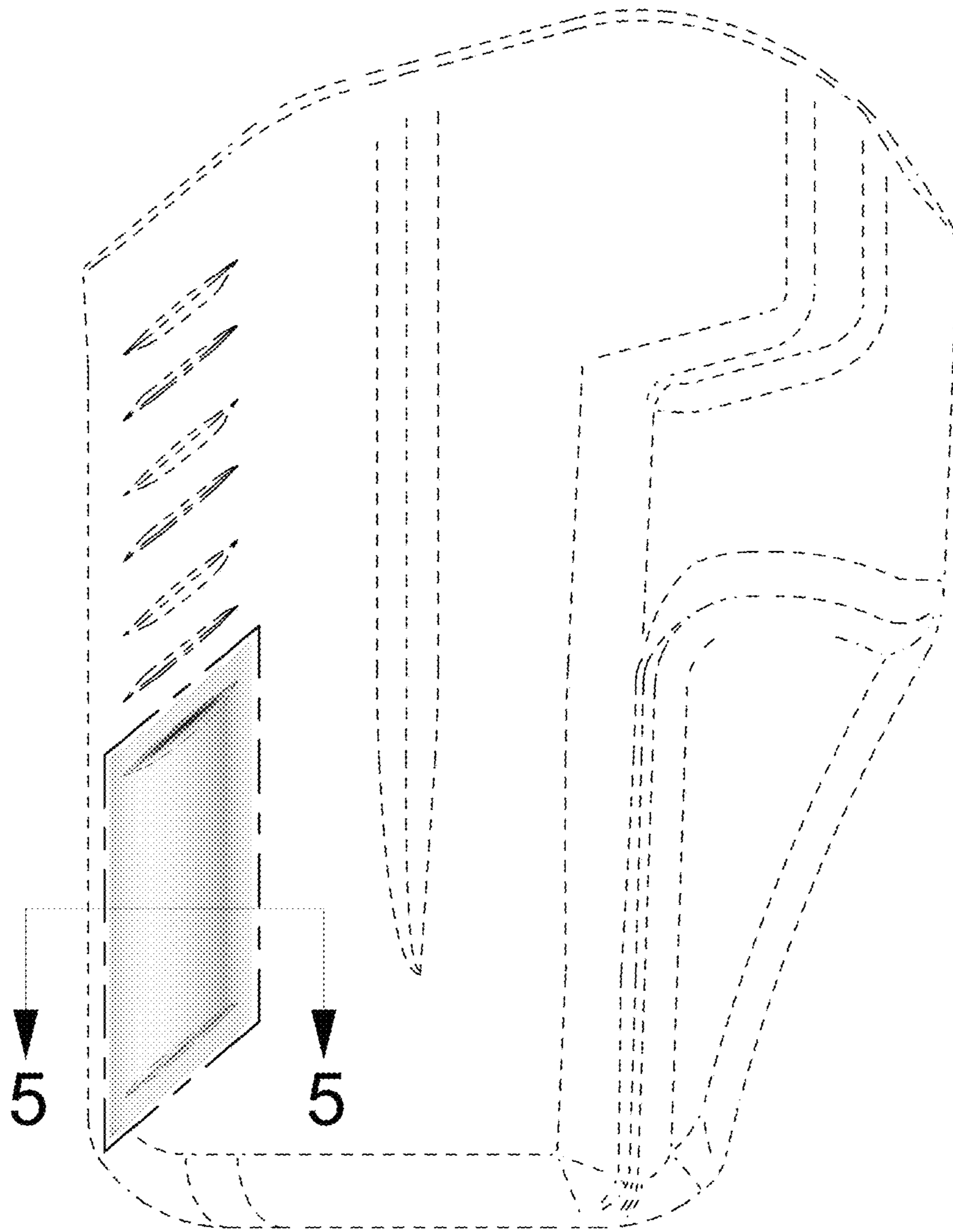

