The broken lines shown represent portions of the flexible hose with tool engagement surface and hose connection/hose fittings that form no part of the claimed design.

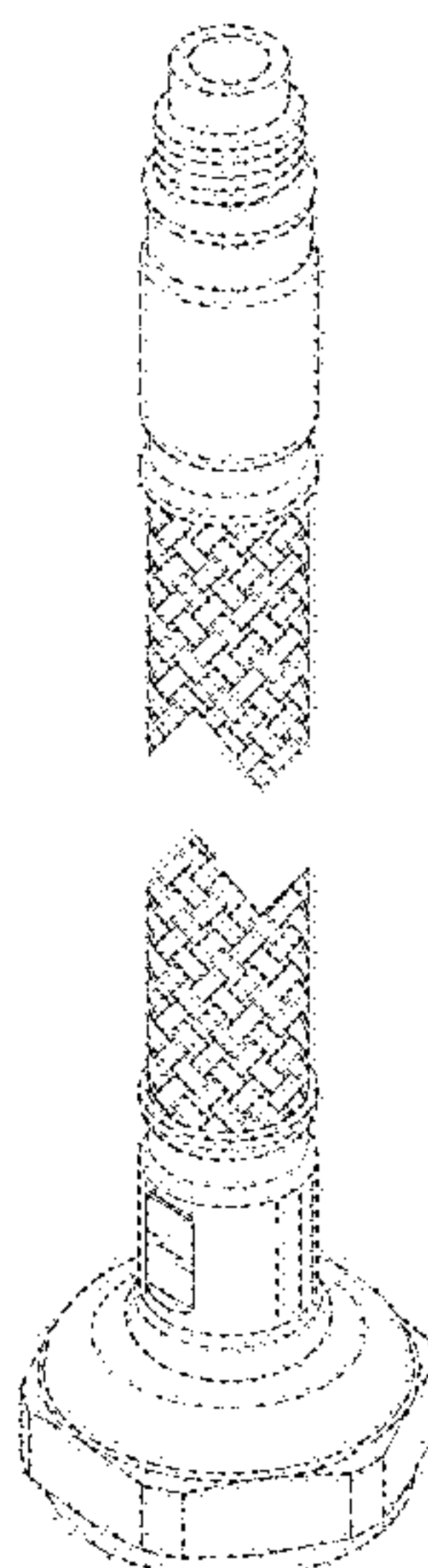

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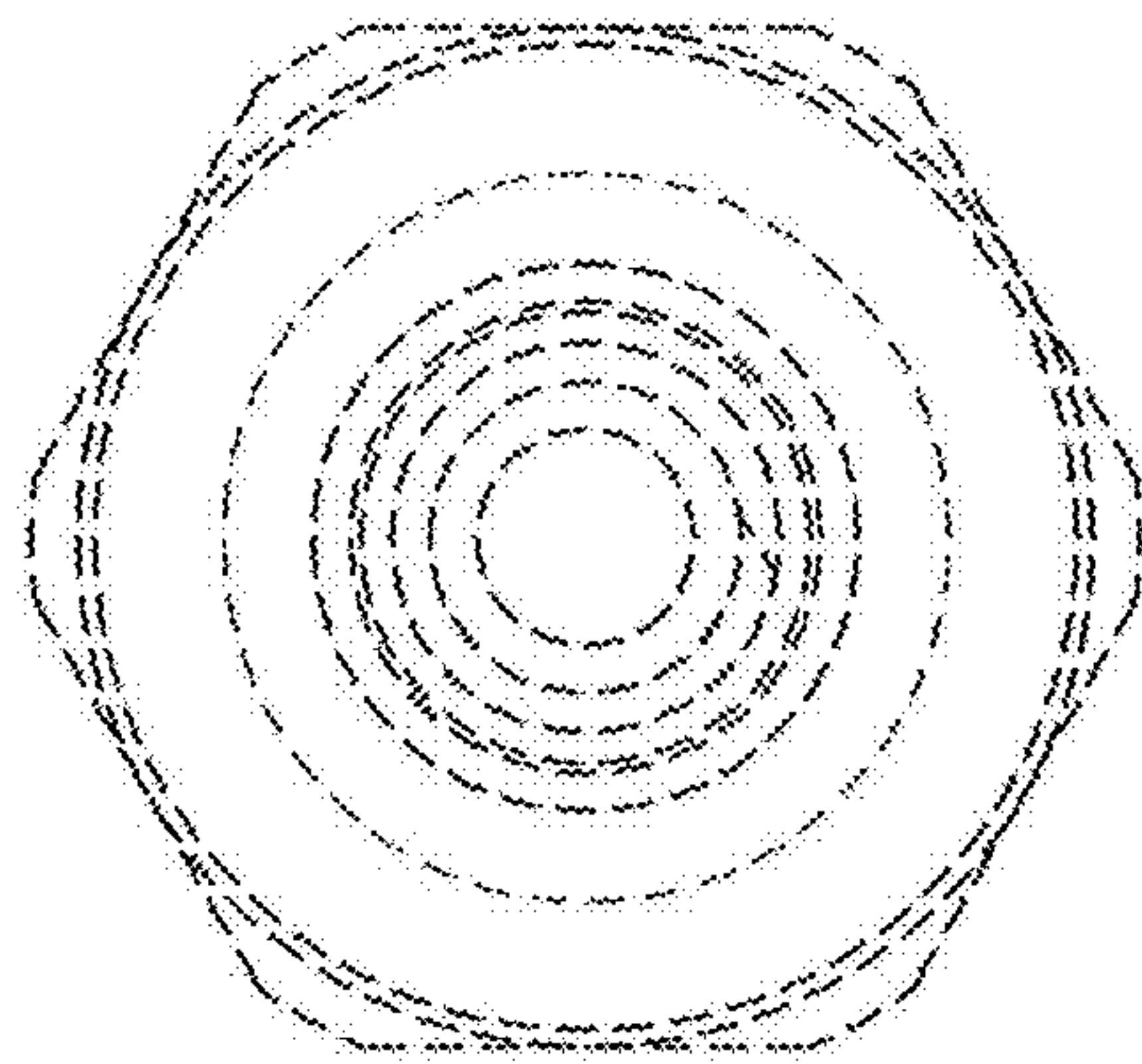

