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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a utility tote panel insert, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a rear view of a utility tote panel insert according to our new design, wherein the utility tote panel insert is in a folded configuration;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left-side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right-side view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top perspective view of the utility tote panel insert of FIGS. 1 to 6, but wherein the utility tote panel insert is in a flat or unfolded configuration;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view thereof;

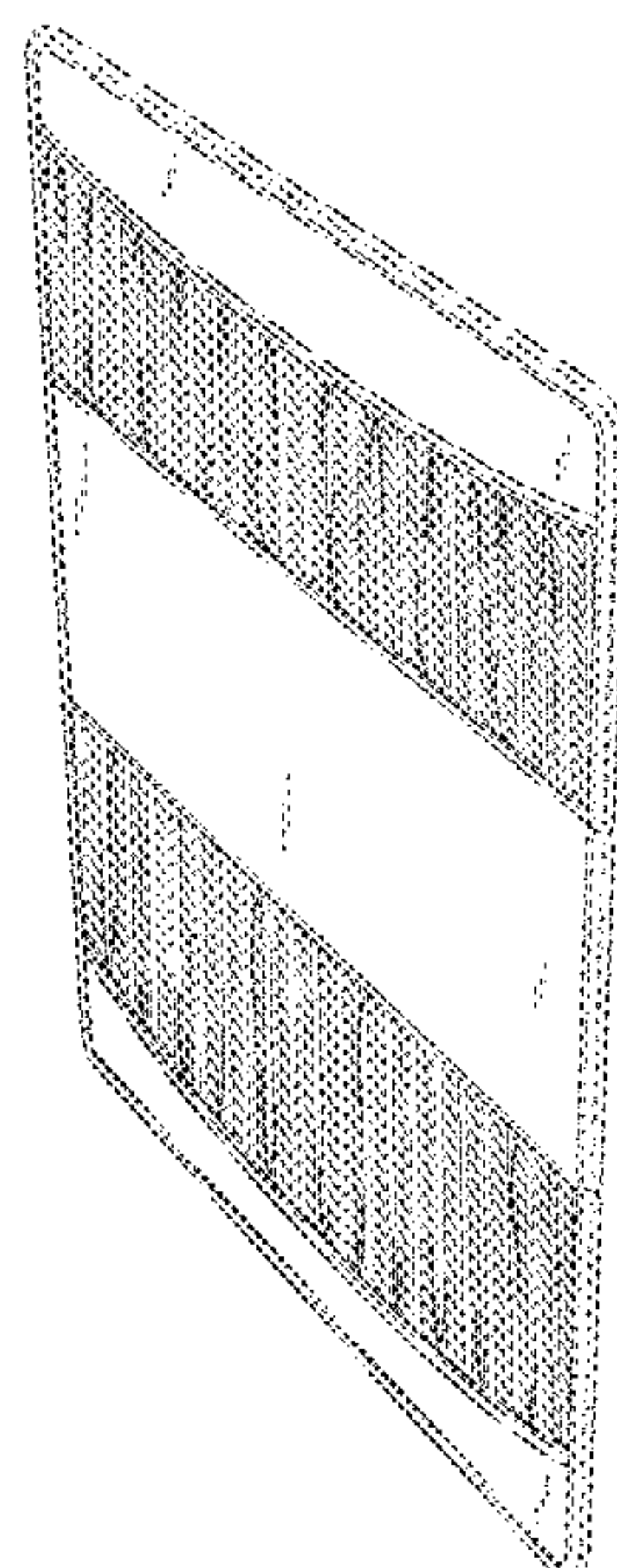
FIG. 11 is a rear view thereof;

