(57) CLAIM

What is claimed is the ornamental design for a shoe with ball and chain, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe with ball and chain;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.
The broken lines shown in the figures are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the shoe with ball and chain and form no part of the claimed design.

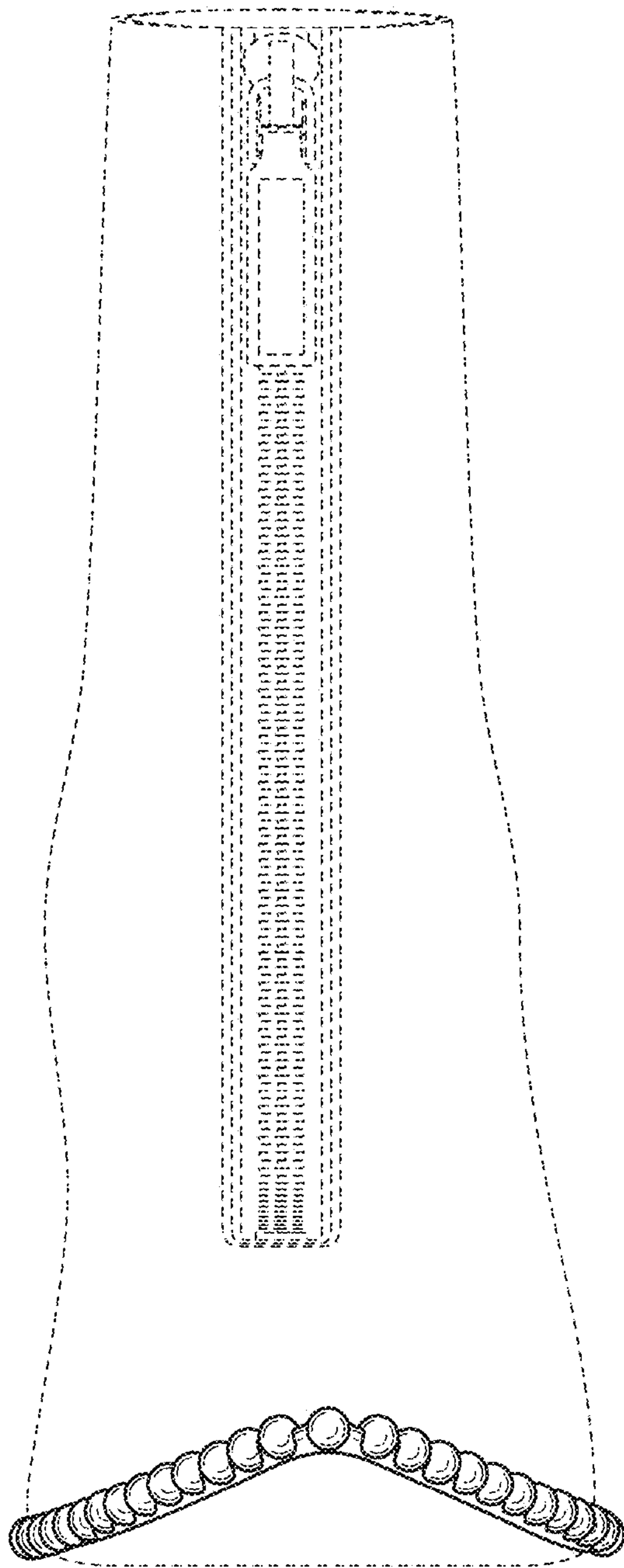

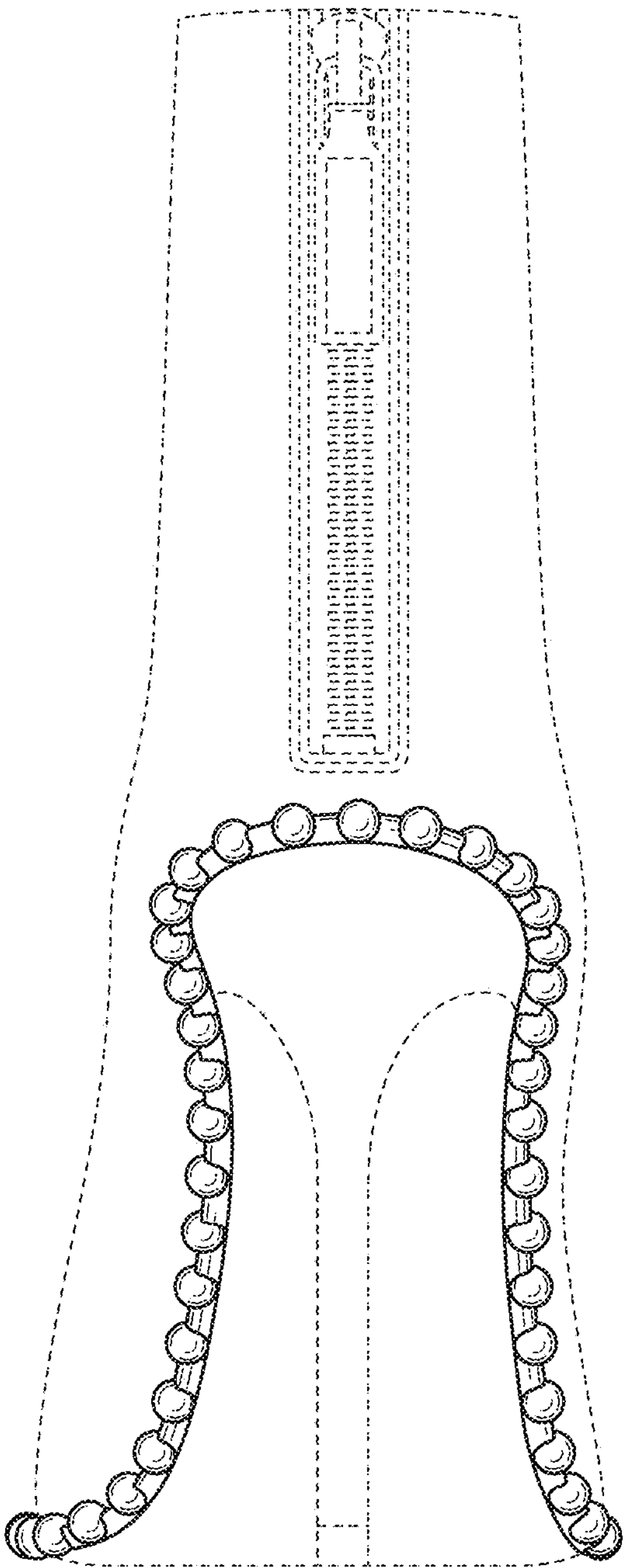
