(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a maternal belly band, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a maternal belly band
showing our new ornamental design.

FIG. 2 is front elevation view thereof with an extender
portion of a maternal belly band shown as detached from a
front portion of the maternal belly band and because the
extender portion is elastic or soft the bottom and top line are
shown curved after detachment.

FIG. 3 is back elevation view thereof with an extender
portion of a maternal belly band shown as detached from a
front portion of the maternal belly band and because the
extender portion is elastic or soft the bottom and top line are
shown curved after detachment.

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a back elevation view thereof

FIG. 6 is a top, plan view thereof.

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

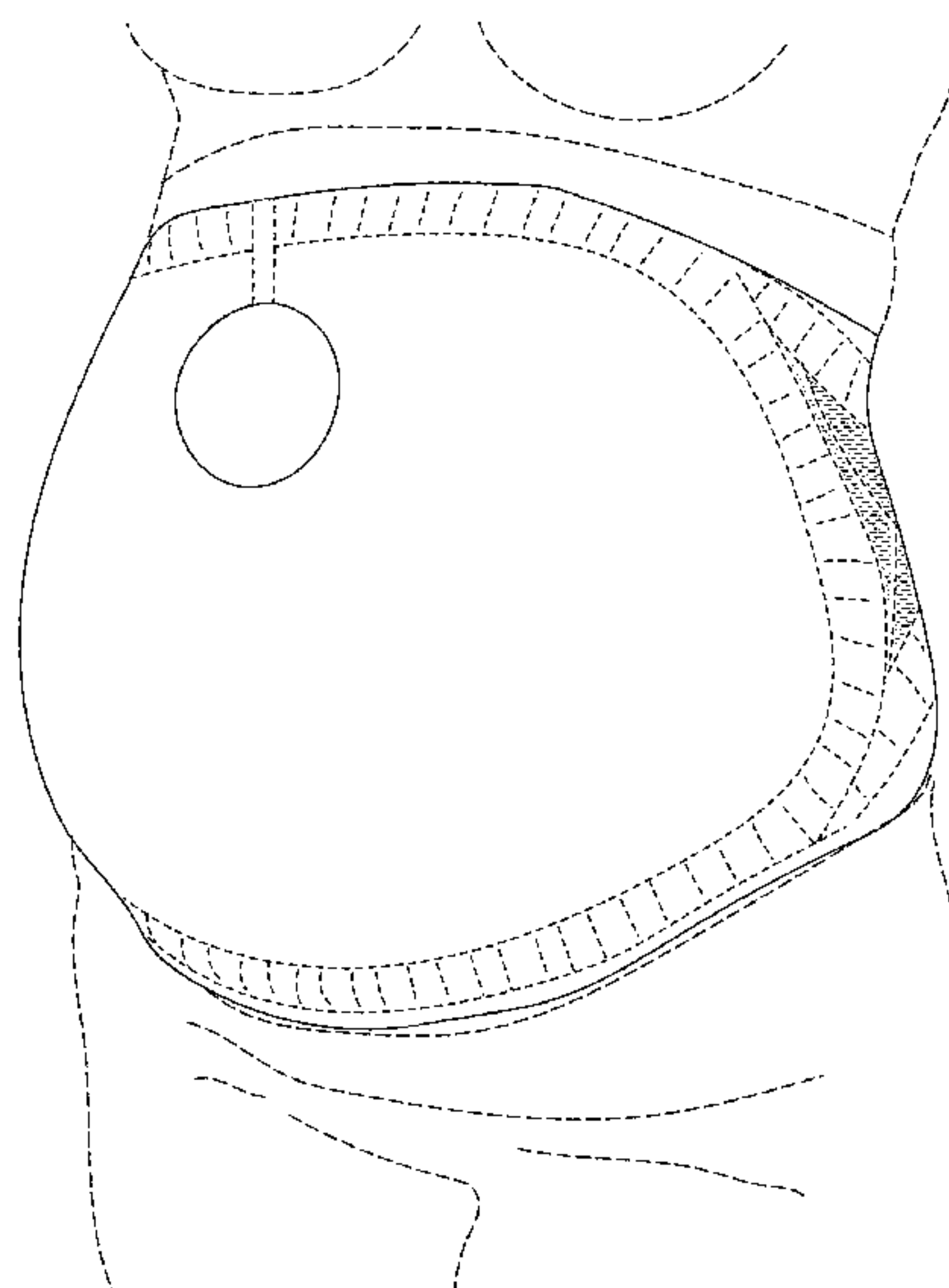
FIG. 8 is a left elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 9 is a right elevational view thereof.

The above described figures do not provide true elevation or
plan views, but are perspective views of a soft good that may
comprise different proportions and shape depending upon
the appendage to which the soft good is attached.

environmental subject matter and form no part of the
claimed design. All other dashed lines in the figures depict
portions of the maternal belly band that form no part of the
claimed design.