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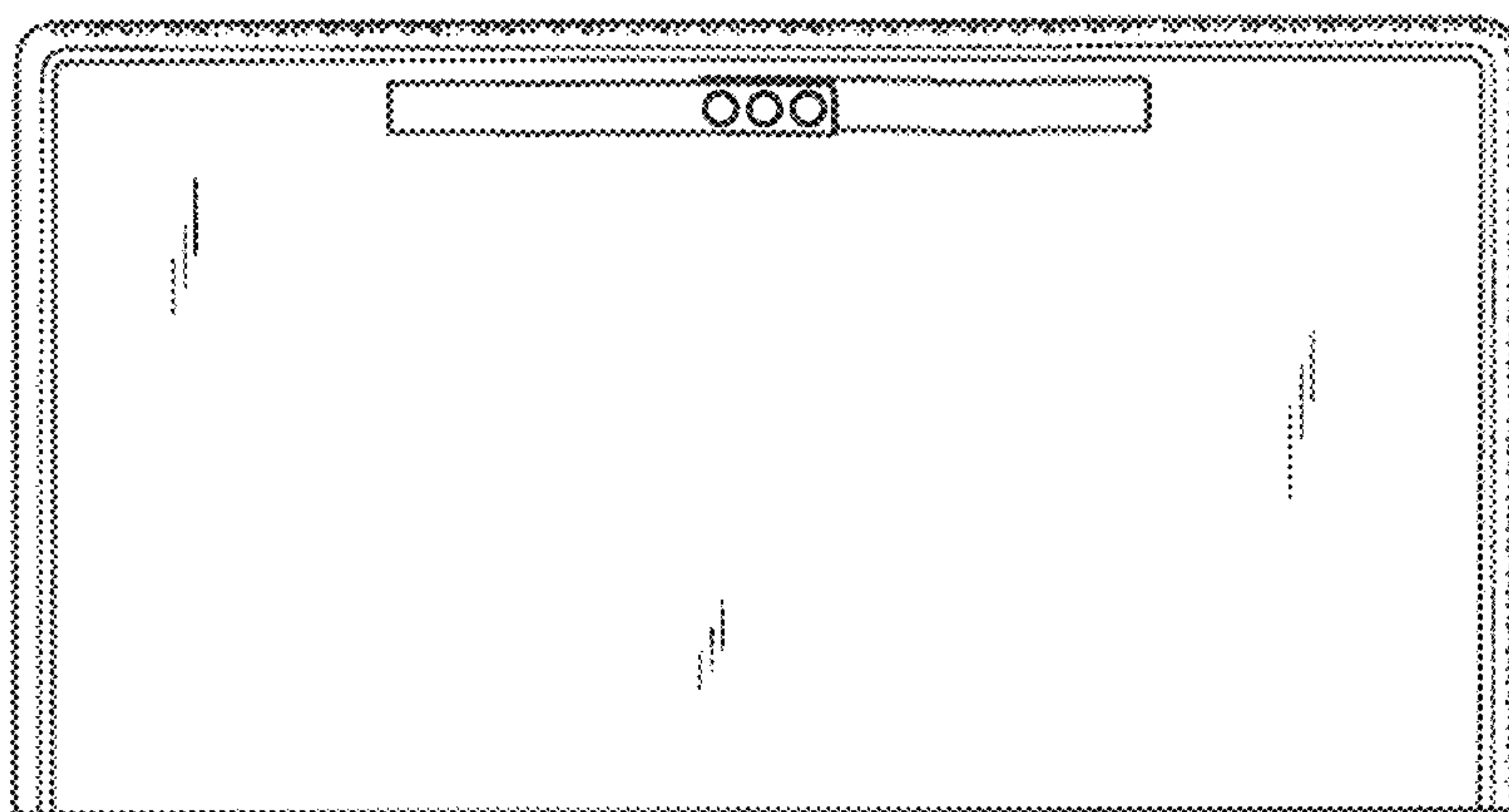

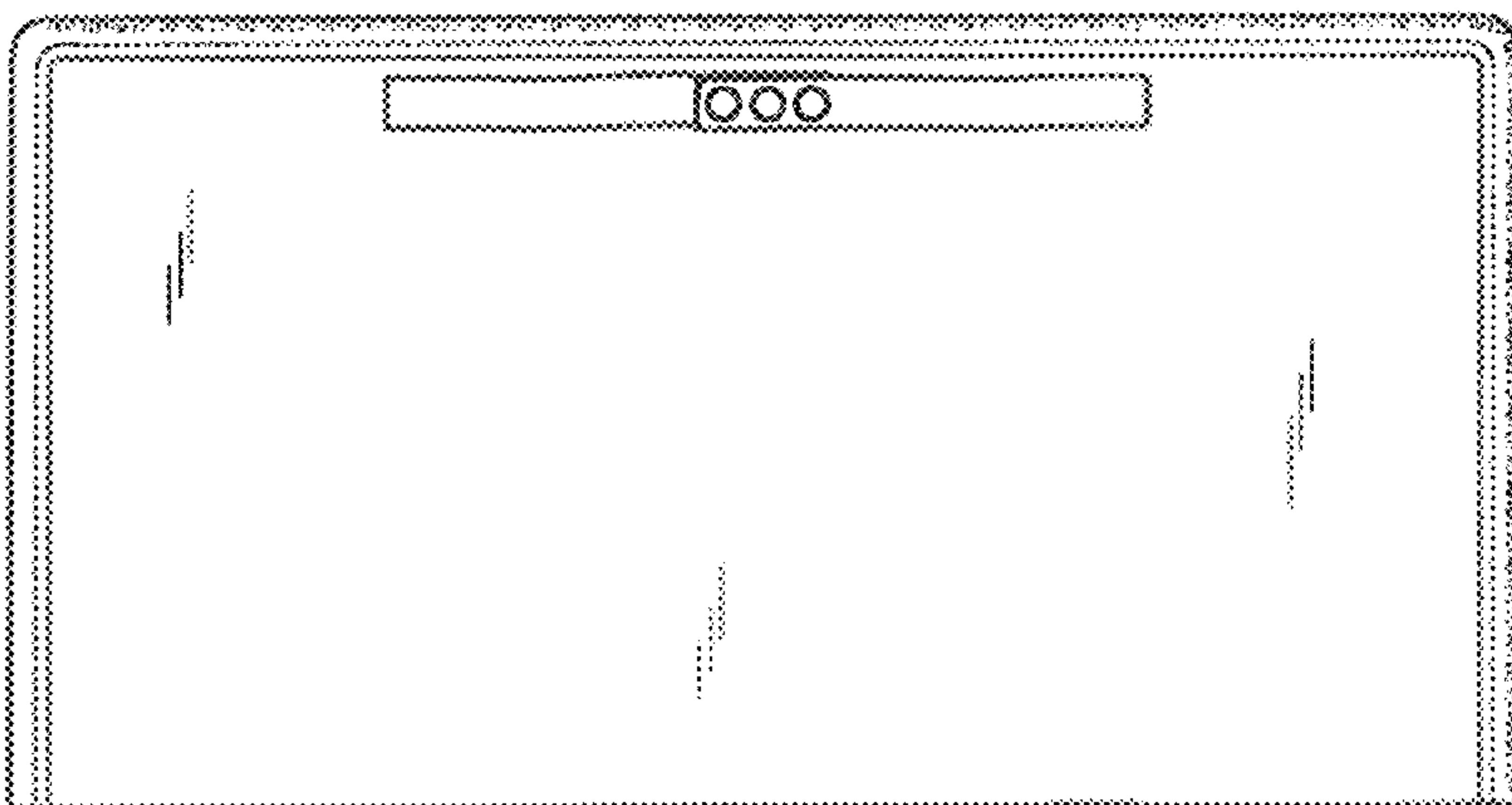

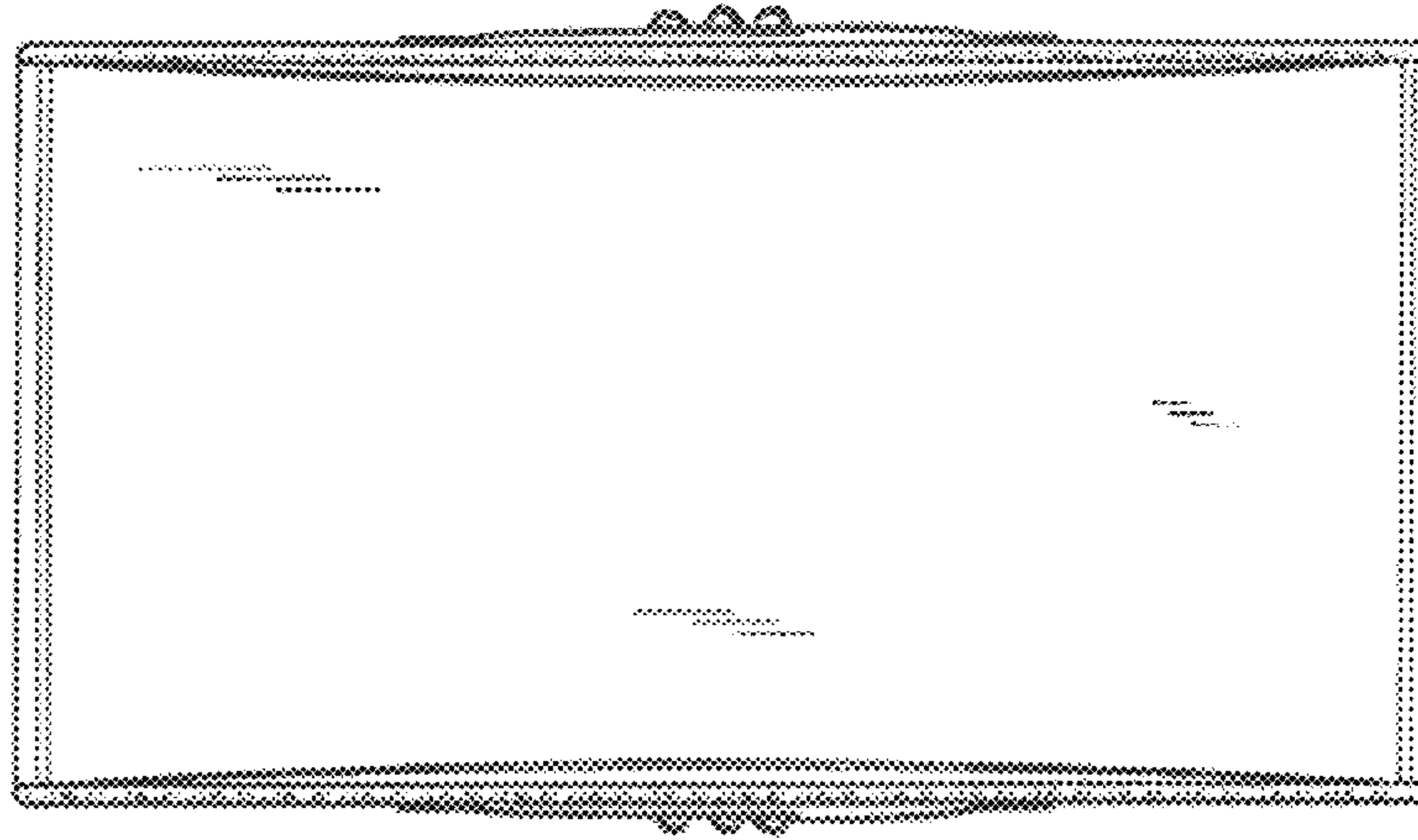