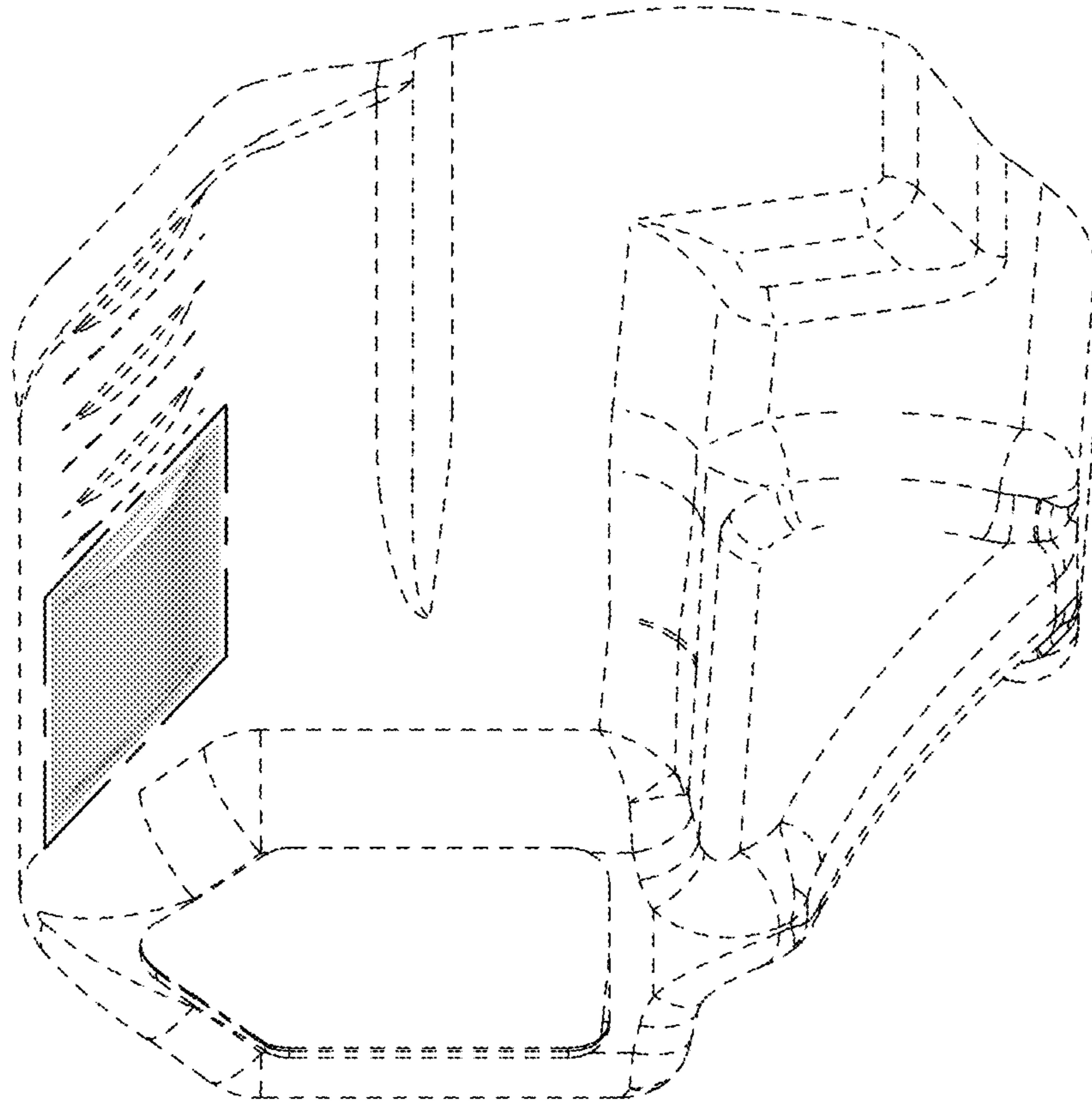