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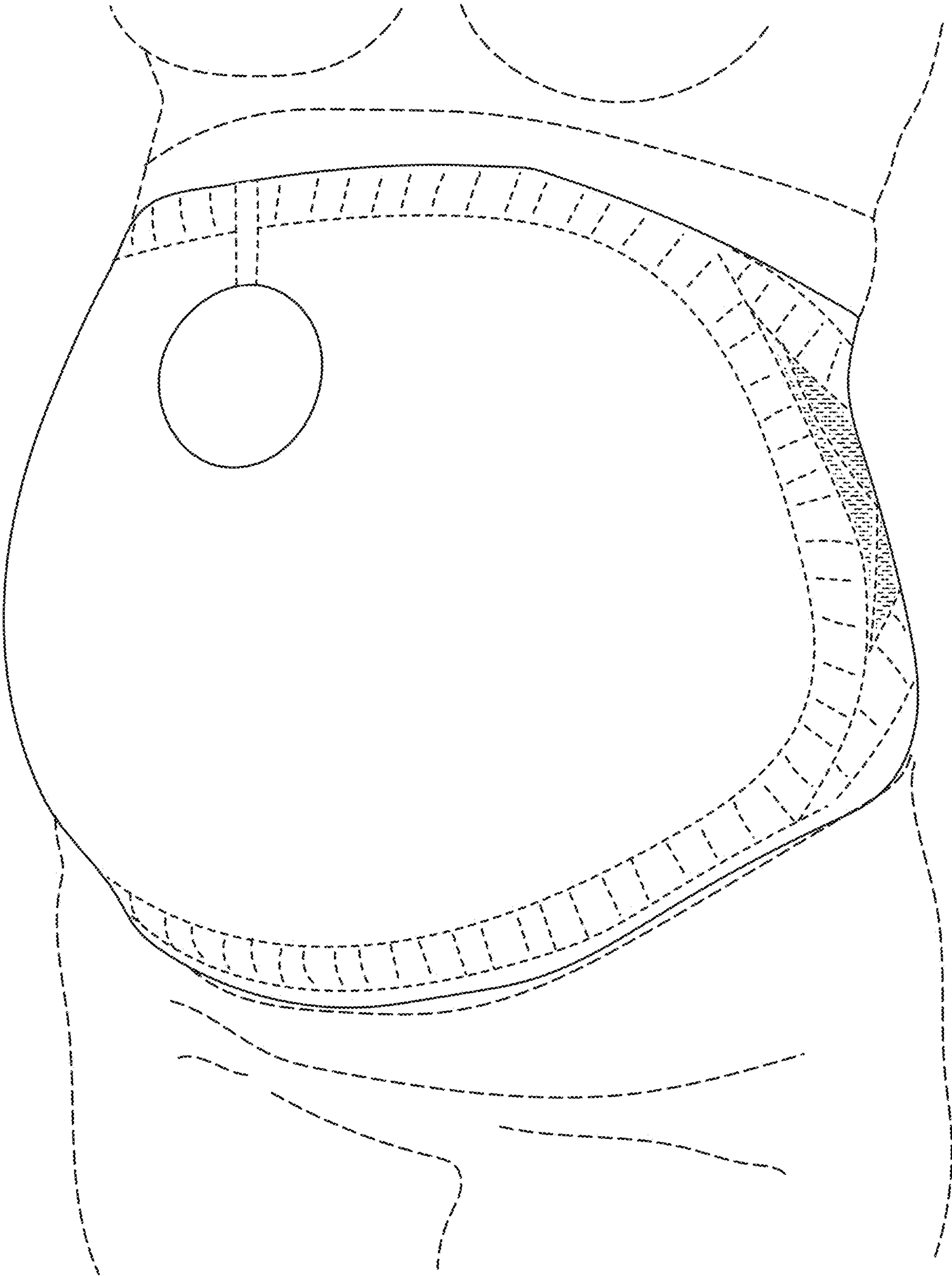