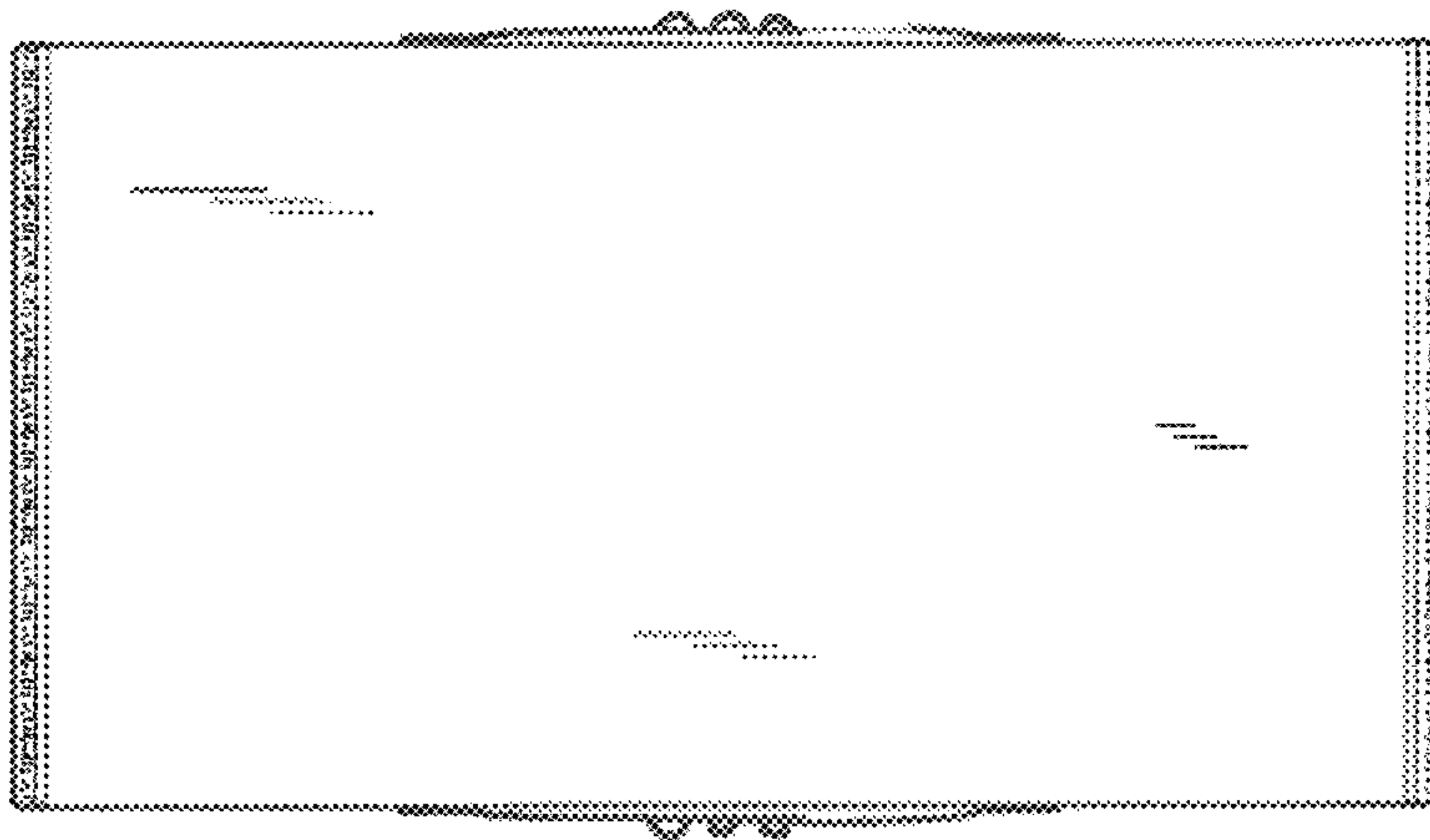

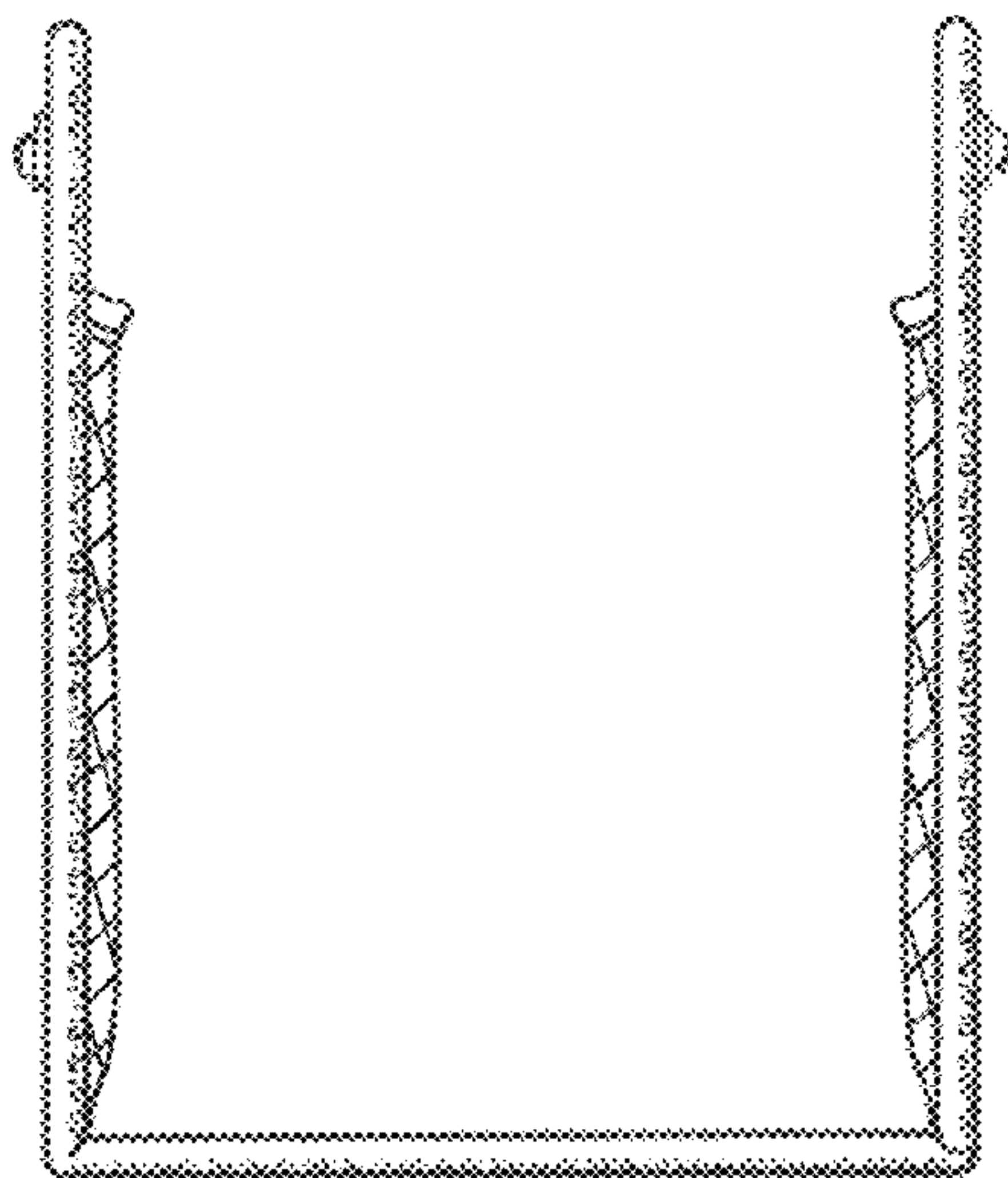

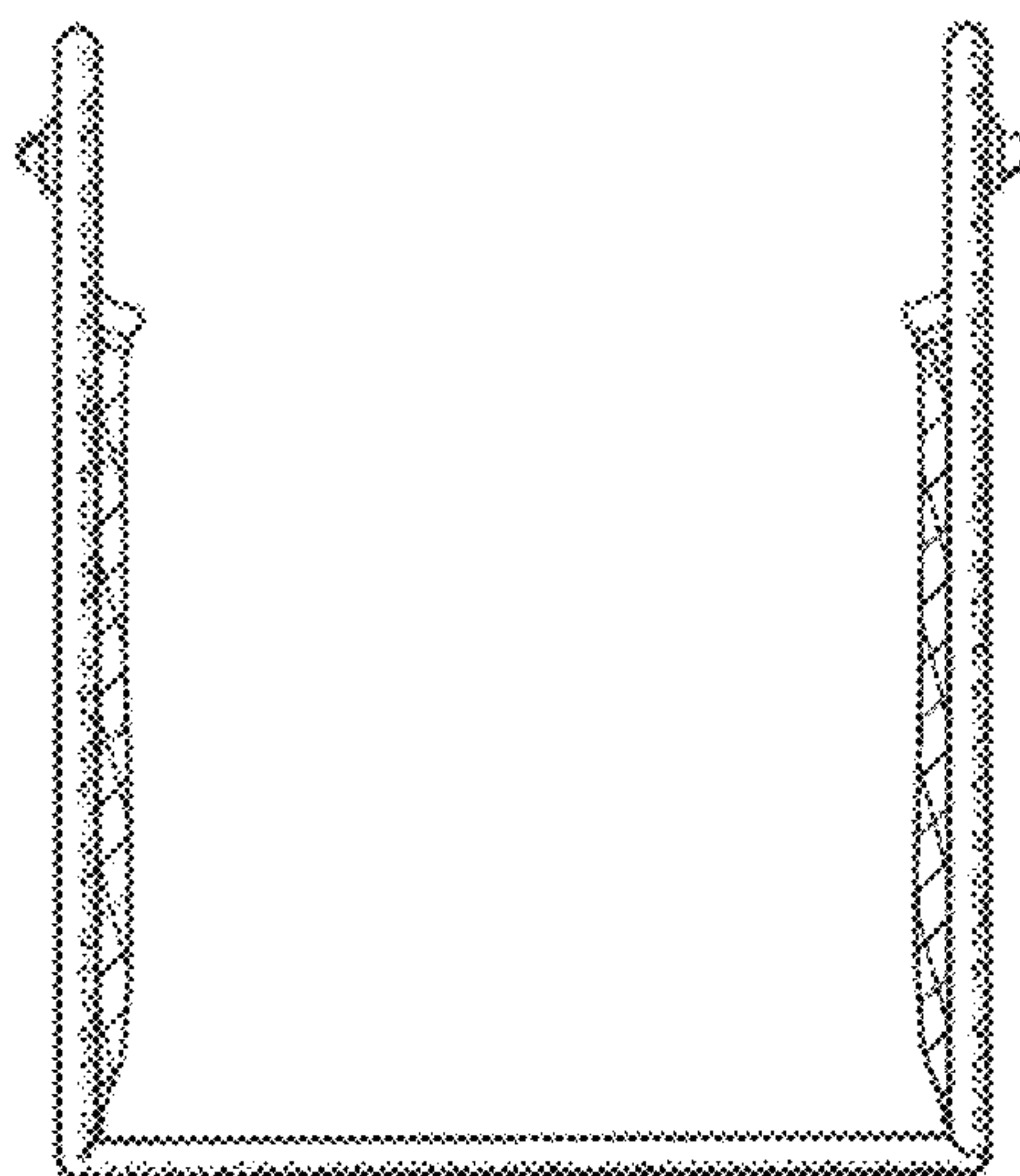

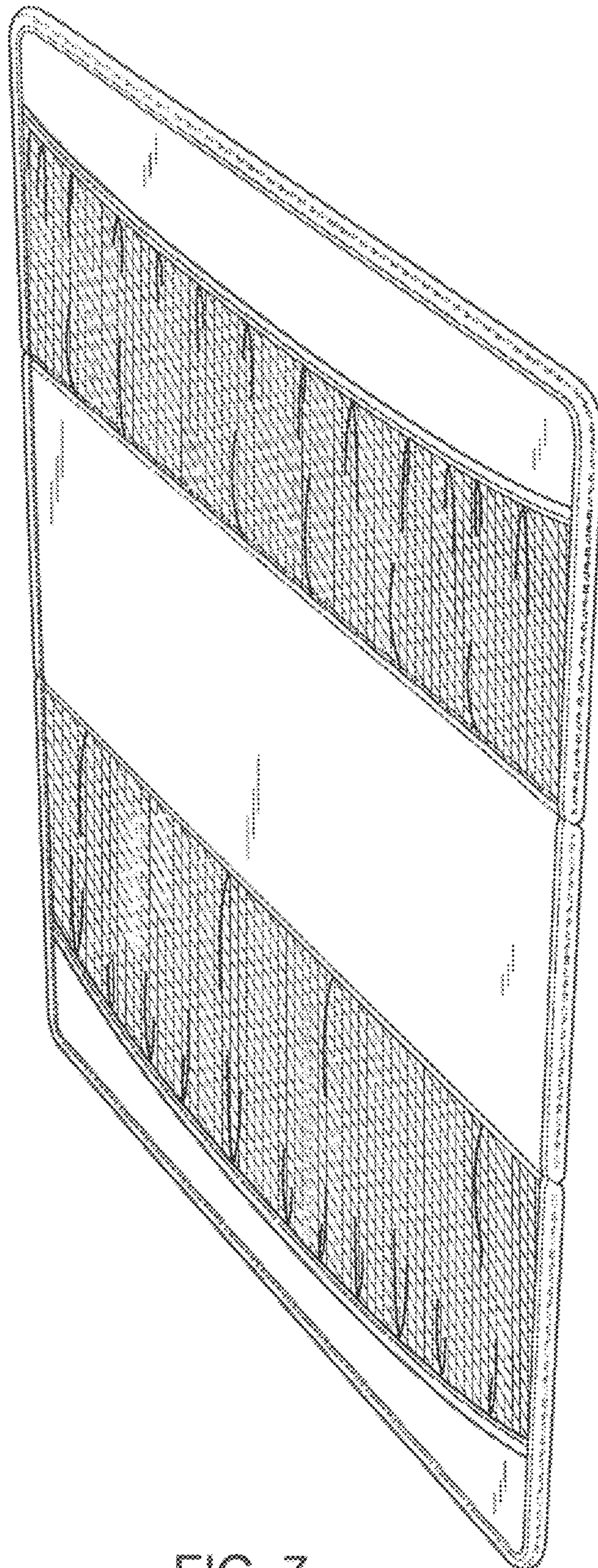