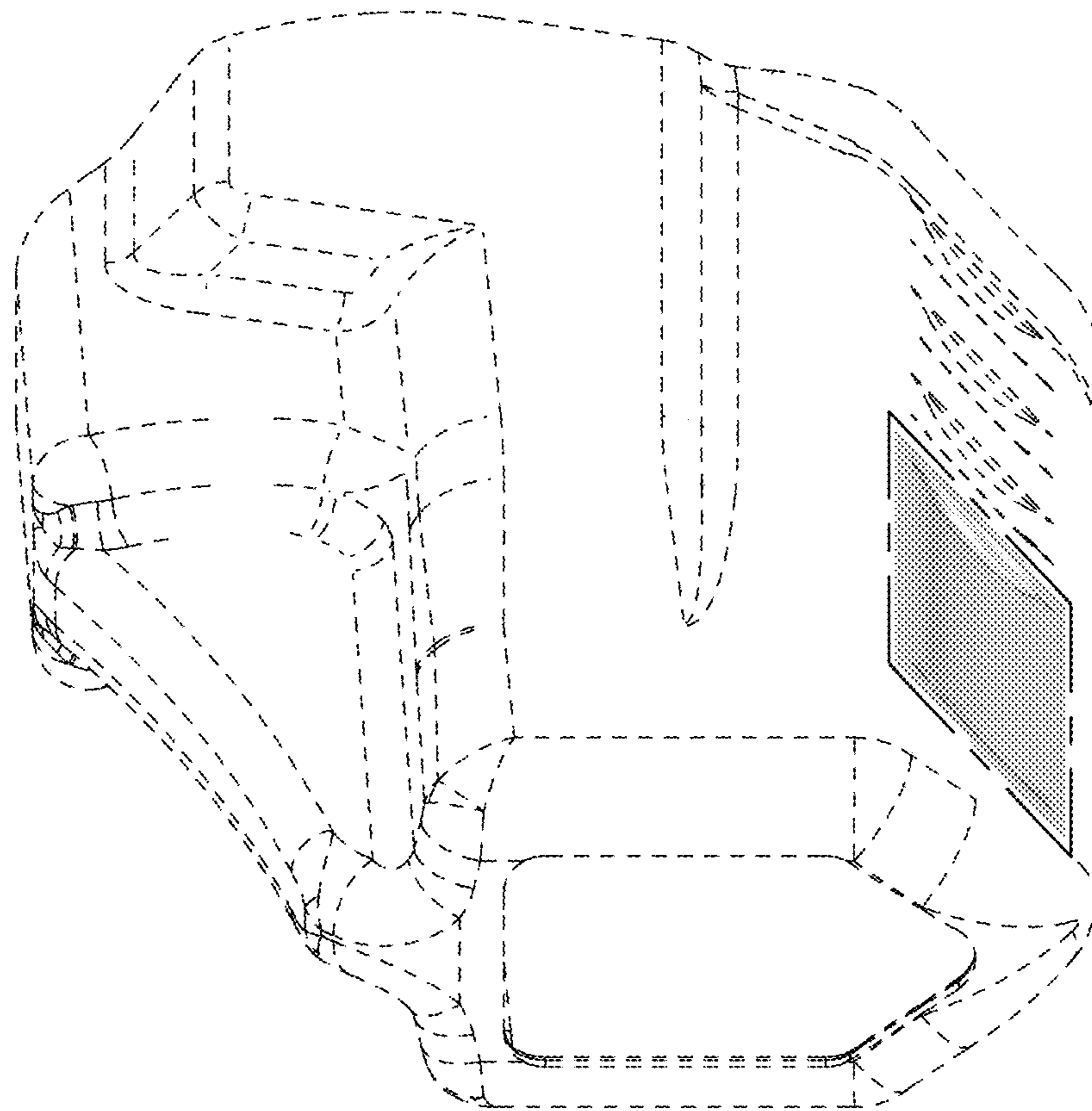