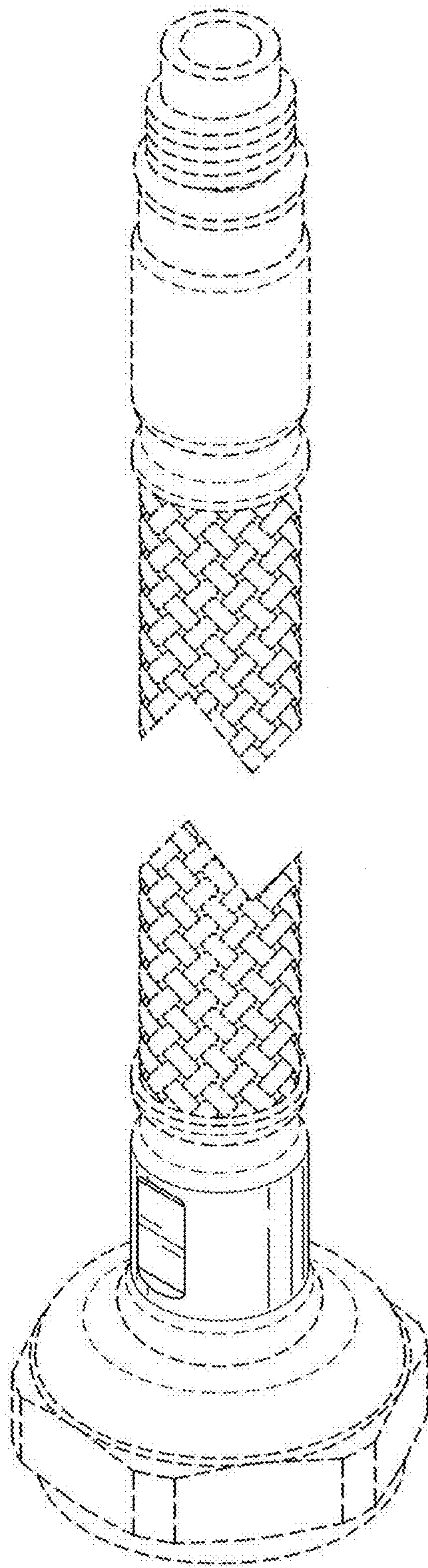

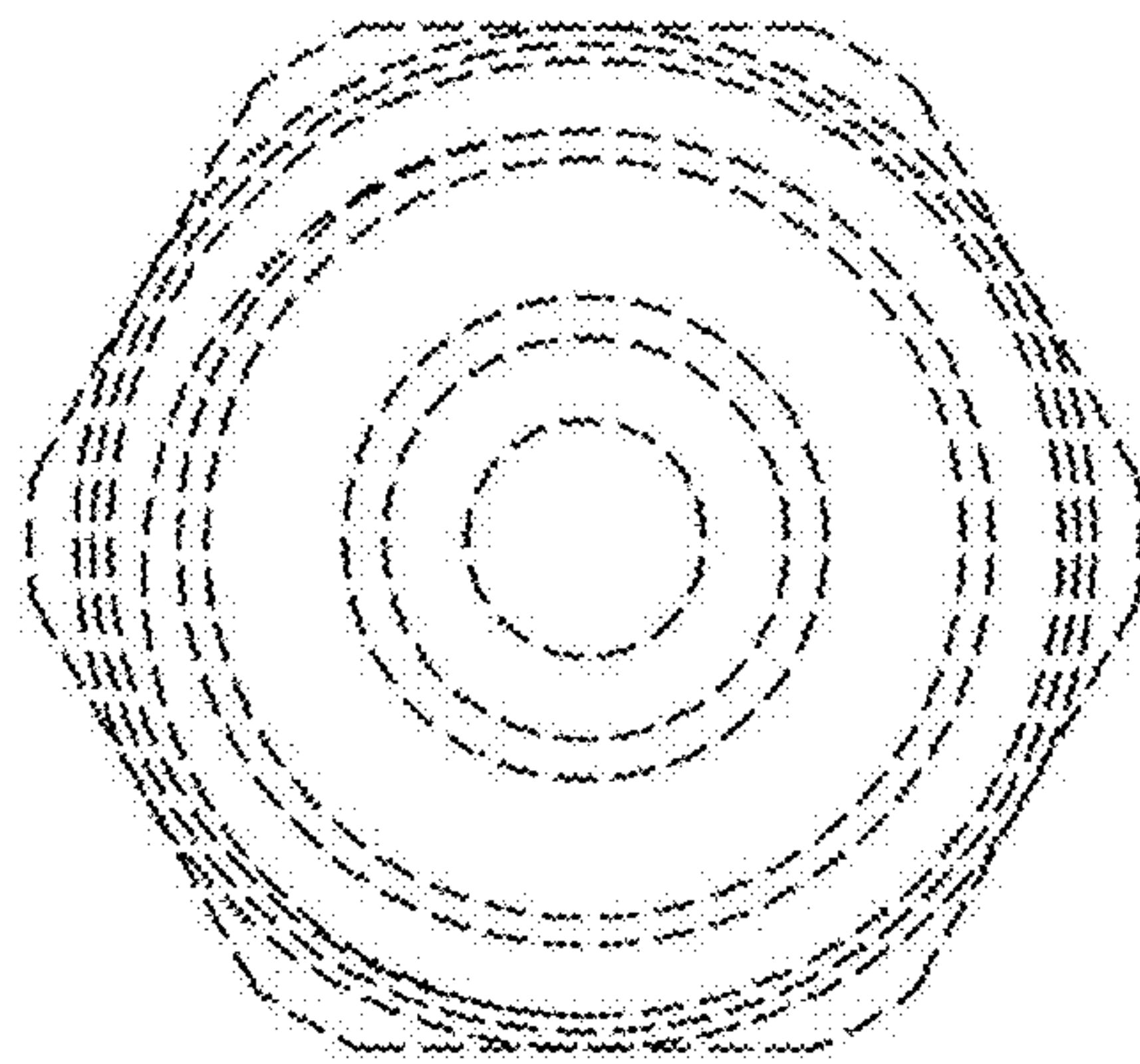

