FIG. 8 is a front view of the second embodiment;

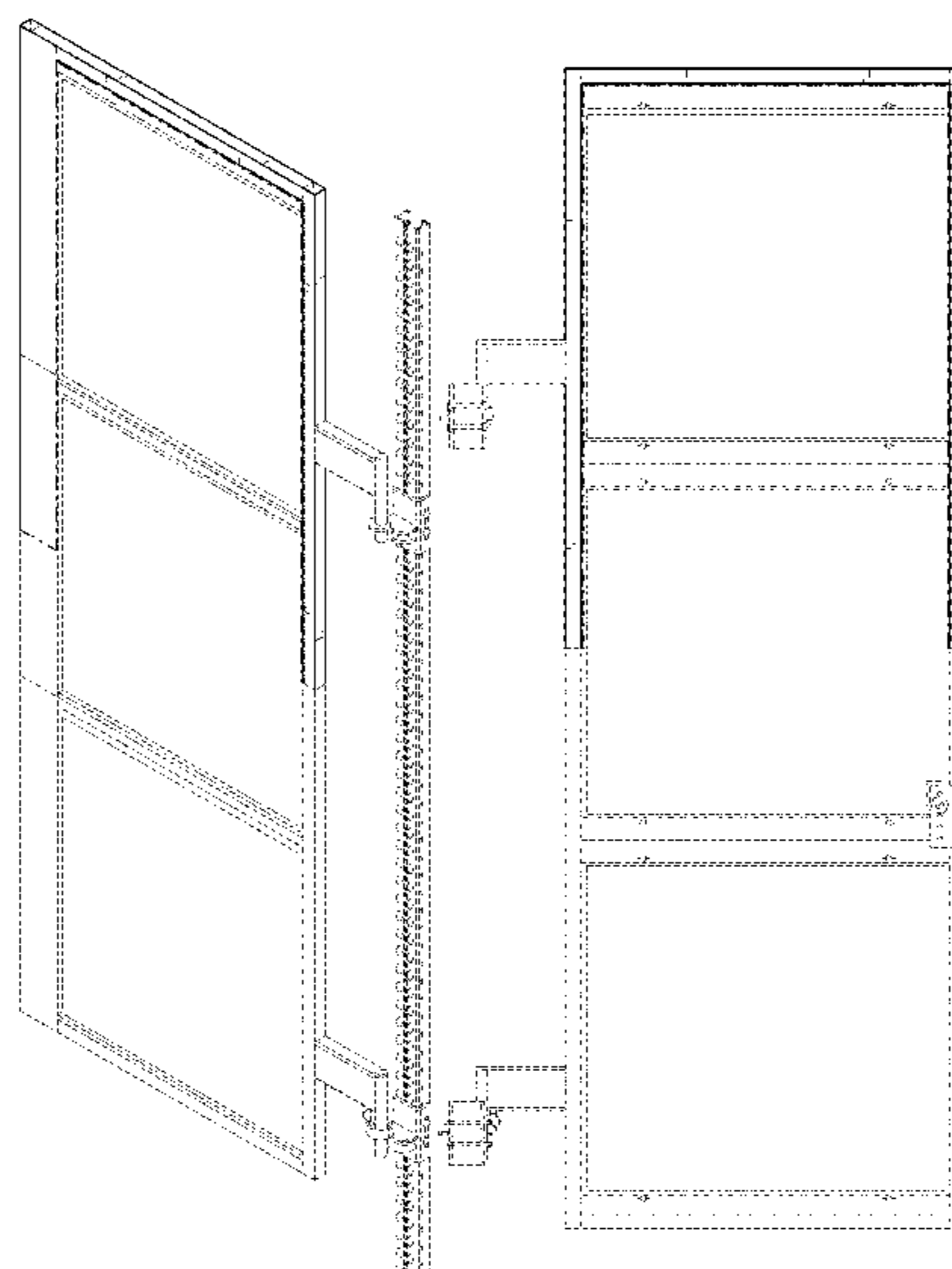