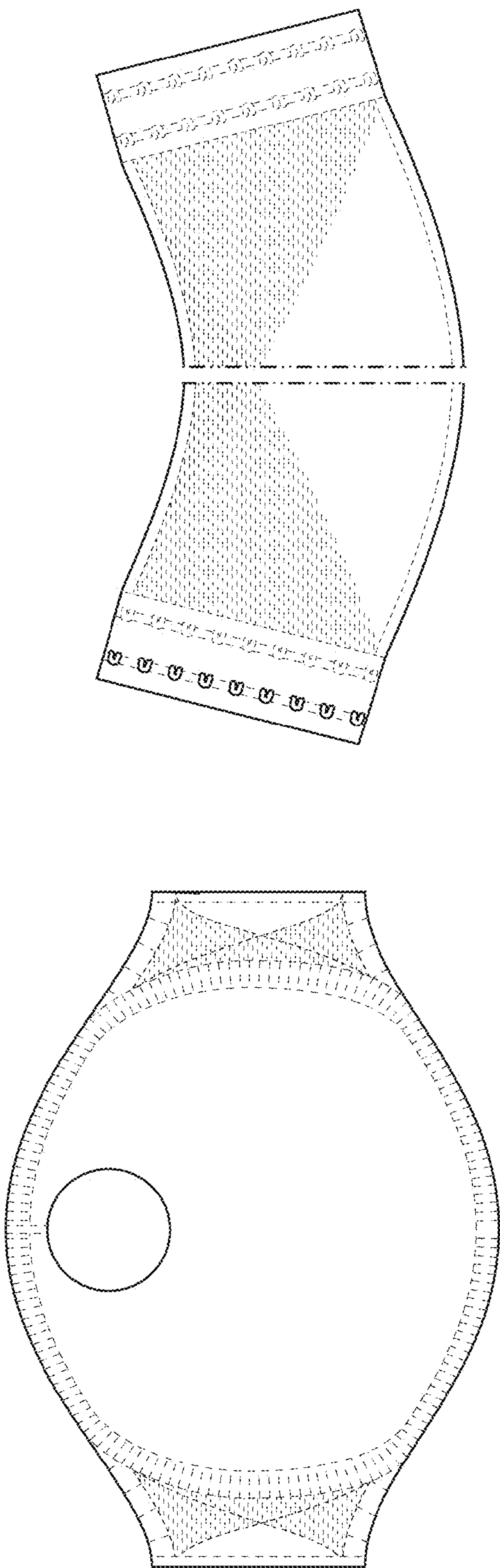