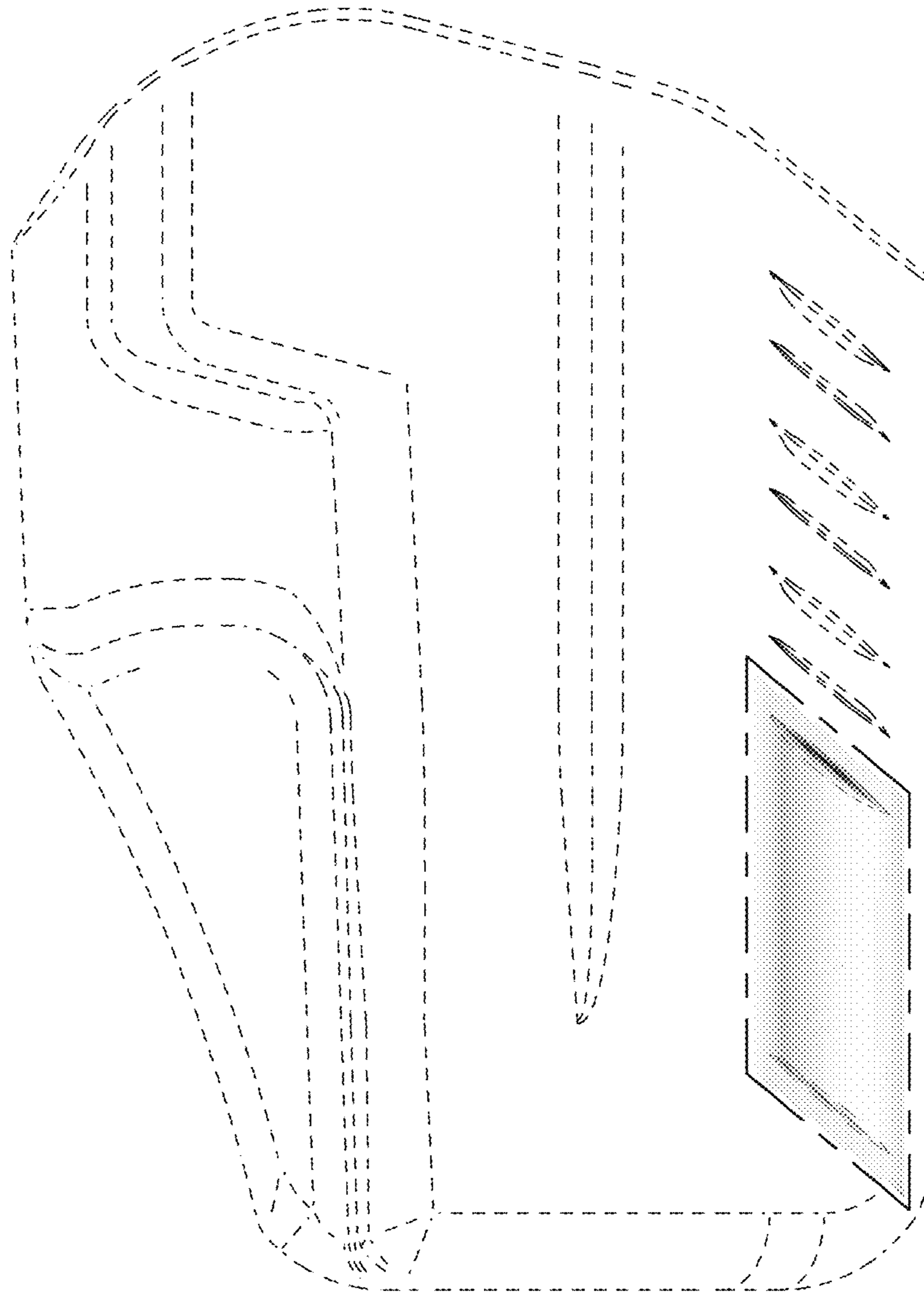