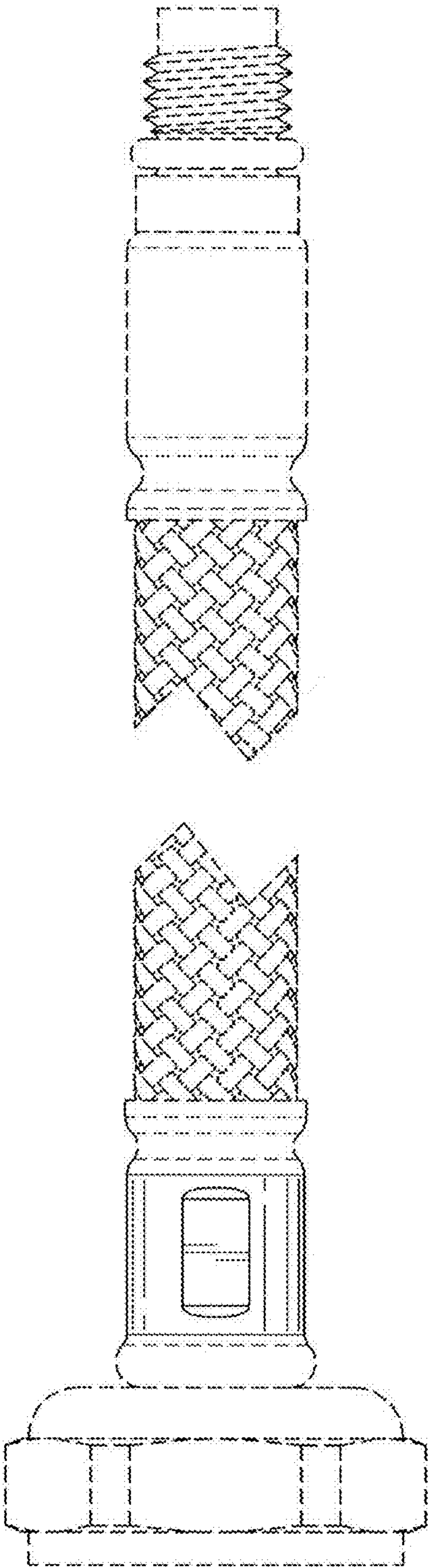

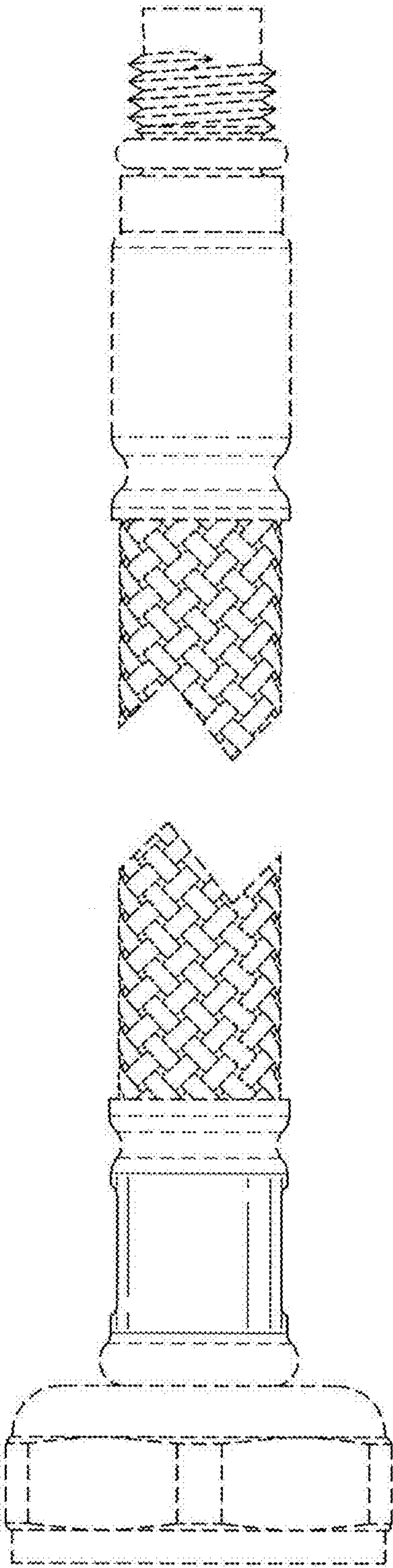