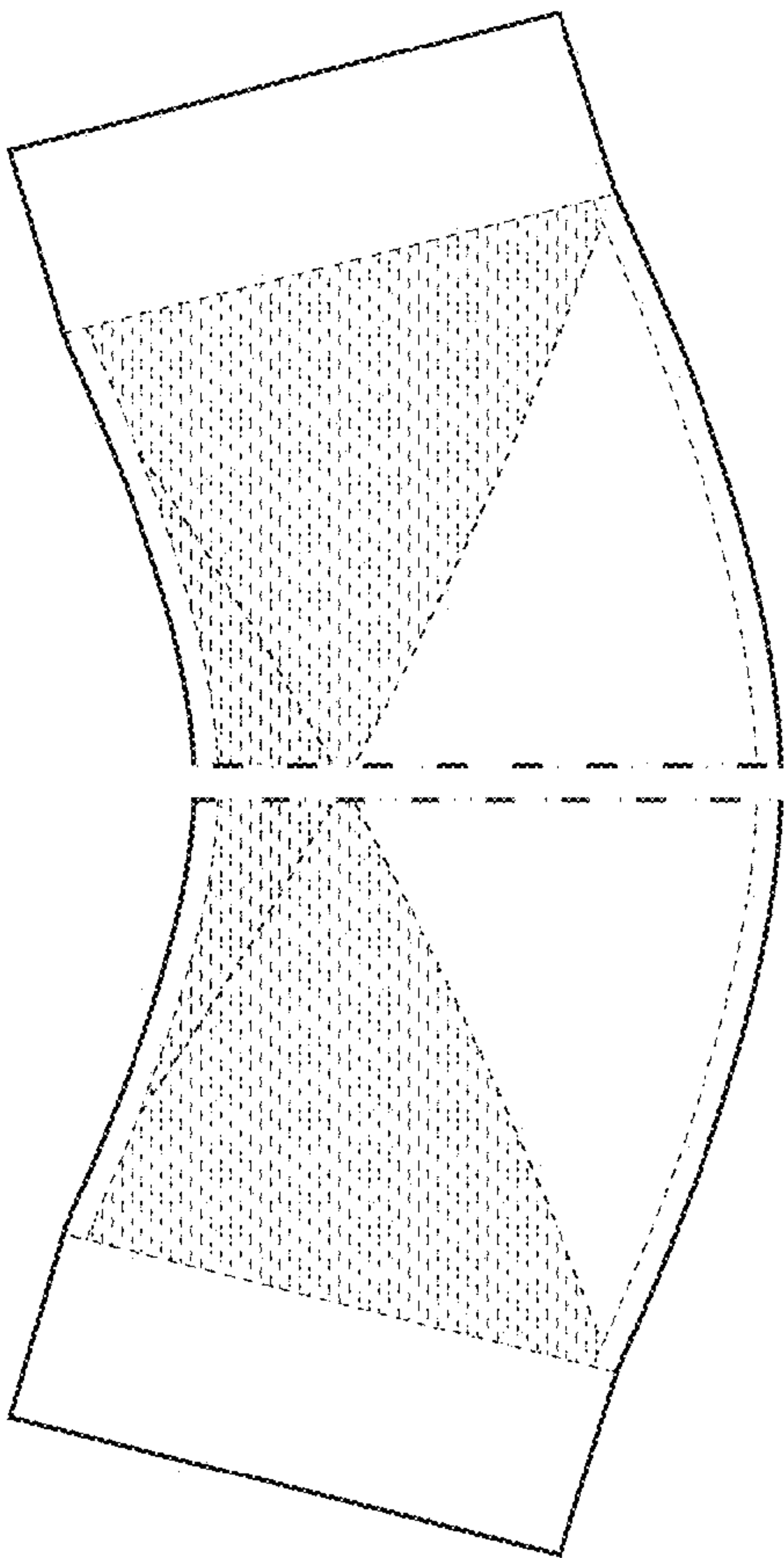
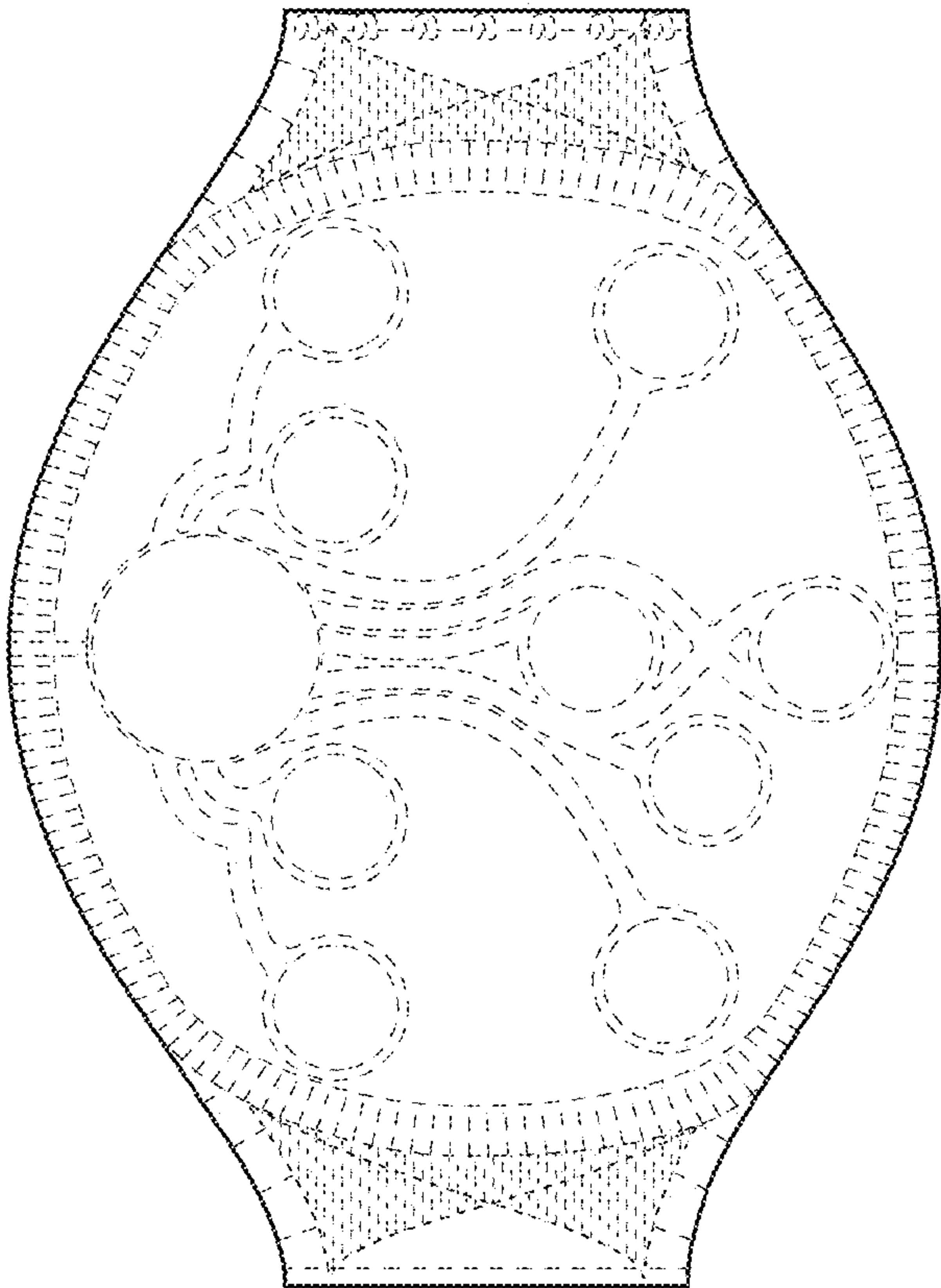

