DESCRIPTION

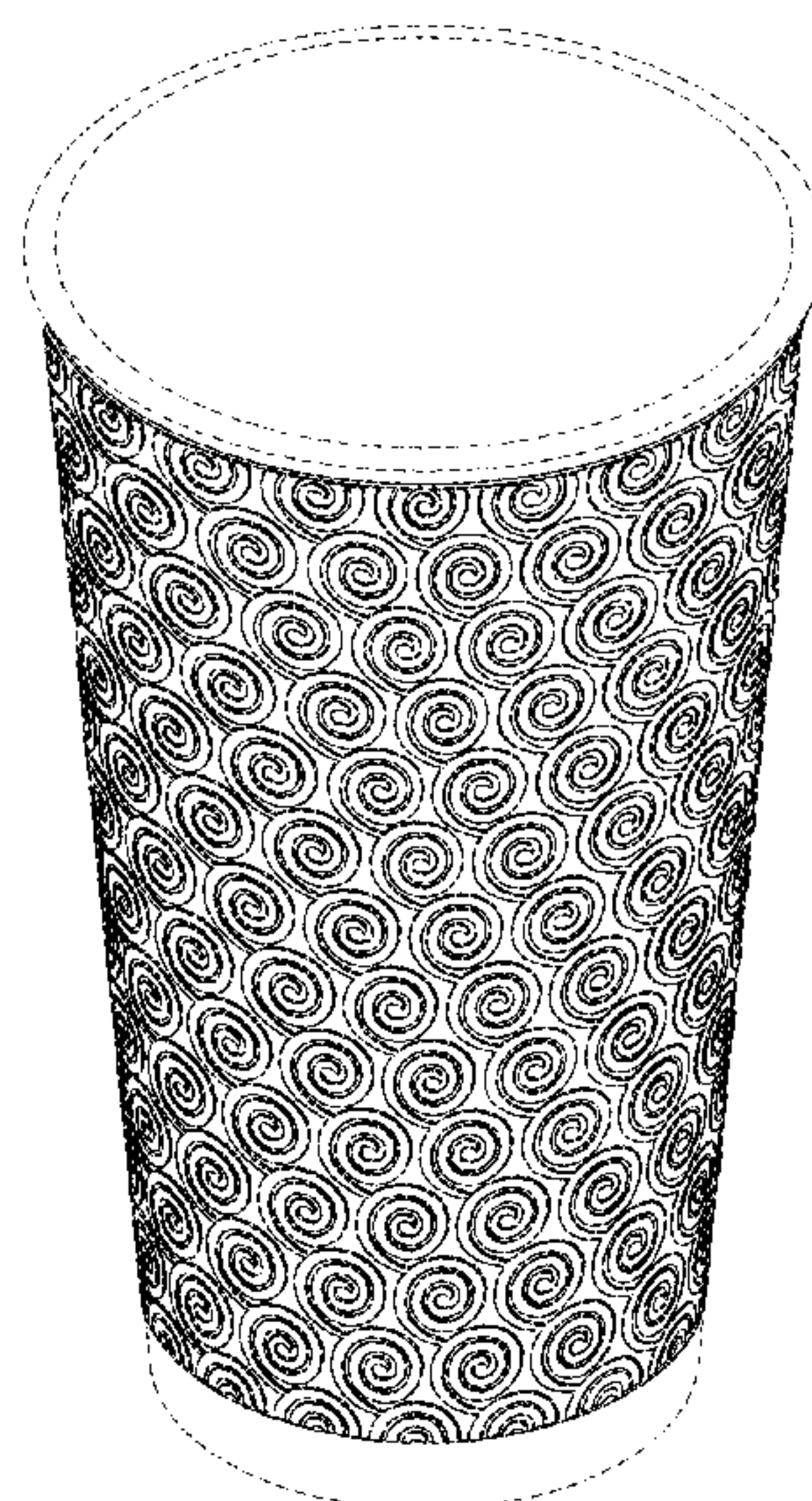
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the design of an insulating cup sleeve showing the new design;