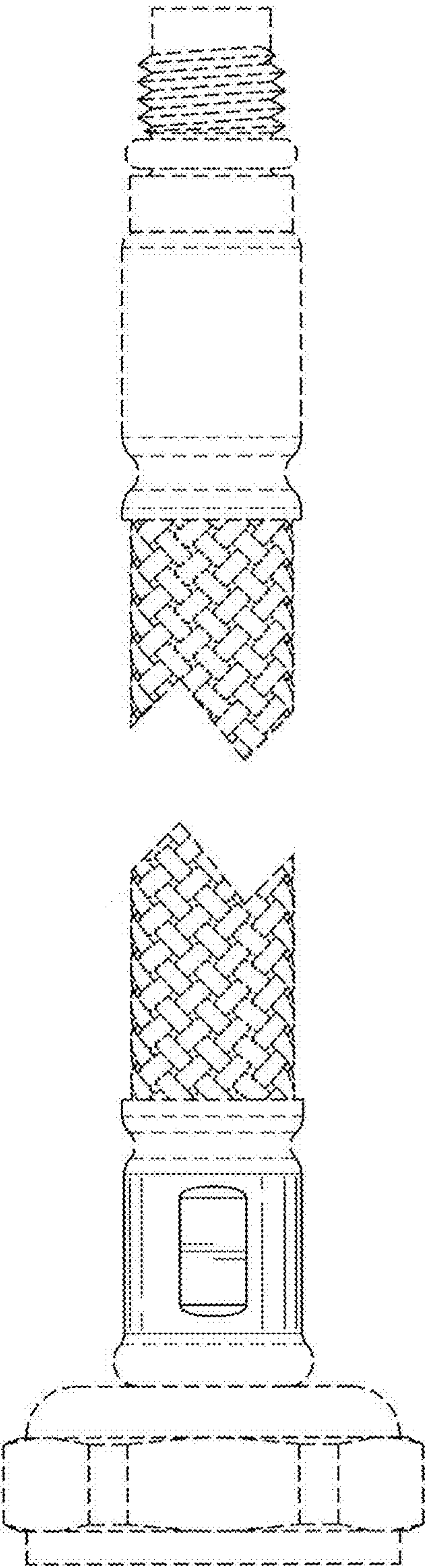

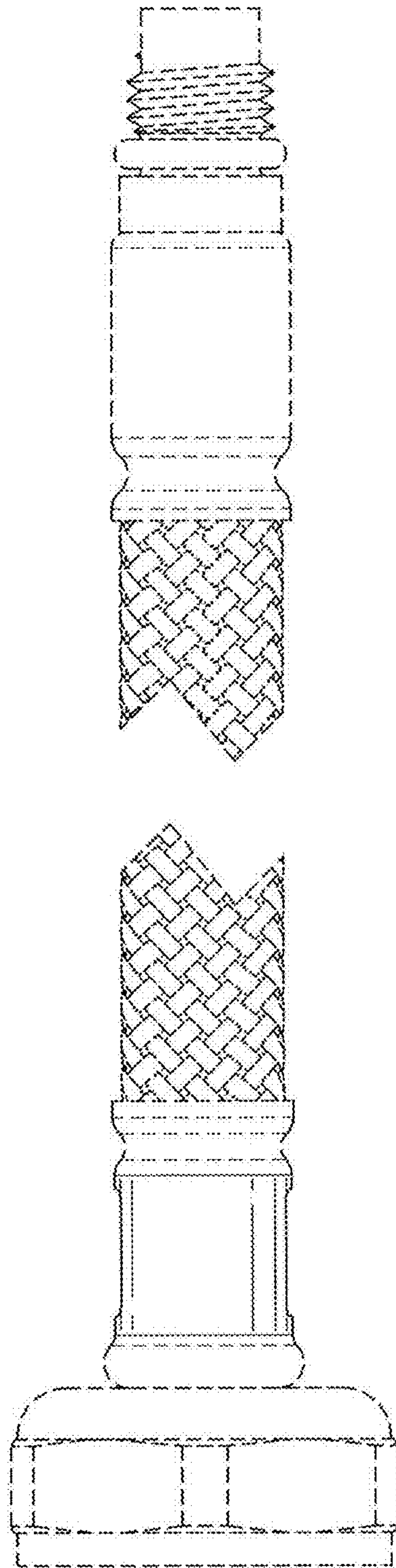