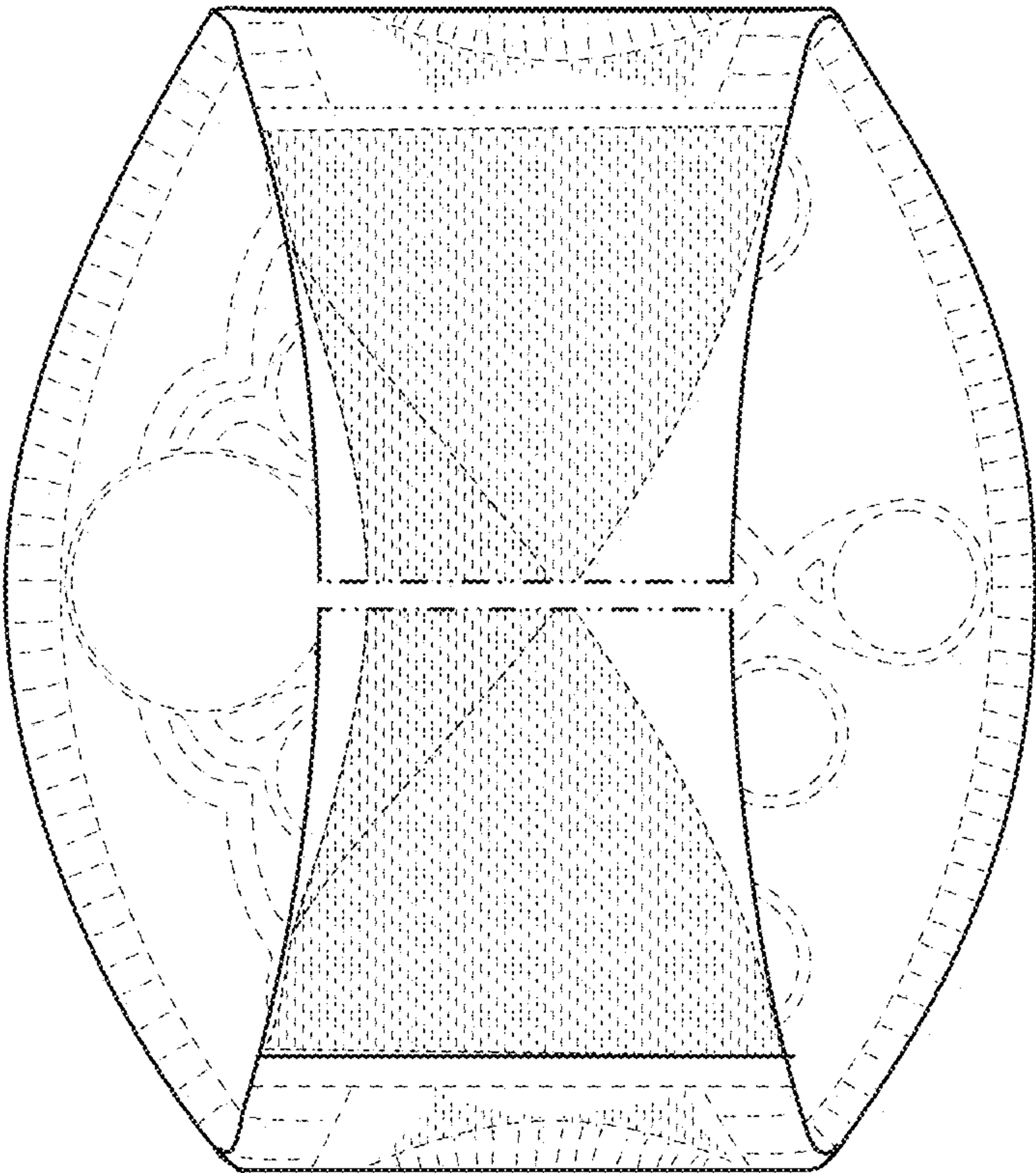

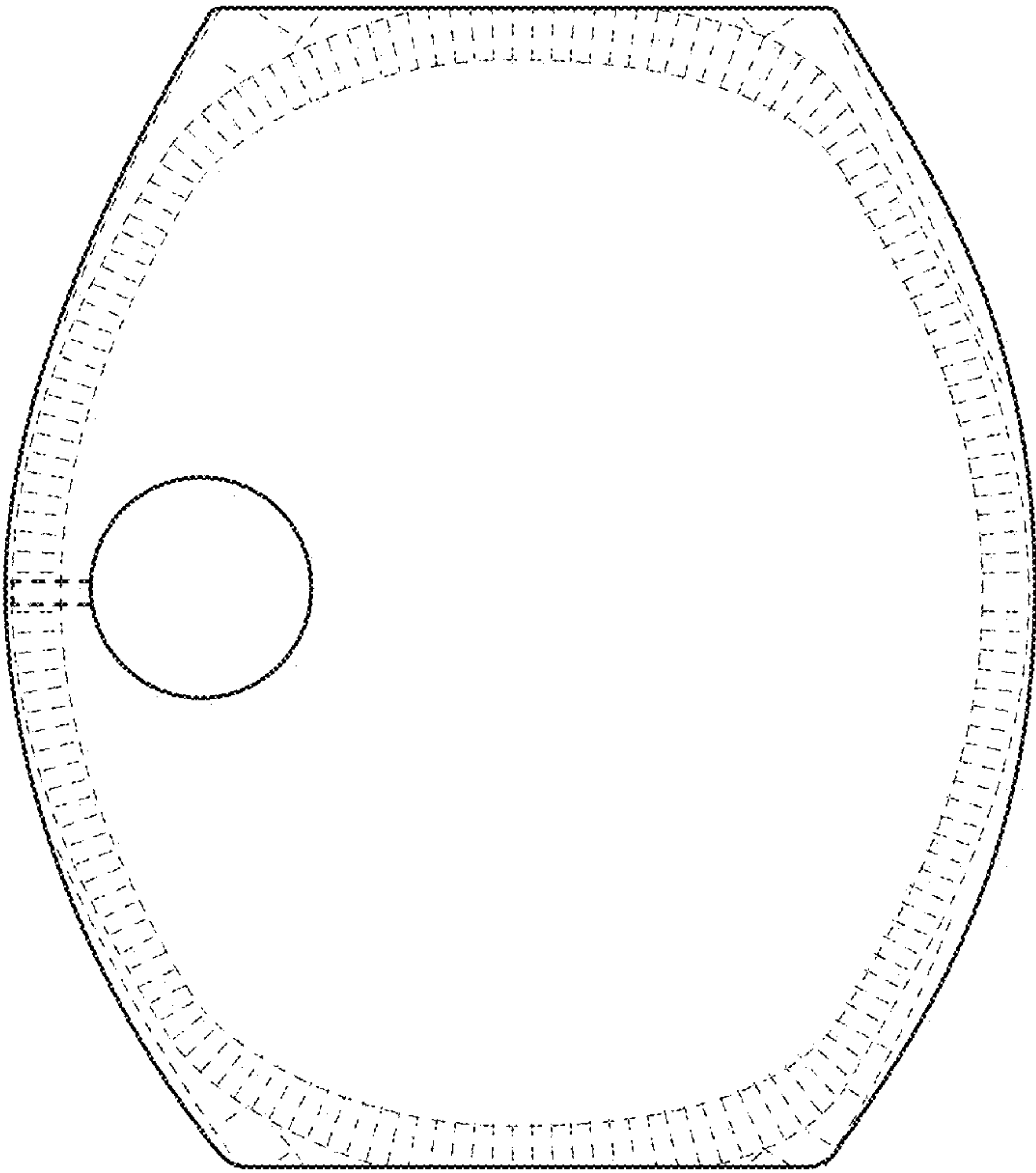