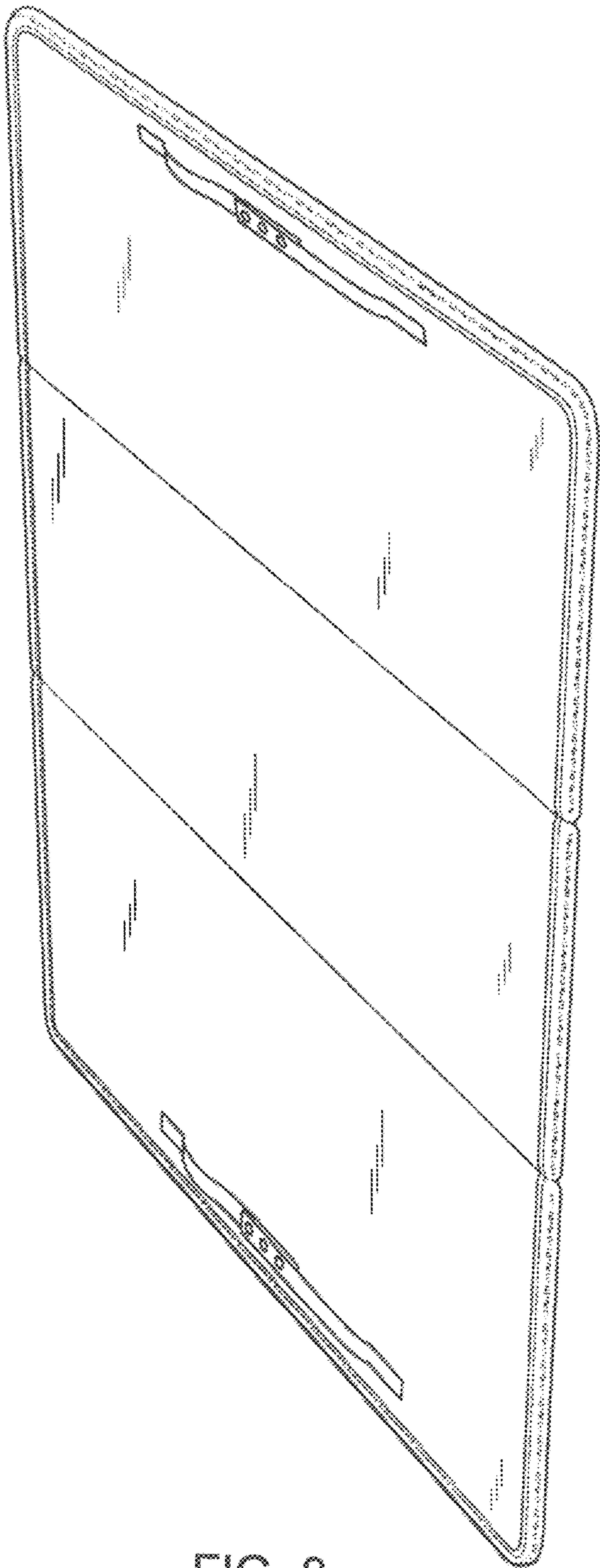

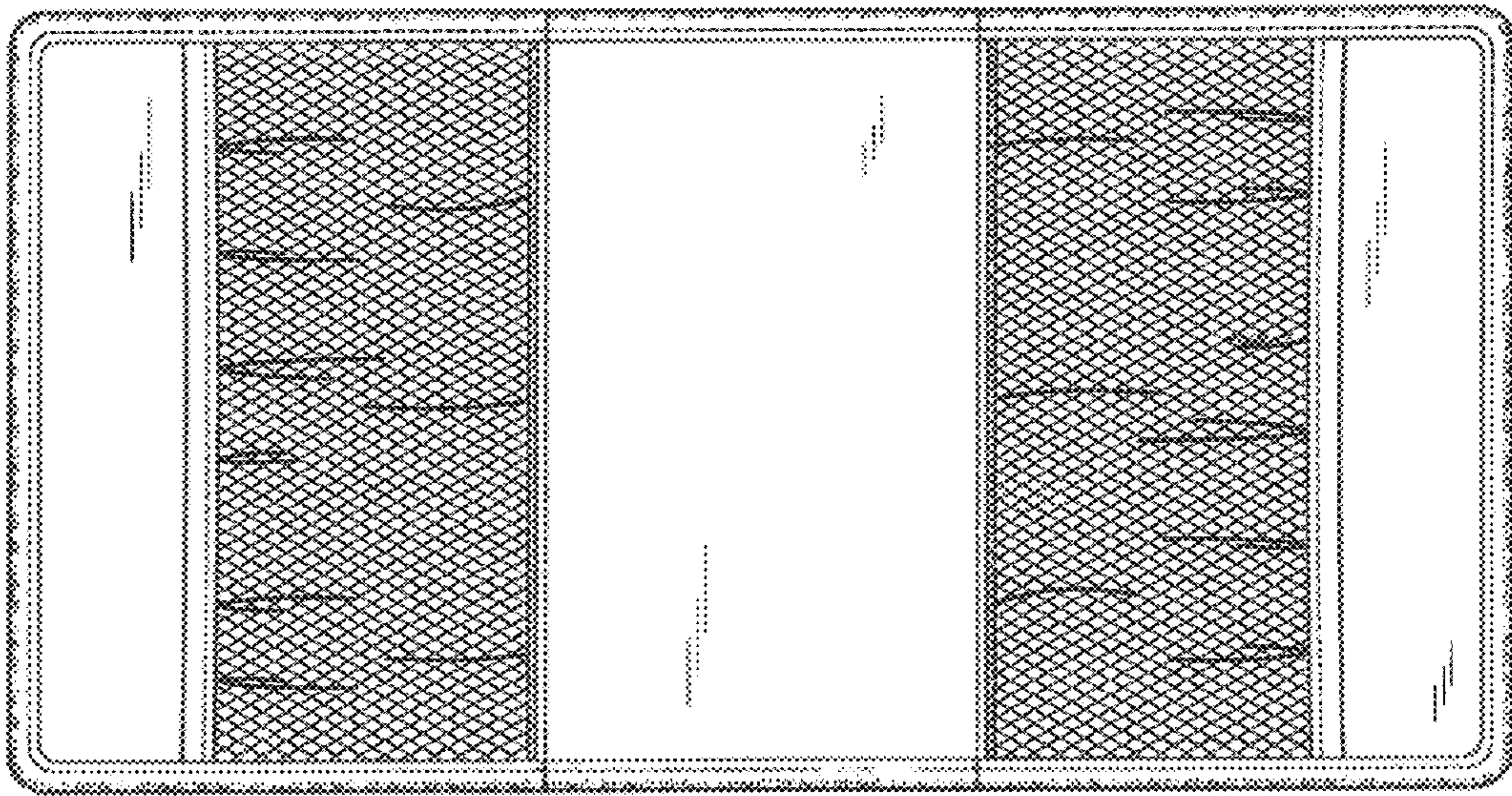

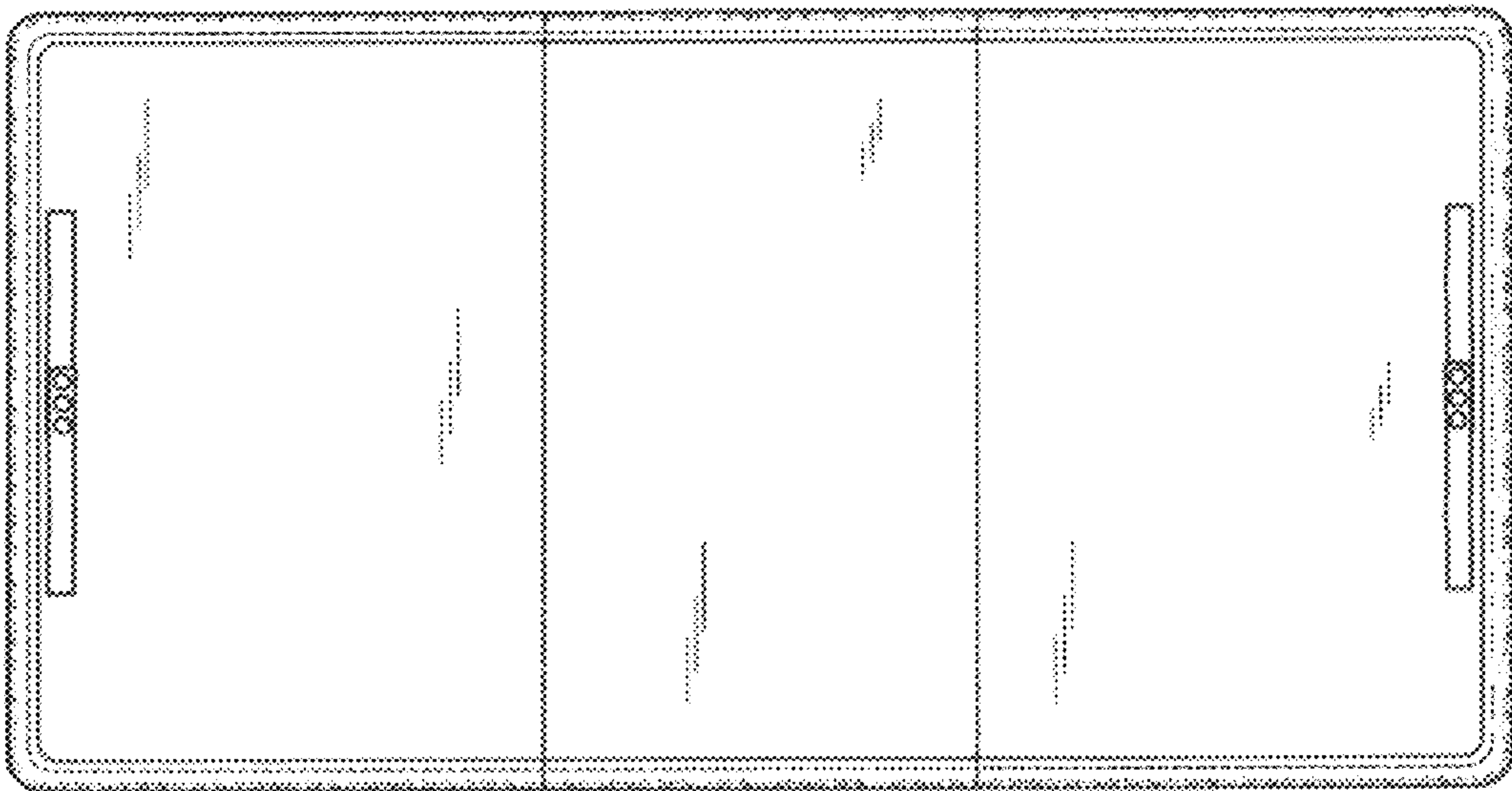

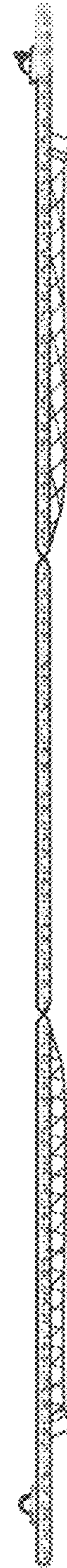