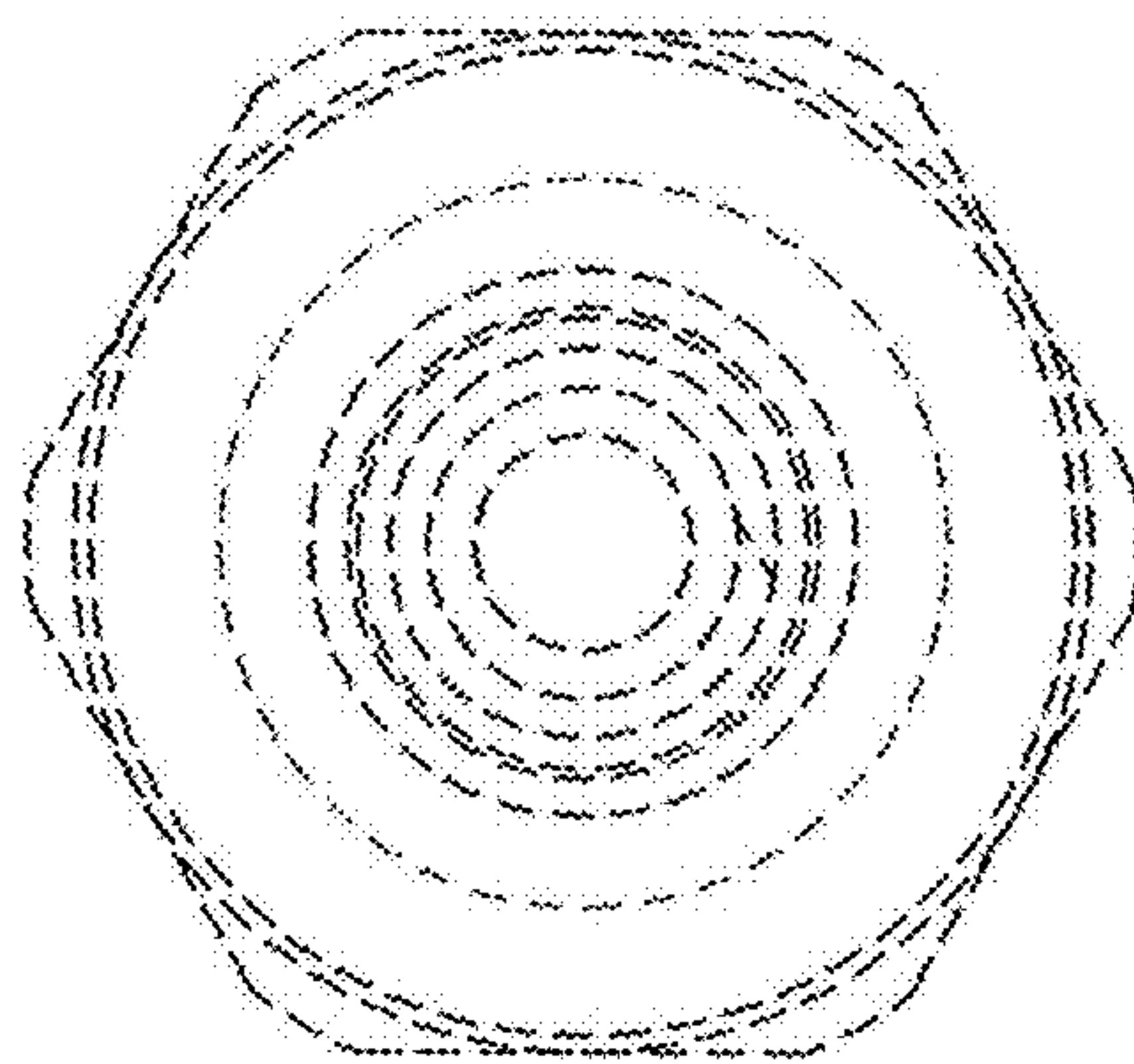