FIG. 9 is a back view of the second embodiment; and,

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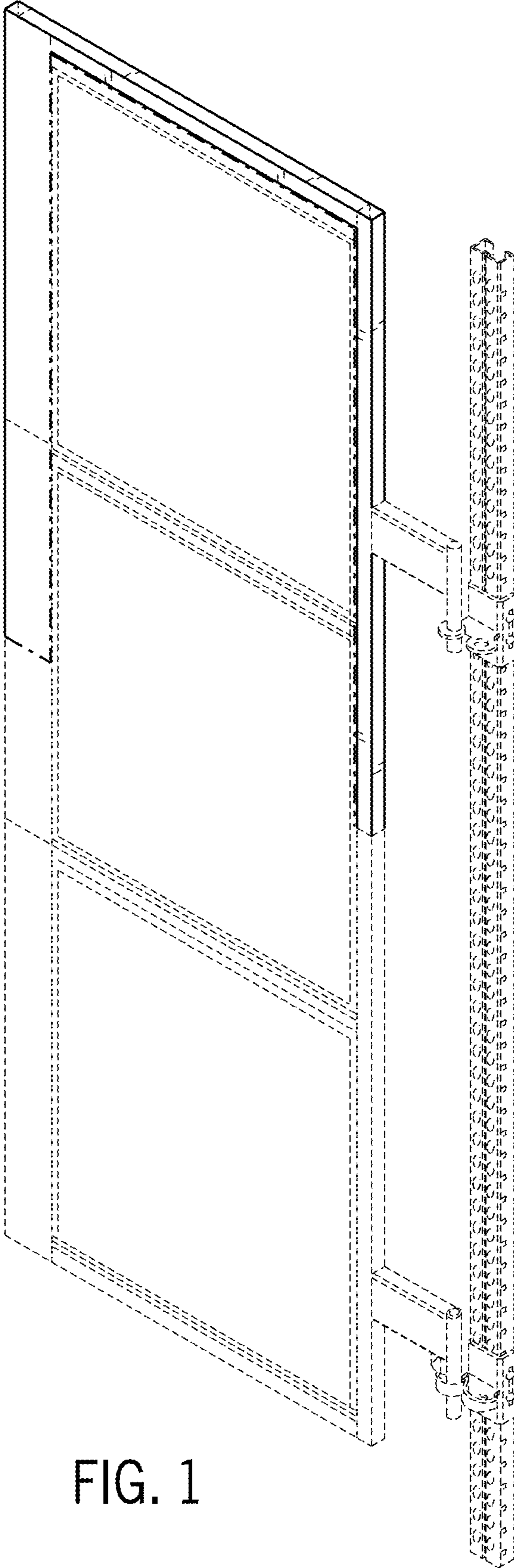

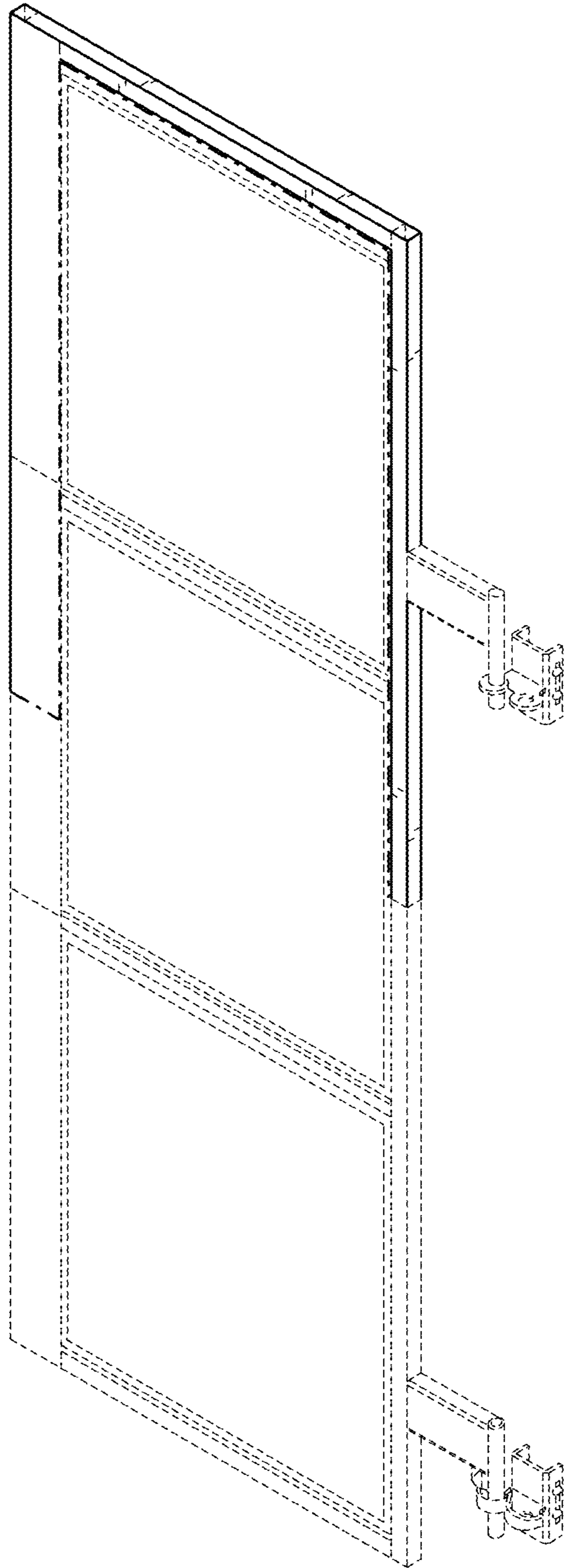
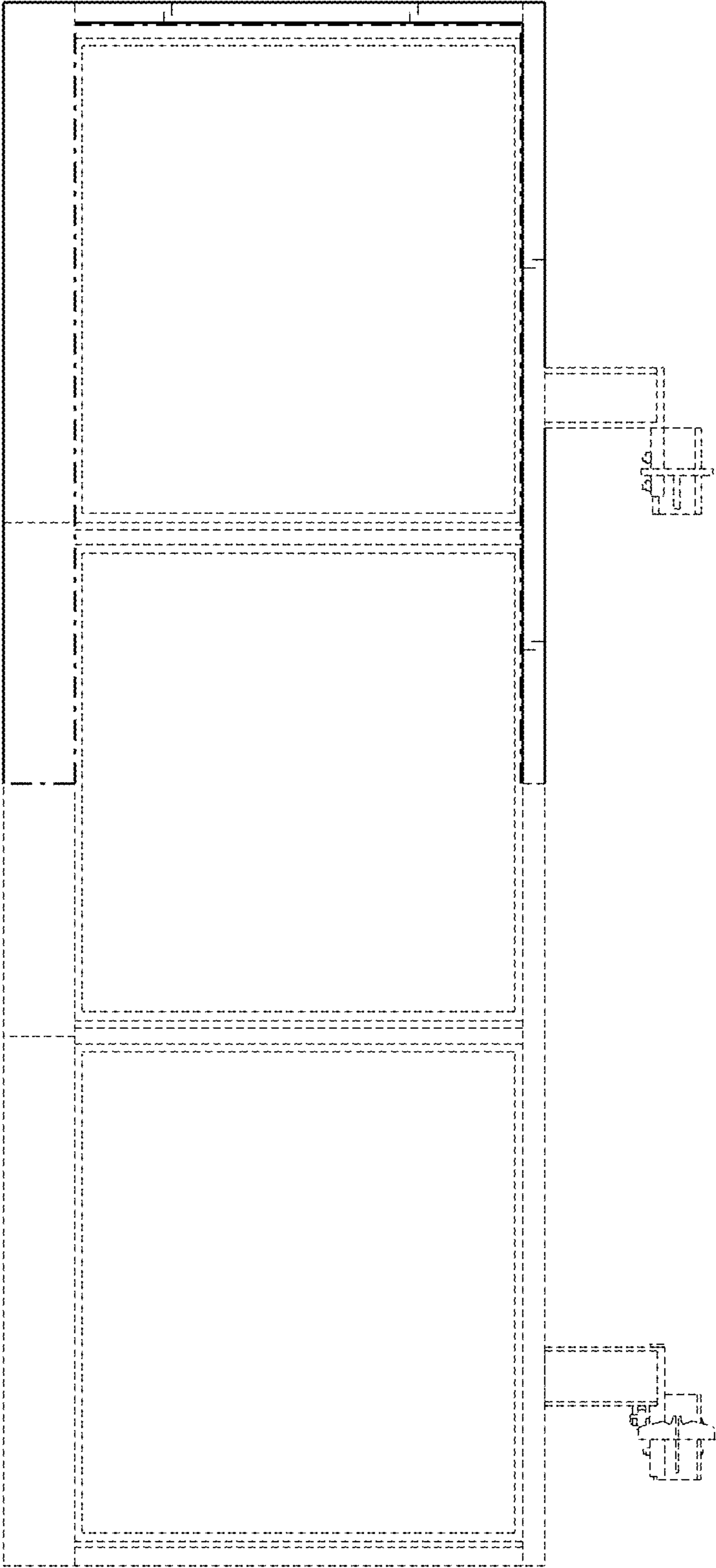