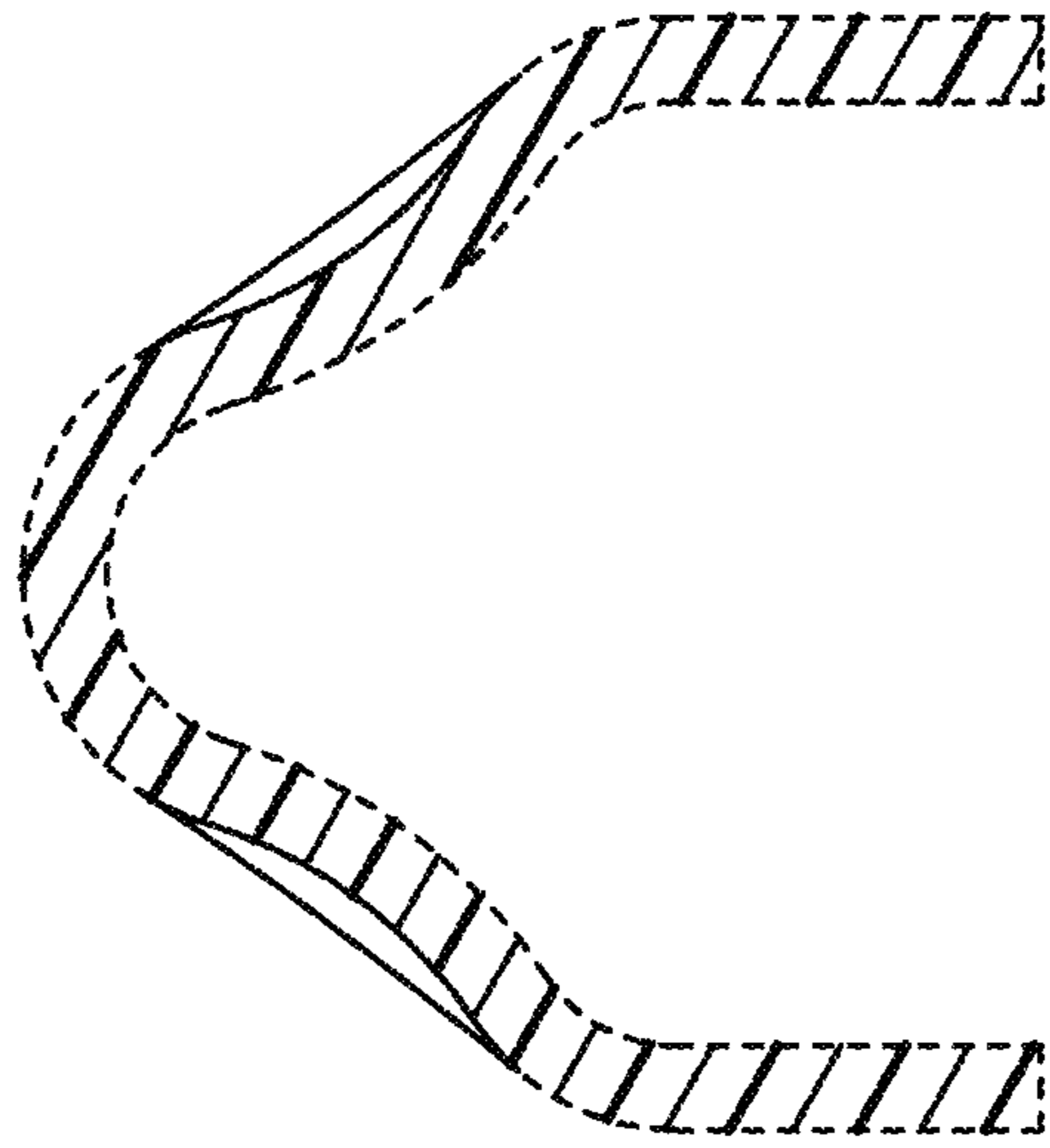