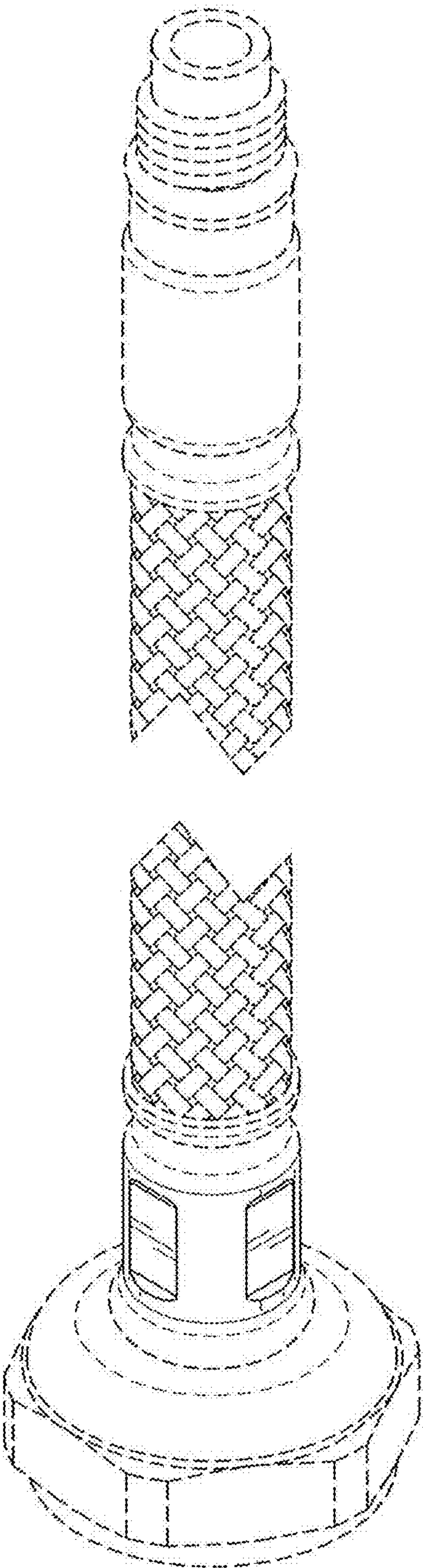

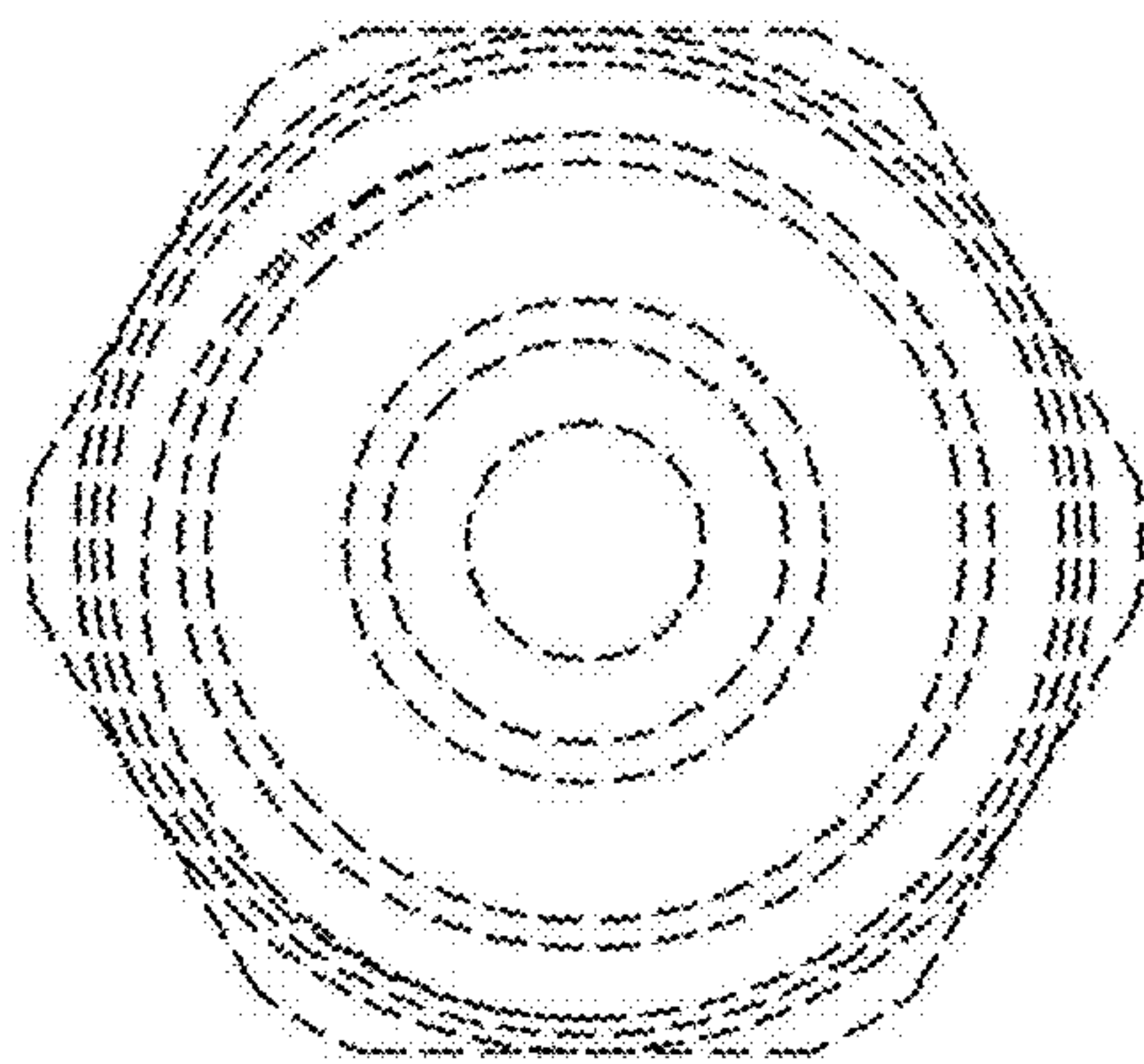