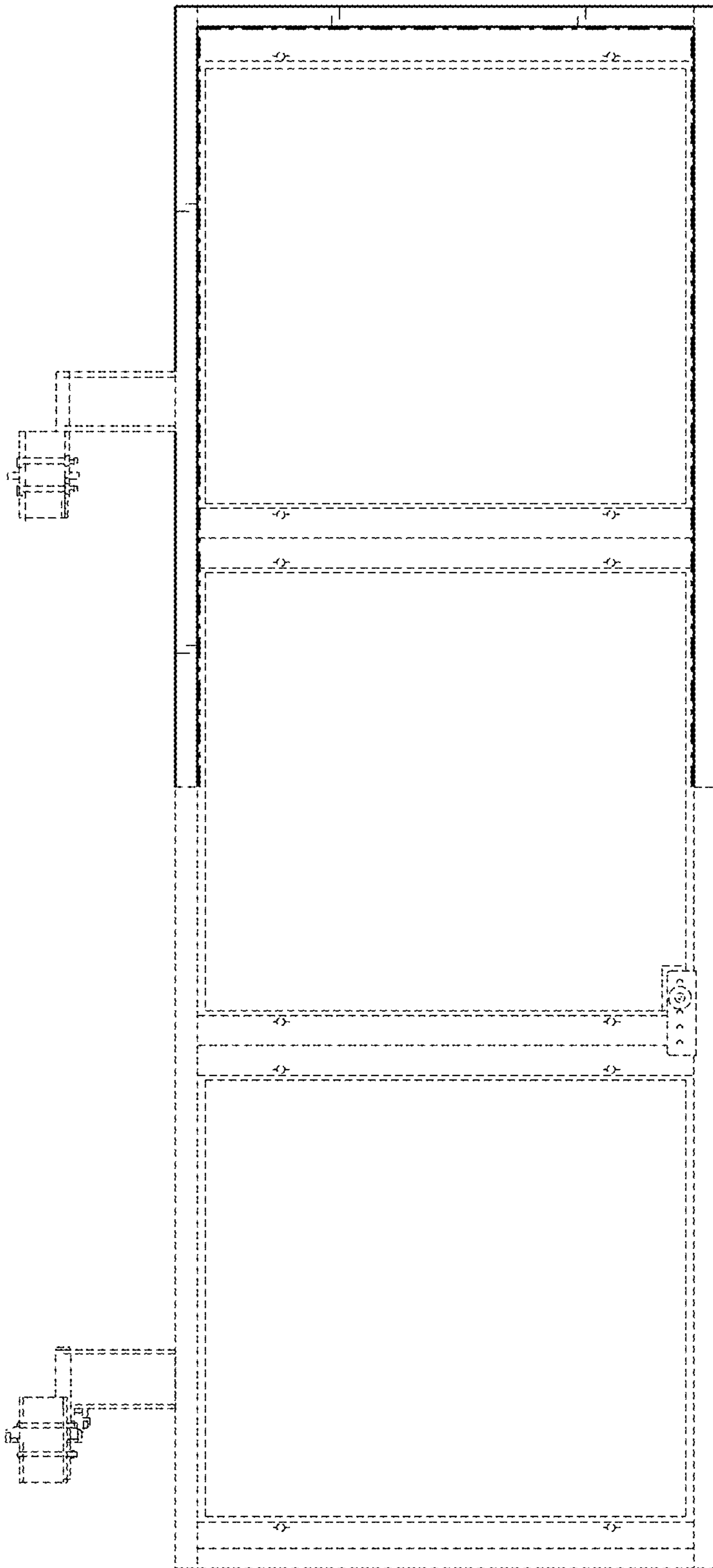

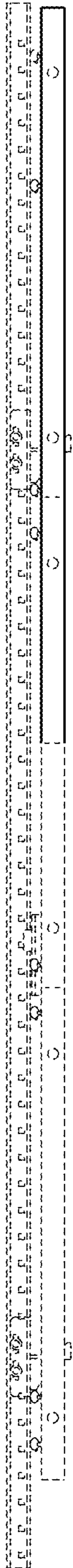