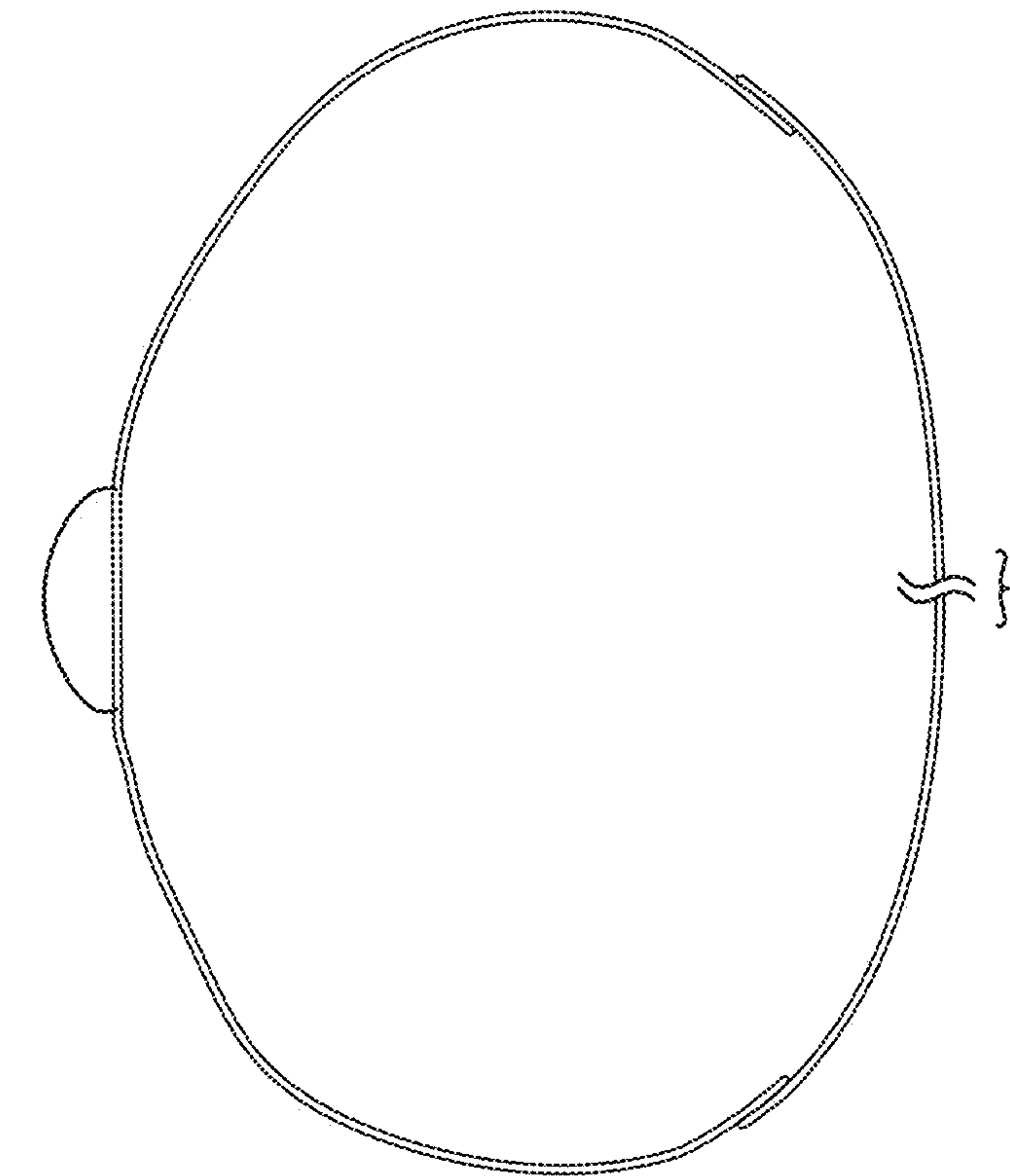