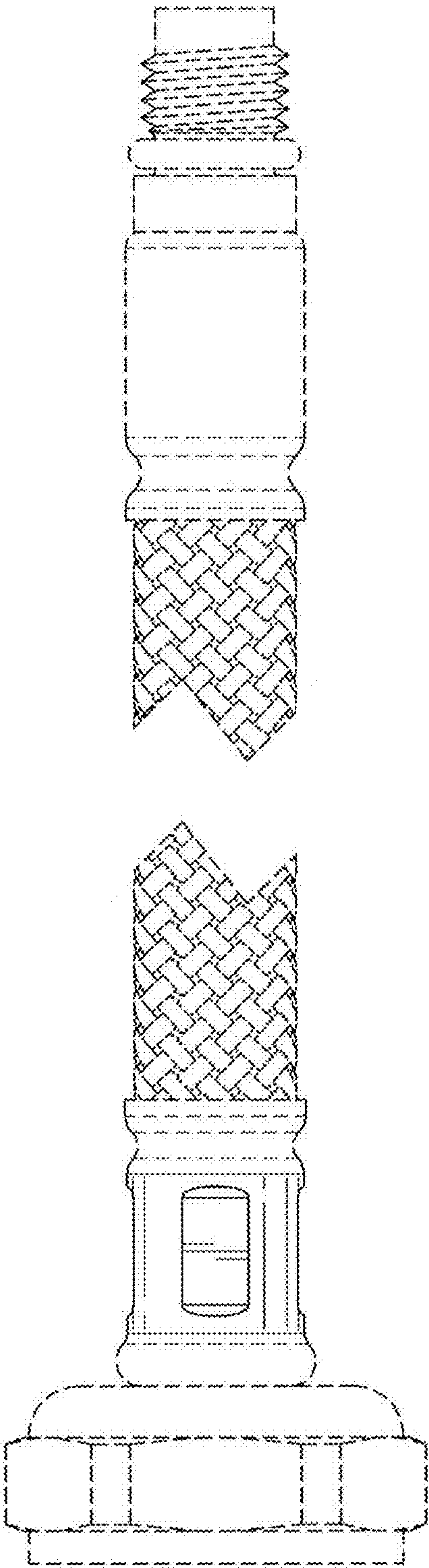

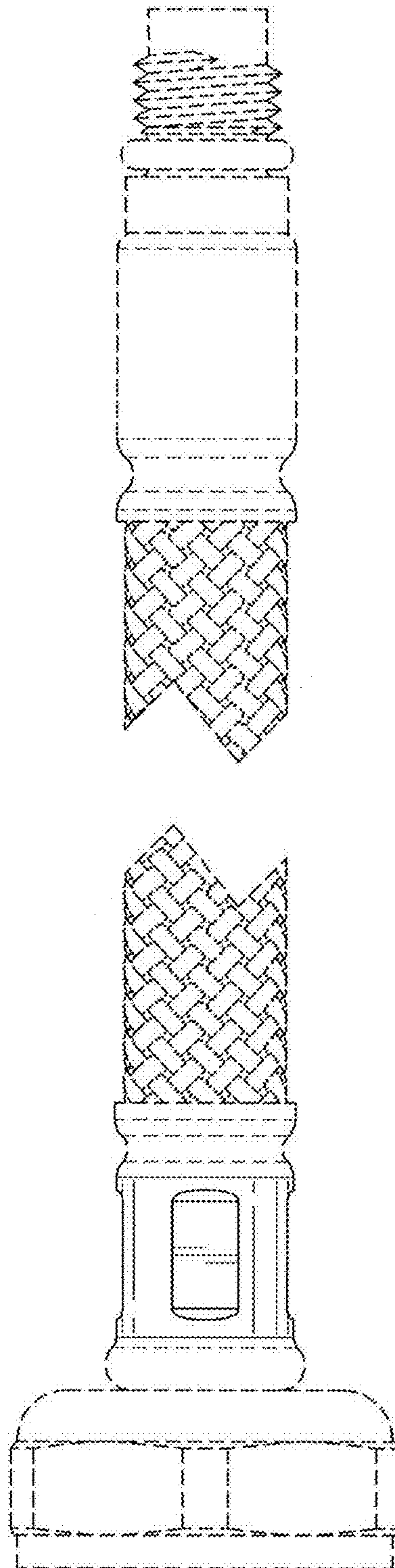

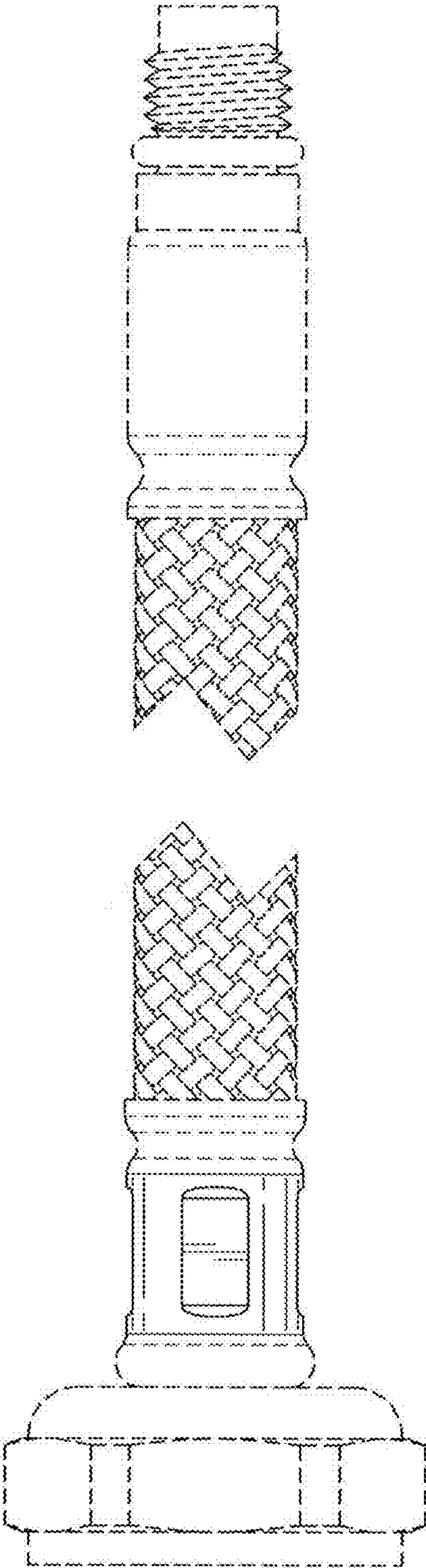

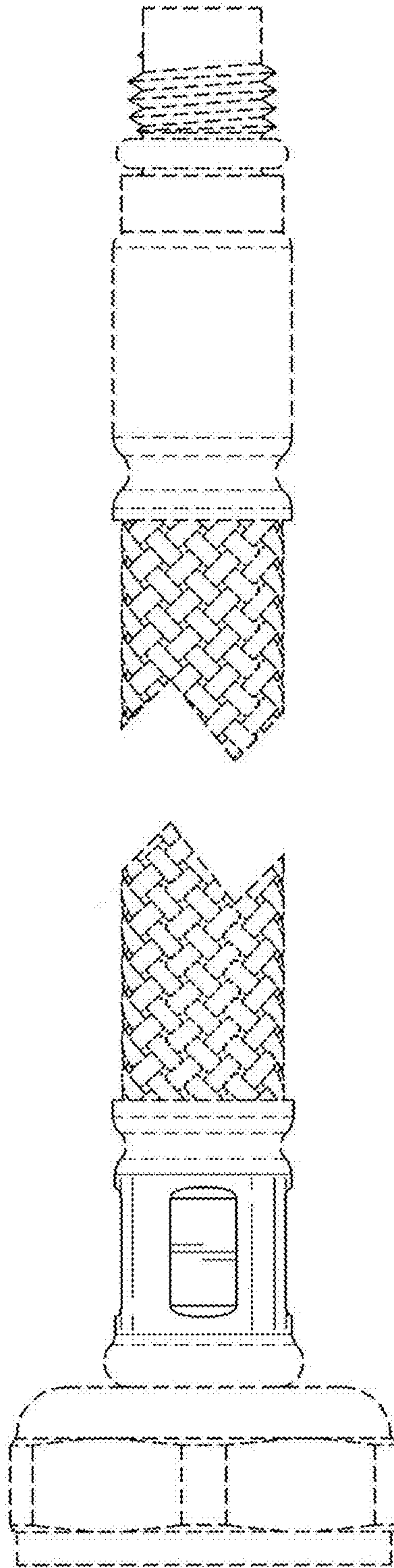