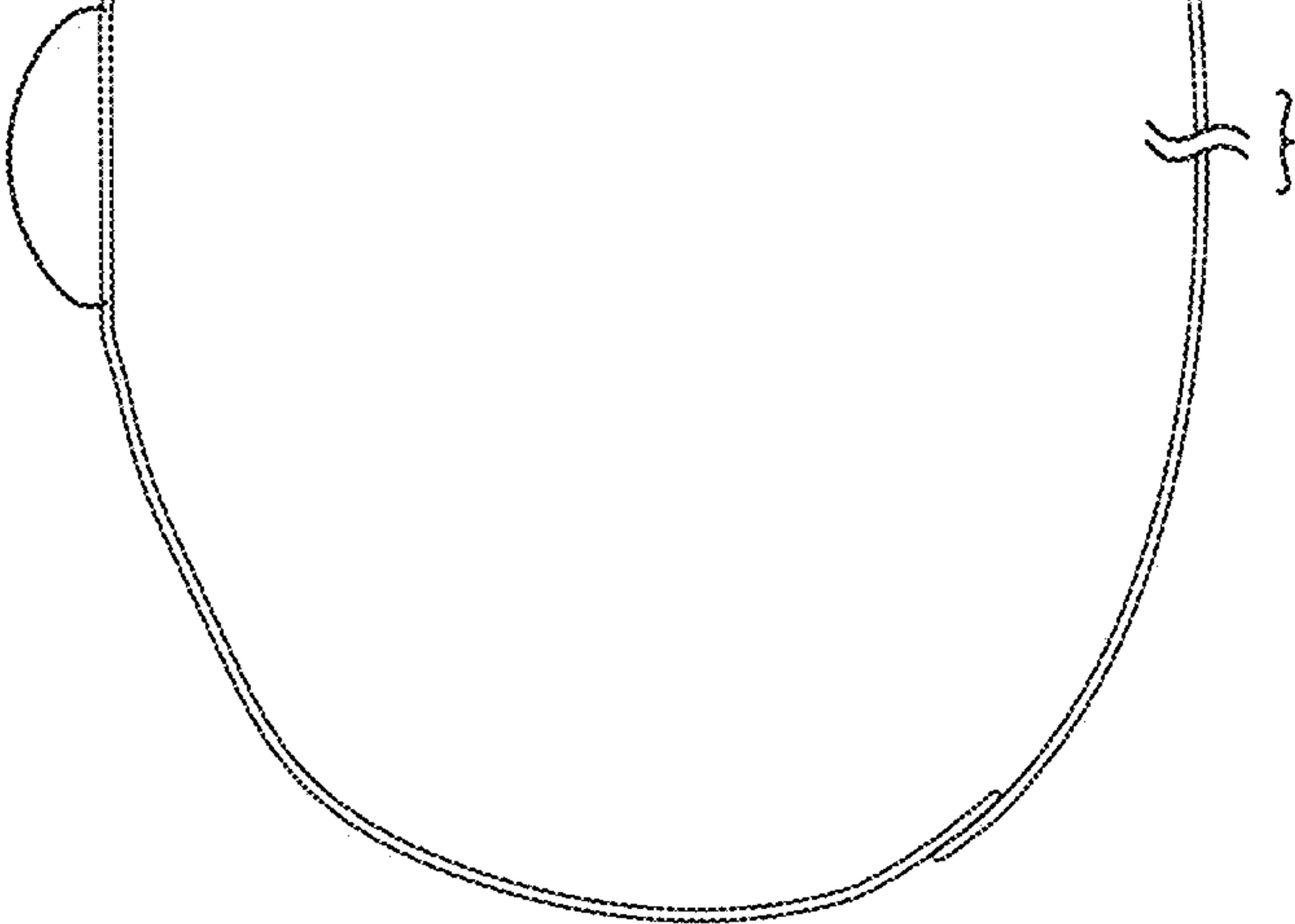

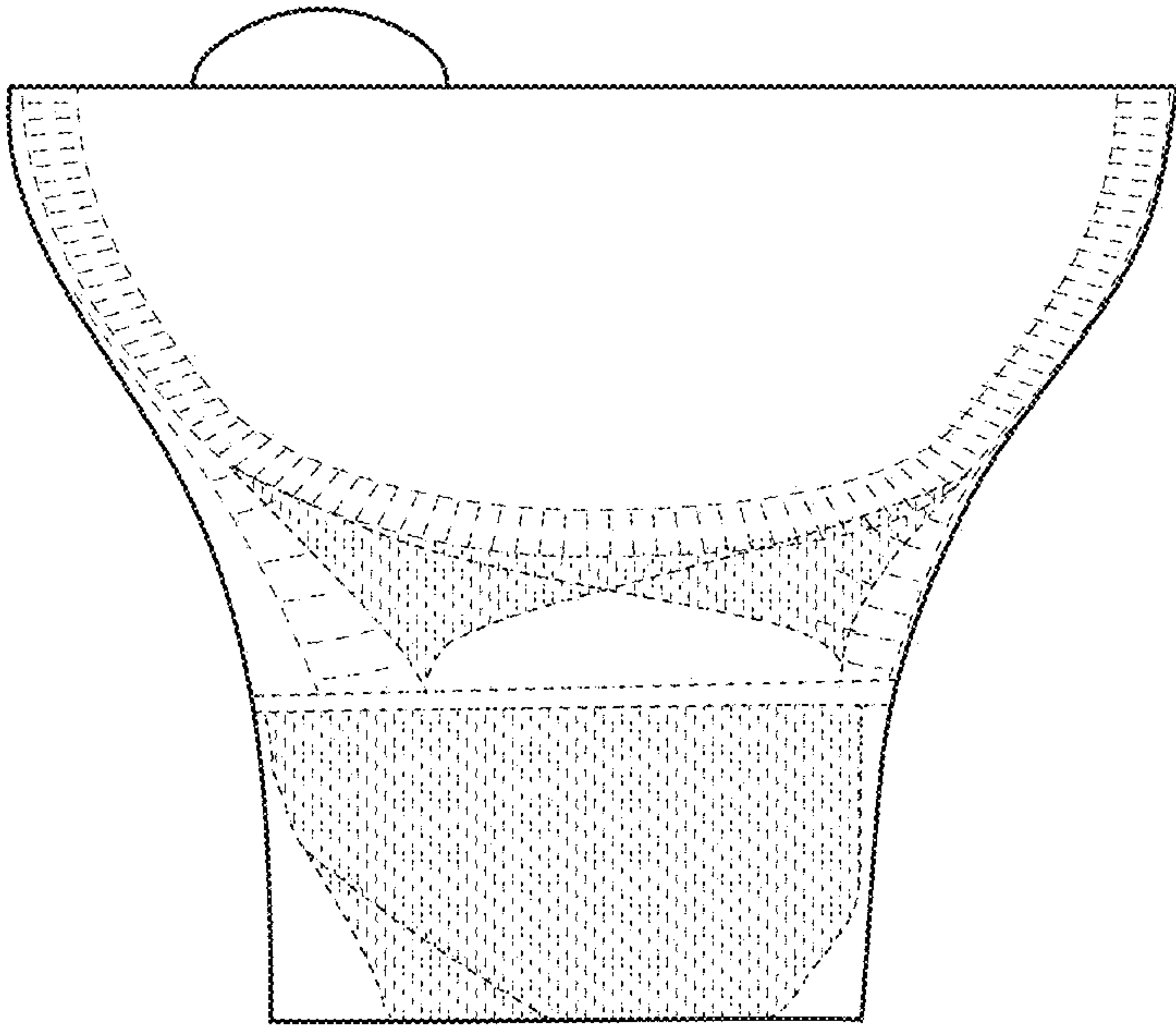

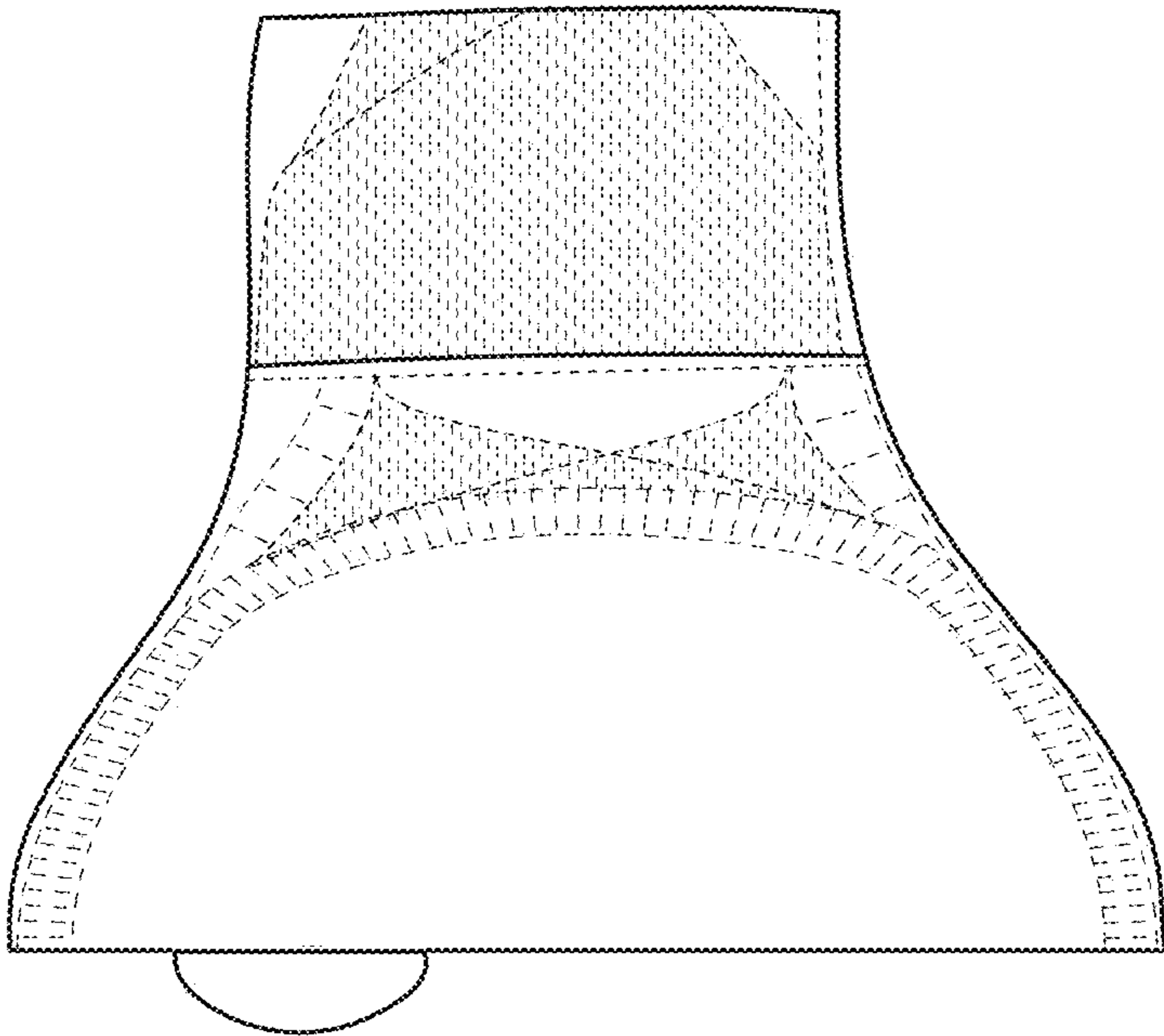
